Leader Of The Gang Heads Yonkers Trot

YONKERS, N.Y.--Leader Of The Gang (Muscles Yankee), a top colt from last year still seeking his best stride this season, is the 9-5 favorite in the \$445,474 Yonkers Trot on Saturday night, the kickoff of the Trotting Triple Crown.

With only seven in the entry box last week, there was no elimination needed as everyone advanced to the final.

Leader Of The Gang landed post No. 2 with David Miller set to drive for trainer Jimmy Takter. The son of the 1998 Yonkers Trot winner is still looking for his first win this season.

After two disappointing starts at the Meadowlands, Takter added trotting hobbles for the Earl Beal Memorial elimination at Mohegan Sun at Pocono Downs. Leader Of The Gang raced much better, getting third to qualify for the \$500,000 final where he finished fifth.

In 2010, Leader Of The Gang earned \$356,772 in a season that included a win in the New Jersey Sires Stakes final and a fourth in the Breeders Crown.

Del Cielo (Broadway Hall) is the 3-1 second choice from the rail. Like Leader Of The Gang he is winless in four tries this year while picking up a second and a third in a pair of Pennsylvania Sires Stakes.



Evil Urges could be a major player in Yonkers Trot

Evil Urges (Cash Hall) could be a major player as the 4-1 third choice from post No. 5. The gelding, co-owned and trained by Homer Hochstetler, is nimble on a half-mile track, having already won New York Sires Stakes this year at Monticello and Buffalo Raceways.

"He goes fine around the turns," Hochstetler said. "He took that turn at Buffalo and they should have a caution light there. He trots clean, so the turns don't really bother him."

Hochstetler, a longtime mainstay in Illinois, bought Evil Urges for \$27,000 at Harrisburg in 2009 with longtime partner Robert Buddig, a Midwestern producer of lunch meats.

Hochstetler came east in May, settling in at Vernon Downs with six horses including his two Hambletonian prospects, Evil Urges and **Whit** (Classic Photo).

"This horse (Evil Urges) is a little better," Hochstetler said. "He's got a little more step."

The companion event, the \$237,714 Hudson Filly Trot, also drew seven with the remarkably consistent **Jezy** (Credit Winner) the one of beat. She is 16 for 17, including a perfect 6 for 6 this year for the ownership group of trainer Ray Schnittker, Jerry Silva, Jeff Gural and Ted Gewertz.

Bourbon Slush's First Entrant Breaks, Sixth at Yonkers

Lil Miss Bourbon (American Ideal), the first starter from the Bourbon Slush Stable, the partnership group put together by Frank M. Antonacci to generate increased interest in harness racing, had a rough go of it last night at Yonkers, finishing sixth in a division of a New York Sire Stakes Race at Yonkers. Sent off the 6-5 favorite, she broke just after the start and broke again in the stretch. In between breaks, she raced evenly, never advancing past fifth.

Cat Manzi drove.

The stable will try again tonight with **Bettorwithbourbon** (Bettor's Delight), who makes his debut in a sires stakes event at Yonkers.

Fate of Running Aces Rests With Minnesota Judge

With four cards having already been canceled due to a budget impasse in the state of Minnesota between the Governor and the Legislature, Running Aces Harness Park has reached out to a state judge in hopes that she will allow the track to re-open.



Both Running Aces and thoroughbred track Canterbury Park have not been able to race during the government shut down because judges are state employees. But the two tracks have

argued that since they pay the judge's salaries the shut

down should have no bearing on racing. The tracks' requests to be allowed to re-open has already been turned down by the same judge, Kathleen Gearin, but officials hope their new argument, which they say has been presented in a more convincing manner, will cause Gearin to change her mind.

Running Aces has drawn a card for Saturday, but will be forced to call it off if not winning their case before Gearin. She is required to rule today.

But Running Aces Racing Director Gregg Keidel said that if Gearin turns down the request to re-open and if the impasse continues track officials may soon have to pull the plug on the 2011 season.

"It looks like the Governor and the Legislature are only getting further and further apart," he said. "This is a serious situation. Running Acres is losing \$100,000 a day in revenues and it costs us \$30,000 a day to operate even when we don't race. We can't be expected to continue that way."

Keidel said that even if the impasse is settled some time down the road there might not be enough horses left to hold a meet.

"Our horsemen have been unbelievable," he said. "They have become a band of brothers and are willing to wait this out at least one more week. But after that, we are going to have a problem. They need to race and are going to head out of town. Once they're gone, we'll never get them back."

Running Acres is required to race 50 cards a year in order to operate a poker room. Kiedel said that if racing ends for 2011 management will ask for a waiver so that the poker room can continue to operate. It is also currently closed.

"If we don't get a favorable ruling from the judge, there's going to have to be some signs of significant progress soon on the budget," Kiedel said. "If not, I'd say by this time next week we'd have to decide to call the meet off."

Running Aces has over 600 employees on layoff while Canterbury has over 1,000.

Hambo Hopefuls To Battle at Big M

Though the race is worth just \$25,000, tonight's 10th event at the Meadowlands will bring together several of the top candidates for the Hambletonian.

The 6-5 morning-line favorite in the Open is **Pastor Stephen** (Cantab Hall), who is coming off a second-place finish in the Earl Beal at Pocono, but driver Ron Pierce is expecting a better effort tonight.

"During the week, three days before his last race, he kicked the stall," Pierce said of the Jimmy Takter-trained colt. "He bruised his right hind ankle, so he wasn't 100 percent for his last race. With Takter training him, he's just going to get better and better until the Hambo."

Pastor Stephen was beaten at Pocono by **Dejarmbro** (Credit Winner), who is not eligible for the Hambletonian. That is among the reasons Pierce is confident that Pastor Stephen is well on his way to winning one of the sport's biggest prizes.

"It certainly looks like it," Pierce said when asked if Pastor Stephen should be considered the leading candidate for the Hambletonian. "But Blue Porsche is also an extremely talented horse. I am a little concerned with him."

Six have been entered for the Meadowlands race.

Broad Bahn (Broadway Hall) is the second choice in the line at 3-1. **VC Chocoholic** (Chocolatier) is next at 9-2.

It has also been announced that Pastor Stephen will now be racing for charity. He is named after Rev. Stephen Heinzl-Nelson from the Allentown (NJ) Presbyterian Church. Five percent of the colt's future earnings will be donated to the human Pastor Stephen's charity, which assists the people of the African nation Malawi.

Wishing Stone (Conway Hall) with Swedish top driver, Ake Svanstedt, went to post as the even money favorite in the final of Swedish stake race, Sprintermästaren, but had to settle for second place.

Wishing Stone had to trot outside the early leader **Amaru Boko** driven by Jorma Kontio and couldn't find an extra gear as **Orrichetti**, driven by Örjan Kihlström, came from behind down the stretch.

Orrichetti won by 2 lengths in 1.53.4f, followed by Wishing Stone, who just got his nose in front of Amaru Boko.

The purse for the winner was \$185,000.

Orrichetti is sired by From Above and is bred by Hambletonian-director Margareta Wallenius-Kleberg.

Wishing Stone won his elimination very easy in 1.54.1.

Postcards From France

Even on vacation and with no plans to go anywhere near a horse, I couldn't escape harness racing. While visiting the Normandy region of France to take in the historical sights where D-Day occurred, I stumbled upon quite a sight at Utah Beach—a collection of French trotters.

Utah Beach was one of the key spots of World War II. Some 23,250 Allied troops landed on Utah Beach on June 6, 1944 in an effort to liberate France. They had to dodge land mines and enemy fire. Had they come some 67 years later they might have had to also dodge some horses.

On one of the most historic beaches in the world and hallowed ground so far as the U.S. is concerned, a French stable apparently prepares its horses for battles on the racetrack.

Normandy was gorgeous and I would have loved to make it to the races, but none in the area were racing while I would have been able to attend. I did watch the simulcast of a few races from Argentan, including a "monte" race, a spectacle I hope to see in person some day.

Newly Minted Hall of Famer Jim Simpson Strikes Encouraging Note For Game

GOSHEN, N.Y.--It was a damp evening as raindrops danced off the tent shielding the honorees and attendees last weekend at the Hall of Fame induction ceremonies on the lawn of the Harness Racing Hall of Fame.

At times, it got moist under the tent as well, especially when Joe Hartmann was tearfully remembered at his posthumous enshrinement in the Communicator's Corner.

And there were lighter moments, especially the guest appearance by Gallo Blue Chip, still looking hale and hearty, for his induction.

Hall of Fame inductions are always a walk down memory lane. Judge Walter Russell treated the crowd to recollections of his illustrious career as an official.

Jim Simpson, the other headliner, hit everyone with a change of pace. The master of Hanover Shoe Farms used his time at the podium to look forward rather than back.

And he is encouraged by what he sees.

His theme was optimism, something always in very short supply in horseracing.

With the sport having come through recent rough patches, Simpson painted a standardbred landscape that looks much brighter than it did a mere six months ago. First and foremost, Simpson pointed to the rescue of the sport's premier showcase.

"The Meadowlands is now in private hands, thanks to Jeff Gural and the SBOA," Simpson said. "It's been a great run with the Meadowlands being owned by the state of New Jersey. They've been a great partner but now it's time for the operation to be in private hands. I congratulate Jeff Gural, the SBOA and wish them the most luck."

Simpson pointed out Pennsylvania survived a purse cut by the state's legislature.

"As you know, many states, if not all, have economic problems," he said. "We made it through this year without any purse cuts and the fourth track in Pennsylvania is probably going to be announced next week. We keep hearing that rumor but one day it will be true."

All around, Simpson sees things on the upswing.

"Indiana missed a major purse cut problem. Ohio is at the brink of slots at the tracks. Yonkers Raceway just raised its purses again. Rosecroft Raceway is now owned by the Penn National gaming juggernaut. Ocean Downs is open with slots in it now. Illinois, if you take a look at what's going on there, there is a bill sitting on the governor's desk that would give slots to the Illinois harness

horsemen."

Simpson got the greatest cheers when shifting to the integrity issue. Even there, he sees reason for optimism.

"The technological revolution happening as we speak has made drug testing more sensitive and reliable," he said. "I do believe the day is going to come soon where the drug testing equipment and the bad guys intersect and drug testing equipment is going to win.

"The use of race day Lasix is being questioned more than I've ever heard. I hope to see the day soon when Lasix is prohibited on race day."

In a few short minutes at the microphone, Simpson lifted the fog that had shrouded the quaint town where harness racing was born.

Yes, it was a night to remember the past and heroes of the sport. But it was also an evening to look onward and upward, with hope and pride.



While recognizing the dominance of Arch Madness in the Titan Cup, as well as in his previous 2011 starts, we should remember that fifty years ago, in 1961, another 7-year-old gelding was lording it over the senior trotting

division, the same way Arch Madness is today. That, of course, would be Su Mac Lad, who was sold for \$750 at two, didn't race at three, earned \$7,300 at four, and was subsequently purchased for \$35,000 by Irving Berkmeier and turned over to Stanley Dancer, in whose care he flourished.

In 1960 he won a shade under \$160,000, which was more money than any other trotter made that year; he won 11 of 24 starts with 7 other board finishes. He overcame marginal breeding and an idle

youth to win the prestigious Gotham Trot at Yonkers Raceway, and was beginning to exert his authority in a division that the following year would include Air Record, Hickory Pride, Tornese, Senator Frost, Masina, Elaine Rodney, Tie Silk and Silver Song.

When he opened his 1961 campaign at the end of March, with driver Harold Dancer Sr. subbing for brother Stanley, he was prepping for the \$165,000 International Trot series at Yonkers. These international races would prove to be a steady source of money and prestige for Sumie throughout his career. That year he outdid himself, earning more than \$245,000. He won the Gotham again, as well as the United Nations Trot, and fifty years ago this month, he won the Roosevelt International for the first

time, a race he finished second in the following year, and won again in 1963.

When Sumie won the \$25,000 Volo Song at Yonkers at the end of August, he became the richest trotter ever, with earnings of \$422,664. With this win, he also topped Bye Bye Byrd's single season earnings record for either gait. He would more than double that overall figure before he was through. Su Mac Lad had at that point in the season won 12 of his 15 starts, and made the board in the other three. He was Trotting Horse of the Year from 1961 through 1963, and Horse Of The Year in 1962.

He retired at age ten, after winning his last start, the Trader Horn at Roosevelt. He had earned almost \$885,000, making him the richest harness horse ever. Unlike Arch Madness, and the other premier older trotters of today, Sumie fought his biggest battles on the Metropolitan half-milers, a place today's champions tend to avoid. And in light of that fact, I suppose it makes sense that on this fiftieth anniversary of one of the greatest campaigns ever by an older trotter, the Meadowlands chose to eliminate the series for aged trotters raced in his honor. I wish I could parse out the sweet coincidence of Arch Madness having been wildly successful in the Su Mac Lad, but that didn't happen; his best finish was a second to Lucky Jim in last year's final. Arch Madness has been somewhat fragile and inconsistent, so I'm not sure whether he will sustain his dominance to the point where a major racetrack will honor him with a series, but I do know that this will not happen with Sumie, who although he is still the namesake of a series for three-year-olds in his native Illinois, is now one step closer to being ensconced in the minutia of the sport.
