







It was The A-Team's Hannibal — not owner/breeder Adam Bowden — that said: "I love it when a plan comes together," but nothing could be truer of Bowden's Meadowlands Pace.

When Confederate — owned and bred by Bowden's Diamond Creek Racing and Diamond Creek Farm, respectively — paced away from the field in the stretch of the \$668,000 Pace at The Meadowlands on Saturday (July 15), it was the validation of the plan he introduced in 2020. Bowden explained that **plan** in detail to HRU a couple of weeks ago.

Confederate was sent off as the 1-2 odds-on choice, which boded well at a track where the favorite comes in almost 40 per cent of the time.

However, Pace Night 2023 was not playing true to form, as the majority of the chalk bit the dust. In fact, on the night, the favorites came in at almost half the average, at just 21 per cent.

In the 10 races prior to Confederate stepping on the track, the favorite won only twice: race 5, a conditioned pace, and race 8, the \$169,000 Mistletoe Shalee. Both races were won by less than a length.

The Shalee for 3-year-old filly pacers is the companion race to the Meadowlands Pace and it was won in incredibly impressive fashion by 2022's 2-Year-Old Filly Pacer of the Year, Sylvia Hanover, also a 1-2 favorite. Not bad for the filly's first start away from Woodbine Mohawk Park.

With so many non-favorites crossing the wire first, some may have thought that the odds were not in Confederate's favor, but they were not considering a much more important stat.

Coming into the night, Confederate's trainer Brett Pelling held the record for most Pace victories with four, three of which were the post-time choice. Although Pelling finished second in the Pace more times than he won it — a total of five — he never lost with the favorite and that streak continued.


Confederate, driven by Hall of Famer Tim Tetrick, did it the hard way, going first up from just before the half. The 3-year-old son of Sweet Lou—Geothermal won by 3 ½ lengths, the largest margin of any of the nine stakes races on the card.

Tetrick now has six Pace wins, the most among active drivers and just one behind John Campbell, who has seven, a number that many thought would take a lot more years to even approach.

Bowden had a total of three finalists in the Pace: Confederate, Christchurch and Cannibal, who finished first, third and sixth, respectively.

When asked who he'd like to acknowledge for Confederate's Pace night win, Bowden said: "I'd thank everyone associated with the horse. The farm staff who foaled him, raised him and prepped him. Brian Brown and his groom, Ashley Dowis, who with Marcus [Johansson] mapped out and executed a nearly flawless 2-year-old season. Brett Pelling and his groom, Jessica Shenski, again together with Marcus for mapping out a nearly flawless 3-year-old season. Shaun Laungani, DCF VP, for always keeping us grounded, challenging the norms, making us question our decisions and focused on the big picture. And finally, my father for giving me this wonderful opportunity and encouraging me to reach my goals and always strive to be better. Without him, this doesn't exist."

When discussing standout performances from Pace Night, in addition to acknowledging the great performances by Confederate and Sylvia Hanover, Big M TV simulcast show co-host Greg Blanchard said: "Probably the most entertaining and enjoyable to watch of the night was that Haughton final and great to see Charlie May get a big win like that as well."

Two years after being disqualified for interference in the 2021 Meadowlands Pace, Don Tiger's Charlie May made the biggest score of his career in the \$444,000 William R. Haughton Memorial.

A perfect drive by Hall of Famer Dave Miller got Charlie May to the wire first by a half-length over Tattoo Artist.

Tiger believes his good friend, the late Dave Brower, was smiling down on Charlie May's victory.

At 31-1, Charlie May was the second longest-priced winner on the night. Only Mikala returned more, taking the \$159,000 Dorothy Haughton Memorial at odds of 41-1.

The 5-year-old gelding Charlie May was winless in his five previous starts in 2023 but had never missed hitting the board, finishing second on four occasions and third in the other.

With the 2023 Meadowlands Pace in the books, the 2021 Pace remains in the appeal process with Tiger taking his fight to the New Jersey appellate court.

"We still feel really good about it and I think in the end it'll work out," Tiger said. "I already felt we won when the [Administrative Law Judge, Andrew M. Baron] gave that decision. That's what I needed personally. I'm already satisfied.

"Unfortunately, in situations like this, there's really no winner and what I mean by that is, what happened that day happened. You can't get back that day."

Although it truly isn't possible to go back in time and rectify what happened on the night of the 2021 Pace, should the case eventually be adjudicated in his favor, Tiger wouldn't mind trying to recreate that celebratory winner's circle moment.

"If it all works out legally and we do officially get it all done, I would definitely reach out to Jeff [Gural] and Jason [Settlemoir] and see if they were okay with [presenting Charlie May with an official 2021 Pace blanket] and if they were, I would 100 per cent be there.

"I would make sure the horse was there and I would make sure the people were there. I would definitely do that. So, I would say that's something very fun to look forward to."

Tiger has never wavered from what he said two years ago about giving the Pace purse money away should he finally win his case.

"I would stick as much as I could in the horse racing industry," Tiger said. "It sounds crazy but I would probably set up some kind of legal fund for maybe \$20,000 and get somebody in Jersey and say here's an escrow account and you can use that for horseman that might need an appeal or might need legal help. There are all kinds of cool things that I've thought about along the way to do.

"All the trainers that have been with me over the years, I plan on giving them all a kicker. Obviously, I would give the trainer and driver [of Charlie May] a kicker. It would be kind of fun spending the money to be honest with you. The only thing I've ever done this for was to get the record books straight. I never did it for monetary reasons."

Tiger hopes his case will have an impact on the industry moving forward, but in order for that to happen, the racing commission would have to be open to change, the same way governing bodies in other sports are.

"This is the problem with the commissions," Tiger said. "They feel that it's better to protect the lie and to have their own set of systems than just to try to adjudicate things properly. Sports like the NFL, MLB, NBA, want to get it right. That's all they care about. They just want to get everything on the field of battle right and we just haven't switched over in horse racing to that completely yet."

Guest announcers step up for Ken Middleton at WMP

When a race caller is a major part of a racetrack's identity, finding others to fill in for him isn't easy. When that race caller is Woodbine Mohawk Park's Ken Middleton, out for an indefinite timespan, the matter is even trickier. The mainstay of Canada's top harness track is a familiar and popular aspect of what makes Mohawk so successful.

When Middleton was badly hurt in a June 29 training accident, he was transported to Hamilton [ON] General Hospital and diagnosed with damage to multiple vertebrae in his neck and back. He underwent surgery on July 2 and was able to return



home. He was due to have surgical staples removed this week. As he returns to health with well wishes from across the industry, the timeline for his return to the WMP mic remains undetermined.

Mark McKelvie is the senior manager of communications for Woodbine Entertainment. He told HRU the news about Middleton's accident came at a sadly ironic moment.


"Ken had actually been off for a scheduled vacation for the week leading up to his accident," McKelvie said. "Chad [Rozema, former analyst/back-up race caller at Woodbine Mohawk Park; current racing manager at Grand River Raceway] and I had actually been filling in. It was pretty startling news. Rob Platts is our director of broadcasting; I told him I was good for the next several days."

As Middleton's prognosis became clearer, McKelvie said he learned that it would be many days and nights before the regular announcer was able to come back.

"We knew it wasn't good, but we were waiting for a little more news," McKelvie said. "We got that within a few days. I feel terrible for him right now. Most people don't realize how much time he spends between his own horses and the races going later into the night."

McKelvie is a young-yet-experienced announcer. His expanded role at Woodbine prevented him from being able to fill the position on an ongoing basis during Middleton's recovery.

"My role now involves the standardbreds and the thoroughbreds, spending time between both tracks [WMP and Woodbine Racetrack]," McKelvie said. "Sometimes you have to step up and help the team. I said I'd step up for the time being."



With the King's Plate coming up at Woodbine Racetrack on Aug. 20, he would soon require backup.

The Guelph, ON resident called baby races/qualifiers at Mohawk; made the drive to Woodbine; then returned to call evening cards at the Campbellville, ON track on a couple of occasions. He described it as a good experience, albeit under unfortunate circumstances.

"It was busy, but I think I kind of thrive on being busy," McKelvie said. "I enjoy the chaos at times in the busy part of the racing season. I can say I'm pretty prepared for that."

McKelvie praised his coworkers for going the extra mile when he was busy with added announcing duties.

"The entire team at Woodbine has been really supportive," he said. "Our communications team, Chris Lomon and Grace Martin, are fantastic and on the ball about everything. Jamie Dykstra, my boss, was really supportive."

Announcers were still needed to cover the longer range of Middleton's recovery, as both McKelvie and Rozema were busy in management roles at their respective tracks.

What about Woodbine Racetrack's thoroughbred caller Robert Geller?

"I did harness race trials [qualifiers] for years at Kilmore, a strong harness track a bit over an hour outside of Melbourne in Victoria," Geller said. "It was home to some of the best harness trainers and horses in the state. I did not get to call the actual harness races for Kilmore because I had not become part of the racing radio network then which covered it."

An already-busy schedule keeps him at Woodbine, but Geller said he could assist at Mohawk, under the circumstances.

"I offered to be available should they be in a bind," Geller said. "My boss appreciates the offer though it seems for now at least, they have a roster worked out."

McKelvie said that he and Rob Platts "were in constant communication for the first few weeks" of Middleton's extended absence.

"Between [Platts] and myself, we brainstormed some announcers who we thought were capable of filling in," McKelvie said. "You're looking for people in Ontario who are smooth and accurate."

They decided on Rideau Carleton Raceway's John MacMillan, who called the action at Mohawk this Monday and Tuesday (July 17 and 18).

MacMillan said he got a text from Platts, and agreed, despite the distance involved.

"It's three hours from where I live, in Kingston... three hours east of Mohawk," MacMillan said, adding with a laugh, "[There was just one condition] as long as there aren't too many stake races and mostly overnights."

MacMillan was actually fresh from announcing a Rideau card with Ontario Sires Stakes Gold and Grassroots divisions for 3-year-old filly trotters on Sunday evening (July 16).

"I had called races at Rideau the night before, got home at 2 a.m., slept for four hours, got up and trained my own eight horses and then drove to Mohawk on four hours' sleep to call at a new track for the first time," MacMillan said of his WMP debut. "I hadn't called at a seven-eighths mile track since Montreal about 22 years ago.

"It absolutely felt different because the program has a bunch of horses you've never seen before. It's not like I rotate from track to track; I'm always at the same one. The production is very detailed at Mohawk. But from the horsemen to the track management, they made me feel like I was part of the home team right away."

MacMillan said he particularly enjoyed getting to call two winners on Tuesday night (July 18).

"It was fun to call Paul [MacDonell] winning with One Last Wish, because Paul's a veteran of the circuit," MacMillan said, noting the 3-year-old pacing filly's lifetime-best victory in the second leg of divisional OSS Gold competition. One Last Wish (p, 3, 1:50.1s; \$132,556) is a daughter of Bettors Delight–Arts Diva, owned by Brian Legge, Toronto, ON and Dr. David Legge, Ajax, ON and trained by Ken Sucee.


The following race, Muscle Hill—Shared Past stallion Shadrack Hanover (6, 1:52.1s; \$206,571) beat conditioned trotters in 1:53.1 for driver Louis-Phillipe Roy, owner Triple S Equine of Newton, ON, and trainer Thomas Riley. The latter is a friend of the WMP fill-in announcer.

"It's a lot of fun to call one of your friend's horses winning," said MacMillan.

Like Middleton, MacMillan would know that feeling from both sides of the announcer's booth.

"Kenny and I have in common that we both train horses," MacMillan said. "I think I was there the night that Kenny auditioned for his Flamboro Downs job. I was very enthusiastic when Kenny got his training license and started winning big races, especially with Bob Loblaw [p, 3, 1:50.3s; \$202,744]."

Middleton famously called the Oct. 16, 2021 OSS Gold Super Final for 2-year-old male pacers when his homebred Sunshine Beach—Lady Marina gelding went from seventh to first down the long Mohawk stretch for driver Sylvain Filion.

"A lot can happen in the last 70 yards," said MacMillan. "The one big thing I'd like to make note of is how skilled those [Mohawk] drivers are. As an announcer, you have to be ready. When you get eight or 10 of those drivers in a race, they see an opportunity and seize on it and they're gone."

He will be back into the WMP rotation as Middleton recovers at home in Cambridge, ON. MacMillan said the experience was a good one, and he even received encouragement from a Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Famer who will soon be taking the mic there.

"Frank [Salive] actually texted me before and after, to give me some words of advice and encouragement," MacMillan said. "He texted me after the first night and said he was proud of me."

Mark McKelvie confirmed that Frank Salive and MacMillan, as well as Greg Blanchard and Shannon "Sugar" Doyle of The Raceway at Western Fair, will be filling in for Middleton on a rotating basis.

"You'll hear them at different times throughout the month of August," McKelvie said. "I think it's fair to say having Frank [Salive] back will offer a bit of nostalgia. As a Hall of Famer, it's always good to hear him on the mic."

Salive was inducted into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame in 2022 for his work calling races at Ontario Jockey Club/ Woodbine Entertainment Group harness tracks for 14 years, as well as at Pompano Park, Western Fair Raceway, Clinton Raceway, and Fort Erie Racetrack.

McKelvie said he didn't know when Middleton would be back.

"I know it will be a long recovery for him," McKelvie said. "Woodbine sent a gift basket and a card signed by people at both racetracks, and he's had lots of visitors."

He said multiple O'Brien Award-winning trainer Richard Moreau is training Middleton's horses in the meantime.

Like MacMillan, McKelvie said it was a mixed blessing to recently call so many races on Canadian harness racing's biggest stage.

"It's funny," McKelvie said. "A lot of people have mentioned to me, 'What an opportunity!' But it has that awkward feeling... I've known Ken since I was a kid. I really look forward to when he's back in the booth, that's for sure."









Expected \$1 million purse could be a game changer for Little Brown Jug

When it was announced this week that the purse was expected to be raised to \$1 million for this year's Little Brown Jug in September, I was reminded of a scene in the film, Seabiscuit. The idea was for a non-Eastern track to offer the biggest race purse in American history to attract the top horses in the country. There was a quote in there that was something to the effect that an elitist East might have had all their blue blood, but that their money was just as good as the others.

In a stunning move, the Little Brown Jug is making a similar proclamation by shattering not only all other Little Brown Jug purse records but is going straight to the very top of purses offered anywhere for sophomore pacers.

The purse increase to \$1 million is obviously meaningful from a monetary standpoint but may even be more impactful symbolically. Through the years, the purse of the Little Brown Jug has remained at a consistent number. And those numbers have been pretty well on par with most of the sports other 3-year-old major races. What has hampered the event more so in recent years is the longstanding tradition of the Little Brown Jug giving way to modern day circumstances around same-day heat racing, competing stakes schedules and the nature of half-mile racing. The Jug has already made concessions around some of those concerns such as eliminating a potential third heat. Now, how much of an equalizer will \$1 million be as an offset for remaining reservations?

Those at the Little Brown Jug had long fought to make the Jug the richest pacing event in North America. Working with both horsemen and legislative groups throughout the state of Ohio, the purse increase announcement has come at a much-needed time.

Last year in 2022, the Little Brown Jug drew just 11 starters, two of which were late supplements, Pleaseletmeknow and eventual winner, Bythemissal. With a \$1 million purse, the



hope now is to not only increase the quantity of entrants, but the quality as well. Bythemissal was a rocketing star at the time of the race last year, but it lacked star power from other major 3-year-olds at the time, Beach Glass and Pebble Beach. As another example, since Meadowlands Pace winner Courtly Choice won the Jug in 2018, there hasn't been a Pace winner that has even started in the Jug, let alone won it.

It may now all be different this year. North America Cup winner It's My Show is already nominated to the Little Brown Jug. Same goes for other top 3-year-olds, Cannibal, Voukefalas, Meadowlands Pace runner-up Hungry Angel Boy, and a host of others. Top 3-year-olds not eligible, but thanks to another recent change, could supplement, include the sport's new #1 rated horse, Confederate, as well as Fulton.

The supplement fee is a hefty one at \$45,000. But as already part of the race conditions, that amount is no different after the purse increase announcement. There's been some all-time greats who have raced in and won the Little Brown Jug throughout its storied history and there's an element here of restoring some of that prestige. Even though the Jug or any half-mile race may never be a particular sire-making race, horses who do win the Jug should be held in higher regard. There's been many instances of Jug winners who shortly thereafter go to sale or eventually wind up in claiming races; things you rarely see from other classic winners. Winning the Little Brown Jug for \$1 million seems like an accomplishment that should be right up there with any other race offered anywhere.

The record Little Brown Jug purse prior to this year was \$677,000 in the Jug edition won by Wiggle It Jiggleit in 2015. Coincidentally, that race is regarded by many as not only one of the greatest Jugs ever, but one of the greatest races in all of harness racing history. Now at a purse of \$1 million, could the level of horses and dramatics often produced from the Jug top even that race? Will It's My Show come? Can Confederate be lured? To quote the same film as prior, how can they resist?


The McKee family: harness racing's greatest gift

They came east from Michigan in 1999 for good. The year before Sam had put his toes in the NJSEA waters at The Meadowlands as a fill-in. Sam and Chris' girls were preteens then and, shall we say, a whirlwind of energy, fun, mystery and sass, with some extra on the end there. They didn't even know where the shallow end of the pool was. Instead, they would be jostling off the high board elbowing to see who goes first. If you talked to one of the girls — Lindsey, Meagan or Melissa — another was likely to finish the thought.

Sam, well, he became the single most important person at The Meadowlands. And the most versatile. Oh, my goodness could he do it all. And he wanted to. And all the while, Sam and Chris never took a step without the betterment of their girls first and foremost.

I never could quite separate the girls. To me they were always the "McKee Girls." The wattage in every room went up significantly when they entered, almost always together. More than once on a Sunday afternoon at The Meadowlands I had a program shoved into my chest followed closely by "Pick some winners buster!" Gloria Heyden's cookies were soon a part of the regimen also. The young ladies, now, as I fast forward a bit, seemed to be open books. There was no whispering in the corner. They were sharers all. And on a busy Hambletonian Day or Meadowlands Pace Night, there was no more welcome sight than Chris and the girls. Appointments not necessary.

Sam all the while excelled at each and every role.

I remember what Tom Charters, CEO of the Hambletonian Society, said after Sam's death, "We will have the Hambletonian this year, but without Sam, I'm not sure how." This from the very man who was the backbone of the sport's biggest race.

Sam never said, Sam did. He had your back, and often you didn't even know it. I found out four or five years later after my 2013 trip to Florida for the Horse of the Year awards dinner that Sam had John Brennan looking out for me, hotels, flights, etc. He fought endlessly for Ken Warkentin. He cared like no one I've ever seen and you can bet it carried over to his girls. Melissa told me at his wake in March 2017, "You wouldn't believe what kind of a father he is." Actually, I would.

Harness racing is indeed a community sport. If one of the driver's/ trainer's kids fall off his/her bike, half a dozen mothers are out there in a flash with first aid kits, ice and cold compresses. No event can unify us any more than this. There's a part of all of us that feels almost as if we are levitated above the tragedy for a moment, knowing fully what has happened but powerless to actually do something.

A couple of events stick in my mind, and all the McKees were present. The 2016 Hambletonian, Sam's last, was a grandioso show that featured Nick Jonas and Martin Truex for sure. I know that because I got to chat with them both and many others. Sam

poured it on that day. Can it really be the seventh Hambletonian without Sam in 2023?

Sam and Chris were quite proud of their girls' athletic prowess and their association with Kentucky. Not only college but the Red Mile. Sam's final day there was Always B Miki's 1:46 mile.

Is there a sense of relief involved here? I'd say so. Meagan had bravely been fighting a rare form of pediatric cancer for over three years and wanted to help others after she was gone. There may be a dash of anger/helplessness in there too as the girls were smack in the prime of life. Sam was running five miles several times a week for years for goodness sakes. There's a randomness here that is absolutely maddening. Nobody, not a single one of us, is promised a thing. Life is unifying, then it isn't.

I'm feeling glad, and not sad, now. Emphasis on now. Immediately after getting these thunderbolts? No. Not at all. But I am so grateful for the last quarter century. The entirety of it.

My freshest recollection comes from last Nov. 12 at The Meadowlands for the Dave Brower Memorial. There was a great turnout and it was well deserved.

As I made my way through a sea of familiarity and a bunch of re-introductions, I came to Melissa McKee. Before a word was said I got the biggest bear hug. A please don't let go/thanks for always being there for my dad, hug. Those are my words. I had no clue that would be the last time I would see Melissa.

From *It's A Wonderful Life*, released Jan. 7, 1947, it was said at the end of the movie that George Bailey was the richest man in town. That movie was adapted from the book, *The Greatest Gift*. It's similar to the one harness racing has had for the last quarter century with the McKee Family.





Beckwith grateful for Gerrity opportunity

Brett Beckwith has watched the Joe Gerrity Jr. Memorial in the past but will see it from a whole new perspective on Saturday (July 22).

Three weeks removed from getting the first Grand Circuit win of his career, the 20-year-old Beckwith will drive Semi Tough for trainer Ron Burke in the 14th edition of the Gerrity at Saratoga Casino Hotel. It will mark Beckwith's first appearance in the Gerrity, which features eight of the sport's top male pacers going for a purse of \$250,000.

Semi Tough is one of five millionaires in the Gerrity, along with returning champion Tattoo Artist, This Is The Plan, Funatthebeach N and I Did It Myway. The field also includes MGM Borgata Pacing Series winner Hellabalou and Camluck Classic winner Covered Bridge. Idealsomemagic A, who won three prelims in the Borgata series, completes the group.

"It's super," Beckwith said about the chance to drive Semi Tough in the Gerrity. "I'm grateful to be in the race. It's at my home track and it's always been a fun race to watch every year. To be able to drive in it is surreal."

Beckwith, who is in his third full year of driving, entered Wednesday with 551 lifetime wins. This season, he has 202 victories (ranking No. 15 among drivers in North America) and \$2.02 million in purses, nearly matching the career highs of 230 wins and \$2.25 million he set in 2022.

At Saratoga this year, Beckwith trails only two-time defending champ Jim Devaux in wins, and he is tied for third in victories at Plainridge Park.

"I went into this year, not with a certain set of expectations, but I expected a lot out of myself," said Beckwith, who is the son of driver Mark Beckwith and Saratoga leading trainer Melissa Beckwith. "Saratoga has been really good. Without my parents, I wouldn't be where I am today. They've helped me progress and put me on the map.

"It's been a good year. I try to hustle as much as I can, going track-to-track to get my name out there. I'm always appreciative of the opportunities I get. Whether it's in a big race like [the Gerrity] or a non-winners of \$2,000, it doesn't really matter. I've just been lucky to get the right opportunities."

His opportunities have included getting to sit behind Stormcloudfashion and Walcango in divisions of the Tompkins-Geers Stakes when trainer Jim Campbell needed a driver for those races, which were contested 70 minutes prior to the main card at The Meadowlands on June 30. Beckwith won with Stormcloudfashion — his first Grand Circuit victory — and finished second with Walcango.

Earlier in the year, Beckwith drove Joe Holloway-trained Sheer Terror in the Paul Revere Pace at Plainridge, finishing third.

Now on Saturday, he will drive in his first race with a six-figure purse. Semi Tough will start from post 8 and is 12-1 on the morning line. Tattoo Artist, coming off a second-place finish behind Charlie May in the W.R. Haughton Memorial last week at The Meadowlands, is the 5-2 favorite for driver Jason Bartlett and trainer Chris Ryder.

"In these races, the eight hole is never easy," Beckwith said. "Not many horses can win from the back against these types of horses. These horses can go a half [mile] in :54 and keep on going. But you've got to make do with what you've got."

Semi Tough, a 7-year-old son of Somebeachsomewhere—Jan It Jackson, has won seven of 20 races this year and earned \$143,280. He is owned by Burke Racing Stable, Frank Baldachino, J&T Silva-Purnel & Libby, and Weaver Bruscemi.

Twenty of his 30 career wins have come on a half-mile track, such as Saratoga.

"I'm excited," Beckwith said. "I'll try to do the best I can for the Burke crew. They're good people to drive for, and their horses are always ready to go. I think it will be a great race, just from the way it looks on paper. I think it will be action-packed."

Tattoo Artist has won 32 of 83 lifetime races and earned \$2.04 million. The son of He's Watching—Stylish Artist is owned by Let It Ride Stables, Frank Cannon, Diamond Creek Racing, and Bottom Line Racing.

The only other trainer with the chance to win the Gerrity for a second time is Ron Burke, who sends out Hellabalou (3-1), This Is The Plan (6-1) and Semi Tough (12-1). Drivers with the chance to win a second are Joe Bongiorno with Hellabalou, Mark MacDonald with Funatthebeach N (8-1) and Jordan Stratton with Covered Bridge (9-2).

TATTOO ARTIST AIMS FOR REPEAT

In the 13-year history of the Joe Gerrity Jr. Memorial, there has never been a horse, driver or trainer win the race more than once.

A victory by Tattoo Artist on Saturday would put an end to all that.

Tattoo Artist, who won last year's Gerrity for trainer Chris Ryder and driver Wally Hennessey, returns to this year's race as the 5-2 morning-line favorite for Ryder and driver Jason Bartlett. Although Bartlett did not drive Tattoo Artist last year, he did win the Gerrity in 2015 with P H Supercam.

Bartlett and Tattoo Artist will start Saturday from post 3.

A 6-year-old stallion, Tattoo Artist heads to the Gerrity off a second-place finish behind Charlie May in the William R. Haughton Memorial last week at The Meadowlands. He has a win and three seconds in five starts since returning from a one-month layoff following the Borgata Series in April.

"He wasn't himself in the Borgata," Ryder said, referring to Tattoo Artist's one win in five preliminary rounds and third-place finish in the event's consolation race. "After the Borgata, we freshened him up and changed his program around. We put him on Lasix, too, which has helped him. Now, he's back to himself."

Since his return, Tattoo Artist has won a conditioned race and been second in the #SendItIn Invitational at Harrah's Philadelphia, Gold Cup Invitational at Woodbine Mohawk Park, and Haughton. His only off-the-board finish was a fifth in the Dave Brower Memorial from post 10 at The Meadowlands.

In the Haughton, Tattoo Artist raced on the outside for the entire mile. He was eighth at the quarter, seventh at the half, and a three-wide sixth at three-quarters, but rallied to take the lead in the stretch. Charlie May, though, found an opening along the pylons nearing the finish and got up for the victory.

"I thought we were home," Ryder said, adding with a laugh, "I like Charlie May, but not to beat me when I think I'm a winner."

Trained by Clair Umholtz and owned by Umholtz and Kennedy Racing it was the first win in two starts for Flyin Bullets who has earned \$25,000 this year.

Fearless Ginger finished second with Sarah Said third.

Ohio Sires Stakes action continues Saturday (July 22) at MGM Northfield Park with one division of 3-year-old colt pacers. First race post time is 6 p.m.

Anthony MacDonald and Jason McGinnis teamed up to win two of the four \$20,000 divisions of the Buckeye Stallion Series for freshman filly trotters at MGM Northfield Park Wednesday night (July 19). MacDonald drove **Purplepeopleater** and **Sedona Hill** to wins.

Midnight Nolan and Kurt Sugg took the lead past the quarter pole in the first division and cruised to a three-length victory in a new lifetime mark of 1:57.1. It was the second win in as many starts for the son of Uncle Peter. Both wins have been in the Buckeye Stallion Series. Midnight Nolan has earned \$20,000 for trainer Dan Walski and owner Walski Stable.

Hips Like Honey finished second with Gabbys Treasure third.

In the second division, **Butter N Syrup** and Dan Noble took the pocket trip, swung wide around the final turn, and drew away by four lengths to win for the first time in 1:59.1. Butter N Syrup is trained by Miles Wollam and owned by Dark Horse Farm.

Osaka Hall was second with Elisdreamgirl finishing third.

MacDonald won the first of his two BSS races in the third division. He raced Purplepeopleater to the lead going gate-to-wire winning by three lengths in 1:59.3. McGinnis trains the What The Hill filly for the ownership group of Thestable Purplepeopleatr and Hutchison Harness.

MERRIMAN DOMINATES OHSS TROTTING **ACTION**

Aaron Merriman found the winner's circle three times in four Ohio Sires Stakes races Tuesday (July 18) at Eldorado Scioto Downs. Merriman swept both \$55,000 divisions for freshman colt trotters and one of the \$55,000 divisions for filly 2-yearold filly trotters.

In the first of two races for the colts and geldings, Royal **Precedent** with Merriman claimed the lead going to the first quarter as race favorite Tennessee Tom with Chris Page went off stride. Royal Precedent gave up the lead briefly to Rose Run Zoom and Don Irvine Jr., but quickly retook heading to the half. The gelded son of Creatine had to fight off a late charge from Tt's Magnum Force and Jason Thompson, holding on to win by a head in 1:57, a new lifetime mark. It was the second win in three starts for the Sam Schillaci trainee. Owned by the Claude Gendreau Stable, Royal Precedent has earned \$40,750 this year.

Tt's Magnum Force was second with Rose Run Zoom third.

In the second division. Merriman piloted Spaaaanzano to his second Ohio Sires Stakes win of the year. Spaaaanzano raced to the lead and never looked back, going gate-to-wire to win

in 1:57. It was the third win in as many starts for the son of Coraggioso. Chris Beaver trains and co-owns with Spaaaartners, Bill Manes, and Leo Fleming. Spaaaanzano raised his earnings to \$122,500 with the victory.

Commander Tom finished second with A Million In Coins third.

On the filly side, Merriman collected his first sires stakes win of the night as he took **Possibility** wire-to-wire to win in 1:56. Trained by Beaver, it was the first win in three starts for Possibility. The daughter of What The Hill is co-owned by Beaver, WJ Donovan, Joe Sbrocco, and Mark Moger. Possibility has earned \$55,500 this year.

She's Spicy was second with Sister Wives finishing third.

Sugar Instead made it two-for-two in sires stakes starts. Sugar Instead with Ronnie Gillespie settled into the third spot through the first half mile. Heading up the backstretch Gillespie took the Volstead filly to the lead, holding on to win in a new lifetime mark of 1:56.2. Trained by Virgil Morgan Jr. and owned by Joyce McClelland and Larry Wills, Sugar Instead has won two of three this year, earning \$85,000.

Chapercraz destroys Buffalo Raceway record

Hopefully Buffalo Raceway officials have erasable ink for the record book.

After Deswanslittlelorie set the all-aged trotting record at Buffalo Raceway this past Saturday night (July 15) in a time of 1:55.3, Wild Bill Kelso came to town on Wednesday afternoon (July 19) and tied that mark with a length victory in a New York Sire Stakes event for 3-year-old colt and gelding trotters.

As impressive as that was, Chapercraz (Ronnie Wrenn Jr.) wasn't going to be outdone.

Within 90 minutes of Wild Bill Kelso's etching of his name into the record book, Chapercraz came along with a huge eraser and posted an eye-popping 1:54.2 in his \$57,000 division of the New York Sire Stakes for the sophomore male trotters to take the all-aged trotting mark.

The clocking by Chapercraz obliterated Wild Bill Kelso's newly minted all-aged time of 1:55.3 by over a second. It also set the Buffalo Raceway standard for 3-year-old gelding trotters of 1:56.1 set by Gural Hanover back on June 29, 2014.

It was only the second career victory for the gelding Chapercraz (Crazy Wow-Chaperess). The victory pushed his seasonal earnings to an astounding \$238,152 in 10 outings in 2023 after just making \$4,772 in one start in 2022.

Chapercraz (\$2.10) had absolutely no issues in pounding the field into submission. Quickly gaining the lead, Chapercraz put up fractions of :29.1, 57:3 and 1:25.4 over the lightning-fast track. Owning a 10-length advantage at the top of the stretch, Wrenn Jr. just let Chapercraz do his thing and breezed to a 13-3/4 length victory over You Got It (Niko Karna) while Expresso (Tyler Miller) was third.

Owned by the Burke Racing Stable, Weaver Bruscemi and Phillip Collura, Chapercraz is trained by Ron Burke.

In the first division for the males, it appeared Wild Bill Kelso (\$2.50) was going to be the star of the day. Racing to a big five length advantage to the opening quarter mile in :28.4, Wild Bill Kelso (Jim Morrill Jr.) put up fractions of :57 and 1:26.1 but had Onion Gum hounding him in the pocket. Things remained status quo however as Wild Bill Kelso held back Onion Gum (Jordan Stratton) by a length while Some Kinda Crazy (Marcus Miller) collected the show position.

The time of 1:55.3 put Wild Bill Kelso in the record book temporarily but eventually she would have to be happy with the \$27,950 first place check. The win was the second in six attempts this season for the gelded Wild Bill Kelso (Crazy Wow – Broadway Joe Ell). Owned by the Runthetable Stables, he is trained by Jim Campbell.

The two divisions of the New York Sires Stakes for the 3-yearold fillies were also drama filled.

Woolco (\$12.20) took the first leg as she watched as All The Rage (Stratton) set the tempo with times of :28.3, :58.3 and 1:28.3. The chalk in the meantime, Usosweet, was on a break and lost any hope from the beginning.

Hitting the final marker, Morrill Jr. had Woolco first over on the rim and eventually reached the lead, beating Pride N Joy (Karna) by a half-length in 1:58 with All The Rage settling for third.

Owned by the Hero Stables and trained by Robert Krivelin, it was the third win in four attempts for Woolco (Chapter Seven – Upside Hanover). The score jacked her 2023 bankroll to \$53,500 and \$161,924 lifetime.

The other \$56,000 (approx.) division for the damsels saw **Point** Reyes (Wrenn Jr.) stalk the pace setting On The House (Marcus Miller) just about the entire mile before nudging past in the shadow of the wire to collect the \$16.50 upset by a nose in 2:00.1. Bourbon On Ice (John Stark Jr.) was third.

Notching splits of :29.2, 1:00.0 and 1:30 .3, On The House battled every step of the way but eventually lost out to Point Reyes by a mere nose in the photo finish.

Co-owned by Tom Vassiliou and Nicholas Tallarico, Point Reyes (E L Titan-Sausalito) is conditioned by Nifty Norman. The victory was the second in seven appearances this year for Point Reyes, now a winner of \$43,065 on the campaign and \$100,290 lifetime.

In the two \$20,000 Excelsior Series events for the male sidewinders, Met Your Request (\$4.40, 1:58.2) and Seven Sins (\$15.60, 1:58.1) were victorious while on the ladies' side, **Serendipity** (\$5.20, 1:58.1) and **Destiny's Darling** (\$4.40, 1:58.3) all made trips to the winner's circle.

The final two cards of the 2023 season at Buffalo Raceway are set for today (July 21) and Saturday. The 13-race program on Friday begins at 2:30 p.m. while the finale on Saturday gets underway at 6 p.m. with another 13-race card slated.

Freshman trotting fillies show talent at Philly

There's an old adage that "Rainy days and drunken grooms make good racehorses," meaning that a horse left to her own natural ability will frequently have the best chance of success. This attitude was prevalent during the second preliminary of the Pennsylvania-sired program on Wednesday afternoon (July 19) at Harrah's Philadelphia, as many of the 2-year-old trotting filly winners were either pointed to the top and went on to victory, or were moved first-over and went on to the triumph.

After four divisions of the day's \$162,948 sire stakes action, **Sierra Girl** was the only two-time PASS winner after a 1:56.2 mile for trainer/driver Åke Svanstedt and the partnership of Åke Svanstedt Inc., Young Guns, and Joe Sbrocco & JAF Racing. This daughter of Bar Hopping—Chuckys Luckycharm was one of the few winners not using the two routes described above, instead sitting third on the rail and coming up nicely along the inside in the stretch to tally.

Fastest winner of any baby miss succeeding in a stake was the Fordham Road—A Little Laid Back filly, Little Town Road who dominated her field on the lead while lowering her mark to 1:55.1. Driver Brady Brown, having an excellent year with freshman trotters in all corners of the state, sulky sat for trainer/owner/legend Roger Hammer while running her purse record to 3-for-5.

The other two PASS divisions were taken by daughters of Father Patrick. **The Moment** (dam Myimpossibledream) grinded

to a 1:56.1 maiden success for driver Tim Tetrick, trainer Lucas Wallin, and owners Al Libfeld, Marvin and Lynn Katz, and San Goldband, while **Paulina Hanover** (dam Personal Style) was successful from the front in her purse debut in 1:57, with Andrew McCarthy driving for trainer Noel Daley and owner Mario Mazza.

There were seven \$20,000 divisions for the stallion series fillies, with the only repeater in the class also being a daughter of Bar Hopping, **Tequini Hanover** (dam Tangent). She won in 1:57.4, a new mark, for the hot combo of driver Tim Tetrick and Lucas Wallin, with Wiesman Farms LLC and Pieter Delis sharing ownership with the trainer.

There were a pair of 1:56.4 maiden wins tying for fastest in the stallion series action: from **Fannie Lipkowitz** (Greenshoe—Ma Was Right), another success for the Tetrick/Wallin connection and for owners Wallin and Sherman Stables, and from **Norma Pearl** (Father Patrick—Celebrity Obsesion), brought home by David Miller for trainer Ron Burke and the partnership of Burke Racing Stable LLC, Knox Services Inc., Lawrence Karr, and J&T Silva- Purnel & Libby.

She was driven by Andrew McCarthy for J. Mark Egloff Jr., Max J. Hempt, Philip Scott Racing Stable, and Thomas Biederman.



North America Cup winner It's My Show headlines Adios field of 17

Pepsi North America Cup winner, It's My Show, headlines a field of 17 top 3-year-old pacers for the \$450,000 Delvin Miller Adios Pace for the Orchids at Hollywood Casino at The Meadows. Two \$25,000 eliminations (races 7 and 8) are set for Saturday (July 22), when the card begins at 12:45 p.m. while the final goes on Adios Day, Saturday (July 29), with a first post of 11:45 a.m.

It's My Show (Sweet Lou—Put On A Show) is undefeated in six starts this year, including that impressive 1:47.4 North America Cup victory. He leaves from post 3, race 8, with Scott Zeron driving. He'll be joined in the field by his stablemate, Fulton (race 7, post 7, Dexter Dunn), last year's Pennsylvania juvenile champion. It's My Show and Fulton give trainer Linda Toscano a formidable one-two punch.

Meadows-based trainer Ron Burke, the sport's all-time leading conditioner, will be represented by four horses: Gung Ho (race 7, post 4, Yannick Gingras), Act Fast (race 7, post 9, Chris Page), Ervin Hanover (race 8, post 5, Gingras) and Loubet (race 8, post 8, Gingras).

Updates to Jimmy Freight Stakes conditions

Following review and consultation with industry stakeholders, Woodbine and Adriano Sorella have adjusted the conditions for the inaugural \$100,000 Jimmy Freight Stakes.

The event, scheduled for Oct. 7 at Woodbine Mohawk Park, is open to any 2-year-old colt, gelding or filly sired by Jimmy Freight, with no nomination fee or starting fee required.

Following conversations with owners and trainers, Woodbine and Sorella have opted to remove the conditions requiring horses to have earned a minimum of \$10,000 and made a minimum of two starts at Woodbine Mohawk Park for eligibility to enter.

In addition, the minimum number of entrants needed for the race to proceed has been lowered from eight to five. Should less than five horses enter, the race will be cancelled.

In the event the race is cancelled, Sorella will still distribute the full \$100,000 purse, dividing it between the top-five earning horses sired by Jimmy Freight in 2023. The breakdown is \$50,000, \$25,000, \$12,000, \$8,000 and \$5,000.

"My goal dating back to the first announcement of this race in 2019 was to support Jimmy Freight as a stallion and get this race off the ground," said Sorella. "It is very important to me that those who supported Jimmy and spent their money to breed, raise, buy, and train his sons and daughters are rewarded. I'm optimistic these updates to the conditions will allow us to have this race go on Oct. 7."

Should more than 10 horses enter the Jimmy Freight Stakes, the 10 highest earners will be deemed the starters.

The entry box for the Jimmy Freight Stakes will close on Tuesday (Oct. 3) at 10:30 a.m.

Oh, what a (Meadowlands Pace) night!

It wasn't late December back in '63, but just last Saturday (July 15) when The Meadowlands management, fans and horsemen might have been heard singing "Oh, What a Night."

Meadowlands Pace Night 2023 was filled with tremendous action from start to finish — both on the track and at the windows — and during a 14-race card where favorites failed 79 per cent of the time, two public choices turned in what were arguably the most impressive performances of the night.

First up was Sylvia Hanover, whose parked-out-at-every-call masterpiece in the \$169,000 Mistletoe Shalee for 3-year-old fillies on the pace gave the daughter of Always B Miki—Shyaway her 12th win from 13 career starts.

"What a Lady, what a night."

The Mark Steacy-trained, Bob McClure-driven miss, who returned \$3.00 to win as the 1-2 favorite, did this in what was her first start ever outside of Woodbine Mohawk Park, and, after a three-week layoff as well, since her score in the Fan Hanover at her home track in Campbellville, ON.

In the \$668,000 featured Meadowlands Pace for 3-year-olds, Confederate delivered as an equally heavy public choice as his sister-event counterpart, stopping the teletimer in a lifetime-best 1:47 after powering up to the lead coverless around the far turn, before sprinting clear of his foes by 3½ lengths. Did winning driver Tim Tetrick say: "I felt a rush like a rollin' ball of thunder"? It's unclear.

The win gave trainer Brett Pelling a record-extending fifth Big M Pace victory while Tetrick added a sixth Pace trophy to his mantle, meaning he is now just one behind John Campbell, whose seven Pace wins are still tops among drivers.

The evening also saw a pair of heavily favored 1-5 shots from the Ake Svanstedt stable taste defeat for the first time in a long time, as Bond finished third in one of two divisions of the \$105,250 Del Miller Memorial for 3-year-old trotting fillies, ending her winning streak at nine, while Jiggy Jog S failed in her bid for a ninth straight score after getting gunned down by M-M's Dream in the \$410,250 E.T. Gerry Jr. Hambletonian Maturity.

Harness Racing Update

"We had great performances all night long on Meadowlands Pace Night," said track chief operating officer/general manager Jason Settlemoir. "Exciting racing, full fields and unpredictable finishes led to a tremendous night of business."

All-source wagering on the 14-race card totaled \$5,672,535, the biggest number on Pace Night in 17 years, when wagering was just over \$6 million in 2006.

Since 2009, only twice has betting busted the \$5-million barrier, the other being 2020, when \$5,051,261 was put in play.

The \$5.6 million wagered Pace Night was an industry 2023 best and represented a 20 per cent increase over a year ago, when just over \$4.7 million in action was taken.

Adding a third 50-cent Pick-4 to the betting menu proved to be a smart move, as the three Pick-4s took in action of just over \$450,000, with the All-Stakes P4, featuring The Meadowlands Pace as the payoff leg, took in \$180,638.

"What happened on Saturday was the result of many factors coming together," said Settlemoir. "Gov. [Phil] Murphy and the New Jersey State Legislature's continued support of the horse racing industry in the Garden State is first and foremost. Handle on The Meadowlands has exploded since the Governor signed the appropriation bill in February of 2019, bringing enormous attention to New Jersey, and vaulting The Big M to become the most popular nighttime signal in North America, regardless of breed.

"Add in the support of our horsemen and top it off with our national telecasts on the networks of Fox Sports and you get a complete picture of how our success has come to pass. We are optimistic that we can keep this momentum through Hambletonian Day (Aug. 5) and beyond."

THE MARKET IS UP: The \$100 million appropriation that Gov. Murphy signed into law in 2019 creates a hard line between levels of action at The Big M.

Betting on the 2018 Meadowlands Pace was \$536,305, while Saturday night, the total wager on the race was \$821,356. The increase? A whopping 53 per cent.

Total action on the 2018 Pace Night card was \$4,083,401, so Saturday's handle represents an uptick of 39 per cent.

And what about the races shown live on Fox Sports 1 (FS1)?

The previous editions of the Hambletonian Oaks, Hambletonian and Meadowlands Pace saw a total handle of \$1,904,214.

The three most recent Oaks, Hambletonian and Pace, which were all shown live on the networks of Fox Sports, took in a total of \$2,656,317, an increase of 39 per cent.

FABULOUS FRESHMEN: Another key to lengthening the Garden State's harness racing lifeline is the renewed interest in breeding — thanks in part to the appropriation — and action on last Friday's (July 14) program, when 12 of the 14 dashes were for 2-year-old New Jersey Sire Stakes competitors.

As recently as 2017, the night before the Meadowlands Pace did less than \$2 million in total handle. Last week, wagering topped \$3 million despite many horses making their first-ever parimutuel starts.

"I can't begin to tell you what an extraordinary number \$3 million on our baby races is," said Settlemoir. "Gov. Murphy and The NJ. State Legislature helped bring the world to New Jersey. Their efforts made the \$8.6 million bet during Pace weekend a reality."

NATIONAL EXPOSURE: The remaining schedule for when The Meadowlands' races will be shown on either FOX, FS1 or FS2 is as follows (with highlighted races):

- Saturday, Aug. 5 (FOX, 3-6 p.m.; FS2, 6-7 p.m.; Hambletonian post time, 4:45 p.m., Hambletonian Oaks plus other stakes for total purses of \$3.5 million)
- Sunday, Aug. 6 (Hambletonian replay show on CBS Sports Network, 2 p.m.)
- Friday, Sept. 8 (FS1, 9-11 p.m.; New Jersey Classic Series finals)

"All of us at The Meadowlands have been so pleased with the partnership we have with the TV crew at The New York Racing Association (NYRA)," said Settlemoir. "They, along with the team at Fox Sports, put out a first-rate product on a show that is normally seen, in large part, by a thoroughbred-centric audience. These shows have helped us display our competitive harness races to a fan base who now might be more likely to follow harness racing in addition to the runners."

HAMBLETONIAN COUNTDOWN: On Saturday (July 29), the highlighted races on The Big M card will be eliminations for the \$500,000 Hambletonian Oaks and \$1 million Hambletonian. Then, one week later, harness racing's biggest day of the calendar year takes place on Hambletonian Day, Saturday (Aug. 5), with a special first-race post time of noon.
