# Stars at The Meadowlands' qualifiers provide an early glimpse of what's to come

Excitement is building as the stakes horses begin to return to the track.

Qualifiers from Friday morning (May 2) at The Meadowlands marked the on-track return of multiple champions from last season — and likely — what will include eventual champions this year. Providing the earliest glimpses into what will be a long stakes season between now and November, there were plenty of notable performances from races on the sunny 70-degree morning.

There were two races that went one-fifth-of-a-second faster, but the most visually impressive, and maybe the one that had the highest probability of setting the tone for the season, was the race won by Captain Optimistic. Closing out his 2-year-old season with a win in the Governor's Cup in 1:49.3, Captain Optimistic won multiple times last year in under 1:50, among other stakes wins, was a Breeders Crown elimination winner and beaten favorite in the Breeders Crown final.

In his first return to the track since that Governor's Cup in November, Captain Optimistic sat last, in fifth, throughout much of the mile, came off the pylons at around five-eighths-of-amile, was impeded somewhat by flat cover forcing him to move even wider into the stretch and closed powerfully under some encouraging from Dexter Dunn to track down the leader with a final quarter in :25.4 and win in a final time of 1:51.4. In that sequence, Captain Optimistic tracked down last year's Metro Pace winner and co-third fastest 2-year-old of 2024, making his second qualifying start back, Fallout, out closing that rival by over a full second. In fact, the final quarter by Captain Optimistic was at least one second faster than how anyone closed in the qualifier which also included last year's Kindergarten winner Papi's Pistol (1:49.3), who was third.

Staying with the newly turned sophomore pacers — this one on the filly side — Dan Patch champion Miki And Minnie won in a near identical manner as did Captain Optimistic, both driven by Dunn. Friday marked the third qualifier in as many weeks for Miki And Minnie and if that most recent one from Friday is any indication of what's to come, Miki And Minnie is set to begin the year right where she left off last season, where she stormed through major late season stakes including the Breeders Crown and Three Diamonds to earn divisional honors.





There were two races that went one-fifth-of-a-second faster, but the most visually impressive, and maybe the one that had the highest probability of setting the tone for the season, was the race won by Captain Optimistic.

In the qualifier, Miki And Minnie got away sixth and stayed there for nearly the first three-quarters-of-a-mile through mild fractions. She was charted nine lengths back with a quarter-of-a-mile to go which included a gapped-out filly in front of her, came off the pylons right at that mile marker where she was gradually eased into contention. From there, she continued to pick up steam through the stretch and was gaining all the time, eventually besting the race pace setter by a head after outsprinting that one in the final quarter-of-a-mile by almost

two full seconds. That qualifier also included Rose, one of the higher regarded 2-year-old fillies earlier in the season last year, who had a useful mile in her first qualifier back, closing in :26.1 and passing a bunch in the stretch.

A division with a ton of potential intrigue is that of the older/open trotters. In two different qualifiers featuring horses from that division, one of those was won by last year's Maple Leaf Trot champ, and maybe even the horse that the division will go through this year, Periculum. Having finished last year dueling with the likes of divisional champion Winners Bet and then finishing the year being second to Logan Park in the FanDuel, Periculum coasted as a strong wire-to-wire winner in his return qualifier, with a confident looking Scott Zeron in tow. In a close battle for second was Up Your Deo over Oh Well and for all the success those two horses have enjoyed in their 2- and 3-year-old seasons, were somehow just a combined one-for-23 last year.

Another notable from that qualifier won by Periculum was the presence of Amazing Catch. This was the first start for Amazing Catch since that seemingly incomprehensible \$1.85 million price tag from the Harrisburg sale last November. He was a non-threatening fifth in the race and so begins what I believe will be a much tougher campaign than perhaps first thought at the time last year's Canadian Trotting Classic winner was purchased.

In addition to foes from this race, the other older trotting qualifier was won by Ari Ferrari J but also showed the horse Get A Wish DK. If you recall, Get A Wish DK was Denmark's entrant

into last year's Yonkers International Trot. Highly accomplished in his native land going back a couple of years, he's been training since remaining Stateside with Svanstedt and could turn out to be a force here this year – his first qualifier from Friday was good! Between the wild card factor of Get A Wish

DK and the initially unforeseen, but what will be a welcomed return nonetheless of Karl as a 4-year-old, this division could go in any direction.

From the second-to-last qualifier Friday, last year's Horse of the Year Twin B Joe Fresh made her second qualifying start back, while My Girl EJ made her first. These two had the race to themselves and the qualifier produced the same result as did their final race from last year in the FanDuel. A big money purchase to close out last year, My Girl EJ gave it a game try as a 3-year-old against the older Twin B Joe Fresh in the FanDuel, and looked up for the challenge as she returned in her qualifier. Driven by Todd McCarthy, My Girl EJ tracked the helmet of Dunn and Twin B Joe Fresh all the way around the track to finish second, miles clear of everyone else. Will My Girl EJ, or any other pacing mares, be able to step up and challenge the reigning Horse of the Year?

As these horses go from the first of their qualifiers and progress through the major stakes races there will undoubtedly be many twists and turns, but already the stage is being set for what promises to be another exciting half-year of racing.



# Rick Zeron has slowed down slightly, but loves his horses even more

There has been 8,177 wins and \$103,555,691 in earnings by the horses driven by Rick Zeron since he first made his presence known in the winner's circle of the Ottawa Valley racetrack of Connaught Park.

Actually, the real numbers are somewhat greater, since the USTA only started keeping those records in 1977. The trainer statistics are far more incomplete, having only been kept since 1991. From that point onward, he is credited with having trained the winners of \$28,717,770.

Today at 68, Zeron looks upon himself as being a trainer who occasionally drives a few horses almost entirely from his own stable.

Whereas in the past, he would often be down to drive a half dozen, or even more horses in a given evening, today, it would be somewhat rare for him to drive near that many in a given week.

Would that indicate that Rick "The Whip" has slowed down?

"Perhaps a little, certainly a lot where it relates to driving, but not a great deal where it pertains to training," he said. "I still have a full draft of 18 head under my care here at Classy Lane Training Centre in Puslinch, a short distance from my home track of Mohawk Raceway. I'm still at the stable seven mornings a week. As much as I've loved racing all of my life, I love these horses that I have been privileged to have had put in my care, even more."

Let's start with the name. How did you come to be called "The Whip?" You were never what I considered to be what is called a whip man. If anything, from my viewpoint, I would be inclined to label you a driver who, more often than not, relied on the pace of the race and the quality of the opposition to determine how you would drive your horse.

"It began when I was driving at Blue Bonnets in Montreal. Occasionally, after winning a race, I'd be asked for my whip while in the winner's circle.

"I was usually glad to comply. I suppose that with the passage of time it became somewhat of a trademark. At Blue Bonnets, I was among the few anglophone drivers. I wanted something that would make me stand out. Throwing those whips was that something. I'd estimate, through the years, I've probably given away somewhere in the area of 5,000 whips. I moved to Ontario in 1995. I decided I needed something to help me stand out there and hopefully bring attention to myself. That is where and when I started doing the **Zorro schtick** [by making a 'Z' in the air with my whip in the winner's circle].

"It was designed to bring attention to myself and maybe get me more drives. There's no doubt that it brought me some notoriety, but looking back, I'm inclined to think that in this game, the only thing that is going to get a driver more drives is success. The more races you win, the more drives you are going to pick up."

# What do you think about being the last of a dying breed, a trainer/driver?

"There are indeed fewer and fewer of us. I suppose it's because driving is almost entirely a young man's game. In the same way that the breed has improved and progressed, the same has happened with drivers... In years previous, our horses had all sorts of faults, both physical and in the way they stood and traveled. Nowhere is this more evident than at a horse sale. It used to be that you could eliminate a whole bunch of horses,



maybe even the majority of them, due to physical faults. We rarely see the big, coarse yearling nowadays. The breed has become more refined, more athletic and more stable. I don't remember the last time I saw a curb on a yearling. The same applies to most conformation faults. Our breeders have done a great job in raising their horses.


"In somewhat the same manner, drivers have improved. Gone are the days when you had the big, unathletic lummox sitting behind a horse. That type just cannot compete with today's drivers. The great drivers of today are all great athletes. They are disciplined. They stay in the best of shape both physically and mentally. They work out. They watch what they eat. The majority of them not only know the horses which they are scheduled to drive, but they also know the ones that they will be racing against and those that will be guiding them. There has never been a time when there has been so much talent available."

# Speaking of youth and today's top drivers, isn't there one that you are pretty close to?

"I think that without prejudice, my son Scott is among the half dozen or so best drivers in the world today. With some prejudice, I consider him to be the very best one. It began when Scotty was about 12 years old and he told me that he wanted to become a driver, a great one.

"I told him I would do everything in my power to help him achieve his goal. His mother, my wife, Joyce, had another idea. She told Scott that he had to get a good education first. Then he could become a driver. Between Joyce and myself, we managed to help Scott achieve both goals.

"Scott continued his education and graduated as an accountant, then he worked at becoming a great driver. I am a firm believer that great drivers are born, not made. They have to possess that certain gene in their DNA that enables them to achieve greatness. If they possess that gene, they can hone on that talent and sometime reach their goal.

"In addition to his possessing that gene, Scotty possessed other assets. He is an exceptional horseman and loves horses. He drives with a degree of patience that I do not see with any other driver. It is this patience that has enabled him to win some of his greatest races. He is a great student. He knows the horses he is down to drive as well as those that they are in against and those other drivers that are driving them.

"He is the antithesis of a whipper and slasher. I believe if drivers didn't carry whips, he'd be as good as he now is, maybe better. Don't get me wrong, I'm not proposing that we don't carry whips, I believe them to be necessary for education and guidance.

"I still watch all his races. We still speak every day. Somehow though, our roles have reversed. I used to be the teacher, now I'm the recipient of more knowledge than I impart.

# What can you tell us about your greatest equine pupil?

"You are referring to Atlanta of course. As a 2-year-old, Atlanta wasn't even the best filly we had in the stable. We had two nice ones. Courtney Hanover was the better of the two. When they were in races together, I picked 'Courtney' over Atlanta, because she was the better of the two.

"It wasn't until she was 3 that Atlanta became what we know her as. Courtney Hanover turned out to be what I always believed she was, a very nice filly. She was a stakes winner and ended up earning \$229,971. On the other hand, Atlanta became ATLANTA.

"It was not without a little degree of angst that the transition occurred. She was beginning to show the degree of speed that she has ultimately been known for, but she was also making breaks. I believe the turning point was when I put some half hobbles on her. They seemed to steady her. I believe from that point forward she was on her way. We took her to a stakes race at Tioga. She exploded and finished a good third. It was at her next race, a stakes race at Vernon where both Scott and I felt we had something special. Scott told me, 'We are going to the Hambletonian with this filly.' You mean the Hambletonian Oaks don't you?' I said. 'No, I mean the Hambletonian,' he responded.

"The rest is history. In the first heat Scotty said he let her get away from him at the start and she got nipped at the wire. She'll win the final and the race. She's the best, he said between heats and sure enough she did just that."

#### What does your stable look like today?


"As I've said, we have 18 in training. I'd like to think that I have a Hambletonian horse among them. His name is Landing On Time. He is the first foal out of Courtney Hanover. Yes, that same Courtney Hanover that was better than Atlanta as a 2-year-old. We sold that mare to Kevin Greenfield and her first foal was this colt. We bought him as a yearling for \$80,000.

"Landing On Time was a nice colt last year earning \$70,6540. We just qualified him in 1.56. I was very pleased with how he went. The game plan right now is to race him about twice a month. If he looks good enough, we will have him ready for the Hambletonian at The Meadowlands on Aug. 2. He is staked to everything, both before and after the Hambo.

"Of course, it's a big challenge to expect a lightly raced 2-year-old to be good enough to tackle a field that will likely include one of the very best 2-year-old trotters ever, Maryland. But you never know. We did it once before. Why not again?"

# Borups Victory showed no mercy winning the Paralympiatravet

The runner up in the 2024 Elitloppet — and one of the favorites this year — **Borups Victory** (Googoo Gaagaa) showed no mercy on the lead when the \$300,000 Paralympiatravet was held at Åby racetrack in Sweden on Saturday (May 4) afternoon. Heavy rain made the track sloppy midway into the card, but when the Paralympiatravet final was underway, the sun hade made its comeback and the track dried surprisingly well.

The initial part of the race was full of go as Önas Prince sprinted to the lead with A Fair Day pressuring on the outside. Önas Prince's driver Per Nordström was not interested in letting A Fair Day take over the lead, but 200 meters later he opted to let Borups Victory pass him by. A pocket trip at Åby means that you will get the chance on the inside open-stretch lane, so the tactics on Nordström's part made sense.

Borups Victory got company on the outside from San Moteur with a kilometer to go, but the exciting duel never appeared. Borups Victory was too strong and via a :26.6 last quarter, the opponents on the outside had a really hard time trying to challenge. Önas Prince, in the pocket, did what he could, but finished fourth and was never actually a threat for the win.

Mats Sundin, former NHL pro in Toronto, co-owns Borups Victory, who has started his 2025 season with two big stakes wins. He claimed the Seinäjoki Race in Finland two weeks ago and his next objective is Elitloppet at Solvalla in three weeks.

Borups Victory had a mile rate of 1:52.4 over 1.3 miles. Replay here.

San Moteur was a brave runner up and French contribution Inmarosa finished strongly in third.

#### FREE TIME JEPSON OUTSTANDING AT ÅBY

Alessandro Gocciadoro exhaled after the \$200,000 King's Trophy at Åby on Saturday (May 3) afternoon. "Okay," Gocciadoro said. "I had to win, the best horse, for sure, but I had to win. It's not so easy... For me, this is a champion."

And he couldn't be more right. **Free Time Jepson** (Face Time Bourbon) was the heavy favorite at Åby this day, but races must be raced before a king is crowned and now, we know that the European king among 4-year-olds is bred in Italy and trained by Italy's dominant Gocciadoro.

Rain made the track sloppy, and contenders wanted to see what kind of horse Free Time Jepson really is and there were a few more obstacles in the way before Åby's public would celebrate the king of the 4-year-olds. But Gocciadoro solved the initial 100 meters by playing it safe while Lando Mearas sprinted to the lead for Daniel Wäjersten. Out of the first turn, Gocciadoro attacked three wide, aiming for the front position and some hundred meters later Free Time Jepson overtook the lead. Free Time Jepson probably didn't choose the pace himself, but the chronometer showed pace that is usually for older elite trotters with a kilometer to go, and a normal 4-year-old horse racing on a little bit of a sloppy track would be marked by the speed, but Free Time Jepson is not a normal trotter. He is a king, at least for now, and he left his opponents in the stretch and won in a mile rate of 1:54.2.

A champion he is, and the same can in the future be said about the runner up, American bred Luke The Spook, who entered the home stretch as the last horse. Adrian Kolgjini's horse showed great speed as he flew far on the outside and claimed the silver ahead of Izod Zet.



# ANDRÉ EKLUNDH TAKES QUEEN'S TROPHY WITH PANTHERE D'INVERNE

Trainer/driver André Eklundh belongs at Åby racetrack. That's his home playground and he's been the kind of trainer that produces great trotters, but also a trainer that lacked wins in some of the big stakes races in Sweden. Until Saturday (May 3), when he showed a very strong winner in the \$200,000 Queen's Trophy for 4-year-old mares.

**Panthere d'Inverne** (Brillantissime) finished third in her elimination race, which meant that Eklundh had no other choice than be saddled with post 8 behind the gate, against opponents that impressed a lot in their eliminations, respectively. And Panthere d'Inverne had to face a very tough trip from her problematic post position. Three wide throughout the first turn and eventually an attack for position first over, outside of leading favorite Vivillion, was Panthere d'Inverne's race destiny in the biggest objective so far in her career.

Vivillion looked like the probable winner when the field turned into the last turn, but 200 meters later, at the end of the same turn, Panthere d'Inverne had put some serious pressure on the favorite. Eklundh won one of the biggest races his home track offers, with a horse that he has shaped from the beginning and it's easy to understand why tears fell from his eyes in the winner's circle.

Panthere d'Inverne won in a mile rate of 1:56 over 1.3 miles and favorite Vivillion held on for second place ahead of Elegance Silvio.

#### **KOCTEL DU DAIN BEST IN PARIS**

Philippe Allaire trained **Koctel du Dain** (Boccador de Simm) impressed when Vincennes raced Saturday (May 2). The 5-year-old colt has battled in the top of the French K-crop pretty much all his career and there is no doubt that he can continue his path towards the very big races for the older elite, especially after Saturday's \$120,000 Prix Albert Demarcq over 2,850 meters.

David Thomain drove Allaire's trotter and he hit the lead with a mile to go, with the race's first choice, Kanto Avis, on his outside.

Kanto Avis couldn't challenge Koctel du Dain and chasers from behind never got seriously close as the leader hit the wire in a stakes record mile rate of 1:55.2 over 1.7 miles.

# FRANCESCO ZET OUTSTANDING IN ELITLOPPET PREPARATION

Daniel Redén's **Francesco Zet** (Father Patrick) is, by many fans, favored to win Elitloppet and Redén has opted for two races before the big battle later this month. Francesco Zet started his season with an easy win at Solvalla on April 23 and his second race, and probably last before Elitloppet, came in Rättvik, in a \$10,000 race over 1,640 meters and the 7-year-old champion jogged, more or less without opponents chasing him, to a superior win in 1:51.3.

# Greg Samples is enjoying the 'unmatched' excitement of harness racing

Thirteen years ago, Greg Samples bought in on his first racehorse, partnering with his father. The idea was that they could share in the experience together as Sam Samples battled health issues. With that first purchase, Greg was hooked. More than a decade later, he has owned pieces or all of more than 80 horses, focusing heavily on the claiming game.

"That was the main impetus in getting involved in the harness racing, and then it just took off from there," Greg said of that first claim, gelding Marky Mike. "My little \$8,000 claimer made \$50,000. So, of course, I was hooked at that point. He was a nice little horse and we really enjoyed him."

Claimed in June 2012, Marky Mike hit the board in eight of 13 starts for Greg, but he failed to reach the winner's circle before closing out the year. The next season the pacer would collect seven wins, taking his career mark of 1:52.1 before being claimed in September. Greg and his wife, Tracy, enjoyed the experience and have remained involved through both the good and the lean years.

"The claiming game, which I still enjoy, I tell all my friends, it's just like Christmas," the owner said. "Sometimes you get exactly

what you're wanting and then sometimes you get a lump of coal. We've enjoyed all of them. But most of them being claimers, we didn't really own them for very long at a time."

And one thing Greg tries not to do is claim horses back multiple times. He learned at an early age to have an appreciation for horses, but not to get attached.

"When I was in first grade, I had a little pony and I loved that little pony," he said. "Well, I came home from school one day and my pony was gone. My dad sold it. So that was a good lesson for later in life that I don't become too attached to them. We don't see them every day like the trainers do, so it's easier not to become attached. But you still enjoy every one of them."

If there is an argument to be made for becoming attached to a horse, Rollin Rosie is a worthy exception. Greg is a partner on the 5-year-old mare, a 23-time winner also owned by trainer Tyler George and Steve Price's SCP Stable Inc. In 42 lifetime starts, the daughter of JK Endofanera—Rock N Roll Baby has finished off the board only six times, and has yet to miss a check while banking over \$600,000 to date.

Although his preference is claimers, Greg couldn't pass up the opportunity to buy in on a then yearling Rollin Rosie when offered.

"I had raised a few babies with not a lot of success," Greg said. "The year that 'Rosie' was in the sale at the State Fairgrounds, I went to the sale that day. I told my wife, 'I'm not buying a colt.' So, the first thing I did was buy a colt. Tyler bought her. Immediately after, I told him he got the best deal in the sale. He said, 'Well, you can own part of her,' so I bought part of her."

Rosie had brought \$9,500 in the sales ring, and she may very well be one of the best deals to come out of the 2021 Hoosier Classic Sale. As a freshman, Rollin Rosie won six of seven starts, racing third in the Indiana Sires Stakes Super Final and finishing the

year with \$209,250. As a sophomore, she added nearly \$235,000 to her card, notching a runner-up performance in the Super Final. Last season the pacer won nine of 22 attempts and was again second in the sires stakes final for older pacing mares.

With all that success, it can result in some high expectations each time out.

"It's hard," Greg said. "You expect her to win every week because of the success she's had. There are so many really good mares out there that I know that's not realistic. But it's fun to have that possibility."

Rollin Rosie's success as a young horse has led Greg to continue pursuing yearlings to complement his claiming interests. Before retirement, he spent 40 years working for Firestone, primarily managing retail outlets around the Indianapolis area. Now he is happy if he has a horse racing each night at Harrah's Hoosier Park.

"I still want to be involved in the claiming game," he said. "I want to maintain my involvement in the yearlings, the young horses. For me, it's about enjoying the people you deal with and enjoying the sport. Whatever I feel would increase my enjoyment in this, that's what I'm going to do."

Part of that enjoyment is centered on the relationships developed with the trainers Greg employs and partners with on horses. In the past he has worked with Charlie Stewart and Charlie Conrad, and today his partnerships include George and Ross Leonard.

"I think it's important that the trainer has some skin in the game," Greg said. "We have been so lucky to be involved with the people we've been involved with. With the trainers especially, we've been involved with. That's one of the best things about this business, I think, is the people you meet and the people you interact with."

# Sarah Atlas is a true superhero

Five years ago, I approached Dave Briggs, the editor of HRU with the idea of writing a column to honor all the females in harness racing. There has been a diverse group who have told their story — all quite different — but each as important.

In reality, every woman is a "Superstar" for each has dedicated their time, life, and endless love to harness racing and the horses.

Sarah Atlas, this month's superstar is no different. In my eyes, she is not only a superstar, but a superhero. She has battled cancer, endured many heartaches, and was one of the nation's heroes who spent 10 days searching for people in the rubble that

fateful day of 9/11, accompanied by her faithful companion, a German shepherd named Anna, who sadly had to be put to sleep four months after returning home due to medical conditions that developed from exposure.

Atlas was part of the New Jersey Task Force One, urban search and rescue, who became part of FEMA.

Born in New York City, Atlas had been horse crazy since birth. Her family was not involved in our sport, but they supported their young daughter, getting her riding lessons in Staten Island, a three-hour trip by bus and ferry.

When Atlas was 15 years old, while on a bus trip with her aunt to Washington, D.C., she met a young man who groomed horses for trainer Carter Duer. The two young people exchanged numbers.

At the time, Atlas' parents owned a summer house in Monticello, about two miles from the racetrack. When Duer had his horses shipped into Ruth Kephart's barn, who also had horses for Duer, Atlas visited the athletic animals at the barn. Although this was the very first time she visited a harness track, that's all it took, she was hooked.

At that time, Kephart was one of the first licensed female horse trainers, and taught Atlas the business the 'old fashioned way,' walking and cooling horses, etc.

Fast forward to when Atlas was attending nursing school and worked summers at Roosevelt Raceway. She assisted top trainers, John Chapman, John Patterson, Sr., Walter Marks, and Norman Dauplaise, before meeting her soon-to-be husband, a veterinarian at Roosevelt and Yonkers. When the two married the newlyweds moved to Ohio after he was hired as the vet at Hill Farm.

she learned from her husband, including palpating mares, collecting semen and foaling and teasing mares.

"I purchased my first horse, a \$4,500 yearling filly named Tika Belle [originally named Theme Hill]," Atlas said. "I trained her at Hilliard fairground until she was ready to qualify, then moved her to Terry Holten's barn. My partner on the filly was Ron Jackson."

For those of you who don't recognize the name Tika Belle (Skipper Walt—Tika Hanover), the mare went on to produce one of the greatest fillies of all time, Shady Daisy.

"Call it beginner's luck, but Tika Belle went on to win multiple sire stakes races when trainer Gene Riegel approached me to buy her," Atlas said. "I was having too much fun with 'Tika,' but because of the divorce I was forced to sell her.

"After I got divorced, I was offered a job at Rivenoak Farm in Millbrook, NY, putting together their trotting broodmares, as well as purchasing shares in Speedy Crown and Super Bowl for the farm. Sadly, after working there seven years, economic devastation hit our country and Rivenoak Farm got out of the business.

After her divorce, Atlas worked for Walter Marks in Pennsylvania, taking care of a claiming mare by the name of Fashion Trick, who went on to produce the extremely fast Falcon Seelster.

"At one time, I was also the assistant trainer at Pinehurst for Young Meadow Farm one season," Atlas said. "I feel very blessed to have been involved in the sport when it was in its glory. Horseman Alan Leavitt had the right idea, he would throw a big party during the sales trying to draw new people in. It worked, but sadly we don't see much of this happening today.

"I started a driving school which was very successful in attracting new owners. I also had promotions that got new people involved, pet adoptions, a psychic Sunday brunch, and barn tours.

"Today, the business is not doing enough to get young people involved. If you go to Goshen on Fourth of July weekend, although the stands are full, there is no betting, and not one table is set up to tell people how to get involved. All we do is sell racing to ourselves."

The day of Sept. 11, 2001, was devastating to all Americans and people throughout the world. It was a calm, crisp September

What Atlas didn't learn from working for her renowned bosses, morning like many others, and then it was not. Forces from afar would fade away days of innocence when terrorists linked to the Islamic extremist group al Qaeda hijacked four commercial passenger airplanes and carried out suicide attacks against targets in the United States. Two of the planes were flown into the World Trade Center in New York City where both twin towers collapsed while a third plane hit the Pentagon in Arlington, VA, and a fourth crashed in an open field near Shanksville, PA.

> When the horrific acts were over, almost 3,000 people were killed from the terrorist attacks. Those shocking events would forever leave the world reeling in horror.

> Immediately thousands of rescue workers from across America deployed to Ground Zero to help search for survivors. One of those courageous people was harness racing's own Atlas along with her faithful four-legged companion Anna.

> Both Atlas and Anna, were superheroes, but sadly paid the price. Atlas got injured while her dog was sniffing for human remains and Anna was diagnosed shortly after with bacterial and fungal infections in every major organ and had to be put to sleep. The courageous canine was put to sleep four months after 9/11 due to the effects of working at Ground Zero, and Atlas has personally had to deal with many ongoing complications.

> While still battling the effects of post 9/11, Atlas was hit with another devastating blow, she was diagnosed with a benign brain tumor. Enduring five days of radiation along with the work injury, Atlas has been out of work for 15 months.

> Presently she imports, trains and breeds Czech-line German shepherds to eventually go to police departments and search-and-rescue.

> Note: I have personally known Atlas for over 30 years, and she is one of the nicest people I know. She is one of our harness racing family's true heroes. A GoFundMe page has been set up by Gen Sullivan to help Atlas with her medical bills.

# A look back at milestone Hambletonians

Will the 100<sup>th</sup> Hambletonian follow in the exciting footsteps of its milestone predecessors?

Let's hope so. Here's a closer look at three of the most memorable Hambletonians.

**1950:** Lusty Song wins the richest edition, \$75,209. It was the first time since 1926 that the initial year offering of \$73,451 had been bettered. Del Miller becomes the first driver to capture the Little Brown Jug (Dudley Hanover) and the Hambletonian in the same season. It was Miller's third try at the Hambletonian after finishing fourth (1946) and sixth (1948) and probably most amazingly Lusty Song was a mind-numbing 19-for-32 as a freshman. The winner's price was \$5.40, not as the favorite.

1975: Bonefish in yet another nose finish gets the measure of Yankee Bambino. Neither ever competed again after this the sixth of seven four heat Hambletonians. This purse was \$232,192, the new high-water mark by \$72G. Stanley Dancer won his third as a driver and fourth overall. Bonefish was the winter book favorite (\$3.20) and would go on to a spotty siring career. He actually passed in Sweden the week after the 1988 Hambletonian. He was second with Firm Tribute, fourth with Bolla and the fifth-place finisher Supergill was out of a Bonefish mare. Continental Stable had a strong run with Bonefish fillies such as Conch, Crevette, Victorious Tail, and the dam of Moni Maker, Nans Catch. Not bad for a son of 1968 Triple Crown winner Nevele Pride who went for \$27,000 in the fall of 1973 to Canadian A. M. Cuddy.

**2000:** Yankee Paco, a chestnut son of Balanced Image who would grab a second credit just three years later with Amigo Hall. Doug McIntosh was the winning trainer. There was \$1,210,000 on the line for first time. Three-time Hambletonian winning conditioner Per Eriksson was second in his Hambletonian finale before going back to his homeland of Sweden. Hall of Famer Dave Magee made his lone Hambletonian appearance finishing fifth with 9-5 post time favorite Dreamaster. Ray Schnittker duplicated what he had done in his Hambletonian debut just three years earlier. He was third then with the longest shot in the field Armbro Plato at 47-1. In 2000 with Armbro Trick he was third again as the second longest shot at 40-1.

#### THE MOST HAPPENIN' HAMBLETONIAN?

Upon closer look/review of all 99 Hambletonians, it appears that more was going in 1985 than in any other year. See if you agree.

- 1. Bill O'Donnell wins his lone Hambletonian en route to a \$10 million season, the first for any driver.
- 2. The 1:54.3 final won by Prakas was the first sub-1:55 Hambletonian.
- 3. How great was Hans Enggren's day? He was breeder and part owner of Prakas in the richest Hambletonian at \$1,272,000. That pot was \$53G higher than the Historic Freight (\$1,219,000) purse just a year earlier. He also bred runner-up and heat winner Torway (\$76.40).
- 4. This was the last time Stanley Dancer would enter a pair: Bon Sport was seventh overall and Piggvar was fifth and third, but sixth overall in summary.
- 5. This was the third-straight year that the ownership group also bred the winner. In 1983 Clearview Stable had Duenna, in 1984 ABC Stables had Historic Freight and Enggren (1985) as breeder and part owner of Prakas.
- 6. There was a father-son driving appearance in the final. Jan Nordin qualified both Master Willie and Ron B Hanover. His dad, Soren, opted for Ron B Hanover and finished second in the final and third overall while Master Willie with Jan was ninth in the 1:54.3 record finale.
- 7. This year was the first Hambletonian simulcast. Simulcasting had been ruled unconstitutional late in 1983 but was up and running some 21 months later.
- 8. It was a family affair, as Tina Eriksson was the caretaker of Prakas for her 24-year-old husband Per, who became the youngest to condition a Hambletonian winner.
- 9. There were 37,652 in attendance; a New Jersey Hambletonian best.
- 10. Nihilator set the track and world record of 1:49.3 that day also. O'Donnell thus won with a new Hambletonian mark, a new world mark, and the richest ever trotting event.

# YOUR FAVORITE HAMBLETONIAN OR MEADOWLANDS PACE?

The key word is *favorite*. Let's say you chose the first Meadowlands Pace (1977), and the first Meadowlands Hambletonian (1981). Those two share something in common. No favorite won. In the 1977 Pace, Escort was 4-1 third choice, and in the 1981 Hambletonian, Shiaway St Pat was the 6-5 second choice in the three-horse race off.

# Keeping a level head has Logan Lanpher on the path to a small but successful stable

Logan Lanpher remembers the moment as if it were yesterday.

The ninth race at Bangor Raceway on Sept. 15, 2023, drew seven hopefuls, including River Runs Deep, a veteran pacer trained by Lanpher and owned by his father, Russell.

There were encouraging signs — a near miss last time out, 7-5 favoritism on the tote board on this night, and a wealth of back class — that gave the bay gelding's connections sufficient reason to feel good about their chances.

Now, it was up to River Runs Deep and driver Walter Case, Jr., to get the job done.

The pair powered off the gate and settled on the front end ahead of a :28 opening quarter. A length and a half clear through a half in :58, River Runs Deep stretched his lead to 1½ lengths after three-quarters in 1:27.1.

Lanpher, watching the action unfold from the paddock, liked what he was seeing.

"I had a good feeling going into the race," he said. "He's a nice, classy old horse, and fit perfectly at that level at the time. I was watching him come around the turn for home and it was looking like he still had plenty in the tank."

Case kept his charge to task and midway down the lane, the only thing left to decide was second place.

At the wire, River Runs Deep was four lengths clear in 1:56.2.

"Once you know you have it all under control, it's surreal, especially for the first time," Logan said. "Doing it with him

made it even more special for me. He was the type of horse who you could learn a lot from."

At season's end, Logan added two more seconds from a total of 16 starts.

Beyond the numbers, it was the overall experience the rookie conditioner was most grateful for.

"I learned a lot," he said. "Two of the biggest things were that you need to put every single ounce of your focus and energy into the job, and that hard work makes everything go right."

That yeoman approach served Logan well in 2024.

It was Cutter Loose, a pacing daughter of Western Terror—Beckys Filly, who gave the sophomore trainer ample reasons, 13 of them to be exact, to celebrate.

Bred by Kyle Gardiner and Joseph Gardiner, the bay mare fashioning an 'irregular star' was a shining star for the stable.

Cutter Loose won 13 times, to go along with one second, and a trio of thirds, from 37 starts in 2024.

"She's a little horse with a big heart," Logan said. "She is great to work with, a lot of fun to be around, and was always ready to race each week. I continued to learn the ropes from her. I really couldn't ask for anything more from her – she is the type of horse you'd like to have a barn full of."

With year three of his training career well underway, Logan, who has a stable of two horses — he owns both — is looking to build off a 2024 campaign that produced a 16-7-6 mark from 46 starts.

So far, the results have been pleasing.

In four starts, Logan has posted two wins and two thirds, courtesy of Cutter Loose and Little Power, an 11-year-old pacer he also owns.

"I just want to see my horses race the best they can and if it's not working, I want to do whatever I can to fix it," he said. "It is about moving forward for me.

"Consistency is key. I want to have my horses do well regularly throughout the year."

Logan, who also helps jog horses for other trainers, would like to see his operation expand soon.

"I'd like to add a few horses and have a small, but successful stable," he said. "In the long term, I want to keep working to win races. I suppose one of the things I'd like to achieve is 100 career wins. But I don't want to stop there.

"I was told when I started to keep a level head and no matter how many horses I end up with, that is something I will always remember. Be grateful for the wins, but don't get too down on yourself when you lose."

It is how Logan views his four starts in 2025.

After posting a pair of thirds over two days at Cumberland Raceway, the half-mile oval in Maine, he made two trips to the winner's circle at Bangor Raceway – Cutter Loose won the third race and Little Power took top prize in the fifth.

"You always have to keep going no matter what the result," he said. "When we had those two wins at Bangor, I was back in the barn at 5:30 in the morning. Obviously, you are happy and grateful, but the work doesn't stop – it's onto the next day."

When he isn't in the stalls or the shedrow, Logan unwinds by watching sports.

"I am a big sports guy — basketball and football are my favorites — but outside of that, there isn't much I like to do," he said. "Being around the horses is what I have always known."

Logan was a fixture in his father's barn at an early age.

He took an immediate liking to the horses, horsepeople and the camaraderie of the racing community.

"My dad always had between five to 10 horses at a time – it was just always fun going into the barn after school or on the weekends," Logan said. "I always looked forward to seeing the horses."

He still very much does.

"The horses are amazing athletes, and each one has their own unique personality," Logan said. "You might not always realize it in the moment, but they teach you so much about your career. That is something I really enjoy. Any time you get to spend around the horses is good for you. They have a calming effect that always puts you at ease."

Apart from watching them compete.

"Well, you do get excited when you watch your horses out on the racetrack," he said. "It can be nerve-wracking, but at the same time, it can give you the best feeling in the world when they get to that wire first."





# **Lane changes**

My first career move occurred in the 10th grade. After one year of playing high school football, I switched to pole vaulting, where opponents did not try to maim me. As a pole vaulter, I lounged in the soft foam rubber pit and worked on my tan. If you disregard the run-up and only calculate the time airborne, my total career lasted about one minute and 37 seconds, which was fine with me. It allowed me plenty of time to ogle high school girls.

Pole vaulting is a primitive sport in which a human being (or teenager) attempts to soar over a stick using another stick. The whole thing is sort of dull and stupid, but one thing about the sport - it is very fair. You get over the barrier, or you don't.

One day, our track coach, Mr. Rademacher, strolled over, tapped me on the shoulder, and grumbled, "Your idiot friend Freddy Tetherfield has just been kicked off the team for smoking behind the bleachers, so you are taking his place and running the first leg of the mile relay." He finished this shocking request by saying, "Just stay in your lane, do your best, and hand the baton to Smithers."

Rademacher escorted me to the starting blocks and gave me instructions that I immediately forgot. I was delighted that my starting blocks, red wooden triangles that he stomped into the gravel, were several yards in front of lane three and many yards in front of lanes two and one.

The starter pistol cracked.

The other three hopefuls were in my rearview mirror. Panting, arms pumping, mullet hair flying, suddenly I was "The Speedster of Richfield High." My euphoria lasted approximately 20 seconds. At that point, runners from lanes one, two, and three loomed into my peripheral vision. When a scowling Albert Smithers almost received the baton (yes, I dropped the damn thing), Trey was looking at the taillights of all other competitors.

My first reaction was to blame everyone else. Blame Raymond Tetherfield for being caught with my cigarettes, Coach Rademacher for sending me out so unprepared, and the Machiavellian configuration of the track.

The above is a long-winded introduction to one of my pet peeves in harness racing – the unfairness of an outside position. I cannot understand why years of griping about this unfair travesty generate replies like, "Yeah, well, getting stuck with an outside post is a bummer."

It is preposterous. Every horse should have an equal distance to travel regardless of assigned position. As constituted, the chances of winning a race from the outside post are minuscule. Starting at a post near the parking lot or empty grandstands makes many races unbeatable, unwatchable, and unconscionable.

Any person capable of simple mathematic calculations and physics (which excludes me) could quickly analyze how much of a distance each post position should be ahead of post 1 to make the distance traveled throughout one mile equal.

I can think of five ways to make the post positions more equitable in five seconds.

Re-engineer the starting gate using lighter-weight composite material. The starting gate should be designed so the outside posts are forward, not just a tiny amount, but tilted significantly so the race will be equitable. Not only is this fair, but viewers would also get a complete view of each horse at the start.

Like the high school mile relay race where I was an unfortunate lab rat, horses should stay in their delineated lanes for the first quarter-of-a-mile. At the end of the first quarter, all will have covered the same distance, and drivers will vie for positions near the coveted rail.

Get rid of the clunky cars and trucks. Just because you have watched a billion harness races line up behind a motorized vehicle does not mean it is the only or the best method. An obtrusive and jarring motorized vehicle as part of a horse race is ludicrous. Use a technique from OFF the surface; What about a laser beam or curtain instead of a starting car fence? What about an audio cue instructing the driver via headphones on the proper placement at the start of a race from sensors below the surface?

What about a standing start where horses stay in assigned lanes?

If we outsourced the beginning of our races to Silicon Valley or a Mensa group as a problem to be solved, it would be very cool to see what new solutions they would suggest for increasing interest and improving our product.

Imagine the start of a horse race without the obtrusive vehicle that can scare horses and cause accidents. Imagine a staggered start that allows viewers to see every single horse. Imagine a race where the draw isn't so much of the story. Imagine a stationary start. Imagine races with fewer chalks and tosses.

Cheaper, fairer, and more visual esthetics are reasons to say yea instead of neigh. Even a mullet-headed teenager knows that we should innovate. Why not start at the start?





# Innovator Eric Cherry still going strong after 55 years

He's been involved in harness racing since 1969 and has owned horses since 1972; with the modest Dominion K Magic his first. Now some 55 years later, after a highly diversified and innovative career, Eric Cherry is entrenched among the sport's leading owner/breeders.

Currently, he has major involvement in three stallions: Tattoo Artist, Heston Blue Chip, and Bettor's Wish.

Of those, Tattoo Artist, a son of He's Watching, had an incredible 96 starts over a five-year career that saw him earn over \$2.8 million while collecting accolades such as O'Brien Awards in both 2020 and 2023 as Canada's top 3-Year-Old Colt Pacer and Older Pacer of the Year, respectively. Tattoo Artist stands at Winbak of Canada.

Heston Blue Chip a son of American Ideal, has been around for a while and has sired such notables as Zero Tolerance, Save Me A Dance and Fulton to name a few. Heston Blue Chip stands at Diamond Creek of Pennsylvania.

Bettor's Wish, by the venerable Bettors Delight, earned over \$2.6 million in a three-year career that saw him





heralded as the Dan Patch 3-Year-Old champion of 2019 and the older Dan Patch champion of 2020. Bettor's Wish was the leading sire of 3-year-old pacers in average earnings for 2024 and stands at Southwind Farms in New Jersey for 2025.

Currently, Cherry's equine holdings via Let It Ride Stables and Best Bet Partners consists of 65 2-year-old colts and fillies, 17 3-year-old colts and fillies, and a smattering of older horses strategically placed between 18 leading trainers.

At present, Cherry has 60 broodmares, with 45 babies born thus far and a total of 50 yearlings whose futures will be determined at a later date.

Whereas his equine holdings are significant, Cherry has been one of the most innovative personalities in the harness racing world for decades now.

He, along with Maurice Chodash, started the National Race Line back in the 1980s, long before the internet was a figment of Al Gore's imagination.

Via a quick and easy call to a 900 number, patrons could get virtually instantaneous results, or complete race or partial stretch calls from whatever track they deemed important.

The National Race Line flourished for years until simulcasting and internet results rendered it somewhat obsolete.

Significantly, the National Race Line's 900 number became utilized by a variety of "services" during the '90s. Eventually, websites rendered the 900 call-in system unnecessary as anyone with a computer could obtain information as soon as it was posted.

Cherry said, at its peak, around 2,000 services utilized his lines during their heyday before 900 call-in services were discontinued around 2012.

In 1996, Cherry started one of the initial third party billing services on the internet which lasted until dispersed in 2002.

His next innovation occurred in 2001 when he launched on Gait Online Auction service.

OnGait has truly changed the way the business works, as there's no longer a need to wait for the next "auction" sale in order to unload or purchase racehorses, broodmares, stallion seasons, etc. It's all done instantaneously online.

Chodash, Cherry's long-time associate, formulated the original onGait concept and handles the details as, every day, significant horses change hands via the onGait auction site.

As with a live auction, bidders determine the actual prices. According to Chodash, roughly \$750 million has been handled by onGait since its inception in 2001 and that number increases every day. In essence, onGait has changed horses from an asset class to a commodity since one can sell any time at will.

For the record, Atlanta holds the record for the highest-priced sale via onGait at \$1,550,000 in 2019, making her the

highest-priced mare ever sold at public auction.

As of yet, on Gait prices are not included in the official United States Trotting Association registry, but Cherry said he hopes to have that amended at some point.

In 1982, Cherry also got involved as a part-owner of the now defunct South Florida Trotting Center in Lake Worth. By 1997, he owned 100 per cent of the trotting center until its sale in 2015.

Currently, Cherry, via his Let It Ride and Best Bet pseudonyms, ranks third among breeders in both earnings and wins.

He plans to continue breeding and racing champions.



# Hard Seven a natural in Dexter Cup at Big M

Driver Todd McCarthy wasn't taking any chances this time around.

After rebounding from an early break before storming home to win from well off the pace in his seasonal debut a week ago, McCarthy put **Hard Seven** on the lead Saturday night (May 3) in the Dexter Cup at The Meadowlands, the first significant event of the year for 3-year-old trotters, and the Nancy Takter trainee held off a late charge from My Degenerate to take the \$115,500 event in wire-to-wire fashion.

The Dexter Cup was relocated to The Big M this year after previous home Freehold Raceway closed down at the end of 2024.

"He actually started to grow up a lot at the end of last year," said Takter of the son of Chapter Seven—Whispering Oaks. "He finished with a nice win streak racing in the Kentucky Sire Stakes. He came into this year confident and he's grown up a bit and I'm kind of really excited about the way he has progressed."

Hard Seven burst away from the gate from post 6 in the six-horse field and put 5-2 second choice My Degenerate in the pocket. Hard Seven cut out soft fractions of :27.4, :57.2 and 1:26.4, but despite having things his own way, still gave his backers a scare when My Degenerate came at him quickly approaching the wire, only to come up a small head short. Civilian Drone was third.

Does Takter think Hard Seven can compete at a high level in the Aug. 2 Hambletonian?

"For sure, he's a quick colt," said the two-time winning Hambletonian trainer. "He definitely knows what this is about. He fought to the bare tooth when Andy [Miller, driving My Degenerate] was coming at him down the stretch. He's got all the tools to get there. We just have to have some luck and health on the way and he should be just fine."

Hard Seven, bred by Ola Yoder, is now five-for-11 lifetime and has career earnings of \$176,165 for owners Let It Ride Stables, Maurice Chodash and Boca Racing LLC. As the 2-5 favorite, he returned \$2.80 to win after stopping the clock in 1:53.4.

# **Corey Callahan reaches 8,000 in career victories**

"Captain" Corey Callahan drove the 8,000th winner of his illustrious career on Friday afternoon (May 2) at Harrah's Philadelphia, guiding I See A Star to a 1:56.1 victory in a \$13,500 trotting contest for developing horses.

Callahan settled the Bar Hopping mare, the choice of the Friday Philly crowd, in fourth early and sat there during fractions of :28.2 and :57.4, then moved out to follow the cover of second choice Herecomesdajudge, who was advancing towards the 1:26.1 three-quarters. The "Judge" put in bad steps on the far turn, leaving Callahan and I See A Star uncovered but with a clear path to the front, and the pair won safely for trainer/owner Brian Emerson, with Herecomesdajudge regaining his equilibrium and closing well to regain second.

Callahan, 47, had seasonal highs in 2013, when he won 618 races, and 2015, when the horses he guided earned \$9.8 million. The "Captain," currently fifth in wins on the local scene and tied for third at Harrington, has been consistent for the better part of two decades now, and his lifetime earnings of \$116.3 million

put him 25th in the sport's all-time annals. For 2025, he is 25th in North America in sulky successes and 18th in earnings. Philly will close out its racing week today (May 4) at 12:40 p.m. Free Philly program pages are or will be available at www.phha.org.

# Ayeaye Captain Deo sails home in Paul Revere Pace

**Ayeaye Captain Deo** (Captaintreacherous—Oceania) remained undefeated in 2025 after getting up late to win the \$100,000 Paul Revere Pace for 3-year-olds at Plainridge Park on Thursday (May 1) afternoon.

Dune Buggy (Tim Tetrick) and Waterfront (Jason Bartlett) traded leads off the gate before Primo Maschio (Walter Case, Jr.) took the front passing the :26.2 quarter. But that lead was short lived as Dune Buggy was back out and motoring in front of the stands and grabbed the point, where he stayed until very late in the race.

As the pack paced past the half in :54.1, Ayeaye Captain Deo (Todd McCarthy) pulled first-over from fourth in pursuit of Dune Buggy, who was still in command and looking strong. Ayeaye Captain Deo finally drew alongside Dune Buggy as they went by three-quarters and the pair pulled away from the field in the last turn while matching strides all the way. This match race continued into the straight and into deep stretch where Ayeaye Captain Deo edged ahead of Dune Buggy by a half-length to win in 1:50.4.

The time was a lifetime best for the winner and only one-fifth of a second off the stakes record.

Ayeaye Captain Deo (\$4.40) is now two-for-two this year for owner Gino Toscani and trainer Garry Merner, Jr.

The next Grand Circuit stop at Plainridge will be in two weeks, on Thursday (May 15), when the \$100,000 Grade 3 Battle of Bunker Hill 3-year-old open trot will take place.

Drivers Matty Athearn and Walter Case, Jr. and trainer Gretchen Athearn all registered three wins apiece in overnight action during Thursday's card.

Racing resumes at Plainridge Park on Monday (May 5) at 4 p.m. when there will be a \$5,368 carryover available in the Wicked Hi-5 pentafecta in race 6.

# Chapercraz puts out the 'Fire' at Big M

Benefiting from a perfect drive by Hall of Famer Yannick Gingras, **Chapercraz** scored in the Friday night (May 2) feature at The Meadowlands, taking down Outside The Fire, who was seeking a third straight score in the \$25,000 winners-over trot.

"He might be a step below the top trotters in the country but he's a little bit better than open trotters when he's on his game," said Gingras of the Ron Burke trainee.

Even-money favorite Outside The Fire blasted away from post 7 in the seven-horse field (Sir Pinocchio was scratched) but had Usain Hanover (post 5) leave underneath him while Chapercraz took advantage of the rail, leaving enough to make the top two work.

Usain Hanover reached the quarter in a snappy :27.1 as Outside The Fire continued to gain first-over and reached the lead at the three-eighths before hitting the half in :55.2.

Chapercraz went into attack mode at the five-eighths, vacating the 3-hole and sprinting up to take on the leader, and was just a length behind that foe at three-quarters, which went in 1:23.3.

The duo was on even terms at the head of the stretch, but the early fracas proved too much for Outside The Fire to overcome, as Chapercraz reported home a 1½-length winner. Usain Hanover looked exceptional in his seasonal debut, nailing Outside The Fire for the place spot.

"I just wanted to make sure that the pace was fairly hot," said Gingras. "I wanted to make sure the last quarter wasn't a full sprint. The fractions were honest and I was happy with that. I would rather have been in the 2-hole but it was fine the way it worked out. If you're going to beat Outside The Fire, you're going to have to make him work a little harder."

A 5-year-old gelded son of Crazy Wow—Chaperess, Chapercraz notched his ninth lifetime victory from 43 starts after completing the mile in 1:51.2, a time that lowered his previous lifetime best by two-and-one-fifth seconds. He now has earnings of \$1,031,139 for owners Burke Racing Stable, Weaver Bruscemi and P. Collura. As the 7-5 second choice, he returned \$4.80 to win.

**A LITTLE MORE:** Dexter Dunn led the driver colony with three winners on the program... Noel Daley and Michael Posner topped the trainers with two victories each... Allsource handle on the 14-race program totaled \$1,878,543.
