Three heats and a final – Sweden Cup delivers a thriller and a U.S.-bred winner

Double Deceiver, bred by Steve Stewart and Oakwood Farms, won the top stakes race at Solvalla on the eve of today's Elitloppet.

EUROPEAN REPORT

With three elimination heats and a final, the \$120,000 Sweden Cup turned into one of the highlights of Saturday's (May 30) racing card at Solvalla.

Defending champion **Double Deceiver**, bred in the U.S. by Steve Stewart and Oakwood Farms, captured the first elimination in impressive front-running fashion for Örjan Kihlström, while the second division produced an upset as Dutch raider **Novato** led every step of the way for Dion Tesselaar. The third elimination also went gate-to-wire, this time courtesy of Finnish-trained **Need'Em**.

In the Sweden Cup final, Double Deceiver (Cantab Hall – Sarcy) was forced to work considerably harder than in his elimination to defend the lead, and the pace never relented after the opening quarter. The field reached the half-mile in a blistering :54.2.

The fierce tempo was largely due to Hades de Vandel, who was parked three-wide after being challenged by the aggressive Savastano, whom Adrian Kolgjini had sent first-over already in the opening turn. Hades de Vandel remained

stranded on the outside while Antonio Di Nardo searched for racing room behind Working Class Hero, launching his move entering the final turn.

Savastano was spent turning for home, and at that point Dion Tesselaar elected to pull Novato (Maharajah) from the pocket in an attempt to overhaul the leader. The move cost him dearly.

Meanwhile, Dexter Dunn demonstrated exactly why he is considered one of the world's premier drivers. Starting from post 8 with Crown (Chapter Seven), he secured a trip in third along the rail and simply waited for the stretch. With racing room finally appearing, Crown surged late for second in the final strides. Novato faded to fourth, while Working Class Hero (Village Mystic) held well for third.

The winning time of 1:50.3 established a new Sweden Cup final record. The previous mark of 1:51.2 had been shared by Bengurion Jet and Volstead, while Always Ek won an elimination in 1:50.2 in 2024.

"He was like a tiger today," said Kihlström. "It's not easy to open in 1:08 for the first kilometer, but he was incredibly eager. This was a tremendous performance. Had the pace remained strong all the way, he would have gone even faster. I actually slowed things down quite a bit in the final turn because I only feared the horse sitting in behind us. He's extremely quick."

Double Deceiver was purchased by Stall Zet for \$500,000 at the 2022 Harrisburg Sale.

At the time, he had compiled a record of 25 starts, 11 wins, eight seconds, and one third, including victories in the Matron Stakes (\$143,950), three legs of the Kentucky Championship Series (\$80,000), a division of the Tompkins-Geers Stakes (\$43,000), a Pennsylvania Sire Stakes division (\$66,544), and a Breeders Crown elimination (C\$33,750). He was also runner-up in the Yonkers Trot behind Joviality. One of his Kentucky Championship Series victories came in 1:50.2, just one-fifth-of-a-second off the world record for 3-year-old geldings.

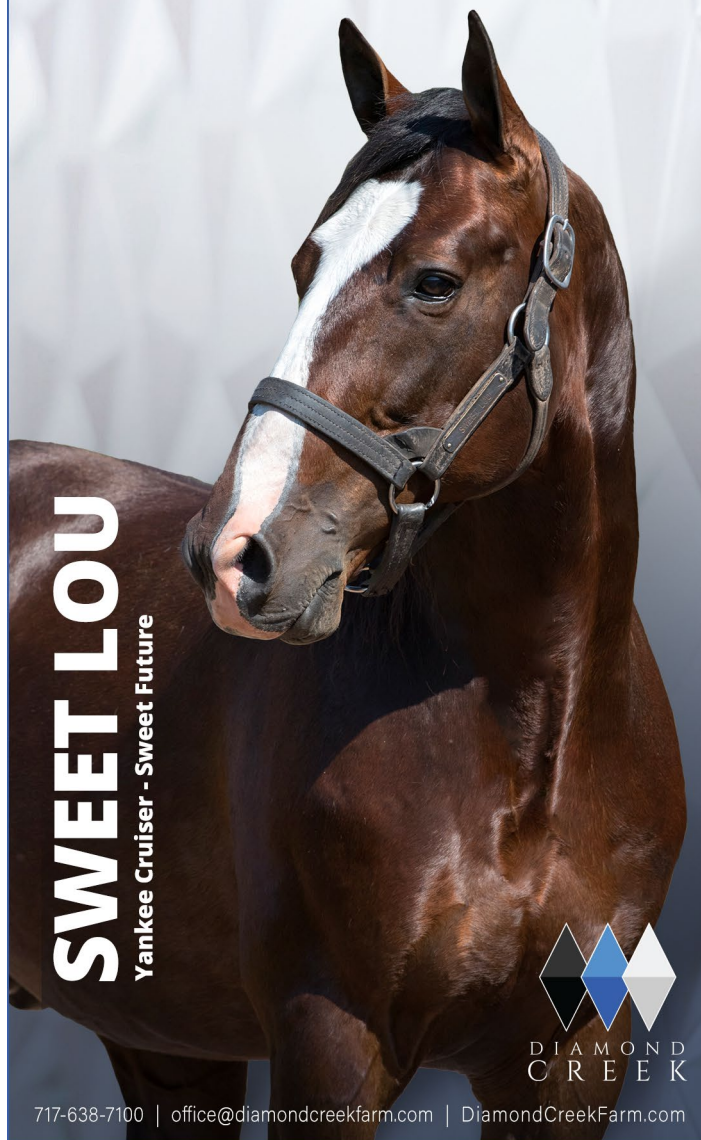

As a yearling, Double Deceiver sold for just \$17,000 in Lexington. He is out of Sarcy (Donato Hanover), 1:10.3 (\$261,333), who was trained by Jimmy Takter. Sarcy is also the dam of Hambletonian winner Tactical Approach (Tactical Landing), 1:08.4 (\$1,544,489), winner of the Hambletonian, Breeders Crown, and Kentucky Futurity. The family also includes Menhammar-owned Dutiful (Trixtion), 1:10.3 (\$96,796).

Second dam Southwind Allaire (Valley Victory), 1:10.7 (\$876,199), was also trained by Jimmy Takter and captured both the Hambletonian Oaks and the Elegantimage Stakes.

UNREAL PERFORMANCE IN HARPER HANOVER TROT

The Harper Hanover Trot, contested over three laps at Solvalla, is traditionally one of the marquee events on Elitlopp Saturday, and this year it appeared perfectly set up for a Swedish victory.

Defending champion Inmarosa represented France but started from a 40-meter handicap behind **Gaining Experience**, Timo Nurmos' emerging star. Entering the race with only nine career starts — eight of them victories — the 5-year-old was facing world-class competition over a marathon distance.

Björn Goop sent Gaining Experience to the lead early and controlled the race throughout at a steady 2:00 mile-rate pace. What followed was nothing short of astonishing.

The son of Readly Express exploded away from the field 400 meters from the wire, and Goop was already celebrating wildly with 150 meters remaining.

Ten starts. Nine wins. Another \$100,000 added to the bankroll.

The final time over 3,140 meters was an eye-popping 1:56.2 mile rate.

An almost unbelievable performance from a lightly raced 5-year-old with so little experience. Invitations to the world's biggest races should already be on their way.

GOCCIADORO WINS WITH THE OTHER ONE

Alessandro Gocciadoro sent out the heavy favorite Clarissa in the opening V85 event on Elitlopp Saturday, the \$100,000 Joviality's Race, carrying a first prize of 500,000 SEK.

And yes, Gocciadoro won the race.

Just not with Clarissa.

After drawing post 8, Clarissa was left parked three-wide through much of the opening stages. Meanwhile, stablemate **Celiaz** (Varenne) secured the lead and never looked back.

From his seat behind Clarissa, Gocciadoro could only watch as his other mare powered to victory in 1:52.1.

ADVENTURES IN ILLINOIS

Illinois harness horsepeople cautiously optimistic as legislature enters final weekend of spring session

After seeing some progress in pursuit of their objectives, members of the Illinois Harness Horsemen's Association (IHHA) were cautiously optimistic going into the final weekend of the spring session of the state legislature that will end on Sunday (May 31).

The IHHA website reports that on May 26 the organization's executive committee members testified on the merits of the new House Bill 5369 sponsored by Representative Bob Rita and emphasized the need for the proposed racino in downstate Decatur, a quicker path to another racino in Chicago's south suburbs and an end to the 1995 "recapture" provision in the racing statute.

According to the website: "This bill appears to become the larger anticipated gaming bill. We expect to see amendments added."

A similar bill passed the Illinois Senate 49-8 last fall.

Amid the upheaval created by Hawthorne Race Course's debt crisis and subsequent bankruptcy, there has been virtually no discussion of the much-maligned "recapture" law that allows Illinois racetracks to recoup losses on live handle as a consequence of the authorization of full-card simulcasting of races from other states. The recapture amount is 2 per cent of the decrease of Illinois handle on Illinois races in 1994 before enactment of full-card simulcasting.

Since then, recapture has escalated and over the past 30 years has cost harness and thoroughbred owners a small fortune.

While members of the IHHA have fixated on developments at the state capital in Springfield, in Chicago on May 27 there were two developments in the Hawthorne bankruptcy case:

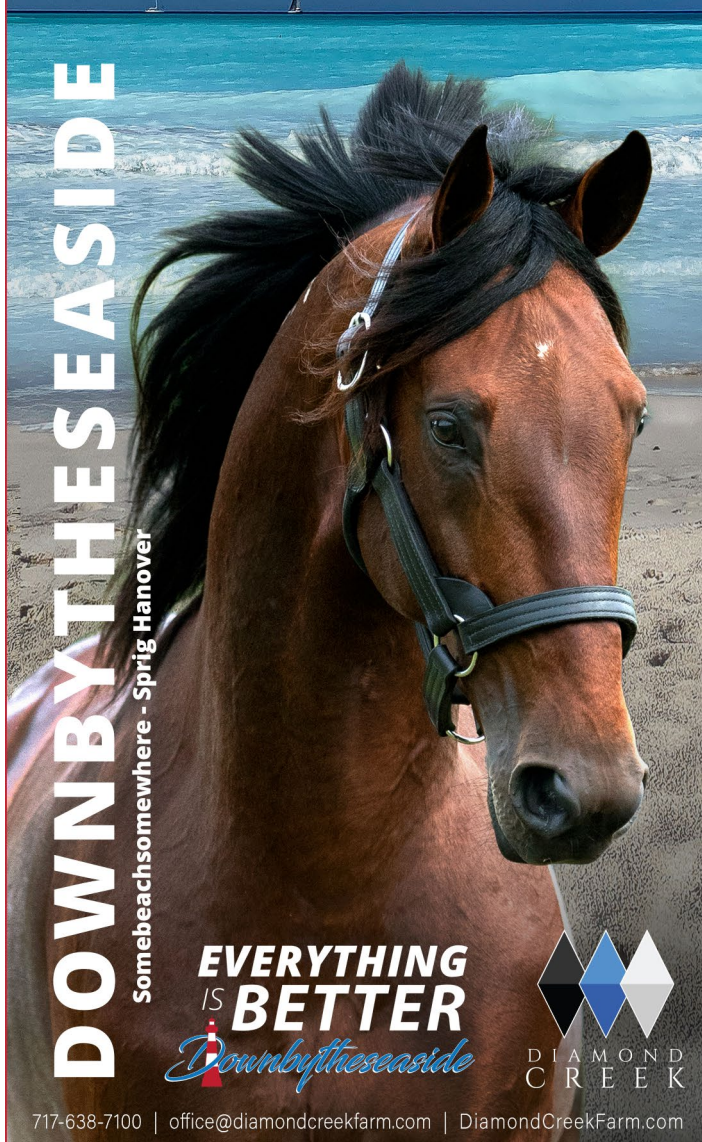

Tim Carey, president of family-owned Hawthorne, said in a statement he is considering offers not only from prospective buyers who want to continue racing and add the casino component that 2019 gaming expansion legislation entitles the track to incorporate but also those who would tear down the track and develop the real estate.

1. U.S. Bankruptcy Judge Timothy Barnes has granted a request from the financially besieged track that conducts both thoroughbred and harness racing to investigate its allegations that the Illinois Department of Agriculture and its director, Jerry Costello, improperly diverted state funds from the track to benefit Fairmount Park Casino and Racing.

Hawthorne is asserting that Jerry Costello has a conflict of interest because his brother, John, is a lobbyist for the Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association (HBPA) that represents owners and trainers at Fairmount.

2. Hawthorne's court filing also alleged that Fairmount – which is located across the Mississippi River from St. Louis about 275 miles south of Hawthorne – is undermining its ability to conduct thoroughbred racing and hurting its chances of emerging from bankruptcy as an ongoing racetrack operation.

The crux of the argument is that Fairmount is doing this by sending text messages to trainers barring them from the grounds if they take horses for races elsewhere when similar races are in the Fairmount condition book during the approximate same time frame.

Fairmount also has doubled purse supplements for some of its races from \$10,000 to \$20,000 and raised its minimum purse from \$4,000 to \$10,000.

In a text message to members of the HBPA, Fairmount took a shot at Hawthorne by stating: "Unlike other racetracks that are in serious and possible fatal declines, Fairmount Park is on a definite upward swing that will continue to improve. Come race with us where the future is bright."

Hawthorne and Fairmount are the only remaining tracks in Illinois. Unlike Hawthorne, Fairmount is limited to thoroughbred racing and has an onsite casino.

Currently, Hawthorne is holding twice-weekly thoroughbred programs during a meeting that began on April 19 – three weeks later than originally scheduled – and racing is scheduled to continue through Nov. 1.

The Suburban Downs harness meeting is scheduled to restart Nov. 6 and continue through Dec. 27 with programs on Friday,

Saturday and Sunday in November and Saturday and Sunday in December.

But, given Hawthorne's dire and uncertain financial situation, many doubt that the harness meeting will be held.

All 14 of Hawthorne's Suburban Downs harness dates in January and February were canceled because of the track's inability to pay its mountain of bills and its Suburban Downs license was suspended by the Illinois Racing Board on Jan. 26.

Then came the Chapter 11 bankruptcy filing on Feb. 27. Under Chapter 11, the target date for a sale is July 13.

Tim Carey, president of family-owned Hawthorne, said in a statement he is considering offers not only from prospective buyers who want to continue racing and add the casino component that 2019 gaming expansion legislation entitles the track to incorporate but also those who would tear down the track and develop the real estate.

In a May 26 story, the *Chicago Tribune* conservatively estimated that Hawthorne owes more than \$100 million. Its more than 200 creditors include simulcast outlets, contractors who did interior demolition work in preparation for the racino that has never materialized, vendors, and the IHHA.

The May 27 ruling by Judge Barnes authorized Hawthorne and a committee of unsecured creditors to subpoena records from Fairmount, the Illinois Department of Agriculture, its director Jerry Costello, and his HBPA lobbyist brother, John.

Hawthorne alleges that under the direction of Jerry Costello, the Department cut its funding by \$316,895 and terminated its grant agreement and the track points to "troubling connections" between Jerry and John as the reason.

John has called the allegations false and defamatory and said they will be addressed in court.

It's past time to get to know Mike Carter

When I first approached Mike Carter with about writing this article his response was something to the effect of: "Why would you ask an old coot like me, someone who very few people in this sport even know about, to be the subject of a profile?" I had no answer to the old coot reference. After all, I'm one as well. But if there is truth to the part about not knowing who Mike Carter is, then I believe that its way past time that people learn more about this astute gentleman and his lovely bride.

Mike and Jan, married for a few months short of 70 years, have been involved in our sport since 1970. Their participation has been primarily as owners throughout most of that time, but it has included ownership of a breeding farm and most significantly as fans of our great sport.

By profession, Mike, now on the cusp of 87 is a retired attorney who has among other ventures owned a piece of a racetrack, Saginaw Valley Downs, a television station, and several Little Caesars pizza outposts.

Mike, I had previously known you slightly, but it was during our visit to the Vincent Delaney Memorial in Ireland where we in effect picked up the pieces of our friendship.

"Jan and I have been privileged to attend major harness racing events throughout this world of ours. In addition to virtually all of the major races in North America we have been to races throughout Europe and Down Under.

"We have been fortunate enough to have known most of those that I consider to have been the great horsemen of the last 50 plus years. One of those was Delvin Miller, a partner in Saginaw Valley.

"Jan and I were planning to visit New Zealand to celebrate our 25th anniversary.

"I knew Delvin had been there and wherever Delvin went he made friends, often friends in high places. I reached out to him to get some tips on who we should meet and what we should see while there. He said he would get back to me in a few days. True to his promise, he did. He gave me some names of people I might want to contact.

"Delvin, being Delvin also didn't tell me some of what he had apparently arranged. Upon landing in Auckland, we were

greeted by Sir Roy McKenzie, then the most prominent breeder in the country. We were treated as though we were visiting royalty, taken to all the major races and introduced to a who's who of harness racing in New Zealand."

You've been involved in the sport for more than a half century. When, how, and where did it begin?

"I knew nothing about harness racing. I hadn't yet even seen my first pari-mutuel race. I had a good law practice in our state of Michigan. In 1970, I was approached by an uncle of mine, Art Putnam. He was an auctioneer and a race caller. He wanted to start a breeding farm in Michigan.

"He needed startup capital and approached Jan and I. We agreed to come in with the caveat that Jan would control the money. She would be the only one authorized to sign the checks. Thus, Pastime Farms was founded. Jan not only did the books and wrote the checks, she did many of the chores on the farm including inseminating the mares.

"I was an absentee owner tending to my law practice.

"We grew to become the second largest breeding farm in Michigan. Bob Huff's Shiawassee Farms was number one. We became active. We bought reasonably well-bred fillies to race and then breed in Michigan.

"The first filly we owned was a Super Bowl filly named Super Flower who won the Merrie Annabelle as a 2-year-old.

"We later became involved in a conflict regarding the future of breeding in Michigan. We opposed the establishment of a sires stakes only program, believing that it would stifle the quality of mares being bred in Michigan. So, we left the Michigan program and decided to breed and race on a bigger stage. We quickly discovered how difficult it is to compete against the best of the best."

Since that time, you have been involved almost entirely as an owner of mostly trotters.

"We have owned parts of horses, most of the time since then with the exception of the years that we lived in Puerto Rico. Most of the time we have partnered with our son Barry Carter who is an equine veterinarian. He specializes with standardbred horses and with a focus on lameness. He has been in practice for nearly 40 years."

What in the world led to your setting up camp in Puerto Rico?

"I had the opportunity to become involved in the ownership of a television station there. As a byproduct of that ownership, we also became owners of several Little Caesars franchises."

How did that happen?

"The biggest part of our TV revenue came from advertising. We had some dead time where we didn't have any advertising sold. My partner asked how can we fill that time - either we use it or we lose it. I mentioned to him that I had some clients in Michigan who were Little Caesars franchisees and were doing quite well with them. So, we established the first Little Caesars stores in Puerto Rico to take advantage of being able to advertise them on our TV station. Ironically, those became more successful than the TV station. We eventually sold everything and came back to the States as retirees."

What are the major changes you've experienced in all your years in the sport?

"There are so many. One of the major ones is that it is far less a sport and more of a business, albeit a lesser business, than it once was. The greatest loss from my perspective is that we lost the feeling of community that once was prevalent throughout the game.

"Many of the social aspects are gone.

"Things that I looked forward to no longer exist. One of the highlights of the year for me was Grand Circuit week at The

Meadows which culminated with the Race for the Orchids, The Adios.

“The Adios is still there, but it has lost some of its former luster. The week leading up to it was one social happening after another led by Delvin Miller and his entourage of celebrities often in attendance including his friends Arnold Palmer, Mickey Mantle, Whitey Ford, Stan Musial, Perry Como, and numerous others.

“I recall sitting with Hall of Fame jockey Eddie Arcaro watching the races on the rooftop of the grandstand. That was the same location where I met a teenager named Sam McKee, who was learning his trade under the tutelage of Roger Huston. We hired Sam to call the races at our Michigan Breeders Futurity a couple of years later. He called the races at Saginaw Valley Downs for us. The rest is history as he became a legend in our sport at The Meadowlands, The Red Mile, and as a pedigree reader at the major sales.

“Lexington is still great, but not quite as great as it once was. The entire Western swing of Indianapolis, DuQuoin, and Springfield is nothing more than the dimmest shadow of its former self.

“I live near Vero Beach where the Palema Training Center is located. Some of the best trainers [currently all Swedish and Canadian] and many of the best trotters get their early lessons there. It is among the best training facilities to be found anywhere. It is a fine place to watch babies train. Among the many positives that the Swedish trainers have brought to these shores is the Swedish custom of Fika. It is akin to what we generally regard as a coffee break. On most mornings at Palema, those in attendance take a break, sit down to a respite of coffee and pastries and discuss most anything, but rarely that relating with the work at hand and what we are there for.

“In terms of the racing itself, we have made it easier for people to stay away from the racetrack by having the races so easy to access via the internet. By doing so, we have eliminated the method by which a significant number of those in the sport, perhaps the majority of them, learned to love it.

“In terms of the horses themselves, as most have said, they are better, far better than they used to be. But even there, perhaps it is indicative of the lesser number of people involved in it, we have become rather blasé regarding how great these equine athletes are. I recall sitting with Curt Greene and Bob Schmitz at The Red Mile the day that Niatross performed his sub 1:50 time trial. There was an exceptional crowd. Horsemen packed the fence from the barns to the grandstand. Everyone started cheering loudly as he passed the three-quarter pole. We had witnessed an historic event.

“The closest we came to that recently was in Bulldog Hanover’s world record feat. Maybe it was close, but nowhere near as resounding.”

“I knew nothing about harness racing [when I started]. I hadn’t yet even seen my first pari-mutuel race. I had a good law practice in our state of Michigan. In 1970, I was approached by an uncle of mine, Art Putnam. He was an auctioneer and a race caller. He wanted to start a breeding farm in Michigan.”

What is you and your wife’s presence in harness racing today?

“We have been fortunate in having had some of the greatest horsemen ever as trainers of our horses through the years. They’ve been in the hands of greats such as Howard Beissinger, Linda Toscano, the Beavers – Charlie and Chris – Ake Svanstedt, Marcus Melander, and Reijo Liljendahl.

“Presently, we have a 2-year-old with the Melander stable and two with Chris Beaver.

“Melander’s success has been incredible. He and Ake Svanstedt have come close to dominating our 2- and 3-year-old trotting classics.

“I kiddingly refer to Chris Beaver as a bottom feeder. That is not a fully accurate characterization. He has also bought and trained great horses at serious yearling prices. There is no other trainer to my knowledge who has done so well recently with reasonable priced, perhaps even cheap yearlings as Chris has

done. A couple who come to mind are Raging Samantha which he bought for less than \$10,000, earned just about half a million with, and then sold for half a million. He also bought Endurance for \$14,000. The colt has now earned over \$700,000 and is one of the top 3-year-old trotters anywhere.

“We are still active with our son Barry and have three horses in training. I sometimes wonder if we didn’t have the great association with Barry whether we’d be involved to the extent that we are or whether we might be involved at all. At the moment, we still read sales catalogs. We pay attention to pedigrees. We watch horses train when we can and still find time to stream most of the important races and all of them where we have a horse racing.”

Grand Circuit Canadian Weekend begins with Camluck Classic

It was an eye-catching Canadian debut for Lou Hill.

The Somebeachsomewhere Stake (Grade 3) for 3-year-old pacers and the first leg of the Grade 2 Graduate Series for 4-year-old male trotters and pacers marked the annual arrival of the Grand Circuit at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Saturday (May 30). But first, the Grade 3 Camluck Classic.

The invitational pace is Canada's first Grand Circuit stop on the calendar, taking place on the final night of the 2025/2026 meet at The Raceway at Western Fair in London, ON. In race 10, a field of eight horses and geldings went behind the starting gate for the seventh edition of the \$150,000 Camluck Classic. The race originated in 1972 under a different name and title sponsor; it was founded as the Labatt's Blue Invitational Pace, then became the Molson Pace in 1992. In 2018, it was renamed for Camluck, the stallion who stood at sponsor Seelster Farms of Lucan, ON and left a lasting impression on the sport.

Lou Hill (p, 4, 1:49m; \$515,202) won Camluck Classic 2026, with driver Jason Bartlett in the sulky, as the 1-5 betting favorite.

It was the first Canadian start for the gelded son of Sweet Lou—Pretty Katherine, who pocketed up early behind pacesetter Helium N (driven by Dan Noble) enroute to a :26.3 opening quarter. A first-over bid past the :54.4 half by Donegal Luther N (Yannick Gingras) carried him alongside Lou Hill to three-quarters, reached in 1:22.4, but the parked-out challenger never cleared Helium N. Second-over Calicojack Hanover (Bob McClure) went three-wide on the final turn, gaining ground late, but open lengths behind

the top two. When Lou Hill left the pocket in mid-stretch, Bartlett's patient drive paid off. He won by a length-and-a-half over Helium N, with Calicojack Hanover up for show in the 1:51.2 mile.

"That's not really where I wanted to be," Bartlett told interviewer Greg Blanchard on the walk to the winner's circle. "I wanted to cut the mile with him, but you know, sometimes just things don't go your way, but he's very versatile... I'm just hoping to be able to get out [of the pocket]. He's really good off a helmet too, so he's just a really good horse."

"You know, the problem was, he wasn't in the Borgata [Series at Yonkers], so he really wasn't racing a lot, because all of the good horses were racing at Yonkers. We always knew he was a really good horse, and he showed it again here today, but he'd been racing really well all year."

The Camluck Classic was Lou Hill's seventh victory from 11 starts this year. He has only missed the exacta once in 2026, in the March 9 invitational at Yonkers. His latest win was the fastest by a gelding in Canada on a half-mile track this season, but far from his personal best on a half: Lou Hill won going away at Yonkers on May 18 in 1:50 flat.

"Every half-mile track's a little bit different, but [The Raceway at Western Fair] kind of reminds me of home, to be honest with you," said Bartlett, who began his career in Maine.

Blanchard asked Bartlett what was next for Lou Hill, who has now won 20 of 50 career starts, making up for lost time. The well-bred homebred did not race at age 2; he won his second-ever qualifier at Scioto Downs on June 26, 2023, but ended up a vet scratch from what would have been his pari-mutuel

debut there on July 15, 2023. He did not return to qualify again until April 12, 2024 at Miami Valley, and finally made his first career start a winning one on May 10, 2024 at The Meadows. Lou Hill moved from trainer Virgil Morgan to Per Engblom in Nov. 2025, corresponding with the horse's increasing presence on the East Coast.

"Like I said, he tries, he's got a great attitude, and his gate speed is something that's always going to put him in the hunt," Bartlett said.

He guided Lou Hill along the fence for fans to get a closer look at the 2026 Camluck Classic champion, who walked calmly on a loose lead shank held by caretaker Helene Engblom.

Per Engblom trains Lou Hill for owner/breeder Tom Hill of Hamilton, ON. Per said that his latest visit to The Raceway was not his first.

“I’ve actually been here before, I think 10 years ago when I worked for Jimmy [Takter], when we were up here racing in this race,” Per told Blanchard, making reference to Sunfire Blue Chip, who finished second by a neck to Evenin Of Pleasure in a then-track record (1:50.3) in the 2016 Molson Pace.

“[Lou Hill’s] last two starts have been great,” Per said. “Actually, the whole year has been great, but the last two starts, at Miami

Lou Hill is sustained to the 2026 Canadian Pacing Derby, scheduled for Sept. 5 at Mohawk. His next Canadian appearance could be in the Mohawk Gold Cup (Grade 3) invitational on Saturday (June 13), a star-studded card highlighted by the Grade 1 North America Cup final.

Camluck Classic Night caps 2026 season at Western Fair in style

The Raceway at Western Fair District closed out its 2025-26 live racing season in spectacular fashion on Friday night (May 29), delivering a thrilling Camluck Classic program that showcased top-tier talent, record-setting performances and a large, boisterous crowd enjoying the action.

LOU HILL DOMINATES CAMLUCK CLASSIC

Headlining the evening was the \$150,000 Camluck Classic presented by Seelster Farms, where **Lou Hill** delivered as the prohibitive favorite, stopping the clock in 1:51.2.

Driven by Jason Bartlett, the reigning 2025 Dan Patch Award winner as U.S. Driver of the Year, Lou Hill executed a textbook 2-hole trip, tracking pacesetter Helium through blistering fractions of :26.3, :54.4, and 1:22.4. Helium came under pressure

from a first-over bid by Donegal Luther N, softening the leader just enough for Lou Hill to explode from the pocket in the stretch and surge to a decisive win.

Helium held gamely for second, while Calicojack Hanover closed to finish third.

The victory marked Lou Hill's seventh win in 11 starts this season, pushing his lifetime earnings beyond \$700,000. The standout pacer is owned by Tom Hill of Hamilton, ON, and trained by Per Engblom.

GRIT N GRACE SETS TRACK RECORD IN FOREST CITY PACE

The undercard feature, the \$50,000 Forest City Pace for older mares, saw **Grit N Grace** deliver a front-end masterpiece for driver Jody Jamieson.

The 5-year-old mare blasted to the lead early and never looked back, carving out fractions of :26.4, :56, and 1:23.3 before stopping the clock in 1:52.2 – a new track record for older pacing mares at The Raceway.

Grit N Grace held off a late charge from Raptors Won to win by a half-length, while defending champion Caviar N Crackers rallied for third.

The victory was Grit N Grace's first in four starts this season and elevated her career earnings to over \$440,000. She is owned by Loraine Rey of Manitoba and trained by Mike Kwietniowski. Notably, the performance marked a triumphant return after finishing as runner-up in last year's edition.

LONDON CLASSIC SALE SERIES FINALS HIGHLIGHT STRONG FAVORITE PERFORMANCES

Favorites shone brightly in the quartet of \$40,000 London Classic Sale Series finals, capturing three of four divisions:

- **Southern Cowboy** – Horse and Gelding Trot (2:00)
- **Aunt Gertrude** – Filly and Mare Pace (1:56.2)
- **Skip The Honey** – Horse and Gelding Pace (1:55.4)

The lone mild upset came in the Filly and Mare Trot, where second-choice **Look A Diamond** prevailed in 1:59.2.

ONTARIO SIRES STAKES ACTION AND RECORD TROT PERFORMANCE

A trio of Ontario Sires Stakes Grassroots divisions for 3-year-old filly pacers added further depth to the card. The winners were:

- **Could Be A Queen** – 1:55.3 (driver: James MacDonald)

- **My Girl Friday** – 1:54.4 (James MacDonald)
- **Tainted Love** – 1:56.3 (Jason Bartlett)

Garry Merner who trains Tainted Love enjoyed a memorable evening, also sending out **Passarino** to victory in the \$16,000 preferred trot. Driven by Mark MacDonald, Passarino delivered a historic performance, stopping the clock in 1:54.3 to establish a new track trotting record at the London oval.

STRONG WAGERING CAPS MEMORABLE NIGHT

The Camluck Classic program attracted a total handle of \$825,000, marking an increase over the 2025 figure. On-track wagering was particularly strong, posting a 15 per cent increase year-over-year, as local fans were out en masse for the closing night card.

Friday's program wrapped up another solid season for the London oval which will now be dark until racing returns in early October.

San Patricio makes a statement in Indiana Sires Stakes opener

Last season, San Patricio's freshman campaign came to a disappointing close after a ninth-place finish in Indiana Sires Stakes competition. On Memorial Day, the trotter made his sophomore debut at Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino, turning in an impressive 1:52.4 effort in the opening round of sires stakes at the Anderson oval. The homebred wired the field in his \$50,500 split, serving notice that he will be a top contender in the division.

Bred by Tony Holmes and the late Walter Zent, San Patricio is a gelded son of Swan For All out of the Cantab Hall mare Kaikoura. Digging into the trotter's pedigree, he has a strong family behind him, products of the Holmes/Zent breeding program. Kaikoura is a full-sister to Grade 1 Valley Victory winner Fast As The Wind (\$833,274), and her dam, Wind Stroll, is a half-sister to millionaire and world champion Guccio and PASS final victor Lagerfeld (\$804,050). Trainer Tyler Butenschoen noted that while the stable has not had many Swan For All-sired trotters in the barn, San Patricio has the characteristics a conditioner desires.

"He's just very business-oriented on the track," Butenschoen said. "He's big, he's strong. When he's out there, he's a great moving colt on the track; good stride to him. And he stays pretty sensible for the most part with things. If we're racing, he wears a little bit more of a closed up cheater cup just to help keep his attention because he looks around. And then jogging throughout the week, we pull that off of him and let him go with almost an open bridle. He's got just a real small cut down, can't see back. He just really relaxes on the track. He's easy to work with that way."

The dual-eligible trotter began his career with two consecutive trips to the winner's circle in 2025, claiming victory at Harrah's Philadelphia before shipping to Oak Grove to score a Kentucky

Sire Stakes leg by more than six lengths with a 1:56.1 clocking. Tangling with Endurance and Silverstein the next time out, he trotted third with a 1:54.1 effort. When racing moved to The Red Mile, San Patricio recorded a fourth-place effort in the opening leg of the Kentucky Championship Series before dropping into the Commonwealth Series to collect a win.

Shipping to Hoosier Park last August, the trotter picked up back-to-back wins in sires stakes action for driver Trace Tetrick. In the first attempt, San Patricio enjoyed a pocket trip before sprinting home to a 4½-length victory in a time of 1:54. Nine days later, the margin was a length and a quarter, this time tripping the timer in 1:57. In early September a pair of breaks in the opening panel took the gelding out of contention in a sires stakes contest. The ninth-place effort was his last charted line of the campaign.

“We were real high on him, really happy with his races there at Hoosier,” Butenschoen said. “We thought he’d be one of the top ones up there and have a good shot in the finals when they came around as long as he stayed that way. Unfortunately, just growing there and some colt soreness kicking in changed our plans for him. He just wasn’t 100 per cent. We talked to owners, and they have some thoroughbred background, and they just wanted to kind of do what they thought was right for him and just shut him down instead of trying to push through with him.”

San Patricio wintered in Lexington before returning to training in Florida. On the track, the sophomore, owned by Tony and Michael Holmes, June Zent, and Timothy Thornton, returned to the form that produced five wins in eight attempts and added \$105,150 to his card last season.

“He came back well,” Butenschoen said. “He was turned out at the owner’s farm there in Lexington until he shipped down to Florida and pretty well picked up right where he had left off last year. The qualifiers down in Florida were pretty much just training miles. We like to get a couple lines into them before they come up.”

At Oak Grove, the trainer hoped to get a couple easier starts for his charge before moving directly into sires stakes. He had no such luck as the class for non-winners of \$7,500 last four starts or non-winners of eight pari-mutuel races lifetime repeatedly did not fill. Butenschoen resorted to a pair of qualifiers at the southwest Kentucky track before heading to Indiana.

“We had entered him three times down there and unfortunately the non-winners of \$7,500 wasn’t filling,” he said. “They had

offered to put him in the open and have him draw the inside but we didn’t want to go that way for a 3-year-old making his first start back. There’s some really nice horses racing in the open down there.”

Clocking qualifying wins in 1:57.3 and 1:55.3, San Patricio didn’t disappoint in his debut. Lining up fifth in a nine-horse field, Tetrick placed the favorite on the lead and never relinquished. The duo set the tempo with fractions of :28, :56.2, and 1:25. While his :27.4 last quarter was not the fastest of the group, he crossed the wire with a comfortable length and a half advantage. The 1:52.4 time was more than two seconds faster than the other division, dead-heated by Dan D Man Can and August Salazar.

The sophomore is back in to race Tuesday (June 2) at Oak Grove, drawing into the same class the trainer tried to enter without success prior to the Memorial Day win. The goal is to get San Patricio a start between Indiana Sires Stakes legs, as well as keeping the door open to Kentucky Sire Stakes.

“Looking at the schedule, there’s 17 days before the next sires stake leg up there,” Butenschoen said. “He’s also Kentucky eligible so we figured it would be good to get him a start down there just to make sure he handled that track. He raced there last year so there shouldn’t be any issue with it, but just to make sure everything was good in case we wanted to look at trying to do a leg of the Kentucky Sire Stakes as well as Indiana.”

San Patricio’s full-sister is currently in training, and Butenschoen had high praise for her progress thus far. Named Karamea, the filly is the second foal from the dam, and is physically much different than her brother.

“She is a completely different horse than he is,” Butenschoen said. “Looks nothing like him. Different color, different build, different body, all of that. But she’s very nice on the racetrack. I mean, she’s the kind of horse that anyone would want to drive. When you ask her to go, she goes. You ask her to slow down, you barely touch the line. She’s one of the most drivable 2-year-olds we’ve had in a long time. Just completely different as far as the way they’re put together, but very impressed with the way she handles work so far.”

Mike Murphy, Jacob Fox, a banana peel, and amateur clubs

One of the joys of harness racing is the conglomerate of horsemen one meets over the years.

Back 43 years ago, I was lucky enough to meet Mike Murphy at Pompano Park.

Of course, times have changed over those many years and, back then, Mike was kind enough to introduce me to one Top Line Collins, p, 4, 2:03.1 – \$23,046.

He was “bred to be a good one,” as they say, and Murphy loaned him to me for a media race at Pompano Park where he cut perfectly rated fractions – if I do say so myself – :32, 1:05.1, and 1:38 and a piece on the front end before he was mercilessly passed like he was standing still around the final bend and finished third.

I joked with Murphy the next morning when trackman Ted Malloy said he found a bit lying on the track near the three-quarter pole and I said, “That’s where Top Line Collins spit his out!”

Anyhow, Murphy has had some good news over the years... like Four Socks and Tater Twister and Just For Trix, the only sub-1:50 trotter of a few seasons back.

He is 80 years young these days, having been given the second chance at life by his non-blood grandson, Jacob (J.W.) Fox, who, despite tote-board odds of 1,000,000 to one, had a matching kidney to donate to grandpa, which he did.

This led to yet another life-saving moment in late 2022 when Fox plucked the pacer, Feelin Lika Winner, off a kill pen truck, sent him over to grandpa, who nursed him back to health and won another \$25,000 in just a couple of months, sending his career earnings to \$632,7511 in 311 starts with 50 wins to go along with a mark of 1:49.2.

As Murphy lamented, “Horses give their heart and soul to you during their racing careers and should not be tossed away like a banana peel.”

Those words seemed too profound to toss them away like a banana peel, as well.

That’s why Murphy found Feelin Lika Winner a retirement home at the Kentucky Horse Park, where he’s living the life of luxury he deserves.

That's the happy part.

Years prior, an equine rescue team had taken a trotting horse – a horse, not a gelding – that had a 2-year-old mark of under 1:54 with earnings over \$150,000.

The horse was said to be in emaciated condition with the rescue farm accepting the horse into its program for much needed care, which it began to receive.

Here's where amateur clubs can play an important role in mitigating horse slaughter.

These clubs, whose members donate 100 per cent of their earnings driving in their events for charitable distribution, play a significant role in saving the lives of our standardbreds and every racetrack holding pari-mutuel events should feature these events, as it gives the sport a chance to bring harness racing to the forefront with new participants coming to the track with backstretch tours, starting gate rides, visits to the announcer's booth and, most importantly, donations to rescue organizations such as the Standardbred Retirement Foundation, After The Finish Line, Equine Assisted Therapies, Bit-By-Bit, American Horse Rescue Network, Equine Advocates Rescue, Peaceful Ridge Rescue, Vinceremos Therapeutic Riding Center, New Vocations, Rocking T Equine Sanctuary, Therapeutic Riding Center, Safe Harbor Sanctuary, Redemption Ranch, Volunteer Equine Advocates, Tomorrow's Rainbow, Cassidy's Cause, and Steele Magnolia Sanctuary.

The United States Harness Driving Club, as an example, has been donating to places like these for three decades with several more donations scheduled in the near future.

USHDC president Dein Spriggs and treasurer Tom Eichas carefully map out a plan to make certain that our standardbred horses receive their just reward when their racing days are complete.

"We can only do so much," they echoed in unison, "but we and our members do all we can do, as do the other clubs around the country."

Not only do these emporiums save horses, many offer therapeutic benefits to children from 2 years old to 92 years old, assisting in rehabilitation efforts from a number of maladies that can affect us both physically and mentally.

In other words, our standardbred horses can serve humanity in so many ways once their racing days are history.

Today, Feelin Lika Winner is enjoying his years at The Kentucky Horse Park in Lexington.

They treat him like a champion there.

Won The West (\$3,939,836) is there, too.

So is Mr Muscleman (\$3,582,823) and Marion Marauder (\$3,392,609).

The steeplechase champion Andi'Amu is a Park resident, as is the thoroughbred Roy H, a Breeders Cup Sprint winner of \$3,139,765.

They are just a few of the legends, and they do not have to be legends to spend their lives in luxury, as Feelin Lika Winner, plucked off of a kill pen truck, has proven, although he's a champion in the eyes of Murphy and Fox.

Murphy has some other retirees at the park, as well, unless they are giving some kids the rides of their lives at a farm in Sadieville.

Murphy then shook his head and said, "They sure don't deserve to be thrown away like a banana peel."

June's super and rich history

Welcome to June; the racing season unofficially is really now underway. There is a ton of history to go through, so let's take a look at some standout June moments from the past.

- **June 2, 2007:** Southern Lynx wins the \$1 million Art Rooney at Yonkers. It was the first and only million \$ event ever held on a half-mile track. George Teague trained the colt who then won the \$1 million Meadowlands Pace in July. Tim Tetrick's first two million-dollar drives were with "Lynx" and he was the first horse to ever record back-to-back victories, no wins in between, both in seven-figure events. The previous high pot in the Rooney was \$490,904 set in 2006.
- **June 3, 1987:** Harmonious is foaled. Three years later he would team with John Campbell to capture the Hambletonian, without a stakes victory on his card.
- **June 3, 1978:** Dream Maker (\$27.60) won the very first Graduate final at The Meadowlands. Ron Waples drove the winner for Bill Robinson and Antonio Chiaravalle. That team of trainer/owner 13 years later would leave the 1991 yearling sale in Kentucky with a three pack, Lotta Soul, Riyadh, and Presidential Ball. That triumvirate would combine for career earnings over \$7 million.
- **June 6, 1987:** Jate Lobell wins the NJ Classic in 1:51.2 at The Meadowlands. That time would remain his career best. He then made his way two weeks later to win the first \$1 million race held in Canada, the 1987 North America Cup.
- **June 6, 1984:** The first of 12 straight editions of the Miss New Jersey are held. Showplace Trixie and Ray Remmen captured the initial sophomore pacing filly state-bred event. Remmen repeated in 1985 with Poplar Lil. The Miss New Jersey was contested up until 2015 with the stakes mark set in 2013 by I Luv The Nitelife in 1:49 flat.
- **June 9, 2006:** Tioga opens in upstate New York. Bruce Aldrich, Jr. wins the opener with So Real.
- **June 10, 2000:** Magician wins the first of consecutive Cutler Memorials at The Meadowlands in 1:53.4 with Dave Miller. He went on to a \$3.5 million plus career without ever taking a single step overseas.
- **June 11, 1982:** A record crowd of 52,975 cram into The Meadowlands to watch the Gerry Cooney and Larry Holmes

heavyweight title fight. The irony here is that two decades later, from 2001-03, Cooney spearheaded a movement to help disabled fighters and had a dinner every year in Pegasus, and Larry Holmes was among the featured guests.

- **June 13, 1984:** Highly-touted Nihilator makes his pari-mutuel debut a winning one with Tommy Haughton driving for father Billy. It would be nine weeks later when he would capture the richest race ever, the \$2,161,000 Wilson, and that still remains the high-water mark today.
- **June 14, 2008:** Paul MacDonell becomes the first driver on NA Cup night to bank over \$1 million. He took down the Elegantimage with Lantern Kronos for a purse of \$576,932, but the feature, the North America Cup, of course also went to him 18 years ago for \$1,470,000 with Somebeachsomewhere.
- **June 17, 1985:** The Statue Of Liberty debuts. Meadow Road dominates the 1½ mile test in a track record time of 2:57.3. But the most memorable part of the evening might have been the ad which was advertising the "Free Statue Of Liberty button to the first 20,000 patrons while supplies last." Oh, those were the days.
- **June 18, 1999:** Day In A Life becomes the very first Meadowlands Pace winner to ever be claimed. The \$156,250 ticket went to Perfect World Enterprises, one year after his career moment.
- **June 19, 1993:** Staying Together lowers the world race record to 1:48.2 down from the 1:49.2 Artsplace posted the year prior in the same race the Driscoll. Both were trained by Bob McIntosh.
- **June 21, 1956:** Ron Pierce turns 70 this year, 11 years after his finale. He's the only driver to win a million-dollar race in six consecutive seasons (2006-11).
- **June 22, 1996:** We are staring at the 30th anniversary of Jenna's Beach Boy posting his 1:47.3 scorcher at The Meadowlands as a 4-year-old. Riyadh was second.
- **June 23, 1983:** Cam Fella's streak of 28 in a row to end his career had a hold-your-breath moment when he dead heated with Walt Hanover in 1:53.1, a time that stood up as his career mark.
- **June 25, 1999:** Red Bow Tie romps in 1:48.2 in the William Haughton Memorial, the first year the Alfred E. Driscoll was renamed for the one and only Billy Haughton.
- **June 28, 2010:** Mark MacDonald has a night for the ages. Actually, the biggest night ever in Canada on NA Cup night. He won the Fan Hanover with Western Silk for a healthy \$646,020 followed in the very next race in the \$1,455,000 Cup with Sportswriter for \$1.22 million on the night.
- **June 30, 2017:** John Campbell wins race 6 at The Meadowlands with Muscle Diamond in his driving farewell. Oh wait, that doesn't count Goshen the next week and he won there too.

Mary McDermott is determined to bring harness racing back where it once was

Mary McDermott grew up in the barn with her siblings, Caitlin and Liam, and said it was the best life and way to raise a child. "My father Kevin and my mother Sheri dedicated their life to harness racing and have been involved in the sport in some way for the past 35 years," Mary said. "My parents met when mom was working for Ron Waples and dad worked for Jack Parker, Jr. Both trainer/drivers were and will always be some of the finest in the sport, so my parents learned from the best.

Mary was born in Freehold, NJ, and her family bounced around Monmouth County, but basically, they stayed between Millstones and Allentown, NJ.

"I grew up in New Jersey at Show Place Farm and spent every day there that I could. My siblings and I would run around playing like crazy, normal kids.

"My friends would love to have sleep overs so they could come to the barn with us. After all, every child loves and wants to be around a horse."

Even though Mary and her siblings made the barn their second home, her parents did not want them to make harness racing their career, saying it was tough to make a living training horses.

"So my brother became a construction engineer, and my sister became a doctor," Mary said. "Well of course I was the one that didn't listen and went the horse route. After high school I attended college. When I graduated college, I went right back to where my heart was, the horses."

Mary said she has always been a "daddy's girl" and she would accompany her father on the road when he raced and that's where it really all began for her.

"I wasn't old enough to get a license and go to the paddock so different people babysat me while dad raced," she said. "I wish I could remember all of them to thank them, for they were the best.

"During those days, harness people were one big happy family. Everyone chipped in to help watch each other's kids while their parents were busy racing horses.

"It was the best way to raise a family, and I have lots of great memories. One of my fondest memories was being picked up on Fridays from school in a horse trailer. I was so excited and didn't even mind the smell that lingered in the trailer."

Mary said she considers herself to be a “trainer’s daughter” and loves being part of her family’s business.

“Besides my mom and dad, I am the only one in the barn,” she said, adding with a laugh, “I’m there to help my parents and a lot of the time I have to remind my dad what equipment the horses wear. I always own a couple of horses in dad’s barn... and we race mainly at Saratoga Harness, but ship to Plainridge, Yonkers, Meadowlands, and Vernon Downs.

“Currently, I own two horses, one is a retired 23-year-old standardbred, and the other is a horse named Reign Of Honor.

“My dad trains between 10 to 15 horses every year, and I plan on owning another racehorse, I’m just waiting for the right horse.”

Mary said her all-time favorite horse is Hypnotic Blue Chip.

“During 2009 through 2011 he was a freak,” she said. “He set the record for the U.S. Pacing Championship at the old Meadowlands in 2010 in 1:47.2. He also won the Battle of Lake Erie that year beating world champion Foiled Again in a record time of 1:49.4.

“That was the best summer of my life and I’ll never forget it. Hypnotic Blue Chip is now happily retired and has a wonderful home where we get updates 24/7 from the new owners.

“My heart horse is Reign Of Honor. Thankfully, I own him and everyone knows he will never leave me.”

Besides owning and working with standardbreds, Mary has plans to help bring harness racing back to where it once was.

“I am a big believer in social media,” she said. “You will always see me pushing it. I now work for the New York Racing Association (NYRA) as the social media/content creator for thoroughbred racing. I absolutely love my job, and I can’t believe how many people don’t know we even [harness racing] exists.

“Saratoga Racecourse shares a street with our harness track and people still tell me they didn’t even know that we exist.

“When I’m at the flats, I talk about harness racing as much as I can. I bring my coworkers over when my dad is racing and people actually love it. They find it exciting and want to know more. Through the power of social media and posting daily updates and pictures of the daily ‘dos’ in the barn, we’ve gained real relationships with people.”

Mary said that people want to learn about our sport’s horses and racing and ask questions, but we don’t give them a platform to ask.

“This past year we purchased a yearling colt from Winning Key Farm; his name is Munster Truck,” she said. “I shared him with our followers since the day that we bought him.

“The people [followers] involved went through the breaking process in a POV from my dad’s eyes with him wearing Meta glasses that give over 600,000 views. We did multiple days of it, and it makes the people feel as if they own a part of the horse.

“We take the people to the barn and show them the horses. We explain the different equipment and allow them in the stall as ‘Munster’ is being groomed.

“My job at NYRA [New York Racing Association] allows me the opportunity to work with some of the most talented thoroughbred equine athletes, and yet my passion is still and always will be in my roots, harness racing. I’m really one of those people that can tie the two individual industries together. I believe that’s important, but in the end, I’m just a girl whose parents let her live out her dream.”

“Munster Truck literally has many fans. People send PR packages to the stable gate for Munster all the time. These fans really want to learn the quirks of each horse in our barn as they all have different personalities. They can’t wait until Munster makes it to the races.”

Mary’s online presence has been a win-win for all.

“From social media I was able to get my father five new owners after they saw our videos,” she said. “One is one of the bigger owners of Linda Rice [a top female thoroughbred trainer in New York]. The man was telling everyone he was going to claim a 12-year-old standardbred that day. To me that’s exposure we’ve never gotten before, and I think it’s so cool.

“My job at NYRA allows me the opportunity to work with some of the most talented thoroughbred equine athletes, and yet my passion is still and always will be in my roots, harness racing.

“I’m really one of those people that can tie the two individual industries together. I believe that’s important, but in the end, I’m just a girl whose parents let her live out her dream.”

Brandon Blvd stellar in Somebeachsomewhere

Brandon Blvd delivered a statement performance ahead of the Pepsi North America Cup eliminations by winning the Grade 3 Somebeachsomewhere Stakes on Saturday night (May 30) at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

The Andrew Harris trained **Brandon Blvd** and driver Jason Bartlett posted a stakes record clocking of 1:48.1 to win the \$140,500 Somebeachsomewhere for 3-year-old pacers. The clocking bested the previous mark of 1:48.2 set by Bulldog Hanover in 2021.

The opening quarter of the race saw No Waitlist blast to the lead, while Sweet Lovin Lou also hustled forward, but had to settle for the 2-hole with **Brandon Blvd** right in behind third. After a :26 opener, **Brandon Blvd** swept to the lead and hit the half in :54.3.

Brandon Blvd would then pace a :26.4 third quarter in effortless fashion, posting a three-quarter time in 1:21.1. The stretch drive

would see the son of Downbytheseaside—Alexis Faith close things out with another :26.4 clip to win by 2¼ lengths.

“I asked on him a little bit at the head of the lane and he just took off... the last three or four pylons he was just shut down and I actually thought I was going a :47 clip,” said Bartlett, who was subbing in for regular driver Dexter Dunn. “What a great horse, professional, leave out of there and put people where we need to put them and then remove him. Just a professional.”

Sweet Lovin Lou angled out in the lane and got up for second over No Waitlist. Borderline Mobby was fourth. All 10 starters are eligible to the Pepsi North America Cup.

Brandon Blvd was making just his second start of the season, following up a victory in the Grade 3 Paul Revere at Plainridge on May 2.

“The schedule gets so busy that you want to try and bring them in easy,” said Harris. “These horses really only race about 13, 14, 15 times a year and you got to have them ready for the right starts.”

Brandon Blvd is owned by Punisher 11 Stable LLC and now has nine wins in 12 career starts. His latest graded stakes win takes his career earnings over \$675,000.

The next step for **Brandon Blvd** is the Pepsi North America Cup and Harris is ready to see what will happen.

“We’re just going to sit here and do what we do on the track,” he said. “Beau Jangles is amazing, Odds On Mr Mamba is amazing, there’s a few other horses that are amazing. Let them do all the talking and nobody has to talk about us, and we’ll just show up on race day and see what happens.”

Brandon Blvd paid \$2.40 to win.

The Grade 2 Graduate Series for 4-year-olds started Saturday night at Woodbine Mohawk Park with **Ayeaye Captain Deo** and **Monserrate** drawing first blood.

Both the Graduate Pace and Trot opened with a single full field division for a purse of \$101,250.

Ayeaye Captain Deo and driver Bob McClure capitalized on a wicked front-end battle to sweep up for a career best 1:47.3 victory in the Graduate Series Pace.

All eyes were on Bruno No No No and Prince Hal Hanover, as both have turned heads to start their 4-year-old seasons. “Prince Hal” got away third, while “Bruno” got away fourth. The duo would both make a move entering the backstretch, with Prince Hal touching down on the lead just prior to a :54.1.

Driver Todd McCarthy had a decision to make with Prince Hal as Bruno and Doug McNair came right up beside. The decision was a final-turn throwdown that saw the pacers get toe-to-toe for a :26.2 split to hit three-quarters in 1:20.3.

Prince Hal Hanover turned away Bruno No No No for the stretch drive, but didn’t have much left in the tank. The backfield got into play, as Fifth And Five and Ayeaye Captain Deo started storming on the outside.

Fifth And Five was spotted fifth, several lengths off the lead turning for home. Ayeaye Captain Deo was on his back. Both came surging in the lane to go by rivals, with Ayeaye Captain Deo delivering the most on the end to win. Fifth And Five was second by 1¾ lengths.

Prince Hal Hanover hung in tough to finish third. Bruno No No No didn’t quit either and was just a little more than a length back of his main rival to finish sixth.

Trained by Garry Merner, Ayeaye Captain Deo entered Saturday's contest with two wins in five starts on the season. The son of Captaintreacheraus—Oceania owned by Gino Toscani.

The Graduate Series leg win, and 10th overall, will move Ayeaye Captain Deo's career earnings to over \$400,000.

With the bulk of the money coming in on Prince Hal and Bruno, Ayeaye Captain Deo went off at 25-1 to pay \$52 to win.

Over on the trot, Monserrate got room up the rail late to win the Graduate Series opening leg in 1:52, giving driver Jason Bartlett and trainer Andrew Harris a second stakes win on the Saturday program.

Leaving from post 6 in an overflow field of 11, Monserrate was a parked out third at the opening-quarter, which saw Hey Porter leading the group in :27. The added horse making it a field of 11 made it a movement filled race, as six were along the rail and five on the outside coming out of the first turn.

Monserrate marched up to the lead in the second split before

allowing Mr Mouton to clear around just after a :55.2 half. Mr Walner Fashion was left first-up and pressed Mr Mouton's wheel to three-quarters in 1:23.3.

In the stretch, Mr Mouton did his best to fight off the outside challengers, but couldn't keep the rail shut, tiring late and opening up enough room for Monserrate to shoot through for the victory. Hey Porter finished third, while Warrior was fourth.

A son of Chapter Seven—Guinevere Hall, Monserrate was entering off a bounce back 1:51.4 score at The Meadowlands on May 15. The Harris trainee has now won two of four starts this season and is a seven-time winner lifetime.

Owned by Punisher 11 Stable LLC, Monserrate has earned over \$750,000 lifetime.

Monserrate paid \$4.40 to win.

The Graduate Series now shifts to The Meadowlands for the next leg on June 12.

Caesars Entertainment, owner of Harrah's Hoosier Park, Eldorado Scioto Downs and Harrah's Philadelphia sold to Fertitta Entertainment

Fertitta Entertainment has agreed to pay \$5.7 billion to acquire Caesars Entertainment Corporation, owner of 60 casino and racing properties, including harness racing tracks Harrah's Hoosier Park, Eldorado Scioto Downs and Harrah's Philadelphia.

The deal, which in total is worth \$17.6 billion since Fertitta would be taking on \$11.9 billion in Caesars debt, has yet to be finalized. Caesars has until July 11 to seek competing bids.

Fertitta, which plans to take the casino company private, is owned by Tilman Fertitta, the billionaire owner of the Houston Rockets and the U.S. Ambassador to Italy.

If the deal goes through, Caesars investors would receive \$31 for each share they own. That's nearly a 50 per cent premium over the Caesars share price before word of a possible deal was first mentioned in February.

Caesars operates 53 properties in 18 states and one province, including three in Atlantic City: Harrah's Atlantic City, Caesars Atlantic City and Tropicana Atlantic City. The company also has 15 casinos in Nevada, including seven in Las Vegas where the flagship Caesars Palace is located on the strip.

There has been no word, yet, what Fertitta's vision is for the horse racing tracks in the Caesars family that also includes thoroughbred tracks Horseshoe Indianapolis and Harrah's Columbus Racing and Casino in Nebraska.

Diplomacy takes Big M feature

Diplomacy made his first start at The Meadowlands in 19 weeks a winning one Friday night (May 29), as the Per Engblom trainee came from well off the pace to record his second victory of 2026 in the featured \$15,000 high-end conditioned trot.

It certainly didn’t look good for those who backed the 9-2 third choice, who came into the race off a last-place finish at Yonkers after an early break. Camera Man led at the quarter in a snappy :26.4 before 3-5 public choice Chapercraz took over and led at the half in :55.

Diplomacy was anything but menacing heading past the five-eighths, sitting gapped along the rail in fourth as Chapercraz hit the gas and led at three-quarters by 3½ lengths in 1:23.

Celebrity Bambino, the 2023 Hambletonian favorite, was now in motion, as Diplomacy picked up some cover around the far turn to get into contention and go after the leader. Winning driver Todd McCarthy swung the 5-year-old gelded son of Muscle Hill—That’s All Moni to the center of the track for the stretch drive, before taking off and surging past Chapercraz by a head at the wire in a lifetime-best 1:52.2. Camera Man was placed third after Celebrity Bambino was disqualified for going off-stride at the finish.

“I was pretty happy after the first half,” said McCarthy. “I just had to help him get around that last turn a little bit. Once he straightened up [in the stretch] he really wanted to go forward.”

Trained by track leader Per Engblom, Diplomacy lifted his lifetime numbers to 11 wins in 42 tries, good for earnings of \$120,208. He returned \$11.20 to win.
