

Truisms are thus named because they are always true. One of which I can almost guarantee to be so is that "The older we get, the quicker we get to where we are going." An adjunct to that might be that we get beyond it even more quickly.

The Meadowlands Pace takes place in less than a week. The Hambletonian is less than four weeks away. The racing season is beyond half over, albeit in terms of quality the best racing is almost certainly still on the horizon.

I sometimes become possessed by the foolish notion that I am capable of predicting the future. In simplistic terms that has translated to trying to be able to predict the outcome of horse races. Having tried to do so without significant success for almost seven decades, I perhaps foolishly haven't even considered giving up. I obviously never will.

I've decided to take my nuttiness even one step further. I won't predict the winners of the individual races. But I am going to predict at this half-way point in the season the horses that

will ultimately become the Dan Patch award winners as the champions of 2023.

Even though it's almost certainly too early to embark on such an adventure for the older classes, it is most definitely beyond reason to include 2-year-olds in the predictions. So those will wait for another day.

PACERS

3-YEAR-OLD COLT PACERS

At present, the leader in terms of earnings and important wins is It's My Show (\$460,084). I expect that once the season is over the Dan Patch winner will be Confederate (\$197,250). I would be somewhat surprised if he doesn't start his road to seasonal honors with a victory in the Meadowlands Pace next Saturday. Both It's My Show and Confederate are sons of the Diamond Creek stallion Sweet Lou who is in the midst of his most successful season in the stud.

3-YEAR-OLD FILLY PACERS

In this observer's view, only one filly is in the running. Her name is Sylvia Hanover. What she has thus far accomplished is awesome.

I've been known to sometimes make foolish predictions. Here's another one. In terms of what I've seen this incredible amazon do, I doubt that we've even scratched the surface. Thus far, she has not only been unbeatable, but she has yet to be seriously challenged. It's rare that one sees a pacing filly that one believes might be able to take on and beat the best colts. Sylvia Hanover strikes me as that kind of filly.

Now that I've uttered the unthinkable, I hope that it never comes to pass. Not that I don't think that she might be able to beat the best colts someday, but rather that it is an extremely daunting journey that can challenge even the greatest of horses. I would hope that she stays where she is; a head above all of the other fillies.

One great asset she has in her favor is the great combination of the Steacy family as her trainer and Bob McClure as her driver. I am certain that what is best for the filly will be paramount in her future. Sylvia continues the great line of top fillies sired by Diamond Creek's Always B Miki.

OLDER MALE PACERS

This is a quality group; both deep and strong. Right now, in terms of money earnings, it's led by Hellabalou (\$367,770), followed by Covered Bridge (\$318,860), Lochinvar Art (\$274,817) and Leonidas (\$263,710). I'd be surprised if any of these leads the parade at season's end.

My choices for the Dan Patch winner would include the Hanovers: Ruthless, Abuckabett, Allywag, Linedrive and maybe Mad Max. Of those five, only Ruthless is in the top 50 of money winning older pacers at this time. Despite this, any one of them being the recipient of the Dan Patch Award next winter would not surprise me. As my friend Clay Horner has suggested, next week's





Haughton Final will probably go a long way in determining the outcome. They all come from power packed stables. Their sires include Betting Line (2), Sweet Lou, the inimitable Somebeachsomewhere, Captaintreacherous, American Ideal and Always B Miki.

OLDER FEMALE PACERS

Presently, in terms of money earnings, the category is led by the New Zealand import Amazing Dream N (\$253,293). I don't expect her to lead at season's end, but she is ultra consistent and seems to always get a decent piece of the action. She has a shot.

My choice for the pick of the lot at Dan Patch time would be Grace Hill. I would also include Silver Label and Hot Mess Express in my thinking. The sires are Bettors Delight (2), Always B Miki and Panther Hanover.

TROTTERS

3-YEAR-OLD COLT TROTTERS

At present the reigning Yonkers Trot winner Up Your Deo leads the parade with earnings of \$213,800. There are several others who trail including Air Power, Kilmister, Southwind Coors, Gaines Hanover, Oh Well and Ponda Jet. The reigning 2022 top colt Volume Eight has yet to show the exceptional ability that I expected from him. I am in no way going to underestimate the ability of trainer Noel Daley to get one ready for the big race, though. I expect that at Dan Patch time next winter for his connections to be the recipient of the award. I feel that at present there are no great stars in this group.

One unusual note in this category is that six of the top earning 3-year-old male trotters are geldings. I doubt that that has even been close to the case in the entire history of our sport.

3-YEAR-OLD FILLY TROTTERS

In the same manner that Sylvia Hanover stands way above her contemporaries in the 3-year-old pacing filly ranks, so does Special Way among the 3-year-old trotting fillies. One cannot easily pick the correct word to describe this incredible filly. The first words that come to this mind are "awe inspiring."

This breed has had an incredible number of great trotting fillies. Even before Hambletonian weekend of her 3-year-old season, I believe Special Way belongs in their ranks. Of course, the job still remains to be done by her. I have little doubt that, if misfortune does not present itself, she will do that and perhaps more.

There is still a lot of racing to take place, but if things continue as they have, I wouldn't be at all surprised if Sylvia Hanover becomes the Pacer of the Year for 2023, Special Way becomes the Trotter of the Year for 2023 and Special Way becomes the Horse of the Year.

OLDER MALE TROTTERS

As is often the case, the category presents a mixed bag. There are quite a few good ones and very few, if any, top ones. To these eyes, and to these eyes only, there is nothing resembling a great older male trotter. I believe the foreigners will probably clean our clocks when they come over for the Cashman Memorial and the Yonkers International. As this is written, Keg Stand leads with earnings of \$171,160 followed by Hillexotic (\$113,496) and It's Academic (\$162,094).

OLDER FEMALE TROTTERS

In relative terms, and perhaps also in actual ones, the older trotting females are better than the older ones. At this point, my two choices for the best ones are Jiggy Jog S (\$130,095) and Bella Bellini (\$98,330). When all is said and done, I expect the Bella Bellini will receive the Dan patch Award. Other older trotting mares include Pioneer As, Hey Livvy and Refined.







The benefits of betting 2-year-old trotters

Rarely does this column contain helpful advice for wagering. There are reasons for this lack of punting prognostication. I am pathetic at picking winning racehorses. Consider me sort of the anti-Pandy (Bob Pandolfo, handicapper extraordinaire).

A psychological aversion to wagering on a harness racehorse that will go off at odds lower than 4-1 is part of my problem. The idea of winning a race that does not pay enough to purchase a small bag of popcorn seems ridiculous. I would rather rip up my ticket that would have paid over \$30 than collect a pittance on a racehorse everyone suspected would win. Where is the feeling of superiority in agreeing with the majority?

In online wagering, a digital record of my transactions tells a sad tale. When my available funds balance icon registers less than a dollar, it is time to reload with \$100 from my groaning checking account. I have tapped the deposit funds button on my gambling account many times and never cashed out a single cent. I do not even know the process for receiving funds. Nevertheless, after this handicapping forewarning, I am breaking tradition. This column will contain a few words that the less sophisticated gambler may wish to consider.

I suggest unsophisticated gamblers will have more fun and stretch their gambling money by leaning into early racing in the 2-year-old season and specializing in trotting horses.

I love these opening races where traditional handicappers do not have an edge. I love the drama of the start of a horse's racing career when computer programs can't crunch the data because there is very little data to crunch. The kickoff of this niche is an excellent quartet of races in early July named the Next Generation for purses of \$150,000. The Next Generation races are for 2-year-old Ohio-bred horses and

need a \$10,000 nomination fee. As the calendar pages flip to early qualifying, owners of the slots carefully eye the promising prospects. When the dust settles, all the handicapper has to go on to solve the riddle of these races are a few qualifiers.

I love the Next Generation races and play the unpredictable races like a maniac. How unpredictable? One field of eight trotters in the Next Generation had five breakers, which is my kind of race. Next week, I seek out other races like the first leg of 2-year-old stakes, 2yo NW1 and even early fair races. My window is not open long, barely over a month. After the horses have multiple starts and performance levels get established, smart money begins to funnel into the pools, and I crawl back into my cave. Ah, but I am in harness racing heaven in those early days of 2-year-old racing.

Allow a few thoughts on these early races:

- All 2-year-old trotting races are good to play and fun to watch; but 2yo filly trotters are better because fillies may be a tad flightier.
- Longshots are playable during the early days. After all, merely trotting the course successfully may be good enough if all the other participants fall, run out of the draw gate, or break stride.
- Speaking of breaking, I love the chaos, the scattered fields, and the excitement. Often these races are like demolition derbies. These races are much more enjoyable than the predictable, single-file speedballs.



- I smile when a trotter makes a break in the first turn. Handicappers know that going off stride will happen with young horses. Psychologically, a misstep in the first turn is much easier to process emotionally than your horse staying flat and losing a photo finish.
- The subject of breaking horses brings me to an improvement in our sport that I suggest every year; any horse racing free-legged, without hobbles, receives a 25 per cent bonus on any purse money earned.
- Imagine if all of these 2-year-old racehorses raced without hobbles: what a wonderful world that would be.
- Watching the pre-race warmups of 2-year-olds is essential.
 Wagerers can notice little things like gaits, bulging eyes and runaways. Watching the contestants in the post-parade helps to discern if the horse appears calm, nervous or has launched the driver out of the sulky.
- The payoffs in these types of races are more palatable when not a single horse has competed. They may all have one qualifying line where less than two seconds separate the fastest from the slowest. It is doubtful there will be heavy favorites or massive long shots in this race of brand-new, fractious young horses.

- There are very few numbers and mathematics to digest in the first few races of a horse's career; this is excellent news for those who can barely manage a checking account.
- The top drivers are still top drivers, but every driver in these early races is just trying to keep the horse together. Finding holes and courtesy tucks are less of a problem. When five trotters in a race go off stride, there are more holes in the first turn than in a moonshiner's smile.
- The troubling problem of doping horses may be minimized or eliminated. Revving up a 2-year-old trotting filly that took a half hour to get into the van and depends on "keeping her mind on business" will not need to go to warp five.

I have my popcorn, wine coolers, chicken wings and 2-yearold racing schedule. I have my cash loaded onto my betting platform. I may even go to the racetrack to watch the "young uns" in action. These few weeks are the best time of the year for a bad better like me.

Let the mayhem begin! But hurry, this wagering window closes fast.

Tellmeaboutit is Alvin Miller's second "horse of a lifetime"

When older pacer Rocket Fuel retired following the 2015 campaign, trainer Alvin Miller believed he was sending his "horse of a lifetime" out to pasture. Two years later, he purchased a yearling colt from the first crop of Tellitlikeitis that has thus far compiled a career that rivals the horse he replaced. Tellmeaboutit, now 7, has taken the conditioner and co-owner on a thrilling ride that, most recently, yielded back-to-back triumphs in Harrah's Hoosier Park's top class. The latest victory came by a narrow margin Friday (July 7) in the \$22,000 open handicap.

"There's a lot of similarities between the two of them," Miller said when comparing Tellmeaboutit and Rocket Fuel. "They've both been pretty sound and consistent horses. The biggest thing I've had to do with both of them is keep them fresh and ready."

The veteran trainer has done a masterful job on that front. Friday night's score is the 29th of Tellmeaboutit's career, coming in the gelding's 95th trip behind the starting gate. The pacer has hit the board in 79 per cent of his starts, and the latest victory pushed his career bankroll to just over \$850,000.

"We've always known he had talent. I guess my biggest challenge at 2 was to keep the foot on the brakes long enough to keep him good and keep his head on straight," said Miller. "Honestly, the first time I ever trained him with another horse, my son and I were training together. His horse was kind of lazy and he got to hollering at the horse and this little guy liked to climb out of his skin getting away from him. I knew at that point we had something."

There was a time when harness racing was merely a hobby for Miller. His focus was farming 2,500 acres of corn and soybeans while raising thousands of pigs. However, when his stake in agriculture began to contract, it cleared the way for an expansion


into racing. The late Phil Harts and his wife, Twila, were one of the first owners to reach out and inquire about sending horses to the Bunker Hill resident. It was Phil that signed the slip on Rocket Fuel, paying \$10,500 at the 2005 Hoosier Classic sale.

"When we bought Rocket Fuel, Phil didn't want him because he was acting so silly and crazy at the sale," said Miller. "I told Phil, 'If you don't want him, I think I'm going to go ahead and buy him.' Phil responded, 'Well, you're the one that's got to mess with him. If you want to tackle him, I'll go ahead and buy him.' So he did."

The son of Dontgetminmyway didn't make it to the races as a freshman. When he debuted at 3, however, he immediately made an impact. That season, the sophomore won nine times, including his first three starts, and hit the board in 17-of-21 attempts, banking \$133,435. He captured the \$100,000 Indiana Sires Stakes final at Indiana Downs that fall in a time of 1:52. Rocket Fuel went on to add two more ISS finals wins as a 4-year-old and later at age 8.

"Rocket Fuel was push button from the word go," Miller said. "That horse, you could leave 10 weeks in a row with him and then put him to the back the next time and you wouldn't need hand holds to drive him. That's how easy he was. One of the reasons he was such a good horse was because he was so versatile."

Rocket Fuel finished his career with 40 victories over 198 starts, finishing first, second or third nearly 53 percent of the time. He made at least 15 starts in each of his nine seasons, taking seasonal marks of 1:51 or faster in all but two years. The gelding recorded at least one trip to the winner's circle each season, and retired with \$784,006 on his card.

It would be hard to match Rocket Fuel's exploits, but in Tellmeaboutit, Miller and partner Twila Harts have another special horse with personality and grit. Initially, the conditioner picked out the yearling pacer for himself, paying \$25,000, but brought Harts on as co-owner.

"Twila and I, we had a list of some horses we tried to buy," said Miller. "We had our budget set. We even raised it the second day to \$75,000 and still didn't get one that we wanted. Twila was kind of down in the dumps because we just bought another horse or two, but didn't get the one she wanted. I said to her, 'If you want half of him, you can have him.' I made that deal with

her on the way home. I was happy to do that because we've had a lot of success together."

Their success extends beyond the two geldings. Harts and Miller partnered with Ted Comerford on pacing filly Topville Cadillac, who won the Super Final as a freshman in 2015. The two families have collaborated on several horses over the years with good results.

"I tell people that Twila and Phil have been my rabbit's foot, my lucky charm," Miller said. "She and Phil have made great owners because they let you manage the horse. There's not a lot of owners that will let you do that."

Entrusting the trainer to manage Tellmeaboutit has produced some memorable moments. Like Rocket Fuel, this gelding also has three Indiana Sires Stakes finals victories under his belt. After claiming a Super Final at 3, Tellmeaboutit added titles at 4 and again last season as a 6-year-old. At age 5, the gelding came within a neck of winning the 2021 Dan Patch Stakes over his home track. Sent off at 69-1 odds, Mike Oosting and his charge stormed home in :25.2 to fall just shy of Catch The Fire at the wire.

"That was a highlight. The one where he just missed out of the nine hole, that was probably one of the top five thrills I've had in the horse business, and he finished second," Miller said.

On the track, Tellmeaboutit is a fierce competitor. Around the barn he is given the moniker 'Snip' due to his sometimes-challenging disposition.

"This one has a little bit more of an ornery streak in him. He'll bite you if you don't watch him. It's almost like a game to him. He's not being mean, that's just how he plays. And he plays a little rough sometimes," Miller said.

He concedes that the fast miles are beginning to take their toll on his star pacer. Friday night Tellmeaboutit won by a head in a scratch-shortened field of five, pacing in 1:48, a new seasonal mark for the Lavon Miller-bred pacer. One week earlier he collected a 1:49.1 victory, pacing home in :25.3. Miller knows that Tellmeaboutit can turn in a fast mile, but realizes producing these efforts weekly may be a tall order.

"I'm not sure he's quite what he was two years ago. He might have lost a half step. He can still do it on any given night. He's had enough hard miles in him, I don't know that he'll bring it every week like he did," said Miller. "He's still plenty capable. Last week he was extremely sharp, but he felt good all week. He played in the stall a lot and you could just tell he was his old self. Hopefully we'll have a few more of those weeks."

The victory is the third of the season from seven starts. Tellmeaboutit has earned show dough twice in open competition to pair with the wins. Friday's time is one-fifth of a second shy of the gelding's career best, taken last August. The trainer and part-owner is soaking up the experience and enjoying each moment.

"Fifteen years ago, I never thought I'd have one like that. To know you've got one of the few to pace across this track in [1:47.4], it's a great feeling. It just doesn't happen for everybody," Miller said. "The horse has made a lot of good memories along the way. Hopefully he'll make a few more."



Beginning Friday (July 14), Hollywood Casino at The Meadows will offer a multi-leg Pick-4 wager that combines legs from its track along with its sister thoroughbred track, Hollywood Casino at Penn National. Both Pennsylvania-based tracks are owned by PENN Entertainment.

After some research to see logistically what was even possible around the wager, the concept came together through discussions between Scott Lishia and Eric Johnston, respectively the directors of racing at The Meadows and at Penn National. With both tracks offering early evening post times in the summer, there was alignment between the tracks.

One of the main features of the wager is a near bottomlevel takeout. It's something that Lishia hopes can help fuel momentum for the bet.

"We've put a very low takeout on the wager of 12 per cent," said Lishia. "As we all know, horseplayers look for those low takeout opportunities. So, hopefully this will be of interest. We're going to give the wager a run and we'll see what happens. It won't be a one-and-done for sure. We're going to commit at least 4-5 weeks to it and see how it goes."

Multi-leg wagers across different tracks have gained momentum of late. In the thoroughbred industry, "Cross-Country" Pick-5's are offered each weekend consisting of legs from as many as three different tracks, and even combining tracks from other countries. Years ago, harness racing did similar in their Balmoral and Cal Expo Pick-4 which at that time came with a \$25,000 guaranteed pool. Cross-breed wagers, while rare, aren't unprecedented in harness racing. The Meadowlands and Monmouth Park used to offer a Haskell-Hambletonian wager, and more recently in 2021 The Meadowlands and Belmont Park attempted a cross-breed Pick-5.



We've put a very low takeout on the wager of 12 per cent. As we all know, horseplayers look for those low takeout opportunities. So, hopefully this will be of interest. We're going to give the wager a run and we'll see what happens. It won't be a one-and-done for sure. We're going to commit at least 4-5 weeks to it and see how it goes.

For The Meadows and Penn National, there could be some commonality across horseplayers. The tracks are located a couple of hours away from each other and have comparable standing in their industries. I'd say there's a greater likelihood that those who play Penn National would be far more inclined to also make wagers at The Meadows, as opposed to let's say someone who is dedicated to Santa Anita. So, from that perspective, Penn National aligns as a strategic partner in the wager.

Lishia likes the idea of combining different entities together to see how core fan bases react to additional tracks being included and see if there is an overall net benefit.

"It may be a stretch in trying to get your core thoroughbred players to play harness and maybe vice versa, but we're taking a shot to see if maybe we can generate some interest," said Lishia. "It's a way of taking normal, standard wagers out there like the Pick-4 and trying to freshen them up a bit. Maybe it'll be enticing to some people, maybe people will find it interesting, but we won't know for sure until we give it a try. As far as handle, I really don't have a specific handle expectation in mind, but I think if we can show some increase in growth over the first couple of weeks and throughout the summer, that's the trend that we're looking for."

In his role at The Meadows, Lishia has already shown to be unafraid in trying something new, and then re-assessing based on those results.

"For example, when we changed our Pentafecta wager, we realized that having a Jackpot tied to it wasn't working for us," Lishia said. "We weren't really generating big pools with it, and so we took the Jackpot component off it. Now that it has become a more popular bet, we've added a couple more of them, and just this past Wednesday we ended up guaranteeing \$20,000 into the pool. The final pool was nearly \$25,000 which for us, on a single wager, is pretty significant for us.

"Some things work out and some things don't. The post time drag was one of those things we thought we could eliminate and the way it ended up, it became unmanageable, let's say. Because once you set your post times and then somebody else ends up coming on top of you it defeats the purpose. But we do continue to try things."

With full fields expected throughout the wager at both participating tracks, Lishia said he is grateful for the support.

"Part of what is happening is that Penn National will be throwing in a couple of turf races early on which generally have full fields, and we've had a lot of really good support from our horsemen this year with big fields as well," he said. "We max out at nine horses and have had a lot of eight- and nine-horse fields this year, averaging over eight horses a race. So, in addition to the low takeout, we're hoping to have nice, big fields for our two legs of the race, and bettors like that. It's really kudos to all our horsemen, they've really been participating and supporting the entry box."

Of course, the big event that The Meadows is already geared up for is the Adios with the finals coming at the end of this month on July 29.

From The Meadows racing secretary Tom Leasure, currently under consideration for the Adios is North America Cup winner It's My Show, trained by Linda Toscano. Another top contender trained by Toscano, Fulton is also under consideration, as well. As usual, trainers Ron Burke and Tony Alagna have several eligible horses. Trainer Norm Parker also has the Adios on the radar for his 3-year-old A Rocknroll Dance gelding Flite Craft.







Djuse brothers celebrate magic night in Halmstad

Trainer Mattias Djuse and his youngest brother, Magnus, a driver, together celebrated a safe wire-to-wire victory with 4-year-old **Hustle Rain** (Raja Mirchi) in Thursday's (July 6) \$240,000 Sprintermästaren in Halmstad, Sweden.

Three elimination heats over the mile were scheduled on the card during the evening and Stefan Melander's **Following** (Nuncio) claimed the first heat in nice style from the lead with Björn Goop driving.

Hustle Rain was best from position first over in the following race and **Staro Mack Crowe** (Bold Eagle) finished strongly from the far outside to capture the win in the third elimination.

Magnus A Djuse got to pick his post position first for the final and chose #1 behind the gate for Hustle Rain. Magnus was pretty confident that his horse would keep the lead from that post and he was right. Hustle Rain kept the lead and got an eager Staro Mack Crowe on his outside. The pace was set high as the field approached the first kilometer.

It's fair to say that Hustle Rain deserved to win the race, but high grades will be handed out to the runner-up Staro Mack Crowe and even to some of the horses behind the top duo.

An emotional Mattias Djuse noted that Hustle Rain won the Sprintermästaren in 1:52.3 and the Raja Mirchi son will now aim for the Derby in September.



Across the river and into the swamp, Part 2

Part 1 is here.

Del Insko. Buddy Gilmour. William Popfinger. Lucien Fontaine. Herve Filion. John Chapman. George Sholty. Norman Dauplaise. Carmine Abbatiello. Ted Wing. Jimmy Cruise. David Dunkley. Russell Rash. These were some names of horsemen recognized by harness racing bettors in the five boroughs of New York City.

At The Meadowlands, after talking with horseman Ken McNutt as he scored a pacer over the new two-turn mile, Thom Savino and I strolled the length of the apron while looking at other horses scoring. We wanted more horsemen interviews for our report on the New Jersey racetrack, but there were none we could find from across the river. We decided it would not matter; we could always write another article with opinions from the New York-circuit horsemen. This article would introduce fresh faces to The Meadowlands' potential Metropolitan audience.

Leaning over the apron fence, we waved our arms and press passes to get the attention of drivers scoring horses down the stretch. Thom got the first response and called me over as the driver eased his horse to a halt and passed it on to an assistant.

"We'll have to be honest," I said to Thom.

"Yeah, we don't know him but maybe we can make like we do?" "All right," I said.

He was a young fellow and he appeared to welcome the press. He approached us while taking his gloves off and immediately solved our identity problem saying, "Hi, I'm Mike Gagliardi."

The identity problem solved, we were left with the void-of-information problem because knowing his name was no clue to New York harness fans; 99 per cent of whom had no familiarity with standardbred racing in the rest of the United States, no less in Europe, Scandinavia or Russia. How were we to know Gagliardi was a super horseman who the next year would drive Bret's Star to victory in the 1977 Little Brown Jug ("The what-colored jug?" said every New York harness bettor). Gagliardi would train horses earning \$1 million or more while winning 2,330 races accounting for \$17 million in his brief ill-fated career.

I said, "Are you new to this area?"

"No, I was born and raised not very far from this racetrack," Gagliardi said.

"For New York fans not acquainted with you on the harness scene," Thom said, "where did you race before The Meadowlands?"

"I started as a professional driver at Freehold Raceway. I started amateur racing at Johnson Park in New Brunswick and worked around the fairs in New Jersey. My first full-fledged meet with a public stable was at Freehold."

It sounded like a smooth transition from amateur to The Meadowlands, but Gagliardi made sure it was not a guick move.

He said, "Ten years ago I was at Freehold, so it took a long time getting here. I raced all through New England [which included Foxboro Raceway, closed by bankruptcy in 1986] and probably every small track in the country. When The Meadowlands opened, I had horses that were competitive to race at this particular meet, so I wanted to be here."

"Most of the other tracks you raced were half milers?"

"Yes. But I never drove at Yonkers or Roosevelt. Just at Monticello."

"And what about two-turn racing?

"The mile is not a whole lot different," Gagliardi said. "You change styles a little bit, like trying not to be too aggressive too early in the mile. Other than that, it's the same thing; the best horse wins the race. But, look, every other racetrack in the country is second class compared to The Meadowlands. It's in a class of its own. Once you race here you don't want to race anywhere else. I came and I've done fairly well."

"Can you tell our readers," Thom said, "if there is one thing you dislike about this colossal place?"

Gagliardi paused for a moment and then said, "When we first started here, anything at all we felt was not to our liking we told them about it and they made it to our liking. So, there's nothing I can think of that I don't like here. That's an honest answer. It's not because I'm here and want to impress anybody."

Gagliardi's comments and all of the testimonies we recorded went unpublished because the publication shut down shortly after we submitted our piece. Thom would eventually refer to it as, "Brooklyn Today, the newspaper that would not see tomorrow."

Our positive impression of Gagliardi was true. He became the leading harness trainer at The Meadowlands three times from 1981 to 1986. He drove in his last race on May 1,1996, retiring due to severe illness. He died at his New Jersey home. He was 48.

It would take decades until my fascination with the New Jersey track found me professionally facing the man whose business constructed the foundations for The Meadowlands.

Righteous Resolve makes statement in seasonal and OSS debut

Star filly **Righteous Resolve** made her seasonal debut Thursday (July 6) at Woodbine Mohawk Park in the second of two \$103,100 Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Gold divisions for 3-year-old trotting fillies with an impressive off the pace score.

When the wings rolled in race 8 the trio of Stonebridge Bravo, Mass Hysteria and Believe You Me took turns up front early, leading the field through opening fractions of :26.4 and :55.3 while James MacDonald settled Righteous Resolve back in fifth.

Doug McNair moved Baroness Hill to the front through three quarters, but Righteous Resolve proved too strong, finding cover in the third panel and trotting home in :28 to win by a head in 1:53.

"James is a pro. He knows how to campaign the horse and take care of them if you can," said trainer Matt Bax. "There were hot fractions early and he was smart enough to take it easy. He's maybe got some ice water in his veins where he can sit chilly back there, I was sweating though."

Righteous Resolve was ready to go earlier in the season, but a combination of wildfire smoke related postponements of both OSS Gold legs and a sickness meant this was her first parimutuel start since the Breeders Crown last fall.

"That's just the way it worked out," said Bax. "But I think she is going to be better for it. It meant she had a lot of time to get

better after the sickness and train up. It worked out tonight."

The Resolve filly's OSS record improves to 5-1-0 in six starts, including a victory in last year's Super Final.

Her overall mark is 9-1-1 in 11 career starts with over \$675,000 on her card for owners Bet Max Stables Inc. and Benenati Inc. Her win paid \$2.50.

Baroness Hill continues her strong season with the runner-up finish. Chantal Mitchell trains the Kadabra filly for owner Tom Hill. She now has a record of 3-1-0 from seven starts in 2023.

Stonebridge Brave finished third for trainer Dagfin Henriksen who was also behind the horse. It's her second career on the board finish in the OSS for owner Alan Janik.

Race 8 replay.

The first OSS division was in race 3 and trainer/driver Paul MacDonell piloted **Muscling Vegas** to her third win of the season and first career OSS victory.

MacDonnell and the daughter of Muscle Mass left well from post 6, beating Wedding Dancer and Enola to the early lead and trotting fractions of :27.2, :56.2, and 1:24.3, en route to a new lifetime mark of 1:53.1.

"She can make a driver look pretty good," said MacDonnell. "She's push button at all times. She's so smart, and she's just a pleasure to have in the barn."

Lightly raced as a 2-year-old after developing some soreness, Muscling Vegas has come back strong as a sophomore.

She won the SBOA Final earlier this year, and was a runner-up to Baroness Hill in a Gold division on June 16. Her overall mark on the season is 2-4-1 with \$176,440 on her card and over \$75,000 in the OSS for owners Chris and Michael Storms.

"Her honesty is going to take her so far," said MacDonnell. "She wants to trot. She wants to give you what she has every night, and you can't ask for anymore in a racehorse than that."

Muscling Vegas paid \$6.90 for the win.

Doug McNair and Wedding Dancer chased Muscling Vegas around the track from second the entire way around and finished three lengths back when the wire came.


The Tony Alagna trainee is a J L Benson Stables Inc. homebred, and it was the biggest score to date for the Muscle Mass filly who doubled her career earnings to \$49,400 in her OSS debut.

Rounding out the podium was Enola who continues to improve for trainer Keith Jones. A Grassroots horse as a sophomore, the Resolve filly has stepped up to the Gold level in her sophomore season and has finished second and third through two Gold legs.

Cannibal, Confederate take Meadowlands Pace elims; Confederate morning-line favorite for final

Cannibal and **Confederate** won Saturday's (July 8) \$50,000 Meadowlands Pace eliminations for 3-year-old pacers at The Meadowlands and will start the \$668,000 final on July 15 from posts four and five, respectively.

Following the draw, Confederate, who won the faster of the two elims, stopping the clock in 1:47.3, was established as the 6-5 morning-line favorite for the final. Cannibal was made the 4-1 third choice behind Voukefalas, who finished second to Cannibal, at 7-2.

Both elimination winners are owned by Diamond Creek Racing and were bred by Diamond Creek Farm.

Confederate won his elimination by a half-length over El Rey. Christchurch was third and followed across the finish line by Ammo and Stockade Seelster. However, Stockade Seelster went off stride coming out of the last turn and in the stretch and was placed eighth for violating the breaking rule and interference. Save America was sixth-placed-fifth to get the last spot in the final.

In that second elim, Christchurch took the field to the opening quarter in :25.4 and half-mile point in :52.1 as he battled with longshot Lyons Surfing to maintain the lead. Christchurch was still on top as he reached three-quarters in 1:20.1 but Confederate, who was fourth for much of the way, moved three-wide on the last turn and burst down the stretch for the win.

Tim Tetrick drove Confederate, the 1-5 favorite, for trainer Brett Pelling.

"He's got high speed, he can follow speed, speed is his thing," Pelling said about Confederate. "He loves to go quick. Timmy thinks he's okay either way (from in front or off the pace). He's raced him a lot more than what I have. But his best runs that I've seen have been coming off a helmet."

Added Tetrick, "He chased big speed and when it was time to go, he got the job done."

Confederate, who was second by a head in last month's million-dollar Pepsi North America Cup, has won three of four races this season.

"He's been perfect," Tetrick said. "He's very consistent. He's just a good drive away from everybody being happy."

A son of Sweet Lou—Geothermal, Confederate has won eight of 11 lifetime starts and earned \$665,950.

He paid \$2.40 to win.

Cannibal, who was fifth at the half-mile point in the first elimination, rallied off a second-over trip behind favorite Voukefalas to win by a half-length in 1:48.1 for driver Scott Zeron and trainer Nancy Takter. Voukefalas finished second, followed by Its A Me Mario, Hungry Angel Boy and Fulton to reach next week's final.

Bamboozler held the lead as the field reached the opening quarter in :26. Fulton went to the front on the backstretch, hitting the half in :53, then faced first-over pressure from Voukefalas on the last turn as they got to three-quarters in 1:21.2. Voukefalas, the 4-5 choice, took the lead in the stretch but was unable to hold off Cannibal.

"I lit up when I realized they were going too fast for (Voukefalas) to make a power move and he would eventually be the first-up horse, and I would be in a position that I wanted to be," Zeron said. "Whether or not I had the horse to do it, we were going to find out.

"I didn't really have to do any of the heavy lifting throughout the mile. At the point of coming out of the last turn is when I realized that mine was feeling as good as the rest of them looked."

With the victory, Cannibal improved to 4-for-4 this year. Two of those previous wins came in the Pennsylvania Stallion Series

in May and the other was against older horses in a conditioned race on June 24.

"I think that was the management he was under; they wanted to keep him brave, keep him confident racing against the cheaper division horses," Zeron said. "So far, it's worked. He couldn't have been any more confident than he was today."

Cannibal, a son of Sweet Lou—No More Losses, has won seven of 12 career races and earned \$175,798.

Sent off at odds of 9-1, Cannibal paid \$20 to win.

Jiggy Jog S trounces male foes in Graduate Trot final

Jiggy Jog S, the magnificent 4-year-old Walner—Hot Mess Hanover mare driven by Dexter Dunn, made one sweeping move on her seven male trotting foes to get the lead and then drew off to punctuate her dominance and win the \$230,000 Graduate Series Trot final on Saturday (July 8) at The Meadowlands.

When the field left the gate, Keg Stand and Iwon't Backdown As got going best as Pretender broke stride, with Looks Like Moni next and Jiggy Jog S from post 1 staying close at the inside. Going into the :27 first quarter, Looks Like Moni stayed out of further trouble as Iwon't Backdown As broke stride.

Dunn steered Jiggy Jog S out of any other problem that might arise from her foes and easily strode to an outside path and took the lead just before the :55.4 half. Slay took the overland route with a charge to challenge, but Jiggy Jog S was through with any hijinks and went into overdrive through three-quarters of

1:23.4. She drew away from all the early starters and breakers and put two, and then three, and then five lengths between her and the five horses left trotting for minor prizes. Jiggy Jog S clocked the mile in 1:50.3, winning by 4-1/4 lengths. Looks Like Moni held the second spot at the wire and Cool Papa Bell was all out to get third over Pappardelle.

Jiggy Jog S equaled her seasonal best time while winning her eighth straight and staying unbeaten from four starts this year.

"She makes me look good, that's for sure; the way she's doing it," said Dexter Dunn. "I couldn't be more happy with the way she's come back this year. Obviously [she] had an outstanding year [at 3] but she's just gotten stronger. She's smartened up; she matured.

Dunn said he loves that he can do whatever he wants driving her, like in this race. "We just let the dust settle there [in the] first turn, moved her and it was all her after that.

"We probably didn't race her as much on the front last year. We came from behind a lot of the time. She knows what she's doing now. Put her on the front and both her ears go up, fully pricked, and she's just as happy as anything [leading]. I'm extremely lucky. It's always an extra pleasure to sit behind horses like her."

Ake Svanstedt trains Jiggy Jog S. Jorgen Sparredal Inc. owns the mare that has now earned \$1,369,438.

A prohibitive favorite (there was no show betting), Jiggy Jog S paid \$2.20 to win.

Stonebridge Helios holds; Dunn, Svanstedt sweep Graduate finals

One race after Jiggy Jog S strolled to victory in the final for the Graduate Series Trot, the tandem of driver Dexter Dunn and trainer Ake Svanstedt united on another odds-on promise in **Stonebridge Helios** and secured the spoils in the \$240,000 Graduate Series Pace — for pacing 4-year-olds — on Saturday night (July 8) at The Meadowlands.

Dunn floated Stonebridge Helios forward in a first-turn skirmish led by I Did It Myway to a :26 first quarter. Dreamfair Arnie B edged off the pylons to the backstretch sweeping to the lead before Stonebridge Helios seized control just before a :53.4 half. Mad Max Hanover, the 3-1 second choice, followed the flow but then raced uncovered and pressed Stonebridge Helios to the final turn.

Mad Max Hanover only challenged briefly, and then he began backtracking midway through the final turn. Stonebridge Helios meanwhile attempted to scoot clear through three-quarters in 1:21.2, but grew leg weary in the last eighth. Dunn held the 4-year-old stallion by Sunshine Beach—Ken Doll J together through the lane as he strolled three-quarters of a length in front at the finish of a 1:48.1 mile. Dreamfair Arnie B vacated the pocket and held second from a headstrong Trendy Teen charging for third with I Did It Myway back in fourth.

"I wanted to try and get him on the front: he was so good winning in [1:]47 on the front," Dunn said. "I had Timmy [Tetrick and Mad Max Hanover] inside of me that can go out with fast speed, too. But once we got out of the gate quicker than him, the plan was to keep going forward, get him on the front and get him churning on the bit. It worked out.

"Coming off the last turn, he was travelling pretty good, but I could still hear horses on my back. Toddy [McCarthy and Dreamfair Arnie B] was still travelling pretty good behind me. I just let him roll. He's a big strong boy and he fought on really good."

Svanstedt trains Stonebridge Helios, who moved into their barn at the start of his 4-year-old season. He competes for owners John Fleischman and breeder Angie Stiller, and has now won 12 times from 21 outings while accruing \$583,605 in earnings. He paid \$3.40 to win.

Newsroom schools foes in Big M's Kindergarten

One week after a dazzling parimutuel debut, **Newsroom** came back to stay perfect in two seasonal starts taking one of nine \$20,000 divisions of the first leg of the Kindergarten Series for 2-year-olds at The Meadowlands Friday night (July 7).

Newsroom, who won a Tompkins-Geers split last week, went after early leader Swifty Lazar at the quarter, took the lead away from that one shortly thereafter, and went down the road from there for trainer Joe Holloway in the first of two divisions for colt and gelding pacers.

The 2-5 favorite, a son of Always B Miki—Well Hello There, paid \$2.80 after stopping the clock in 1:51, a national season's best

for freshmen on the pace. It was 2¾ lengths back to secondplace finisher Swifty Lazar.

"He's a pretty nice horse," said winning driver Dave Miller. "I figured we'd go ahead and let him roll along [on the lead]. He gets like two weeks off now. He's coming along just the way you want him too. I'm real excited about him. He's a big, strong horse who doesn't seem to get tired."

Another impressive performance on the card was supplied by 6-5 favorite **Tandem Hanover** (Walner—Think Twice), who won the first of three filly trots in 1:54.2 in her parimutuel debut for trainer Andrew Harris.

The \$510,000 Harrisburg purchase led at every call, and used a :27.1 final quarter to defeat Prominence (who was later disqualified and placed sixth) by three lengths. Tandem Hanover paid \$4.40 to win.

"The owners [William Pollock, Bruce Areman and Andrew Harris Racing] put some money up and it seems like they have a pretty special filly," said winning driver Andy McCarthy. "She's pretty professional about everything. I put her on the front at [Harrah's Philadelphia] in her first start. Then we raced her off the pace in last, but tonight, I figured we'd see what she's made of."

LEARNING CURVE: The winners of the three colt and gelding trots were **Classic Landing** (Tactical Landing—Classical Annie) for driver Yannick Gingras and trainer Ron Burke in 1:54.4 as the 7-5 second choice; **Robinhood** (Walner—Confession Session) for Niko Karna and Noel Daley in 1:55 at odds of 105-1, by far the longest shot on the board; and **Bargain** (Chapter Seven—Batoutahill) for McCarthy and Nancy Takter in 1:56.4 as the 8-5 second choice.

The other two filly trots were taken by **Cheval Rapide** (Father Patrick—Shake It Cerry) for Gingras and Takter in 1:56.3 as the 4-5 favorite and **Internationalmodel** (International Moni—Flying Glider) for Scott Zeron and Domenico Cecere in 1:56.3 as the 3-2 public choice.

On the pacing side, **Captain Albano** (Captaintreacherous—Angelou) won the other male pace for Todd McCarthy and Daley in 1:53.1 as the 1-2 chalk while **Miraculous Deo** (Stay Hungry—Worldly Beauty) was victorious in the lone filly pace as Todd McCarthy and Daley struck again, this time as 29-1 outsiders.

A LITTLE MORE: Daley had a big night, training three winners on the program while Takter had a pair. Miller, Andy McCarthy, Todd McCarthy and Gingras all drove a pair to victory lane. Gabe Prewitt was up to his usual tricks, hitting the Early Pick-4 to the tune of \$1,690 to take Night 11 of the track's "Battle of The Meadowlands Masterminds" handicapping contest. Allsource handle totaled \$2,517,297 on the 14-race program.

Nine wins is fine for Alagna

Breakfast With The Babies sponsored by Jules Siegel's Fashion Farms went a day early this week, due to stakes scheduled on Saturday (July 8). An overcast, muggy setting was the weather to begin, temperatures hovering near 80 degrees with a mild helping wind in the stretch.

The talent on display this morning was remarkable, heavy with progeny of and siblings to the stars of the sport carrying very high price tags.

Tony Alagna operates at that level, his entrants on today's card numbered 35, the cost at auction slightly north of \$4 million. That number does not take into consideration the considerable value of the homebred stock. Alagna started his freshman crop a bit later this season but when they come, they come to play. Today's tally was nine winners and endless high hopes.

The Alagna trained Muscle Hill colt **Bright Star** was the barn's first winner of the day, going pillar to post for Dexter Dunn in the second race. They clicked along on a :30 beat until the stretch, where Bright Star responded when asked to the tune of a :28.1 end to the 1:58.2 mile. Coors Hanover (Ake Svanstedt) and Diplomacy (Scott Zeron) closed well into the final split to be second and third, respectively. The winner is Brittany bred and the breeder retained an interest, along with Pryde Stable, Caviart Farms and Plouffe & Riverview, in this \$150,000 (LEX) yearling purchase.

Alagna struck again in the third with **Winter Soldier** (Andy McCarthy) who sat off the hot fractions of :57.1 and 1:26.3 posted by stablemate Mars Hill (Todd McCarthy) then rallied well between rivals for the impressive 1:55.4 win, trotting his final quarter in :27.4. Cragieburn (Yannick Gingras) also closed it up nicely to be second. Winter Soldier was winning for the second time in as many outings. The son of the French sire Face Time Bourbon was a \$140,000 (LEX) purchase by Peter Alagna and Robbie Pryde as Pryde Stables, INC. Order By stable is the breeder.

Special Talent (Dunn), the Walner full sister to Special Way, was Alagna's third trotting winner on the day, using an impressive brush to zip by the field from fifth and last on the final turn then continue on to a clear 2:00.4 win with a :28.1 final quarter while in hand. Hilljorda (Trond Smedshammer) closed nicely to be second. The winner is Brittany bred and went through the ring for \$250,000 (LEX) with Robert LeBlanc, Grant & Pryde Stable, Caviart and Coyote Wynd Farms the successful bidders.

Andy McCarthy drove the Brittany Farms homebred Walner filly **Local Honey** to a wire to wire 1:59 score in her first outing for trainer Alagna. Crisp off the gate, Local Honey cruised along comfortably through a 1:30.4 three panels before kicking home in :28.1 to hold off Treatyofversailles (Domenico Cecere) and a quickly closing She Shaq (Svanstedt).

Sadbirdstillsing (T. McCarthy) rung up another win for the Alagna armada when she went all the way and finished the 1:57.3 mile with a :28 flat final quarter under no urging by the driver. Bohemian Hanover (Dunn) rallied bravely for second with Minnelli (Andy Miller) third. Crawford Farms bred and retained part ownership of the Chapter Seven filly with Pryde Stables, INC. after she went through the Lexington sale for \$190,000.

Pacing colt **Captain Luke** (Dunn) took over before the half when a rival went off stride, continued along at an easy rate then took off through a :26.1 end to a 1:53.3 mile over stablemate Hungry To Win (A. McCarthy) continuing the Alagna assault on the day. The son of Captaintreacherous was a \$135,00 Lexington buy for Robert LeBlanc, Pryde Stables, Brad Grant and Steve Head from breeder Vieux Carre Farm.

Alagna's seventh of the day came with a colt that he (along with Marvin Katz) bred, by the first crop sire Bettor's Wish, **Better Is Nice** (A. McCarthy) who inherited the lead before the :59 half and held sway through a :26.3 end to the 1:53.4 mile over stablemate Rock The Captain N (Anibal Borjas). The winner went through the ring for \$30,000 (LEX) and is now owned by Alagna Racing, Pryde Stables and Birnam Wood Farms.

Caviart Dawn (Dunn) made Alagna's eighth win an adventure, drifting out while on the lead near the :59 half, thus surrendering the lead, settling in second around the second turn them re-rallying in through the :27.4 final quarter to get by stablemate Heart Of Love N (Borjas) then holding off another barn mate in Odds On Steno for the 1:55.1 win in a photo. The winner is a Sweet Lou filly, a Caviart Farm homebred.

The last 2-year-old race on the card saw Alagna get his ninth and Dunn his seventh win when **Run The World Deo** cut the mile and held on by an inch over stablemates Gifted One and Bree Hanover in 1:55.2, home in 27.1. Pryde Stable, Brad Grant, Pete Alagna and Caviart Farms share ownership of the Stay Hungry colt who was purchased at Harrisburg for \$80,000 from breeder Deo Volente Farms and Fidencio Cervantez.

Trotting colts kicked off the day with **Skydiver**, a Greenshoe colt from Ariana G, sweeping by the field in the stretch for Dunn to win in 1:59.4 while trotting a :27.2 final quarter to get the job done over another Greenshoe colt, Oh Brother (A. McCarthy) who was also trotting well late. The winner was a \$350,000 Lexington Select Sale (LEX) yearling now owned in part by breeder Marvin Katz with Bud & Kelly Hatfield and Brixton Medical and is trained in the Marcus Melander barn. Al Libfeld gets a co-breeder credit on this sharp colt.

A princely pair of Chapter Seven colts dueled through the length of the stretch and a :27.4 final quarter with **Wild Ticket** (Brian Sears) refusing to be denied and just edging by mile cutter Fly By (Scott Zeron), who dug in gamely, at the end of the 1:57.2 mile.

The winner is another Melander trainee, bred by Al Libfeld and purchased for \$200,000 (LEX) by AMG Stable, Kenneth Kjellgren, Heights Stable & Mantorp Stable.

Chaparmbro came to trainer/driver Trond Smedshammer for the princely sum of \$250,000 from the Harrisburg sale, a higher than usual price for Smedshammer to pay for longtime owner Wanda Polisseni as Purple Haze Stables along with partner M3 Racing. Clearly, Smedshammer saw something in the half-sister to Dejarmbro, the major stakes winner that Smedshammer trained to a million-dollar winning career for Polisseni a decade or more ago, as the Chapter Seven filly won powerfully this morning over a good field in 1:58.4. Chaparmbro and Smedshammer stalked behind the 30 second beat through the three quarters and when tipped out responded with a :28.2 finish to hold off the close of a pair of Alagna fillies in Whoops Hanover (Dunn) and Harley Quinn (A. McCarthy). Fair Winds Farm bred the winner.

Ake Svanstedt drove **Situationship** to a 1:58.2 / :27.1 win for Knuttson Trotting, Little E, LLC, and Tomas Anderson in the eighth. Svanstedt sat along mid pack through the usual fractions then threaded the Chapter Seven colt through as rivals were scattered across the track through the drive to get the win. Caballero (Smedshammer) also split horses with good late foot for second and Alamo Mission (Dunn) rallied nicely from last to be third. Situationship was bred by Crawford Farms and brought \$85,000 at Lexington.

Bee Our Money (Patrick Ryder) led early, yielded then reemerged from the pocket in the stretch to win in a very civilized 2:01.3 / :28.3. Big Ben Pellini S (Zeron) cut the middle fractions and gave way grudgingly late while Loxahatchee (Brian Sears) the Greenshoe first foal of Hannelore Hanover had trot late for third. Chris Ryder trains the winner and owns in partnership with Bill Ezzo, Carl Sackheim and J&T Silva. The cost was \$150,000 (LEX) from breeder Lindy Farms.

Ryder combined with Dunn to get his second and Dunn's fifth winner of the day with **Gem Quality**, a Captain Crunch first cropper, who went eyeball to eyeball with Remember The Alamo (A. McCarthy) through a :26 flat end to a 1:53.3 mile, neither colt giving an inch until the final strides where Gem Quality took the win. The winner is a Let It Ride and Bottom Line homebred with Brad Grant and Enviro Stables joining in as owners.

Trainer Ron Burke and driver David Miller combined to win the first of the day's pacing races with the Lazarus filly **Mary Of Bethany**. She sat a pocket as Well Aware set easy fractions, slipped through in the stretch to get the lead and hold off a three-pronged Alagna assault led by Reachingforthemoon (A. McCarthy) through a :27.4 end to the 1:55.4 mile. Mary Of Bethany was a \$50,000 Harrisburg buy for Tom and Scott Dillion from breeder Peninsula Farm.
