Andy Miller Likely to Be Out Six Months

Injured in a spill Tuesday night at Yonkers driver Andy Miller underwent successful surgery Wednesday at Columbia Presbyterian Hospital to repair broken vertebrae in his back. He continues to have feeling in all his extremities, but Miller still faces a long recovery. Speaking yesterday to Harness Racing Update, Miller's wife, Julie, said the estimate is that her husband will be out of action for about six months.

"How long will he be out? That's the \$1 million question," Julie Miller said. "The doctors are hesitant to say, but they did say that it usually takes a good three months for the bones to heal and another three months for the ligaments to heal.

So we're looking at six months, but time will tell.

"The doctors are really optimistic. They said it really helps that he was healthy and fit before he came in here. He is a good candidate for a full recovery. It's just going to take time."

Miller was driving a horse named Marmara Denizi for his brother, trainer Erv Miller. The spill began when In The Clear, driven by George Brennan appeared to step on the wheel of another horse and fell. Racing near the back of the pack, Miller fell as part of a chain reaction.

Brennan was not hurt.

Miller was originally taken to Lawrence Hospital in Bronxville, New York before being transferred to Columbia Presbyterian in Manhattan. The surgery involved placing rods and screws in his back to stabilize the injured area.

"They expect he'll be walking around by (Friday) and if things continue to go well he should be out of the hospital on Monday or Tuesday," Julie Miller said.

The accident came at a particularly inopportune time for Miller as stakes season is right around the corner and it appears he's going to miss virtually all of the big money races.

"He's disappointed, especially with the 2-year-old races coming up," Miller said. "But we could be talking about something far worse. He could have been paralyzed. He's got mobility and he's strong and, in my opinion, he's a pretty tough guy. So he's going to come out of this OK. It could have been a lot worse. I've got to thank Mr. (Jeff) Gural and

Jason Settlemoir who were very helpful. They referred us to the very best doctors and made sure we got to see them. Andy has also been really happy with the outpouring of thoughts and prayers we've received from people in the horse racing community and is very appreciative of that."

With Julie doing the training and Andy the driving the Millers have been a winning combination for years. The stable's star thus far this year has been Perfect Alliance, who is 8 for 8 on the season and headed for the finals of the Weiss Series Wednesday at Pocono. Miller said she hasn't given much thought yet as to who will take over the driving role in Andy's absence. In Saturday's \$55,800 Artistic Vision Final at the Meadowlands Mike Wilder will drive the Miller-trained Panera Hanover. Yannick Gingras drove Perfect Alliance and Take The Money for Julie Miller last week at Pocono.

"Finding another driver, that's not something I've ever had to worry about," Miller said. "The top 10 guys are in the top 10 for a reason and I am hopeful a lot of those guys will want to drive our horses because we have some pretty good horses."

Miller is currently tied for third with Corey Callahan in the Meadowlands driver's standing 54 wins.

Burke: My Levy Horses Are Not For Sale

Ron Burke's domination of the Levy series at Yonkers has led to a nice problem to have: he has too many horses eligible for the finals.

Entering Saturday's card at Yonkers, which will feature the last preliminary Levy rounds before the April 26 final, Burke trains five of the top eight in the standing, led by points leader Foiled Again. The 10-year-old pacing great has won in all four prior legs.

The problem for Burke is that no trainer can start more than two horses. If the series were to end today, Foiled Again and Bettor's Edge would represent the Burke stable. Last year Burke solved that issue

by selling Something For Doc to a group headed by trainer Mark Ford. But he said this time around he's not interested in selling any of the horses who have been competing in the Levy series.

"We're not looking to sell any of them," Burke said. It would take some sort of unbelievable offer. We're comfortable with all these horses. We have a good group of older horses and want to keep them around all year."

Burke said some have called him looking to buy one of his Levy starters but people have been told they're not looking to sell any of them.

Burke said his main regret is that it doesn't look like Clear Vision will make the final. He's currently in fifth place.

"If it had ended up being Foiled Again and Clear vision I would have been happiest," he said. "But Foiled is going to carry the torch. Clear Vision is like Foiled, he can win from anywhere. Where the other two (Bettor's Edge and Itrustyou) need their trip, need their way on this track. On a mile track they are different horses."

The two-horse per trainer rule only affects Burke, but he said that knowing the rules going in he can't be too upset with how things have worked out.

"I wouldn't say it's unfair," he said. "When they started this series they couldn't have foreseen what was going to happen down the road with our stable so it's not like this rule was made for me. I know they were trying to help the betting game. But what they ought to do is separate the horse in the betting. Of course I'd be the biggest beneficiary of that. But I also think it would be better for the track because if you can split my horses up it makes for better betting races."

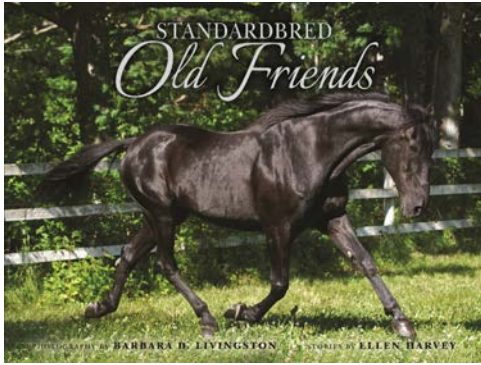

Standardbred Old Friends, Profiling Senior Champions, To Publish in June

Award winning equine photographer Barbara Livingston, whose popular books *Old Friends* and *More Old Friends*, painted a sentimental portrait of champion racehorses long gone from the spotlight, has completed a third edition of that series.



While her first two books focused on Thoroughbred racehorses, the latest, *Standardbred Old Friends*, focuses on the distinctly American breed that evolved from a horse that carried the family to church, raced at the county fair and now

competes world-wide at a trot and pace. The book, at \$30, is ready for pre-order now at www.harnessmuseum.com.

Standardbred Old Friends portrays 43 horses, from age 19 to 37, most of them multimillionaire world record holders with Hall of Fame membership, but some of more modest distinction, occupied as show horses, in law enforcement or hardworking, blue collar performers. With writer Ellen Harvey telling the rich tales of horses from Sweden to southern California, from Maine to Florida, Livingston has captured images of horses whose achievements are now decades past, but whose memories will last a lifetime.

The collaboration, ready for shipment in June, grew from a 2008 Hoof Beats magazine article featuring ten champion Standardbreds over the age of 20. The article, with Livingston's photos and Harvey's stories, won top honors for journalism at the 2009 World Trotting Conference in Norway.

In 2012, the two started a trek of nearly 10,000 miles to capture the lives of nearly four dozen horses whose commercial worth is long gone, but who are cherished ever still. The book's 153 photos and 43 stories were gleaned from thousands of photos and 150 interviews.

Standardbred Old Friends looks at the lives of 43 horses like North American and European superstar Mack Lobell, now 30, at his home along the shores of Lake Malaren in southern Sweden, 2004 horse of the Year Cam's Card Shark at historic Hanover Shoe Farm in central Pennsylvania and mother-daughter Hall of Famers Country Kay Sue and CR Kay Suzie among the live oaks at their home in central Florida.

The senior "old friend," 37-year-old Waco Hanover, was depicted against the deep snow of his home in the foothills of Vermont's Green Mountains. An autumn sunset in the tide pools of Maine's Popham Beach State Park was the setting for Dreamy Starlet and McKeever Hanover, a pair with 297 races over 13 years, with 4 foals between them, now in their 20s, but active in the show ring and hunt field.

Race 7, B-2/B-1 Trot

UNDERCOVER STRIKE makes his second start back for a trotting barn that we'll be hearing much from in the coming weeks and drops out of last week's edition of the Open trot. This one actually beat Quick Deal in a qualifier two back although that one went onto have a suspect race at Philly earlier in the week; tough to leave out from the pole. BLUTO and HIGH BRIDGE were some of best 3-year-old trotters last year for Takter; the former now goes first start for Remmen. HIGH BRIDGE nearly beat standout Maven in that recent qualifier; Takter will drive in his first start back. NF HAPPENSTANCE has now jogged here in two straight for Jack Parker and gets even further tested now. REAL BABE had been beaten last week by Here Comes Numbers but inherited the win as that one skipped at the wire; needs to overcome the outside. SPLITSVILLE had been sharp prior to the recent scratch.

Race 8, F&M C-2/C-1 Pace

MISS MACHQUEEN has found this level a bit too steep in recent starts but she really isn't catching the toughest group for the condition in this spot. Stepping up off an easy win, this one set blazing fractions here four back and rallied willingly three back; closes again. UF DRAGON'S QUEEN was shuffled last week but still wasn't great following that drop out of the Matchmaker. I'm surprised that Dave Miller opted off here too, as he goes instead to PARDON as his choice of three. The Toscano trainee was first over when last seen here but has generally disappointed throughout the meet. BAD GIRL VEGAS hasn't panned out yet for Doug Lewis but continues to drop

This one flashed speed upon his return and then had to alter course a bit as there were some up front breakers; should offer another square price. NONVERBAL HANOVER is likely to be raced from the back while making his first start back since last year but those were some top level trotters this one qualified right behind. MCKENZIE'S STAR sat the trip last week but couldn't go late with a sharp repeat winner. ZUPPA INGLESE took all the money last week and put it all together in a sharp try for Burke; a repeat of that would give him another big chance. HELIOS proves to be unreliable and now gets a new driver as Andy's out.

TREVOR'S BEBE is an interesting type going from the Artistic Vision to the bottom. I know she didn't do anything the last time she was at this level three back but those last two races including the most recent against American In Paris really wasn't bad at all. Picks up Morrill now too! DELICIOUSLYNAUGHTY faced some comparably decent

mares four and five back here and now plummets for Ford; logical short priced contender. ALITTLEEASTERMAGIC is an obvious weekend hunch play as Miller's choice. SHAWNEE DANCER was bet off the board last week when she shouldn't have been; can beat me if she can in current seasonal form. NUTMEGS CIDER shocked two back but then didn't have the same punch last out; another that will likely offer a shorter price than she should.
