Time has not affected Carter Duer's ability to spot good horses

A few days ago, I was following a post on Facebook from Clay Horner about a sister to the leading money winner of 2026 (so far), Tarapasta (\$346,900 this year and \$820,395 lifetime), a mare that he had recently acquired.

Strangely, for me, I wasn't all that familiar with her pedigree. So, I went to Pathway and drew out a five-generation lineage of her ancestors. It was not all that surprising that she comes from one of the great maternal families in the sport, that of Midnight.

Her fifth dam is a Worthy Boy mare named Stand By who was quite familiar to me. I remembered her not by her lineage, but rather by what I remembered of her as a race filly. She was the first standardbred that I had ever seen that wore a hood when racing. Not so surprising, in that her trainer, Billy Haughton, would try almost anything that he thought might help one of his equine pupils.

What to me was a little surprising is that Stand By's dam Alerted came from a rather non-productive *trotting* branch of a great family, which until Stand By's emergence was all but dead. Since Stand By, there have been four consecutive maternal pacing generations of top producers including chronologically, Scene Stopper, Sabella Lobell, Mattaroni, and now Pasta Blue Chip who is the dam of Tarapasta. Another major 2026 performer from that immediate family in addition to Tarapasta is the recent Harrah's Philadelphia track record holder Captain Optimistic (\$1,146,257).

Something else in Stand By's pedigree caught my eye. Something that I had not previously noticed. In addition to her being trotting-bred, she was sired by Worthy Boy, a son of Volomite and out of the mare Alerted who was by Lusty Song, also a son of Volomite. Although it is not that strange to find such incidences of line breeding today, it was rather rare back then.

Why and how did this mating come about? I went to what I believed was the source, Carter Duer, who I believed was the farm manager at Castleton Farms when Stand By was bred. I

called Duer and asked him the question. He didn't immediately recall what had led to the mating, but said he would give it some thought. I said that while we were at it, I asked him why don't we explore a second interview with The Curmudgeon in HRU? The first one, [here](#), was in the issue of March 27, 2021. Time for an update, I thought.

I called him the next day.

The answer was that Duer, although working there at the time, was not yet the farm manager at Castleton. Bill Brown was still at the helm. Duer's guess was that the mating likely came about by happenstance. Back then it was kind of rare for market breeders who stood stallions to breed their mares away from the farm. He thought that later on in his career Brown might have attempted such a mating, but he doubted that he would have done it knowingly at the time. In simple terms, he guessed that it came about by accident. Castleton was standing Worthy Boy, so they decided to breed him to Alerted.

Thus, this week's column came about.

We old guys are becoming somewhat of a rarity these days. Many of us have died off and others have, in the words of General MacArthur, just faded away. But you still maintain a significant presence in the sport.

“I don't know how significant it is. I certainly don't do near as much, nor am I near as involved as I once was. These days I tend to do mostly what it pleases me to do. That involves helping to raise and prepare the yearlings for sale. I tend to stay away from the daily, sometimes mundane chores on the farm such as foaling, teasing, and inseminating the mares.


“I still follow racing. I like to think that I do it with as near a passion as I once did.

“Where in the past, I'd rely on the phone and for lack of a better term, hearsay, on letting me know how horses raced, today I can watch every horse and see every race that I want to see - live. It's a great source of enjoyment to me. I'm now able to leave the more boring chores to the kids. I suppose that's one of the few benefits of growing old.

“As beneficial as this has been for me personally, it also has its negatives. The major one is that it has kept me away from the racetrack and our major events. The last time I was at the Hambletonian was the year that Malabar Man won. I used to go to the Jug every year. I don’t remember the last time I was there.”

You are now nearing your 87th birthday. You have previously faced a few health issues. How would you describe your health?

“I would say that generally speaking it is pretty good. Although I still use that cane that you gifted to me many years ago at Harrisburg, I consider myself to be pretty mobile. I sometimes suffer from low blood pressure which causes me to feel dizzy occasionally, but thankfully rarely, pass out. I get along pretty well for an old guy.

“I think that mentally, for what it is, I am near as sharp as I ever was. I think I can still look at a horse as well as I ever could.”

Speaking of looking at a horse. I have known thousands of horsepeople through my many years in the sport. You are unique and among the very few, who once they saw a horse, that horse’s image was imprinted in your brain forever. If you were to see it years later, you likely would be able to identify it.

“I don’t know why. But that has been the case all of my life. I look upon it as being lucky. I consider it to have been a helping point in my career.”

You’ve been involved with horses, almost literally, since you’ve been able to walk and talk. What is it about the transition of the sport that you find most interesting?

“First of all, and most importantly, the horses themselves – in just about every way. They are certainly a whole lot faster, smarter, talented, and quicker to come to their speed.

“In a relatively short period of time, we have managed to breed out most of the defects, especially with regard to conformation and increase the positives. I look back to when I was at Castleton. We, and most commercial breeders of the day, produced an offering that couldn’t come close to matching the individuals that are being produced today.

“I’m not sure of the trainers being quite the all-around horsemen as some of those back then. Probably some of it goes back to the horses being so good today and the business being more specialized. Our trainers today don’t face some of the problems that those guys did. It seems like with trotters especially, a lot of the Europeans and Down Under guys have been close to the front of the pack here. People like Noel Daley, Marcus Melander, Ake Svanstedt, and a Swede by birth in Nancy Takter, do extremely well. Of course, at or near the top of every category, especially with pacers, you have Ronnie Burke. That man and his operation are simply amazing. I have no idea how he does it, but he continues to do it at the highest of levels.

“As there always are, there are several Canadians who do an exceptionally good job of developing good horses. Dr. [Ian] Moore seems to come up with one or more good ones each year. So do folks like Mark Steacy, Dave Menary, and Carl Jamieson. I know I’m leaving out some names that should be included. For that I apologize. My excuse would be that of an old guy. I just forget. I’m certain that there are some of those who stand out today, who would have likely done extremely well back then.

“But I don’t see as many Baldwins, Ervins, Millers, Haughtons, Simpsons, and Dancer types as those I experienced in those

years. Maybe a big part of it, is that of the great natural talent of the horses themselves and the fact that those men both trained and drove their horses.

“Those guys reached their areas of success because they had to. They had no other choice. They had to make good racehorses out of often imperfect individuals. The only other option available to them was failure.

“On the other hand, the drivers today are generally so much better than they used to be. There are so many of them that are very good. If they weren't, they wouldn't survive. Back then,

the vast majority of the drivers were also trainers. There were a few that were good at doing both - but very few.

“Today's drivers as a group are so much better in so many ways than those who came before.”

There is a horse racing today by who I am overwhelmed. His name is Beau Jangles. What I am about to say I believe is crazy. Years ago, Delvin Miller told me he believed that one day the fastest horse ever would be a 2-year-old. You told me that John Hayes said the same to you. It hasn't happened yet. It may never happen. But I believe that Beau Jangles could have been that horse. Wisely, Dr. Moore didn't try to accomplish that with him. What are your thoughts on him?

“I'm not about to say that I either agree or disagree with what you said. If you asked me if I felt that he is one of the greatest 2-year-olds I've ever seen? He undoubtedly is. Perhaps the greatest ever.

“He did what he did at 2 without seemingly ever being seriously challenged.

“His mile last week at Mohawk in 1:49.3 looked to me to be the easiest sub-1:50 mile I’ve ever seen by a horse of any age.

“They say, especially in these times, that time is just a number. I suppose that, to some degree, is true. But I believe a sub-1:50 mile by a 3-year-old making his second seasonal start and having it look like a walk in the park is extraordinary. I look forward to watching what he can and likely will do as the season goes on.”

We’ll close by discussing a horse, who in my opinion, in a very short period of time, might be responsible for an upheaval in the trotting breed. His name is Captain Corey. You bred and raised him. On the eve of his 3-year-old season, you mentioned him in glowing terms in our last interview. What do you remember about him?

“I’ll use one word to describe him. That word is *special*. That’s what he was from the day he was foaled until where he is now.

“I owned this Angus Hall mare named Luv U All. She was okay, but just that in all respects. She didn’t have a remarkable pedigree – just an all right one. We trained her and she looked promising, but not much more than that. She had broken a bone in an ankle as a weanling. Maybe that compromised her. But in terms of talent, she came across as just being average. We were approached by Corey Callahan who had a booking to the hybrid trotter with a pacing pedigree, Googoo Gaagaa, that then was standing at Richard Hans place in Maryland. I had seen the horse race. He was a very fast and a quite impressive trotter. It was May, and I hadn’t booked Luv U All yet. I thought to myself, ‘Why not?’

“From the time he was foaled, he was remarkable. He was great looking. He seemed very smart and had a terrific nervous system. He grew into the beautiful yearling I hoped he would become.

“Nevertheless, what could I hope a yearling not eligible to any significant sires stakes, with an ordinary pedigree page, might bring - as good looking as he was and as much as I liked him?

What happened at the sale?

“I indeed got lucky. He ended up selling for \$150,000! I was thrilled. Even more so when I found out that the great Swedish trainer Ake Svanstedt was going to become his mentor. The colt that I liked so much was going to get the chance to become what I thought he might become.

“Did I envision him becoming a Hambletonian winner? Of course not. Even more enthralling, did I believe in him becoming the stallion that it now looks like he will become? Almost certainly

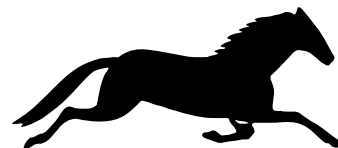

not. Either one of those two happening is like catching lightning in a bottle. Having them both happen is almost miraculous.

“In our last conversation, I mentioned how highly I thought of him. He had won five-in-a-row at 2. He then lost a couple. Then Ake wisely stopped with him. At that point, I thought he had a chance, but only a chance of becoming a special horse.”

But you did believe greatly in his destiny after he was retired to stud.

“When he was syndicated after his 3-year-old season, I asked to buy two shares. They only allowed me to acquire one. In addition, they did allow me to breed another as a paid booking. That’s business I suppose. But I was disappointed.

“I’ve bred to him every year that he has been in the stud, both using my syndicate share and in paying for an additional booking. This breeding season I was cut off from my paid booking.

“I believe what he has shown thus far from his first crop may only be the tip of the iceberg. He did get full books each season. That will help any stallion. But, for the most part, the mares he received were just decent, with very few great or near great ones among them. His first year’s crop to the races was sensational.

“The other day at Pocono, there were three divisions of the Pennsylvania All-Stars for 3-year-old trotting colts. These are what is looked upon as being good, but not the top bunch of 3-year-old trotting colts. They won two of the divisions and finished second in the other one, with each division going around 1:52. Not bad for 3-year-old trotters early in the season. [Yesterday (May 23)] the All-Stars had four divisions of fillies. Get this, 12 of the starters in those races are by Captain Corey.

“I don’t believe I’ve ever seen a trotting sire who gets so many of his offspring to the races at this sort of top level. They have thus far included many stakes winners and high-quality trotters.

“We’ve got four of his yearlings to sell this fall. They just have a look about them. You can pretty much just pick them out.

“Beginning with this year’s book, he has received a full book of some of the best mares in the sport. This portends for the results for his offspring improving as time goes on. Of course, that’s the logic. But this is harness racing and sometimes logic doesn’t prevail. But I sure as heck wouldn’t be surprised, nor would I bet against it happening.”

Giving credit to Oak Grove for handle gains

There has been much warranted attention on Oak Grove Racing in recent weeks, as it wraps up what should be considered an historic month of May for the relatively young track.

Thoroughbred synergies between ownership group Churchill Downs Incorporated and the May 2 Kentucky Derby located less than 200 miles from the southwestern Kentucky harness track first kickstarted the Grand Circuit month. From there, sire stakes and Grand Circuit stakes along with their alternate gaming-fueled purses has bolstered stakes opportunities, and it was highlighted by last Saturday's "Festival of Racing" concept that saw the 3-year-old trotting races the Oak Grove Trotting Derby and the Oak Grove Trotting Oaks go for \$500,000 and \$300,000, respectively.

But for purposes of this column, success has been the record-breaking handle. It's one thing for tracks to be the beneficiary of inherited purses and develop a stakes program, but at the same time, Oak Grove has also increased the amount of money wagered on its product in a meaningful way.

Two days after the Kentucky Derby, Oak Grove absolutely crushed its former best race day handle. Handle for the Monday (May 4) card was over \$873,000, where the record prior to that in the track's six-year history was just \$582,000. In the context of the track's history, the \$873,000 number was massive. That, of course, led to an overall record-breaking week, and that momentum continued.

Speaking earlier this week with track announcer Peter Kleinhans, who also shared track broadcasting responsibilities with Ray Cotolo, he highlighted some of the success seen this month.

"Today is actually the perfect time to talk about it because yesterday [May 19] was an amazing day for us," Kleinhans said on Wednesday. "Tuesdays are usually much worse than Mondays, but yesterday was our third or fourth highest handle ever and similar to Monday. It really has been a few great weeks since the Derby. And I think a lot of it this week had to do with the carryover in the Pick-4, which ended up working out great."

"I also think there's a really great flavor to the racing here. It's great that we have the contingent from Mississippi here – I love that entire group. I see this track as one of the few places where you can see relations between all these different groups of people coming together."

The Pick-4 referenced by Kleinhans turned out to be incredibly successful. Though, funny enough, not the way it was planned. For last Saturday's Pick-4 that included the two big stakes races on the Festival of Racing card, the track issued a \$20,000 pool guarantee. But only \$13,463 was bet into it, falling short of the guarantee.

As things played out, however, the Pick-4 kicked off with a bomb when Aperfect Annie upset the heavily-favored Dan Patch winner Yo Tillie to pay \$119. From there, a carryover was almost a certainty, and that was finalized in the last race when Breeders Crown champion Spencer Hanover was let go at odds of 4-1 and beat Endurance, which forced an unplanned and unlikely carryover into the Monday card. On Monday, between the carryover and an upped guarantee to \$50,000, the Pick-4 handle produced a total pool of \$83,060 – the highest record wagering pool ever for the track.

As purses have continued to soar, so has the quality of racing.

“The racing has been competitive,” Kleinhans said. “We still have too many big favorites, but I’d say it’s still better than some other places. Again, it is speed favoring but you can still come from other parts of the track, and I think people have enjoyed the action. There’s kind of been two sets of horses. There are the really good horses in the sire stakes which at some points can almost fill an entire card with all the different divisions, and then there’s the overnight horses that people have become familiar with.”

“I also think there’s a really great flavor to the racing here. It’s great that we have the contingent from Mississippi here – I love that entire group. I see this track as one of the few places where you can see relations between all these different groups of people coming together.”

What I’ve enjoyed personally with the Oak Grove product which I think does a nice job filling the late afternoon void in the racing schedule, is its simulcast broadcast. The fact alone that the track sees it important enough to include live, race-by-race commentary between Kleinhans and Cotolo as part of its broadcast shows some element of caring about the racing product.

As for whether the broadcast has had a role in increasing handle, Kleinhans said, “I’m not sure, exactly. Obviously, I’d like to think it has something to do with our show and what we’re doing and the people tuning in, but certainly people are watching us more than last year. I know we heard from some people at The Meadows where they almost didn’t even get our signal this year, but we heard from them and were able to work that.”

“I also have to say that I just find Ray so much fun. I never know what he’s going to do next, it’s not like we have anything scripted or anything. We start the show, and he’s in Pennsylvania – and when he came down for the big day Saturday that was actually the first time he’s been here. But when we start the show, I never know what his first routine is going to be. He does stand up comedy too, so he’s got a mind for trying to come up with some outrageous stuff. It’s very fun. And when I’m laughing when he says something it’s genuine – we’re all trying to have fun with it too.”

For all the success this season, Kleinhans would have been remiss to not attribute a degree of it to the track’s senior sales and racing operations manager.

“The broadcast does show that we care – and you know – Cara [Collins] deserves so much credit overall,” said Kleinhans. “I’ve never had a better boss to work for and she’s just so into it. It’s so great Churchill found her because she’s just so enthusiastic and you know that for once if possible, she would love for the track’s racing to be able to make money on its own standing. Her passion makes you want to work harder for it and she’s just everywhere all over the track – it really has been inspiring.”

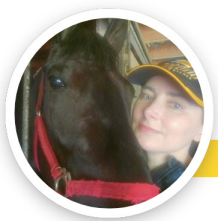

Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame marks 50th anniversary year

On Wednesday (May 20), the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame (CHRHF) introduced its recently-elected Class of 2026 at a well-attended president's reception. Located at ground level in the west end of the Woodbine Racetrack grandstand in Rexdale, ON, the Hall is filled with informational plaques and portraits celebrating renowned racehorses, horsepeople, and racing industry builders and media from the thoroughbred and standardbred worlds. Although live harness racing ended at Woodbine Racetrack in April 2018, with the former standardbred track transformed into an inner turf course, both breeds are very much alive in the CHRHF.

Hall of Fame president Bill Ford addressed the audience by welcoming new CHRHF board members, veterinarian Dr. Maurice (Mo) Stewart and harness horseman Mark Horner. He also noted

the passing of Andrea McGee, an active volunteer at the Hall for two decades, in September 2025.

"As you see, we have a new set-up this year," Ford said. "Many of you have seen, or will soon see, the new additions to the Hall: the statues of Northern Dancer and [Secretariat's jockey] Ron Turcotte. These are important and fitting tributes. The installation took place not long before Ron's passing, and we're pleased that we're able to ensure that his legacy is recognized in such a prominent way. Both pieces were previously located at Canada's Sports Hall of Fame in Calgary. It's meaningful to have them here as part of our permanent collection."

Ford next acknowledged that 2026 is "a milestone year for the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame," as the facility celebrates its 50th anniversary. Founded in 1976, the CHRHF has inducted over 500 equine and human achievers so far, and will be promoting the past, present, and future of Canadian racing by hosting public events over the coming months.

"We plan to recognize the anniversary in several ways," the CHRHF president said. "At the grassroots level, you'll see a presence at track events, such as Clinton Raceway's Legends Day in July, alongside other initiatives aimed at celebrating our history, including the broader racing community."

A public ribbon-cutting for a new mural was announced for Woodbine Mohawk Park that took place on Saturday (May 23) at 5:15 p.m.

"The mural lists all Hall of Fame inductees and prominently features Ontario-based standardbred contributors," Ford said. "It's an impressive visual representation of the Hall's history."

He added that there will be “continued efforts to expand the Hall’s presence across the country” at other Canadian tracks by means of “similar projects.”

“In conclusion, I’d like to take a moment to reflect on what has brought us all here today,” the Hall’s president said. “That’s the horse itself. The Hall of Fame exists to recognize excellence across the sport, the common thread that connects every story, every achievement, and every person in this room is the horse.”

Event co-hosts Kelly Spencer and Robert Geller introduced the CHRHF Class of 2026, who were recognized in standardbred and thoroughbred video presentations. On the harness racing side, Dr. Maurice Stewart (builder); Majestic Son (male horse); Western Dreamer (veteran horse); Put On A Show (female horse); Doug Arthur (trainer); and Mike Saftic (driver) were in the spotlight. The thoroughbred inductees include John Burness (builder); Dale Saunders (trainer); Michael Burns, Jr. (communicator); Richard Dos Ramos (jockey); One For Rose (female horse); and Rahy’s Attorney (male horse). Each name was met with applause by those in attendance at the invitation-only gathering.

Linda Rainey is managing director of the Hall of Fame.

“I’ve been with the Hall since 2012, so it’s been quite a length of time, at this point,” she said. “We are so excited about the 50th anniversary... [It] provides a great opportunity to highlight things like the number of stake races in Canada that are named after Hall of Fame members. We are looking at opportunities to work with tracks on topics like that. It’s a great way to bring the entire

industry together and make them think about the history of the sport.”

Rainey said that tickets were available to purchase for the annual CHRHF induction banquet, scheduled for Aug. 12 in Mississauga, ON. The event helps raise funds in support of the Hall’s work.

“We’re certainly working on some ideas that will make it unique and a little more special,” in recognition of the 50th anniversary, she said.

“We’re working with Ontario Racing on putting some [commemorative 50th anniversary] merchandise together... and they are going to be available on the Ontario Racing website, in their online store, with proceeds coming to the Hall of Fame. That will be happening in the next 10 days or so.”

The CHRHF managing director said that she was “thrilled” for the Hall “to have a presence at Mohawk” in the new mural that was unveiled on Saturday (May 23).

“The mural takes up over 50 feet of wall,” she said. “It’s right near the entrance, on the inside [of the grandstand]. It’s right across from the Armstrong trophy case. That mural contains the names of every Hall of Fame member from both breeds. In addition, we’ve done special features on individuals and horses who are from the Ontario market, standardbred side.”

Rainey said everyone was welcome to visit the CHRHF at Woodbine Racetrack, which is open when the grandstand opens. There is no admission fee.

“We want to make sure that everybody realizes it’s much more a hall of fame than a museum; we have limited artifacts here,” she said. “You can wander around in here.”

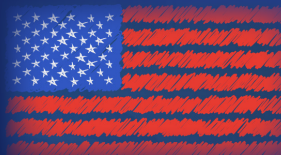

Fresh Face Yankee proving she is more than a fair horse

Last season, Fresh Face Yankee took Tim Smith on an incredible ride as owner/trainer/driver. The then-freshman captured nine races, including a Governor's Cup championship on the Indiana fair circuit. This season, the trotter will step up to the state's premier program, competing on Memorial Day (May 25) in Indiana Sires Stakes action for the first time after going a perfect three-for-three in series action to start the year.

"It's been unreal, so whatever happens from here on out, it's in God's hands," Smith said of the experience thus far. "I'm not worried about it. She's done unbelievable, just unbelievable."

The conditioner suited up as a driver for the first time last season, steering Fresh Face Yankee at several Indiana fairs. With the Spencerville resident at the controls, the Crescent Fashion—Swan Yankee lass hit the board in 10 of 11 starts, registering six victories. She finished her freshman campaign with six wins in her last seven attempts, including two scores with veteran catch

driver Jay Cross in the sulky. After her last start in September, Fresh Face Yankee was turned out before Cross and his wife, Pam, took her to Florida for the winter.

"I could have kept her, but my track being up here, I knew I couldn't get her ready like she should have been," Smith said. "Jay's got a lot more experience. He and Pam are excellent horsepeople. I knew that they could get more out of her and get her to her full potential."

That reasoning came from prior experience with the pacer Clever Character. At 2, he won six of nine starts during the 2019 campaign. Training over the half-mile farm track, the gelding did not advance and match that success as a 3-year-old.

"That's another reason I went this route; I haven't had a lot of luck with the 3-year-olds, you know, bringing them back," Smith said of his experience with Clever Character. "I don't have the facility to do it, and I had a tough time bringing him back. And not that he was bad, he just could have been better."

Under the tutelage of Jay and Pam Cross, Fresh Face Yankee prepared for the 2026 season in Bell, FL. Qualifying twice at Gilcrest Training Center before shipping north, the trotter arrived at Harrah’s Hoosier Park Racing & Casino ready to make her sophomore debut. She is now three-for-three heading into Monday’s sires stakes test.

“I have really been happy with the way Jay has raced her,” Smith said. “He’s won, but yet he hasn’t killed her doing it. He’s brought her slowly back. As you can see, every time she’s dropped.”

In the \$12,000 first leg of the Msnaughtbynature series, held April 29, Fresh Face Yankee and Cross sat in the pocket at the second choice behind favored Omg Am I Ok. In the stretch, the sophomore kicked home in :27.3 to win by two lengths, stopping the clock in 1:57.1. The next time out, the filly raced off the pace and again sprinted home in :27.3, this time circling the oval in 1:55.1. Most recently, Fresh Face Yankee captured the \$25,000 series final going gate-to-wire, clear at the finish by two lengths in a time of 1:54.4.

“I give Jay and Pam all the credit,” the owner said. “They’ve done an excellent job.”

Fresh Face Yankee now sports a record of 12 wins in her first 18 starts, with career earnings of \$65,710. This season she has already collected \$24,500. Not too shabby for a \$5,000 yearling purchase.

“I told Jay as long as he wants her, he can have her,” Smith said. “I’m happy with the way everything is going. It’s working out well. I was happy that Jay said he’d take her and that they got along with her well down there. She’s just come back good. She just impresses me every start.”

Fresh Face Yankee has drawn into the second of two \$48,500 Indiana Sires Stakes divisions on the Memorial Day Card. Cross will guide the trotter from the outside post in the field of six. The group also includes Bluebird Kazoom (post 2), now five-for-five to start the season, Help Cum Laude (post 4), runner-up in last year’s \$250,000 Super Final, and Expressive Gal (post 3), most recently third in the Msnaughtbynature series final. For Dayze, last season’s divisional champion, has drawn into the first division. Smith is optimistic that his filly has what it takes to compete with the group.

“After her last start, I think she’s got a shot at it,” he said. “So far, he hasn’t really had to use her much to get there. So, it’s going to be exciting. We’ll see what happens. If she can compete with them, that would be great.”

Last year Fresh Face Yankee delivered a fair championship. Now racing fans will see how she stacks up against the best trotting fillies in the state. No matter the outcome, Smith will enjoy the experience.

“I know what reality is,” he said. “She’s done way more than anybody ever thought she would. I bought a fair horse, but I got way more than that.”

Zeron, Balmer, Beach, NA Cup, and more

This week we're going to celebrate a couple of birthday boys (Scott Zeron and Somebeachsomewhere), look back at some early days at The Meadowlands with Dr. Rick Balmer, and then share some notes on the North America Cup and harness hodgepodge.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY SCOTT ZERON

Scott Zeron has had quite a career for someone who just turned 37.

- He just went back-to-back in the Cutler Memorial with Periculum.

- He had his third Hambletonian win by 34 which is unmatched.
- He was the 2024 Dan Patch Driver of the Year.
- He passed \$50 million at 27 and is now well into his second \$100 million.



Claus Andersen

Scott Zeron turned 37 on Saturday.

- If you bet on all of his Breeders Crown winners including Meshuggah, you have averaged over \$70 per victory.
- He broke the post 10 Hambletonian jinx in 2023 with Tactical Approach.
- He turned away eventual Horse of the Year Confederate in the 2023 North America Cup with It's My Show, four years after setting the then stakes record of 1:47.2 with Captain Crunch for Nancy Takter and 3 Brothers Stables.
- His dad trained Atlanta, who got her soon-to-be-recognized Hall of Fame career officially in gear in capturing the 2018 Hambletonian with Scott in the bike.
- He is the driver of the sport's last Triple Crown winner Marion Marauder (2016).
- He remains the youngest driver to ever capture a Pacing Triple Crown race (Michaels Power in 2012) when he was just 23.
- He has won nine Triple Crown race before the age of 35, and only John Campbell can also say that.

- A \$409 Breeders Crown winner at Hoosier Park in 2020 may be a record that lasts forever.

Did someone just whisper the words Hall of Fame?

THE LATE, GREAT SOMEBEACHSOMEWHERE

The great Somebeachsomewhere would have turned 21 on Memorial Day as he was born on May 25, 2005.

- He was Hip #268 and the first horse sold on Day 3 of the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale. He went for \$40,000 and was the fourth foal out of Wheres The Beach.
- His racing and sireng careers were legendary.
- We lost him in 2018 at just 13, but his sons and daughters are carrying on his legacy.
- His \$153G plus per start remains the all-time pacing mark.
- His son Stay Hungry is the only colt to win two thirds of the Triple Crown in the past decade and a half.

DR. RICK BALMER

Retired vet Dr. Rick Balmer has indeed paid his dues.

"I drove up [to The Meadowlands] with Mike Gagliardi who was shipping in 20 horses, way back when," Balmer said. "It was so early that the stall doors weren't even installed yet. The next day they brought in hundreds of union workers and hung 1,200 stall doors in two days."

What was racing secretary/director of racing Joe DeFrank like?

"It was opening week 1976. He called all the vets into his office for a meeting. He told us it was a great time for harness racing. He said, 'No waves' and left the room. I got to become good friends with Joe through the years."

Who were the most memorable horses that you worked on?

"Starchip Entrprise for Jim Doherty. Guts for Barry Abrams. I remember driving to Kentucky with Barry when they bought him. Gallo Blue Chip [2000 HOY] for Mark Ford. Fools Goal was the most aggravating. He made a lot of breaks one year and left \$1 million on the table. That was when Jim Doherty made the decision to use Jackie Mo [Jack Moiseyev and then won back-to-back Breeders Crowns (2002-03)]. Rock N Roll Heaven [2010 HOY] for Bruce Saunders. Self Possessed was the hardest to keep sound. Cantab Hall and Continentalvictory

also for Ron Gurfein. No Nonsense Woman [for Jim Doherty]. Magician was the toughest to work on. I even worked on Palm Peter for Ed Sabatini at Freehold in the 1970s.

Sounds like you were at The Big M a long time.

"Yes, I spent 40 years working in the backstretch at The Meadowlands seven days a week all year, from Opening Day, Sept. 1, 1976, until they closed the barn area in 2011. Myself, Ray Remmen, Jim Doherty, and Red Fazikas we were the only ones there throughout."

THE NORTH AMERICA CUP

The Pepsi NA Cup is just right around the corner, so in order not to get overloaded that week, we'll do some Cup notes now.

- Bud Fritz is the only winning driver no longer with us, as he passed in 2022 at 86. Had the 1990 winner Apaches Fame. Fritz is also the last trainer/driver to win on Cup Night.
- Of the last 30 winning trainers, 21 were first timers.
- Jate Lobell might have made the biggest impact in NA Cup history. Not only did he capture Canada's first million-dollar race in 1987 he also sired three Cup winners from his first six crops: Safely Kept (1992), David's Pass (1995), and Gothic Dream (1997).
- Dave Miller will miss the 2026 edition and is the last to go back-to-back with Betting Line (2016) and Fear The Dragon (2017).

- Six times the winner has been HOY in the States: Precious Bunny (1991), Cam's Card Shark (1994), Gallo Blue Chip (2000), Rocknroll Hanover (2005), Somebeachsomewhere (2008), and Talk Dark Stranger (2020).
- Jeff Snyder is the leading owner with a four-pack: Cam's Card Shark (1994), Red River Hanover (2002), Rocknroll Hanover (2005), and Well Said (2009).
- Louprint in 2025 with an effort for the ages in a 1:47.1 stakes mark.
- In the 21st century, 16 of 26 have had all or partial Canadian ownership.
- Odds On Mr Mamba has never left Indiana and will indeed be on "foreign" soil for the elims. Ironically neither had his ancestor, the great Hal Dale, who also competed in Indiana. They say that 98 per cent of every pacer racing in North America today can trace back, as we speak, to Hal Dale.

HARNES HODGEPUDGE

- Jason Bartlett at 44 last year became the fourth driver to capture his first national earnings title while in their 40s, joining Ron Pierce (48) in 2004, Mike Lachance (46) in 1996, and Clint Hodgins (42) in 1949.
- May 20 marked the 60th anniversary of the 1966 "Race of the Century" at Yonkers. Cardigan Bay won his 10th straight race over favored Bret Hanover in :28.3, :59.3, 1:30.4, and 2:00 flat a length apart on the wire. Cardigan Bay was in his third of five years in North America (37-87 here) and Bret Hanover successfully defended his two-straight HOY titles with yet another in 1966.
- Who are the last two U.S. Horses of the Year to not race that year in New Jersey? Savoir (1975) and Beau Jangles (2025).

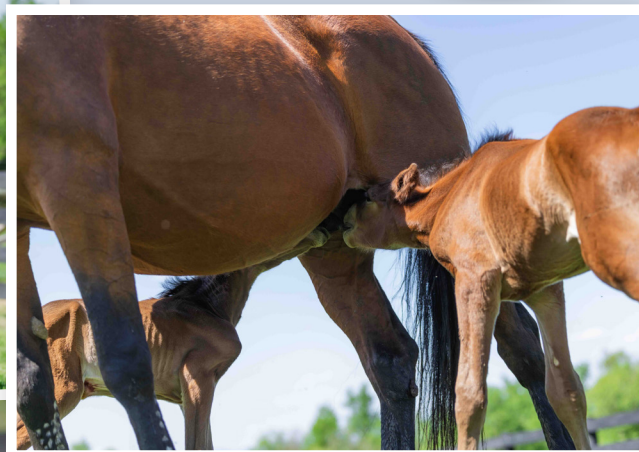

Elitloppet field taking final shape

Elitloppet is beginning to take its final form.

Saturday's (May 23) \$80,000 Prins Daniels Lopp at Gävletravet, part of the V85 card, had in previous years served as a direct qualifier to Elitloppet. This year, however, the rules were changed and the race instead became part of the E-series, where horses accumulated points in an effort to reach Solvalla's great race next Sunday (May 31).

Before Saturday's contest it was announced that Norwegian star Charron (Code Bon), trained by Geir Vegard Gundersen, had received an invitation from Solvalla. At the same time, Finnish contender Massimo Hoist withdrew from Elitloppet due to poor blood values.

That left two spots still open heading into Saturday, and there was virtually a guarantee that the winner of Prins Daniels Lopp would receive one of Solvalla's coveted pink invitations.

That ticket was earned by **Mellby Jinx** (Ready Cash), trained and driven by Daniel Wäjersten, after a gritty first-over performance outside the leader Powwow.

Whether Mellby Jinx will actually take part in Elitloppet, however, remains uncertain.

"Our plan before the race was that we would not participate in Elitloppet this year," Wäjersten said of Mellby Jinx, who won an Elitloppet elimination heat last year. "Three races within eight days would be tough."

That means Solvalla racing director Ola Lernå is expected to keep the final two invitations open until the draw ceremony at 5:30 p.m. Swedish time (11:30 a.m. ET).

MAHARAJAH DOMINATES KUOPIO STAKES

Super sire Maharajah stamped his authority all over this year's \$75,000 Kuopio Stakes in Kuopio on Saturday (May 23), producing a remarkable sweep of the trifecta. **Piccolo Cocktail** (Maharajah–Cocktail Princess) had narrowly lost his elimination heat to Magnitude, but turned the tables emphatically in the final.

Racing from third-over, Piccolo Cocktail unleashed a powerful stretch kick to score in 1:55 flat over the mile.

Magnitude (Maharajah) finished second after a tough first-over trip in the same time, while Arctic Fiona (Maharajah) held third from the lead in 1:55.2. The victory was the ninth in 35 starts for the 4-year-old trained by Timo Korvenheimo. Earlier in his career, Piccolo Cocktail captured the \$70,000 Jokimaa Jackpot and also finished as a runner-up in both the Finnish Derby and Breeders Crown finals.



AMONG OURSELVES

with FRANK COLTOLO

Picking and betting numbers and the insidious flow of handicapping misinformation

I remember my first pari-mutuel bet even though there was a lot going on in my life. It was the early 1970s. I was just out of college and still living with my parents. New York City Off-Track Betting (OTB) opened a slew of storefront parlors within walking and bus-riding distances from my house in Brooklyn. But I was not ready to become a customer even though my affection for harness racing was developing into the kind of love that attracts wagering. I watched many races on Stan Bergstein's TV show and learned a lot from him on the broadcasts. But handicapping? Risking money to make more money solely by backing horses pacing and trotting in circles? I went to an OTB parlor for the first time while with a friend of mine. He wanted to make a bet. It took a few minutes on a short line and he put two dollars on a Triple bet.

"The horses have to finish one-two-three in the order I choose," he said.

"I know that," I said. "But how do you pick them to finish in that order?"

He chose three specific horses in a group of eight. Posts 1 and 2 and 4. OTB did not use numbers for horses in a field; it used capital letters. He chose B (post 2) and A (post 1) and D (post 4).

"Spells BAD," he said.

"And?"

"Those three look as good to finish in the correct order as any other trio spelling a word do."

"So," I said, "there is no science to it?"

"You mean handicapping."

"Right. That's what I just did. I picked a winner and a place and show finisher."

I thought: That could not be handicapping. That was guessing. Like playing Bingo in a church basement. Like playing the local illegal bookie's numbers game. That was nuts to me.

Nuts until the next day when he got the results and it turned out he picked the winner and the place and the show finishers in the exact order. He made a-hundred-and-something dollars.

A neighbor of mine said, "I knew a guy who was a real good handicapper. He played the horses all the time. Went to the track a lot before the OTBs came. A guy can get good at making some cash at the races." Then he said the words that changed my life. "But you got to know how to bet."

Not just how to pick numbers, he meant. Not how to rely on luck alone. He meant to bet money in order to make money. That was not handicapping. Sounded like – dare I say it? Math.

My relationship with mathematics was similar to the one between Marc Anthony and Julius Caesar. I was Caesar. I resisted investing a great deal of time taking a math course at home. Relying on Stan Bergstein's TV show for essentials was all I could handle.

Then I met an old friend from high school. Kenny. He played the horses. I recalled during lunch hours in the cafeteria he read the racing section of the *New York Daily News*. I took him to a coffee hang out and told him I wanted to know more about handicapping.

"The runners or the trotters?"

"Trotters."

He gave me a quick class but also suggested there were easier ways. I could buy a slide-rule product that calculates various information and assigns numbers for each horse in a race.

"The highest number is the best horse. Play it to win. And for Exactas or Triples use the next-best numbers in the place and show spots." The slide-rule product cost \$25. "You'll make it back fast."

I bought it and made my first win bet on the highest number in the race. It lost. I won my second bet. It was a huge favorite. I made 40 cents. In a week I was down \$20 so I sought other handicapping methods. The public handicappers in the *Sports Eye* newspaper offered a grid of race picks and comments but they were no better than the slide-rule gadget. I bought a paperback book on handicapping harness racing and the author loaded the pages with information that made him appear smart but were not useful for beginners.

I shuffled various methods around and hit the OTB parlors on evenings I did not work. I lost more than I won. I was taking a beating by the enemy and he was me; betting to break even. I went to the track a few times with friends. Each had his own system. Each met their enemies and it was them. I decided to spend more time and do more math and produce profits by handicapping like a pro. Stay tuned.

This is for all the lonely people

*"This is for all the lonely people.
Thinkin' that life has passed them by..."*

Despite running only 2 minutes and 27 seconds, *Lonely People* by America became a major hit in 1974, climbing all the way to number 5 on the Billboard charts. This was a time when people, even teenagers, talked to each other without a screen between them. We had groups of friends. We sat around for hours talking about absolutely nothing. We drove around aimlessly. We argued about sports, music, girls, horses, and life itself. Sometimes we even sang together.

It turns out that the song may have been 40 years ahead of its time. Because somewhere along the road, people stopped gathering the way they once did. Now people sit alone, glued silently to glowing screens which give us the illusion of connection.

Today, both old and young often feel insulated and alone, and those feelings are not imaginary. Not long ago, the United States Surgeon General released a report titled *Our Epidemic of Loneliness and Isolation*. The statistics were startling, although many people, especially men, were probably not surprised at all.

The pandemic did not create loneliness, but it accelerated an epidemic already underway. Social media is not nearly as social as it appears. Artificial intelligence quietly steers us into commercialized silos designed to capture our attention rather than deepen interpersonal relationships. Over the past several decades, the number of men who report having close personal friends – or even one close friend – has fallen dramatically.

Loneliness is not just sad; it is unhealthy.

So how do you fight back against the loneliness epidemic? As I read through the Surgeon General's recommendations, a thought occurred to me: our silly little sport accidentally checks many of the boxes scientists now recommend for healthier human connections. Oddly enough, harness racing may be one of the better antidotes to loneliness in modern society.

BE PROACTIVE

As the song says, "You never know until you try"

Trying is the hardest part. It is easy to remain inside the cocoon; endlessly scrolling through carefully slanted information, manufactured outrage, and mind-numbing entertainment. Unfortunately, isolation tends to feed on itself. The longer people remain disconnected, the more difficult reconnecting becomes.

Only you can break the cycle. That means intentionally arranging personal interactions. Not online. Not through text messages. Not by sending silly little darts on social media posts, but by actual human interaction.

One of the wonderful things about harness racing is that the barn doors are literally open at fairgrounds and training centers. You can walk through them. You can ask questions. You can stand along a fence and watch horses train while conversation happens naturally beside you.

PARTICIPATE IN A HOBBY OR ACTIVITY

The Surgeon General's report strongly recommends hobbies and group activities as protection against loneliness. Shared interests create natural conversation and remove the awkwardness of forced social interaction. That is where our little world of trotters, pacers, and wonderful people can shine.

It does not matter whether the hobby is entirely new to you, something you once loved and rediscovered, or an activity you wish to explore more deeply. The key is participation with other people, in person.

Harness racing offers dozens of entry points: Fractional ownership, breeding, training, mild gambling with pals, going to sales, visiting farms, learning pedigrees, jogging horses, and debating yearlings over coffee with a catalog spread across the table.

The beauty is that conversations happen sideways instead of face-to-face. Men, especially, seem to connect more naturally while doing something together rather than sitting across a table attempting deep conversation on command.

A racing program in your hand becomes a social tool. A sales catalog becomes an icebreaker. A drive to the farm becomes therapy disguised as a road trip.

One of the wonderful things about harness racing is that the barn doors are literally open at fairgrounds and training centers. You can walk through them. You can ask questions. You can stand along a fence and watch horses train while conversation happens naturally beside you.

BE ACTIVE

The report also suggests physical movement as another important defense against loneliness and depression. Exercise helps. Motion helps. Simply going somewhere helps. A surprising amount of our sport involves movement and shared experiences. Walking through barns, touring farms, standing near fences watching yearlings train, driving to sales, mucking stalls, or watching qualifiers on a chilly morning before breakfast with friends gets you out and moving.

Maybe these words will find a lonely person.

Maybe that person is you.

Others may be waiting for your invitation. Maybe you can reconnect with an old gang, or create a new one centered around this strange and wonderful little sport of ours.

Walk the barns, buy the coffee, ask questions, and take the drive. You can purchase a slice of ownership, raise a baby horse, or simply spend an afternoon around people who still gather in the real world instead of staring silently into glowing screens. If you are not lonely, maybe forward this column to someone who may benefit.

Our sport has much to offer. We can be good medicine.

And when it comes to fighting loneliness, maybe old Yoda said it best: "Do. Or do not. There is no try."

Or maybe Dan Peek said it even better nearly 50 years ago when he wrote: "Don't give up until you drink from the silver cup... You never know until you try."

Beau Jangles dominates Gold test in terrible weather to remain undefeated through 15 career starts

Beau Jangles pushed his career unbeaten streak to 15 with a dominant 1:50.3 victory on Saturday (May 23) in the lone \$140,000 Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Gold Series division for sophomore pacing colts on a cold, wet, and windy night at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Sent off at 1-9 in a field of eight with show and place wagering banned and the next lowest-priced horse at 60-1, Beau Jangles was eased out of post 8 by driver Bob McClure and settled into the third spot in the early going. Up the backstretch, McClure made his move to the front and Beau Jangles controlled the race from there, pulling away from the field in mid-stretch to win by 2½ lengths over No Waitlist (Trevor Henry). Tilthecowscomehome (Jody Jamieson) was third, Borderline Mobby (James MacDonald) was fourth and Wholetthedogsout (Mark MacDonald) grabbed the final check.

“[Beau Jangles] was amazing,” McClure told Woodbine broadcaster Greg Blanchard. “He was so nice and relaxed, and he got to the front and just coasted. He went :29 and change in the third quarter, and then at the seven-eighths I shook a line at him, and he went :26 flat. Wind assisted or not, the track’s not nice. It’s just how easy he does those things. It’s not the time he’s going or what he’s doing, it’s just how easy it’s coming to him. I couldn’t have been happier with how he was tonight.

“He hasn’t been exerted or tested [this year], and I think he’s coming into some pretty heavy races as sharp as you can possibly have him.”

The colt, a son of Cattlewash out of Mrs Major Hill, now sports career earnings of \$1,836,987 and a seasonal bankroll of \$148,237 for owners Graham Grace Stables LLC, of Clifton, VA, Kiwi Stables LLC, of La Plata, MD, and Bolton Stables of Clermont, FL.

The reigning Canadian and U.S. Horse of the Year is trained by Dr. Ian Moore, who said the Beau Jangles’ next race will be in the Pepsi North America Cup eliminations on June 6 at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

“He’s going to have four or five days off now and we’re going to prep him for the NA Cup now,” Moore said.

Beau Jangles was a perfect 12-for-12 in his tremendous 2-year-old season in 2025. He is now three-for-three in 2026 following victories in both the SBOA eliminations and final on May 9 and 16, respectively, at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Moore said part of the colt’s success can be attributed to caretaker Riley Noble.

“Riley Noble, his groom, is doing an excellent job with him,” Moore said, “and everybody else in the barn is proud of [Beau Jangles], appreciates him, and they all chip in and help.

“About 50, 60 years ago, I [was a caretaker] myself. Back then, it used to be if you had a good horse like him, you’d be on the road with him every week, traveling from track to track. I did that when I was 14. So, I do understand how important it is to keep a horse happy, and everything that we can do to keep that horse happy, from having windows open or whatever it may be, we try to do all that for him as well as the rest of them in the barn.”

Beau Jangles, who was bred by Tara Hills Stud of Port Perry, ON, sold for \$65,000 U.S. at the 2024 Standardbred Horse Sales Company yearling sale in Harrisburg, PA.

O'BRIEN WINNER A CLEAN DEAL AND DAYA BOTH GOLDEN IN SOPHOMORE PACING FILLY TESTS

A Clean Deal and **Daya** were victorious on Saturday (May 23) in the two \$90,000 Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Gold Series divisions for sophomore pacing fillies on a cold, rainy, and windy night at Woodbine Mohawk Park. Both divisions featured six-horse fields.

In the first division (race 2), Doug McNair piloted overwhelming 1-9 favorite A Clean Deal – Canada’s 2025 2-Year-Old Pacing Filly of the Year – to a wire-to-wire 1:52.1 victory for trainer Kyle Fellows and owners Yolanda Fellows of Rockwood, ON, Blair Corbeil of Leduc, AB, Windermere Stable LLC of New York, NY, and James Ross of Wingham, ON.

Sent off at 1-9, A Clean Deal posted fractions of :26.3, :56.4, 1:25.1, and came home in :26.3 to win by 1¾ lengths over She’s A Bulldog (Bob McClure) and 3½ lengths over Lavender Seelster (Louis-Philippe Roy).

Given the weather conditions, McNair said A Clean Deal was particularly impressive.

“That’s a big mile,” McNair told WEG broadcaster Greg Blanchard.

“It’s probably the worst conditions you can race in. It’s just about freezing – three or four degrees above freezing – and we’ve got probably 40-50 kilometer-an-hour winds coming from the east shoving us home, with rain on top of that. So, it’s tough for the horses and for the drivers to see.”

McNair said the fact that A Clean Deal handily put away a late challenge from She’s A Bulldog proves the former is “pretty special... She gives you quite a thrill.”

The victory improved the daughter of Cattlewash out of Ideal Talker to a perfect three-for-three in 2026 and 9-0-1 in 10 career starts. She upped her seasonal bankroll to \$125,862, and her career total to \$581,326 with the win.

A Clean Deal was bred by Winbak Farm and was sold for \$20,000 U.S. at the 2024 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale.

In the second division, trainer Jack Darling’s homebred Daya scored a 1:52.4 victory with a late charge orchestrated by driver Jody Jamieson.

Sent off at 6-5, Daya defeated Jen Tilly (McClure) by two lengths. TH Check Me Out (Tyler Borth) was third, Pownal Bay Robbi (Mark MacDonald) was fourth, and P N G Shadow (Roy) grabbed the final check.

Daya, a daughter of Darling’s trainee Bulldog Hanover out of Beach Of A Time, posted her first victory of 2026 in her third start. She is now 6-5-1 in 15 career starts for career earnings of \$544,100.

“I didn’t know how the race was going to go,” Jamieson told Blanchard. “I thought maybe I would go up front, or maybe sit in the 2-hole. As it turned out, there was lots of action and lots and lots of pace going on. She’s never really been tired in her life. It was just a matter of me putting her in the right spot so that she could have a full run. We started at the five-eighths pole and kept going for the last three-eighths pretty good, and she just cruised under the line. I’m just really happy with the result of her now, in her third start, getting the win.”

MCNAIR, MCCLURE OFFICIALLY PRESENTED WITH JOHNSTON AND LAMPMAN CUPS

Earlier on the Woodbine Mohawk Park card, the Ontario Sires Stakes program officially honored the 2025 Johnston and Lampman Cup winners recognizing the top trainer and driver, respectively, in OSS action.

For the second year in a row and seventh time lifetime, Gregg McNair earned the Johnston Cup title. In 2025, McNair won the title with 203 points – 45 more than Kyle Fellows and 49 points ahead of Tony Beaton. McNair previously won the top OSS trainer award in 2024, 2021, 2019, 2014, 2013, and 2012. Only the late legend Bob McIntosh has more Johnston Cup titles to his credit. McIntosh won the title eight times.

Bob McClure won the 2025 Lampman Cup race with 384 points. Finishing second was Louis-Philippe Roy with 360 points. James MacDonald, Canada's five-time Driver of the Year, was third in the 2025 Lampman Cup standings with 347 points. It is McClure's second title. He previously won the Lampman Cup in 2020.

In both the Johnston and Lampman Cup, one point is awarded for each OSS start. Four additional points are awarded for a win, three for a second, and two for a third-place finish.

The Johnston Cup was founded in 1993 in memory of Bruce Johnston, the publisher of The Canadian Sportsman.

The Lampman Cup was established in 1987 in memory of long-time Ontario Jockey Club harness racing publicist Jim Lampman.

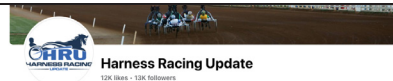

Luke Plano surpasses \$20 million in career purse earnings

Veteran driver Luke Plano crossed the \$20 million mark in career purse earnings on Thursday night (May 21) at Running Aces when he piloted **TJB Secreharriet** to victory in the first race.

The 46-year-old reinsman has been a mainstay at Running Aces for 14 years and always ranks near or at the top of the standings. He is currently the only driver to ever surpass the \$1 million mark for single-season driver earnings at the Minnesota track, accomplishing that feat in 2023 when he also won the leading driver title.

Plano currently sits in second in the driver standings for the new season with five wins.

In the milestone race, Plano left alertly with TJB Secreharriet and opted to drop in third while Fiftyshadesofcray (Lemoyne Svendsen) and Juliet Duz (Brandon Jenson) battled for the top. He sat patiently through moderate fractions and waited for the homestretch to make his move.

As they rounded into the lane, he angled his charge out to the middle of the track and they kicked into gear, posting a :28.3 final quarter to surge past the leaders and draw clear to win by 2¾ lengths in 1:55.4 in the \$5,700 conditioned pace.

Plano also trains the 5-year-old daughter of Wind Me Up for owner Scott Ehrlich. It was her first win of the season and equaled her career best clocking. She returned \$5.60 as the race favorite.

Plano wasted no time in getting started on his next milestone, picking up another win in race 2 aboard **Wish I Had Thyme** (\$17.80) who recorded a new lifetime mark in 1:53 for trainer Alexia Kehl.

Post time tonight (May 24) at Running Aces is 6 p.m. (CDT) and there is a T-shirt giveaway to the first 500 patrons as well as family night activities and specials and a special visit from Keith Gisser with his “Herps Alive” interactive reptile display.

Crossover takes Big M feature

Crossover used a third-place finish in the Lady Suffolk three weeks ago as her first-start-of-the-year tightener to grab an off-the-pace victory in the Friday night (May 22) feature at The Meadowlands, a \$20,000 conditioned event for 3-year-old trotters with Hambletonian and Hambletonian Oaks dreams.

Facing five colts in the field of eight did not deter the betting public, as Crossover was sent to the gate as the 7-5 favorite. The daughter of Gimpanzee—Piranha Fury sat a perfect pocket trip as Tindra Cash S led at the quarter in :29 and half in :58.2.

Off those fractions, 9-5 second choice Ultimate Betrayal was up to challenge the leader and was on even terms with that foe at three-quarters in 1:26.2. Dexter Dunn vacated the pocket to follow the attacking horse around the far turn, swung three wide for the drive, before taking over nearing the wire to go on to an easy one-length win in a lifetime-best 1:54.2. Big Boys Don't Cry was second with Tindra Cash S holding third.

"She's a beautiful moving trotter," said Dunn. "We were definitely moving [approaching three-quarters]. [Niko Karna driving Ultimate Betrayal] was coming with a lot of steam. The three of us were trotting pretty well coming to three-quarters but once I moved her over, she really moved well and I think she's got a bright future."

A Marcus Melander trainee, Crossover won for the third time from just nine lifetime starts. She returned \$4.80 to win.

BECKWITH'S A HIT: Brett Beckwith, about a month away from returning to driving at The Big M after getting hurt in a spill last month at Saratoga, tried his hand at broadcasting as part of The Meadowland's TV team and showed he's as comfortable talking about the horses as he is driving them.

"It's been an absolute pleasure doing the show," said Beckwith, who conducted the post-feature-race interview with Dunn. "I didn't think I'd have this much fun doing it. I wasn't nervous because I really enjoy talking about the sport, which is probably what makes it the least bit stressful. I would definitely do it again. Hopefully, tonight is the first of many times that I do, until I get back driving, of course."

The 23-year-old pilot distinguished himself, selecting five winners on top, which included two exactas and one trifecta. His best price came in the fifth race when Baby Doll Jen scored and paid \$13.40.

Gary DiLeo also had five on top. His followers made a big score in the third race when Hold My Tiara pulled off an upset and returned \$57.20 as his value play of the night.

A LITTLE MORE: Joe Bongiorno, who took home Driver of the Week honors during the pregame show, got a leg up on taking home the trophy for a second consecutive week after leading the driver colony with three walks down victory lane... Bongiorno was also top trainer with two wins... All-source handle on the 14-race program totaled \$2,539,593.
