Come spring, this scribe's thoughts tend to focus on yearlings, likely in part because beginning each spring I spent decades traveling to various parts of North America to evaluate those yearlings that had been consigned to Harrisburg.

It was a chore that took a lot of time, a lot of hours and close to 20,000 miles yearly in the car.

Was it demanding? Perhaps a little, but I loved it. Any angst was overcome by the pleasure that a new crop of yearlings and the people that raised them presented.

That circuitously brings me to the topic of this week's column.

Come springtime, I do not possess nearly the patience required to wait for the annual yearling catalogs to come out in September. Instead, I peruse the various websites to get an inkling of what will be offered this fall.

This past Sunday, I occasionally left the NCAA basketball games to peruse this year's yearling crop from Crawford Farms. I find it rather remarkable what the second generation of Crawfords have done in a relatively short period of time. They have established a broodmare band that, on a mare by mare basis, ranks up to the very best in our industry and far exceeds most.

The Crawfords have 16 by Tall Dark Stranger, second in number only to Hanover's 17, for that much awaited young pacing stallion. They also have 10 yearlings by superstar trotting stallion Chapter Seven, the largest number to be sold by any breeder this fall. The yearling group also includes substantial representation by Always B Miki, American Ideal, Captaintreacherous, Downbytheseaside, Father Patrick, Huntsville, Muscle Hill and Walner.

The broodmare band now numbers 100 active mares. It is made up of 57 trotters and 43 pacers. They include an abundance of stakes and classics winners at both gaits. The mares are booked to all the world's greatest stallions. Some have already produced stakes and classics winners and champions on both gaits. There are, undoubtedly, significantly more to come.

Which leads me to this year's yearling crop.

It is one which should interest every serious yearling buyer.

The Crawfords have 16 by Tall Dark Stranger, second in number only to Hanover's 17, for that much-awaited young pacing stallion. They also have 10 yearlings by superstar trotting stallion Chapter Seven, the largest number to be sold by any breeder this fall. The yearling group also includes substantial representation by Always B Miki, American Ideal, Captaintreacherous, Downbytheseaside, Father Patrick, Huntsville, Muscle Hill and Walner.

For purposes of this article, I will only concentrate on their first foals. They have 14 yearlings that are first foals, six of which are

out of mares that have earned over \$200,000 and a seventh out of a \$100,000 winner.

The first foal brigade is without a doubt headed by a Muscle Hill filly out of the world champion and Hambletonian winner Atlanta (\$3,533,707). She very well might become the most looked-at yearling being sold this year. There is also a Tall Dark Stranger colt from Stonebridge Soul (\$763,959); a Captaintreacherous filly out of Hen Party (\$594,518); a Tall Dark Stranger filly from Alexis Faith (\$580,546); a Tall Dark Stranger colt out of Brooklyn Lilacs (\$277,090); a Chapter Seven filly from Sans Defaut (\$275,720); a Tall Dark Stranger colt out of Attention Hanover (\$206,617) and a Captaintreacherous filly from Mink Pink (\$127,720).

Attesting to the great race career of Atlanta, her career earnings eclipse the total earnings of the six other mares mentioned by almost another million dollars.

I feel those and certain others not mentioned, should be enough horsepower to get any buyer's juices flowing. They certainly do mine and I am not what I would describe as a buyer.

Debbie Little named HRU associate editor

Harness Racing Update is proud to announce that Debbie Little has been named its associate editor.

Little has written HRU's weekly Meadowlands Matters column since November 2020. She will continue in that role as she adds editing duties.

She is the 2022 USHWA of the Year and was the 2020/2021 John Hervey Award winner for feature writing.

Born Deborah Ann DeBiase, she was introduced to harness racing at an early age when she and her father would watch New York City Off-Track Betting's "Racing from Yonkers" show.

The Yonkers native saw her first harness race – not surprisingly – at Yonkers Raceway, when her parents took her to the Westchester County Fair.

Perhaps it was just a logical progression that her first job

in the industry was in the publicity department at Yonkers in 1987, sending out entries and results. She would later do the same job at The Meadowlands.

It was during this time that she met then-*New York Post* writer and handicapper Dave Little, and the two married in the winner's circle at Yonkers Raceway in September of 1989.

Debbie's big break would come one year later when the *Post* was looking for racing staff. She was hired as a handicapper, harness writer and racing clerk in October of 1993 and spent almost 27 years at the tabloid.

Among a long list of other harness racing credits, Debbie has served as a national officer of the United States Harness Writers Association for 10 years, including two years as president. She is currently the president of USHWA's New York City chapter. This year is Little's 24th as an USHWA director. That number ties her for fourth among active directors for her service on the board.

She is also co-chair of the Clyde Hirt Journalism Workshop and is responsible for getting the students their writing assignments and coordinating all activities.

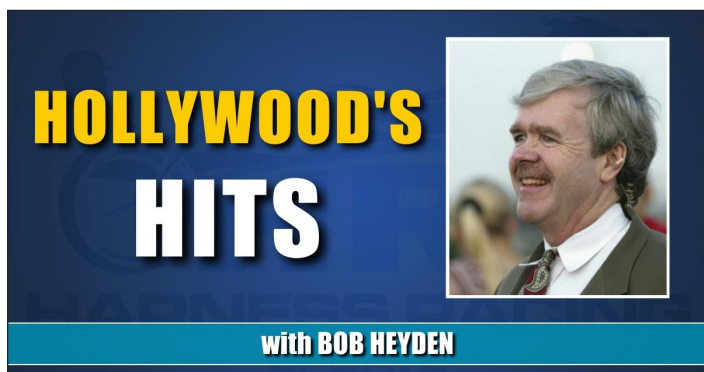

Remembering 1983 and some of the 1960s

Can it really be 40 years since the memorable year of 1983?

PACE DOUBLE

It was the last time we had a Triple Crown winner who also won the Meadowlands Pace. That champ was the great Ralph Hanover. Niatross is the only other one who has accomplished this.

HONORING DAD

On June 27, 1983, Green Speed died. He was the 1977 Horse of the Year. His first crop yielded Hambletonian winner Duenna. That was the first million-dollar trot (\$1,080,000). Green Speed is the last Horse of the Year to be a December foal, born Dec. 18.

EPIC HAMBLETONIAN STREAK UNDERWAY

Joie De Vie was a Hambletonian heat winner that year and it marked John Campbell's debut in the race. Joie De Vie was second in summary and fourth in the final. He also raced, but broke stride that year, in the Roosevelt International. Campbell would appear in every Hambletonian until the Malabar Man year of 1997. His final first- or second-place finish would be with Nuncio in 2014 when he finished second.

SPEED MERCHANT

On Oct. 4, the year's fastest performer on all three-sized tracks, It's Fritz, time trialed at the Red Mile. It was three years to the day of Niatross' 1:49.1. But Marty and Carl Allen's super speedy 4-year-old fell a bit short with fractions of: :28.1, :54.2, 1:22.1 and 1:53. The very next week he attempted to go after the Trenton 1:51.3 world race record set the previous summer, but had to settle for a 1:51.4 season's mark. It's Fritz retired to stud

and lived to the ripe old age of 31 dying in 2010. Coincidentally, Team Allen's CR Kay Suzie is also 31 and remains the oldest living former Horse of the Year (1995).

OUT IN STYLE

Rambling Willie and Cam Fella both retired that year and both held the all-time money record, with 13-year-old Willie at \$2,038,219 and Cam at \$2,041,367. Cam's final race weekend saw him win his 28th straight, but it was bittersweet as his sire Most Happy Fella passed away that very weekend at age 16.

BLIZZARD WARNINGS

In March — 40 years ago this week — New Jersey had its worst snowstorm in years. Quietly, a trotter was foaled during the blizzard and Paul Minore named the Lindy's Crown—Deficit colt Jersey Blizzard. He went on to have a fabulous career of 376 51-82-52, \$804,990 with an amazing 10-straight years of at least 30 starts and three straight six-figure years. He even had a 38 0-13-13 slate in 1988, but again made six figures. Then, a few years later, a brother was born, Another Blizzard, also a Lindy's Crown—Deficit. He was a mind-boggling 443 89-66-62, \$910,897 for his career. He competed in the Su Mac Lad against SJS Photo and had five-straight \$100G years at 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 and set an unofficial record of at least one pari-mutuel race for 71 consecutive months.

And by the way, when they retired, who were they both running around the pasture/paddock with? Deficit.

DO YOU REMEMBER THE 1960S?

Would Romola Hanover's (April 27, 1957-May 6, 1979) sparkling record as a broodmare extraordinaire hold up as well as it had a half century later?

1963 Romeo Hanover — \$658,505 (Triple Crown champ)

1964 Romulus Hanover — \$485,000

1965 Nevele Romeo — \$141,821

1966 Romano Hanover — \$133,676 (Top NJ sire)

1968 Dexter Hanover — \$329,014

1969 Romalie Hanover — \$394,385

Four of her yearlings sold for six figures. Did anyone ever have a better decade?

That Tim Rooney signed the slip for Hip #130, Albatross in 1968, at the Standardbred Horse Sale, for \$7,000. He also bought #131 for \$3,700, Saint Clair Bit.

The National Association of Harness Drivers formed on March 7, 1967 in New York City and 202 drivers signed up to be represented by F. Lee Bailey, then 33.

The press, owners and other interested parties showed up and presented F. Lee Bailey with a Red, White and Blue driving helmet.

Del Insko was the association president and Bob Baumann its executive director.

"I believe in these drivers and their cause," Bailey said. "I couldn't tell you the difference between a trotter and a pacer. I've never even made a \$2 bet. I only believe in gambling in court. But I'm certain I can learn everything I have to know about this sport. A good lawyer has to represent all kinds of clients. What you don't know, you find out."

The goal of the group was to change the public perception of the sport and for the drivers to have better benefits going forward.

"I found that these drivers have the same problems as the members of my profession," Bailey said. "When one bad apple turns up, the public takes the perception that the whole barrel is rotten. Nothing could be further from the truth. But there are certain steps I feel this association must take.

"We must see a constant upgrading of the ethics and standards of this profession from within. On the other hand, we intend to deal with those who make unjust charges. Once the members, through their own screening committees, have decided that one of them has been unjustly accused, I will make the most persuasive effort I can to clear that person... I hope to be of service in this respect."

In addition to Insko and Baumann, Lucien Fontaine was vice president, Wendell Wathen, treasurer and Lou Miller, secretary.

"This organization is dedicated to the driver and his specific problems," Baumann said. "We feel we should have the same kind of security for ourselves and our families as the professional basketball, football and baseball player. We'd like life insurance, medical plans and a pension plan. We put on the show and risk our lives every time we take a horse postward. I played a lot of football in my life and would rather get hit by a 250 pound tackle than an 1,100 pound horse. Even more important we'd like a greater voice in the sport. We're proud of our sport and our profession. We only want what is best for harness racing—nothing more.

"We started this organization last fall. I really think we're off the ground now. A tremendous response. I'm hoping we'll have 1,000 members signed up in two months. Eventually we hope to have every licensed driver in the United States and Canada (7,176 combined in 1966).

Del Insko finished with: "I'm honored to have served as president of this association. I think it's something we've needed for many years."

Finding your niche

Waiting for the first pitch of a minor league baseball game between the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels and the Daytona Tortugas, I began chatting to a strange fellow seated near me who looked like he was in town for a Grateful Dead reunion. He was a wiry guy, maybe 60, with long scraggly grey hair and flip-flops, wearing a well-worn t-shirt that read "A Day Without Baseball Will Probably Not Kill Me, But Why Risk It?"

We bantered easily about the current crop of Tortuga players, places to get a good pizza and hometowns (he was born in Juneau, AK) and then drifted into pastimes and hobbies. I threw out "harness racing." His eyes glazed over as if he was experiencing an acid flashback. His pause forced me to pantomime, grabbing a pair of invisible reins, shaking them and saying, "horses, racing." My performance did not generate a response, he appeared to be unfamiliar with our sport, so I quickly asked, "What about you?"

He said, "Guitars."

Having played bass guitar in a garage band, The Mad Mushrooms of Mulhern Drive, I was familiar with the instrument. Before I could ask him for clarification, he filled the gap and clarified for the next 15 minutes. The guy – we never exchanged names – built custom guitars using wood from forests in exotic places. He hardly took a breath and talked about tonality, hardwoods, travels and how he marketed some of them on the Internet. He mentioned a few rock guitarists that were clients, but I had never heard of them or their bands.

When he finally took a break in his monologue, I asked, "Acoustic or electric?"

My simple question was not so simple. Guitar man began another long ramble about economics, "I do some electrics for sales purposes, but my preference for creating and playing would always be eight-string acoustics made from Brazilian hardwood."

While most of his guitar details went over my head, his excitement was contagious. If he invited me to his basement workshop to watch him turn a tree into a tune, Trey would

go. Here was a person who found his niche and was gleefully lost doing his thing. After the tape-recorded National Anthem, I settled into my seat and wondered about two things.

What was the origin of the word – niche?

How could I have better explained my passion for harness racing to guitar man?

The term niche was a quick etymology search. The Latin word nidus (nest) was messed around by French folks and morphed into nicher (to make a nest) and eventually niche (which refers to a recess in a wall). I like the nesting angle. It fits people who find a pastime where they feel safe and happy, like guitar man and people involved in harness racing.

Then, I pondered how I could have introduced harness racing to guitar man less ponderously since my simple reply meant nothing to him. I muffed a chance to promote our sport. At the top of the third inning, a sudden summer rain blew into the ballpark, driving players and fans to shelter. I stood beside the guitar man next to the funnel cart on the concourse.

He gave me another chance when my new friend asked, "So what's with your horse thing?"

I was ready this time with my new approach, "You make guitars. I make racehorses. I grow a young horse each year."

He widened his eyes, gave a tiny nod, and said, "No shit?"

"Oh, trust me, manure is involved."

He smiled, showing several missing teeth, "So you race them?"

"I try to sell the baby horse, but if not, I try to race it against other horses of the same age and sex. I will find it a good home if I still own the horse at age 3. The process is a lot of fun. Every horse is a story that allows me to play a part."

My revised explanation did not scare him off. Guitar man asked me a series of simple questions; where did the horse live, how much did it cost monthly and did I get emotionally attached to a young horse? Can horses come in twins or triplets? Could I wager on my horse? He appeared interested in harness racing for a full five minutes. Still, soon he segued back into his passion and went on a rant about shipping and storing guitars, with profound scorn for people who ignore humidity changes.

The rain stopped. The ballgame resumed.

After the game, guitar man and I strolled toward the parking lot. He pointed down Beale Street and told me he had walked to the ballpark. We said goodbye. He disappeared into the warm darkness of the palm-lined street. Nice evening. We both learned a little about each other and learned about each other's passions, and we both had our niche.

Lucky guys.

San Moteur begins his journey towards the Elitloppet

Björn Goop-trained San Moteur, who became the first horse to get an invitation to the 2023 Elitloppet, will race on his home track Färjestad on Friday (April 7) for the first time since his world record performance in the \$320,000 Jubileumspokalen at Solvalla in August 2022.

Six-year-old San Moteur will compete in a \$12,000 race with seven opponents and the race is just the first step towards bigger objectives later on in the season.

In the \$65,000 Prins Carl Philips Jubileumspokal for 5-year-olds, Stefan P Pettersson's Iznogoud Am will be back after his successful 4-year-old season. Iznogoud Am finished second to Francesco Zet in the Sprintermästaren in July last year and was one of the favorites ahead of the Breeders Crown in November, where he had to be scratched. It's not a secret that trainer Pettersson and owner Courant Stable aims for this year's Elitloppet with the charismatic trotter.

RACKHAM IN PARALYMPIATRAVET ELIMINATION

A pretty tame edition of the first elimination for the Paralympiatravet at Åby was held at Åby racetrack on Saturday afternoon (April 1). The \$42,000 elimination race attracted only eight horses for the elite and the quality of the contenders was, to be fair, pretty moderate for the season.

Perhaps the long and never-ending Swedish winter made interest in the race so low, but one of the eight contenders won to secure a spot in the final at Åby in the beginning of May.

Christoffer Eriksson-trained **Rackham** (Love You) took the lead in a very slow opening and the duo kept up a very moderate pace until a half-mile of the race remained. Then Eriksson pushed on the gas pedal and though Rackham lost his gait significantly in the last turn when the pace was at its peak, he held on and won in a mile rate of 1:57.3 over 1.3 miles.

GERMAN BRED 3-YEAR-OLD BEST IN PARIS

Italian, German and French bred 3-year-old trotters fought for the win on a sloppy Vincennes track when the \$75,000 Prix Penthelsilea was held on Friday (March 31) afternoon. Until then undefeated Executiv Ek had to stand back when German-bred **Jazzman** proved to be best.

Jazzman (Niky), trained by Laurent-Claude Abrivard and driven by Alexandre Abrivard, hit the lead and controlled the field without problem all the way to the wire.

Jazzman will most probably show up at Solvalla in May, according to driver Abrivard and the 3-year-old Niky son won Friday's race in a mile rate of 2:01.1.

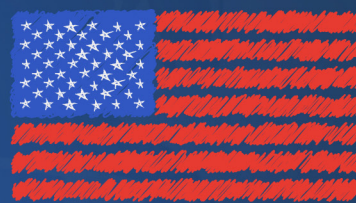

Favorites reign in third round of the Blue Chip Matchmaker Series

The recent import **Dougs Babe A** found the winner's circle for the first time in the U.S. in the third leg of the Blue Chip Matchmaker Series on Friday night (March 31) at MGM Yonkers Raceway. Dexter Dunn guided the 6-year-old mare from off-the-pace and scored in 1:53 to capture the first of three \$40,000 divisions.

Jason Bartlett and Mabalene N were airborne at the outset, leaving over second choice Majorca N into the first turn. Dunn and Dougs Babe A had thought of leaving but elected to tuck in fourth on the opening bend with no other options.

Corey Callahan guided Majorca N on a regaining move off the first turn and the veteran mare hit the quarter in :28.2 and half in :57.1. The field remained in line until Dunn moved just before the three-quarters with the Nifty Norman-trained Dougs Babe A.

Majorca N hit three quarters in 1:25.2 and held the favorite at bay through the final turn, but once in the homestretch Dougs Babe A asserted her will and sprinted home to an easy victory with a :27.3 final quarter. Majorca N held second with Man Dontforget Me and Matt Kakaley closing sharply for the show spot.

Owned by Tom Vassiliou, Nicholas Tallarico, Patricia Stables and Enzed Racing, Dougs Babe A is now a 12-time winner in her career and has banked \$173,026. As the favorite Dougs Babe A returned \$3.30 to win and led a \$5.80 exacta and a \$33.80 trifecta.

Amazing Dream N and driver Yannick Gingras continued their winning ways in the second \$40,000 division, popping the pocket on the final turn and rolling past pace-setter Racine Bell on her way to a 1:51.4 victory. The Linda Toscano-trained 7-year-old mare pushed her career earnings above \$1.3 million with the win.

Racine Bell and Bartlett used high speed to out-sprint Amazing Dream N on the first turn and take control off that bend. Racine Bell controlled the fractions of :27.3 and :56.2 with Amazing Dream N content to travel in second and Hot Mess Express third.

On the backstretch the final time Lit De Rose began a first over assault, followed by Drama Act. Gingras didn't wait for trouble, moving Amazing Dream N to the outside past the 1:24 three-quarters. The Bettor's Delight-sired mare was able to wear down the leader and sprint home in :27.4 for the win. Racine Bell did well to hold on to the place, with Lit De Rose and Drama Act following in third and fourth, respectively.

Owned by Enviro Stables, Richard Gutnick, Tom Pontone and Joseph Lozito Jr., Amazing Dream N, who made her 29th appearance in the winner's circle, paid \$3.20 as the public choice. The exacta and trifecta were worth \$5.50 and \$16.60, respectively.

Incaseyoudidntknow and driver Andrew McCarthy came overland in the third \$40,000 Blue Chip Matchmaker division and overpowered Gia's Surreal in the stretch on her way to a solid score in a 1:52.3 clocking.

McCarthy looked to leave the gate at the outset but was looped when Watch Me Now N and Jordan Stratton blasted by them from post eight into the first turn. McCarthy settled for a tuck instead, as did Watch Me Now N behind Karma Seelster. Karma Seelster had settled things on the opening bend for Matt Kakaley but was soon under attack from Gia's Surreal and Bartlett, who hustled to the front in a snappy :27 second opening quarter.

McCarthy didn't wait very long to energize the 2-1 favorite and had Incaseyoudidntknow on the offensive first-over with Morning Has Broken and Lucky Artist A trailing her in second- and third-over position. Incaseyoudidntknow turned up the pressure past the :56.1 half and was on even terms with Gia's Surreal through three-quarters in 1:24.2.

Gingras came three-deep on the final turn with Morning Has Broken, looking for the upset, but McCarthy had something in reserve and Incaseyoudidntknow, a 5-year-old daughter of Always B Miki, responded with a :28.1 final quarter to secure

the victory. Morning Has Broken settled for second with Karma Seelster getting room along the pylons and finishing third, while Lucky Artist A settled for fourth.

Incaseyoudidntknow won for the third time in 2023 and 19th occasion overall for trainer Les Givens and owners James Magno and Joseph Forte. Now an earner of \$298,551, Incaseyoudidntknow returned \$6.00 as the betting favorite and was atop a \$51.00 exacta and a \$140.00 trifecta.

Preliminary round action in the Blue Chip Matchmaker Series runs through Friday, April 14 and will conclude with a \$125,000 added final that should go for at least \$250,000 on April 24. The final of the MGM Borgata Pacing Series and companion consolation races for both events will also occur that night.

Stakes action will resume on Monday night (April 3) at MGM Yonkers Raceway with four \$50,000 splits of the third leg of the MGM Borgata Series for free-for-all pacers. Trotters will also be in action next week as the John Brennan Series gets underway on Wednesday (April 5).

Also, continuing into April, the Pick 5 pool on Thursdays at MGM Yonkers Raceway will be seeded with \$10,000 and also have a guaranteed pool of \$25,000. This initiative is being offered in partnership with the Standardbred Owners Association of New York as part of the United States Trotting Association's Strategic Wagering Program.

MGM Yonkers Raceway is currently operating on a Monday through Friday live racing schedule with post time at 7 p.m. (EDT).

Kakaley looks for big points in Borgata round 3

Matt Kakaley will enter Monday's (April 3) third round of the MGM Borgata Pacing Series with three horses within nine points of the top eight in the standings — None Bettor A, American Courage and Backstreet Shadow — and an eye toward enhancing their chances of qualifying for the lucrative April 24 championship.

The annual MGM Yonkers Raceway series for male pacers features five preliminary rounds. The top-eight horses at the completion of the Borgata's prelims are eligible for the \$200,000-added final. Horses receive 50 points for winning, 25 for second, 12 for third, eight for fourth and five for fifth. In addition, all starters in each round receive 25 points.

Idealsomemagic A and Lochinvar Art A sit atop the standings with 150 points apiece after each winning their first two assignments in the series. Hellabalou and Jimmy Freight, both with a first and a second, are next with 125 points each.

Rounding out the top eight, including ties, are Leonidas A (112), Priceless Beach and Tattoo Artist (100 each) and American Dealer and Rockin Withelvis A (83 each).

Kakaley's three Travis Alexander-trained hopefuls are next: None Bettor A with 80 points followed by American Courage with 75 and Backstreet Shadow with 74. All three will be looking for their first win in the series on Monday.

"If you don't win one of the first two legs, you have to make sure you win the third or the fourth," Kakaley said. "A lot of it has to do with the draws. You know how it is when you draw (post) seven or eight over there, you're behind the 8-ball. If you get good draws early on, it's kind of key to make sure you do well and get the points."

None Bettor A races in the third of Monday's four \$50,000 third-round divisions, which features four of the top-seven horses in the standings. None Bettor A, whose two starts this season have both been in the Borgata, will start from post three and is 4-1 on the morning line. Hellabalou is the 2-1 favorite, followed by Tattoo Artist at 5-2.

The 10-year-old None Bettor A finished second by a neck to Lochinvar Art A last week and was fifth, beaten only 1-1/4 lengths, in the first round after getting caught in traffic on the final turn.

"We were in the two-hole behind Tattoo Artist, you think it's the best spot to be and off the last turn [Tattoo Artist] was done," Kakaley said. "Otherwise, I think None Bettor would have been first or second. He was just unlucky."

"Last week, he was really good. He just got mowed down by probably the best horse in the series."

None Bettor A was no worse than second in his final five races last year, winning four, including the \$250,000 MGM Aria Invitational.

"He's a handy horse," Kakaley said. "He likes to be on the lead or in the two-hole and he's quick enough to get there. That's an advantage on a half-mile track [like Yonkers]. He can leave fast."

American Courage will compete in the fourth division, which includes 3-1 favorite Idealsomemagic A. American Courage, who starts from post two, is the 7-2 co-second choice, along with Jimmy Freight.

Five-year-old American Courage, who won the 2021 MGM Grand Messenger Stakes at Yonkers, finished second to Idealsomemagic A in his seasonal debut in round one of the Borgata and was seventh from post seven last week.

"I couldn't have been happier with his first race," Kakaley said. "I moved him twice to make the front and then in the last turn he still felt like he was going to hang on. The horse that got us is probably the second-best one behind Lochinvar Art. He was a little bit sharper."

"Last week, our fate was kind of sealed when we drew the seven and there was all that speed underneath us. That was a crazy good mile they went in the mud. There was just no way for us to get involved."

Backstreet Shadow is in the first Borgata division and will start from post five for the third consecutive week. He is the co-second choice with Nandolo N at 3-1. This Is The Plan, the 2021 Borgata champion, is the 5-2 favorite.

Eight-year-old Backstreet Shadow finished third in both his previous starts in the series, missing by a neck in the first round after being nine-lengths back in seventh at the half-mile point.

"He's been racing phenomenal the last couple weeks," Kakaley said. "Last week, it was hard for closers to get involved, but he

still rallied and was pacing hard on the end of it. The week before, he made a huge rally coming three-wide around the turn. It's a little bit better when I can just make one run and not use him leaving. It seems like he's better that way."

Kakaley, who is the leading driver at Pocono Downs at Mohegan Pennsylvania and tied for fourth at Yonkers, picked up a drive with Hemsworth N in the second division. Kakaley had conflicting drives in the first two weeks, but posted four wins and a second in five previous trips with Hemsworth N.

Hemsworth N, a 6-year-old trained by Jared Bako, finished eighth from post eight last week and fifth, beaten only 1-3/4 lengths, from post six in round one. He is 4-1 on Monday's morning line, starting from post three in a field that includes even-money favorite Lochinvar Art A.

"I like the horse," said Kakaley, who ranks third among drivers in North America in purses with \$1.58 million. "He hasn't really gotten to show what he's got in the Borgata yet, but the talent is there. He's a fast horse."

SRF Series winners impress at Big M

The Standardbred Retirement Foundation series for 3-year-olds kicked off Friday (March 31) night at The Meadowlands and not only did the connections of some inexperienced competitors get a feel for how good their horses may go on to be, but a handful of retired pacers and trotters also benefited in a big way as well.

The brainchild of Meadowlands' president/chief executive officer Jeff Gural, a big chunk of change went toward the care of retired standardbreds as 175 horses entered the series at \$200 each. After The Big M matched that dollar for dollar, the donation to the SRF totaled \$70,000.

That's a good thing for horses no longer racing, but as far as those who are still on the track, the first of three \$20,000 divisions, this one for filly pacers, went to **Super Girl**, a daughter of Downbytheseaside—Symphony In Motion, who stopped the clock in 1:50.3 for trainer Mark Harder.

The 5-1 third choice in the betting, Super Girl returned \$12.60 while winning for the second time from seven career starts, all during 2023. It was a head back to Always B Naughty with 4-5 favorite C Is For Cookie third.

"She's been racing super," said driver Todd McCarthy of his pocket-trip winner. "They come a pretty quick back half and she did a pretty good job."

In the second division, for trotting fillies, **Bella Macchiato** took down 1-5 public choice Sheer Faith by a diminishing neck at the finish with a wire-to-wire score in 1:53.4 for driver Josert Fonseca. The Empress Ice was third.

Friday marked the first Big M appearance of the year for 2020 Dan Patch Trainer of the Year Nancy Takter.

"It's our first weekend of racing this year at The Meadowlands," Takter said, "and it's good to get everybody rolling again. [Bella Macchiato] raced super. Josert was able to get her to relax during the middle half [which was rated in :59]."

Bella Macchiato, a daughter of Bar Hopping—Sorbet Hanover who was making her seasonal debut, paid \$11.60 as the 9-2 second choice in the betting.

Division three, another filly pace, went to the 8-5 favorite, **Anna's Wish**, a daughter of Lazarus N—Keystone I Wish, in 1:52.2.



The Christopher Freck trainee, who was making her 2023 debut, made the top while parked to the half with Tim Tetrick driving and sailed home from there an easy 2-length winner over Always A Show Off. Ultimate Loulou was third.

Anna's Wish, another making her first start of the year, returned \$5.20 to her backers.

24 STRAIGHT: All-source betting, thanks to a 12th-race that saw \$335,312 put in play, totaled \$3,116,790, keeping The Big M's streak of surpassing the magic \$3-million mark intact.

There have been 24 Friday and Saturday night programs conducted during 2023 and everyone has seen wagering exceed \$3 million.

During 2022, betting went past the \$3-million mark 23 times during the 85-program season.

A LITTLE MORE: The 20-cent Pick-5 returned \$6,209.62 after winner's odds during the sequence were a far-from-outrageous 8-1, 5-1, 9-2, 4-1 and 8-5. Tetrick led the driver's colony with three winners on the night.

Purses increase for DSBF finals

At the March 22 meeting of the Delaware Standardbred Breeders' Fund board, it was approved to increase all final purses for the 2023 racing year.

The finals will now race for \$110,000 beginning with the Governor's Day races at the Delaware State Fair on Thursday (July 27).

There are 104 eligible 3-year-olds.

Also, to continue for the breeding season of 2023, any mare bred to a registered Delaware sire will be eligible for the \$10,000 broodmare bonus drawing which will be held at the 2024 DSOA banquet.

McLenaghan ready for spring at Shenandoah

Shenandoah Downs might not be home for Stacey McLenaghan, but it's close. McLenaghan moved with her family from Canada to Virginia when she was 12 and grew up in New Kent, about three hours southeast of Woodstock, VA, where Shenandoah is located.

McLenaghan followed in the footsteps of her father, Ron, in getting into harness racing. Her dad, who passed away in 2020, drove and trained horses in addition to owning and operating a construction company. The family raced primarily at New Kent's Colonial Downs, where McLenaghan spent her formative years and added Shenandoah Downs when it began racing in 2016.

In 2021, McLenaghan tied for the most wins among trainers at Shenandoah with 10. Last year, she led the way with 15.

Until this year, Shenandoah Downs raced only in the fall. Yesterday (April 1), the track opened for its first-ever spring pari-mutuel meet. McLenaghan was there with a stable of a dozen horses, with six entered to race over the weekend.

The seven-week April/May session — with racing taking place every Saturday and Sunday at 1 p.m. — marks the first spring harness meet in Virginia since 1998, when the inaugural standardbred campaign at Colonial Downs was conducted.

"I think it's great for them to be able to put on two different meets [spring and fall] throughout the year," McLenaghan said. "It's a great atmosphere there. They put on a great show for the people.

"It's nice to be somewhat close to home and have friends and family come watch what we do for a couple weeks. I have a lot of friends that have no clue about racing and when they come, they think it's just awesome. The racing is so close and personal there because the grandstand is literally right on top of the track. They can see the horses up close. Everyone loves it."

McLenaghan played softball, volleyball and basketball in high school and then played softball for four years at Averett University, where she was an honorable mention all-conference selection in 2005. She got a degree in sports medicine and added a master's in physical education, but the allure of racing proved too strong.

In 2009, McLenaghan got her first win as a driver with Beyond Perfection, a horse owned by her father, at Colonial Downs. Her father also drove in the race, finishing third.

For her career, the 38-year-old McLenaghan has won 342 races as a trainer and 34 as a driver.

On Saturday, McLenaghan will send out 3-year-old male pacer Buzzer and 6-year-old male pacer Art Nukem in separate conditioned events.

Buzzer won his season debut last week at Rosecroft Raceway and is the 2-1 morning-line favorite in his race. The colt has won four of six career starts and earned \$14,435.

Art Nukem has two second-place finishes among seven races this year, all at Rosecroft. Last year, he won six of 30 and banked \$41,816.

Corey Braden, McLenaghan's fiancé, will drive both horses.

"Buzzer has been pretty consistent," McLenaghan said. "We had a couple issues with a bit of colt soreness last year at 2, so we didn't push him, but he's been a nice little purchase for us.

"Art Nukem really enjoys the half-mile track. He was pretty decent [at Shenandoah] in the fall for us. I think he'll enjoy not chasing the speed he's been having to face at Rosecroft. He's been in the open and preferred and they go [1]:51 every week. I think he'll enjoy the slower momentum of the half."

On Sunday, McLenaghan will have DW's Revenge and Creekside Pete in the open handicap trot and Kotare Yael N and Twist Knot in conditioned races.

"I think this meet will be a little different with new people coming that haven't raced there because of the time of year," McLenaghan said. "We usually have a good meet and we're hoping for the same thing this spring."

Charlie May should be the correct winner of the 2021 Meadowlands Pace

I've watched the replay of Charlie May's [2021 Meadowlands Pace](#) over and over again. The fault Dear Brutus, is Southwind Gendry's. He got "steppy" (meaning his stride wasn't a normal stride, almost like he was going to go off stride) just coming to the top of the stretch. At that very instant, Charlie May was making his move to the outside for his stretch run.

Charlie May was forced to check hard and impeded the horses also moving up for their stretch drives. This event occurred at the worst moment in the race when all are looking, scrambling for position.

I failed to see that very night why Charlie May was taken down, and no I didn't have 2 cents bet on him. Now 1.5 years later it was reversed and now reversed again.

I don't know what else the driver could do. Even Gingras said of his horse, Southwind Gendry, "his horse slowed down at that moment." What he refers to as "slows down," was he got "steppy." With that action, at that precise moment, Charlie May was stepping on the gas.

Now if you're driving along and the guy in front of you slows down at the moment you look to pass him on the right, your start over to the right and he starts coming over as well. Now what can you do? In a car you could jam on the brakes, but this is a horse, so he continues to move to the right. But now the horses that were behind you on the right come up on your bumper and it becomes a mess.

Who's at fault? Southwind Gendry, call it "slowed down," I say "steppy" started the chain reaction. Southwind altered his course too. He didn't continue straight, he drifted out, slightly, but still, and forced the horse behind to alter their course.
