A DQ and a dazzler included in Pace night reactions

BETWEEN THE LINES

For the second time in four years, the Meadowlands Pace resulted in the disqualification of the horse first past the wire, and that's what the night will be remembered most for, although the night was full of other memorable performances, including a new world record.

There's not a need for full throttled weigh-in after many others have already expressed their views on various social media, and most readers of this column will already know where I stand. In summary, just as I would have done with What The Hill in the 2017 Hambletonian and with Charlie May in the 2021 Pace, I would have let the original results stand as is with Prince Hal Hanover, the winner. In a poll taken on X by user @polarcritter with 58 votes to date, 57 per cent agreed with the disqualification, 26 per cent did not, and 17 per cent didn't have an opinion.

It's the minority view, but simply stated, I didn't feel the alleged interference from Prince Hal Hanover was as egregious as some have made it out to be. That said, I'm more indifferent about this disqualification than the prior two mentioned because in this case it's entirely possible that without confusion around being impeded, **Madden Oaks** could have very well crossed the line first. In those other instances, horses were placed first as indirect beneficiaries.

An interesting vantage point comes directly from driver Boyd's line of sight where just as it was in the North America Cup, his Pace drive with Madden Oaks was captured through a driver-cam set up by industry photographer Jessica Hallett. As opposed to the distant head-on view used by judges, the Hallett video puts the viewer directly in the seat of Boyd.

In this example, I don't think it would lead to a different conclusion than what the head-on provided, but it does raise the question, why not make driver cameras mandatory, where they can be used as an additional view that judges can utilize while making decisions? There's no better way to see in those split seconds what drivers encounter, how much room they have, and how they react. I would be all for such an innovation.

The performance of the night goes unquestionably to Elista Hanover. I referenced on Friday the absolute remarkable trip she went last out in the Graduate which really was one for the ages, and she may have even topped that in Saturday's E.T. Gerry, Jr. Hambletonian Maturity. Evidently, I wasn't the only one who took notice of her prior race, as she was bet down from a programmed line of 5-1 all the way to 7-5, and in a field of 13 no less!

Seemingly lost in the disqualification is that Madden Oaks somehow went off at odds nearing 7-1. He was rated 5-2 on the morning line which I referred to in [last Friday's column](#) as "deserved," and in that same column wondered if the morning-line favoritism would hold to post time favoritism between he and more well-known connections. But nowhere in my wildest imagination did I think Madden Oaks would drift up to a win mutuel of \$15.20. That he was the fifth wagering choice in a field of nine ahead of only the horses without a realistic chance does go to show that the smart money isn't always right, although credit to Prince Hal Hanover who was raced as a valiant favorite. Handle for the 14-race Pace card was \$5.1 million on the nose, comparable to last year's Pace card which handled a little over \$5.1 million with the same number of races.

The performance of the night goes unquestionably to **Elista Hanover**. I referenced on Friday the absolute remarkable trip she went last out in the Graduate which really was one for the ages, and she may have even topped that in Saturday's E.T. Gerry, Jr. Hambletonian Maturity. Evidently, I wasn't the only one who took notice of her prior race, as she was bet down from a programmed line of 5-1 all the way to 7-5, and in a field of 13 no less!

In the race, she took a long time to make the lead through a (straightaway-aided) opening quarter of :25.1, yielded to Private Access, was on the move again with a retake through :54.1, took pressure from another Blais trainee in Drawn Impression, kept on rolling through a mile rate that went in 1:49.3 and finished off the mile and an eighth race in a time of 2:03 flat. For perspective, the stakes record was 2:04.1 set in 2015 by JL Cruze and in 2022 by Bella Bellini. More often than not, as was the case last year, the race goes in over 2:05.

Elista Hanover first and Warrawee Michelle second reversed the top 2 order of finish from the prior week in the Graduate. But this time, rather than being 15-1 and 13-1 longshots, they completed the exacta as the 7-5 favorite and 3-1 third choice. The odds certainly had this raced pegged despite the 13-horse field size.

Trained by Annie Stoebe, Elista Hanover wasn't the only notable this weekend from the barn. Stoebe also sent out a 2-year-old winner on Friday named **Diabolic Hill** in 1:54.4, who has

now started his career impressively at two-for-two and has me wondering if it's too early to start thinking about Hambletonian 2026. He was a \$300,000 yearling from Lexington last year whose second dam produced 2-year-old champion Crys Dream.

Onto this year's Hambletonian contenders, the two Stanley Dancer Memorial divisions from Saturday went mainly to form and perhaps the most intriguing question right now will be which horse does Dexter Dunn ultimately drive in two weeks – **Super Chapter** or Maryland?

race, Dunn opted for last year's divisional champion Maryland over Super Chapter. The amazing thing is what was the case then and is still the case now, Super Chapter hasn't lost yet this year and Maryland hasn't won. But obviously that doesn't tell the full story.

I still get the sense that Super Chapter has been in tactically better race spots than Maryland, save for the Dancer when Maryland was placed up front and wouldn't give up in a stretch long duel with the horse whom I proclaimed last week as my favorite, **Go Dog Go**. Both Maryland and Super Chapter are in the Melander barn, so Dunn's decision truly will come down to the horse without having to consider who the trainer is.

On the trotting filly side, **Yo Tillie** kept her perfect seasonal streak intact while hammered all the way down to 1-9 and jogged in 1:51 flat as the only one in her Del Miller Memorial division that's not Hambletonian Oaks eligible, much to the pleasure of all the others that are. In the other Del Miller, **What A Bid Hanover** re-established herself as perhaps the Oaks favorite when wearing down a stubborn R Dutchess.

There were surprises in both splits of the William Haughton Memorial. **Oakwood Ardan IR** and **Maximus Miki** both won Meadowlands open's two weeks apart in June, and on Saturday paid \$67.80 and \$31.20, respectively. In the Maximus Miki win at 14-1, the second, third and fourth finishers were odds of 99-1, 27-1 and 23-1. The \$1 trifecta paid \$16k, but the \$1 superfecta would have only paid \$24k (it was \$2,400 for a dime). It goes to show how much these 10-cent wagers can dilute the payoffs, where it's hard to imagine there were approximately 15 separate 10-cent winning tickets with horses of those odds in an 11-horse field.

Pace Night recap and more

With the 49th edition of the Meadowlands Pace in the books, here's a look at some interesting facts from that night.

1. For the 10th time, a Meadowlands Pace winner was sired by a Meadowlands Pace winner: Nihilator (1985) by Niatross (1980), Mach Three (2002) by Matts Scooter (1988), the trio of Bettors Delight (2001), Holborn Hanover (2004), and Roll With Joe (2011) all by Cams Card Shark (1994), Tall Dark Stranger (2020) by Bettors Delight (2001), A Rocknroll Dance (2012) by Rocknroll Hanover (2005), Control The Moment (2016) by Well Said (2009), and both winners in the past two seasons Legendary Hanover (2024) and Madden Oaks by Huntsville (2017).

2. Yo Tillie dominated again to remain perfect at three-for-three, but she's not Hambletonian eligible. The Hambletonian Oaks debuted in 1971. Every 3YOFT who has competed since then and been named HOY has raced in either the Hambletonian or the Oaks.

3. Captaintreacherous had three in the Pace and all three cashed: Prince Hal Hanover (placed second), Fallout (fourth), and Captain Optimistic (fifth). His sire Somebeachsomewhere had eight of nine finalists by either a son or a grandson of his.

4. Cameron Capone at 26 is the second youngest Pace winning trainer. Blair Burgess was the youngest from 1987 with Frugal Gourmet at 25 years 10 months. The youngest trainer ever to compete in the Pace, was Marc Fontaine (20) with Forrest Skipper in 1985 who never threatened in the Nihilator year.

5. Yannick Gingras ended the evening at \$249.8 million just \$127G from becoming the sport's fourth \$250 million driver.

6. Dave Miller was third with Papis Pistol in the 30th anniversary year for him in the Pace. He finished fifth with Cinder Lane Sam (1995) in his debut. At 60, he was vying to become the oldest Pace-winning driver. The two youngest Pace drivers – Braxten Boyd (25) and Todd McCarthy (32) – went 1-2, with a combined age of just 57.

7. Dexter Dunn and Scott Zeron, winners of the past six Driver of the Year awards, are both still searching for that elusive Pace victory.

8. Only two drivers have won the Meadowlands Pace as the active \$\$ leader in the sport at the time. Billy Haughton in 1978 with Falcon Almahurst and John Campbell starting in 1989 with Dexter Nukes. Dave Miller will try again next year, possibly as the all-time leader just \$5.5 million away at the conclusion of Pace night.

9. Twin B Joe Fresh is right back in the winner's circle after her decisive Dorothy Haughton score. She is a candidate to do what only Adios Butler has accomplished prior, which is be named Horse of the Year at ages 4 and 5. He did it in 1960 and 1961. At \$2,588,657 lifetime, she's got some luminaries coming up in her path, Loyal Opposition (\$2,640,935), Bunny Lake (\$2,843,476), Burning Point (\$2,853,289), and Darlins Delight (\$2,901,926).

10. Speaking of defending HOY Twin B Joe Fresh, she is the sixth pacing female to be so honored. All five raced the following year and combined got zero HOY votes in their follow up seasons.

ETCETERA

- Ron Burke is at \$355.7 million career; the next three trainers combined are at \$335 million.
- July 15, 2025 marks the 10th anniversary of the first sub 1:50 trotting mile in Meadowlands history: JL Cruze (1:49.4). John Campbell drove the 4YO for trainer Eric Ell. He's still at it too now at 14.
- Dunn set the record in 2024 for Breeders Crowns with six and divisional champions with eight. Can he continue on this path? In the Triple Crowns, he's already won the Yonkers Trot and Messenger and is all but certain to have the Hambletonian favorite.

• July 15 marked 39 years since we lost Billy Haughton at 62 from a racing accident 10 days before at Yonkers. At that time, he was fourth in wins lifetime and third in earnings all time.

• Braxten Boyd is not the only 25-year-old driver to debut in and win the Meadowlands Pace. Tim Tetrick did the same in 2007 with Southwind Lynx.

• Finally, here are some Meadowlands Pace Night fact for the ages. 48 years ago, on the very same July 12, the first Meadowlands Pace was held, won by Escort. After the first two elims were held the only trot of the night was contested and was won by 22-year-old Charlie Connor, Jr. driving Hurricane Star.

"I was driving at Scarborough in Maine and a judge there told me it was time to get my "A" license," he said. "On Pace Night, I had only had it a couple months. Hurricane Star was a real good one. I have win pictures of him beating Savoir and Mickey Rodney."

Connor, Jr. is the only driver still active from that entire initial Meadowlands Pace card in 1977.

"I need 29 more for 2,000 wins," he said. "I guess until I get there [I'll keep driving]."

Leap To Fame could become Down Under's all-time richest pacer on Saturday

A second Inter Dominion title would push him to the top past Blacks A Fake.

The Inter Dominion has always been a story-making race.

Since the iconic event – the biggest and most famous Down Under – was run for the first time in 1936, it has been littered with champion performances, epic contests and wonderful narratives.

Another two, albeit very different chapters will play out at Brisbane's Albion Park on Saturday night (July 19) with the \$1 million pacing final and \$500,000 trotting finals.

The build-up and promotion of this series was always going to be about hometown hero Leap To Fame.

Even the doubters would now struggle to dispute that he is one of, maybe the greatest pacers we have seen Down Under.

Victory will be his second Inter Dominion title, but the \$540,000 first prize will make him the all-time richest pacer Down Under.

Leap To Fame will move to \$4,630,884 and surpass another former great Queensland pacer and four-time Inter Dominion winner, Blacks A Fake (\$4,575,438).

Yes, Blacks A Fake raced almost 20 years ago, but the sad and important reality for Leap To Fame's bankroll is that prize money hasn't gone up in Australasia's major races over that time.

While Leap To Fame's first Inter Dominion, also at Albion Park in December, 2023, was a contest before and during the series, this has been a procession.

And one that most expect will continue into Saturday night's final despite the one barrier draw (post position) that Leap To Fame's trainer/driver Grant Dixon did not want, gate 1.

Leap To Fame's \$1.25 odds (for a \$1 bet) are the shortest in Inter Dominion history. The former superstar Kiwi pacer Elsu was closest when he won all heats and the final in the 2005 Auckland series.

Champion Kiwi driver Anthony Butt, who now calls Australia home, has seen the greatest of greats, driven some and against even more, and he now has Leap To Fame top of the list.

"It was always Blacks A Fake for me and Lazarus as a Kiwi, but 'Larry' [Leap To Fame's stable name] is number 1, now," Butt said. "He's just so dominant and he's done it year after year now.

"He's so far ahead of his rivals in this series, it's actually scary. He's won both heats by big margins, in the fastest times of the night and still in second gear.

"The draw doesn't matter, especially given it's over such a long distance [3,157 meters]. Even if he can't hold the lead, Grant [Dixon] won't get pocketed. He's just far too good for them. He's one of those very rare horses where the draws just don't matter."

Dixon's "Plan A" is to try and hold the lead from gate 1, but zippy beginners like Rakero Rebel (gate 2) and Cya Art (4) could have plenty to say about that.

Going into the series, defending Inter Dominion champion Don Hugo was considered a clear second elect and the only serious danger to Leap To Fame.

Even though Don Hugo won last year's series while Leap To Fame was sidelined with illness, he did beat the champion in the Miracle Mile on March 8.

But they clashed in last Saturday night's second round of heats and Leap To Fame beat Don Hugo out of sight, albeit the latter had a torrid run outside the leader, which ruined his chances.

Still, the result saw Don Hugo's final odds ease from \$3.50 to \$7 and he could even start longer from a wide draw, gate 6, in the final.

It's almost impossible to see how he turns the tables – especially over a grueling 3,157 meters, which is made for Leap To Fame – in the space of a week.

Excitingly, if Leap To Fame wins as expected, his owners Kevin and Kay Seymour are holding off any stud offers so he can

tackle at least one more Inter Dominion final next year, again at Albion Park.

Now to the trotting series, which is so different to the one the great Just Believe *owned* and totally dominated back in late 2023 at Albion Park.

This final has depth and is a fascinating mix of ageing, established and emerging stars.

A little like the pacing series, the favorite, Arcee Phoenix, has drawn the pole.

Even his trainer/driver Chris Svanosio says it isn't an ideal draw – he's a chance to lead, but far from a lock.

The most likely runner to seriously challenge for the lead is young buck Kiwi trotter Bet N Win, who sailed through the two heats with easy all-the-way wins.

He's set to start from gate 4 and begins very quickly, but will he be quick enough to get a full length and half on Arcee Phoenix and cross him.

That will go a long way to shaping the result of the race.

The race goes well beyond that pair with the talented, but nutty, Gus absolutely flying. He's out of the draw so starts from outside the second line.

Gus' two heat runs have been monstrous and he will relish the long trip.

If he does everything right again and there is some spice between the two favorites early, Gus is a great chance.

Old Kiwi millionaire Oscar Bonavena miraculously made the final after making breaks in both heats.

Like Gus, he's got the talent and sheer speed to win even though he too is outside the draw.

And talented trotters like Parisian Artiste, driven by popular new mum Tayla French, and London To A Brick, are good enough to win if everything went their way.

Of all the possible narratives in this series, Jess Tubbs is the biggest.

At that last Brisbane Inter Dominions series 19 months ago, Tubbs and husband, Greg Sugars, won the trotting final with Just Believe and snared second in the pacing final behind Leap To Fame with Better Eclipse.

Although Better Eclipse just failed to make the final, Tubbs' classy mare Rakero Rebel did and is drawn ideally from gate 2.

Tubbs is doing it alone this time after Sugars tragically passed away at just 40 years old, in his sleep, less than three months ago.

Shawn Steacy's Mohawk milestones and Hambletonian dreams

by Melissa Keith

When trotter Outbound Train crossed the finish at Woodbine Mohawk Park on June 24, he brought driver Bob McClure across the line and trainer Shawn Steacy over the \$10-million (CDN) mark in career earnings. The Lansdowne, ON native relocated to Guelph in 2011, after getting his start alongside father Mark Steacy at Rideau Carleton Raceway and Hippodrome de Montréal.

Shawn's first official training victory was with pacer L Weather B on Feb. 28, 2019 at Mohawk, but he said with a laugh that he's not someone who tracks his own statistics closely. In fact, on Monday (July 14), he told HRU that he was completely unaware he was on the brink of the \$10-million breakthrough.

"I had no idea until the day after it happened, when I walked into the barn and someone said it to me," Shawn said. "A friend, Barry Drury, Jonathan Drury's father, was the first one to tell me. I didn't know what to make of it. It hadn't really registered to me, because we're a family business."

The 38-year-old trainer added that he welcomed the news, but he considered it part of the Steacy Stables' combined efforts.

"It's really more of an addition to my dad's lifetime stats," he said. "It's a family business. Anything under the Steacy name is a cumulative statistic, in my eyes."

In 2020, Shawn was awarded his first Johnson Cup for being the leading Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) trainer by seasonal points. He repeated in 2023, following in the footsteps of his father Mark, who had previously brought home three consecutive Johnson Cups (2016-18).

After earning his first OSS training title, Shawn described his horses' under-the-radar progress in an interview.

"We never really had that one killer kind of horse, we just had a large group of good horses," he said. "They kind of picked away and picked away all year, compared to maybe some other stables that took big chunks of the pie all at once... They had a couple of really flashy horses, where we just had the lunch pail team."

Shawn said that the same was true this year.

"It's kind of the same style of barn, a lunch pail team overall," he said. "We don't have any major superstars in the barn... I think we'll just be a team that chips away this year... Typically, we're always two weeks or so later to the party [with young horses]. We try to go for freshness late in the season, for the OSS Super Finals."

Sylvia Hanover's beginnings reflect that approach. She first qualified July 12, 2022 at Mohawk and broke her maiden there in her first career start, July 26, 2022, in the first leg of the Whenuwishuponastar for driver Bob McClure.

"With our stable, you can ask a lot of the guys who drive for us regularly, typically, as the season goes on, our stable gets stronger when other stables may have plateaued," Shawn said. "We always find that if we're not too hard on 2-year-olds, they make better 3-year-olds. That's what's worked for us, in a general way."

"We have horses at First Line [Training Centre in Nassagaweya, ON], and our farm in Lansdowne is where they all develop. My brother Clarke [Steacy] starts them, then they come up to First Line to qualify and race. We have a small stable of seven horses in New Jersey right now, so 45 to 50 horses overall... We usually start out with around 60 [per year], and we try to focus on younger horses. That's kind of the business model that my dad's had for the past 20 years; sell most of them after the 3-year-old year and replenish with new ones."

In 2023, Sylvia Hanover (p, 4, 1:47.3m; \$1,927,219) was voted Canada's O'Brien Somebeachsomewhere Horse of the Year, raising Shawn to greater prominence. The striking Always B Miki—Shyaway mare owned by Hudson Standardbred Stable Inc. of Hudson, QC earned O'Brien and Dan Patch Awards at ages 2 and 3. Her two wins so far this year came in the June 7 Mohawk filly and mare preferred for McClure and the Perfect Sting at The Meadowlands June 28 for Tim Tetrick.

Saturday night (July 12), Twin B Joe Fresh turned the tables in the Dorothy Haughton Memorial at The Meadowlands. Shawn said that while his father handles U.S. training duties, he was also there for Sylvia Hanover's place finish.

"She raced fantastic again, leaving from the 9-hole in :26.1 and still closing in :25.4," Shawn said. "You couldn't ask any more of her. Hopefully we reverse post positions next week, if all goes as planned."

Sylvia Hanover's next start is in the Clara Barton pace at Plainridge on Sunday (July 20). She dominated the 2024 edition in 1:48.2 for Tetrick.

Green Moni Queen was an 8-1 winner for McClure in her first lifetime start, drawing clear down the stretch for a 1:56.2 maiden victory.

The Green Manalishi S—Essence of Lindy filly was a \$70,000 Harrisburg yearling purchase, owned by the Landmark 18 Racing Stable of Lansdowne, ON, Stephen Downey of Quispamsis, NB, Dan Mogridge of Coldwater, ON, and Mark Steacy.

Sweet Mama T (Muscle Mass—Sweet Ashley T) was a \$40,000 Harrisburg yearling, also making her pari-mutuel debut Monday night at Mohawk. Shawn said he was hopeful about her potential.

“She’s a big, powerful filly with a lot of upside to her, I believe,” he said.

Owned by Landmark 18 Racing Stable of Lansdowne, ON, Bertrand Gilhespy Stable of Lake Country, BC, Stephen Downey of Quispamsis, NB, and David Reid of Sydenham, ON, Sweet Mama T faced an outside post position and overland trip, finishing 10th.

Elbows Up (Muscle Mass—Vegas Virgin) captured the final Grassroots leg, winning by a half-length in a front-end trip and taking a mark of 1:58.3 for McClure and Steacy.

“She’s a sister to a really nice filly, Mischevious Rose [4, 1:52.2s; \$413,588],” Shawn said. “She’s a pretty athletic filly and will make a nice OSS horse.”

A \$30,000 Harrisburg purchase, Elbows Up is owned by Doug Clark of Mississauga, ON, Guy Haskell of Guelph, ON, Mark Steacy, and Cara Steacy of Lansdowne, ON, the wife of Shawn’s brother Clarke.

These wins follow another for Shawn Steacy; he was re-elected as a Central Ontario Standardbred Association (COSA) director on June 30. Eight candidates ran for four positions on the board, Steacy and Woodbine Mohawk Park outrider Joanne Colville were both chosen by voters for

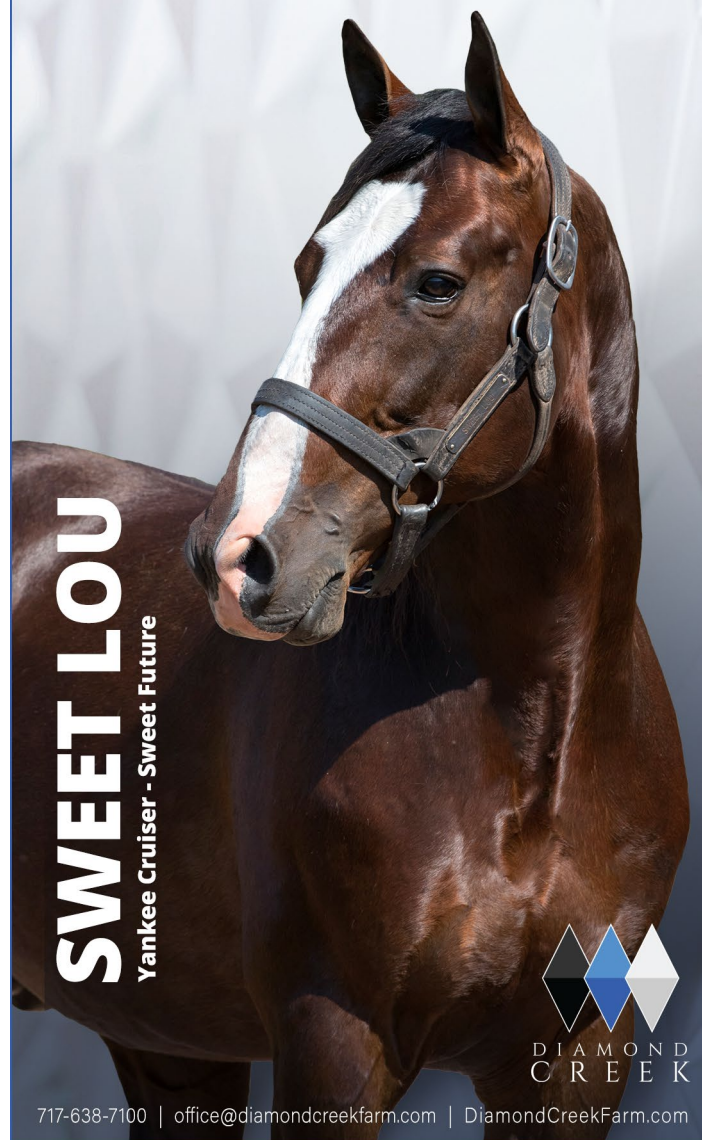

another 3-year term. Mohawk driver Tyler Jones and Princeton Farms owner/operator Jesse Belore were newly elected to join them on the board of COSA, which was founded in June 2009 to represent the interests of Ontario harness racing participants.

Shawn said he has additional future goals, but driving is not among them, despite blowing up the Mohawk tote board with Armored Dove (3, 1:54.4s; \$13,578) on May 30, 2024. At odds of 78-1, the filly was Ontario's longest-odds winner last year.

“Usually, I drive to work out little quirks and problems, or to set them up for catch drivers later on,” Shawn told HRU. “I’m too big and too old to drive [regularly], but I drive when I need to figure things out. I trained that horse a lot and I had more confidence in her than anything else. It proves that lightning can strike anywhere.”

His long-range goals include working towards one specific race.

“I want a strong, successful stable and I want to win the Hambletonian,” he said. “If I need to live to be 300 to do it, I will win a Hambletonian.”

Mark Steacy trained the show finisher in the 2014 Hambletonian, Harper Blue Chip (3, 1:54.3s; \$882,951), later voted 2014 O'Brien 3-Year-Old Trotting Colt of the Year. His sire, Majestic Son (3, 1:52.2s; \$1,756,883), was also trained by Mark; the eventual 2006 O'Brien Horse of the Year was ineligible to the Hambletonian.

As for Hambletonian hopes this year, Shawn told HRU that the Oaks was closer to reality.

“We have a filly that's on the fence, Grand Reserve [3, 1:53.4f; \$44,005],” he said. “She got away a little bit back and the flow didn't work out [July 12 in the Del Miller Memorial]. She's got one more start this week to decide, and then we'll see about the Oaks. Between the owner [Hudson Standardbred Stable] and us, we'll figure out if we're going to take that plunge or not.”

Unreasonable tops five track records on Oak Grove KYSS final day

The near \$1-million day of Kentucky Sire Stakes (KYSS) finals at Oak Grove Racing, Gaming & Hotel on Monday (July 14) saw five track-record performances, the fastest of which came in a powerhouse romp by Erv Miller trainee **Unreasonable**

to win the \$100,000 final for 3-year-old pacing fillies in 1:49.4.

Driver Marcus Miller motored Unreasonable to the top through a :26 first quarter and pocketed Reckless Abandon (driven by Todd McCarthy) moving past the grandstand for the first time. Odds-on chalk Odds On Chesapeake (Dexter Dunn) abandoned her leave attempt and landed fourth out of post 7, but tried to claw first over after a :55 half. Miller accelerated with Unreasonable up the backstretch and started to peel away from the competition through three-quarters in 1:22.1. Odds On Chesapeake retreated as the others fought to hold position in behind widening winner Unreasonable. She crossed the line under wraps and 4½ lengths better than Reckless Abandon in second. Accede (Yannick Gingras) grabbed third while Caviart Delight (Scott Zeron) closed widest of all for fourth.

Unreasonable, who matched the track record for 3-year-old pacing fillies of 1:49.4 set by Charleston in 2023, won her third race from four starts this season and her sixth race from 15 starts in her career. Erv Miller trains the daughter of Huntsville for owners Ervin Miller Stable Inc. and David J. Miller. She has earned \$260,582 and paid \$6.52 to win.

One race later, **Caviart Daisy** (Andy McCarthy) blew off the barn doors with a 13½-length victory in the \$100,000 KYSS 2-Year-Old Filly Pace and also lowered the track record by a full second. McCarthy bided his time from fourth as Eternal Blush (Dunn) pushed through an early tussle to plant onto the lead after a :26.4 first quarter and :55.1 half. Caviart Daisy launched into action as proceedings settled on the lead, and she brushed forward with ease while opening a growing advantage on the charge to three-quarters in 1:22.1. McCarthy looked over his shoulder twice, and with nobody coming he began to race the clock to the finish. Caviart Daisy won by a chasm in 1:51, beating the previous mark of 1:52 set last year by Skywalker Sea, while Kissin In The Dark (Atlee Bender) scooted up the inside for second. Eternal Blush took third and Carolina (Todd McCarthy) finished fourth.

Jamie Sullivan trains Caviart Daisy, an undefeated daughter of Sweet Lou, for owner Frank Chick. She has now banked \$90,000 from three victories and paid \$2.94 to win.

Yannick G Kemp (Todd McCarthy) won the first KYSS final of the day, the \$100,000 KYSS 3-Year-Old Colt and Gelding Trot, in a track-record time with a surprise front-stepping performance at odds of 17-1. Having to return to the paddock before the race for a shoe repair, Yannick G Kemp came back to the track, went behind the gate and uncorked great speed to land on the point out of post 6 through a :27.3 first quarter. With his competition just trying to find a rhythm in behind, Yannick G Kemp coasted by a :56.2

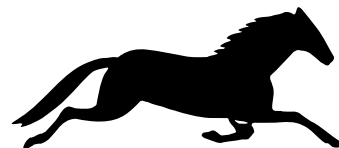

half and through three-quarters in 1:24.1 with a strong lead coming for home. My Degenerate (Dunn), the 4-5 favorite, tried to rush first up late before losing stride, which left Yannick G Kemp alone to coast in a two-length winner in 1:52.3. Te Quiero Lindy (Andy McCarthy) sat a pocket trip for second with Big Shoes (Gingras) closing for third and Grande Via (David Miller) in fourth.

Richard "Nifty" Norman trains Yannick G Kemp, a 3-year-old colt by Walner, for owners Melvin Hartman, Rojan Stables and Little E LLC. In winning his seventh race from 22 starts, Yannick G Kemp padded his bankroll to \$214,889 while also lowering the track record for 3-year-old trotting colts of 1:53 set by Brodeur in 2023. He paid \$36.04 to win.

Endurance (Andy McCarthy) beat his own track record that he set one week ago in winning the \$100,000 KYSS 2-Year-Old Colt and Gelding Trot at the end of the card. McCarthy plowed past San Patricio (Zeron) through a :27 first quarter to lead the field through a :56.1 half and to three-quarters in 1:24.4. San Patricio trotted level for home, but Silverstein (David Miller) emerged out of third to take a shot at Endurance. McCarthy gave his charge a few taps of the whip and Endurance held by three-quarters-of-a-length at the end of a 1:53.2 mile over Silverstein. San Patricio chased in third and Zephyr Kemp (Dunn) settled for fourth.

Chris Beaver trains Endurance, a colt by Captain Corey, for himself and co-owners Bill Manes, Leo Fleming and Mark Moger. He collected his second win from three starts – his first win in 1:54.3 beat the previous track record for 2-year-old colts by a fifth-of-a-second – and has now earned \$73,200. He paid \$3.36 to win.

The fifth track record of the day came at the start of the card in a KYSS consolation when **Global Sensation** (Dunn) swooped three wide around the last turn to win the \$25,000 consolation for 3-year-old trotting colts and geldings in 1:52. Marcus Melander trains the Chapter Seven gelding whose time bested the previous mark of 1:53 set earlier this season by My Degenerate. He paid \$4.08 to win in collecting the second victory of his career in his 17th start.

Global Sensation opened a wildly successful day for Dunn, who piloted five winners on the day. He teamed with Melander later in the card to win the \$100,000 KYSS 2-Year-Old Filly Trot with **Setyoursightshigh** in 1:53.3, which was just one-fifth-of-a-second off the track record. Dunn powered the daughter of In Range first up after Avenzee (Andy McCarthy) cut early fractions of :27.1 and :57.1 and continued pressing for the lead marching to three-quarters in 1:25.3. Setyoursightshigh slid past Avenzee in the lane and strode home with ease to a 1¾ length win over Victorianas Secret (Zeron) closing for second.

Country Glide (David Miller) shook free from a pocket ride for third and Avenzee settled for fourth.

Setyoursightshigh won her second race from three starts and has now accrued \$135,000 in earnings for owners Heights Stable, Mantorp LLC, AMG Stable Inc. and K. Kjellgren Livs AB Inc. She paid \$5.18 to win.

Dunn and Melander also paired – to complete a training hat trick for Melander – with a shocking victory in the \$100,000 KYSS 3-Year-Old Filly Trot by **Belmont** in 1:54.4. Belmont landed last of the five fillies still trotting to a :26.2 first quarter, but found a helmet to follow into a :56 half from 2-1 favorite Clarissa W (Todd McCarthy) as she moved first over after tempo-setter Ms Prada (Gingras). Clarissa W locked into battle with Ms Prada in the backstretch figuratively, but then literally when the spokes of their race bikes hooked and caused the field to scatter. Dunn circumvented the confusion by launching Belmont three wide, and she got a sizeable jump on her rivals coming to three-quarters in 1:24.4. The cushion proved sufficient in the lane, and she crossed the line 2¼ lengths better than Admiring (David Miller) in second. Kngtstlkr's Pistol (Andy Miller) took third and Super Freak (Zeron) recovered from an early break to finish fourth another 20 lengths behind.

Belmont, a daughter of Gimpanzee, won her third race from 10 starts and has now earned \$90,350 for owners S R F Stable and Holly Lane Stud East LTD. She paid \$41.38 to win in her upset and capped four straight driving wins on the card by Dunn.

Alongside Dunn's two victories in KYSS finals and his track record to open the card, he also won in two other KYSS consolations. He first guided **Bourbon County** (1:51.2 winning mile; \$3.74 to win) to a pillar-to-post victory in the consolation for 3-year-old pacing colts and geldings and followed that two races later with a win in the consolation for 3-year-old pacing fillies by **Hip Shot** (1:51.3; \$6.08). The only consolation not won by Dunn went to Zeron as he piloted **Heartofthesunrise** (1:54.3; \$7.68) to victory with a first-over push off fast fractions in the consolation for 2-year-old pacing fillies.

Funky Buddha (Todd McCarthy) proved supreme in the \$100,000 KYSS 2-Year-Old Colt and Gelding Pace with a first-over push to a 1:53 win, snapping driver Dunn's win streak on the card. McCarthy settled Funky Buddha in third while What Nooo Waaay (Gingras) rushed to the lead in a :27.2 first quarter before hitting the brakes to a :57 half. Despite the breather, Funky Buddha tipped outside and inched forward in a third-quarter sprint up the backstretch. What Nooo Waaay clocked by three-quarters in 1:24 but had little answer to Funky Buddha's challenge spinning for home. Funky Buddha pulled away and then held off a late

bid from Prolific Blend (Zeron) to win by three-quarters-of-a-length in 1:53. What Nooo Waaay held third and Clouseau (Dunn) took fourth.

Tony Dinges trains Funky Buddha, a colt by Sweet Lou, for owner Rick Berks. He won his third race from four starts, has now banked \$86,000 and paid \$3.64 to win.

Falcon (Marcus Miller) pulled off the last upset of the day in the penultimate race on the card when he capitalized off of heated fractions set in front to win the \$100,000 KYSS 3-Year-Old Colt and Gelding Pace in 1:49.3. Favorite Harrisburg Heist (Gingras) set the stage when chugging forward on the rim through a :25.4 first quarter and :53 half to plant onto the point, and Ayeaye Captain Deo (Todd McCarthy) further intensified the tempo with a first-over bid out of third coming to three-quarters in 1:20.2. All the while Marcus Miller pivoted Falcon wider and wider to turn for home with clear sailing at the center of the track. Falcon soared by weary rivals to win going away by 1¾ lengths. Captain Arturovico (Jeremy Bobbitt) rallied off a second-over trip for second with Delray Beach (Dunn) skimming up a seam at the pylons for third and Handsome Stranger (Andy McCarthy) swooping from near last for fourth.

Robert Taylor trains Falcon, a gelding by Captain Crunch, for owners Taylor Racing LLC and Tristan Taylor. He won his sixth race from 16 starts, has now earned \$103,724 and paid \$24.42 to win.

Monday's stakes-packed card at Oak Grove also featured a \$10,000 guarantee in the 20-cent Pick 5, which was spurred by a \$1,962 carryover from the Sunday card. 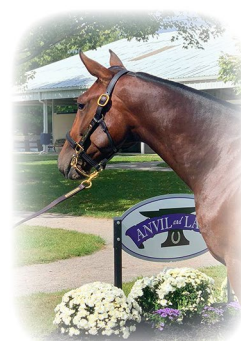

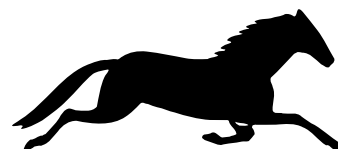

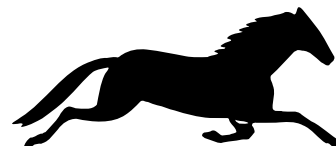

There were three \$30,000 divisions of a Pennsylvania All-Stars event for 2-year-old pacing fillies on the Sunday (July 13) twilight card at Pocono Downs at Mohegan Pennsylvania, and all three of the winners scored in identical times of 1:53.4.

Scott Di Domenico conditions the fleet filly for Triple D And Oompa Farm, Michael Rekoon, Craig Henderson, and Steve Stewart.

The other two winners were driven by three-time defending Pocono champion Matt Kakaley, and they both recorded maiden victories after debuting with a second in Sire Stakes competition. 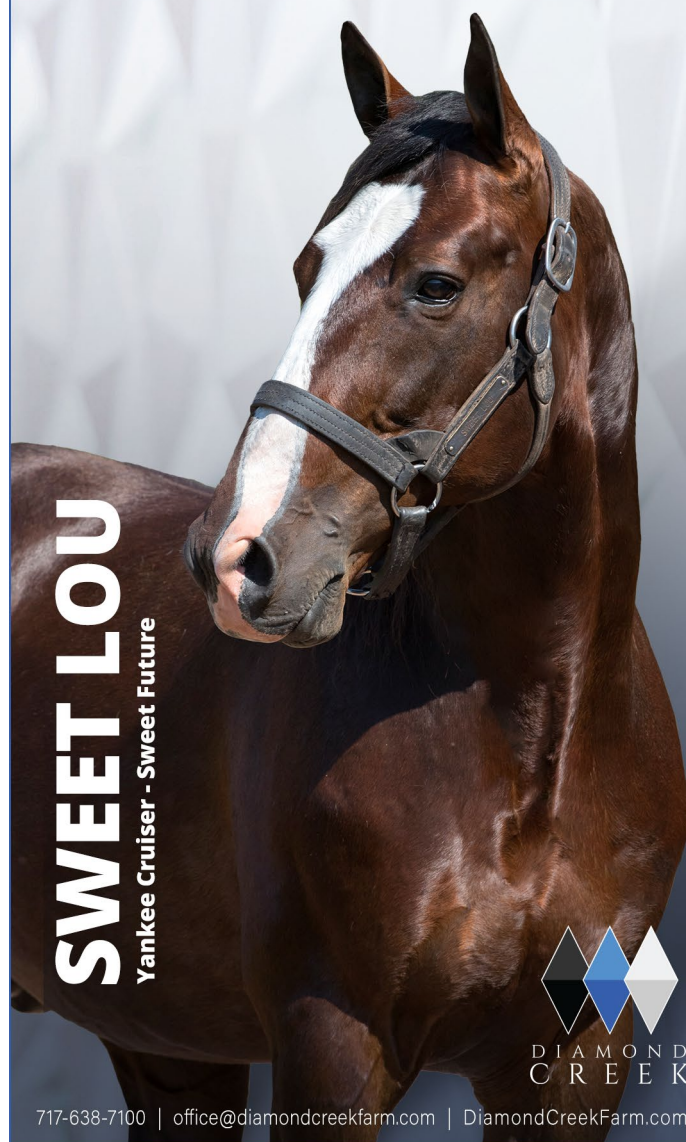


Other live music will be provided by the Berkshire Valley Boys who will be performing throughout the day between races.
