Market Share Beats Stellar Field in TVG Free For All Series

A champion and a Hambletonian winner at age 3, Market Share (Revenue S) Has come back firing at four. Though the purse of last night's TVG Free For All at the Meadowlands was just \$50,000, the race was loaded. And when it was over Market Share was clearly best.

With Tim Tetrick driving, he won by a half-length over Uncle Peter in 1:51.1.

The field brought together anybody who was anything among the older male trotters, including the red-hot 5-year-old Wishing Stone, an entrymate of Market Share's, Elitlopp runner-up Arch Madness and 2012 Hambletonian runner-up Guccio.

Cutler winner Sevruga had the lead as the field made its way into the stretch. Meanwhile, Tetrick was driving a patient race with Market Share. He was sixth early and bided his time until the driver tipped out at the top of the stretch. Sevruga had a 1 ½-length lead in mid-stretch, but Market Share came at him, eating up ground with every stride. The Hambo winner drove clear in the final 15 yards, as Uncle Peter got the place. Sevruga was third and Wishing Stone completed the superfecta in fourth.

"With the eight hole I was just trying to get him in play as best I could. My horse loves to track down horses," Tetrick said. "I knew that if I could keep him within four or five he would give me a great run, and he did. You have to trust the animal. He wants to win. He's just four and a great little horse."

When asked the difference between the 3-year-old Market Share and the 4-year-old Market Share, Tetrick replied: "He's gotten faster and carries his speed and he can come off the helmet real good. As long as I can trip him out he'll make a lot of money this year."

As part of the entry with Wishing Stone, Market Share paid

\$3.60. He is trained by Linda Toscano.

With a terrific group of older trotters around this year, there's no telling how fast one of these races might go. The 1:50 barrier could fall.

"It's amazing how fast these trotters can go," Tetrick said. "It's going to be a great year for the owners, fans, drivers, everybody. Hopefully my horse can stay on top and do what he does best, which is win."

For the "Little Guys", Jurgen Hanover Looks for Glory in the Beal Elims

Norm Smiley, one of the owners of Jurgen Hanover (Credit Winner), was ready to try something different. Smiley knew he had a quality colt, but nothing seemed to go right for him last year as he failed to win in his two pari-mutuel starts. So he made a trainer change, and found someone who would give the horse their undivided attention.

Marshall.

"We chose Donna and her husband Jim because they are honest, hard working people," Smiley said. "They do things that a lot of the big barns don't do today. They'll be rubbing their legs, handling the horses themselves. They watch the p's and q's and they are very attentive to detail. They just do a great job. I've been in the biggest barns—every one of them. You name them I have been in there. I am very happy to be with these people. I get honesty, integrity and hard working folks that do everything themselves."

On paper, the barn switch didn't look like the best decision. Miller has played the game at the highest level, while Donna Marshall heads a small stable that has never had much to work with. In 2012, she won just eight races. But she has done outstanding work with Jurgen Hanover,

who has won all seven of his starts this year and is among the head liners in tomorrow's Beal elims at Pocono Downs.

"I thought I would go this route and give them a shot," Smiley said. "They deserve it. If you look at the stock they have had you would see that you can't take horses that are poorly bred or crooked and do any good with them. They have not had the opportunity with better horses because they're not in the minds of the people that buy these high priced yearlings. I'm not saying all the big guys are bad, just that this is a different experience."

Donna Marshall works closely with her husband Jim, who is also a driver. In 2004 they developed Sleep Easy, who won the Lou Babic and the Battle of Freehold and made \$325,695 that year. But TLP Stable, the same group that is part owner of Jurgen Hanover, opted to go with a bigger name and turned the horse over to Chris Ryder. But TLP must

have liked something about Marshall because they were the ones who recommended her when Smiley was looking to make a change.

"That was very hard," Marshall said. Of the Sleep Easy experience. "It's very hard when you have one that you like and you've done pretty well with him and you've done right by everybody. This business is so tough."

They were due a break and got it when Jurgen Hanover arrived on their doorstep. His two biggest wins this year have come in the Weiss Final at Pocono and in the Empire Breeders Classic at Vernon Downs. With this horse, the Marshalls have done something right.

"We're pretty much from the old school," Marshall said. "We're here all day. We stay from the morning at feed time and we put in all those hours. I can't really say what the difference is between the big stables and ours. I think just because we've always had a small stable, they don't have that options we have because they're always racing, they're training, they're qualifying and going. We're not as busy, I guess."

The closest Marshall has come to the Hambletonian was in 2011 when she assisted the multi-talented Hambletonian executive Moira Fanning at the 2011 running. In 2013, Fanning could be handing her a trophy. You never know.

Among the favorites for the Hambletonian, Jurgen Hanover will face an immediate test in the Beal as he wound up in the same division as Smilin Eli (Muscles Yankee), who has looked super winning New Jersey Sire Stakes races. There will be three elims for the Beal, a race that will go a long way toward deciding who will go on to compete in the Hambletonian.

In the first elim, Dontyouforgetit (Cantab Hall) and Celebrity Maserati (Andover Hall) highlight the action. The second elim pits Historic winner Corky (Muscles Yankee) against Breeders Crown runner-up Royalty For Life (RC Royalty).

It will be a busy and important night at Pocono as the card also includes elims for the Lynch, the Hempt and the Ben Franklin. The biggest name on the program is Captaintreacherous (Somebeachsomewhere), who is coming off a win in the North America Cup. Clearly the top

Pricey Trotter Trixton Highlights Meadowlands Baby Races

Trixton (Muscle Hill), the most expensive yearling trotter sold at auction in 2012, will have his unveiling in today's qualifying events for 2-year-olds at the Meadowlands. Trained by Jimmy Takter and owned by Brixton Medical AB and Christina Takter, the colt sold for \$360,000 last fall at the Lexington sales.

"I think this is a nice colt," Takter said. "He's a big, powerful horse and I think he's going to be real player."

Yannick Gingras will drive the colt, who is a half-brother to \$501,074 earner Impressive Kemp. There will be 18 baby races Saturday and Takter has eight entered.

"I am very happy with the 2-year-olds I have this year," he said. "It is a strong group and there are a couple with star potential. We'll know a lot more after they have started a few times."

Trainer Jonas Czerynson is another who will bear watching this morning as he will unveil three horses bred in Sweden. In the seventh race on the card he has a Varenne filly named Steffi S and a filly by Express It named Spanish Princess S. His foreign bred horses are owned by Menhammar Stuteri Ab.

"They decided to pick out some of their babies that looked the best in Sweden," Czerynson said. "The idea is to get them started here, get them established and then send them back to Sweden later. The Varenne filly is very tough, which I am told seems to be the case with a lot of his babies. The Express It filly looks to me like she's a very nice horse. Time will tell."

Czerynson will also send out Swedish bred Sincerely Yours S, who is by Cantab Hall.

Tioga Downs Holds "Old Style" Sulky Race on Friday Night

Tioga Downs held its first "Old Style" sulky race on Friday night where the horses racing in the fourth race of the night were restricted to use older style sulkies which ended up being eight Tel-Star bikes. The race favorite, If I Didn't Care (Greg Merton) didn't care what race bike she was hooked to as Merton put If I Didn't Care on the engine through fractions of 27.2, 56.3, and 1:24.4 before drawing away from the field with ease in 1:53.4. The margin of victory was three and a half lengths as If I Didn't Care recorded her third win of the year for the Rock & Roll Stable of Chicago, Illinois and trainer Rick Dane.

In the \$10,000 featured Miracle Mile 1 pace on Friday night, Fair Voltage and Greg Merton used a second over cover trip and turned it into a 1:53.1 score. It was the third win at Tioga Downs this year for the 5-year old daughter of Village Jolt – My True Art for Charles Lewis and trainer James Clouser Jr. Itstimeformetofly (Phil Fluet) finished second, while Haggin Oaks (James Kennedy) hung on for third.

Aaron Byron and Greg Merton each posted driving triples on the night's ten race card, while Keith Kamann recorded a driving double

For the second consecutive night Dauplaise has a very formidable looking entry in one of these mini-series finals and even with the sick scratch last week, LONG LIVE ROCK remains the one to knock off. This one was won his last two starts by a combined six lengths and a number of rivals from his recent lines are superior to these; entymate ANDY BARAN is capable too as a bailout should the stronger choice falter. AWESOME ARMBRO N just ran out of ground last week but it was his second straight good looking try and is easily playable despite the post as Carlson gets the drive. AVOGADRO HANOVER capitalized off a quick pace to score last out and that entry might be a bit overbet now while ESPRIT DE KAYJAY A heads a short priced Surick entry. BLUE STRIKE proved last out his try from two back was no fluke and he's certainly performing better than his recent \$6K claiming tag.

BOBJACKS ANGLE A took serious tote support last week and was never put in play; typical. His prior effort two back against series favorite Long Live Rock (as above) would be good enough to seriously threaten; lands an ideal post to work out a trip. CC RACY sported a nice rally two back against a big favorite and then couldn't hack it last out when coming first over for Chiodo. Stands chance at a price with any lively pace up front. FREDDY DAY HANOVER raced too good to lose last week and will wind up in here as the deserving favorite. No mistakes or excuses allowed. HE'S A BEACHBOY might be able to tow along for a share.

TOUGH LOVE is a hunch call in a wide open race for Scamporino and Berry. This one wasn't terrible five back at Yonkers against the likes of High Noon and at least attempted an aggressive move last out; doesn't seem much worse than anyone else. THANKS FOR STOPPIN has taken action throughout this series and looms an obvious short priced threat; acquisition of Parker tonight won't hurt. CITY PIE was lurking last out and does appear playable at a price with Plutino; KAUFMAN HANOVER was Ginsburg's choice of the entry.

JETTIN JUSTIN chased Escape The News in his most recent qualifier three weeks ago and despite not making it to the races for a variety of reasons over the past two months he still might be good enough to beat these. This one already owns a win over the track this year and will threaten if he's right. PRETISSIMO will be blasting from the outside and was used last out against a number of foes better than what he's seeing tonight. POP A TOP POP was aggressively handled upon arrival here last week and held well. BANGBANGKISSKISS fits on paper while invading from Maryland.
