## Legends Day at Clinton Raceway is the gift that keeps on giving

The tiny Ontario track opens its 54th season today and will play host to the 12th edition of Legends Day on June 30 — complete with a new twist.

Every racetrack around Ontario has its signature event. What makes each one unique, however, is not purse size or television ratings, but rather the infusion of a town's identity that cannot be imitated or reproduced elsewhere.

Today (May 19) is opening day at Clinton Raceway, home of one of harness racing's greatest events and charitable efforts over the last 25 years.

Ian Fleming, Clinton Raceway's general manager and 2019 Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame inductee, came up with the idea for a Legends Day in the early 2000s.

The vibrant program featuring and feting Hall of Fame drivers Keith and Ron Waples, John Campbell, Bill O'Donnell, Buddy Gilmour, Clint Galbraith, Mike Lachance and Ray Remmen — all Canadian natives — allowed the half-mile track to showcase that immense driving talent, while also supporting community members.



"Every track has an event," Fleming said. "We're just trying to come up with one that would be unique, and not only draw some interest to our track but raise money for local initiatives. That's something we've always tried to do.

"We've always dedicated that day to a cause, whether it be to the hospital or the local school. At the end of the day, we're trying to showcase racing and raise some money for local causes at the same time."

Since debuting in 2001, the biennial event has raised more than \$330,000 for local organizations.

That number is set to rise, once more, with the 12th edition of Clinton's signature meet making its highly anticipated return on Sunday (June 30).

"It's by far our biggest day," Fleming said. "Once we have Legends Day, two years later is our next biggest day."

Fleming says the once-every-two-years model works well for Legends Day. That way, the event doesn't risk going stale and Clinton's team has more time to plan the one-of-a-kind experience that the town of 3,200 has come to love.

"For people in racing, it's a chance to come out and see people that they wouldn't normally see," he said. "A lot of the drivers that come out on Legends Day are the ones that are actively seen on TV, but even the ones that aren't active still come back to it.

"It's a chance for people to come and see them when they wouldn't get to otherwise, which is something really unique."

The lineup has changed slightly each time Legends Day is held, but recent participants include harness racing royalty in the form of Hall of Famers Campbell, Ron Waples, Trevor Ritchie, Dave Wall, Doug Brown, Steve Condren and Paul MacDonell.

Together, they account for nearly 50,000 career wins and purse earnings exceeding \$806 million. They are all returning for this year's Legends Day.


As far as what else fans can expect this go around, Fleming says all the on- and off-track cornerstones, including the Kin Pace eliminations and crowd favorite post-race barbecue chicken dinner, will remain in place.

The hometown horseman also noted that all funds received from ticket purchases will go directly to the Clinton Public Hospital Foundation.

This year's Legends Day, however, is set to feature something a little different than past iterations.

The added flare comes as a result of Clinton's collaboration with The Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame, designed to bring a new element to the track's timeless celebration.

Officially branded as 'The Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame Reunion at Legends Day,' Fleming has high hopes heading into the big day.

"This year, we're going to be inviting all the members that are in the Hall of Fame and the families of people that are in the Hall of Fame," Fleming said. "That's something we've never done before. We're going to try and get some more people out that day, and when people see some of the families that are going to be there it might encourage them to come and see everyone.

"We hope it'll be a reunion of sorts."

Having played an integral role in driving the evolution of Legends Day, the selfless Fleming took pause to recognize the drivers for their unwavering commitment to Clinton's title event.

"You have to remember, these people are coming up for free, so we appreciate them taking a day to be here," he said. "Sometimes, they could have other places they have to be. They may come up and have a good day once they're here, but it's quite a commitment during a busy time of year to take a day out of their schedules and come to Clinton, and that means a lot to us."

Legends Day also means a lot to the little town with a long tradition of supporting horse racing; even if the event is held just once every 730 days.

"We get horsepeople that maybe just come once a year and we get people in the local community that want to support the track, they want the track to stay, and they want the hospital to do well, too," Fleming said. "Legends Day gives people a chance to support two things at the same time."

Clinton regulars, on the other hand, won't have to wait until June 30 to satisfy either their harness racing or philanthropic itch. In true Clinton fashion, community is at the core of all of its race cards this summer.

"We have 15 Sundays and 15 different groups that we'll be highlighting throughout the year," Fleming said. "We're doing a fundraiser every day we race and that helps get the local people out knowing they're supporting something local."

Meanwhile, Fleming also provided an update on the Raceway's grandstand improvement project. Although it won't be ready in time for opening day, Clinton's GM said his team should have a better timeline very soon.

"We're hopeful, of course," he said. "We ran into some cost issues two years ago when we were trying to get it done. We've reworked some of it and we're hopeful we'll get something going this fall. We should know in another month or so."

Fleming cited the renovation as a key cog in his team's mission to introduce more people in that part of Ontario to harness racing.

"It would be nice to make it more accessible to the new patio area, which would be good for bringing out new people," he said. "The entertainment business, of course, is trying to attract new people, and a fresher facility will certainly help in that regard."

Clinton's gates will open at noon on Legends Day, with live racing starting at 1:30 p.m., and the HPIBet Legends Day Trot set for 4:30 p.m.









## The red barn on the road to Mohawk

Lloyd Chisholm and Arawana Farms stands as a monument to the establishment of Woodbine Mohawk Park in Milton and the Ontario Sires Stakes program that celebrates its 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary this year.

Anyone driving to Woodbine Mohawk Park has seen it alongside the Campbellville Road in Milton. The old-fashioned red barn emblazoned with the name "Arawana Farms" is partially concealed by trees, just as its history is somewhat obscured by time. But the lasting achievements of its late owner Lloyd Chisholm (1911-92) are indelible.





Chisholm was inducted into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame in 1991 for his contributions as a builder in the standardbred industry. He served as the first chairman of the Ontario Standardbred Improvement Association, which lobbied the provincial government for greater recognition and support for harness racehorse breeders in the late 1960s. This organization later became the Standardbred Breeders of Ontario Association (SBOA), which named its Lloyd Chisholm Achievement Award in his honor.

"For countless thousands of horse racing fans in North America, Milton is perhaps best known as the home of the Mohawk Raceway. But why is this track here rather than elsewhere? And who were the people responsible for keeping this area in the forefront of racing over the years?" asked a Sept. 1, 1989 issue of *The Journal*, a publication of the Milton Historical Society.

The questions were rhetorical, because the next paragraph named Chisholm as the main speaker at an upcoming meeting of the historical society. He was the only standardbred breeder in Ontario's Nassagaweya Township (now part of Milton) in the early 1960s. When a group wanted to build a racetrack there, Chisholm was asked about it by the township council. He reached out to John Mooney, president of the Ontario Jockey Club, and plans for Mohawk were soon approved. On April 26, 1963, the new five-eighths-mile track conducted its inaugural live races.

His Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame biography also noted that Chisholm helped the new racetrack obtain its liquor license, not an insignificant revenue stream in the early years of Mohawk Raceway.

In a Jan. 1, 1993 interview with *The Journal*, Mary Chisholm described her late husband's dedication to improving harness racing in Ontario.

"He contributed a lot," Mary said. "He always made time to help out. Lloyd is largely responsible for bringing Mohawk Raceway to this area. He wanted to have a first-class racing operation and he was concerned that people here might be willing to settle for less. He approached the Ontario Jockey Club and showed them what this area had to offer. It took the racing authorities only a few weeks to decide to build the track on the Guelph Line site."

Lloyd was an accomplished breeder and judge of Guernsey cattle, serving as president of the national breed association. He was also director of the Canadian Live Stock Records Corporation in the 1960s, but became increasingly involved in raising standardbreds after part of his family's farm was expropriated for highway construction and other development. As *The Journal* reported on Jan. 1, 1993, "The government paid \$200 an acre. Lloyd considered that ridiculously low."

A 2023 study by McGill University graduate student Mary Wyn-Gunn found that losing two-thirds of his original 150 acres of farmland convinced Lloyd to get out of the dairy business. "The Department of highways and then the local conservation authority claimed a hundred acres for the Kelso dam project. This had forced Chisholm to sell-off most of his herd of 'prized Guernsey milkers' and turn to raising horses."





And raise horses he did. The U.S. Trotting Association lists nearly 100 standardbreds originating from Arawana Farms.

Lloyd's profile for the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame noted that he bought his first harness horse in 1954 and dispersed his Guernsey cattle herd in 1966. The Dutchess (Volomite—Laurel Hanover) became a founding broodmare at Arawana Farms, producing 11 foals, nine sporting the farm name. Her most successful racing offspring were sons Arawana Oro Spike (p, 6, 2:04.2h; \$17,877); Arawana Danny (p, 8, 2:08.3h; \$22,375); and Arawana Adios (p, 4, 2:06f; \$17,322). Her daughter Arawana Dutchess produced eight offspring bearing the Arawana' prefix. Her best was trotter Arawana Vic (7, 2:06f; \$3,664).

If the purses seem small, remember that they are from the era before Lloyd helped establish the Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) program.

In the Jan. 1, 1993 interview with *The Journal*, Mary told the Milton Historical Society that her husband had developed the idea for the OSS and helped make the concept into a reality. Standardbred Canada historian Robert Smith documented how Lloyd and fellow standardbred breeders Ed Boland, also of Nassagaweya Township, and "Wib" White of St. Marys, ON,

devoted five years to creating a program based on the template of the New York Sires Stakes. When the OSS was introduced in 1973, Smith noted that provincial yearling prices instantly "more than doubled."

This year, the OSS program celebrates its 50th anniversary year with a stakes season that begins with the Grassroots 3-year-old male trotters on Sunday (May 19) at Flamboro Downs. The first Gold events of the season will be at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Saturday (May 25), when the 3-year-old male trotters, 3-year-old male pacers, and 3-year-old pacing fillies debut.

Arawana Farms produced standardbreds from the 1950s through the early 1990s. Lloyd stood stallion Laryngitis (3, 2:05.1f; \$2,133), a Nevele Pride son out of Whispering, half-sister to U.S. Hall of Fame trotter Super Bowl's dam, Pillow Talk. As noted by the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame, General D Brook (4,1:58.2f; \$265,438), a top offspring of Laryngitis, represented Canada in the 1974 Roosevelt International Trot.

Arawana Snap Shot (p, 4, 2:04.2f; \$22,800) was reputedly Lloyd's favorite horse. The Hoot Frost—Arawana Neon mare was a half-sister to five other Arawana Farms winners, and won 10 of 87 lifetime starts. Arawana Snap Shot later became a 100 per cent producer, her four sons all winning in 2:00.4f or faster and collectively earning \$402,933.

Looking back at his career in a 1991 interview, Lloyd was quoted as saying, "I've always been a little out-going. I liked to see progress. I didn't do it to reap the glory; I did it because it was best for the industry."

So, when driving to Woodbine Mohawk Park, consider the historic red barn on the way to the track. The Arawana name may no longer appear in the racing program, but 60 years after it became a standardbred nursery, the influence of Lloyd's family farm is immeasurable.



# TALES FROM THE CURMUDGEON

### Horses have given Ellen Harvey everything and she won't betray their trust, Part 1

Most people would agree that Ellen Harvey has led a most interesting life. So much so, we're going to split this column into two parts. Just as an example, how many people in the sport can you name living today who have had a close relationship with two of the equine giants of the sport's history, the great stallion and racehorse Adios and then a few years later, another great stallion and racehorse Albatross? The list is a pretty short one. It consists of Ellen and her siblings: her brother Leo and sisters Anne and Kathryn.


#### I suppose it begins with Adios. Let's start there.

"Actually, it begins a little before that. My dad [Hall of Famer Harry Harvey] was a second trainer for Delvin Miller. Delvin

All my young life was spent on [Delvin Miller's] Meadow Lands Farm. We lived on a satellite farm and the yearlings were raised at Delvin's ancestral family farm, Bancroft, about 25 miles away... It was a great time and place to be a kid. We had ponies and a pond. Dad cut trails in the woods for us to ride and hike. Buster Henry, Adios' groom, lived in an apartment over Mary Lib and Delvin's and he and his wife Lucy babysat me. Buster taught me how to dunk a donut in (very weak) coffee and I ate Cocoa Puffs in front of their TV, forbidden pleasures at home. ??

had three horses in the 1953 Hambletonian; dad had driven Helicopter all along and he drove her that day.

"She made a break before the start in the first heat. She then scored from post 17 in the third tier of the second heat and won to force the third heat. I recall dad saying that in deep stretch, he was alongside Tom Berry driving Kimberly Kid, the favorite. Tom had given him his first job in the business, as a groom, in 1947. Kimberly Kid was fading, losing his crupper, something dad said he'd never seen before or since. Helicopter went on by and won, but the irony of beating the person who was the reason you were there was not lost on him.

"My mother, Cornelia, was raised near Goshen; she was home from college the summer of 1953 and riding saddlebreds stabled at the same farm as Delvin's horses. Turns out that winning the Hambletonian is a really good way to impress a local girl; they married a year later, after my mother graduated from college.

"My dad grew up on a farm in Vermont and my parents wanted to raise children in one place. Adios was in his ascendency then and dad left the racetrack to manage Meadow Lands Farm for Delvin.


"All my young life was spent on Meadow Lands Farm. We lived on a satellite farm and the yearlings were raised at Delvin's ancestral family farm, Bancroft, about 25 miles away. Dad was there weekly and often said that Bancroft was a major element in the success of Adios' progeny. 'A lot of those horses outraced their pedigrees,' he said.

"I'm hard pressed to fully describe just how hilly it was. The yearlings were up and down hills, and if I recall correctly, water was at the bottom of the hill and feed at the top. That area was rich with bituminous coal and I suppose the water and grass were replete with minerals that contributed to bone density.

"By the time I was old enough to understand the effect Adios was having on the sport, he had already done so. There was nothing too extravagant for Adios. He had a double stall with windows all around and straw up to his knees. His stall was air conditioned at a time when very few people had air conditioning. I'm not sure Delvin and Mary Lib had it. He had a radio tuned in to his favorite station. You couldn't change the station or Adios snorted and stomped. Every year Delvin and Mary Lib had a birthday party for him and always, there was media and a cake concocted out of oats and carrots.

"The walls outside his stall were filled with pictures of Adios with celebrities. I recall Eddie Arcaro coming to the farm — in a suit — to meet Adios.

"My mom occasionally rode the stallions, but never Adios. She knew how valuable he was and didn't want to take chances. Delvin had all manner of horse drawn vehicles, including a surrey that really did have a fringe on top, and a one-horse

sleigh. One Christmas, mom was convinced to drive Adios in the sleigh along the berm of the street along the farm.

"It was a great time and place to be a kid. We had ponies and a pond. Dad cut trails in the woods for us to ride and hike. Buster Henry, Adios' groom, lived in an apartment over Mary Lib and Delvin's and he and his wife Lucy babysat me. Buster taught me how to dunk a donut in (very weak) coffee and I ate Cocoa Puffs in front of their TV, forbidden pleasures at home.


"I knew Amy, Delvin's mother. She lived at Bancroft after Delvin's dad died in the 1918 flu epidemic; she was born in a sod house in South Dakota. She made homemade bread and apple butter for me and had a Lincoln Log set I played with.

"We had Christmas twice a year. Delvin and Mary Lib went to Florida right after Thanksgiving. Mary Lib cooked Thanksgiving dinner and gave us Christmas gifts.

"After Mr. Sheppard bought Adios in 1960 for the then unheard-of price of \$500,000, Adios developed laminitis. There was a steady stream of vets to try to manage this, but in June of 1965, he was euthanized. It was a terribly sad time. Dad had devoted so much time and care to looking after this great horse.

"Without Adios, Delvin started downsizing. Dad saw the handwriting on the wall. He bought the farm we lived on, plus the 100-acre farm next door and started a small breeding operation with two stallions. In his spare time — I'm joking, he had no spare time — he also returned to training and driving at Arden Downs. He raised yearlings, trimmed their feet himself and terraced about 20 acres of the farm to prevent erosion. Maybe there was someone who could outwork dad, but I doubt it.

"Around that time, Jim Harrison was editing the original *Care* and *Training of the Trotter and Pacer* and dad wrote the farm management chapter. We still have a photo Ed Keys took of a kitten when he was at our farm to take photos for the book."

**Author's note:** It is my belief that Adios' progeny most certainly outraced their pedigrees; perhaps to some degree because they were raised at Bancroft, but more because of the absolute dominance of Adios in the breeding arena. There were numerous other offspring of Adios that were raised elsewhere that also outraced their pedigrees.

#### Thus began the Albatross era?

"At first, dad raced mostly at The Meadows and the Pennsylvania fair tracks. I remember going with him to Gratz. There were maybe five races, each race went two heats. He won every race on the card.

"The stable grew to the point where he was in two barns and had two second trainers. The home builder Ed Ryan and 84 Lumber's Joe Hardy gave him horses to train, as did Art Rooney and his son Tim, and Saul Finkelstein on the recommendation of Jimmy Cruise.

"Then came Bert James. Mr. James was a former Canadian automobile dealer who became involved in all facets of the game, especially in racing. He had consigned a peanut-sized Meadow Skipper colt to the 1969 Harrisburg Sale. The colt didn't bring very much, so James bought him back. That colt was Albatross.

"I don't recall seeing Albatross train but I heard a lot about his kicking. He kicked like crazy in his stall. Dad tried various stalls/ windows/neighbors to find a place he liked. My brother was a wrestler and through his coach, dad got wrestling mats to put up in his stall; he kicked those, too. I suppose he just had so much pent-up energy.

"Dad built a paddock for him in the centerfield at Arden Downs and he had a portable version that shipped with him when he raced.

"I don't know as I ever saw Albatross race other than his first baby race at The Meadows. He won easily in about 2:07 and people were stunned. I was in middle school and almost none of his races were anyplace we could get to easily and my mom had her hands full with four children and bookkeeping for the farm and track.

"Albatross kept racing and winning. Dad brought home fancy blankets most weeks and newspaper stories from wherever he'd raced. One of his few losing efforts at 2 was before hometown fans at The Meadows where he was defeated by Billy Haughton's Seton Hanover; I guess I was there but I've scoured that from my brain.

"Dad's goal above all others with Albatross was to win the Fox Stake, then, without doubt, the premier event for 2-year-old pacers. I cannot remember him being more happy, ever, winning a race than that one. My siblings and I taped paper together and made a sign ("Congratulations Albatross") that we put up on the fence along where he parked his truck when he got home, yet again, in the middle of the night.

"I recall dad saying many times, to various people interviewing him, that it wasn't so much his speed or brain or his conformation, that made Albatross great, it was his ability to convert oxygen to energy.

"I was 13 when all this was going on. I never worked at the racing stable or the farm, there was no watching races on satellite then. I heard one end of phone calls and read the stories in the newspapers dad brought home.

"There was a break in his schedule. He had a big race coming up the next week. He tried to get him a race, but all he could find was one against older horses at Roosevelt. I remember some grumbling about it. That was all that was available, so he took it.

"Albatross got pretty much every kind of award he could get that winter. Dad called Frank Ervin and asked him what he did with Bret between 2 and 3 – did he let him down, jog him all winter? Frank advised to 'do a little something' with him every day and not send him away and that's what he did."

**Author's note No. 2:** I believe that through almost 70 years in the sport I've never seen a more dominant 2-year-old than Albatross. He did things among which was something that had never been previously done and almost certainly will never be replicated. He took on and defeated older Saturday Night Specials at Roosevelt after being given the outside post position.

#### **SUNDAY**

I began using Oxycontin when I was 18 years old. I have been an addict for seven long years. I'm lucky to be alive. The inside of my brain is still a battlefield. The demon still lives. Maybe the best I can say is I am keeping the demon at bay, but the demon still terrifies me. I know if I do not make it this time, the odds are I never will. Today, I am six months sober, my longest stretch by far.

I went to church with my mother this morning. Sundays are tricky days for me. Not going to the barn and seeing the horses give me too much time to think. When we got home from the church, I went to my bedroom and read this diary. I cried several times, strange tears. Some were tears of sadness, and others were of gratitude. Gratitude is not an emotion I am familiar with. So many people helped me, well, tried to help me. I have been horrible to them.

If I had to name a turning point, it would be the horse therapy program at my last rehab. Yeah, I messed it up, did not finish the program, and relapsed twice, but being around good people and horses planted a seed.



#### **Harness Racing Update**

When I was using, everything in my life was designed around one thing – filling my need for drugs. My relationships with people, what I did from the moment I woke up until I passed out, drugs were the center of everything. Everything that went wrong was someone else's fault, and my need squashed any iota of empathy. My life was me, me, me, drugs, drugs, drugs.

I am hopeful that I may make it out of the darkness. I feel a crack in those walls because I am beginning to feel grateful. My mom is a rockstar, the one person who has never wavered. The drug programs and NA did not fail me. I failed them. Paul, a disgraced addict, has shown me a path. And the horses, God, those horses, they are magic. No more writing today. I'm getting misty – damn empathy. (LOL)

#### **MONDAY**

I have a dream. Right now, the dream is like me, fragile as a soap bubble. I am afraid if I say this dream out loud, it will burst and disappear, so I have not told anyone, but I will write it in this diary. That way, the dream can stay alive, and I can think about it before I suggest it to Paul.

I believe that there is a particular ingredient that allows people with an addiction to reach the stage of sobriety that Paul has reached. I think that a person with an addiction needs to progress from needing crutches to becoming a crutch.

I want to try helping a few recovering people with a substance use disorder. Retired racehorses need good homes and are donated. I keep thinking about plotting a project involving some form of equine therapy.

Oh well, one day at a time. One thing is for sure — we will never run out of people with addictions who need help or magical horses needing homes.

I see this in Paul every day. Before I knew him, he was a total mess and should be dead after years and years of drug abuse. He was an overweight pariah with zero self-respect. Like me, he tried everything and was a lost cause. Both of us were getting older and using in an endless circle. The most significant change I see, which is not scientific, is that Paul somehow shifted when his grandfather died.

The main difference in his life was that he needed to care for his mom and grandmom. Somehow, someway, this purpose allowed him to pass that test he had failed many times. Each day, he was sober and purposeful. His sobriety led him not just to attend NA meetings but to lead the meetings. Again, another purpose for him was to help others. Then he took ME on as another opportunity to help. Each day, he had a reason to rise and not an excuse to use.

Six months sober is a LONG way from sobriety, but I am feeling some pangs of benefits from helping others. One little thing I am doing is gently, very gently, nudging Bart, the alcoholic who works at the farm, to attend meetings. Bart is a good guy. He is in his 30s, and I see goodness in him, but his drinking is destructive and getting worse. It's weird being in my mental space, the twilight between using and not using. People with an addiction are, in a way similar to politics, separated into tribes - users and non-users. Users resent the non-users and have a hard time listening. But Bart and I have reached a little breathing space. He doesn't bark at me to mind my business if I approach him with a joke instead of a flat-out suggestion. Bart is a stubborn, prideful guy. Maybe my nagging will help him, or it won't help him.

A germ of an idea got planted when I reported for the rehab horse project. I knew nothing about horses, farms, or horse racing. But on the first day, being around horses made a difference. When the dust settles from Paul's pin hooking experiment, I will see if any horses remain in the barn. The gist of my idea is to bring a few addicts struggling with sobriety to report to the farm and work with horses. The structure of how this could work is unclear, but I know that ever since the fentanyl scourge, money has been on the table for treatment options at the federal, state, local, and municipal levels.

I want to try helping a few recovering people with a substance use disorder. Retired racehorses need good homes and are donated. I keep thinking about plotting a project involving some form of equine therapy. Oh well, one day at a time. One thing is for sure — we will never run out of people with addictions who need help or magical horses needing homes.

## Scarlett Wilder – It's in her genes

Breeding and producing a potential world champion takes guts, brains, and a whole lot of luck.

I guess you could say developing a champion can also work the same way with humans. A great example is this week's superstar Scarlett Wilder.

Born to Mike and Heather Wilder — two incredibly talented, humble, and respectful people — Scarlett's lineage goes a bit deeper as her grandfather, horseman Dan Altmeyer, was the developer of superstar racehorses Cambest, Make A Success, Santastic Pan, Look Out Hanover and Michael's Western.


Ruth, Dan's wife, and Scarlett's grandmother, was a Rankin — sister of the late great buckeye Dave Rankin — so I guess you could call Scarlett royally bred in the sport of harness racing.

## Where were you born and where do you live today?

"I was born in Washington, PA, and live on the family farm located there."

## When did you know you wanted to follow in your family's footsteps?

"Growing up my passion was in the riding horses. I was probably 13 when I started to groom for my parents in the summer. By the time I was 17 or 18 I retired my barrel horse and decided to get more involved with the racehorses."



#### What about your barrel-racing career?

"I barrel raced for most of my youth, winning many championships, qualifying for big races, and finally running at the Junior National Finals Rodeo in Las Vegas in 2019 where I finished 24th in the nation. My horse Rollin With The Stars was retired after that run. I often get asked to ride for other people, but today I enjoy coaching and giving lessons to kids who want to get started in the sport and 'Rollin' is the most amazing lesson horse."

## Recently you received your nursing degree. Where do you work and how do you manage to juggle schedules?

"I am currently a registered nurse in the critical unit at The Washington Hospital. On the days I am not working at the hospital, I help my family groom, jog, and train at The Meadows."

#### What about driving?

"I have not yet driven in a pari-mutuel race but I did drive in two qualifiers with my horse America First, and look forward to more opportunities to drive in the future."

#### Who is your all-time-favorite horse?

"I am a little biased, but my favorite would have to be Cambest. My grandfather trained him as a 2- and 3-year-old, launching his remarkable career as a world champion and shaping him into becoming one of the all-time best standardbreds ever.

"When he was sold, as we do not keep horses past the age of 3 (our focus is on young horses), I admired Cambest for the ability to set the amazing record of 1:46.1 (this was in 1993) which stood for 24 years before broken by Always B Miki. Cambest, he was a true champion in his time, as well as our time today, as not many horses will ever see a mile that fast."

#### What was your biggest moment in the sport?

"There were many. Many people would assume it would be my first training win or first time driving my own horses, but I would have to say it was watching my father win The Adios with Catch The Fire, or when he won the first elimination of The Little Brown Jug with Catch The Fire."

#### How do you think we can improve our sport?

"I think we need fresh, new blood. It is our job to make that happen. We need to welcome outsiders in and teach them about our sport and how much fun it could be. I can personally say that it is very hard being young and starting out because you don't have the experience.

"I believe Roger Huston said it best one morning at The Little Brown Jug, 'If you see a young person in this sport trying to make it, don't try to stop them but encourage them and give them all the help and support in the world."

#### What are your plans for the future?

"I'm planning to join my family in DeLand, FL, in the winter to help train babies, as well as do some travel nursing while I'm there. I want to learn as much about the business to potentially be the one to take it over in years to come, as I am the only grandchild interested at the present time. My sister Lauren and my cousins Grace and Luke enjoy watching the horse races, but I want to eventually own horses in the stable and keep it a family business."

#### What person do you admire most in the business?

"I am so blessed to have the role models of my grandfather and father who is now in his 38th year of driving. He started out driving matinees at 14 years old and has almost 9,000 wins and \$76,000,000 in career earnings.

I really didn't know much at the time, but by the grace of God, Greengo supported my family for many years, although his crazy antics had me on edge every week. He was wicked fast and back then would go to the front no matter how fast and only get caught the last few steps at the wire. I don't believe he ever sat in a hole.

Greengo was banned from the winner's circle after he once jumped the fence into the grandstand. Talk about nerve-racking.

After every race ended, the horsemen would part in the paddock like the Red Sea to let Greengo come off the track and into the paddock in order to stop him. Yes, he was nuts, but I loved him and kept him until he died.

Being new in the business I guess it was crazy to claim a horse from Dan for he was one of the best trainers there. But things worked out and Dan was a gentleman in helping me out.

As good a horseman as Dan is, Scarlett's father Mike is equally as good a driver. So, it came as no surprise to anyone when Scarlett decided to carry on her family's legacy.

The Altmeyers and Wilders are some of the most respected, admired and liked people in our sport. I call them good friends and wish them all the luck in the future.

## Seven Colors aims for redemption in Juravinski final

After watching Seven Colors take a misstep in his Charles Juravinski Memorial Cup elimination this past weekend, trainer Andrew Harris is hoping to see the 4-year-old pacer put his best foot forward in today's (May 19) \$263,000 final at Flamboro Downs.

Seven Colors went off-stride at the start of his elim, getting away seventh in the seven-horse field, but rallied to finish fourth to advance to the Juravinski final. He will start from post 1 in today's (May 19) event for 4-year-old pacers with regular driver Dexter Dunn in the sulky after Trevor Henry guided the stallion in the elimination. He is the 2-1 second choice on the morning line.

Pacers win at a 20.2-per cent clip leaving from post 1 at Flamboro Downs, the best win percentage of any of the nine starting spots at the half-mile oval.

"He's doing good now," Harris said. "The elim didn't exactly go our way; nothing went our way that day. But, touch wood, it seems like everything is starting to go our way now. He's drawn the rail, so that's a good spot, and right now he seems great."

Harris was unsure why Seven Colors made his miscue in the elimination, which was his seasonal debut. The horse's only other break in 25 career starts came in September of his 2-year-old season in 2022.

"You don't ever expect anything like that to happen," said Harris, who began training Seven Colors in August 2023 following his purchase by a group that includes himself, Bill Pollock, and Bruce Areman. "I think it was just one of those random things. He got around the track perfect after that. Trevor said he was perfect on the turns.

"We'll just reset and look ahead. I trained him a little bit [in Canada on Thursday] and he seemed great. We're in it, we've got the rail, and Dexter is coming back up. We'll just put our best foot forward and try to get it done."

Last year, Seven Colors won seven of 18 races and hit the board an additional six times on his way to \$685,220 in purses. He finished second in the Cane Pace in his final start for trainer Brian Brown, then captured the Carl Milstein Memorial in 1:48.1 at Northfield Park in his debut with Harris. That winning time is the fastest in history for a 3-year-old pacer on a half-mile track.

Seven Colors also won the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes championship for 3-year-old male pacers and finished second in the Little Brown Juq.

A son of Stay Hungry—Rainbowinthedark, Seven Colors will have a full stakes schedule ahead of him this season.

"He came back three times bigger than he was last year, and he's way stronger," Harris said. "He's got a full dance card. It will

be fun to get to travel around with him again."

No Control and All Class were the winners of the Juravinski eliminations. No Control, trained by Tan Micallef and driven by Louis Roy, will start from post 4 and is the 8-5 favorite. All Class, with Bob McClure in the sulky for trainer Per Engblom, leaves from post 5 and is the 5-2 third choice.

Racing begins at 6:55 p.m. (EDT) at Flamboro Downs.



# Dan Patch winner Geocentric launches soph campaign with unpressured PASS win

Defending Dan Patch Award winner **Geocentric** kicked off her sophomore campaign in worker-like fashion, knifing through the slop to score in 1:51.1 in Friday's (May 17) Pennsylvania Sire Stakes at Hollywood Casino at The Meadows. **Pass And Stow** and **Rocket Deo** captured the other division in the event for 3-year-old filly pacers.

When trainer Brian Brown was speculating a few days before the race about what his perfect trip would look like, he described it as a "win without paying a big price." The trip unfolded as if Brown had drawn it up. The 1-5 favorite, Geocentric shot to the lead at the quarter for Tim Tetrick and never faced pressure thereafter, winning for the 10th time in 11 career outings. Sweet Gal was second, 13/4-lengths back, with Asweetbeachhere third.

"That was the perfect race to start one out with," Brown said. "I wish it hadn't been sloppy, but we can't have everything. I think we'll tighten her head pole a little. She put in a step in the first turn and got to running in."

He indicated Geocentric will next race in the Fan Hanover at Woodbine Mohawk Park. Milton Leeman, Alan Keith, Jim Stambaugh and Joe Sbrocco campaign the daughter of Sweet Lou—Geometry, who now boasts a lifetime bankroll of \$581.088.

Pass And Stow hadn't led until the last call in any of her six most recent races, yet Aaron Merriman, who had never driven her before, decided the point is where she belonged. The daughter of Betting Line—OK Heavenly rolled to an easy front-end victory in a stakes- and career-best 1:50.4. Melmar Melmar finished second, beaten 2 lengths, while Whassup Hanover completed the ticket and saw her four-race winning streak snapped.

"She was very good in her last start at Woodbine Mohawk," Merriman said. "She was super, steered straight. I don't know how many times she's cut miles, but she did today."

Anthony Beaton conditions Pass And Stow for West Wins Stable and Mark Dumain.

Rocket Deo was riding the bumper of Breeders Crown champion My Girl EJ, who had been hard used to get the lead. Did Andrew McCarthy think the daughter of Captaintreacherous—Rocklamation had a chance to kick by her more celebrated rival?

"I just needed to get out," McCarthy said. "I had plenty of go, just needed some room and let the big girl pace. She's very slick, very powerful."

Rocket Deo did kick by, downing My Girl EJ by a length in 1:51.1, a new life mark, with Donegal Spirit third. Brett Pelling trains Rocket Deo for Morrison Racing Stables and John Fielding.

#### PA Stallion Series — 3-Year-Old Filly Pacers

Classic Crunch, Parkavanue Lisa, Direction and Davenport each took a division of Friday's sub-feature, the Pennsylvania Stallion Series, with Pelling enjoying a double — Direction and Davenport — giving him three wins over the day's stakes.

Classic Crunch lost the first nine starts of her career before breaking her maiden last week at Harrah's Philadelphia. To some, the daughter of Captain Crunch—Classic Star may have appeared overmatched. But not to Dexter Dunn.

"She was really good," said Dunn, who prevailed for trainer Chris Ryder and owner Ruari McNulty. "That's the first time I sat behind her, but I think she's probably a little stronger than she was last year. That was a solid mile for her. She gave me a good feel."

Classic Crunch triumphed in a career-best 1:51, 2½-lengths ahead of Capytreach. Sweet Illusion earned show.

## **Grace Hill wins first race of 2024 at Scioto Downs**

The Dan Patch 2023 Older Female Pacer of the Year, **Grace Hill**, won her first start of 2024 at Eldorado Scioto Downs on Friday (May 17). Leaving from their assigned post 8, Tony Hall sent Grace Hill straight to the top and won the \$27,000 fillies and mares open pace by three-quarters of a length in 1:50.3.

Trained by Virgil Morgan, Jr., Grace Hill set opening fractions of :26.3, :55 and 1:22.1. Coming home in :28.2, the 6-year-old daughter of Always B Miki held off stablemate Alexa Skye (Dan Noble), who finished second, and a hard charging Scorecard Dandy (Sam Widger) who was third. Grace Hill, owned by Tom Hill, earned \$573,526 and took her 1:47.4 lifetime mark at Woodbine Mohawk Park in 2023 on her way to divisional Dan Patch honors. She qualified three times before making her seasonal debut at Scioto.

Also on the Friday evening card was the \$26,000 open trot, won by **Spitfire Oversees** (Brett Miller) in 1:53.2. The 4-year-old ridgling by International Moni is trained by Stacey Van Huizen for Thestable Spitfireovrsees. He now has four wins in his last

seven starts and \$91,750 earned in his 14 seasonal starts in 2024. Scorecard Dan (Sam Widger) finished second and Wildfire Seelster (Jeremy Smith) was third.

The 90-day 2024 Eldorado Scioto Downs race meet runs through Saturday (Sept. 14). Races are held Tuesday-Saturday, with special holiday cards on Memorial Day and Labor Day taking place instead of the Tuesday card that week. First post is at 5:45 p.m. each day except for Thursday (July 4) with a post of 3:15 p.m. and Friday (Sept. 13) which will have a 6:15 p.m. post to help accommodate horsemen attending the Ohio Selected Yearling Sale. ## Agent Of Fortune, Helpem Dance romp in series finals at Hoosier

Sophomore trotters took center stage on Friday (May 17) at Harrah's Hoosier Park with a pair of \$25,000 series finals highlighting the 14-race card. **Agent Of Fortune** completed a clean sweep of the Msnaughtybynature series, while **Helpem Dance** shook loose late claim the Expresson each for non-winners of two trotters.

The Msnaughtybynature for the fillies served as the eighth race on the card, with Agent Of Fortune sent off as the 1-5 favorite from post 4. Driver Robert Taylor settled in the third position off the gate while Ponda Aesthetic (Jordan Ross) worked hard to clear Swan So Fine (Marvin Luna) for the lead just beyond the first quarter of :28.2. Taylor gave Agent Of Fortune her cue on the backstretch to quickly take command of the field before reaching the halfway point in :57.1. Agent Of Fortune began to separate herself from the field on the final turn, stretching her lead to 2½ lengths at three-quarters in 1:26, while Swan So Fine ranged first-over into second.

Turning for home, Swan So Fine utilized her momentum to reach the leader's wheel at the top of the stretch, but Agent Of Fortune dug in gamely to rebuff the challenge. Trotting home in :27.4, Agent Of Fortune reasserted her lead back out to 2 lengths on the wire over Swan So Fine to score in a lifetime best 1:53.4, Kanita (Atlee Bender) would round out the trifecta.

Taylor also does the training of Agent Of Fortune who is now perfect through four starts in 2024. Owned by Taylor Racing LLC and Bert Paddock, the daughter of Dover Dan—Posterity surged into six-figures in career earnings, having now banked \$109,700. The victory was one of two training wins on the evening for Taylor, who teamed up with Jordan Ross to score in the \$22,000 open pace with **Crooked Smile** in 1:49.3 later on the card.

Helpem Dance used off the pace tactics to take the Expresson final in just his second start of his 3-year-old season. Leaving

from post 6, driver Ricky Macomber, Jr. took back in the early-stages while Hudson Swan (Jordan Ross) protected the rail position to lead to the quarter in :27.1. Bear's The One (Robert Taylor) pushed to the lead and took charge to the half in :57 while Water Torpedo (Mike Oosting) assumed command of the outer-flow. Bear's The One continued to lead as the field entered the final turn, reaching three-quarters in 1:26.3 as Helpem Dance shook off the rail from sixth with 5 lengths to make up turning for home.

In the stretch, Helpem Dance swung wide and began to pick up steam, exploding home with a :27.1 final quarter to power to the lead. Helpem Dance crossed the wire 2¼-lengths clear to stop the timer in a career best 1:54.4. Hudson Swan rallied up the passing lane to finish second, with First Option (Dan Shetler) closing for third. Helpem Dance returned \$7 to his backers at the betting windows.

Trained by Jamie Macomber, the victory was the second in the career of Helpem Dance through eight lifetime starts. The gelded son of Helpisontheway—Serena's Serenade is owned by Doug Overhiser and vaulted his career earnings to \$33,030 with the win.

### 'Benjamin' guns down Lexus Kody in Big M feature

**Benjamin Hanover** used an ideal pocket trip and a perfect steer from Hall of Fame driver Dave Miller to take down 1-2 favorite Lexus Kody Friday night (May 17) at The Meadowlands in the \$27,500 featured winners-over trot.

Looking for a fourth straight win, Lexus Kody was predictably away quickly from post 7 in the seven-horse field and settled on the front out of the first turn. Miller had Benjamin Hanover on the go, and settled into the 2-hole as Lexus Kody hit the quarter in :26.4, which may have been the difference in the outcome, since his fastest opening panel during his three-race win streak was :27.2.

There were no issues down the backside, as Lexus Kody trotted the half in :55.1 and three-quarters in 1:23.1, with all appearing well for the chalk players.

But just after straightening away with three-sixteenths-of-amile to go, Miller eased Benjamin Hanover off the rail, and inched away at the leader's edge through the entirety of the stretch drive before hitting the wire a head in front of Lexus Kody in a lifetime-best 1:50.3, four-fifths-of-a-second faster than his previous mark. Stabile Genius was third.

"He's a little bit of a nervous horse, a little antsy," said Miller. "So, I gave him a score to calm him down. After that, he felt like himself. [In his last start, when he broke at the start but eventually finished second] he was way too hot and got crammed at the gate. Tonight, my plan was to sit the pocket and he got his nose up. He went a couple of real good races at [Harrah's Philadelphia] and we couldn't be happier with him."

Trained by Joe Holloway, Benjamin Hanover is putting together a superb season. He's won half of his eight starts and hit the board on seven occasions. The 4-year-old gelded son of Sebastian K S—By A Nack Hanover now has 11 victories from just 18 lifetime attempts, good for earnings of \$85,730 for owners Sarah J Andrews, Angela Cornell and Jarod M Miller.

As the 4-1 second choice, Benjamin Hanover paid \$10.80 to win.

A LITTLE MORE: There were no winning favorites during the Early 20-cent Pick-5 sequence, but none of the winners went off at odds greater than 6-1. Those with winning tickets were rewarded with a payoff of \$1,051.78. All-source betting on the 14-race card totaled \$3,102,763, the 32nd time from 38 race cards this year when wagering went past the \$3-million mark.

### Ruthless Hanover, Twin B Joe Fresh return Sunday at Philly

A week from this coming Sunday (May 26), Harrah's Philadelphia will be holding its annual Super Sunday, with three \$100,000 invitationals (pace, trot, mare pace), a \$50,000 invitational, and a preliminary round of the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes for 3-year-old pacing colts.

Today's card at Harrah's Philly has no such big-money races on the schedule, but it does contain three horses of national interest; two of which may be racing seven days afterwards.

Ruthless Hanover, who last season paced the fastest mile ever on a five-eighths-mile track, 1:46.3, at Philly, makes his seasonal debut in the fast-class pace. Now 7, the altered son of Captaintreacherous, trained by Tom Cancelliere and owned by his brother John, has made only 54 career starts, but he's made the most of his 22 victories, including his win in the Auger Memorial on Super Sunday 2023. In that race he laid down supersonic splits of :25.2,:53, and 1:19.2 en route to his world record clocking.

Ruthless Hanover has had two qualifiers to prep for his 2024 bow, in the latter missing a half-length to A Rocknroll Star in 1:50.4 at The Meadowlands. Andrew McCarthy has been tapped for the fifth race driving assignment behind Ruthless Hanover.

A race later, the star distaff Twin B Joe Fresh, winner of \$1,440,263 at 2 and 3 while battling the great Sylvia Hanover, makes her first start of the year against a field of fellow 4-year-olds, her opposition being all males. Twin B Joe Fresh is well-remembered by eastern Pennsylvania fans for her memorable clash with 'Sylvia' in last year's Lynch Memorial at Pocono, where the pair dueled through a :25.4 third quarter before Sylvia Hanover lapsed from stride, with Twin B Joe Fresh taking full advantage.

Twin B Joe Fresh, who has a mark of 1:48.2, comes to this race off a pair of qualifiers at The Meadowlands, the latter a win in 1:51.2,:26 final quarter. She also has drawn post 4, with Dexter Dunn in the bike for trainer Chris Ryder; those two are also co-owners with Peter Trebotica and Barry Spak.

Today's first race features the horse who recorded the fastest mile of the local season, 1:49.1. That would be Total Stranger, who accomplished the feat while breaking his maiden. A son of Bettor's Delight and a full brother to champion Tall Dark Stranger, Total Stranger, good but not a winner at 2, came out of the box roaring for trainer Nancy Takter and the partnership of Judith Taylor, Caviart Farms, and Chuck Pompey. Like the other two horses featured in this release, he'll start from post 4, with the meet's leading driver, Tim Tetrick, piloting him.

Ruthless Hanover might defend his Auger title on the 26th, and Twin B Joe Fresh, who beat older mares in the FanDuel Championship last year, might be in the Betsy Ross mare pace, but Total Stranger is Ontario-sired, and thus cannot be in the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes on Super Sunday. (It's doubtful a horse two races removed from maiden status would try such a huge step up to an invitational level, but there may be a conditioned race for him that day).
