# Oak Grove's Festival of Racing could serve as a launching pad to bigger things

The racing world is two weeks removed from the thrilling 152nd running of the Kentucky Derby, the pinnacle of thoroughbred racing. This weekend, at the Churchill Downs Incorporated-led Oak Grove Racing & Gaming, officials look to begin a new harness racing tradition in the Bluegrass State. Saturday (May 16), the track will play host to the inaugural \$500,000 Oak Grove Trotting Derby and \$300,000 Oak Grove Trotting Oaks, stakes that the Kentucky Harness Association's Kenny Jackson hopes will develop into key events on the racing calendar.

"We are tremendously pleased," Jackson said. "We had 101 nominations between the colts and the fillies. So, in this first year, we're incredibly excited. The entries into the eliminations were fantastic. With the colts and fillies, there were 48 horses, so the support is incredible. From what we're seeing right now and from what we're hearing, there's a real buzz."

The two stakes anchor the track's Festival of Racing, which culminates in a day that will feature an 11-race program, the Preakness Stakes simulcast, and capped with a concert by country music artist Jake Owen. Oak Grove's program features \$1.5 million in purses, with the two featured events complemented by a quartet of \$100,000 Kentucky Sire Stakes finals, Oaks and Derby consolations and a pair of \$50,000 4-year-old open

events. The facility, located an hour from Nashville, has come a long way since first opening in October 2019.

“When Oak Grove started in year one, we started with 16 racing days and I think our purses were, at that time, \$600,000,” Jackson said. “By the end of this season, including sire stakes, overnights, and stakes, we’ll probably push over \$11 million in purses. The reason behind the growth and success and creating this niche is tremendous support from the entire Churchill Downs team from top to bottom, in management and even on the execution team on the local level. I’d say the other thing that’s made it work and be a great experience for everybody involved is that everyone is rowing the boat in the right direction. We keep a positive attitude towards growth and realize that everything can’t be perfect overnight, but with time we can achieve the goals we want to achieve.”

Partnering with CDI, a team that knows how to put on big events, and with the benefit of revenue from historical horse racing machines, Jackson’s goal is to build upon the inaugural Festival of Racing. He is drawing upon his experiences in the standardbred and thoroughbred industries; as a co-owner of Kentuckiana Farms, and owner and breeder campaigning horses in both breeds. Taking cues from the Road to the Kentucky Derby and Breeders’ Cup World Championships, he would like to see Oak Grove’s events become graded, premier events that lead into the Hambletonian.

“From the racing perspective, it becomes one of the top signature events in our industry,” he said of his vision for the Trotting

Derby. "It kicks off the racing schedule each year for 3-year-old trotters. It's recognized for what we hope it is becoming rapidly as truly one of the elite prep races for the Hambletonian, and that the experience that people have at the event will be shared, and give us the opportunity to use those people as ambassadors to help us grow it in future years."

Attract racing fans and provide a first-class experience. Attract top racing talent – horses and their connections – by offering lucrative purses early on the calendar where few opportunities currently exist. It is a recipe stakeholders believe will lead to success. And if Oak Grove is viewed as a key stop on the path to the Hambletonian, it would be to everyone's benefit.

"When Churchill Downs created the Road to the Kentucky Derby, handle grew exponentially not only at their track," Jackson said. "I mean it was just huge growth, but all the tracks that were fortunate enough to have a race as part of that road, you see their handle go up on those days that those stakes are being raced."

While the inaugural card has yet to be contested, interest is already high for future editions. This year's stakes were seeded with a combination of 22 champion 2-year-olds from select open stakes and regional sire stakes winners through a "Win and You're In" format, as well as nominated trotters that did not automatically gain entry though a victory in the aforementioned events.

For the 2027 events, 2-year-olds could be made eligible for \$250 by the March 15 deadline. Failing to make a horse eligible by the deadline will result in a \$2,500 supplemental payment next year to go along with the \$500 nominating and \$500 sustaining fees. Jackson was blown away by the interest the Derby and Oaks generated.

“The number of 2-year-olds that made that nomination for 2027 participation so far exceeded anybody’s expectations,” he said. “It’s really exciting. I haven’t shared it publicly, but the number is over 550. It’s a massive number.”

Another massive number, and a target for operators, is the growing Nashville metropolitan area: over 1.3 million inhabitants as of 2023. It is one of the fastest growing metro areas in the United States, and one lacking a strong harness racing presence.

“We have an incredible opportunity to introduce harness racing to Western Kentucky and Nashville,” Jackson said. “It’s got a huge love for the horse and we’re an hour away, so part of the long game is to create a signature event that you can go promote

to new people that may not even know what harness racing is and probably don’t. Last Saturday alone they had 35,000 people at the steeplechase and we’re working closely with the management team that has put on the steeplechase for the last 20 plus years and we’re excited to build a relationship with a huge audience of people and professionals and horse lovers, to introduce them to the performance racing side of our game.”

Saturday’s Festival of Racing is a big step forward for Oak Grove Racing & Casino. It could serve as a launching pad to much bigger things. And, for the sake of our industry, let’s hope that it does.

# Burke Brigade bragging rights on the line in Saturday's Cutler

They say there is no "I" in "Team," but harness racing is not a team sport, so when it comes to Saturday's Arthur J. Cutler Memorial at The Meadowlands, Burke Brigade caretakers Joseph "Jo Jo" Tosies and Alex Peralta will be battling it out for bragging rights.

Technically, Peralta and Tosies won't be the ones coming to blows, instead they'll let their charges, Chapercraz and Lexus Kody, do the fighting for them.

"It's a really tough field with nice horses," Peralta said. "I want to win, he [Tosies] wants to win, we all want to win."

On paper, reigning Dan Patch Trotter of the Year Lexus Kody and Fair Island Farm Caretaker of the Year Tosies have the edge as the 3-1 morning-line favorites from post 8 in the field of nine 4-and-up open trotters.

"So, you'd rather draw better, but it is what it is," Tosies said. "It's basically his first stakes start [this year], and he's a good

enough horse where he should be able to overcome it and I just want to see him race well, and then just keep moving forward. I mean, hopefully we'll win, but I just want to see him race well, come out of it safe, and just keep his confidence intact and keep going forward."

On May 2, in his first start of the season, Lexus Kody finished second to stablemate Antognoni S, also one of Peralta’s charges.

“We have a nice friendly rivalry,” Tosies said of Peralta. “Matter of fact, after that race, he was afraid to tease me.”

Tosies wasn’t the only one unhappy with the loss.

“When he got beat, he was actually mad... he pinned his ears [after the race in the paddock],” Tosies said of the 8-year-old gelded son of Archangel—Lexus Helios. “He didn’t like to get beat. That’s the one aspect of him that I really liked the last couple years, his desire, because there have been times he wasn’t at his best, and he still managed to gut it out.”

Like Lexus Kody, Chapercraz, who Peralta lovingly refers to as “my old man” also finished second in his last start.

The 6-year-old gelded son of Crazy Wow—Chaperess is 12-1 from post 2 in the Cutler and will be driven by the red-hot Joe Bongiorno.

“You can put him in any kind of spot you want,” Peralta said of Chapercraz. “He’s got the speed to get to the front, and he loves to fight, he loves to pass horses, and he can win, too.”

Tosies said that “Kody” may have still been a little under the weather heading into his last start, but that he’s good to go now.

“He needed that start, and he got beat by a good horse,” Tosies said, adding with a laugh, “Unfortunately, Ronnie was right.”

Burke was quoted earlier this season saying that he thought Antognoni S might be better than Lexus Kody.

“All kidding aside, that’s a real good horse that beat him,” Tosies said. “So, yeah, he’s doing great. Matter of fact, Tuesday [May 12], coming in from the field, he was up in the air and just acting like his old self.”

“We’ve just got to pray for a nice, clean trip, and we should be all right.”

At the end of the day, if Lexus Kody doesn’t win, Tosies wants the victory to go to Chapercraz, Peralta, and the Burke Brigade.

“It’s a team,” Tosies said. “There are no individuals.”

“The sport, you know, it’s supposed to be fun. And that’s why I still do it, because I love horses. We have fun in our barn. Me and Alex, we jab at each other back and forth all the time.”

Tosies said he has nothing but respect for Peralta, the senior member of the Burkes’ caretaking staff.

“We joke around that he’s like Ronnie’s son because he’s been working for them for so long,” Tosies said.

Peralta said he couldn’t have chosen a better group to work for.

“I started with Mickey [Burke], Sr. when he only had like eight horses in Jersey,” Peralta said. “I have over 20 years with them. I’m happy with the people that are around. I’m happy with my boss. I’m happy with the kind of horses that I’m taking care of, and that’s cool.”

As for his rivalry with Tosies, Peralta was very matter of fact.

“We do what we can, we try to do the best, and we love to win, and that’s the best part,” Peralta said.

Lexus Kody will have Yannick Gingras back in the bike for the Cutler. Gingras had to drive Antognoni S on May 2 against Kody, because he is a co-owner of the 6-year-old gelded son of Father Patrick—Bouncing Bax. Antognoni S is not eligible to the Cutler.

“It’s going to be interesting, but Kody’s got enough speed where he should be able to keep himself out of trouble,” Tosies said. “But as far as him and his attitude and soundness, he couldn’t be doing any better.”

# Richard Moreau appeal hearing to continue

Late last week, the Ontario Horse Racing Appeal Panel (HRAP) issued its ruling on whether the ongoing case of suspended trainer Richard Moreau would continue or come to a conclusion on procedural grounds about testing. An “interim decision” dated April 22, 2026 noted that regardless of issues raised about the collection and handling of blood samples from Funtime Bayama, a confirmatory lab had established the presence of DPO (darbepoetin-alfa) in the gelding’s plasma. The Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) prohibits use of DPO in racehorses because it is a long-acting, synthetic performance-enhancer that can permanently damage the animals’ red blood cell production.

The **appeal hearing had come to a pause** on March 20, 2026 as the HRAP took time to weigh the evidence and arguments.

Counsel for the Defense Jean-Marc MacKenzie had raised serious concerns about breaches to Moreau’s anonymity and the sample’s integrity due to chain of custody and handling issues.

“Livelihood is at stake; standards must be met,” he said in his March 20 closing arguments. “There needs to be a framework, not just with the testing, but in the forensic part of it. This is very much a penal proceeding Mr. Moreau is facing. He’s already faced 605 days, a serious monetary fine, and suspension.”

MacKenzie said that because test results provided by LGC Laboratories were “insufficiently reliable” and “prejudicial to the proceedings,” they should be excluded from consideration.

“If we allow what happened here, this panel is signaling a double standard: The CPMA [Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency] will apply one standard and the AGCO, when it decides to spend its own money, can apply a different standard, [a] lower standard... This cannot be in the best interest of the industry.”

MacKenzie compared the case to an incomplete “home run” in baseball. While describing the logic as “novel and fascinating” in their decision, HRAP Chair Stanley Sadinsky and members Dr. John Hayes and Nicolle Pace ultimately disagreed with his explanation.

“[I]n our view, this analogy does not carry over to the circumstances of this case,” the HRAP ruling, dated April 22, stated. “In baseball if a home run is hit and the batter while

rounding the bases does not touch one of the bases or home plate, a baseball rule provides that the batter is out and the home run does not count. There is no such rule that applies in horse racing to the testing procedures or the chain of custody of a sample on its way to being tested. The panel based its decision on LGC lab’s Certificate of Positive Analysis declaring that Funtime Bayama’s blood sample “did contain synthetic DPO.” The Moreau appeal hearing will continue at a future date to be set by the HRAP secretary and the parties involved.

On March 20, Brendan van Niejenhuis, Counsel for the Registrar, had stated that Moreau's case did not meet the Supreme Court of Canada's standard for "an abuse of process." He concluded that MacKenzie's argument "seemed to be pointing more in the style of a 'reasonable doubt' case," rather than indicating "practically beyond the shadow of a doubt that the matters speculated about did not occur."

Van Niejenhuis disagreed with the argument that Funtime Bayama's blood samples may have degraded due to documented irregularities in its handing enroute to confirmatory testing in Fordham, UK.

"With respect to hemolysis, no witness testified that sample hemolysis was a concern here," he stated. "All of them were asked. They all agreed it was irrelevant to the confirmatory process."

The Counsel for the Registrar also questioned whether there was any evidence of tampering.

"Is it more likely than not that this is the blood that was drawn from Funtime Bayama, that it wasn't tampered with by the adding of DPO to it during transit, while it was with the courier or by one of the witnesses who told [the HRAP] what they did with it, and that it reached [confirmatory lab] LGC's SCIEX 7500 [mass spectrometer] machine in just that same form?" he asked.

Van Niejenhuis noted that the differences between CPMA and AGCO protocol cited by MacKenzie were not deficiencies but "intended to serve as a proxy for proof by witness" in cases where witnesses did not appear.

Van Niejenhuis' concluding arguments on March 20 noted the recent discovery of additional, untested samples taken from Funtime Bayama back on June 10, 2024.

"The Registrar, like [MacKenzie] would love not to have been learning that there were three more vials of blood shortly before the [Moreau] hearing began in December [2025]," he said. "That having been said, it makes no difference.

"There were months of correspondence, through the pre-hearing conference process with [MacKenzie] and [counsel for Sylvain Filion] Ms. [Jennifer] Friedman in the related case, offering the remaining sample residue that was then known to be retested or to be sent to an independent lab for retesting.

"That opportunity was not taken, and of course that cannot be held against Mr. Moreau in any way, but you may take it into account in assessing the submission about whatever [MacKenzie] is trying to throw on the process as a result of the late discovery that there are three more full vials of blood sitting in BV Labs in Vancouver. There have been three months since then. No effort has been made to do anything with that blood that would ground the speculation that you've heard today in some concrete evidence."

Funtime Bayama (p, 3, 1:49.1s; \$394,999) originally raced for owner/breeder Bayama Farms of Saint-Andre-D'Argenteuil, QC, the farm of Yves Filion, father of the gelding's original driver Sylvain Filion. Like Moreau, **Sylvain is currently awaiting a date for an HRAP hearing.** Filion's application for a stay was denied on March 19, 2025.

Since leaving the Moreau stable in June 2024, Funtime Bayama has raced for owners William Pollock and Bruce Areman of Freehold, NJ and owner/trainer Andrew Harris of Allentown, NJ. (As of April 28, 2026, his ownership group is registered as the Punisher 11 Stable LLC of Freehold, NJ.) Now 5 years old, the pacer found vindication at Woodbine Mohawk Park, his one-time home track, when he won the Canadian-Sired Graduate Series final on May 3, 2025.

Although DPO can cause irreparable harm to a horse, Funtime Bayama has gradually found his way back to the winner's circle, most recently at Oak Grove on April 4. He finished second on Sunday (May 10) in a class drop from the Oak Grove open handicap pace.

### Diva Ek unstoppable in the Finlandia-Ajo

**Diva Ek**, trained by Alessandro Gocciadoro, did not appear to have the ideal setup beforehand when the \$200,000 Finlandia-Ajo was contested at Vermo Racetrack on Sunday (May 10), but despite racing near the back for most of the mile, she still emerged victorious when the dust settled.

Magnus A. Djuse sent Mellby Knekt, trained by Timo Nurmos, to the lead shortly after the start, while Örjan Kihlström initially landed first-over with Keep Asking (Chapter Seven) before yielding to Diamond Truppo after 400 meters.

Approaching the final half-mile, Keep Asking launched his attack, with Massimo Hoist tracking the move. One lane farther back, Gocciadoro grew impatient behind Diva Ek (Trixtion–Nike Ek) and boldly fanned four-wide midway through the final turn.

Mellby Knekt was spent with 200 meters remaining, and Keep Asking appeared to have the race under control at the top of the stretch. Then Diva Ek came flying widest of all with tremendous momentum. Over the final 100 meters at Vermo she wore down Keep Asking in a stirring duel and surged past to win in 1:53 flat.

Keep Asking was second in the same time, while Gio Cash (Victor Gio), who had been buried fifth-over before launching a sweeping late move, finished third – also in 1:53. Gio Cash closed ferociously, but unfortunately for both him and Keep Asking, only the winner earned the coveted berth into Elitloppet.

“I’m so happy – now she’s in the race,” said Gocciadoro, naturally referring to Elitloppet invitation. “Why shouldn’t she be able to win the Elitloppet? Sure, she’ll need some racing luck, but now she’s in the field.”

### BORUPS VICTORY HANDLES WEAKENED E-SERIES FIELD

The fifth E-series qualifier toward Elitloppet was held at Solvalla on Wednesday (May 13), but the field had lost much of its shine after Don Fanucci Zet was scratched earlier in the evening.

Trainer Daniel Redén withdrew the 10-year-old due to track conditions, and with the son of Hard Livin already guaranteed a place in Elitloppet – while also leading the E-series standings beyond reach – the scratch carried no consequences for his qualification hopes.

Still, the race became somewhat anticlimactic and appeared tailor-made for the already invited **Borups Victory** (Googoo Gaagaa), trained and driven by Daniel Wäjersten.

Borups Victory raced with what was essentially a training setup and was far from peak condition, yet still managed to grind down a brave Hades de Vandel (Ganymede), who had done the heavy lifting first-over throughout. Borups Victory stopped the timer in 1:52.4, finishing with a blistering final half-mile in :54.2.

### ELITLOPPET PICTURE CONTINUES TO TAKE SHAPE

Dream Mine (Maharajah), trained by Jörgen Westholm, received an Elitloppet invitation on Saturday (May 9), while Diva Ek punched her ticket via the Finlandia-Ajo. Don Fanucci Zet is already safely qualified, and now only two E-series races remain before the final participant is determined. Before then, however, Solvalla still has more invitations to distribute. Three additional wild cards remain, along with the final E-series qualifier behind Don Fanucci Zet.

## GOCCIADORO STRIKES TWICE IN ITALY

Within the span of 15 minutes, Alessandro Gocciadoro added two more Group-level victories to his résumé. At Modena Racetrack Sunday (May 10), **Ideal Turdance** captured the \$190,000 Gran Premio Tito Giovanardi.

Driven by Antonio di Nardo, Ideal Turdance (El Ideal–Chimera Jet) was unable to protect the rail but settled into the pocket behind leader Il Trio Jet. By the final backstretch the race had become a two-horse affair, and Di Nardo waited until 200 meters from home before angling Ideal Turdance off the rail. In a sharp finish, the son of El Ideal powered past Il Trio Jet (Wishing Stone) to score in 1:57.2 over 2,080 meters.

The victory was the sixth straight for Ideal Turdance, whose résumé already includes the Group III Gran Premio Italia.

Shortly afterward, Gocciadoro and Di Nardo teamed up again as **Ingrid Am** (El Ideal–Connemara As) captured the \$75,000 Gran Premio Carlo Cacciari for 3-year-old fillies.

Racing first-over throughout, Ingrid Am pulled clear in the stretch to win by approximately 1½ lengths in a new stakes record of 1:56 flat, shaving one-tenth off the previous mark. Irma Ferm (The Bank) chased gamely from the outside but had to settle for second in the Group II event.

# Yonkers series finals bolsters the case for added distance races

Coming as a newer development to many, last Friday's (May 8) MGM Borgata Pacing Series and MGM Ursula McIntyre Series finals were raced at the added distance of 1¼ miles. The change in distance deviated from all preliminary legs throughout both series which were held at the traditional one mile, as has been the case with the two series finals historically.

A growing — and, in my opinion, positive — trend at Yonkers has been to include more added distance races, particularly for series finals. Though this was the first time the Borgata and

Ursula McIntyre were held at 1¼ miles, the track has thrown in the extra quarter-of-a-mile in different races throughout the year.

For the larger 10-horse fields such as the Yonkers International, the Aria Invitational Pace and the Bob Miecuna Invitational Trot the 1¼ distance has become the go to. Even with the normal eight-horse fields as were the series finals last Friday, Yonkers has dabbled with going 1¼ miles there in the past also. Last year's John Brennan trotting series final was raced at the added distance, although this year's Brennan final was back at one mile.

If the case for added distance races sounds familiar, [I spoke about the distance topic in this eloquently written January 2024 column here](#). Many of the points made in that column are even more so applicable now, and it's even more relevant as not only Yonkers but also tracks like The Meadowlands are continuing to stage certain graded stakes races at distances of more than one mile.

It can't be said for sure if the extra quarter mile in last Friday's Ursula McIntyre final is solely what did in the 1-9 favored Louies Girl N who never really looked the part of her favoritism much throughout the latter part of the race, but one thing for sure is that the distance did make it more difficult for her to last. In the end, the race was won by the

surging 25-1 longshot Tarapasta in what turned out to be an exciting finish and a relatively exciting race.

The extra quarter-of-a-mile wasn't an issue for Borgata champion Captain Albano, but then again after making the lead past an opening quarter of :28.4 he could have gone four miles and it might not have mattered. But the extra distance perhaps did allow time for Huntinthelastdolar to mount a late charge of his own, go from fifth to second and was narrowing the gap late.

To put it most simply, what it comes down to is this: the breed has outgrown and outlasted the traditional one-mile standard. Adding an extra quarter mile is the best and most efficient way to counteract it.

A one-mile distance made sense 100 years ago when horses were trotting in 2:20, and it was even fine up until the 2:00 barrier was a thing. But when you have \$6,000 claimers today going through fractions of :26 and :54 and going wire-to-wire easily – it seems like something has gone wrong. Added distance races would introduce more skill and strategy, moving beyond one-dimensional speed as the primary driver as to how races are run and won.

Golf comes to mind as another sport with a similar problem. Just like in harness racing with modern equipment and other modernizations, the distances of golf courses too, are too short to contain the modern advancements in that sport for the elite athletes. But unlike golf where it's not so easy to begin reconstructing courses, you could simply have horses in harness racing go one more turn around the track, and it all works out.

It doesn't have to be a sudden change where every race is now at a different distance and it throws havoc into the way standardbreds are raced and bred, but rather continuing to have more selected races at an extra distance of at least a quarter mile. Doing so makes the races unique compared to how

almost all other races are run, but it could also provide greater importance for the winner of those races.

Allow me one more comparison to another sport, and think of the above proposed changes and liken them to the Kentucky Derby or the Belmont Stakes in thoroughbred racing. These races are both career defining and breeding defining – and they are both raced at unique distances that those horses will never race at again. But it's the ability to prove themselves at distances other than the normal ones and against the very best horses that make those wins so valuable.

For harness racing here in North America, it could be a way to have some delineation between sires who may be able to specialize more at farther distances. In this sense, classic races at longer distances could further strengthen the breed.

The column referred to and linked earlier made the case that current breeding shouldn't be a reason to not have more added distance races. Breeding has become globalized, and horses with the same breeding have no issues racing at one mile here in North America or at distances closer to two miles in France, Sweden, or anywhere else in Europe or Australia. Further, horses who have spent their careers trained to race longer distances in Europe have come to North America and have been just as successful at the rolled back one mile. The same holds true with horses who began their careers here and then have gone onto longer distances overseas.

Races at Yonkers prove that the longer distance races have merit. And this comes at a track where more circles around the Yonkers turns shouldn't necessarily equal a better race – but for the most part, it has. Others should take note.

# Brett, Brax and Billy get the headlines, but what about Adarryl and Zyler?

As you know, our sport is crying for new, young talent to carry our torch forward for generations to come.

Yes, we have Brett Beckwith, and, yes, we have Braxten Boyd, William Carter, and Marvin Luna, all of whom are in their early to mid-20s, getting the headlines these days for their heroics in the sulky and, of course, we wish Beckwith quick and complete healing from his recent injuries.

But that's not even a handful of the future stars we need to keep harness racing in the limelight and the headlines for the next generations that, hopefully, will follow, whether they be caretakers, trainers, drivers or, as importantly, *fans*.

Beckwith, now 23, got his start, humbly, eight seasons ago and banked \$25,000 and change for his owners.

Now, 2,187 wins later, he's won over \$22 million in purse money for those owners, before the dangers of harness racing finally encompassed him.

Boyd burst onto the scene from the ground up, too, earning \$200 in purse money at the Montpelier Fair with Megatron years ago.

He just spiked over the \$20 million mark and has well over 1,500 wins.

Carter began his quest at age 17 and is approaching 500 lifetime wins with over \$3.4 million in purse money.

All were brought up around horses, and it shows.

Luna, now approaching age 25, burst on the scene in 2023 and has over \$8 million in purses.

All had humble beginnings and have been raised to be respectful of their surroundings and competition.

The years seem to fly by faster than a 1:45.4 mile, don't they?

I have lost many wonderful friends in this industry over the years – many by the inevitable, many by retirement.

It's about 67 years since my first foray into our grand sport and over 62 years since my first writing appeared in the *Horseman and Fair World* – that being Feb. 4, 1964, ironically, the week Pompano Park opened.

The list of the folk I have seen come and go stretches almost from A-to-Z and numbers in the thousands.

Some are famous, some not-so, but all are horsemen and women with equally interesting tails – make that tales.

A short sampling includes the Abbatiello brothers, Tony Avenatti, Dave Bartlett, Peter Blood, Warren Cameron, Kelly Case, Coco Cormier, the Dancer clan, Chet Emerson, Bob Farrington, Clay Faurot, Loosh, Edgar Leonard, Buddy Gilmour, the Haughtons, Kim Hankins, of course, Wally Hennessey, Del Insko, Jackie Ingrassia, Jim King, Harold Kelly, Clifford and Opal King, Carl LeCause, Jo Ann (when she was Looney), Ken Lighthill, Merriman, Edith Mouw, Soren Nordin, Bruce Nickells, Billy O, Frank O'Mara, Joe O'Brien, Butch Paisley, Bill Popfinger, Dwayne Pletcher, Bob Quigley, Lou Rapone, Walter Ross, Curly Smart, Harold Snodgrass, Mel Turcotte, George Ursitti, Gene Vallandingham, Bob Williams, Ben Webster, Robert Yohn, Snake Willis, and Rick Zeron.

See, some famous, some, not so, some are still with us, but most are gone with the ages.

Ken Lighthill is mentioned above. He had the distinction of driving Scotsdam to a world record victory at Maywood Park on March 17, 1962.

With the track a quagmire as winter was in a battle with spring and the temperature hovered a degree of two either side of freezing. It took Scotsdam 3:38.3 – no misprint, 3:38.3 – to cover the mile dodging snowflakes, freezing raindrops, and a horrendous combination of precipitation.

Two nights later, Bob Farrington drove Great Northern to a win in 3:35.3 – last quarter 1:03.

Remember, that's 1962 we're talking about.

Yes, the years fly by and, all of a sudden, we are missing the many acquaintances and friends and history that have come and gone over the time to record a mile that will be forever known as the slowest pari-mutuel mile in history, and two nights later, the slowest final quarter.

It's all part of our history, although few remember such incidents as time, somehow and sadly, erases it from history.

Soon, there will be nobody left to remember such a mile – make that milestone.

Yes, some have left us naturally and some have perished proving the danger of participation in a sport that offers possible tragedy every step of every mile when a horse and driver step onto the track, whether it be limestone, clay, or silt.

One false step can make the difference.

Mickey McNichol can tell you that from a spill just weeks ago.

Gentlemen like Billy Haughton, Shelly Goudreau, Wayne Smullen, Hal Belote, Hunter Myers, even Pop Geers a century ago, and many others all claimed by accidents.

And the recent incident in Ohio at Scioto proves that the invincible are not invincible.

And that is why I – make that we – must treasure our horses and horsemen every step of their long miles.

Yes, how the years fly by.

I remember Montrell Teague winning his very first pari-mutuel race.

It seems like yesterday, yet it was back in 2009, and Teague is 35 today.

Hopefully, he's got three decades left in his star-studded career.

Timmy Tetrick will be 45 this semester and still will be at the top of his game in 10, 15, or 20 years.

Hennessey is just strides away from being 70 – although, being from Charlottetown, he claims to be only 21 Celsius.

Tony Morgan is approaching 68, Dave Palone is 64, David Miller is 62, Kevin Wallis will be 70 in a few months, Jack Moiseyev is 66, Peter Wrenn is 63, Bruce Ranger is 66, and the amazing Rick Plano is, 1:51.3 away from being 75.

This is just a small sampling of the desperate stage harness racing faces in replacing these great horsemen with generations that may – or may not – cast our future.

Who is next for stardom in harness racing?

Could it be McGwire Sowers, Trae Porter, Luke Hanners, Jacob Cutting, Kyle Cummings, Kyle Swift, Zach Vickerson, Koltin Noble, Tim Johnson, Jacob Baird, Kiwon Waldron from Bermuda, Case Bateson, Logan Coney, Ryder Skinner, Adarryl Gates, Jr., Lauren Harmon, Winter Asher-Stalbaum, Christian Myers, James Gould, Carson Conrad, Lucas Myers, Wyatt Farmer, Dylan Huckabone-Miller, Donald Coy, Danarius Dortch, Cornelius Stewart, O'darius Johnson, or Zylar Maxwell?

These are roughly half of the roster of participants in harness racing 25 years of age or younger.

Yes, they account for less than 1 per cent of the drivers and trainers in harness racing.

They are the future of our sport, and there are just not enough of them to sustain the number of tracks and races as we lose – one by one – our aging roster of drivers.

There are those that will give critical feedback once these words are read – but somebody better realize that we are not Major League Baseball or the NFL or the NBA or every other successful major sport that has a draft to bring along new talent.

Many of the above-named young drivers have serious talent, but we don't have nearly enough of these young men and women to garner new headlines and subsequent stories about their success.

Gates, Jr., 25 years of age, is a Mississippi native plying his trade at Oak Grove Racing and Gaming and has been for the past five years.

He has 28 career wins and comes off of a .360 year winning 12 of 46 starts and finishing first, second or third in 21 of them.

His success this year has been at Oak Grove in USHDC events, where he works with his stable of four with the hopes of catching on at The Red Mile when they open in July.

Maxwell is 19, and has been driving winners – 79 thus far – in his five seasons.

He, too, is a Mississippi native that has recently driven horses like Just A Rocket Man and Timothy to wins at Oak Grove.

Farmer is a Chicago native who, at age 20, already can claim six seasons of solid credentials on the tough Ohio circuit.

Lucas Myers is a 25-year-old from Pennsylvania who is making waves in that state, approaching 150 lifetime wins and over \$1,000,000 in purse earnings.

Gould is an Iowa native that has never been below .300 for a batting average over his career stretching back to 2019, when he was 16.

Skinner is 18 years old and has been trying to break through at Dover Downs and Harrington with recent wins with Bikini Miki and a sharp score with Warrens Charm in a \$50,950 stake at Dover.

This is just a sampling of the great talent that awaits the future of our sport.

Yes, these are just a few of the thousand or more we need to insure that harness racing has a future – a lucrative future – for drivers, trainers, owners and, of course, our most important commodity – our fans.

## Daley duo ready to go in inaugural Oak Grove Trotting Oaks

Naked And Famous is the type of horse that doesn't take a lot of work to get ready to race, but she still surprised trainer Noel Daley with her track-record-setting seasonal debut on May 4 at Oak Grove Racing & Gaming in Kentucky.

Naked And Famous won her elimination of the inaugural Oak Grove Trotting Oaks, for 3-year-old fillies, in 1:51.2 with Todd McCarthy in the sulky. She was 7½ lengths clear of runner-up Jailbird Jog, the 2-1 favorite, as she lowered the track mark for a sophomore trotting filly by two-fifths-of-a-second. Sent off at nearly 15-1, the daughter of Six Pack—Sleep Tight My Luv led to the first quarter in :26.4 and never looked back.

The top three finishers from three \$30,000 eliminations on May 4 advanced to Saturday's (May 16) \$300,000 Oak Grove Trotting Oaks final. Naked And Famous will head to the race as the 5-2 morning-line favorite in a field of nine. She will leave from post 1.

"I knew she was forward, but I wasn't planning on a track record with her," said Daley, who trains Naked And Famous for owner CTC Stable. "She's a big, athletic thing and could have been ready six weeks ago. She's ready whenever you want her to be ready. She showed talent last year, but that was a real eye-opening mile."

Naked And Famous, a \$70,000 yearling purchase at the Standardbred Horse Sale whose family includes two-time Dan Patch and O'Brien awards-winning filly Pampered Princess and O'Brien Award-winning colt Was It A Dream, won four of 12 races last year and earned \$181,950. Her victories include a \$100,000 Kentucky Sire Stakes final at Cumberland Run in early November and she finished third in the \$400,000 Kentucky Sire Stakes Championship Series final in September at Lexington's Red Mile.

"Trotting-wise, she can be a bit of a handful around the place, but she's a beautifully going big filly," Daley said. "If she's anything like she was last week, I think they're going to have trouble beating her. She drew the rail and she can leave, so Todd has got plenty of options there."

Daley will also send out Carve in Saturday's final. Carve, a daughter of Captain Corey—Alpine, finished third in the elimination won by her stablemate, Naked And Famous.

Last year, Carve won two of 10 races, but hit the board an additional seven times on her way to \$216,791 in purses. Her wins included a division of the Grade 3 International Stallion Stakes at The Red Mile in 1:52 – the second-fastest win time of the season for a freshman filly trotter – and was second

in a division of the Bluegrass (G3) when she was beaten by a half-length in 1:51.4 by Southwind Chaska. She finished fourth in the KYSS championship.

“She was probably the stronger of the two last year,” Daley said about Carve and Naked And Famous. “She’s just a different type of filly. She’s built differently; she’s very solid. She’ll take a run or two, so I expect her to improve a lot off that [first start]. Whether she’s forward enough to go with [Naked And Famous] if she does the same thing again, I’m not sure. But hopefully she’s in for a good year. She’s a very smart filly that you can do anything with. She’s nice to be around. She’s a very agreeable filly.”

Carve is eligible to August’s Hambletonian Oaks (Grade 1) at The Meadowlands; Naked And Famous is not.

“It wouldn’t hurt to have ‘Naked’ eligible to the Oaks as well, but there are a lot of options these days if a horse is Kentucky eligible and somewhere else,” Daley said, referring to Naked And Famous being Kentucky and New Jersey eligible. “You just have to make sure you don’t over-race them.”

Carve will start the Oak Grove Trotting Oaks final from post 4 with Andy McCarthy driving for lessees Patricia Stables, L.A. Express Stable, and Sjoblom Racing. She is 6-1 on the morning line.

Setyoursightshigh, who was the 2025 Dan Patch Award winner for best 2-year-old filly trotter, is the 3-1 second choice on the morning line. She finished second to Custom in her elimination, beaten by a half-length in 1:52.4. The Marcus Melander-trained daughter of In Range—Special Interest has never finished worse than second in 12 career starts, with seven wins. Dexter Dunn will drive the filly from post 8 for owners Heights Stable, Mantorp LLC, AMG Stable, and K Kjellgren Livs AB.

“It would be nicer drawing 4 or 5, something like that, but she can leave and it is what it is,” Melander said. “It’s out of our hands. I think Dexter will find some good position for her.”

“I think she’s the best one in there, but it’s an open race. But then, you know, Noel’s filly raced great in the elimination and there are some other nice fillies in the field as well.”

Custom, a daughter of Walner—Goldy Mary FR is the 9-2 third choice on the morning line. She will start from post 6 with Jason Bartlett driving for trainer Per Engblom.

The remaining elimination winner, Victorianas Secret, will leave from post 3 with Ronnie Wrenn, Jr. in the sulky for trainer Vernon Beachy. The daughter of Tactical Landing—Victoriana won her elim in 1:53.3 and is 8-1 on the morning line.

One race after the Oak Grove Trotting Oaks, the track will host the inaugural \$500,000 Oak Grove Trotting Derby, for 3-year-old colts and geldings. Spencer Hanover is the 2-1 morning-line favorite, leaving from post 1, for the driver-and-trainer combo of Bartlett and Melander. Endurance is the 5-2 second choice for Andy McCarthy and Chris Beaver, leaving from post 6.

Endurance won his elimination in 1:51.3, a track-record for sophomore male trotters. Spencer Hanover, the 2025 Breeders Crown champ, won his split in 1:53.4. The remaining elim was won by Matt Burkholder-trained Silverstein in 1:52.3. He will start from post 9 and is 8-1.

The Oak Grove Trotting Oaks is race 10, with a 4:52 p.m. (CDT) post time. The Oak Grove Trotting Derby is slated for 5:23 p.m.

## Horse of the Year Beau Jangles victorious in season debut

Defending Horse of the Year **Beau Jangles** made a triumphant return in Saturday's (May 9) SBOA Stakes elimination at Woodbine Mohawk Park, turning in a sharp and professional season debut for driver Bob McClure and trainer Dr. Ian Moore.

The undefeated son of Cattlewash—Mrs Major Hill left from the rail in a field of seven and got away second behind Tilthecowscomehome through a :27.3 opening-quarter. McClure gave the champion his cue to move once straightening onto the backstretch and took his time clearing on the leader who gave him a slight stretch.

On the lead at a :56.1 half, Beau Jangles ramped up the tempo halfway around the final turn to hit three-quarters in 1:24.3. The stretch drive saw the Moore trainee power home in :26.3 to secure a four-length 1:51 victory in effortless fashion.

"He's definitely fresh," said McClure post-race. "He was just a dream to drive out there tonight, just like he always has been. I turned for home and I didn't even speak to him, he just took

off on his own... halfway down the lane he was looking around at stuff just playing so [I] had to get his focus a little bit, but it's scary how much he can do with little effort.

"I look forward to a great year for him, Doc, the owners, and everybody. I just hope he can do what everybody hopes he can."

Beau Jangles is now a perfect 13-for-13 and went over \$1.7 million earned with his season debut win for owners Graham Grace Stables LLC, Kiwi Stables LLC, and Bolton Stables.

After an award-winning dream season at 2, the hype surrounding Beau Jangles heading into his 3-year-old season has rivaled that of the great Somebeachsomewhere. His wins last year in the Metro Pace (Grade 1) and Breeders Crown (Grade 1) give him the opportunity to join Tall Dark Stranger (2020) as the only horses to win those events at age 2 and then return to win the Pepsi North America Cup (Grade 1) at age 3.

"We gave him all the time off we could," said Moore of Beau Jangles' winter break. "We never started jogging him until about the 19th of January. He didn't really grow any, he filled out some, he got bigger in the chest, but didn't grow any taller and he came back like a trooper.

"Last year there was no pressure, every week was a bonus. This year, the pressure has been going for a while."

The top five finishers were completed by Tilthecowscomehome, Mega Moves, Wholetthedogsout, and Count On Gord.

With place and show wagering removed, \$94,140 of the \$103,469 win pool was wagered on Beau Jangles.

The second \$25,000 elimination in the SBOA for Ontario sired 3-year-olds saw **Borderline Mobby** prevail in 1:50.4 for driver James MacDonald and trainer Dave Menary.

The son of Cattlewash—Hot Gossip looped to the lead in the second-quarter around Windor and would keep that rival at bay all the way to the wire to win by a length. Redland Rocket Man, Illicit Behavior, and Dax Seelster also qualified for the final.

Borderline Mobby is now one-for-two on the season after winning just once in 10 starts at age 2. His career best victory takes him over \$111,000 in earnings.

A \$2 win ticket on Borderline Mobby returned \$8.

## FELLOWS' TRAINEES SWEEP SBOA COLT TROT ELIMINATIONS

The SBOA Stakes eliminations continued Saturday evening (May 9) with the 3-year-old colt and gelding trot splits contested early on the 12-race card at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

The opening division of the SBOA eliminations delivered a compelling top-level showdown, as **Touchedbyanangel** held off the heavily favored Strobe Lite to win in 1:54.1.

Driven confidently by Doug McNair for trainer Kyle Fellows, Touchedbyanangel secured a perfect 2-hole trip behind Wolverine Legend through fractions of :28, :57, and 1:25.4. Touchedbyanangel angled into contention turning for home and powered on to secure the victory over the late-closing heavy favorite Strobe Lite.

Strobe Lite, the O'Brien Award-winning standout from last season, made a strong seasonal debut for driver James MacDonald and trainer Benoit Baillargeon. The 1-5 favorite was settled into a mid-pack trip before unleashing a steady late rally. Despite closing ground through the stretch, he came up just a neck short off a :27.2 kicker.

Rounding out the top three was Wolverine Legend, who set the tempo for driver Trevor Henry and held on admirably to secure

a qualifying spot. Dream For Peace and Stonebridge Mac also made the final.

With the win in Saturday's season debut, Touchedbyanangel now has three wins in 13 starts and over \$200,000 earned for owners Yolanda Fellows, Blair Corbeil, Mike McAllister, and Peter Porter. The son of Archangel paid \$8.40 to win.

The Fellows stable carried the momentum from the first elimination win to a sweep of the top two spots in the second split, as **Toss Of The Dice** pulled off a 34-1 upset in a scramble of a finish that saw the top-five separated by just two-lengths in a blanket finish.

Driven by Mark MacDonald, Toss Of The Dice swept the field from last by going three-wide around the final turn. The three-wide move was forced after longshot In The Black began to fade after being parked throughout. Race favorite First Class Mass was stuck behind the fading rival, while Mike Me Up and Toss Of The Dice got around.

In the stretch, L P Bay, who had been pressured by In The Black, surrendered the lead to Trouble With Names. However, the new leader could not hold off the Fellows trainees, as Toss Of The Dice reached up to win by three-quarters-of-a-length in 1:56.1.

Mike Me Up was second, while Trouble With Names was third. First Class Mass finished up strong after the last turn traffic to finish fourth, while L P Bay hung in tough to be fifth.

Another son of Archangel, Toss Of The Dice was winless in two starts this season before Saturday's elimination. He now has four wins in 13 starts and over \$59,000 earned for owners Yolanda Fellows, Leo Fleming, Bill Manes, and William Cripps.

Toss Of The Dice paid \$71.30 to win.

**Cher Hill** was a gate-to-wire winner in the second elimination for driver Doug McNair and trainer Gregg McNair.

A daughter of Muscle Mass, Cher Hill marched to a sharp 1:54.2 win, defeating nearest rival Arkona Seelster by three lengths.

My Ghost, Lo And Behold, and Twin B Showbiz also punched their ticket to Saturday's final.

Cher Hill's season debut win moves her record to four wins in 11 starts and over \$143,000 earned for owner Tom Hill. She paid \$7.60.

# Dexter Dunn doubles in NJSS dashes at Big M

He only had a total of 54 drives this year heading into Saturday night's (May 9) races at The Meadowlands, but Dexter Dunn showed why he is a five-time Dan Patch Driver of the Year award recipient, showing no rust after guiding the winners of both \$25,000 leg 2 platinum divisions of the New Jersey Sire Stakes for 3-year-old pacers.

In the division for fillies, Dunn had to deal with scraping mud off of his colors at the conclusion of the race given the sloppy track condition, but didn't break a sweat during it.

**Be Perfect BG**, a daughter of Perfect Sting—JK Mardi Says, won as impressively as a 1-20 favorite should, as after sitting a

4-hole trip early on, Dunn moved the eventual winner off the rail at the five-eighths and had zero trouble winning for fun despite racing first-over on the slick surface.

She Stings, the 11-1 second choice, left alertly for the pocket, allowing Interstellar to race on the point at the quarter in :27.4 before taking the lead at the half in :56.2 as they lined up, She Stings-Interstellar-Sunny Station-Be Perfect BG.

Be Perfect BG, who ran her lifetime record to seven wins in as many starts, then moved to the rim at the five-eighths, and was handled with care on the far turn before sprinting home a much-the-best winner in 1:50.4 by two lengths over She Stings. Perfect Thought was third.

"When I asked her in the straight, she had plenty," said Dunn. "You can't put them on the front every start. It was good when she did what she did when I asked her."

Be Perfect BG, an Anthony Beaton trainee, returned \$2.10 while lifting her lifetime earnings to \$146,950.

Dunn showed he doesn't necessarily need to guide the favorite to find his way to the winner's circle after pulling off an upset in the split for colts and geldings with the Tom Cancelliere-trained **Sonofanutcracker**, who sparkled in his seasonal debut, going wire-to-wire in 1:50.

Azrael Blue Chip, the 2-5 public choice who was a spectacular second a week ago in his fast-closing nose loss at the hands of the unbeaten Bookie J, worked out a perfect second-over trip, but with Sonofanutcracker sprinting home in :26.4 on the front end, could not threaten the winner, falling 2¼ lengths short. Rocknacious finished third.

"I put him in the North America Cup, but not in the Meadowlands Pace," said Cancelliere. "This horse trained down perfectly as a 2-year-old, but the light didn't come on until he got to the track. He realized then that he could do this.

"I'm hoping that he just keeps getting better. He may not be as good as the top five horses in the division, but he can cash a lot of checks. He likes his job. It makes it so much easier when they like their job."

Dunn said, "Tom said he was ready to go. Once he got to the front, he was strong."

A colt by Nutcracker Suite—Rob Them Blind, Sonofanutcracker lifted his lifetime stats to four wins from just eight starts, good for earnings of just over \$150,000. As the 9-1 fourth choice, he returned \$21.40 to win.

**THAT'S A HALF-DOZEN, COUSIN:** Dunn was red-hot in the slop, racking up six wins on the program to lead the driver colony, despite leaving after the 10th race. The only other time this year that a pilot piled up a half-dozen victories was when Brett Beckwith did it on Feb. 6.

**A LITTLE MORE:** Cancelliere and Joe Bongiorno topped the trainers with a pair of walks down victory lane each... All-source betting on the 14-race program totaled \$2,780,819.

# Caviart Daisy powers to a divisional track record in Virginia Breeder's Fund competition at Shenandoah Downs

Frank Chick's **Caviart Daisy** established a new track record in the 3-year-old filly pacing category Sunday with a dominating 1:53.1 effort as Virginia Breeder's Fund elimination weekend competition continued at Shenandoah Downs.

The Sweet Lou filly powered away to a three-length lead after the start and cut panels of :28, :56.2, and 1:25 before carrying a six-length lead into the top of the stretch. The Jamie Sullivan trainee crossed eight lengths the best and added to the \$217,360 career bankroll she had entering the race. Tony Morgan guided the winner to victory. The previous divisional record holder was Caviart Sophie who set her 1:54.1 mark in 2024.

Julie Collins' Caviart Santa Fe finished second and Jason Walters' Fools Journey took third.

Hagerman Racing's **More Than Better** wired the field in the other Breeders filly division in 1:56.3. The More The Better N filly's margin throughout wasn't as robust as Caviart Daisy's but she got the job done in panels of :29.1, :59.4, and 1:29.1. She finished a half-length ahead of Ron Millman's runner-up Meemaw's Column. Debbie Warnick's Watch Sparks Fly finished third.

Dr. Edward Ward's **Caviart Sheridan** and William Hartt's **Caviart Cadet** won their respective Breeders divisions in the colt/gelding category. The former won by 2½ lengths in 1:55.1 courtesy of a coast-to-coast trip authored by driver Nick Roland. The Tracy Bradshaw trainee won his third lifetime race in a career best time. Calin Savage and Pennie Savage's Savage Warrior finished second while Lawrence Cooper's Caviart Hartley was third.

The latter's trip mirrored that of Caviart Sheridan – a front stepping route as the 1-9 favorite with Tony Morgan in the sulky. The Tall Dark Stranger gelding's time of 1:58.2 was triggered as unexpected rain moved into the area. The Britney Dillon trainee finished second in the 2025 Breeder's final as a 2-year-old behind

Caviart Trenton – who was second in Sunday's elimination. The runner-up is owned by Ramna Gillespie. Jamie Bozman's Caviart Harper was third.

Breeders' weekend action kicked off Saturday (May 9) as Scott Betts' **Cindy Lou Goo** captured the fastest of four sophomore trot elimination races, covering the mile in 1:59.2. The Googoo Gaagaa gelding stuck a nose in front of Joyce Lineweaver's front stepping Punchin Preacher just past the quarter fraction and never looked back, crossing in 1:59.2. Russell Foster piloted the winner for co-owners Tim Betts and Shanamphilankilou, Inc.

Bob McKim's **Kalispel** took the other sophomore male trot, wiring the field of eight in 2:01. The son of Gregory Pecs was fresh off a second-place finish in a \$100,000 Virginia Sire Stakes final two weeks ago. On Saturday, he held off a pesky Ahtohallan in the final quarter to win by a half-length with 21-year-old driver Koltin Noble in the bike. Kalispel won for the seventh time in 10 starts and pushed his earnings to \$88,504.

Trainer Ron Millman's filly trotters **Progressivekathy** and **Caviart Gemma** swept ladies divisions in 2:00 and 2:00.1, respectively. Dr. Scott Woogen owns the pair who were driven respectively by Russell Foster and Fern Paquet, Jr.

The former, a daughter of Il Mago, passed eventual runner-up Wolfpack One at the head of the stretch and charged on en route to a ¼ length triumph. Wolfpack One, owned by a trio from North Carolina that includes Stuart Chambers, Bcjm Inc., and Divine Horse Racing, was second, while The Stable Cherrys Girl and Hutchison Harness LLC's Cherry's Girl finished third.

The latter finished second initially to Timothy Betts and Shanamphilankilou's Honolugoo but after a judge's objection review, the order was flip flopped and Woogen's Captain Corey filly gained the top spot. Ashley Mulhern's Twisted Janet finished third.

A second round of Breeder's eliminations will be held this weekend followed by a Day of Champions card on May 23 when a four-pack of \$100,000 finals will be contested.

### Bartlett lands career win number 12,000

Jason Bartlett became just the 11th North American driver to have 12,000 career victories after he captured the eighth race on Tuesday night (May 12) at MGM Yonkers Raceway with **Heaven On High N**.

Bartlett came into the program needing two wins to get to 12,000 and took the third race with Rob Harmon-trained **Mind Hunter** in 1:54 to set the stage for the milestone with Heaven On High N, a Ricky Bucci trainee, in 1:54.1.

The defending Dan Patch Driver of the Year, Bartlett is the perennial leader in the standings at Yonkers and is well on his way to another local title in 2026 as he is over 100 wins clear of second-place Brent Holland at this point.

In addition to his success finding the winner's circle, Bartlett is also ninth all-time in earnings as his charges have banked over \$181.5 million.

### Widger gets win number 8,000 at Scioto

Driver Sam Widger notched win number 8,000 on Tuesday (May 12) at Eldorado Scioto Downs with **Saying Grace N** in 1:53.3.

Heading into Tuesday's card, Widger was only two wins away from hitting the milestone. He captured the first race with Born To Run As in 1:54 for owner/trainer Mark Headworth. Five races later, it was the Adam Short owned/trained Saying Grace N that put him at the milestone.

"It's huge, I guess I look at that, and I think that there's someone like me who didn't know the first thing about a horse when he graduated high school, it's a pretty big accomplishment," said Widger. "I have to thank all the owners and trainers for putting up with me over the years. And the good Lord for keeping me safe."

Originally from Illinois, Widger first got his license in the fall of 1985 and his first win the following year. He made the switch to race more in Indiana in 2009, followed by a move to the Ohio circuit in 2023.

With 60,268 lifetime starts behind the starting gate, Widger has finished in the top three 23,389 times, or 38.8 per cent of the time. Horses he has driven have earned over \$77.2-million.

By the end of Scioto's Tuesday card, Widger won three races and finished second or third in two others.

Racing at Scioto Downs continues Wednesday (May 13) and there are three carryovers, two with guaranteed pools, for the 16-race card. The \$.50 early Pick-5 will, for the second day in a row, have a \$20,000 guarantee. The takeout on new money is 14 per cent and the pool will be started with a \$5,000 carryover from Tuesday's card.

The 91-day regular season 2026 Eldorado Scioto Downs race meet runs until Sept. 19. Races are held Tuesday-Saturday, with special holiday cards on Memorial Day and Labor Day instead of the Tuesday card that week. ## Dandy Ideal sharp in readying for 4YO campaign

**Dandy Ideal**, one of the major players in the 3-year-old pacing male ranks last year, showed he was ready to start his 4-year-old season with a 1:52.2 victory in a Wednesday morning (May 13) qualifier at Pocono Downs at Mohegan Pennsylvania.

The American Ideal gelding was sent to the lead by Jason Bartlett, fresh off his 12,000th career victory at Yonkers the night before, in a :28.4 opener, yielded to sit in the 2-hole through middle fractions of :56.4 and 1:24.4, then roared out on the turn and won by 3¼ lengths while clocking his own last quarter in :27.3 for trainer Hunter Oakes and owners Susan Oakes and Alan Johnston.

At 3, Dandy Ideal won 11 of 19 starts for earnings of \$936,782. He won his Breeders Crown elim by a nose in 1:48 while defeating divisional champion Louprint and taking his mark, then finished second, just a neck behind Sippinonsearoc in the Crown final. Also, on his 2025 scorecard were the Hempt Pace right here at Pocono and numerous successes in the New York program.

Two 3-year-olds with stakes ambitions also won during the session. The Huntsville filly **Odds On Monetary** came her back half raw in :55-:27.2 to get the decision in 1:53.1 in a four-pacer picture for driver Matt Kakaley, trainer Travis Alexander, and Odds On Racing. The Chapter Seven miss **Aviatrix Blue Chip**, second in the recent Weiss Trotting Series final to series sweeper Concise, sat in the golden chair and then powered off to a 3¼ length decision in 1:56, her own back splits in :56.4-:28. Jason Bartlett drove the Jared Bako trainee for Blue Chip Bloodstock Inc.

Bartlett had three success stories in the seven-race session, while Kakaley had two, and trainer Alexander saw three of his charges taste victory.

## Yonkers announces bonus program for new horses

MGM Yonkers Raceway, in association with the Standardbred Owners Association of New York, is proud to announce a new program aimed at increasing the horse population and wagering options for its patrons while at the same time rewarding owners and trainers for supporting the best overnight program in the country in terms of purses.

Any horse which has not made a pari-mutuel start at MGM Yonkers Raceway as of May 17, 2026 will be eligible to receive a \$2,400 (\$800 per start) bonus payment if they race at least three times between May 18 and August 21 of this year. While they do not need to be consecutive, horses must make three starts during the prescribed period and be sent out by a track-approved trainer to be eligible. The \$2,400 bonus will only be released upon completion of the third start. Stakes races are excluded from this promotion.

Should a new horse arrive at MGM Yonkers and get claimed in their initial start, the original owner will get an \$800 bonus. If a horse is claimed again in its second start, the owner who entered the horse will get the \$800 and subsequently, the new owner will get the \$800 for the third start. Additionally, if a horse is claimed in its second start, the original owner will get \$1,600 and the new owner will get \$800 after the horse races a third start.

“We are continually looking for ways to improve the racing product at Yonkers,” said racing secretary Joe Frasure. “Joe [Faraldo] and I developed this plan with the help of DRF Harness’ Derick Giwner, who had the idea that a bonus program to offset the costs of shipping to our location at a time when gas and other prices are soaring, could benefit our horse population.”

## Pisces Rising the big fish in Pocono trotting series

In last week’s first preliminary of the Game Of Claims Trotting Series at Pocono Downs at Mohegan Pennsylvania, there were four divisions – but five winners, as there was a dead-heat for first. One of the “DH1” horses, **Pisces Rising**, on Tuesday (May 12) became the only two-time winner to date in the trotting series with a 1:55 victory in one of five \$16,000 divisions, with the base claiming tag this week raised to \$25,000.

An altered son of Father Patrick haltered for \$20,000 out of the first leg by owner Guy Gemore and trainer Richard Johnson, Pisces Rising paid immediate dividends, coming on the grind just off the second turn, trotting his own back half in :56.3 under the guidance of Todd McCarthy to ward off the horse on his back, second-over Songs In The Wind (another first-round winner) by a neck. Pisces Rising went back to his own stall after the race as well, as only two horses, neither of them winners, changed hands this week, although the total transfer amount was a hefty \$56,250.

Todd McCarthy won another division of the GOCTS with the Wishing Stone gelding **Epos Ostervang DK**, who didn’t race in the first leg and thus could be considered “undefeated in the series” (though that claim won’t help him make the final if total points become close). “Epos” is conditioned by the meet’s leading trainer, Per Engblom, and he trotted the fastest of Tuesday’s divisions, a lifetime best 1:54 for Engblom Farm LLC.

Also skipping the first prelim but winning in the second was the Mister Anson gelding **Sir Maverick**, coming from Ohio and winning his second straight for owner Anastasia Meshkova; he was driven by Anthony Napolitano for new trainer Frank Calcagni.

Rounding out the success stories in the second series leg were **Abruzzo**, a Walner gelding second in the first leg and here a 1:54.2 winner for driver Jim Pantaleano and trainer/owner David Hoover, and **The American Eagle**, a son of Trixton who got the job done in 1:55.4 while a nose to the good of 32-1 shot Dusty Dungarees for driver Tyler Buter, trainer Herbert Lux III, and owners William Mullin and Howard Taylor. The series’ final prelim will be held in seven days’ time with the \$50,000 championship seven days after that.

McCarthy and Napolitano recorded triples on the Tuesday card, while Braxten Boyd, meet leader Buter, and Ridge Warren notched doubles. Fourteen different trainers sent out winners on the 14-race card.

Saturday promises to be a very big day at Pocono, with the 1 p.m. card spotlighting the glamour division 3-year-old pacing male set in \$231,270 of action spread over three Pennsylvania Sire Stakes divisions and six Stallion Series sections. It figured that trainer Ron Burke would have a big hand in this division this year, and indeed he has four of the prime contenders – it is only a surprise that Another C Note, undefeated in five starts this year, would be the barn’s current “big horse” over Frantic Hanover, Al Papi, and Melillo, who have earned \$1,366,911 already in their careers. Respect must be accorded as well to Sneaky Squeaky, who like Another C Note is undefeated in five seasonal starts and who like “C Note” won his first round PASS prelim.

### MISS JUM JABBER CONTINUES TO IMPRESS IN PA ALL-STARS:

The Bettor’s Wish filly **Miss Jum Jabber** continued to push her way into national consideration by notching her fifth straight victory, equaling her mark of 1:51.1, in one of three \$30,000 divisions of her Pennsylvania All-Stars event on Monday (May 11) at Pocono Downs at Mohegan Pennsylvania.

Owned by trainer Brett Pelling’s Pelling Racing LLC, Miss Jum Jabber got away mid-pack behind early fractions of :27.4 and :57. But pacing her own back half in :53.2 while uncovered doesn’t seem to bother this filly, as Andrew McCarthy got her straightened away and made the lead coming into the stretch, winning by an easy 1¾ lengths over Kissin In The Dark. The latter filly had the distinction of being a 49-1 shot to complete a \$5.20 exacta return for \$2, as Miss Jum Jabber created a sizable minus pool across the board.

Andrew McCarthy won a second division of the All-Stars by coming from sixth at the stretch call with the Papi Rob Hanover distaff **Say Goodnight** to be along by a neck over Carolina in

a new mark of 1:51.2. Contested fractions of :27.2, :56, and 1:23.3 helped set up the late charge of the winner for trainer Nicholas Devita and owners David Hamm and Glenn Phillips. The winner returned a \$34.40 win mutuel – mere peanuts against the \$135.60 Say Goodnight paid in winning her Sire Stakes championship at 2.

The third All-Stars section was the fastest of the three at 1:51, as the Captaintreacherous filly **Darlin's Angel** continued a good All-Stars form run for her sire, who got three credits in Saturday's action for the equivalent division of males. Darlin's Angel, undefeated in three starts this campaign, was quarter-mover number 2 by the :27.3 opening pole, cut middle fractions of :56.2 and 1:24.2, then blitzed home in :26.3 to win by 2½ lengths over Tall Dark Tequila for driver Lauren Tritton, trainer Juan Cano, and Hot Lead Farm.

The Pennsylvania All-Stars series next pops up at Pocono on Monday (May 18), with Hambletonian hopefuls trying to build a solid case for going onto the Grand Circuit in the All-Stars 3-year-old male trot.

The glamour division 3-year-old male pacers will contest their Pennsylvania Sire Stakes and Stallion Series second round preliminaries on Saturday, with \$231,270 on the line among three divisions of Sire Stakes and six Stallion Series sections.

## Tioga Downs working on incorrect payout

Tioga Downs incorrectly paid out a dead heat in Sunday's (May 10) fifth race due to a United Tote error. In the race, Joe Pavia, Jr.'s trainee, **Last Goodbye** won as the 2-1 betting favorite by over a length. Bettor Sun and Kourageous Key finished in a dead heat for second.

When the race went official, tote displayed win payouts for the top three finishers and incorrectly indicated a triple dead heat. Track officials, working alongside the New York State Gaming Commission judges, requested a stop to the incorrect payments and held a slight delay to the races to rectify the situation.

Tioga Downs is presently working with United Tote on a resolution for those paid incorrectly and to amend the exotic payouts. United Tote is currently awaiting reports from the hub, and a solution was expected this week. Safeguards are also being investigated with the New York State Gaming Commission to ensure a mistake like this does not occur again.

## Oliveira wins pari-mutuel contest; Ahle with two winning dead heats

Charles Oliveira, the UFC lightweight division star, won his first pari-mutuel race in North America on Sunday (May 10) at Harrah's Philadelphia, guiding **Ben Solo** to a front-end victory in 1:51.2, just a tick off the pacer's lifetime mark despite coming off of a scratch.

Oliveira, who got his nickname "Do Bronx" because in the favelas (hardscrabble neighborhoods outside a main city) of his native Sao Paulo, Brazil, toughness is identified as a needed trait in both areas. Oliveira came off a victory at Yonkers Raceway, which is separated by "Do Bronx" only by the Bronx River, in an exhibition race Friday night (May 9), then came to the City of Brotherly Love on Mother's Day and high-lined Ben Solo to a length victory over Komodo Beach. Family, friends, and a good portion of the Philly paddock came out to greet the personable Oliveira after his victory.

Records among the local drivers' colony were also the order of the day at the Harrah's facility. On Sept. 27, 2009, there were three dead-heats to win on the card, giving Corey Callahan and Daniel Dube the distinction of joining the rare "Two DH1s On One Card Club," including perforce tying one another in one contest. On Sunday, there were two races inseparable for the win position, and Johnathan Ahle guided **Ramblin Reck**, the longest shot on the board, and **Benhope Rulz N** in those two contests, also notching a pair of "DH1"s on one card.

Echoes of the 2009 card resounded over 16 years later: driver Andy Miller, who dead-heated with Callahan on the first occasion, tied with Ahle on Sunday, and Callahan (whose win dead heats came in consecutive races in 2009) drove in both of the Sunday dead heats, and won two other races. For the record, Bradley Chisholm drove the other horse in the other dead heat to win Sunday.

Joseph Columbo was the sole trainer to post two wins here Sunday; the driver's side had five sulkysitters with two-baggers: Ahle from the dead-heats, Simon Allard, Corey Callahan, Mark Herschberger, and George Napolitano, Jr.

The closer was won by **Odds On Phil**, a son of Lather Up, and Luke Hanners in 1:53. Another with Morgan/Odds On Racing connections making his first seasonal start, Odds On Phil notched his fourth lifetime victory. Fired Up Henry L (Hand LeVan) was second with Ninetynineproblems (Wilder) third.

Drivers L. Hanners and Page are tied for the lead with eight wins each so far in the first three nights of racing. Brett Miller and David Miller are then tied for third with five wins each. On the training side, Morgan, Jr. has taken the early lead with nine wins in 27 starts.

The 91-day regular season 2026 Eldorado Scioto Downs race meet runs until Sept. 19. Races will be held Tuesday-Saturday, with special holiday cards on Memorial Day and Labor Day instead of the Tuesday card that week.
