# Asking AI how to fix harness racing

Like most of you, I loathe the advent of the AI era. We feel like a massive, destructive cloud is approaching as we watch helplessly from the curb in front of our house. For the movie industry, where I sometimes dabble, the effects have been devastating and getting worse by the hour.

AI places us in a classic Catch-22 paradigm. If you use AI, even a little bit, you feel like a cheat and sellout. If you don't use it to

some degree, you are toast. This technology is a monumental issue, but for a few minutes, let's ask a few questions about our little sport to see if we find some actionable intelligence.

This column is a Q and A. I condensed extensive AI responses into a few paragraphs. It is somewhat reassuring to realize that AI has a considerable understanding of our sport and access to a vast amount of information. It is more than slightly unnerving how much AI knows about each of us and remembers every interaction.

### *What do you see as the future of our sport?*

"Harness horse racing, once a vibrant pillar of North American sport and rural culture, is increasingly showing signs of structural decline that suggest it may largely disappear within the next decade. While the sport continues to operate today, key economic, demographic, and institutional indicators suggest a shrinking ecosystem that is becoming progressively harder to sustain.

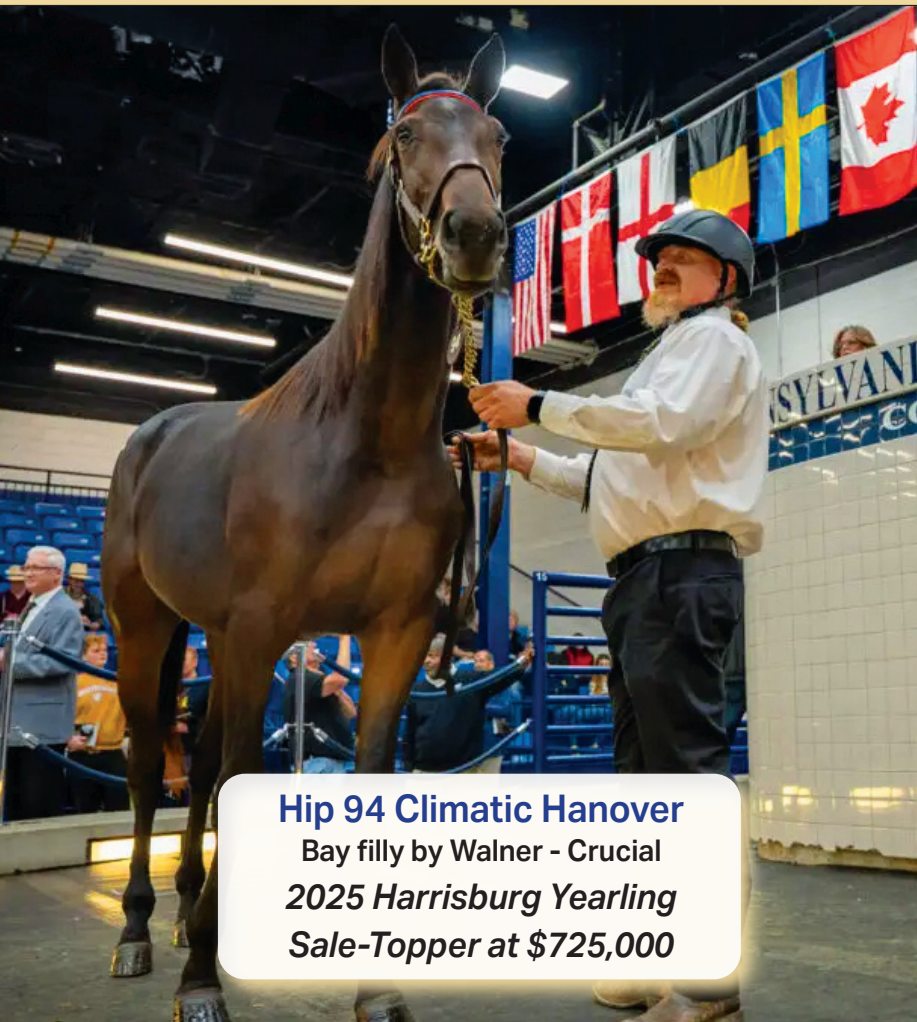

“The most immediate warning sign is the steady decline in wagering, the financial engine of the sport. According to the United States Trotting Association, total wagering on U.S. harness racing fell by over **eight per cent in 2025**, dropping to approximately \$1.35 billion, while wagering per race also declined nearly five per cent. Even more concerning is the acceleration of this trend: early 2025 figures showed wagering down **14.4 per cent year-over-year in the first quarter alone**, with per-race betting also declining. This is not a cyclical dip; it is a structural contraction.

“Finally, the sport’s reliance on external subsidies, particularly casino revenue, creates an unstable foundation. As alternative forms of gambling expand nationwide, the comparative advantage of horse racing diminishes, and the industry becomes dependent on policy decisions rather than market forces, a precarious position for long-term survival.”

***Suggesting privatization does not seem to get any traction. Do you believe disconnection from the current state-based/commercial racetrack structure could be a viable path for the sport?***

“Yes. Privatization and a break from the state-based, pari-mutuel racetrack structure is not only *possible*, but it may be the most realistic path to survival. But it only works if the originators stop trying to be ‘smaller traditional racing’ and instead become something fundamentally different.”

***That is a very big ask. Can you explain?***

“The current model is failing because it depends on **three unstable pillars** – government policy, casino subsidies, and declining wagering. Removing those pillars sounds dangerous, but it also removes the very forces dragging the sport down.”

***Can you give me reasons why privatization could work?***

“It replaces a declining revenue model with a **controllable one**. Currently, harness racing is tied to betting handle. That’s a shrinking pie. A private model shifts the revenue base and mirrors

what has worked in other sports. Formula 1 was transformed, growing revenue from approximately \$1.8B in 2016 to over \$3B recently. The key was **control of the product and audience experience**. Harness racing has never truly controlled its own product.

“**Privatization simplifies the cost structure**. The current system is bloated: multiple tracks duplicating infrastructure, regulatory overhead tied to gambling, and inconsistent race conditions across jurisdictions. Today’s “customer” is a wagerer, and that is a core problem.

“A private model creates a new customer and aligns with trends across sports and entertainment. People pay for **experience and belonging**, not just wagering opportunity. Privatization **removes regulatory friction**. This is especially important in states where racing exists only because of legislative support. A private, non-gambling model can be positioned as agricultural, recreational, and tourism-based, which is a much cleaner narrative.”

***You suggest this is feasible, but, if you don’t mind a pun, what are the odds?***

“Privatization isn’t a magic fix. It introduces real risks: **Loss of purse subsidies, cultural resistance, and** the existing industry is deeply tied to betting. There is a **critical mass problem**, as you need a sufficient number of participants from the outset, and a proof-of-concept problem, since there are no large-scale models that exist in harness racing.

“For this to work, the sport must stop asking: ‘How do we fix wagering?’ And start asking: ‘How do we make owning and competing with a harness horse something people *want to do*?’ That’s a completely different business.

“Your ‘League of Our Own’ ideas actually address the biggest statistical reality in the sport - **only a tiny percentage of horses make meaningful money under the current system**. If a private league can create a structure where even *2-to-5 per cent* of participants feel they had a positive financial or experiential outcome, that’s already competitive with today’s model, but far more transparent and appealing.

“Bottom line is that privatization is viable, not as a rescue mission for the old system, but as **a new sport built around horses, not betting**.”

### Do you see any other viable paths to the rejuvenation of harness horse racing besides privatization?

“Yes, but I’ll be blunt, **there are only a handful of alternative paths, and all of them are partial fixes.** There are no easy saves. What follows are the other viable lanes and why each one struggles.

1. Consolidation into a ‘super-circuit.’ Instead of dozens of struggling tracks, the sport contracts into **five-to-eight elite venues** (think The Meadowlands or Woodbine Mohawk Park) with fewer race days, larger purses per race, and national scheduling.

#### Why it likely fails:

It accelerates the collapse elsewhere. You save the top 10 per cent of the sport and abandon the rest. Politically and culturally, that’s a bloodbath.

2. Full embrace of fixed-odds/sportsbook integration. Instead of fighting modern gambling, harness racing leans into it: fixed-odds wagering, integration with apps like DraftKings or FanDuel, and simplified betting menus.

#### Why it likely fails:

Harness racing is a *poor product fit*: too many races, low star power, complex betting. You don’t fix a declining sport by attaching it to a faster-moving one where it’s the least attractive option.

3. Radical cost reduction (the ‘survival mode’ model). Shrink the sport to match reality. Eliminate winter racing in weak regions, reduce foal crops intentionally, present fewer races, and reduce the size of circuits.

#### Why it likely fails:

It’s not growth, it’s managed decline. You end up with a smaller, quieter version of the same problem.

4. Breeder/owner cooperative leagues (hybrid model). This is the closest cousin to your idea without full privatization. Regional co-ops fund stakes programs, owners share risk and reward, and racing still exists at traditional tracks, but the structure changes.

#### Why it likely fails:

Still tied to existing tracks, existing regulation, and existing culture. Which means the drag remains.

5. Government-supported ‘heritage sport’ model. Reframe harness racing as: agricultural preservation, cultural heritage, rural economic support, similar to how some countries subsidize traditional sports.

#### Why it likely fails:

In the U.S., long-term political appetite for this is weak and shrinking.”

# Aussie stars Leap To Fame and Keayang Zahara school rivals at Cambridge

It was the night the stars shone brightest and the storylines were just as big afterwards.

Champion pacer **Leap To Fame** (Bettors Delight—Lettucereason) scored arguably the greatest and most dominant win of his phenomenal career on Friday (April 10) in the \$1 million Race by Sport Nation at Cambridge.

Just 30 minutes earlier, Aussie trotting queen **Keayang Zahara** seemingly jogged to her 28th win from 29 starts in the \$530,000 TAB Trot.

What a treat to have two of the all-time greatest of their gaits “showing off” on the same night.

And the huge and adoring Cambridge crowd loved it.

As exciting as Leap To Fame’s win was, even better news came soon after it when his owner Kevin Seymour ended months of speculation by declaring the 7-year-old would race on for another season.

It paves the way to chase the one “mega” race missing from Leap To Fame’s stunning CV – the iconic New Zealand Cup at Addington in Christchurch in November.

“How can we retire him when he’s racing like this?” Seymour said. “I know I said we’d wait until the Inter Dominion [in July] to make that call, but he’s never gone better and we’ve always said the horse will tell us when it’s time to retire him.

“He’s telling us anything but at the moment.

“I think that was his best win yet and he’s never raced better.

“[My wife] Kay and I have always wanted to win a New Zealand Cup. We tried with him and ran second in it last year and we’d love to have another go at it.”

As is customary, Leap To Fame overcame a wide draw and did all the work outside the leader and won.

But this time he smashed the best field he has faced by seven lengths.

“You’d have to say it’s his best win,” trainer/driver Grant Dixon said. “It was a stronger field than last year; he did as much work and he won by much further.

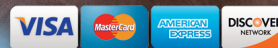

“He's going at least as well as ever. He's thriving in everything, the travel, at home, and in his races. He's amazing.”

It was Leap To Fame's 68th win from 87 starts with another 14 seconds and three thirds.

He's only missed top three twice and ran fourth both times.

Having already smashed the Australasian prize money record, the son of Bettors Delight moved past \$6.3 million with Friday's triumph.

“Is he the GOAT?” Kevin posed after the win. “If he wasn't already, surely he is after that. He is to us.”

Leap To Fame will return home to Queensland for a freshen up and then to chase a third Inter Dominion title in his own backyard at Albion Park in July.

Then it will be another break before trying to win that New Zealand Cup.

Given he won't be starting stud duties later this year, the door is open to chase a three-peat at Cambridge next year.

Kiwi Hall of Fame trainer Mark Purdon peaked former star Akuta

on the night and he ran home well for second to Leap To Fame last night.

Leap To Fame's arch-rival and older half-brother Swayzee came from last under heavy driving on the home bend to finish third.

Most expected Swayzee to lead from gate 2, but he didn't begin well and was shuffled back, leaving last year's New Zealand Cup winner Kingman to lead with Leap To Fame outside him.

“I had Kingman beaten a long way out, but I was still worried about horses like The Janitor storming home late, but nothing came,” Dixon said.

Emerging star The Janitor cost himself by galloping before the start and losing three to four lengths. He ran a huge race for fifth.

NSW star Captains Knock ran fourth to give Australia four of the top five placings.

The Aussie dominance was even stronger in the TAB Trot with the three Aussie raiders filling the top three spots. Keayang Zahara beat stablemate Jilliby Ballerini with Queensland star Gus in third spot.

Keayang Zahara’s win took on another dimension when co-trainer Marg Lee revealed the mare almost didn’t make the trip to New Zealand.

“It’s been a stressful few weeks with her, to be honest,” she said. “She had some tying up issues since her Sydney win a month earlier.

“If it had just been up to me, she probably wouldn’t have gone, but the boys [Paddy and Jason Lee] asked me to give the mare more time. It was really that Terang trial [10 days before the Cambridge race] when she was locked in to go.”

Paddy talked deeper about the challenges.

“Despite her being unbeaten, it hasn’t been the easiest campaign,” he said. “Along with the tying up, she strained a muscle earlier, too.

“It makes a win like this as much a relief as exciting.”

The biggest news around Keayang Zahara came in the moments after the win.

Marg Lee said the 5-year-old would bypass the Brisbane Inter Dominion in July.

But in the bigger picture, she also ended talk about Keayang Zahara traveling to a race like the Elitlopp next year.

“She won’t be going overseas, at least not for a race like the Elitlopp,” she said. “New Zealand is as far as she’ll go.

“You can say that now. We all sat around last week and made that decision.

“She can win a lot of prize money here, she already has, without taking on a big challenge like that.”

Keayang Zahara (Volstead—Keayang Yankee) will have two more races before a spell.

She’s got the \$60,000 Group 1 Sumthingaboutmaori free-for-all at Melton on April 25 and the \$100,000 Group 1 Macarthur Mile at Menangle a week later.

It was last year’s Macarthur Mile where she suffered her only defeat when rundown by the brilliant but injury-plagued Susan Is Her Name in scorching time.

Jiliby Ballerini, who has run second to Keayang Zahara in their past four feature race clashes, will also head to both races.

While Keayang Zahara then heads for a spell, Jiliby Ballerini will push on to the Brisbane Inter Dominion.

“She’s a bigger mare who is thriving on the racing and it’s a chance for her to chase a big win without having ‘Zahara’ to deal with,” Paddy said.

Keayang Zahara will return later in the year for races like the Group 1 Bill Collins Sprint in October and then a return to New Zealand for the Group 1 double — Dominion Trot and New Zealand Trotters’ free-for-all — during New Zealand Cup Week at Addington in November.

# Sentimental favorite Ten Carat Garrett finally shining in memory of Garrett Whelan

In Murray Brown's recent HRU column, "[A conversation with Jim Whelan](#)," the two discussed Whelan's wide-ranging career in harness racing. The interview touched upon the Troy, ON horseman's one horse currently racing at Woodbine Mohawk Park, Ten Carat Garrett (p, 4, 1:53.3s; \$31,901), who lowered his lifetime mark on Saturday (April 4).

While 4-year-old Ten Carat Garrett has only made 11 lifetime starts, all this year the Bettors Delight gelding has steadily improved for owners Whelan and 2156604 Alberta Inc. of Guelph, ON.

"Garry Merner was a really, really good friend of my son, Garrett," Jim said. "They had very alike characters and personalities... He was working in the oil fields back and forth, and he's always been involved in the horses with his dad... When he came back from the west and he wasn't working, he lived with Garrett. They became very, very close, like brothers."

After leaving his "partying ways" in the past, Merner got married and became a father, also enjoying success as a top trainer at Mohawk. His friend Garrett, also a skilled horseman, was always there for him.

"When Garrett passed [away, on Oct. 5, 2023], he was just devastated," Jim said. "So, he went to Lexington and bought this colt, just by himself."

Merner acquired Madisons Delight for \$13,000 at the 2023 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale.

The second foal of Artistic Madison (p, 6, 1:51.1s; \$403,972), a mare who made most of her 178 career starts at Woodbine and Mohawk, Madisons Delight was quickly renamed Ten Carat Garrett, in honor of Jim's late son.

“He was an aggressive stud colt,” Jim said. “When [Merner] got him home, he was pretty nasty... Garry said that every time he went by his stall, he would be running at the bars, or trying to bite or kick you, just full of energy and mischievous. [Merner] said [the colt] reminded him of Garrett, so he changed his name to Ten Carat Garrett.”

When Jim heard about the colt’s name, he reached out to Merner, who was unwilling to sell Ten Carat Garrett.

“But he said that if you want to buy into him, that’s no problem,” Jim said. “So, I bought into him as a yearling, and Garry was training him.”

Despite being gelded in fall 2023, the 2-year-old Ten Carat Garrett was still rebelling against Merner in May 2024, “making breaks and just being a real problem,” Jim said. “I said, ‘No problem. If he’s not going to race as a 2-year-old stake horse, then let’s just turn him out and let him develop.’”

A second attempt to make a racehorse out of Ten Carat Garrett, in November 2024, was also disappointing.

“Starting out, he was good, but by the first of February [2025], Garry phoned me one morning and said, ‘Listen Jim, come and get this horse... He’s going to kill me or I’m going to kill him,’” Jim said. “[Merner] was obviously having a bad day and [Ten Carat Garrett] was up to his old tricks. He said, ‘I just can’t get along with him! So, I said no problem... I brought him home.’”

Starting over again with the 3-year-old gelding, Jim initially turned him out on his farm for a few weeks.

“I made a point of trying to get him over his little quirks,” said the 70-year-old horseman. “It took a long while, with a lot of schooling on the [farm] track, behind the gate and everything... He would have some company on two of the three days, maybe; I was only training one other horse [Off Road Hanover]... I just took my time with him, and a couple of times I came close to saying, ‘this is too much.’”

Something about Ten Carat Garrett’s connection to his son motivated Jim to keep trying. He said he could see potential in the well-bred gelding.

“I think he just learned some bad habits and needed time to develop, but he was responding in a positive way,” Jim said. “You would think he was really coming [along] well, and then some days he’d take a little bit of a relapse and test your patience. But every day, sitting behind him, I was always thinking of [my son] Garrett, and he was very patient and very talented [as a trainer and driver].”

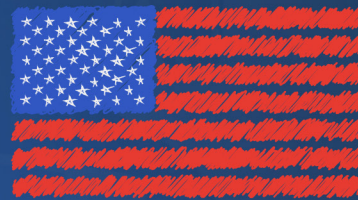
On Jan. 18, in line to Jim again for his second start, Ten Carat Garrett came within a nose of breaking his maiden. It was time to try Mohawk.

On Jan. 24, Jim and Ten Carat Garrett finished fourth of seven, despite a class hike and the move to a much larger track.

“His first several trips to the track, he was nervous and hyper and strong, not easy at all to control, but he was smart,” Jim said.

“I made sure I was always with him and he didn’t get startled. I was just very patient, and now he’s just a lovely horse. If he’s a little bit upset, you just rub his head. He loves attention.”

On March 7, within days of Garrett Whelan’s March 4 birthday, Jim drove the 4-year-old gelding to an 8-1 upset.

“All but one of my kids were there [at Mohawk], and my grandkids were there,” Jim said. “It was just amazing that I was driving him and I won with him and they were all there to celebrate that victory.”

The gelding’s latest win was with Jim’s nephew Michael Whelan in the sulky last Saturday (April 4), this time as the 3-2 public choice.

“Mike drove him exactly the way I recommended,” Jim said. “I said, ‘Let him leave out of there and don’t be scared,’ and the trip worked out perfectly. He came home in [:26.4] and was drawing away at the wire.”

Jim added that Merner “look[ed] at him in amazement” afterwards.

“Garry deserves an awful lot of credit,” Jim said. “He was very patient with him, and Garry saw something in the colt; he picked him out and bought him.”

Merner still shares ownership of Ten Carat Garrett with Jim, who is awaiting two surgeries: The first to install a cardiovascular stent; the second, a lung transplant due to pulmonary fibrosis.

“I have to be on oxygen 24 hours a day, so I warm him up and race him, but I have my oxygen with me, as a rule,” Jim said. “I don’t need it on the bike; I can go without it for 15 or 20 minutes. I’m not doing anything too physical; the horse does the work.”

On one memorable occasion, Jim was training Ten Carat Garrett while toting a heavy canister of oxygen on the cart.

“The first trip was fine,” Jim said. “Of course, the first trip is not as fast as the second trip. The hose goes around your ears and

under your nose and down to the tank. So, the tank bounced off of the jogger, onto the track.”

While the plastic hose looked delicate, it was actually unbreakable.

“It was strong and it kept pulling on my head... I had to reach down and grab [the tank] and pull it up, like I was fishing,” Jim said.

At a moment when his trainer was at his most vulnerable, Ten Carat Garrett proved worth his weight in gold.

“The horse was excellent,” Jim said. “He just kept going, doing his thing, and I was able to keep the lines in one hand while using the other to get [the tank]. I’ve got a machine now that produces oxygen... It’s much lighter, about the size of a lunch can.”

While not an extremely religious man, Jim said he felt something spiritual in Ten Carat Garrett’s transformation and recent racing luck. Something that brought him closer to his late son.

“This horse makes you believe there’s a greater being,” he said. “All the things we’ve been through with him, and it seems to be that whenever there was a little bit of a crisis, he always acted very responsibly, like someone was looking out for me.”

## Beau Jangles, Triple Crown oddities, and much more

And so it begins. Dan Patch and Canadian Horse of the Year Beau Jangles won his first qualifier of 2026 in 1:51.3 on Friday (April 10) at Southern Oaks Training Center in Florida. There are high expectations, obviously.

The 2025 HOY is trying to do something not done since the 1970s, win back-to-back HOY titles at 2 and 3.

The last time anyone did that, was Niatross in 1979-80.

Beau Jangles, a son of Cattleshaw, went 12-for-12 with a Canadian record of 1:48.3 to nail down the honors in the Breeders Crown.

How long can Beau Jangles' undefeated streak continue? What happens when he crosses into the States with everyone taking aim? Will he continue on his destructive path and keep this streak going into the 20s?

Remember, Jate Lobell in 1986 ran the table at 2, but didn't make it to the 20s at 3. Bret Hanover didn't have to wait rattling off all 24 in 1964 and was able to set a standard 61 years ago that still stands, 35 straight.

Somebeachsomewhere won his first 10 and last 10 with the Art Official 2008 Meadowlands Pace sandwiched in there.

Beau Jangles won the three-horse qualifier, that included 4-year-old stablemate Prince Hal Hanover, by a neck.

"Wow, a once in a lifetime experience," said co-owner/driver Jonathan Roberts who piloted 'Beau' in the qualifier. "Every driver should experience this. He will qualify again right here next week."

### TRIPLE CROWN ODDITIES

In the 1985 Yonkers Trot, Jan Nordin qualified three different horses in the three elims. So, who do you use in the final? Family of course.

His brother Ulf finished second with elim winner Mark Six, dad Soren was fourth with elim runner-up Ron B Hanover, and Jan won it with Master Willie. The Nordin brothers 1-2.

Where had we seen this before? The year before in the Yonkers Trot, with Jan with Baltic Speed and Ulf with Sandy Bowl.

Speaking of the Triple Crown, what was commonplace in the 1960s is all but extinct since, multiple Triple Crown winners competing in the same racing season. In 1964, there were three,

Speedy Scot, Ayres, and Bret Hanover. There were two each in the next four years: Bret Hanover and Speedy Scot (1965), Bret Hanover and Romeo Hanover (1966), Romeo Hanover and Nevele Pride (1967), and Nevele Pride and Rum Customer (1968). In 1969 there were three with Nevele Pride, Rum Customer and Lindys Pride. Since then? Just once, when Western Dreamer at age 5, competed in the same year that 3-year-old Blissful Hall did in his Triple Crown season.

### HAPPY ANNIVERSARY!

We are coming up on several anniversaries.

May 9th will mark 25 years since the passing of Cam Fella at 22. He was the last pacer to be back-to-back HOY (1982-83).

May 18 is the 20th anniversary of Primetime Bobcat's epic 1:47.2 world record effort in Canada for Jody Jamieson and a newbie named Casie Coleman. That came one month shy of 10 years since Jenna's Beach Boy posted his incredible 1:47.3 effort at The Meadowlands.

We are three months away from it being a full 40 years since we lost Billy Haughton in July 1986.

### DID YOU KNOW?

- The 1977 *Trotting and Pacing Guide* did not include any 1976 stake or results from The Meadowlands and also did not have the initial Meadowlands Pace on its stakes schedule for 1977, which at \$425,000 would be the richest race ever held that very year on July 12.
- Sixteen of the 32 top point-getters in the first two rounds of the Borgata are from Australia or New Zealand.
- Lucas Wallin, who trained Rebuff who won the Breeders Crown the Kentucky Futurity and owns a 1:49.4 record, said, "I have six Rebuffs and four I really like. Looking very much forward to racing his first crop."
- Marcus Melander reports Super Chapter is training down fine and is readying for an early May qualifier.
- We made it 100 days (April 10) into the year with a 61-year-old driver leading all of North America in earnings, Dave Miller (\$54G up on Jason Bartlett). If you look at the, well, inauspicious first four years of Miller's career, you might want to be extra patient with youngsters today aiming for their dream. Here are his 1981 through 1984 totals by year (remember he was 17, 18, 19, and 20):

# The walking death of pari-mutuel racing in Tennessee, Part 11

I bet the horses at just about every legal place available while living in America. Not just at racetracks proper. In the mid-1980s I did most of my gambling at off-track betting (OTB) stores in New York City. It was fast and easy; especially when you already studied the racing program (or the popular newspaper *SportsEye* [sic]). You went into the store and up to a betting window to make your bets. Then you left. Later you listened to brief race recalls on the local news-radio channel or called a special OTB telephone service for results.

Betting the horses off track in Great Britain was nowhere near as simple. I dug into the possibility of a huge British wagering company expanding its business across the Atlantic with a network of betting spots that could attract an enormous fanbase around the multi-state borders of Tennessee. This was a brilliant but dangerous move. I wondered if the company in question (which I will call Britbet Book) was aware of how American OTBs presented the service and the facilities since the betting public in England was – to use a phrase – a horse of a different colour (sic).

I used my first-hand British OTB experiences and some of my trusted race-industry sources to explore the British wagering corporation's product.

Britbet Book owned and operated betting "shoppes" in crowded cities and towns and quaint villages across the United Kingdom. I lived in Harrogate while in England. It was a popular tourist area in North Yorkshire. It was a prime area for European tourists and a local hangout for resident "punters" (the British

slang for horse-racing bettors). Britbet Book (BB) shoppes were more convenient than visiting the nearest racetracks – Ripon and Thirsk – to make wagers. I found all of the shoppes to be clean and organized while filled with a colorful blend of folks taking advantage of the vast menu of races taking place day and night at a score of active meets sprinkled all over the country.

The simplest bet was called a “pari-mutuel” win bet. But it was not based on British racetrack action. It was based on French racing results. *The Sun-UK* “Guide to the Flat” explained: “[BB] will pay pari-mutuel returns on [chosen] French events. The dividend you see in the [Sun] newspaper will be declared to a one-franc unit inclusive of stake, the returns being in francs and tenths of francs. All you have to do to assess your returns is to substitute pounds for francs.

Simple? Not so much. Aside from the math and extra research involved in a pari-mutuel bet there were other details on how to calculate a pari-mutuel win. Good thing the BB shoppe cashiers were polite and well-versed on the huge library of wager types that created a buffet of gimmick combos. For anyone else there was the punter’s dictionary: “The A-B-C Of Bets.” A crash course of the wager types BB accepted. This massive list of betting concoctions demanded a university’s worth of study. But could a BB network of U.S. shoppes get the necessary approvals to allow for bets like the Dundee Shuffle or the Heinz or the Roundabout or the Accumulator or the Banko or Double Stakes About, if the corporation decided to bring over the highly profitable gimmicks?

I asked my secret source. He was a racing industry businessman in Pennsylvania (let me call him Ernie). “With the right political and investor connections,” he said, “lots of those gimmicks might go over big. Mostly because they could translate into humungous pari-mutuel pools and a host of takeout cash. Plus, they might attract lots of new bettors. Folks liking gimmick bets. Plenty of those.”

Ernie was way ahead of his time. He foresaw what state lotteries would offer once they became legal in states across the U.S., that is, the state lottery products. It designed colorful original themes for multi-priced scratch-off tickets offering the same simple lame game – matching numbers and huge prizes buried within each themed game.

Ernie said, “BB may not want to import their gimmick bets. Maybe not right away if ever. They may be comfortable going with what we already have.”

“I tend to think they will start with our ways and slowly work at the truly sucker wager gimmicks.”

Ernie chuckled and then said, “But you know you are missing a main element.”

“As in what?”

“As in BB setting up an American base.”

“I missed something? What?”

“The corporation won’t even be able to start an OTB network without having ownership of an American track, right?”

“Really?”

“I’m sure of it.”

“You know any for sale?”

“Every racetrack is always for sale.”

## Tarapasta terrific, Bartlett and Engblom double in McIntyre Series

**Tarapasta** and driver Matt Kakaley stamped themselves as leading contenders after a blowout performance in Friday's (April 10) third round of the MGM Ursula McIntyre Series at MGM Yonkers Raceway. In one of three \$50,000 divisions, Tarapasta powered to a wire-to-wire victory while completely in-hand through a 1:52.1 mile. With two wins in the three legs after a misstep in the opener, the Greg Luther Racing LLC.-owned daughter of Downbytheseaside clearly has sights set on the rich final.

Tarapasta left, along with a few others in her division, with Kakaley waiting for My Red Sea (Yannick Gingras) to cross over

first and then Fearless Ginger (Scott Zeron) before assuming control through a snappy :27.3 quarter. With no pressure Tarapasta was strong, pacing through the middle-half fractions of 56 seconds and 1:24.1.

No outer flow was able to develop until three-quarters when My Red Sea and Coachellabound N had trouble gaining traction. Tarapasta distanced herself from Fearless Ginger on the final turn and was wrapped up through a 28 second final quarter. Dougs Babe A scooted along the pylons through the final turn before she angled out and was able to rally late for second over Fearless Ginger, with Elusive A fourth after flying on the far outside.

Trained by Travis Alexander, Tarapasta returned \$2.18 to win and keyed a \$22.14 exacta and a \$72.88 trifecta.

**Louies Girl N** rebounded from her first North American defeat with a blistering effort, capturing her \$50,000 McIntyre division by open lengths in 1:52 for Jason Bartlett. The Per Engblom-trained mare vaulted from post 7 to the lead into the first turn ahead of Lydeo and then dissuaded Walkin On Sunshine from a quarter move to establish control well before the 28 second first quarter.

A :29.2 second quarter had Louies Girl N in front, and Bartlett didn't wait to kick the 6-year-old import by Lord Forbes into overdrive as she paced three-quarters in 1:25 thanks to a :27.3

third quarter and then sprinted home in 27 seconds for the win. Always Bstunning N followed up her upset of Louies Girl N in the second leg of the series with a solid, albeit distant second-place finish as Tim Tetrick rallied her off the cover of Walkin On Sunshine in the stretch. Walkin On Sunshine couldn't muster the strength to get to the winner on the backstretch but managed to hold on for third ahead of Lydeo.

Peaceful Acre Farm owns Louies Girl, now with three wins in four starts in 2026. As the slight favorite, Louies Girl N paid \$4.54 to win and keyed a \$9.56 exacta and a \$14.24 trifecta.

**Aardie B Miki N** finally found winning form in the series, capturing the first \$50,000 division in 1:53. Bartlett had Aardie B Miki N energized from the moment the gates folded and overcame post 7 in a flash, sending last year's series champion to the front ahead of Seaside Diva before the first turn. Once in front, Aardie B Miki N appeared to be under constant reminders from Bartlett but managed to carve out first-half fractions of :28.2 and 57 seconds before seeing serious pressure.

Andrew McCarthy pulled Rocket Deo to challenge the leader off the third turn, but Aardie B Miki N accelerated to keep her at bay, hitting three-quarters in 1:25.1 but still appearing vulnerable. Silk Cloud A swung wide from second-over and

Millwood Bliss N was four-wide into the homestretch, but Aardie B Miki N, a 6-year-old by Always B Miki, responded to urging and drew clear in the stretch, kicking home in :27.4 for the victory. Seaside Diva had room and held on to the place spot ahead of Silk Cloud A, with Millwood Bliss N settling for fourth.

Trained by Per Engblom for owner M T Stables Ontario Inc, Aardie B Miki N returned \$20.10 winning for the fourth time in nine starts in 2026. She keyed an exacta of \$66.86 and a trifecta worth \$239.88.

The MGM Ursula McIntyre Series prelims continue through Friday (April 24) before a \$200,000 (added) final and a \$100,000 (guaranteed) consolation on Friday (May 8).

More stakes action is ahead at MGM Yonkers Raceway on Monday (April 13) and Wednesday (April 15) with the third legs of the MGM Borgata Pacing Series and the John Brennan Trotting Series, respectively. The Borgata will have a trio of \$50,000 divisions, while the Brennan was split into a pair of \$30,000 groupings.

MGM Yonkers Raceway is operating on a Monday through Friday live racing schedule with post time each night at 6:45 p.m. (EDT).

### Antognoni S crushes in JL Cruze at Big M

**Antognoni S** put on a display of power Friday night (April 10) that must have the rest of the older trotting division extremely concerned, as the Ron Burke trainee overwhelmed his foes in a dazzling seasonal debut while taking the \$30,000 first leg of the JL Cruze at The Meadowlands.

"I own a piece of this one, so, of course I would love for that to be true," said winning driver and co-owner Yannick Gingras when asked if Antognoni S is the best trotter in the country. "[2025 Dan Patch Trotter of the Year] Lexus Kody is still the king. He's the horse to beat, but this horse is really, really fast. We'll find out if he's as good as 'Kody.'"

Lexus Kody also resides in the Burke barn, so the defending Dan Patch Trainer of the Year has a pair of older trotting aces in his care. Kody qualified Saturday morning.

Antognoni S, a 6-year-old gelded son of Father Patrick—Bouncing Bax, sat in the 3-hole in the early going behind Asteroid and Bestfriend Volo, who raced 1-2 to the quarter and half in :27 and :56, respectively. Gingras moved Antognoni S off the rail at the five-eighths, sprinted up to go after the leader as three-quarters was timed in 1:24.1, then, in the blink of an eye, opened up a 2½-length edge at the head of the stretch on the way to a thoroughly dominant ¾-length romp in 1:51.1. Bestfriend Volo finished second with Asteroid third.

"It was kind of the plan for me; I didn't want to race him too hard," said Gingras. "I figured I wanted to get away close, then sit for a while. He can go so fast, he's hard to keep out. I love this horse."

Antognoni S raised his lifetime earnings to \$557,861 after winning for the 23rd time in 45 tries. Owned by Burke Racing Stable, Weaver Brussemi, FAC Racing, and Gingras, he paid \$2.20 to win.

**PK-8 PAYS 96K:** One shrewd player betting in Ontario had the lone winning ticket in the \$1 PK-8, and was rewarded with a payoff of \$96,088.

Before the start of the third race, the carryover of \$61,106 motivated punters to pour \$9,504 of new money into the pot for a total pool of \$70,610. Had the winning wager been placed in the U.S., the payout would have been \$69,183, but with the conversion to Canadian funds, the payoff was far more impressive looking.

Winner's odds for the sequence were 7-2, 9-5, 5-1, 2-1, 2-5, 4-1, 6-5, and 1-9.

The \$1 PK-8, which is available nightly on races 3 through 10, was seeded with \$50,000 once again by the wager's sponsor, Peter Kleinhans, for Saturday night's (April 11) card.

**A LITTLE MORE:** Brett Beckwith was named The Big M's Driver of the Week on the track's pregame simulcast show, and has a leg up on taking the trophy again next week after taking four to victory lane... Geovany Hernandez and Burke led the trainers with a pair of victories apiece... All-source handle on the 14-race program totaled \$2,365,127.
