# Build your own AI harness racing machine learning betting model

## BETWEEN THE LINES

Much has been made through the years of the gap between the commercial betting syndicates and computer-assisted wagering (CAW) operations, compared to your typical retail harness player. On one side is the average harness handicapper armed with nothing more than a race program format that's been unchanged for 100 years. And on the other side has been an army of groups with unlimited resources, data scientists, and access to proprietary data.

It's always been an impossible gap between the two groups, but times are changing fast and dramatically.

The latest versions of AI tools have helped level the playing field in ways that wouldn't have even been imaginable up until very recently. I would say any person who has knowledge of the sport (and if you're reading this, that's you) combined with curiosity and a foundational understanding of data – can now build something that in the past would have taken a team of developer's months or years to build.

Easily the most impressive AI tool I've seen is Claude, by Anthropic. To the extent it can take domain knowledge provided by a motivated handicapper and use it to build a working predictive model is truly remarkable. Even as of a year ago using an AI tool to help build a serious model for a non-developer would have been significant work. But now, everything from transforming data into readable formats, building end-to-end code in any programming language, implementing the correct type of predictive methods, building diagnostics, and validations to troubleshoot – it's almost entirely automatic.

Here's a real-life guide as to what it would look like.

Using TrackMaster as the data provider in this example, go to the TrackMaster website and rather than purchasing a standard program in a PDF file format, instead download the data file in an XML format. What the XML provides is all the data that's behind the standard race program – but also with some additional data not always seen in the program page. Once you get into data at this level, you'll start to understand the advantages that these larger groups have had all these years, and this only scratches the surface.

Using Claude or your choice of AI, you're able to upload the data file and direct it to parse through all the thousands of lines of code, tell it what data you want extracted, and transform it into essentially a standard Excel file. I did this the other day with a file from The Meadowlands last Friday (March 13) and the raw data is illuminating.

In this particular file, which contained over 1,600 rows of data with each row reflecting individual past performance lines, what I found most useful was a field for class rating. Each record had a class rating assigned to it – which is also shown in a standard TrackMaster program next to the speed rating – but being able to have a model analyze it in a read-able format opens more ways the figures can be analyzed.

On any given race, depending on the quality of horses in that specific race, an MADC 1 race could be considered exactly the same as a TM 71 field. But some MADC 1 races are lower, and some TM 71 races are higher and vice versa – and it all depends on which specific horses were in those races. Which \$10,000 claiming race was rated higher quality, what about a particular N/W \$2,500 L5 or that random NJ SDF race? This type of information takes all of the guesswork out of it, and now you could have a model treat these races differently based on rating even though they all look like the same class at first glance.

From there, use the data any way you see fit. You can tell the AI to incorporate not only the class ratings, but speed ratings, driver and trainer tendencies, track and post position statistics, and keep going from there. It's solely up to you how you want to weight recent races, treat races differently where horses broke stride, incorporate pace projections, build custom calculations, barn changes, which trainers usually go easy with a horse following a qualifier – there's no limitation. All you do is tell the AI what you're thinking, and it goes ahead and writes the programming code to execute it.

One major caveat that I'll say is that there's only so much a model can do with raw data, especially in harness racing. As opposed to its sister sport, thoroughbred racing, where these models are highly prevalent and where vast amounts of data points can be used to build a well-constructed model, harness racing has more "feel" to it in my opinion and thus greater volatility.

In a thoroughbred race if any horse is fast enough, it stands a chance to be put into the race and win. But in harness racing,

it's much more difficult to model for a driver who has shown early speed with the same horse five straight races but tonight decides to randomly take back to ninth at odds of 3-1, or a horse that sits in from fourth and gets shuffled, or a horse that's further back than planned because he let two horses drop in front of him. The human factors go on and on.

This is purely speculation, but it's for those human reasons that I believe that the best commercial operations using their models in harness racing must have an element of direct driver and trainer information that go into their calculations. It's just too important of a factor not to be included, and that still might be a proprietary edge that these groups have. But that said, if you're someone closer to the physical horses than I am and you have your own information, then by all means go ahead and incorporate that information into your model.

All of this is to say that technology has never been close to what it is today for you to go out and build your own model. If built with sound principles and then layered in with your own knowledge and judgement on human interactions within the sport, there's genuine value that can be created.

For all the massive edges in big data that the larger operations have had for years, this is the first time a regular player can begin to bridge that gap.

# Illinois Harness Horsemen's Association hoping to be a 'critical vendor' in Hawthorne bankruptcy proceedings

Members of the Illinois Harness Horsemen's Association (IHHA) have their fingers crossed, hoping that when the U.S. Bankruptcy Court in the Northern District of Illinois holds a hearing on March 27 that Judge Timothy Barnes will declare them a "critical vendor," thereby enabling them to collect the money they are owed by bankrupt Hawthorne Race Course.

"At that time we hope a final order is issued to get horsemen paid for all the bounced checks and the purse account unfrozen," IHHA executive director Tony Somone said on March 18. "We then hope to be paid on April 4 from the debtor-in-possession financing facility (JDI Loans)."

According to Somone, IHHA members are owed \$1.3 million in overdue purse money and \$1.2 million to cover the bounced checks. In addition, he said, Hawthorne owes the IHHA \$360,000 for seven months of unpaid funding it is legally required to provide to cover the organization's expenses.

JDI Loans has given the Chicago area's only remaining racetrack a \$16 million 120-day line of credit to pay critical vendors who are among the multitude of creditors pressing Hawthorne for payment. Estimates of the track's indebtedness range from \$100 million and \$500 million.

Earlier this month, Judge Barnes approved payments of \$1.1 million in overdue purse money and \$281,000 in bounced checks owed to members of the Illinois Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association (ITHA), putting them in the critical vendor category because their meeting that originally was scheduled to begin on March 29 is now expected to get underway on April 19.

"We expect the money to be available either on Friday (March 20) or Monday (March 23)," ITHA executive director Dave McCaffrey said after the Illinois Racing Board's March 18 meeting.

McCaffrey said he "was upset" that Judge Barnes separated the ITHA and the IHHA in the bankruptcy proceedings, delaying the payments to members of the harness organization: "I even had our attorney go up there [before the judge] and say that 'our client doesn't want them to be separated and has no reason to say this other than our client wants to do what's right.'"

Hawthorne’s Suburban Downs fall/winter harness meeting lost all 14 of its January and February dates because of the track’s financial woes and the Racing Board suspended its license for “failure to provide documentation demonstrating its financial integrity, and proof that they can maintain minimum standards” mandated by the Illinois Racing Act.

The suspension remains in effect, which makes reimbursement of the overdue purse money and bounced checks a vital step in restoring the license.

At the March 18 Racing Board meeting, Hawthorne president Tim Carey testified that he is committed to a bankruptcy reorganization plan that will keep the family-owned racetrack in business rather than sell it to a land developer.

If the track discontinues racing it will lose the casino license it was awarded by the Illinois Gaming Board in 2019 as part of a massive Illinois gambling expansion law passed by the legislature the previous year.

A portion of the grandstand was torn down in 2020 to begin the \$40 million racino project that Carey promised but he has subsequently failed to find a financial partner and the project

remains in limbo. Meanwhile, the demolition ruins remain and the firms that did the teardown are among Hawthorne’s multitude of creditors.

Many racing insiders have second-guessed Carey for not erecting a temporary racino to begin funneling a portion of its adjusted gross revenue to harness and thoroughbred horsemen and women until the racino becomes the real deal.

Bally’s has established a temporary casino at the Medinah Temple in Chicago’s downtown River North neighborhood while construction is proceeding on a permanent structure and American Place’s temporary casino is in its third year of operation in Waukegan, a city near the Wisconsin border, prior to this spring’s start of construction for a permanent structure.

Both temporary casinos are making money. The Waukegan facility has exceeded expectations, while the one in Chicago is slightly under pre-opening projections.

Carey’s rationale for not taking the temporary route is that it would be a disappointment for customers and would significantly dampen their enthusiasm to visit his envisioned state-of-the-art \$40 million racino “with a horse racing motif” when it eventually opened.

## Chris Larmey gives insight into 'Betting on Horse\$'

Chris Larmey, a National Handicapping Hall of Famer and host of [the Bet with The Best](#) podcast, recently published a new book called *Betting on Horse\$*.

HRU contacted Larmey to ask him some questions about why he wrote the book, along with what insights he believes can help both those who play our sport and the insiders and track executives who run it.

### **Congratulations on the new book. What was the impetus for you to write such a comprehensive examination of the sport we all love?**

"Years ago, when I first got started in the game, there were a number of outstanding books for horseplayers. Titles like *Picking Winners* by Andrew Beyer, *Exotic Betting* by Steve Crist, *Money Secrets at the Racetrack* by Barry Meadow, and *Kinky Handicapping* by Mark Cramer. Those books were literary gold and played a major role in educating and developing serious players.

"But it has been a long time since we've seen anything comparable. Mike Maloney's excellent *Betting with an Edge*, published in 2017, was probably the last comprehensive work of that kind. Matt Miller's *A Bettor Way of Thinking* is another strong recent contribution, but it focuses primarily on contest play rather than the full scope of horseplaying.

"So, I wanted to help fill that gap. (And as a side note, all of those authors are featured prominently in *Betting on Horse\$*.)

"At the same time, the game itself has changed dramatically over the past 20 years, and that pace of change is accelerating. Advances in technology, increasingly complex wager types, shifts in the betting product, and the rise of Computer Assisted Wagering (CAW) teams have fundamentally altered the landscape.

"I wrote this book to help players understand and adapt to those changes so they can survive, and potentially thrive, in today's highly competitive environment.

"More broadly, I believe the betting skill set required to succeed as a modern horseplayer is still underappreciated by both players and the industry. There's a real opportunity for improvement with better education and guidance.

"Finally, many critical aspects of the game, including race selection, price discovery, bet sizing, bankroll management, horseplayer psychology, and reviewing performance, are rarely discussed in depth, even though they are more important than ever. This book is intended to address those gaps as well."



### **Who are some of the people you interviewed for the book?**

"The book features all of the authors I mentioned, along with a wide range of accomplished players. That includes legendary figures like Len Friedman, who played a pivotal role in the evolution of *The Sheets* developed by Len Ragozin, and Maury Wolff.

"It also includes current professional players such as Mike Maloney, Paul Matties, Sean Boarman, and Jonathan Stettin, as well as a younger generation of data-driven players like Marshall Gramm, Dennis Montoro, Keith Bush, and David Aragona."

### **You focus a lot on the betting aspect of the game. Will this book help those of us who may struggle with ticket construction, managing bankrolls, and some of the tougher mental aspects of the game?**

"Absolutely. These topics are central to the book.

"Many players recognize that their handicapping skills are stronger than their wagering skills, and that gap can significantly impact their results. That realization was one of the driving forces behind my *Bet with The Best* podcast and is a major reason betting is such a core focus of the book.

"A key theme is helping players develop what I call a 'gambler's mindset,' continually identifying and exploiting edges. I go into detail on topics such as selecting the right pools, sizing bets appropriately, and constructing efficient tickets that reflect your opinion while maximizing long-term returns.

"The book covers all major wager types, including vertical bets (win, exacta, trifecta, superfecta) and horizontal bets (double, Pick-3, Pick-4, Pick-5, and Pick-8). These sections are filled with insights from proven professionals, and I believe most players

will come away with new ways of thinking about how they wager.

“I also spend significant time on areas that are often overlooked: risk and bankroll management, horseplayer psychology, and reviewing performance. These may not be as flashy as handicapping, but they are just as critical for long-term success.

“Additionally, I devote several sections to contest play, both mythical and live-money formats. Events like the National Horseplayers Championship (NHC) and the Breeders’ Cup Betting Challenge (BCBC) are among the few areas of the sport that continue to grow and remain less dominated by CAW teams. The book outlines contest formats, winning strategies used by past champions, and how players can identify formats that suit their style.”

**Computer Assisted Wagering is a relatively new topic. Those who play harness racing (and some of those who run it) struggle with understanding these bulk bettors. Late odds drops, as I am sure you’re aware, plague the sport of harness racing especially because of smaller pools. Did you look into this topic at all?**

“Yes. This is one of the most important topics in the book.

“CAW teams represent perhaps the most significant recent change in the game. I devote a substantial section to explaining

what these teams are, how their models work, and how they operate within the pari-mutuel system.

“More importantly, I focus on how they’ve changed the betting landscape and what that means for everyday players. I also introduce what I call a ‘Horseplayer vs. CAW Teams Map,’ which outlines practical strategies for competing in this new environment.”

**Do you think industry executives would benefit from reading your book? What are some takeaways you think would help them understand the betting market and their customers better?**

“Absolutely. Understanding your core customer is essential, and that starts with understanding how horseplayers think and the challenges they face.

“The section on computer wagering, in particular, provides an historical perspective on how pricing in pari-mutuel wagering has evolved and how we arrived at the current environment. One that many would argue is increasingly dominated by a small number of large CAW teams.

“I also outline potential changes that could help level the playing field and improve the experience for retail players. If meaningful action isn’t taken, particularly around managing CAW participation and reducing the cost of wagering, there’s a real risk that players will continue to leave for more attractive alternatives.

“Without change, the ecosystem risks evolving into one where computers are primarily betting against other computers, which is not a sustainable model for long-term growth.”

**Where can we purchase your book?**

“Thank you, Dean, for everything you do for players, for your contributions to the book, and for the opportunity to discuss *Betting on Horse\$*.

“If you’re a horseplayer, whether novice or experienced, and you’re looking for ways to improve your game, this book was written for you.

# Brad Chisholm is enjoying being back home in New Jersey

Who says you can't go home? Certainly not driver Brad Chisholm, who was honored on Friday (March 13) as The Meadowlands Driver of the Week with five wins in 13 starts the previous weekend (March 6-7).

Chisholm, 28, who like another Freehold native was "Born in the USA," has no recollection of his earliest days living in New Jersey, because his mom and dad left the Garden State and moved back to their native Australia less than a month after Chisholm was born.

After 25 years Down Under, Chisholm, who has dual citizenship, moved to the U.S. in 2023 and hasn't wasted any time making memories.

He said things weren't looking great at that time in Melbourne for racing, and he remembers having a conversation with Anthony Butt, who drove the great Down Under champ Lyell Creek.

"I said, 'I don't want to get to an age where I wish I went,'" Chisholm said. "I'd rather give it a go, and if I fail, at least say

that I did it, then regret not coming over at all.' And he said, 'I can get you a job straight away.'"

Butt mentioned something about trainer Nifty Norman, who Chisholm had never met or spoken with, so he thought it was something that he might get brought up again at some future point, but wouldn't go anywhere, but he was wrong.

"The next day he says, 'Yep, you're in,'" Chisholm said. "[Norman] said he'd love to have you.' So, two weeks later, I actually flew over here [to New Jersey]."

Chisholm spent a majority of his first two years back in the States with Norman, until the trainer cut down on horses.

"He gave me notice, and he said, 'I'm just going to let you know, because I don't want you to be stuck, but it might be an opportunity to go explore elsewhere over here and see how someone else does it, too,'" Chisholm said. "And I was totally fine with that, so it was on good terms."

Chisholm then worked for trainer Joe Holloway for about six or seven months, before landing his current job in the stable of Brett Pelling.

"I've always kind of followed Brett, and my wife [Tea] works at Brett's, too, and everything kind of just fell into place," Chisholm said.

According to Chisholm, he learned a lot from all three trainers, which he greatly appreciated because they all taught him something different.

"The three of these guys, Brett, Nifty, and Joe, not one of them is similar, even the two Kiwi guys, Nifty and Brett, that actually were working together years ago," he said.

Pelling said he thinks Chisholm is taking the right approach to what he wants to do.

“If [driving is] what you want to do, I actually truly feel like in a lot of things, just show up,” Pelling said. “Just show up, be dedicated to what you’re doing, and you’ll get the opportunity. And, like I’ve said to him, ‘The most important thing is really to make fewer mistakes.’ And I think for a young guy, that’s kind of the key thing.”

“He’s good to talk to. He’s a good student. I think he keeps close tabs on other horses, other people, which is kind of important. And, yeah, I think he’s studying it, he’s working it.”

Today (March 20) marks the first day of spring, which means that The Meadowlands’ top drivers will be returning soon from their winter break. With that in mind, young drivers like Chisholm will eventually get fewer opportunities.

“So, if I didn’t have a job as far as working for Brett in the morning, I might have considered a Tioga, or even a Plainridge like just venturing out, because if I could, I would race seven days a week, every week, and look, that’s what I want to do,” Chisholm said. “But just having that job in the morning, which I love and learn a lot, even though Brett would never say no to racing somewhere or whatever, if you had to leave work early, it’s still a lot to commit to and you don’t want to do it half-hearted.”

“He’s asked me and I said, ‘Yeah, I’d like to drive.’ And he said, ‘No worries, I’ll give you a shot.’”

In the coming months, Chisholm will probably focus more on Pocono and Harrah’s Philadelphia, but also be at The Meadowlands, especially on Friday nights, when a lot of drivers will be at Yonkers.

“I always need someone around me like that, because we have a lot of young horses, so young horses need experience,” Pelling said. “One of the key things with me is, when they’re young like that you can’t be aggressive, and we just need to teach them. I try and give as few instructions as possible, and really just watch to make sure that he’s understanding what we’re doing. And so far, he has been.”

Chisholm said he thinks part of the reason that Pelling is so willing to give him a chance is because he’s been through all of this with his son Jack, 30, who also rode horses in the mornings, and drove in qualifiers just like Chisholm.

“I’ve been lucky for the last four years I basically had Jack doing all of that and driving,” Brett said. “One thing about Jack and Brad, if I send them to Pocono on a maiden, or down to Chester with a maiden, or something like that, you know, they can race it the right way... I think with Brad and Jack it’s an understanding, and they know that it’s all about doing the right thing by the horse and the bottom line is, and Brad basically knows this, if it’s a really, really good horse, more than likely it’ll get handed over to one of the [top] guys, but also, good horses are hard to come across.”

“So, that’s why having Brad and Jack driving these young horses and getting them going and getting them to that place is a great asset to me.”

“One of the things that I’ve said to people before is when it’s all said and done, when I hang it up, I’d like people to think of me or remember me as being a good teacher... So, when someone comes along like Brad, I tell him things. I tell him why, and I tell him traits, tendencies, why we do this and that. And I try and talk to him about horses and how we do things and everything, and make sense of it, and give him a reason. And I like that.”

“I like promoting young guys. It’s a good thing.”

# Holland and Willowtime appear to be winning match

Herb Holland has been around long enough to know that horses of Willowtime's caliber don't become available often – but on the rare occasion they do, hesitation isn't an option.

“When he was in for that price, I thought he was a gift for that money because you can't buy those kinds of horses,” Holland said. “So, we claimed him, and he's been worth the money and maybe some more.”

The devoted horseman of 40-plus years had admired Willowtime from afar for years, watching on as the Lookslikeeachpndale trotter dominated Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) competition as a 2-year-old.

The lasting imprint of that marvelous 2023 gold series run, punctuated by a Super Final victory at Woodbine Mohawk Park, provided all the ammunition Holland needed to convince long-time business partner Vincenzo Strangis to cut the check for \$37,500.

“It's pretty back and forth,” Holland said of he and Strangis' business plan. “There have been times where he [Strangis] wanted to claim one and I'd suggest otherwise, but when this horse came up, I said, 'Look, there's a horse in there I think you should claim him.'”

“And thank goodness he did because he's been solid for him.”

Since joining their operation last August, Willowtime has been everything Holland foresaw and Strangis had hoped for.

Across 18 starts for his new battery, the now 5-year-old gelding has landed within the money in 14, and inside the top three in nine (3-2-4).

As Holland sees it, that start-to-start consistency speaks to Willowtime's innate desire to compete.

“I just think good horses show up,” he said. “I'd like to take all the credit for it, but nice horses know how to get their noses to the wire, and he's always been a good horse.”

“[Trainer] Mark Etsell had him as a young horse and did a great job with him and I really like him, too. He's a classy older horse, and he's nice to be around.”

There was, as Holland added, a slight learning curve at the beginning of their tenure, but that was to be expected.

“He made a break the first two times I raced him, and I was a little disenchanted with him, but I knew we didn't have things the way I needed to for him and once I changed him, he was fine,” Holland said.

The brief acclimation period sparked Willowtime's re-emergence as the weekly force Holland envisioned when Strangis put pen to paper seven months ago.

“When they have a lot of back class, even if you're in a claimer – he hasn't been in one since we claimed him

– but if you have to go back there, you can’t beat the class of horse no matter what it is,” Holland said.

“If they won money and major races, you’re not going to get hurt with them and that’s what I looked at when we claimed him.”

The bay, out of Mr Lavec mare SOS Respect, checked several boxes for Holland then and continues to do so now.

While there are several aspects of Willowtime’s composition and character that catch his trainer’s eye, the statuesque trotter’s development post OSS has been particularly encouraging.

“Some don’t keep developing after, but he’s a big, growthy trotter,” Holland said. “He’s probably 17 hands or very close to it and those types generally get a little stronger and a little better as they mature more.

“Coming into his age 5 form, I wouldn’t be surprised if he trotted to his record or better. I wouldn’t be surprised at all because he seems to be getting stronger and a little better each time I go with him.”

The early returns from Willowtime’s fourth professional season have validated Holland’s faith.

Though yet to best his lifetime mark of 1:52.1 through four starts thus far, Willowtime has performed admirably with a pair of wins at Flamboro Downs and runner-up finish, which came last time out on March 15 at Mohawk.

A near-two-month layoff following the end of his 4-year-old campaign is already paying dividends.

“I think the time off is going to bode well for him through the summer,” Holland said. “[Driver] Bob McClure qualified him to start this year, and I was going to enter him at Mohawk, but thought he could use a softer race or two early on.

“Bob said he could get around a half with him, so I took him to Flamboro to get him in a spot where he didn’t have to get stretched and it has worked in our favor.”

Holland’s hope for a 5-year-old Willowtime is to compete in

the “upper-mid conditions” at Mohawk, which he showed a glimpse of in his latest start.

The veteran conditioner has every reason to believe his trusty trotter will stand up to the challenge but understands there is more than one path to reach their ultimate goal.

“If we have to go to a claimer, I would, but it wouldn’t be my choice to lose him because I like the horse,” Holland said. “He’s one of those trotters who will pay more than his way for the owner. At the end of the day, all we need to do is keep the owners busy, keep them happy, and if they can win a few races with them, all the better.”

With their plan taking shape, Holland and Willowtime continue to get more comfortable with each other every day.

“I know him a lot better now – his quirks, the issues he may or may not have, which always goes well because you’re not guessing anymore,” Holland said. “When you first get them, you’ll scratch your head sometimes wondering if you’re on the right track or not. Now that we’ve had him a while, you know what they need.”

What once started as an appreciation from afar has steadily grown into a rock-solid partnership on and off the track.

Willowtime, in his words, is unlike any horse Holland’s ever coached, but the uber reliable racehorse has become everything he’s dreamed of and more.

“He’s kind of his own little boy, that fella,” Holland said, adding with a laugh, “Not a little boy, big boy, he is. But I really like him, I always did. When I saw Mark racing him, I always liked him. After getting him, I like him even more than I did earlier.”

# Spring meeting set to begin at Vincennes

The winter meeting at Vincennes concluded on Feb. 28, and this Saturday (March 21) the spring meeting gets underway.

A total of \$16,781,000 in prize money will be contested between March 20 and June 29 at the Parisian oval.

The overall structure remains familiar – but with a historic change.

The major talking point is the transformation of the Prix René Ballière. Traditionally a Group 1 event, the race has now been downgraded to Group 2, extended to 2,700 meters, and – most notably – opened to geldings.

This is a strategic move aimed at allowing the best older trotters – regardless of gender – to compete against each other in a revamped series of major races.

Another administrative adjustment sees the popular Friday night cards starting slightly later than last year, with opening night scheduled for May 15.

### THE SPRING PROGRAM IS EXTENSIVE AND DISTRIBUTED AS FOLLOWS:

- Vincennes: 36 race days (March 20 – June 29)
- Caen: 18 race days
- Enghien: 12 race days

A total of five Group 1 races will be contested. Four of them will be held on Vincennes' flagship day, June 21, while the fifth is the Prix de l'Atlantique at Enghien.

The total purse for the Vincennes spring meeting amounts to nearly \$16.8 million, with an average of approximately \$56,885 per race. In total, 295 races will be run – nine more than during last year's corresponding meeting.

### FOR OLDER HORSES – NOW INCLUDING GELDINGS – A SERIES OF FIVE MAJOR RACES HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED:

- Prix du Bois de Vincennes – March 20
- Prix Kerjacques – April 4

- Prix des Ducs de Normandie – May 9
- Prix Chambon P – June 6
- Prix René Ballière – June 21

One of the key highlights of the spring is the Prix de l'Atlantique at Enghien on April 18.

The race was won in 2025 by Iguski Sautonne and traditionally marks the beginning of the international spring campaign.

### INEXESS BLEU SET FOR SEASONAL DEBUT

One of Europe's very best trotters of 2025, Inexess Bleu (Vittel de Brevol), is set to make his seasonal debut.

The Laurent-Claude Abrivard-trained gelding is expected to start in the \$105,000 Prix du Bois de Vincennes at Vincennes on Saturday (March 21).

Inexess Bleu capped his campaign by winning the \$540,000 UET Elite Circuit final for older trotters at Solvalla, and prior to that he enjoyed a highly successful stint at Vincennes with six victories during last year's winter meeting.

### BACK-TO-BACK VICTORIES FOR DANY CAPAR IN FLORENCE

For the second consecutive year, **Dany Capar** and Alessandro Gocciadoro captured the \$190,000 Gran Premio Duomo in Florence.

Making his seasonal debut, Dany Capar controlled the race from the front and was never seriously challenged.

In the stretch, Banderas Bi found racing room and launched a late bid, but could not get closer than a length as the 7-year-old Dany Capar (Exploit Caf–Sueia della Luna) held safely to the line in 1:53.3, equaling Urlo dei Venti's track record from 2018.

When the gate released the field, Dany Capar blasted straight to the lead, while stablemates Free Time Jepson and Always Ek both made early breaks and were out of contention.

Björn Goop made an early move with Ideal San Leandro, launching from fourth-over with 1,200 meters to go, but met a response from Funny Gio, who advanced to the outside of the leader with more than a lap remaining.

Ideal San Leandro was left three-wide and was already under pressure down the backstretch.

Banderas Bi (Ganymede) angled out in the stretch and finished well, but had to settle for second, while Funny Gio (Face Time Bourbon), also trained by Gocciadoro, held on for third.

### Donald 'Skip' Hoovler obituary with arrangements

Donald "Skip" Hoovler of Pataskala, OH passed away peacefully on March 13, 2026, one week after celebrating his 83rd birthday with his loving family. Born on March 6, 1943, to Donald and Dolores (Moritz) Hoovler, Skip was a proud graduate of Watkins Memorial High School (Class of 1961) and Ohio University (Class of 1965). As a young man, Skip was a standout athlete, first at Watkins Memorial and then as a two-time (1963 and 1964) All-American football player at Ohio University, where he also earned first-team Mid-American Conference honors for three consecutive years, co-captained the football team, and played in the 1964 Senior Bowl. His 91-yard interception return for the Bobcats in the 1962 Sun Bowl – for which he was awarded the bowl's Jimmy Rogers, Jr. Most Valuable Lineman Trophy – still stands as the longest such play in the Sun Bowl's storied 90-year history. Skip was drafted by the New York Jets in 1965 and played for the Jets and the Houston Oilers in the National Football League. Skip was part of the inaugural class inducted into the Watkins Memorial High School Hall of Fame. He was inducted into the Ohio University Athletic Hall of Fame in 1978.

After his football career, Skip launched a successful decades-long career in business, founding Hoovler Financial and Insurance Services in Columbus and building it into one of central Ohio's leading financial services firms. He also pursued his lifelong passion for standardbred horses and for harness horse racing, serving in multiple leadership roles in that industry while building a national reputation as a horseman, breeder, administrator, and tireless industry advocate. In that vein, Skip served for decades on the board of directors of the United States Trotting Association. He was a past president and longtime board member of the Ohio Harness Horsemen's Association and a director of that group's Political Action Committee for Equine Racing (PACER). He also served proudly on the board of directors of the Little Brown Jug Society – the organization that supports and promotes one of harness racing's premier events – and received the United States Trotting Association's President's Award in 2018 for extraordinary service to that organization. In 2025, the Ohio chapter of the United States Harness Writers Association honored Skip's decades of leadership and service by selecting him as the 51st member of the Ohio Harness Racing Hall of Fame.

Skip was preceded in death by his parents and by his sister, Sharon Hoovler Brill. He is survived by his wife of 60 years,

Tamara (Foor) Hoovler, his brother John (Kathleen) Hoovler, his three children [Jennifer (John) Forren, Amy Hoovler (Steve Helwagen), and Bret (Melissa) Hoovler], eight grandchildren [Kelsey (Rob) Pepitone, Carter Helwagen, Dolen Helwagen, Bryce Forren, Lindey Helwagen, Kendall Forren, Jate Hoovler and Campbell Hoovler], one great-grandchild (William Pepitone) and many special nieces, nephews, great nieces, and great nephews.

A visitation (11 a.m. – 2 p.m.) and memorial service (2 – 3 p.m.) will be held on Saturday (March 21, 2026) at the Pataskala United Methodist Church, 458 South Main Street, Pataskala, with a Celebration of Life to be held immediately thereafter (3:30 – 6:30 p.m.) at Williams Farm, 8405 York Road S.W., Pataskala. ### Kurt Sugg captures 6,000th win Sunday night at MGM Northfield Park

Veteran harness driver Kurt Sugg reached a milestone Sunday night (March 15) when he picked up the 6,000th win of his career behind **Get In And Go** in race 4 – a horse he also trains. The pair delivered the victory with a 3-wide sweeping move around the far turn, grinding their way to the front late and edging past the favorite Mohatu AS (Dan Noble).

For nearly two decades, Sugg has been one of the most reliable winners in harness racing. He has topped the 200-win mark in 17 of the last 18 seasons, and the only year he fell short he still finished with a solid 190 victories. The wins have translated into steady financial success as well, with Sugg posting more than \$2 million in purse earnings in 11 consecutive seasons. His best two seasons were in 2020 and 2021 which were almost identical on paper with 384 and 370 wins, respectively and over \$2.9 million in earnings. Sugg has also picked up 1,068 training victories and over \$7,000,000 in earnings on the conditioning side.

The 2026 driving season appears to be headed in the same direction. Through 378 starts, Sugg has 53 wins and \$440,432 in purse earnings. If the numbers continue at their current pace, another 200-plus win season and another year north of \$2

million in purses looks well within reach. And if Sunday night proved anything, it's that even after 6,000 wins, Sugg is still doing what he's done for years – showing up, putting horses in position to win, and letting the results speak for themselves.

## Hambletonian, Breeders Crown condition changes and Hambletonian host track presentations

At the March 15, 2026 winter meeting of the directors of the Hambletonian Society, the board approved the conditions of Hambletonian No. 103, the stake for foals of 2025 to be raced in 2028, which will take yearling payments on May 15, 2026.

For the first time, the Hambletonian conditions include a supplemental 2-year-old payment, beginning with Hambletonian No. 103. Horses not kept eligible by either the May 15, 2026 yearling nomination or the Aug. 15, 2026 yearling supplement may make a Feb. 15, 2027 supplemental nomination fee of \$1,500 to either the Open or the Oaks. This payment will allow those horses to remain eligible to make the additional 2-year-old and 3-year-old schedule of payments for the year of the respective races.

Also added was language regarding information on the reporting of shoeing changes, an issue currently under committee review by the U.S. Trotting Association.

The following language was added to Hambletonian No. 103, which was approved with May yearling payments:

“Trainers may be subject to notifying the racetrack and/or judges of their intention to race without shoes. The protocols and time frames will be posted on the condition sheet before entry time.”

In addition, the board approved the conditions of Breeders Crown No. 41, which takes yearling payments on May 15, 2026 for the races of 2027 and future years. Added to the conditions was the aforementioned shoeing change language included in Hambletonian No. 103.

In other business, the board reviewed proposals submitted for future host sites of the Hambletonian, beginning in 2027. Proposals received from Harrah's Hoosier Park, Meadowlands Racing & Gaming, and Woodbine Entertainment Group were presented to the board. The board voted to allow additional time to issue a request for information (RFI) to the tracks and to permit further review and clarification of each proposal.

No new directors were elected at this time. The annual meeting of the Hambletonian Society board is scheduled for Lexington, KY, on Oct. 9, 2026.

## AGCO and OLG approve race dates for four Ontario tracks

The Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) and the Ontario Lottery and Gaming Corporation (OLG) have approved 2026 race dates for four Ontario racetracks: Woodbine Racetrack, Woodbine Mohawk Park, Fort Erie Race Track, and Ajax Downs.

The number of race dates is as follows:

[Woodbine Racetrack](#) (thoroughbred) – 128

[Woodbine Mohawk Park](#) (standardbred) – 222 (for all of 2026 counting dates already allocated from Jan. 1 through March 31, 2026)

[Fort Erie Race Track](#) (thoroughbred) – 34

[Ajax Downs](#) (quarter horse) – 22

The new dates begin on April 1, 2026, and extend through March 31, 2027, to line up with the 2026-27 fiscal year.

A group of industry experts comprised of the AGCO, OLG, Ontario Racing, horsepeople groups, and racetracks are currently finalizing the 2026 race dates for the province's other 11 tracks: Clinton Raceway, Dresden Raceway, Flamboro Downs, Georgian Downs, Grand River Raceway, Hanover Raceway, Hiawatha Horse Park, Kawartha Downs, Leamington Raceway, The Raceway at Western Fair District, and Rideau Carleton Raceway. Those dates will be released as soon as possible.

Race dates through March 31, 2026, were previously allocated for all 15 Ontario tracks.

The Ontario horse racing industry is fortunate to have stable, long-term funding from the Province of Ontario. The Long-Term Funding Agreement signed in 2019 provides up to \$120 million annually to the industry through 2038 via the OLG through Ontario Racing.

## Taurasi euthanized at 7

Taurasi, recipient of the 2024 O'Brien Award for Older Pacing Horse, was humanely euthanized on Saturday (March 14) at Woodbine Mohawk Park following an injury sustained on the track.

Taurasi, making his 90th career start, was racing on the lead on the last turn when he broke stride and was pulled up by Doug McNair. Woodbine confirmed on social media that the 7-year-old had been put down. McNair, the horse's longtime regular driver, booked off the remainder of his drives.

The son of Racing Hill—Voluminous came to the fore as a Grand Circuit competitor as a 4-year-old in 2023, and he was one

of Canada's top older pacers since 2024, contesting several stakes events while remaining a fixture at the highest level at his home track of Mohawk. After dominating the Kentucky Commonwealth Series at 3 for trainer Tony Alagna, he finished second in the Kentucky Sire Stakes final for 4-year-olds in 2023 and stepped up to face Grand Circuit horses. His achievements that year include a second in the Allerage, a third in the McKee Memorial, and earning a Breeders Crown final berth. He also set his lifetime mark of 1:47.2 when he won an overnight race at The Meadowlands.

Mohawk became Taurasi's home base after shipping to Ontario at the tail end of that season. In 2024, he won nine consecutive preferreds and 11 overall on the year while also finishing a narrow second in the Mohawk Gold Cup and recording a show finish in the Pacey Mindlin Memorial at Miami Valley Raceway. For his efforts at 5, he was named Canada's Older Pacing Horse of the Year. He defeated top-class rivals four times in 2025 to bring his total to 17 at Mohawk throughout his career.

Taurasi won 30 races with 16 second-place finishes, and 11 thirds and earned \$911,124. He was trained by Gregg McNair since August 2024 and owned by Brad Grant of Milton, ON and Alagna Racing LLC of Howell, NJ since October 2023.

## Copperfield makes foes disappear at Big M

He hadn't raced at The Meadowlands since November of 2023 in the Kindergarten final, but **Copperfield** had little trouble re-acclimating to the mile oval Saturday night (March 14), putting up a powerhouse performance in the featured \$25,000 TrackMaster 90 on the pace.

Since going off-stride and finishing 10th in his last pari-mutuel try at The Big M, the 5-year-old gelded son of Betting Line – American Charm has qualified just twice at the East Rutherford track, but the most recent was a sparkling 1:51 win on March 7 that featured a final quarter of :25.2.

"He looked like he qualified really well," said winning driver Brett Beckwith, who watched the dash on his phone. "I was pretty confident with mine going into the race, especially off that qualifier."

And rightly so.

The early going featured the usual scrum for position as Wish You Well (post 4), World Of Wishes (post 5), Copperfield (post 6) and Joemikiyoursofine (post 10) all used some early gas into the first turn in the 10-horse field.

World Of Wishes, who was so impressive winning his seasonal debut last week in a lifetime-best 1:49.2, had the lead at the quarter in :27.4, but soon thereafter, Copperfield, a Per Engblom

trainee, forged to the front at the three-eighths before reaching the half in :55.2.

Rydingtothewire, a 40-1 outsider, was now motoring up on the rim to go after the leader, and was at Copperfield's throat as three-quarters was timed in 1:23.4.

As the field straightened up with three-sixteenths to the finish, Rydingtothewire started to weaken, but not quite enough to allow 2-1 second choice World Of Wishes the space necessary to vacate the pocket and come after the leader. In deep stretch, Wish You Well ducked to the inside and outpaced World Of Wishes in the race for place as Copperfield recorded a convincing 1½-length score in 1:50.4.

"I followed Patrick [Ryder, driving World Of Wishes] to the lead and my horse outsprinted them," said Beckwith. "He's a really nice horse and is handy for a pretty big horse. He's big, he's strong, and he's versatile. I imagine he's even better off a helmet."

Sent to the gate as the even-money favorite, Copperfield paid \$4 after registering his 12th career win in 61 tries. He now has earnings totaling \$338,487 for owner W.J. Donovan.

**PK-8 CARRIES ON:** The \$1 PK-8 went unhit for a ninth consecutive offering, upping the carryover to \$94,833 for tonight (March 20).

Winner's odds for the sequence were 18-1, 4-1, 8-1, 4-1, 4-1, 7-2, 2-5, and 1-1. Those with six correct collected \$1,497.30.
