Stacy Chiodo has plenty to be thankful for. At the age of 23, she suffered a major stroke and was given a 50/50 chance of waking up. Her parents were told if she did pull through, she might have severe brain damage. By the grace of God, the resilient and determined young woman beat the odds and made a complete recovery.

Chiodo grew up in Holmdel, NJ, where her family farmed vegetables and her grandfather farmed produce that the family sold on the roadside and in local supermarkets. Her love story for horses began at the age of 5 when she befriended a young girl from school who lived on a thoroughbred farm.

“My friend’s mother, Susan Clausen, taught me how to ride and the important horsemanship skills one needed,” Chiodo said. “Shortly after, my mother bought me my first riding horse and I started showing English in local shows.

“Mom bought herself a thoroughbred racehorse, but unfortunately it was not good enough so she sold the horse to a trainer for barrel racing. I was immediately hooked. A woman named Laurie Molnar had a quarter horse and also trained standardbreds stabled at Crystal Brook Training Center in Colts Neck, NJ. I bought a gelding from Laurie and kept him at the training center. Every day after school I would go ride my horse and eventually Laurie let me jog and train with her.”

While in high school, Chiodo worked at a thoroughbred turn out farm. She qualified for the national finals in the NBHA for barrel racing, and when her boss wouldn’t give her a week off, she handed in her notice.

“Laurie got me a job working for standardbred trainer Ross Croghan cleaning stalls,” Chiodo said. “I cleaned 32 stalls a day, which at the time I thought was great. A few months later Ross showed me four horses and said, ‘These are yours to train.’”

Several years later, Chiodo went to work for trainer Chris Height as a groom.

“I loved my job, but when an opportunity came up to work for Bruce Springsteen – yes, ‘The Boss’ himself – I jumped at it. When I told Chris I was going to work for Bruce, he thought I

was joking. Then on March 11, 2000, I suffered a stroke at the age of 23. Although I was given a slim outlook, I defied the odds and woke up. Luckily, Bruce held the job for me and when I was strong enough, I went to work at Springsteen’s farm caring for his spectacular riding horses.”

Although Chiodo loved working for the singing superstar, she missed the action of the racing scene and after a few years, got a job working for trainer Mike Russo.

“That was my first experience working with yearlings,” Chiodo said. “I instantly fell in love with that part; watching the babies grow up and become racehorses. When I decided to go on my own and give it a try, my mother and I went to a sale at Showplace Farm looking to buy a superstar. Everyone has the dream of purchasing a yearling in hopes he will be the next champion. At that time my mother had a budget of \$5,000 to help me buy a horse, but after watching the ‘selections’ we had picked out go for much more, our dreams were quickly deflated.

“We waited until the end of the sale hoping we just might get lucky and purchase a baby that fit in our budget. My mother noticed a yearling colt by Blissful Hall, but when they brought the colt out, he had an ugly scar on his leg. I didn’t think it would affect him too much so we decided to take the chance. He started out at \$1,000 and the final bid was \$4,500 and we got him.”

The colt’s name was NF Trombone Alley.

“I needed help in breaking the colt and thankfully my friend Freddie Carr was happy to oblige,” Chiodo said. “The colt was feisty and rambunctious and one day after bucking like a bronco Freddie said, ‘Whoa, Rodeo Joe,’ and from that day on we called him Joe.

“We decided on registering the name Mighty Joe Young but the name was already taken, so we named him Mighty Young Joe. Joe did not take to pacing easily and I thought it was because I was not experienced enough, but one day the light bulb went off in Joe’s head. When I went back to the barn, I had a smile on my face that could light up a Christmas tree. My mother asked if Joe paced and I answered, ‘One day this horse is going to make me famous.’”

Chiodo drove in her first pari-mutuel race with Joe and won a division of the Reynolds for 2-year-old colts at Pocono Downs.

“He went on to give me many firsts, including ‘the first female to win a leg of the George Morten Levy, and ‘fastest female driving record at Harrah’s Chester and Pocono Downs,’ she said. “Little did I know that our \$4,500 yearling, [at the age of 11] would make me the first female driver to break 1:50.”

On May 3, 2014, Joe won at The Meadowlands in 1:49.3.

“After we retired him, I tracked down, NF One Rose, Joe’s full-sister, and began breeding her, hoping to get some of the speed and heart that her brother had,” Chiodo said. “Rose is a 100 per cent producer, and to date I have bred and trained all of her offspring, with two of them earning over \$150,000 and the fastest being Shezafreaklikeme, who got a mark of 1:50.4. She

also made the Breeders Crown at 3, and although she finished last, it was very exciting.

“I have been very lucky, no, I’ve been blessed in life, and in my career. I had the opportunity to drive in Norway in a women’s driving championship, which I won. Chiodo appreciates the horsewomen that came before her, especially the one she admires most, Jacquie Ingrassia.

“She signed for my license when I got started and is a great role model for women in the sport,” Chiodo said. “I love to joke with her when she wins a race. I tell her, ‘You are my idol and I want to be just like you when I grow up.’ Being the humble woman that she is, Jacquie just laughs it off.”

“As far as my future plans, I hope to continue driving and training, and still have the dream of breeding and owning the next champion, like everyone else. That’s what keeps the industry alive. I’ve come full circle, for presently I train 13 horses at the Crystal Brook Training Center where I got my start.”

Wilfong looks to build on 2023 success

After finally giving up on racing in Chicago, driver Kyle Wilfong has accelerated up the standings at Harrah's Hoosier Park.

Harrah's Hoosier Park's 2023 meet provided an incredible opportunity for driver Kyle Wilfong to raise his profile at the Anderson, IN oval. The 32-year-old reinsman finished third in the standings last season and captured the Dan Patch Stakes

steering Ponda Warrior. This season, he is off to a fast start in the meet's early going and looks to build on that momentum.

"Last year was big for me," Wilfong said. "I really got my foot in the door and everything just went great. From winning the Dan Patch and having a great stable behind me with Jay Hochstetler and a couple others, that's been huge."

Wilfong's career as a driver began in 2007 with four trips behind the starting gate. He won three of those races. By 2011, he logged just over 1,200 starts while guiding 126 winners and earning three-quarters of a million dollars in purses.

“When I first started driving on the pari-mutuel scene, I was driving at Balmoral Park and going to Hoosier Park and Indiana Downs, just mainly driving my dad’s horses,” he said. “Wherever we would get in, if we had three or four horses in at one place, I would be there. I really didn’t have a set schedule. After two years of doing that, I moved up to Balmoral full time and drove there until they closed their doors.”

When Balmoral closed in 2015, Wilfong moved to Anderson, but Illinois was still a big part of his schedule. He gradually moved up the ladder to become one of the top drivers at Hawthorne, winning multiple titles.

“I always got good work there,” Wilfong said. “I was first or second in the driver’s colony. I was so optimistic after they got the slot bill passed that something was truly going to happen. We’re so close, but nothing’s happened. I was living in Anderson and dead set that Hawthorne was going to be the answer for me. I moved a stable up there and it just didn’t work. I got tired of being on the road a lot.”

The fourth-generation horseman split time between Hoosier Park and Chicago through the 2022 season. In 2021, Wilfong finished 18th in the Hoosier Park driver standings with 19 winners and just over \$320,000 in purse earnings. In 2022, he moved up to 11th in the standings, winning 49 races and banking \$767,000 in earnings.

“I always ventured back to Hawthorne and the Illinois racing scene until last year,” he said. “With the direction that Illinois has gone, it was time to find my spot. I’m happy to be at home now.”

Focused primarily on Hoosier Park, Wilfong had an incredible season. He more than tripled his Indiana win total from the previous year, tallying 153, while raking in just over \$3 million in purses. Nationally, he finished the year with 197 scores, second only to his 221 victories one year earlier. He set a personal best in earnings with \$3.56 million, almost one million more than his previous mark established in 2022.

“I was thrilled to be third,” Wilfong said. “That was great. It was a big leap from where I had been in years past. It just all worked out.”

The driver admitted that his fortunes changed after teaming with Hochstetler to win the Dan Patch.

“For me it was huge,” he said. “I was getting some work, but the quality of work definitely seemed to really improve. It was big, it truly was.”

The driver/trainer tandem also found success with freshman trotting filly Ponda Title. The Muscle Massive lass won seven times, capturing the Indiana Sires Stakes Super Final and Trotter of the Year honors in the state while earning just over \$480,000.

With Hoosier Park’s 2024 meet now underway, Wilfong finds himself in uncharted territory. After opening weekend, he topped the standings, and six days into the 160-day meet, he is again in the pole position after bagging six winners Thursday (April 4), bringing his early meet total to 12. It’s not the first time he has guided six horses to the winner’s circle on a card. He did so on Hawthorne’s Night of Champions in 2022, capturing half a dozen finals.

“I’m just trying to do better,” he said. “Try to do the best with every drive I get. When you do that, the better quality of horse comes. Over the years I’ve traveled to Hawthorne or Oak Grove or places like that just chasing work. I think the more you drive the better you’ll be at it.”

The years of hustle are paying off. Wilfong is enjoying early-season success and is within striking distance of a milestone. After Thursday’s six-win night, he sits at 1,980 career victories.

“To get close to 2,000, I’m thrilled,” he said. “It’s all about the next one.”

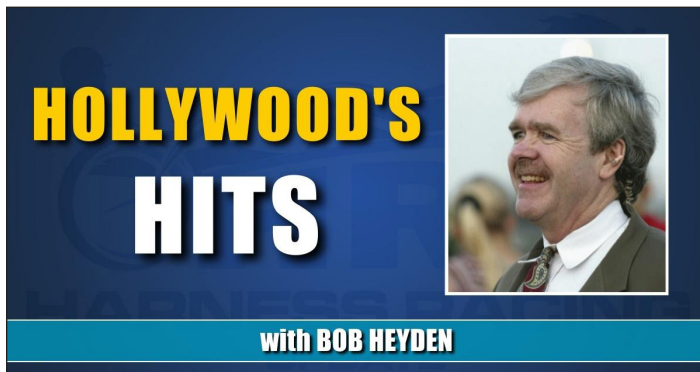

A look at Eternal Camnation, Bunny Lake and the Tetrick brothers

Eternal Camnation – the richest female pacer of all time – was foaled on April 3, 1997. At 27, the daughter from the final crop of Cam Fella, **died last month** on March 5. This October marks the 20th anniversary of her final race, The Allerage Farms Mare Pace at The Red Mile. Her career earnings of \$3,748,574 (101 47-18-5) is a number which has not been approached since.

Eternal Camnation was a \$35,000 yearling and spent her entire career under the care of Jeff Miller. Her career bankroll made her the richest son/daughter of racing/siring legend Cam Fella (1979-2001). She won three Breeders Crowns at ages 2, 4, and 6. Eleven different drivers had the honor to sit behind her in her 101-race career: Eric Ledford, Ron Waples, Jeff Miller, Jay Cross, Mike Saftic, Chris Christoforou, Jr., Luc Ouellette, Trevor Richie, Richard Silverman, Joe Putnam and Jeff Fout.

She went into the Hall of Fame in 2011, fittingly, the same year that the richest ever pacer Gallo Blue Chip also entered. Those two once competed in the very same race, the 2001 U S Pacing Championship (now the Sam McKee), where “Gallo” was second to Goliath Bayama and Eternal Camnation finished eighth. She took her lifetime mark of 1:49.2 at Woodbine on Aug. 10, 2002. She appeared in 35 races valued at six figures and won 18 of them, just over 50 per cent. Her longest winning streak was 12,

the last 12 races of her freshman season. Twice she won by a nose and three times by a neck.

Maybe the most interesting note on Eternal Camnation is the fact that she and Bunny Lake (\$37,000 yearling) retired in the very same race on Oct. 9, 2004 at The Red Mile, as the top two female pacing earners of all-time!

Only Gallo had more than Eternal Camnation as of Oct. 9, 2004. She was second at \$3,748,574 and Bunny Lake was No. 8 all-time at \$2,843,476. You have to dig-deep, very deep, to get to No. 3 on the ladies list at that time, \$1.9 for Worldly Beauty who was 34th all-time among pacers.

Eternal Camnation was second and Bunny Lake fourth in the \$100,000 Allerage that went to Carolina Sunshine in 1:49.3.

Actually, their last three races were together: the Milton elim (won by Always B Cam) and final (Loyal Opposition). In those two races, Bunny was second and fifth and Eternal Camnation finished third and second.

Eternal Camnation was favored in 42 of her 101 career races and Bunny Lake was favored in 55 of her 93 starts.

Average amount per year of racing? Bunny Lake at \$568,695 and Eternal Camnation with \$629,762.

The first time they ever met, was 5-year-old Eternal Camnation's 47th career start and 4-year-old Bunny Lake's 35th. It was in the Classic Series in 2002 where Bunny Lake finished fifth and was placed 10th and Eternal Camnation was fourth from post 10.

The first time Cat Manzi drove Bunny Lake he posted her first sub 1:50 win of 1:49.4 on July 13, 2002 at The Meadowlands.

Eric Ledford (1:49.2) and Trevor Ritchie (1:49.4) combined for back-to-back sub 1:50 victories with Eternal Camnation on Aug. 3 and 10, respectively, at The Meadowlands and then Woodbine.

Bunny also did it back-to-back, going 1:49, her lifetime best, at Woodbine in both the Roses Are Red elim and final on Aug. 27 and Sept. 4, 2004. They were her 89th and 90th lifetime starts with a brand-new mark.

Bunny Lake was 8-for-26 lifetime in six-figure races.

Bunny lake never raced at Hoosier Park, while Eternal Camnation started four of her six racing seasons there and five of six seasons there qualifying. Overall, in Indiana, Eternal Camnation

was 15 7-4-1, the most starts and wins for any member of the \$3 million club lifetime.

Bunny Lake was the first filly to earn \$1 million in a single season among pacers. (Cathedra Dot Com followed close behind in that same year of 2001, both 3YOPF).

Eternal Camnation's \$908,346 season in 2003 at age 6 was the high-water mark for pacing mares for seven years, topped in 2010 by Dreamfair Eternal at \$925,575.

The Meadowlands was the favorite/most frequented track by both Eternal Camnation (30-for-101) and Bunny Lake (34-for-93).

Luc Ouellette is the only common driver for both.. Here's the list of the eight drivers who handled the 2001 HOY Bunny Lake, who raced three more seasons: Ouellette, John Campbell, Cat Manzi, Mike Lachance, Brian Cross, Mario Baillargeon, Rod Allen, and of course, John Stark, Jr.

There had only one trainer in both of their careers: John Stark, Jr. (Bunny Lake) and Jeff Miller (Eternal Camnation). Stark is the last trainer/driver to campaign any HOY (Bunny Lake in 2001).

Bunny Lake's longest win streak was 18, the final 18 of her award-winning 3YO campaign back in 2001.

THE BROTHERS TETRICK KEEP PILING IT ON

In 2023, for the ninth time, the brothers Tetrick, Tim and Trace, combined to win better than 1,000 races. If it wasn't for the COVID-19 year of 2020, they would be gunning for their ninth straight and 10th overall in 2024.

Here are their individual slates added together as they continue the most dominant brother act ever:

2007 – Tim 902, Trace 401 – 1303

2008 – Tim 1189, Trace 287 – 1476 (all-time record)

2009-10 – They fell a couple of bucks short at 896 and 974

2011 – Tim 746, Trace 391 – 1137

2012 – Tim 670, Trace 382 – 1052

2013-14 – Did not reach 1,000

2016 – Tim 613, Trace 478 – 1091

2017 – Tim 533, Trace 569 – 1102

2018 – Tim 581, Trace 485 – 1066

2019 – Tim 758, Trace 478 – 1236

2020 – Did not reach 1000 (943)

2021 – Tim 658, Trace 559 – 1217

2022 – Tim 575, Trace 536 – 1111

2023 – Tim 530, Trace 531 – 1061

What about the record for those brothers not named Tetrick? In 1989 the Filions – Herve 814, Yves 134, and Henri 2 – combined for a total of 950.

Overall, the Tetrick brothers have won at an alarming rate of 21.994 per cent with 112,451 combined lifetime drives and

21,194 winners. Combined in-the-money drives? They had 51,875 winner's circle trips in those 112,451 for a strong 46.13 per cent.

Trace's best year for wins was 2017 with 569 victories.

Tim's best year for wins is the all-time best of 1189 in 2007.

Trace's best season for earnings was last year with \$6,863,130.

Tim's best year for earnings is still the high-water mark of \$19,734,781 in 2008.

Tim also holds the record for drives in a single season at 4,728 in 2007.

Tough finish and upset winner at Vincennes

The older elite trotters battled on Saturday (Apr. 5) in Vincennes' \$130,000 Prix Kerjacques over 2,700 meters and the race's ending developed into a spectacular battle with three horses with a chance for victory.

Favorite Hussard du Landret, who had a great winter meeting in Paris, came to the lead midway into the race and he got company on the outside from Gamay de Liton, while **Usain Töll** (Googoo Gaagaa) found a spot second over.

Attacks were made three wide from several horses on the back stretch and Hooker Berry got, at first, perfect cover from Elie de Beaufour. But in the last turn, Elie de Beaufour's power was empty which resulted in a short moment of interference for Hooker Berry. Nicolas Bazire had to attack four wide in the turn and when Hussard du Landret gave up on the lead at the same time, Gamay de Liton got the advantage.

Usain Töll from second over was served the very best of trips by Benjamin Rochard. Rochard opted to stay two wide in the last turn and he never had to spend extra meters when Hooker Berry's path to the stretch was the opposite of Usain Töll's.

This proved to be decisive for the race's outcome. Gamay de Liton was challenged by Usain Töll down the stretch, while Hooker Berry found his speed again too late, but closed the gap to the two front horses very quickly. Usain Töll managed to disarm Gamay de Liton and Hooker Berry's hopes for the win was spoiled in the last turn. It was a close call when Usain Töll put his nose in front and won in a mile rate of 1:54.2 over 1.6 miles.

ÖNAS PRINCE TO PARALYMPIATRAVET

The first qualification for the Paralympiatravet at Åby was held at Åby racetrack on Saturday (April 5) afternoon and Per Nordström's **Önas Prince** (Chocolatier) was the heavy favorite for the win.

When only eight trotters trying to qualify for the \$320,000 Paralympiatravet on May 4, it's a sign of something not seen in the sport in Sweden. Sure, the winter has been long, but there still ought to be full fields of horses trying to grab a spot in a classic race like the Paralympiatravet.

Önas Prince started from post 8 behind the car and after a safe win in his 2024 debut, he was the natural favorite among considerably less merited opponents.

But even if Önas Prince is known as one of the quickest openers in the sport, he had to settle into position first over since Kagan held the lead from post 1. The race was fired up directly with a speedy first quarter with Kagan in front and the favorite on the outside.

As it turned out, Önas Prince proved best in the stretch and he impressed in a mile rate of 1:55.3 over 1.3 miles.

Önas Prince is now ready for the Paralympiatravet on May 4.

MONDAY

Around noon today, we had a good laugh, not one of those maniacal laughs from the third line of coke or drugs in our bloodstreams. We had an old-fashioned belly laugh from three people who had not had much to laugh about for a decade.

On Monday mornings, Paul takes his grandmother grocery shopping. Before unloading his truck today, he assisted his grandmother, Edith, out of his Ford Ranger, handed her the black hooked cane she uses, and steered her into the barn where Bart and I were cleaning equipment and filling water buckets. Edith had met Bart at some point in time. Paul introduced me as Bridgette. Instead of saying nice to meet you, she referred to me as the girl from the drug place. I shook her bony hand, flashing my best fake smile. She did not smile back.

Edith examined me with beady eyes. Then she wobbled over to a stall and examined Annie, our rehabbing horse. She sighed loudly, then, using her high-pitched cackle like the witch in The Wizard of Oz talking to flying monkeys, Edith screeched: “If I understand the situation correctly, I am financing a pipe dream business idea with racehorses, cooked up by three people with addictions who don’t have real jobs, one lame filly, a granddaughter with multiple problems, a hip that doesn’t work right, and my farm falling to pieces around me.”

Edith took a breath and jabbed her cane into the soggy ground with such force that it stuck. She almost fell over when her cane popped out of the mud with a slurping sound. Edith gave another hefty sigh and began to head towards the house. At the barn door, she froze, looked back, rolled her watery eyes like a silent movie damsel in distress, and said, well, screeched to the heavens – “Ain’t my life one big blue sky.” Then she continued to her house.

It isn’t easy to describe her tantrum or our reactions, but we began with snickers that grew into hysterical laughing. That minute of laughter took away some tension. The silly moment was cathartic. We laughed some more when we settled down and replayed the Edith scene.

Paul suggested we should name our little business Blue Skies For You. I shook my head and said no, we would need to introduce ourselves as representatives from BSFU. Bart chipped in and said we could rename the farm Red Flags Flying.

TUESDAY

We had a guest speaker at the NA meeting tonight. He was from Minnesota, an addict in long-term recovery with a long grey beard. His topic was feelings of shame in recovery. As he spoke (and was a good speaker), I thought about the three of us and the horses at Paul’s farm.

Build or rebuild positive relationships – Spend your time with people who care about you and accept you as you are. Look for associations with nonjudgmental people with whom you are comfortable. Animals and pets can be sources of unconditional love.

Like most good speakers, the man with the beard had a good opening line, part bombast, part question. He said we were all ashamed and guilty and asked if we knew the difference.

The guy startled us so much that nobody made a peep. Then, he began to talk gently and answered his question. His point was that shame and guilt are entirely different feelings, and both play a huge role in recovery. Guilt means you realize you deserve blame for bad things you did. Shame means you feel inferior and unworthy because of things you have done. Guilt means you feel you screwed up. Shame means you think you ARE screwed up. Understanding and overcoming these two are crucial in any recovery.

The speaker lost me when he went through a rather corny list of coping mechanisms using 10 well-worn flashcards. Concentration has never been one of my strong points. But three of his flashcards stuck in my mind. It dawned on me that I was already DOING three with the horse farm experience without thinking!

Live in the present - Try to focus only on today.

New Adventures - Attempt to learn new things with new people and focus on positive things.

Build or rebuild positive relationships - Spend your time with people who care about you and accept you as you are. Look for associations with nonjudgmental people with whom you are comfortable. Animals and pets can be sources of unconditional love.

WEDNESDAY

At the barn, I asked Paul what he thought of the speaker from last night. He said that he felt he had done an excellent job. We talked as we did chores.

Paul was unusually chatty today, so I learned a lot. Paul is going to keep a low profile during his pin-hooking project. He is filled with both shame and guilt and cannot separate the two. He

doesn't want to see people, racing people, and he is not ready to apologize or mend fences. He knows he will need to interact with some blacksmiths, vets, and eventually customers, but he plans on flying under the radar as much as possible. He has concerns about the harness horse racing organizations coming after him. The sport is a small world. He is a pariah and always will be, so he views what we do as entirely out of the sport.

Paul believes that being a persona non-gratis in the sport may help him in some ways. People remember the bad, which is uncomfortable for them and him, so isolation makes life easier. Also, his troubling reputation might help him overcome the biggest obstacle for others who have tried pin-hooking. Buyers are wary of any owner or trainer parting with promising yearlings ready to qualify. A racehorse on the cusp of a career is difficult to find. In Paul's situation, buyers will know he can never race another horse, so he MUST sell.

I think I understand his plan with the horses. I know he carries the same shame baggage that I do.

THURSDAY

Paul is very excited. He has an iPad with the horse catalog for a big horse auction next week and studies it with the enthusiasm of a teenage girl on a Taylor Swift fan blog. Five times today, he walked over and showed me names, numbers, and videos, which meant nothing to me. I could have been looking at a molecular biology chart, but I kept making approving sounds and nods of agreement, which seemed to please him. At noon, Bart showed up to work on the tractor and took some heat off me. For the next two hours, they sat around looking at the iPad and speaking excitedly in a language only known to horse people. It was nice to see them both happy.

Bulldog Hanover colt out of Put On A Show arrives at Hunterton

This royally-bred colt by Bulldog Hanover out of Put On A Show arrived on March 21 at Hunterton Farm in Kentucky. The colt, the seventh out of Put On A Show, is a half-brother to 2023 Pepsi North America Cup and Little Brown Jug champion It's My Show, a Sweet Lou gelding that has earned more than \$1.1 million and had a mark of 1:46.4. Put On A Show has also produced Bettors Delight-sired horse Best In Show (\$672,240, 1:48). On the track, Put On A Show, a daughter of Rocknroll Hanover out of Stienam's Place, earned over \$2.4 million, had a mark of 1:47.3 and was the Dan Patch sophomore pacing filly of the year in 2010. Bulldog Hanover, the 2022 Horse of the Year in both the U.S. and Canada – and the Pacer of the Year in the U.S. – earned over \$2.4 million and is the fastest horse in standardbred history thanks to a 1:45.4 mile. Bulldog Hanover stands at Seelster Farms in Ontario. The combined racing earnings of both the sire and dam of the latest Put On A Show offspring is north of \$4.8 million.

Mikala, Racine Bell tally in round four of the Blue Chip Matchmaker Series

Mikala, driven by George Brennan, marched to the front past the quarter and never looked back on the way to her second victory in the Blue Chip Matchmaker Series, scoring as the favorite in the first of two \$40,000 divisions of the fourth leg on Friday (April 5) night at MGM Yonkers Raceway.

Coachellabound N and Yannick Gingras sprinted from the gate to take control over True Blue Hanover on the first turn and had command until Brennan unleashed Mikala, a daughter of Always B Miki, before the quarter pole with a burst of speed to clear the front past the snappy :27.3 opening fraction. Mikala looked relaxed but was pacing strongly through the half in :56.3 and continued to speed down the pike. A :27.4 third quarter would bring her to three-quarters in 1:24.2 and left second choice Dougs Babe A, who was first-over with Dexter Dunn, at a disadvantage heading into the final turn.

Gingras pulled with Coachellabound N on the final turn and appeared ready to threaten the favorite, but Brennan called on Mikala through the stretch and the mare hung on gamely to score by a neck in 1:53. Coachellabound N settled for second, with Dougs Babe A closing the margin through the stretch but finishing third. Incaseyou didntknow rallied for fourth.

Trained by Nik Drennan, Mikala is owned by Joseph Davino, Brad Shackman, Anthony Perretti Farms and Drennan Stable LLC. As the favorite she returned \$4.20 to win, keying a \$16 exacta, a \$37.60 triple and a \$3.65 superfecta for a 10-cent ticket.

In the second Blue Chip Matchmaker section, Jason Bartlett and **Racine Bell** pulled a mild upset, winning for the first time in 2024 while gamely holding odds-on favorite Lit De Rose at bay after a thrilling stretch drive.

Bartlett left with intent from post 4 and seated Man Dontforget Me late on the opening turn. Delitfulcatherin N and Jordan Stratton also tried to leave but were forced to wedge into a 4-hole off the first turn and wait to move again later. Bartlett had Racine Bell on the front in a :27.3 opening quarter, but he applied the brakes in the second quarter and that got some at the back a bit antsy. Prior to the :57.1 half-mile fraction Stratton

had pulled Delitfulcatherin N to the outside as a cue to Lit De Rose and Patrick Lachance, though Lachance didn't appear keen on moving too early.

Past the half Racine Bell picked up the pace, and Lit De Rose went on with a solid challenge, moving towards the leader. Delitfulcatherin N didn't have the sprinting power to keep with her cover on the backstretch, and that allowed Easy To Please, with Yannick Gingras, to gain second-over cover right before the 1:25.2 three-quarters was passed first by Racine Bell.

In the stretch it was a two-mare contest as Racine Bell fought on the inside and Lit De Rose challenged to her flank but was unable to pass, losing in a tight photo in a mile timed in 1:54.3. Easy To Please gained slowly in the stretch to secure the third spot, with Man Dontforget Me along the inside in fourth.

Owned by Chris and Dale Lawton and trained by David Dewhurst, Racine Bell was a winner for the 38th time in her storied career while getting off the schneid in 2024 with her first win in six attempts. As the second choice Racine Bell returned \$9.70 to win, leading a \$30.40 exacta with the favorite. The triple paid \$112 and the 10-cent superfecta was worth \$20.40.

A 7-year-old New York-sired daughter of So Surreal, Racine Bell increased her career bankroll to \$1,195,499 with the victory.

The fifth and final preliminary leg for the Blue Chip Matchmaker Series is slated for Friday (April 12), with the \$125,000-added final going on Monday (April 22).

Stakes action continues at MGM Yonkers Raceway on Monday night with the fourth leg of the MGM Borgata Pacing Series offering three \$50,000 divisions on the 12-race program. After a delay due to the cancelation on Wednesday (April 3), the John Brennan Trotting Series also begins next week with five \$25,000 splits of the opening round on Wednesday night's (April 10) card.

MGM Yonkers Raceway is currently operating on a Monday-Friday live schedule with post time each night at 7 p.m. (EDT).

Beach Cowgirl takes Big M Friday feature

After a dismal start to her 2024 season when last as the 3-5 favorite, **Beach Cowgirl** followed that up with a solid second-place finish to Always B Naughty, a stakes filly from a year ago, last week. That effort set her up to find the winner's circle Friday night (April 5) at The Meadowlands in the featured \$17,000 high-end conditioned pace for fillies and mares.

Despite facing another top-flight mare, Zanatta, a lifetime earner of over \$600,000, Beach Cowgirl was sent to the gate as the 6-5 favorite and was handled aggressively by driver Tyler Miller, sprinting away from post 6 in the eight-horse field as Zanatta left underneath her from post 2. Miss Chantilly N (post 4), seeking her third win in four tries, went past Beach Cowgirl at the quarter, hitting that station in :27.4, before Beach Cowgirl

retook the top and hit the half in a tepid :57.2 and three-quarters in 1:24.3.

“We were the only three leaving in the race,” said Miller. “When we were able to turn John [Ahle, driving Miss Chantilly N] loose, and then retake, after the half, I knew they’d have to pace pretty hard to get by us. Nobody was pressing hard to the half, and that allowed us to rate the second fraction.”

Through the stretch, Miss Chantilly N emerged from the pocket to offer a challenge that never truly threatened the eventual winner while Zanatta took the inside route in her seasonal debut. Beach Cowgirl finished the mile in 1:52 after pacing her back half in :54.3, and was three-quarters-of-a-length in front of Miss Chantilly N at the finish. Zanatta was third.

“We went :27.1 in the third quarter, some of it due to the wind at our back, but after the half I wanted to get her in gear,” said Miller. “I wanted her to be able to finish strong.”

“I wasn’t very nervous at all through the stretch. I knew that [Miss Chantilly N] had been racing well, but my mare was going to be good off those fractions. She’s a very nice mare, all the credit to Mickey and everyone in the Burke barn. They’ve done a great job with her.”

A 4-year-old by Captaintreacherous—Stonebridge Sundae who is owned by Joseph DiScala, Jr., Zippett Racing Stable and Scarlet Stables LLC, Beach Cowgirl returned \$4.60 to her backers. She now has eight wins from 23 lifetime starts and earnings of just over \$400,000.

A LITTLE MORE: Braxten Boyd led the driver colony with three wins while Marcus Miller and Brett Beckwith each scored twice. Big M TV’s Jessica Otten had three cold exacts, one cold triple and one cold superfecta while giving out selections during the course of the night. Her broadcast partner, John Rallis, tabbed 20-1 shot Corsini A in the ninth race, who returned \$43.60 to win. All-source handle on the 14-race card totaled \$3,107,299, the 22nd time from 26 Big M programs this year when betting busted the \$3-million barrier.

Howard Taylor: Hambletonian Society and John Campbell rolled over

I feel obligated to respond to [Mr. Campbell's comments](#) in HRU [last] Sunday. He is focusing on one misquote in the HarnessLink article.

I do not believe that the Hambletonian Society is barring me from racing. Rather, that is at the sole discretion of [The Meadowlands' owner] Jeff Gural, however misguided. The HarnessLink article stated that in error.

The problem that I have with the Hambletonian Society is that they rolled over and bowed to Gural's wishes and allowed him to exclude me and others. They allowed a clause in their agreement that they defer to the rules of the USTA, state racing agency and the host track. They gain nothing from acquiescing to the host track.

The Hambletonian Society does have the power to convince Gural to back down. There is no obligation to race their races at The Meadowlands. They can take their races to any track. I'm sure that if they threatened to remove the Hambletonian, Gural would back down rather than suffer the embarrassment of losing their signature race. I'm equally confident that several tracks would welcome the most important race in our sport. Instead, the society, led by Mr. Campbell rolled over and deferred to Gural's wishes, without a fight.

There was no provision or notice when I purchased yearlings, or when I staked them to the Hambletonian Society sponsored races that my horses may be excluded at the whim of a track owner. I certainly would not have bought as many.

So that the record is straight, my beef with Mr. Campbell and the Hambletonian Society is that they did not have the backbone to do the right thing and stand up to Gural and protect their best customers.

Harness racing needs more competitive races more than open data

While I agree with [Dean Towers'] theory that [access to more past performance data](#) would possibly benefit harness racing and possibly help drive betting handle, my experience as a long-time harness and thoroughbred bettor would say what harness racing really needs is more competitive races.

I almost always bet less on harness racing due to too many races where there is an outstanding favorite in a race at really low odds that will usually win against other less qualified horses. I usually do not bet anything on those races or a few exacta or trifecta tickets with the favorite as my key horse on top. In thoroughbred races that situation happens less often. So I say challenge the racing office to try and get more competitive races if you really want to increase betting handle.
