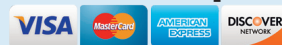

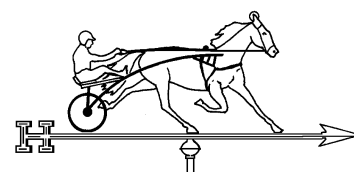

O'Brien Horse of the Year, ended up fourth in the eighth qualifier of the day.

Silver Label and driver Doug McNair settled in early for a winning pocket trip, following fast-leaving leader Bob Loblaw, in line to Sylvain Filion. Hudson Standardbred's Macho Phil sat third, ahead of his famous stablemate, who waited in single-file sixth for her cue from regular driver Bob McClure. Silver Label was first to exit the pylons for the stretch drive and draw away by three expanding lengths ahead of next-best Macho Phil, driven by Jonathan Drury.

Sylvia Hanover (Always B Miki-Shyaway) closed three-wide in the fastest last quarter, pacing home in a sharp :25.4 behind third-place finisher Bob Loblaw. Fractions were :28.3, :57.2, 1:25.4, and 1:52 for the mile over a fast racing surface.

The 4-year-old mare had recently trained at Woodbine Mohawk Park, leading to speculation about when the 2023 Dan Patch and O'Brien 3-Year-Old Pacing Filly of the Year would make her debut in the older distaff pacing ranks. This year, she is sustained for Mohawk's Roses Are Red (eliminations June 7) and Milton Stakes (eliminations Sept. 7), with no other major races yet on her schedule.

Friday (May 3) afternoon, trainer Shawn Steacy answered a few questions about Sylvia Hanover's progress and the season ahead.

“Not too much to say yet,” he told HRU. “She qualified very well today, did everything she was asked and finished within herself. She has grown slightly and continues to mature. Bob [McClure] did a really good job today, qualifying the way we like.”

McClure had been sidelined early in the year by a Jan. 15 **snowmobile accident**. He returned to driving March 22, ahead of Sylvia Hanover's comeback. He has driven the champion mare

in every start of her 22-race career, and all but her first lifetime qualifier.

The fourth-place result in Sylvia Hanover's first charted mile of 2024 raised no concerns with her trainer. The mare finished third to Sweet Amira and Steacy stablemate Front Page Story in her first 2023 qualifier, a 1:54.1 mile last May 12 at Mohawk.

“She is going to need another qualifier or two to be ready, as she will fit so tough [a classification] when she starts racing again,” said Steacy. “Nothing is set in stone yet. We will let her tell the story, and it will be on her terms. It's a long year ahead.”

Stablemate Macho Phil's (p, 3, 1:50.4s; \$160,624) qualifying result impressed Steacy as “really good.” The 5-year-old son of Shanghai Phil-Hazel is also owned by Hudson Standardbred Stable Inc. of Hudson, QC.

“He looks like he's rounding back to the form he had at 3,” said Steacy. “We're hoping he keeps trending in the right direction.”

Macho Phil was an OSS Gold winner at Mohawk on July 2, 2022. The homebred stallion is also being pointed toward his first start of the year.

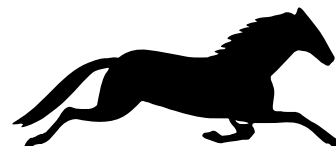

Three NZ starts – two of them epic in major races – and one still to come, in the Group 1 Rowe Cup at Auckland’s Alexandra Park on May 24.

In fact, you could argue Just Believe’s wins against quality opposition after doing all the work in the inaugural TAB Trot on April 12 and Friday night’s (May 3) Group 1 National Trot are the two best wins of his career.

In the TAB Trot, he sat parked outside gifted European import Callmethe breeze and beat him with top Aussies Queen Elida and Arcee Phoenix chasing hard in the third and fourth spots.

The hard luck story of that race was NZ’s best trotter, Muscle Mountain, who drew wide, worked hard early and had no luck. His connections immediately set their sights on another crack at the Aussie champ.

That came on Friday when driver Ben Hope used Muscle Mountain’s early brilliance to burn across Just Believe and lead.

And, true to his pre-race words, Hope held the front and forced Just Believe to (yet again) have to sit parked to win a major race.

The result was definitive, Just Believe had Muscle Mountain beaten rounding the final bend and driver Greg Sugars gave him as easy a time as possible on his way to an arrogant and powerhouse victory.

“It’s up with his best wins,” Sugars said. “To do it racing the opposite direction and having been away from home so long. You run out of things to say about him, but he’s just amazing and we’re so lucky to have him.”

Since returning from his three-race Swedish raid in the middle of last year, Just Believe has raced 15 times for 13 wins and two fantastic seconds.

As good as he was before Sweden, he’s come back even better.

“No doubt he’s better,” Sugars said. “That’s amazing in itself. I really thought it would go the other way, that we’d have a go at Sweden and it could or would take a toll on him.

“We couldn’t believe it when he seemed so great early in his first preparation back home and he’s gone on to show that in his races. It’s incredible really, especially given he’s an 8-year-old now. He’s never gone better.”

Just Believe will return home for a break after the Rowe Cup and then trainer Jess Tubbs and driver Sugars will map out how his back half of 2024 looks.

The obvious target is a piece of history through a third successive Inter Dominion trotting crown in the NSW series from Nov. 29 to Dec. 14.

The burning question is whether Just Believe makes another trip to NZ before that for the time-honored Group 1 Dominion Trot in mid-November.

“It’s definitely an option and more so because of how well he’s gone over here this trip,” Sugars said. “We know he travels so well and that the opposition is good, but nothing to be scared of.

“The Inter Dominion will be his main target, but if we can sort travel that won’t interfere too much with his Inter Dominion preparation, then it would be very tempting to go back to NZ.”

It was the changing of the guard in the Queen Elizabeth II Mile. After almost four years as Australia’s megastar female pacer, Ladies In Red found one better in Australia’s biggest mares’ race at Menangle Saturday (May 4) night.

Younger Kiwi bred-and-owned mare **Aardies Express** produced a stunning display to gun-down Ladies In Red from a seemingly hopeless position.

The margin was only a neck, but the win was so much bigger given Aardies Express raced three-wide for the entire mile and paced it in 1:49.9.

“When I looked up at the top of the straight and saw how far in front Ladies In Red, I thought it was nearly impossible for us,” trainer/driver Jack Trainor said. “But she really unleashed when I asked her and just kept chasing the leader. It was an incredible win.”

Aardies Express, by Always B Miki out of Rocknroll Hanover mare Tatijana Bromac, has now won 15 of just 21 starts and both races in Australia.

It continued Trainor’s incredible record in the Group 1 Queen Elizabeth II Mile (formerly Ladyship Mile). He’s now trained and/or driven the past four winners. It started with Stylish Memphis going back-to-back in 2021 and ’22 before Braeview Kelly won last year and now Aardies Express.

“It’s the race that put me on the map and is so special to me,” he said. “I’ve got some owners back in NZ who keep sending me these fantastic mares to train.

“This mare is special, really special. I’m not sure where we will go next. She deserves a few days off before we decide.”

The Group 1 Golden Girl at Brisbane’s Albion Park in July looks like the obvious target.

It was arguably the first time in Ladies In Red’s phenomenal 33 start career you would say she was clearly beaten on her merits. And it was only her eighth defeat in those 33 starts.

Connections have flagged she’s off to the breeding barn at the end of the season. It will be interesting whether they press on after that defeat, despite the fact she certainly wasn’t disgraced.

As the curtain comes down on Ladies In Red’s career, her trainers Emma Stewart and Clayton Tonkin may have found a replacement in unbeaten 3-year-old filly **Very Pretty**.

Just 30 minutes before the Queen Elizabeth, Very Pretty stretched her unbeaten record to eight races with the most dominant of Group 1 NSW Oaks wins.

The daughter of American Ideal worked to the front, dictated terms and cruised to a 12.7 meter win.


The overall mile rate was a steady 1:55.9 for the longer 2400m trip, but it was Very Pretty’s closing splits which turned heads. She closed-off in :53.1 and :25.7.

“She’s got it all, this filly,” driver Mark Pitt said. “I know she had it easy in front tonight, but she’s tough and so, so fast. I’m sure she’s just going to keep getting better and better, too.”

SATURDAY

My struggle to get out of my drug hole and make a new life is a solo trip. Still, I have plenty of crutches; my mom, the rehab program at the horse training center experience, the NA meetings, the horses in the barn, Paul for a mentor, a lot of structure each day, and this diary in the evening.

I write in this diary in my bedroom after the nightly NA meeting and before going to bed. I write in a spiral-bound notebook, like students use in school. I never show anyone a single word in this diary. I write in cursive using a cheap pen. This pen came from Hartman's Funeral Home. I thought about using a computer and typing this journal, but there is something about putting my pen to paper that feels good. The paper and pen make me feel like I am drawing a picture and not just emailing somebody. Why do I write? I'm not sure, but it calms me. Writing makes me

think. The experience is like the difference between looking at a horse and touching a horse. Writing on a page like this shows I am making progress; hey, it's in ink! Another thing about writing this is nobody judges me, and I do not need to lie or put on a performance. I don't know if any science backs up the value of writing a journal or a diary. I am glad the rehab center put the idea in my head, and my writing seems to get more positive daily.

MONDAY

I had a crazy idea this morning and thought about it all day at the barn. After writing in my diary on Saturday, I might keep a diary about Annie, my favorite filly yearling. It may seem like every day is the same for her; feed, paddock, dress, two miles on the track, shower, and back to a clean stall. A diary about this beautiful 2-year-old filly could go deeper. Maybe a daily notation of how far and fast she trained, specific notes about those troublesome legs and the treatment she receives, quirks in her personality. I'm thinking about this. If I do it (write), I could write as an observer or as if I AM Annie from inside her brain. Hmmmm. What stops me from writing about Annie is if (when) she is sold, which could be a matter of months. The writing would make my heart break more.

TUESDAY

Working in a horse barn is strange, different than most jobs, and not only because you work with live animals. For the most part, my chores are the same daily, but my interactions with Paul and Bart can radically differ. About half the days, I go into a mental bubble, just me and the horses, period. I can go all day and say 10 words. However, and I don't know why, when I talk with one of the guys, the talk can be, not always, but can be serious-minded.

I am not sure why this is. Because we are addicts? Because the horses are there? Because of our personalities? Because we are broken and tired of BS? A lot of the time, the subject matter in the barn becomes more reflective. It's strange.

WEDNESDAY

Yesterday, I wrote about how sometimes we talk deeper as I work in the church-like quiet of the barn. Today was a good example. It started after I complained about these horses going up for sale in the summer. I would be back to square one, with no job and no horses, and the six months until (if) Paul bought new yearlings was always on my mind. Paul answered with his standard 'One day at a time.' but then he said something unexpected. He has doubts about the future of the entire sport of harness horse racing. He said the next few years could be a brand-new ballgame. He said the loss of gambling revenue and common sense made him think a new future was coming fast, so he was working on one plan to train harness horses for a new world.

My struggle to get out of my drug hole and make a new life is a solo trip. Still, I have plenty of crutches; my mom, the rehab program at the horse training center experience, the NA meetings, the horses in the barn, Paul for a mentor, a lot of structure each day, and this diary in the evening.

THURSDAY

Yikes, what a day! This morning, Paul fractured his hip in a freak accident. A wheel fell off the oldest jog cart, and Paul hit the ground. The accident did not have anything to do with his weight (Paul was bragging a couple of days ago that he was down to 221, never felt healthier, and was looking into surgery to remove excess skin). The fall was not spectacular. I was watching from the barn. He was merely jogging Annie slowly, and it looked like he slid off a desk chair. The EMT people came, and they did

not do anything medically. They were pretty sure he broke his hip, so it was just a matter of stabilizing him and getting him into the ambulance.

Now what? The incapacity of Flying Flag's CEO creates all sorts of issues for the next two in command, one of which is me. As they loaded him into the ambulance, Paul asked me to tell the NA group tonight about the situation. He said that I might need to moderate the NA meeting if Rachel was not there and that he would call Bart and me tonight.

He called me at 11 tonight. I told him that Rachel had led the meeting that night, and everything had gone fine. He told me the x-rays showed he was lucky. His right hip had a hairline fracture. Paul would not need an operation, but he would have pain for a few weeks. His diagnosis put the admitting doctor in a jam. Paul's extensive medical records showed him as a person with a substance use disorder. They both agreed to skip Percocet or other pain medication and lean into Advil. He hopes to be released from the hospital on Saturday afternoon but will have minimal mobility and will not be able to drive his truck, let alone a horse. Paul asked me to check on Edith and paddock the horses tomorrow morning. He said he would call around noon, and we must put on our thinking caps.

What a mess.

Chelsie Odriscoll and harness racing in The Emerald Isle

Ireland is known for its beer, greenery, and yes, horse racing. The sport is intricately linked with Irish culture and society. The racing of horses has a long history and is one of the country's most popular spectator sports that provides its fans with steeple chasing, national hunt, flat and harness racing.



Many of the races were raced on Portmarnock Raceway, a half-mile track that opened in 1969. It was halted when the property was sold for development in 2004 but the races resumed after a sharp recession in the housing market stopped the building of homes. In 2011, the races resumed.

Derek Delaney founded and named a race the Vincent Delaney Memorial (VDM) in memory of his deceased brother, Vincent, which was held every year at Portmarnock drawing thousands of fans.

Many horsemen and women, such as Joe O'Brien, John Menzies, Anthony Haughan, Ian Hanney, Robert Cleary and this month's young superstar Chelsie Odriscoll, have strong connections to Ireland.

It has recently been announced that harness racing pacing champion Tattoo Artist's semen will be available to Irish and British breeders. With a record of 1:47.1 and earnings of \$2,822,098, the handsome stud is bound to father some incredible babies.

Where were you born and how did you get your start in the sport?

"I was born in County Cork, Ireland, and I currently live there. My step-father Derry has always been involved in harness racing, as his father was. They owned and trained horses from the town of Drimoleague Cork and raced around the local grass tracks.

"I became interested in the sport when I was 15 years old. In Ireland you are permitted to race in Monte races before you officially become a driver [the driving age is 16]. So, I raced in Monte races for a year before completing my three driving qualifiers. I usually race around the local grass tracks, such as Lyre and Dunmanway; although I have driven at the U.K. tracks such as York, Tir Prince and grass tracks."

When was your aha moment that you knew you wanted to make harness racing a career?

"It was the time I trained my very first horse Rhyds Dilemma with my dad. I loved it and knew I wanted to keep doing it.

“My ultimate goal is to push harness racing onto a bigger stage in Ireland whether it be racing or breeding. I plan to use what I’ve learned from working in the U.K. with a trainer and Oakwood Stud to one day build my own successful business in harness racing. I love training horses and get a buzz from racing, but I equally love seeing a foal I’ve bred progress to a racehorse.”

“I got bitten by the bug and was so excited by every aspect of the sport. I went on to study Stud Management in Kidalton College for two years and decided to put what I learned into practice.”

What was your most exciting time in the sport so far?

“It was definitely winning my first race in the U.K. with GDs Honey at Appleby Raceway. At the time, I was working with the Gills from Yorkshire and they entered ‘Honey’ into a young drivers race for all the younger drivers coming up through the sport. That drive actually ended up with me winning the Tim Tetrick Drive of the Year Award.”

Presently, how many horses do you have in training?

“My family has six horses in training. They are GDs Honey, Teddy Camden, Ayr Beach, Showtime Notorious, Stateside Lockdown and Emily Rose.”

Do you own any broodmares?

“My broodmare is Stateside Fortune (Armbro Deuce–Panama Canal). She currently has a Sweet Lou colt by her side. This is her first foal and she is back in foal to Foreclosure.”

What woman in harness racing do you admire the most?

“I don’t have one, for I admire ALL women in the sport. I try to follow the local women as well as those in the States. I think it’s important to encourage as many women as possible who are doing what they love.”

What is your goal in the sport?

“My ultimate goal is to push harness racing onto a bigger stage in Ireland whether it be racing or breeding. I plan to use what I’ve learned from working in the U.K. with a trainer and Oakwood Stud to one day build my own successful business in harness racing. I love training horses and get a buzz from racing, but I equally love seeing a foal I’ve bred progress to a racehorse.”

“I’ve also learned a lot through college and work placement in different stud farms as part of this. Through this I worked in two thoroughbred stud farms: Charel Park Stud and Powerstown Stud. I helped foal and helped breaking horses as 2-year-olds, and then going to the sales.”

How is racing in Ireland different than in the States?

“Racing in Ireland is on the up and the competition among horses is getting increasingly more difficult. As far as breeding goes, it’s improving every year with the option of breeding to some world class stallions, such as Sweet Lou and now Tattoo Artist. Also, you see many racehorses are being bought and shipped to America to race, and they all proved to be worthy contenders, such as Oakwood Anabella racing in the prestigious Little Brown Jug.”

“As far as racing, it is the goal of the IHRA [Irish Harness Racing Association] to secure another hard track to continue the development of the sport and allow racing to reach every corner of Ireland.”

NOTE: After two years at Tir Prince Racetrack in Wales, the 2024 edition of the Vincent Delaney Memorial will take place at Wolverhampton Racecourse in the U.K.

At the last minute, I decided to throw up a Hail Mary. I called casino marketing at Caesars Palace and asked what, if anything, they could do for me. They looked up the last time I had played there. It had been about a decade ago. They would comp me for the three nights in the Coliseum Tower. I knew that the Coliseum was the former Forum Tower, which was the least attractive and oldest part of the Caesars resort. But I reasoned I could deal with that if necessary. After all, based on my past history in Vegas, I wouldn't be spending much time in the room anyway. Caesars is great. It's extremely well located right in the middle of the Strip. If there was anything further where I wanted to be, there were always taxis. I felt that I couldn't walk anywhere too far because my back problems will always flare up if I walk anywhere more than the equivalent of a city block.

The day before I left, I found out Garth Brooks was in Vegas performing at Caesars Palace. Brooks may be Carol's favorite performer ever. His song "Friends in Low Places" is without any

doubt her favorite song. I mentioned to Carol that Brooks is in Vegas. "I can still try to get you on the plane tomorrow, if you want," I said to her. She mulled it over for a second and said, "Never mind. I love Garth Brooks, but I hate Las Vegas even more. Just go without me and have a great time."

My flight left JFK early Sunday morning. The plane was full, but it left on time. Five-and-a-half hours later, I landed in Vegas and I hopped in a cab to the hotel. That's when sticker shock set in. The cab fare was \$30. It used to be around \$10.

When I get to the check-in desk, I figured I would try the \$20 trick. I picked this up on the Internet. When you check in, you place a \$20 bill between your ID and your credit card. It's designed to get you an upgrade on your room. You might call it bribery, which of course it is. I figured if \$20 gets an upgrade, \$50 will probably get me more. It works. I ask if I can get a room in the Augustus Tower, Caesars best. I especially want it because the tubs are of the spa variety. After a day of walking and sitting at the tables, a water massage in the tub really hits the spot. The clerk tells me that there is nothing in Augustus

available at the moment, but he will call me when one becomes vacant. Sure enough, an hour or so later, he calls. In the interim, I've been killing time at the blackjack tables. I hold my own – neither winning nor losing much. I get checked into my room.

By then it's past 11 a.m. and since I'm still on east coast time, I'm hungry. I decide to satisfy another Jones. There's an In-N-Out Burger joint across the road and a relatively short distance from Caesars. I say relatively because relative to my back issue, anything more than a slight hop becomes a painful chore. Accompanied by my trusty cane "Bubba Stik," I decide to make the trip. Bubba Stik was purchased at a travel rest area someplace in South Carolina many years ago when my back was still healthy. I bought it on a whim, simply because it looked interesting. To say that through the years it has served me well would be a huge understatement. It's a hardwood cane topped by a heavy brass knob. If I ever had the opportunity to use it on someone, they would know they've been hit. It has traveled all over the world with me for at least a decade. Bubba has been lost on innumerable occasions, fortuitously always turning up. On this trip alone, there were times at the blackjack tables, slot machines, Joe's Stone Crabs and even a Burger King at the airport where I lost it and went back for Bubba and still found him where he had been left.

On to In-N-Out. It was as good as always. They were mobbed. I was order number 146. They were at 67. But they are incredibly efficient. Within 10 minutes, I had my double cheeseburger, no lettuce, well done, animal style with fries and a strawberry shake. It was as good as always. I struggled back to Caesars. My back was aching. I played blackjack with a little three card poker the rest of the day.

My daughter Jennifer was supposed to fly in and have dinner with me and my brother-in-law Bobby Stein at Joe's Stone Crabs, but Jen's plane had engine trouble and she was stranded in Phoenix. "Go ahead and enjoy dinner," she said.

I decide to walk to Joe's, which is not the best idea. Although it's in the same building complex as Caesars, it's still a considerable distance. I managed to get lost several times adding to the distance. Bubba and I finally reach Joe's with me hurting pretty badly. Stein and his friends were already there and we sat down. Dinner was excellent, although their menu was missing the dish I always get when eating at their sister restaurant in Miami, their lobster roll.

One thing about my back condition, it hurts like hell when I stand or walk for any distance. However, when I sit, the pain disappears. Now rested, I decide to walk back to the hotel. I somehow do make it back, but I was in terrible pain. But it didn't stop me from hitting the tables. I lose a little, but not too much. While playing I get a call from Jen. She has made it to Vegas. She is at The Cosmo. "Let's meet for breakfast at my favorite Vegas restaurant Mon Ami Gabi at the Paris," I said. It's about halfway between Caesars and the Cosmopolitan. We meet there

and enjoy a leisurely breakfast enhanced by the great company. I am so happy that we are together. It has been so long since we have done this.

After breakfast, we decide to play some blackjack at Caesars. Jen is an excellent player and plays absolutely by the book. We were up and down, mostly down for me, but I didn't get destroyed. After a few hours, we decide to head back to our rooms to rest. Jen goes back to the Cosmo, but I decide instead to play my favorite slots game Buffalo Chief. We agree to meet at 5 p.m. at Bellagio where we will be eating dinner at Ellis Island. I had seen on YouTube that the restaurant supposedly has the best fish 'n' chips in Vegas, maybe the best anywhere. The fish 'n' chips were as advertised, but the order was far too big. I was presented with four large pieces of excellent battered cod – crispy on the outside and moist on the inside. I managed to get halfway through before saying "No Mas." Walking back to Caesars was out of the question. I was whipped. We took a cab back. We sat down at a blackjack table. I lost, but, fortunately, Jen won. I went to bed and Jen continued playing and did well.

The next morning Jen headed back to Colorado. What to do? Would you believe I walked most of the strip from Caesars all the way to the new Fontainebleu and back. How did I accomplish such a monumental feat? I stopped at each and every casino, first on the west side then on the east. Every time my back hurt, which meant at every casino, I'd sit down at a slot machine or a table, rest up, usually leave a deposit and then continue on my journey. I made it back, but was lightened somewhat in the pocketbook.

That evening I thought I'd treat myself to the Bacchanal buffet at Caesars. The price is \$92 a head. Was it worth that high of a price? If you were a huge eater, maybe. For me, probably not. The choices were enormous. They offered just about anything you might want. I had some lobster claws, a requested very thin slice of prime rib and a small dab of mashed potatoes. The desserts were amazing. They had what seemed like hundreds of mini pastries and crepes prepared to order and some wonderful gelato. The price proved to be inconsequential, since the host who was assigned to me saw to it that the casino picked it up.

I played for about two hours more and lost. I was exhausted and went to bed.

I then woke up at 3 a.m. ready for bear. I had nothing to do, so I played some more to mixed results.

My plane home left on time and we arrived 40 minutes early.

On the flight, I watched three of the greatest movies ever made: American Graffiti, Casablanca and Gigi.

It was a great trip, but I'm glad to be home.

Mistletoe Shalee retitled to memorialize Silverman

The Meadowlands is pleased to announce that with its upcoming 46th edition, the Mistletoe Shalee, a time-honored Grand Circuit stake for 3-year-old pacing fillies, will be renamed to pay tribute to one of racing's most colorful personalities, the late Hall of Fame trainer **Jerry Silverman**.

A native New Yorker, Silverman grew up in the Bronx and was among many of that generation who made his bones by attending the races on the Yonkers/Roosevelt circuit. With no family history in the business, Silverman found a way in and quickly ascended to the top rung of the sport with the modestly priced (\$8,500) yearling Romeo Hanover who was the top 2- and 3-year-old pacer of his class and won 31 of 35 career starts including the 1966 Pacing Triple Crown.

Silverman maintained a large stable of Grand Circuit prospects at The Meadowlands through the glory years of the 1980's into the '90's. He trained horses for the highest profile owners of those years and had a strong presence in the major races for decades.

Among the top horses that raced out of the Silverman barn over his six-decade career were 1990 Woodrow Wilson champ Die Laughing p, 3, 1:51.2 (\$2,164,388), 1982 Meadowlands Pace winner Hilarion and other Grand Circuit stars like Fame p, 2, 1:55.3 (\$502,942), Perfect Union p, 3, 1:49 (\$723,598) and Vintner p, 4, 1:52.1 (\$342,802).

Perhaps his most cherished victory was the 1986 Breeders Crown with the free-legged 3YO colt pacer Masquerade who was driven by his son Richie at a mere 22 years of age.

The choice of a filly pacing stake seems apropos as Jerry had quite a way with the ladies and developed some of the sport's finest. Among the exceptional females that bore the Silverman banner were Breeders Crown winner Glowing Report, p, 5, 1:49.2 (\$2,095,144), world champion Hit Parade p, 2, 1:53.4, Must See p, 2, 1:52, Summer Child p, 2, 1:54.2 and the iron-tough Saccharum p, 4, 1:53.3.

Jerry's girls also produced at a high level. Must See is the dam of 2009 Pacer of the Year Well Said p, 3, 1:47.3 (\$2.6 million)

and prolific producer Rodine Hanover p, 2, 1:54 shows up in the pedigree of many current champions.

On the topic of bloodlines, Jerry's son Richie enjoyed an accomplished career as a driver, winning over \$30 million and nearly 2000 races, including many Grand Circuit stakes.

The **past winners** of the stake now known as the Jerry Silverman Memorial include such all-time greats as Three Diamonds, Miss Easy, She's A Great Lady, Bunny Lake, Kissin In The Sand, and who can forget last season's thriller won by Sylvia Hanover.

The 2024 Jerry Silverman Memorial is scheduled for "The Biggest Party in Harness Racing" on **Meadowlands Pace** night, July 13.

Warrawee Yang completes John Brennan Trotting Series sweep

Warrawee Yang finished off a sweep of this year's edition of the John Brennan Trotting Series at MGM Yonkers Raceway by winning Thursday night's (May 2) \$78,000 final in 1:55.2. This was Warrawee Yang's eighth consecutive victory overall. Starting from post 6 and dispatched as the 4-5 favorite, Warrawee Yang showed speed for driver Yannick Gingras and worked up two-wide to take the top spot away from Tachyon (Jason Bartlett) right at the :28.1 opening quarter. Gingras then slammed on the brakes in the second quarter to reach the half in just :58.1, giving Warrawee Yang plenty left in the tank to rebuff a first-over bid by Resolve To Win (Tyler Buter) to the 1:26.4 three-quarters and around the final bend. Resolve To Win faded late on the far turn, which gave Bartlett space to tip Tachyon to the outside for the stretch drive. He did gain some ground to the wire, but it wasn't enough, as Warrawee Yang scored by a comfortable length and a quarter. By The Book (Jay Randall) came in third, followed by Resolve To Win and Ferretti (Matt Kakaley). A 4-year-old son of Trixton, Warrawee Yang was sent out by trainer Ron Burke for owners Burke Racing Stable LLC. and Weaver Brusceci LLC. He is a 16-time winner in his career, has pocketed \$207,926 and paid \$3.90 to win. The exacta was \$11.80 and the trifecta kicked back \$35.60. Gingras and Burke also won the \$35,000 series consolation No. 1 with 1-5 choice **Sea Can** in 1:54.4. Sea Can made a first-over move out of the fourth spot heading to the :57.3 half, advanced uncovered toward leader Immanuel K S (Bartlett), and then forged his way past him after the 1:25.3 three-quarters. Sea Can was able to clear and slide back down to the pylons on the last turn, and he sailed to the wire from there to prevail by 2¾ lengths over Mohatu As (Kakaley), with Cassius Hanover (Pat Lachance) back in third. Also owned by Burke Racing Stable LLC. and Weaver Brusceci LLC., Sea Can is a 5-year-old Muscle Mass

gelding. He has a summary of 13-11-3 from 50 trips behind the gate, has earned \$223,649 and returned \$2.60 to win. He was atop a \$15 exacta and a \$73.50 trifecta. **Coventry Hall** (Bartlett) was a 1:56.2 victor in the \$25,000 series consolation No. 2. He was able to get to the point from post 7 without much difficulty and clicked off fractions of :28.1, :58.1 and 1:26.3. Cal Miles N Shell (Jim Marohn, Jr.) angled out of the pocket as they raced off the last turn and had dead-aim at Coventry Hall through the lane, but his rally came up a half-length short. Black Tie Bash (Lachance) moved from sixth to third in the final quarter. Per Engblom trains Coventry Hall, a 7-year-old gelded son of Cash Hall, for owner Enghavegaard Aalborg Aps. He made his eighth appearance in the winner's circle, has banked \$188,518 and paid \$8.10 to win as the 3-1 third choice. He keyed a \$60.50 exacta and a \$186.50 trifecta. The John Brennan Trotting Series is named in honor of the longtime SOA of NY horsemen's representative who passed away from complications of COVID-19 in March 2020. The series was for 3-year-olds and older who were non-winners of six pari-mutuel races or \$200,000 through Feb. 1, 2024, with winners over \$250,000 as of that date not eligible. MGM Yonkers Raceway is currently operating on a Monday-Tuesday-Thursday-Friday-Saturday live racing schedule with post time each night at 7 p.m. (EDT).

Fillies rock in SBOA eliminations

Ontario sired 3-year-old fillies were the headliners on Friday (May 3) at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

A quartet of SBOA Stakes eliminations, two for pacing fillies and two for trotting fillies, were contested on a wet evening at the Campbellville oval.

Pass Line (\$2.90) kicked off her 3-year-old season with a strong 1:51.1 victory in the first \$25,000 Filly Pace elimination.

Lots of early speed and action up front allowed James MacDonald to move Pass Line out from fifth at the half, riding up into a second-over spot and powering home to win by three-quarters of a length.

Lightning Lizzie moved to the lead in the second-quarter, faced pressured to three-quarters and battled gamely to finish second. Betterwithglasses was third, while Ann was fourth. Bettor Sisters was fifth to advance to next week's final.

A daughter of All Bets Off, Pass Line turned heads throughout her rookie campaign, winning 10 of 13 and earning over \$680,000. Trained in Canada by Dave Menary for conditioner Ron Burke, Pass Line won multiple Grand Circuit events last season and finished second in the Breeders Crown.

Pass Line is owned by Burke Racing Stable, Weaver Brusceci, Frank Baldachino and Rich Lombardo Racing.

Sorcha Seelster (\$26.80) turned in a gritty 1:51.1 upset victory, edging strong closers Its A Love Thing and Coco Jo Jo to win the second Filly Pace elimination.

Driver Bob McClure angled out Sorcha Seelster from fifth at the half and the pair advanced up just one spot while uncovered on the turn. In the stretch, Sorcha Seelster motored down the center of the track to win by a length.

Race-favorite Its A Love Thing was a third-over seventh turning for home, pacing a strong final-quarter with Coco Jo Jo to just miss. Odds On Platinum and Blazing Belle completed the top-five.

The lightly raced Sorcha Seelster entered Friday with one win from four career starts. The John Pentland trained daughter of All Bets Off made just two starts last season and has never missed the top-three. She is owned by R C Molyneux Racing, Pentland, Peter Charlton and Archie Leach.

The SBOA Filly Pace final goes next Saturday (May 11) for a purse of \$141,500.

O'Brien Award winner **Willys Home Run** (\$2.60) unleashed a wicked :26.3 final quarter, rallying impressively from sixth to take the first \$25,000 Filly Trot elimination. James MacDonald steered the Kyle Fellows trainee to the season debut victory, stopping the clock in 1:56.1 and winning by 3 lengths.

Radical Legacy edged Sue Anne for second. Billie Jean Queen, who led the field into the stretch, was fourth, while P L Rainbow Dash was fifth to land a spot in next week's final.

A daughter of Archangel, Willys Home Run won six of 10 starts and earned over \$520,000 in a superb 2-year-old season. She capped off the campaign by winning the OSS Super Final.

Willys Home Run is owned by Dr. Sara Gatchell, Jake and Reg Higgs and Yolanda Fellows.

With the public's top two choices making breaks, **R Liza** (\$19.20) capitalized to take the second Filly Trot elimination in 1:55.4. Jody Jamieson sat third with the Susie Kerwood trainee until near the three-quarter pole, moving out and powering home in :27.2 to win by 2¾ lengths.

Favorite Valuable Miss made a break just after the start, while second choice Lexus Angel jumped it off coming out of the first turn. Love Those Legs, who did the road work, would cross the wire second. No Need For Alarm, Evolving and Flirty Dancer rounded out the top five finishers.

An OSS Gold winner at 2, R Liza was making her season debut on Friday after a four-for-eight, \$110,000 rookie campaign. The daughter of Muscle Mass is owned by M And L of Delaware LLC and Alabama Harness Associate.

The SBOA Filly Trot final will go for a purse of \$137,500.

In the first of six divisions for the sophomore pacers, Smith raced **Rock The Hill** off the gate and the son of Racing Hill never looked back, cruising to an easy 6-length victory in 1:51.3. Rock The Hill won for the first time in three starts, setting a new lifetime mark, shaving nearly three seconds off his old mark. Jessica Roegner trains and co-owns Rock The Hill with Paul O'Neil.

Smith's second win of the card came in the second division as **Wireless Caller** rallied down the stretch to nip favorite High On The Hill at the wire in 1:54. It was the second win in 10 starts this year for the Bullville Powerful colt. Wireless Caller is trained by William Miller II and owned by Trevor Miller.

The third division went to **Threemargaritashot**. Threemargaritashot and Aaron Merriman stalked the leader Jonnys Sea Drop around the final turn and raced down the lane to win by a length in 1:52.1. Trained by Randy Smith and owned by Jessica Smith it was the first win of the year for the Pet Rock gelding.

What An Ocean View with Chris Page grabbed the lead in the fourth division at the three-quarter pole and held on to win by a length in 1:53.3. It was the first win of the year for the Downbytheseaside gelding which is trained by Ron Burke and owned by Burke Racing Stable, Knox Services, RAS Racing, and J&T Siva-Purnell Libby.

In the fifth division, Side Bar had the lead at the top of the stretch, but **Dancin Moon** and Jeremy Smith shot down the passing to take command on the way to winning by a length in 1:53.2. Trained by Herman Hagerman it was the first win of the year for the son of Dancin Yankee. Dancin Moon is owned by Hagerman Racing, Charles Reeve, and Melinda Hershberger.

The final division went to **Attention Span** and Brady Galliers. Attention Span fired from the eighth post position grabbing the lead and never looking back, winning by a length in 1:54.1. It was the first win of the year for the Downbytheseaside gelding. Galliers trains Attention Span for Galliers Racing and David Kryway.

There were also six divisions for the 3-year-old trotters.

What A Dandy and Sam Widger charged down the stretch splitting horses to win the first division by a length in 1:56.4. It was the first start of the year for the son of What The Hill and his first career win. What A Dandy is trained by Jim Arledge, Jr. and owned by Jude Jacobs, Paul Phillips, Greg Buckey, and William Buckey.

In the second division, **Beueastel** and Peter Wrenn took the pocket trip and reeled in the leader No Nap Nash down the stretch to win by a length in 1:54.3. It was the first start of the season for the What The Hill gelding who is trained by Melanie Wrenn and owned by Wrenn Racing.

Sup, the 5-2 favorite, with Kurt Sugg fought off a challenge from Rankin up the backstretch and pulled away to win the third division by 3 lengths in 1:56.2. It was the second win in six starts for the son of What The Hill. Matthew Burkholder trains and co-owns Sup with Samuel Weaver.

The fourth division went to **Chipstead** and Chris Lems. Chipstead sat fourth around the final turn and went three wide down the stretch catching Swan Hilluva Rush at the wire, winning by a neck in 1:57.4. It was the first win in eight starts this year for the son of Volstead. Chipstead is trained and owned by Scott Cox.

In the fifth division, Tyler Smith and 8-5 favorite **You Don't Fool Me** were parked for the second half of the race but grabbed the lead at the top of the stretch and held on to win by a length in 1:57. Don't Fool Me has hit the board in both starts finishing first and second. Rosy Weaver trains and co-owns the Long Tom gelding with Heartland Acres.

In the final division for the 3-year-old trotters, **Tom Swifty** showed why he was the 3-5 favorite in the sixth division. Dan Noble raced the son of Long Tom up the backstretch to grab the lead and pull away to win by 5 lengths in 1:56.2 for his first win of the year. Tom Swifty is owned by Sandra Burnett and trained by Christi Noble.

Gingras wins five; Otten hits big Pick-4 at Big M

Yannick Gingras had the touch Friday night (May 3) at The Meadowlands, becoming just the third driver during 2024 to win five races on a Big M card.

Gingras' night gets more impressive when you consider that he was ineligible to drive in three of the 14 dashes, with those events restricted to members of the Meadowlands Amateur Driving Club.

Not surprisingly, three of the winners came with horses trained by Ron Burke, who uses Gingras as his go-to pilot.

"The Green Hornet" got win No. 1 with the Burke-trained 3-year-old gelding trotter **Wellington Hanover** (International Moni—Wishful Me) in the second race, returning \$6.80 as the 2-1 second choice in the dash for non-winners of two in a lifetime-best 1:54.2.

Spy Coast (Walner—Zeppole) went coast-to-coast for Burke in the sixth race, a non-winners of two for 3-year-old filly trotters. She won for the first time in her career in 12 tries, stopping the clock in 1:53.2, and paid \$5.40 as the 8-5 public choice.

Corsini A, a 10-year-old daughter of Sportswriter—Upton, took an inside route late to win the seventh race and pay \$7.60 as the 5-2 third choice in a fillies and mares TrackMaster 76.5 pace. The Jeffrey Smith trainee, making her 151st career start, lowered her previous lifetime best by one-and-one-fifth seconds after stopping the clock in 1:53.2.

Burke and Gingras struck once more in the 10th race, a mid-range conditioned trot, with the 7-year-old gelding **Yanks Dugout** (Triumphant Caviar—Yansky), who used his back class to register an easy win in 1:52.4. The 3-5 favorite paid \$3.20 to win.

The drive for five came to fruition in the 14th race, as **Massive Matter**, a 6-year-old gelded son of Explosive Matter—Stick Of Butter, went wire-to-wire in 1:54.1, a lifetime best which came in the Donald Maiorano trainee's 104th career start in a low-end conditioned trot. The win payout was \$8.80 for the 3-1 third choice.

Previously, the only drivers to record five wins on a card this year were Jason Bartlett (on Jan. 19) and Andy McCarthy (Feb. 24).

OTTEN SPOTS HUGE PICK-4: It was another tough night for most handicappers Friday night, but not for Jessica Otten.

Big M TV's Otten gave out the Early 50-cent Pick-4 that paid a whopping \$1,961.20.

Playing a 50-cent ticket using a 2x3x3x4 configuration, Otten had 12-1 chance **Crown Monarch** in the eighth race, and then for good measure, picked her first winner of the night, **Sand**

Sniper, in the ninth who paid \$16.40 to complete her huge hit. Her followers made a profit on the play of \$1,925.20 after deducting a \$36 investment.

Otten came close to what's believed to be the all-time high on-set Pick-4 hit, which was \$2,000, set by Dave Brower several years ago.

A LITTLE MORE: It was a big night at the windows, as all-source wagering on the program totaled \$3,450,418, the second-most prolific Friday night during 2024 and the 28th time from 34 race cards this year where betting bettered the \$3-million mark. The 20-cent Pick-6 went unhit, creating a carryover of \$4,222. Those with five correct selections cashed in for \$1,407.76.
