





Maximum Security's trainer Jason Servis was sentenced to four years in prison on Wednesday (July 26) as part of the government's sweeping crackdown on horse doping at racetracks across the country.

The sentence handed down in U.S. District Court in New York was the maximum that Servis could have received. He pleaded guilty in December to two crimes, a felony and a misdemeanor, for violating misbranding laws regarding his use of a compound chemical called SGF-1000, the bronchodilator clenbuterol and of a more potent version of clenbuterol.

Servis, a 66-year-old resident of Jupiter, FL, was sentenced to three years for the felony and one year for the misdemeanor. Judge Mary Kay Vyskocil ordered the sentences to run consecutively.

Servis, wearing a suit and tie, stood at the defense table as the sentence was imposed. He offered no reaction as his attorney Rita Glavin stood next to him with her hand on his shoulder.

Vyskocil rejected Glavin's argument that Servis' conduct was not as bad as other trainers snared in the doping case. She contended those trainers admitted to using more potent illegal drugs that were more dangerous to horses.

Indeed, Vyskocil said even four years might not be long enough given Servis' prominence in the horse racing industry. Four years was the most she could impose, however.

"In my judgement, more than a 48-month sentence might be more appropriate," the judge said.

Vyskocil said Servis sent owners bills disguising the use of SGF-1000 as "acupuncture and chiropractic." Prosecutors say SGF-1000 was an injectable drug compounded and manufactured in unregistered facilities that contained growth factors to make horses run faster.

"You chose to do that," the judge told Servis. "Nobody tricked you into doing that."

Vyskocil said when New York State troopers interviewed Servis, he lied when he said he gave SGF-1000 to only four or five horses.

She said he had admitted that virtually all the horses in his stables had been given the substance, including Maximum Security who was the first place finisher in 2019 Kentucky Derby (Grade 1) at Churchill Downs but was disqualified for jockey interference during the running of the race.


The judge said Servis administered clenbuterol to horses without a prescription and in violation of racing rules.

She also said Servis obtained the more potent clenbuterol from "notorious juicer" Jorge Navarro, a New Jersey trainer who was a co-defendant with Servis in the case. Navarro was sentenced to five years in prison in 2021.

Vyskocil quoted from a wiretap in which Servis told his assistant trainer that he had to keep Maximum Security on the clenbuterol he got from Navarro.

"Then you lied to Maximum Security's owner," the judge said, quoting from an email exchange Servis had with the owner Gary West before the running of the \$20 million Saudi Cup in the Middle East in February 2020, just a month before his arrest.

Maximum Security won that race. Shortly after Servis' arrest, Saudi Cup officials announced that the winning purse of the Saudi Cup was being withheld pending an investigation.

"Just an FYI, Max has never been on anything out of the ordinary," Servis told West.

She also quoted West as begging Servis not to give Maximum Security anything that would risk a disqualification in the Saudi Cup.

The email chain was made public last week as an exhibit to a government sentencing submission.

The chain begins with West telling Servis to "consult whoever you need to consult to be 100 per cent certain we don't have any kind of accidental drug violation. If you have to feed Max just hay and organic carrots for a month before the race, do that too!!!"

West then said, "I would feel horrible to win a life-changing race like this for everyone only to find out we didn't do something right because we didn't know. I will gladly pay for any reasonable consulting work we need to have done to be sure we are 'squeaky clean' for the race."

After Servis responded that the horse was never on anything illegal, West said in response, "That is great but 'over there' they might consider a 'sugar cube' illegal. I am not smart enough to know."

"Instead, you gave the horse illegal performance-enhancing drugs," Vyskocil told Servis.

Prosecutor Sarah Mortazavi urged the judge to sentence Servis to more than three years in prison but less than the max.

Glavin appealed for a sentence of less than three years.

"We are disappointed in the sentence, particularly because both probation and the government recommended a lesser sentence than what was imposed," Glavin said after court. "Our view remains that Mr. Servis' criminal conduct was less egregious than other trainers who received lesser sentences.

"Mr. Servis is deeply remorseful and he remains eternally grateful to the many owners, colleagues and friends who, along with his family, provided him with unwavering support throughout this ordeal."

Invited on Wednesday to address the court, Servis broke down in tears but then declined an offer to take a break.

When he composed himself, he said to Vyskocil, "No words can express how remorseful and sorry I am for the decisions I've made and the hurt I caused my wife, my two sons and others in my family."

Vyskocil ordered Servis to forfeit \$311,760 and to pay restitution in the amount of \$163,932. She also ordered him to pay a \$30,000 fine.

Servis remains free on bail until he reports to prison Nov. 1.

He brought his wife of 45 years, Natalie, and two sons to court with him. Also present were the girlfriends of the two sons and a long-time neighbor.

Servis also submitted 37 letters of support some of them from horse owners, including Joseph Imbesi and Dennis Drazin.

Drazin, chairman and CEO of Darby Development, operator of Monmouth Park, wrote that it was "noteworthy to consider that there was widespread use of SGF-1000 amongst trainers and vets in this country before New York Racing put a warning on it overnight in September 2019."

Mortazavi told the judge Servis was not acting in good faith when he used SGF-1000 on his horses.

"He continued to use it up to the time of his arrest, knowing regulators had prohibited it," she said.

She said that Servis in the defense sentencing memo "spent a considerable amount of time throwing veterinarians under the bus."

Servis had maintained that the vets who worked for him had advised him that SGF-1000 was legal.

Mortazavi said the defense argument that none of Servis' horses tested positive for clenbuterol just "shows how hard it is to catch someone who is cheating."

Glavin told Vyskocil the clenbuterol from Navarro was inexcusable and her client knows that.

"The remorse he feels cannot be expressed for what it has cost him," she said.

"He didn't shock with a shock machine. He didn't milkshake," Glavin added.

"We submit there is a qualified difference compared to what other trainers were involved in and what they did which was beyond the pale," the lawyer said.

Glavin also blamed Navarro for Servis' trouble.

"The greatest regret in his life is that Navarro ended up in the barn next to his," she said. Servis and Navarro had barns next to each other for years at Monmouth Park.

After imposing the sentence Vyskocil again addressed Servis.

"I do accept your several expressions of remorse," the judge said. "Relatively speaking, you are not an old man. You will have a life after you get out of prison."


To which Servis replied, "Thank you."

Equibase records indicate Servis won 1,306 races from 5,281 starts over a career that began in 2001. His stable earned a then-best \$4.9 million in 2017 before growing in subsequent years and exploding to \$11 million in 2019.

Damian Williams, the United States Attorney for the Southern District of New York, issued a statement following the sentencing praising the investigative work of the Federal Bureau of Investigation New York Field Office's Eurasian Organized Crime Task Force and its support of the Bureau's Integrity in Sports and Gaming Initiative in its handling the horse-doping scheme.

"Today's sentence sends a clear signal to those in the racehorse industry that no one is above the law," Williams said. "Endangering the welfare of animals for profit will not be tolerated. Illegally doping racehorses is a serious crime that will be met with a serious sentence."

### **Back in time**

The 2023 Hambletonian will go off at 4:45 p.m., almost two hours earlier than in 2022.

The Hambletonian was first raced at The Meadowlands in 1981. In the years since then — just over four decades — the off time for the final, second heat or race off, of America's trotting classic has been as early as 2:45 p.m., as late as 6:40 p.m., and anywhere in between.

According to the Hambletonian Society's director of publicity/ chief operating officer Moira Fanning, many factors come into play when choosing the proper placement for the Hambletonian and its companion race, the Hambletonian Oaks, including international simulcasting, viewership and wagering.

This year, after a long absence, the Hambletonian will return to one of television's big four networks — ABC, CBS, FOX and NBC — as part of Fox Sports' Saratoga Saturday, which airs on Aug. 5 between 3 and 6 p.m. with an estimated off time of 4:45 p.m.

"We have not been on a big-four network since 2011 and that opportunity was just too much to pass up," Fanning said. "And the timing is not horrible, it's actually good for Europe [who are six hours ahead] and good for the wagering spot as well to precede the Whitney [from Saratoga Racecourse at 5:43 p.m.]. So, you're going to get maximum viewership, maximum eyes, hopefully, maximum wagering, you know, as people are waiting for the lead-up to the Whitney."





The relationship between Jeff Gural, the president/chief executive officer of The Meadowlands and David O'Rourke, the president/chief executive officer of the New York Racing Association (NYRA), made shows like this possible, beginning with their first Meadowlands Pace broadcast two years ago on FS2 as explained here in a 2021 edition of HRU.

The off time for the Oaks was still being discussed at this publication's press time.

"With that massive type of audience being able to see the Hambletonian on Fox Sports, we felt that it was in our best interest and the sport's best interest, most importantly, to get out there in front of all those people from a national audience standpoint," said Jason Settlemoir, chief operating officer/general manager of The Meadowlands.

Fanning said she doesn't know the exact viewership expected on Hambletonian Day (Aug. 5) for Saratoga Saturday on Fox, however, when the Breeders Crown in October of 2022 was on FS2 on Saturday night, they had over 80,000 viewers.


"Remember, we were spread over maybe a four-or-five-hour timeline and people tuned in at different times, but that was a total viewership," Fanning said. "So, that's an impossible number to ignore, and that was FS2. So, it's a win-win in almost every consideration."

In the 40-plus years at The Meadowlands, off time for the Hambletonian has fallen into five different hourly timeframes, with the majority occurring between 4 and 5 p.m. Last year's 6:40 p.m. start was the latest ever at The Meadowlands and only the third time that the Hambletonian started after 6 p.m., including a three-horse race-off in 1981.

In addition to the live broadcast on Fox Sports and FS2, there will also be a replay show on CBS Sports Network from 2-3 p.m. on Sunday (Aug. 6).

"Before we knew the Fox and the NYRA schedule, we have a deal with CBS Sports where we have to commit to them, programming wise," Fanning said. "And our feeling there was that the Hambletonian should have a half an hour or an hour devoted to it. I love that it's on Fox as a cut-in for the Whitney in a lead-up to the Whitney, but it deserves its own showcase, in our opinion.

"And that is why we have kept the CBS show, even when it can't air live. We felt it was important to have a record of the 2022 and 2021 Hambletonian and Oaks as standalone events. So, it's important and especially in the context of trying to lead up to the 2025 hundredth Hambletonian. We wanted to keep that placeholder and try to get back on network with a standalone hundredth Hambletonian. And, you know, because of the constantly shifting networks, what's streaming, what's live, it's impossible to plan two or three years out."

The Hambletonian Day card is packed with stakes, but The Meadowlands has a lot to offer on Hambletonian Eve as well, with divisions of the Muscle Hill and Continentalvictory, two New Jersey Sire Stakes finals and the third leg of the Kindergarten in all four divisions.

"It's not rocket science," Settlemoir said. "We're trying to have a huge weekend for the culmination of our Championship Meet, which has been spectacular this year. I'm excited, obviously, about Saturday, Hambletonian Day, but I'm also excited about the night before. Quite frankly, I'm excited about this coming weekend,

too. And seeing the numbers that we did on Meadowlands Pace Night on FS1, I think it bodes well for Hambletonian Day.

"We're trying to have a big weekend to wrap up our Championship Meet, just the way that it should be here at the marquee track in the world. It should be a great weekend of racing. We just need Mother Nature to cooperate with us."











### Righteous Resolve goes from a controversial placing to Hambletonian Oaks elimination favorite

In a dozen lifetime starts, Righteous Resolve (3, 1:53s; \$528,203) had tasted defeat just twice: Her Ontario Sires Stakes Gold debut last July 3 at Georgian Downs and the Oct. 28, 2022 Breeders Crown final for 2-year-old filly trotters at Woodbine Mohawk Park. At age 3, the Resolve—Motown Muscle daughter began her season with a winning WMP qualifier on May 26, but ended up scratched sick from her 2023 pari-mutuel return, a June 13 OSS Gold leg at her home track.

Trainer Matt Bax said smoke from widespread forest fires further delayed her comeback last month. On June 7, the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) issued a notice recommending racetracks cancel training, qualifiers, and races if the air quality health index was in the high-risk range. Woodbine Mohawk Park canceled qualifiers and racing for Friday (June 30), moving the scheduled OSS Gold 3-year-old filly trot to July 6.

"Her having the respiratory sickness and the air quality, it definitely wasn't ideal, but she came out of it well," Bax said. "Anyway, she got the time that she needed. We talked to the owners about it. She wasn't quite 100 per cent, so you give them time and you hope they reward you later on."

July 6, Righteous Resolve was back with a vengeance, taking a new lifetime mark in what was also the fastest 2023 mile by a sophomore trotting filly in Canada. Teamed up with James MacDonald for the first time, the 2022 O'Brien Award winners were sent off as 1-5 favorites in the second leg of divisional OSS Gold at Mohawk. Biding her time in fifth to the hotly-contested :55.3 half, Righteous Resolve then tipped to follow Stonebridge Bravo from second over in pursuit of leader Baroness Hill. Gaining ground down the stretch, MacDonald's filly edged out Baroness Hill in a perfectly-timed 1:53 flat victory.





In the winner's circle afterwards, trainer Bax told WMP racing analyst Randy Waples, "She's a gritty filly, and you never know, coming off so much time off. I thought that we had her ready and that she was good. The trip worked out nice, and you can't say much more about that heart on her."

Righteous Resolve moved on to the third OSS Gold leg, making the lengthy journey from Bax's private Campbellville, ON training facility to Rideau Carleton Raceway July 16.

"She was strong last year and the last couple of weeks," said her trainer. "I just wanted to see how she came out of the Ottawa trip. It's not a real easy one for horses, and she did really well. So that kind of shows that she can travel well."

Her trip down the Rideau stretch would prove more problematic. Jody Jamieson, driving Climb The Pole in that race, told AGCO judges that he was not allowed to access the passing lane. Winner Righteous Resolve was placed second, and 15-1 longshot Climb The Pole was placed first in what remains a contentious result. MacDonald was also fined \$100 for not maintaining a straight course and obstructing the passing lane.

"We are appealing the decision," said Bax. "You know, the plugs were still in [Righteous Resolve's ears] and the horse [Climb The Pole] wasn't even to the wheel. She was well in hand, so it's pretty disappointing, but hopefully things work out in the end."

Meanwhile, the wheels were in motion for last year's top Canadian 2-year-old distaff trotter to take her biggest road trip yet. She has post 8 in the second of two Hambletonian Oaks eliminations this Saturday (July 29) at The Meadowlands.

"I feel that she's as good as any down there," said Bax. "You know, a [1]:53 mile up here [at Mohawk] is probably a [1]:51.2 mile at The Meadowlands. In my eyes, it's a second and a half faster. I don't really think she was as tight as she could be for that [July 6] race; that was her first start of the year. I was just training her at home, so I was really impressed that she went that big of a mile."

He added that a light schedule so far this season works to Righteous Resolve's advantage.

"It was kind of the plan," Bax said. "You take a little bit [of time] off at the start of the year, and hope that she has a lot more at the end of the year. I would have liked that one OSS start that she missed, but she [will have] three starts going into the Hambletonian Oaks [final, tentatively], and that's a good spot to be in. She's maybe a little fresher than some of the other ones that have a bunch of starts. I think she's trending upwards, not down."

Righteous Resolve is owned by Bet Max Stables Inc., Casco, MI and Benenati Inc., Clinton Township, MI. The ownership group also bred and raced her dam Motown Muscle (3, 1:53.4s; \$447,945), a 3-year-old Ontario stakes winner the same year that eventual Hall of Famer Bee A Magician (3, 1:51m; \$4,055,865) dominated the Hambletonian Oaks. The Muscle Mass mare is out of Bankers Jackpot (3, 2:00h; \$167,886), Bet Max/Benenati's Michigan-bred winner of 25 races from 36 career starts.

"They're great owners to have," Bax said. "They always say, 'Do what's best for the horse.' They really enjoy themselves, watching this filly [Righteous Resolve] race. They have a lot of fun at the track when they go... We're really happy that she could perform for them. They have a great maternal family there, all the way down. I don't know if they're pretty lucky or just that good, but they keep hitting good horses in that family."

Righteous Resolve and her stablemate, Hambletonian contender Southwind Coors (3, 1:52s; \$186,613), are New Jersey-bound this week.

"We'll take the two of them down for Friday," Bax said. "They'll go down to Mark Ford's and then travel the rest of the way on Saturday."

Plans are for the filly to return to Mohawk for OSS and Grand Circuit events after the Hambletonian Oaks, the race Bax called "the biggest goal" of her career so far.

He said she was essentially a more mature version of her O'Brien Award-winning 2-year-old self.

"Same old story, you know, a little bigger, a little stronger," he said. "She always was a nice, big, strong horse last year. She doesn't seem to have too many flaws."

Her steady temperament was a particular strength, in his view.

"She's pretty relaxed," Bax said. "She's got her paddock mate that she goes out with. I don't think you could fault her anywhere. She's a nice horse to be around. Actually, I'm holding her right now while she's getting new shoes on."

Bax admitted he was surprised to learn Righteous Resolve was the 2-1 morning line favorite in her Oaks elim.

"It doesn't matter at all, but I didn't think that they would give her or Southwind Coors [5-1 morning line in Hambletonian elim 1] the respect I thought they should get," Bax said. "I guess I was wrong."

James MacDonald is listed to drive both Saturday at The Meadowlands.

Righteous Resolve looks ready for revenge after her technicality-based defeat at Rideau Carleton.

"It was a big bonus that she trucked really well, and I would say she's even stronger than she was in her first start, so we're really happy going into Saturday," said Bax.







# Ontario 2-year-old pacing crop off to a rocketing start

Just a couple of years removed from that vaunted 2-year-old pacing group of Ontario-sired stars that included Bulldog Hanover, Lawless Shadow and Desperate Man, another crop is emerging that may end up fairly deep as well.

It's not even August yet and the 2-year-olds are just barely into the Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) schedule. Yet, Ontario's group of frosh pacers are right up there with the best from any other program. At the very top of that list is Mirage Hanover, who with a record of 1:50.4 taken last week in his OSS Gold division is currently the fastest 2-year-old in all North America.

By the U.S. and Canadian Hall of Famer Bettor's Delight who is still going strong in his 21st year at stud, Mirage Hanover was a \$175,000 buy from the 2022 Harrisburg Yearling Sale. Out of the classy and multiple OSS winner at 2 and 3, Mayhem Seelster, Mirage Hanover is a half-brother to 1:47.4 pacer Mad Max Hanover.

Last week's five-plus length 1:50.4 Gold win was Mirage Hanover's first career win in three starts, but it wasn't for lack of effort in his first two races. On debut at The Meadowlands at the end of June in a Geers stake, Mirage Hanover challenged first over off a slow half-mile and closed with a final quarter of :25.1 to come up just short against the odds-on favored Newsroom. He was further flattered when Newsroom laid over Kindergarten foes next out on July 7 in 1:51, a mile time that's still tied for fastest to date in the U.S.

It was just last year when Stockade Seelster set a 2-year-old OSS record with a 1:49.3 win in September, and if Mirage Hanover can continue to progress forward, he's already well ahead of comparable times from the same period of other recent OSS stars, including Bulldog Hanover.

Another top OSS prospect is Bettor's Delight gelding Do Better. In going wire-to-wire from the outside post 9 last week in his OSS Gold split in 1:51.3, Do Better ran his young career record to a perfect three-for-three for Hall of Fame trainer Bob McIntosh. That clocking is tied for seventh fastest across Canada and the U.S.

Fortune may have been on the side of Do Better in that recent win as two other potential OSS standouts each broke stride in that race. One of those was T H McMurry (McWicked), who prior to breaking in the first turn of that race, won his Gold division 11 days prior in a time of 1:51.4 in a race where he was used multiple times to make the lead past the half. Though just a \$22,000 buy from the 2022 London Classic Yearling Sale, his dam is the 1:49.2 millionaire mare and former OSS Super Final winner Waasmula. The other notable breaker in that race was Best Night Ever (Betterthancheddar), who looked menacing off the cones when he jumped it off around the final turn. A \$19,000 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale buy, he was just a length behind T H McMurry in that \$103,100 Gold division from June 10. Prior to that, he won on debut when he closed with a final quarter in :25.3.

On the female side, Ontario-sired Pass Line (All Bets Off) is currently tied for the third fastest mark in North America among freshman fillies. That time of 1:51.4 was set two weeks later when she ran her record to three-for-three in an OSS Gold leg before finishing third in last week's Gold leg. Comparing that fast time to last year, Sylvia Hanover won in a similar 1:51.2 also in late July, before lowering that mark as a 2-year-old twice into August and September.

In that race, both Pass Line and another promising filly Watching You (He's Watching), were at each other throughout the mile and each paid the price. That race was won by Odds On Platinum in 1:52.2, who is another Bettor's Delight, this one out of the great American Jewel. Coco Jo Jo (Betterthancheddar) just missed by a neck in that race and has now paced 1:52.2 in consecutive starts.

It's one thing to compare times, and it'll be interesting to see how these Ontario 2-year-olds stack up as the open stakes competition heads North in the coming weeks. If recent years are any indication, they should be able to hold their own just fine, and maybe then some.

### ON TO THE 3-YEAR-OLDS

The sophomore pacers take center stage Saturday (July 29) at The Meadows, highlighted by the \$114,770 Adioo Volo, and then a few races later with the 57th edition of the Delvin Miller Adios final for \$350,000.

Beginning with the Adioo Volo, an extremely competitive race, I'm presuming favoritism will go with Strong Poison out of the 9 hole. She just recently made her 3-year-old debut at the end of June, and it was a massive 1:48 win in the Nadia Lobell at Hoosier. From there, she was well backed last out in the Mistletoe Shalee against the likes of Sylvia Hanover and Twin B Joe Fresh, and loomed prominently around the final turn before order was restored and the top pair in that race came back on again. Fastest on paper, though the post could make things interesting depending on who wants to mix it up early.

It's one thing to compare times, and it'll be interesting to see how these Ontario 2-year-olds stack up as the open stakes competition heads North in the coming weeks. If recent years are any indication, they should be able to hold their own just fine, and maybe then some.

Many others here have mixed it up throughout the year already in Pennsylvania-sired racing. That includes Odds On Hail Mary who was a 1:49 winner over this track three races ago when she crushed Pennsylvania Sire Stakes (PASS) foes by over four lengths. She was second next out to Always B Naughty in another PASS race, though that was a race in which Always B Naughty got first run at a leader she was able to pass and Odds On Hail Mary could only close belatedly for the runner up. Daffled Hanover has overachieved throughout her PASS races this season. Vivian's Dream was second to Twin B Joe Fresh in New York last out. As trainer of Odds On Hail Mary and C Is For Cookie who is another contender from the rail, combined with her unbeaten in 2023 favorite in the Adios, it could be a big day for Linda Toscano.

The story in the Adios squarely revolves around It's My Show. Now seven-for-seven on the year after a powerful 1:47.4 elimination win last week, he'll be heavily backed once again to keep his winning ways intact. His elimination was his first start in over a month and despite that, he was still able to post the identical 1:47.4 clocking from when he won the North America Cup final in June. He's passed every test thus far and is well spotted once again.

Fellow elimination winner Cannibal will get a crack at It's My Show. Aside from that sixth-place finish in the Pace, Cannibal has won all other starts this year. His Adios elimination win was impressive, and the public support was correct in making him easily more favored over Fulton. Ken Hanover is an interesting type. Off a month layoff three back, he just missed in 1:48.2 to Christchurch, and in his elimination last week he wasn't that far off while tracking It's My Show all the way home. The post is bad, but the potential is there if Miller can work out a trip. Redwood Hanover flew late onto the scene in his elimination and he's done so similarly at this track earlier in the year; he can do it either way and we'll see what strategy is coming from MacDonald. Ervin Hanover blazed the way in his elimination before fading; he took a fairly decent amount of support last week. Palone gave Seven Colors an aggressive try in his elimination and it almost

worked out; likely back to closing now. Fulton was just okay in his elimination and now it's out to post 9.

### **IN CASE YOU MISSED IT**

It must be a PA harness thing. In December I wrote about the top two finishers in a race at The Meadows both being disqualified for pylon violations halfway through the race. That was topped Wednesday in what must be an unprecedented happening when the top three finishers were all disqualified in race 10 at Harrah's Philadelphia.

In the race, Trumpster Blues, driven by William Augustine at odds of 1-9 won the race by two lengths. Bettor's Ville, driven by Ivan Llopez, was second by another couple of lengths. And third-place finisher Flying Tiger was seven lengths clear of the fourth-place finisher.

After a review, it was determined that all three of those horses went inside pylons into the first turn of the race. Although it had zero bearing on the way the race was run or the outcome of the race whatsoever, rules are rules, and all three horses were disqualified.

As a result, the fourth-place horse at odds of 24-1 who lost by 11 lengths was placed first. Other huge longshots beaten by 11 and 13 lengths respectively were placed second and third, blowing up the toteboard.

The total amount wagered for the race was just over \$50,000. In situations like this where violations occur early in the race that have no impact on the final outcome, should the entire race result be turned upside down, or should it be dealt with solely through driver fines and suspensions? Doesn't it seem silly to have the official result and payouts in zero way reflect how the race was actually run?





# Hail Mary best in exciting Hugo Åbergs Memorial

The last Tuesday in July is synonymous with the \$310,000 Hugo Åbergs Memorial over the mile at Jägersro racetrack in Malmö, Sweden and Tuesday's (July 25) edition was an open story with several good trotters battling for the win behind the gate.

The draw pointed toward favoritism for Daniel Redén's **Hail Mary** (Googoo Gaagaa), paired with Örjan Kihlström and Hail Mary answered the question of who was going to win the Hugo Åbergs Memorial 2023.

The race turned out to be quite spectacular when Adrian Kolgjini decided to try his Ultion Face in front from post 1, while, from post 2, Önas Prince and his driver Per Nordström hunted for the same position. The battle between the two Jägersro horses ended with Ultion Face in front and Hail Mary on the outside after 500 meters.

Kihlström's move, sending Hail Mary first over, turned out to be decisive. Kihlström is a master at controlling his opponents from that position and Hail Mary has both speed and strength to manage a tough trip. So, when the field turned into the stretch, Hail Mary had disarmed the leader and Kihlström noticed that his two-to-three length advantage would be enough to claim the prestigious race for the fourth year in a row.

Kihlström won with Propulsion in 2016, 2017 and 2018, then with Double Exposure in 2020, Who's Who in 2021 and Don Fanucci Zet last year. The Propulsion victories are not victories any longer, by known reasons, but still, one must admire Kihlström's accuracy in this particular race.

Hail Mary won the Hugo Åbergs in 1:51.4 ahead of an insanely quick Vivid Wise As, who started his attack four wide from last position in the last turn. Hierro Boko, who beat Hail Mary in Mikkeli two weeks ago, was third.

The second \$155,000 Breeders Course final for 3-year-olds was won by a well-known duo in European stakes races. Paul Hagoort and Robin Bakker had Italian-bred **Ester Degli Dei** (Maharajah) in the race and the filly was undefeated after four attempts before the Tuesday final. The win wasn't completely undramatic though. Ester Degli Dei couldn't defend the front position shortly after the start, but when leader Noah Boko made a break after 600 meters, Bakker got the lead for free with Ester Degli Dei.

Ester Degli Dei defended herself bravely when outside trotter Eros Jet applied hard pressure on the backstretch and these two horses battled side by side, all the way toward the wire. Italian-bred horses dominated when the race was summed up.

Ester Degli Dei won in 1:55.2, Eros Jet was second and Everything Bi third. Alessandro Gocciadoro trains the runner up and the bronze medalist.

### ETONNANT WILL COME TO AMERICA

On Wednesday it was announced that Richard Westerink's top trotter Etonnant will enter the \$1 million International Trot at Yonkers in September.

Etonnant tried Yonkers already last year and Westerink is looking for revenge after the horse's break in 2022.

## Jogging a standardbred led Dawn Deaton to a career in harness racing

Dawn Deaton has become used to the routine, the one where tears of sadness are eventually replaced by tears of joy.

She has been around hundreds of standardbreds over her time in racing, a multi-faceted career that includes time as a trainer.

While each horse she has worked with sports a unique personality, her reaction when a horse leaves or comes into the barn she works at is always the same.

"I always cry when they leave," Deaton said. "I get very attached to them. It's hard to watch them go. You take care of them, and you know there will come the day when they have to move on. But as much as you shed tears, you know that another one will come in and you vary those happy tears, knowing you will be able to create a bond with them."

That unabashed love for horses is not a new discovery for Deaton.

Growing up in Cleveland, her childhood years included plenty of time around horses.

"I've always been crazy about horses," she said. "When I was a kid, it was horse camp in the summers and riding horses with friends every weekend. I don't think I ever wanted to do anything else except work with horses."

Her affinity for all things equine eventually led her to apply to Ohio State University's ATI (Agricultural Technical Institute) program, a two-year course she hoped would lead her to a career working with horses.

Those plans took an unexpected turn prior to her second collegiate year when she was offered an opportunity that gave her pause for thought.

Dawn Deaton said Risenshine Seaside is "one of my top-five favorites."

Little did she know, at the time, it would lead her in a direction she had never considered.

"You better have a lot of money if you are going to want a career riding horses because it's just not there," Deaton said with a laugh. "So, I switched programs to focus on breeding and that's how I became introduced to the standardbred side. It was a holiday break, and I didn't go home during the holidays. One of the guest instructors asked me if I wanted to jog a horse."

Deaton was momentarily lost for words.

"I had never jogged a horse before in my life," she said. "But then I did it and I was hooked for life from that moment. They are just the best breed in terms of versatility and being good-natured."

That experience prompted a major life decision for Deaton.

She could either stay in school for another year or pursue a racing career.

horses," she said. "It's not about winning, having the fastest horses or going to the big races. "It was my second year in college and I started having these thoughts of whether I wanted to stay or not," Deaton said. "You could get a job and learn just like you would in the classroom. [Ohio Hall of Fame trainer/driver] Tom Brinkerhoff said that he would give me a job 'and I'll teach you more than that school will and you'll get paid for it."

Deaton accepted the offer and worked for Brinkerhoff for two years. After she got pregnant, she ended up in Lebanon, OH, where she trained her first horse and began the conditioning side of her racing career.

Along with her now ex-husband, Dawn formed a successful stable.

The mother of three sons — two of them, Timothy and Ryan, drive and train — enjoyed her own personal highlights over a training career that began in 2006.

For the past eight years, she's worked as a groom in the barn of trainer Brian Brown.

"I used to gallop thoroughbreds in college, but when I met the standardbreds I knew that this is what I wanted to do," she said. "I've had my trainer's license since I was 23. I've had some good ones and some bad ones over the years, but I loved them all. I like the foaling and the breeding, but these racehorses are just so exciting to watch."

Horses like Dart Victory and PJs Legacy.

"Dart Victory was a horse that always gave 110 per cent every week," Dawn said. "He was probably the first really good horse I took care of. PJs Legacy, who was owned by Brian's wife, was a sires stakes filly, and she was a really nice horse."

Then there is Seafire.

The 3-year-old bay son of Downbytheseaside is 5-2-2 from nine starts in his career to date.

On July 1, at Scioto Downs, Seafire, with Ronnie Wren Jr. in the race bike, eked out a head win in 1:49.1 in a \$55,000 Ohio Sires Stakes race.

"He's one of the best horses I've ever taken care of in my life," Dawn said. "He is just so fast. I don't think we know just how fast he is yet."

Dawn knows what the future could hold for Seafire.

"Brian's owners are stakes owners," she said. "So, at 4, they move on to other homes. You cry and then you fall in love with the next baby that comes in. It doesn't matter to me if they are big earners or not. For me, I always feel connected to the personality of the horse. Not all of them are easy to work with and not all of them come to you looking like a star athlete."

Risenshine Seaside, another son of Downbytheseaside, is a prime example.

"He's one of my top-five favorites," she said. "He was the little, scruffy yearling, who had an abscess on his neck when he came in. After the first couple of months, I told Brian that I thought this was a really nice horse. He was tiny, but he just kept getting better and better. He just had this look in his eye that told me he was special. He's made almost \$250,000 in his career. So, you can't always judge a book by its cover. Every horse is special."

Which is what keeps Dawn coming back every day.

She knows what's waiting for her the moment she first sets foot in the barn.

"It's just love for the horses," she said. "It's not about winning, having the fastest horses or going to the big races. Don't get me wrong, I really do enjoy that, but when you walk in the barn and every head pops over the gate and they start nickering at you, that's when you are reminded that they love you like you love them."

Another reason to shed a happy tear.

"They really do have a profound effect on you," she said. "I'm used to it now. I know I'll cry when they leave, but I know I'll be smiling when a new one comes in."





# **Canadian standouts set for Scioto visit**

So Much More is another year older, and perhaps even another year better.

Already a two-time O'Brien Award winner, the 7-year-old female pacer went the quickest mile of her career  $-1:49.1-\mathrm{just}$  a month ago to win a preferred for fillies and mares at Woodbine Mohawk Park. She has nine victories in 19 starts this season after winning 16 times in 2022, a total that tied for second most among all pacers in North America.

She has faced male rivals 10 times this year at the preferred/ FFA level at Mohawk, winning three of those races and finishing second on four occasions.

"I think she's as good as she's ever been right now," said Don Beatson, an Ontario native who trains and co-owns So Much More with his son Kenneth and grandson Cole England. "She's been pretty tough. We've [raced the boys] on a pretty regular basis; you've got to go with the races you can get. But it's been fine. She's treated us very good."

On Saturday (July 29), So Much More will race outside of Canada for the first time in her 144-race career when she competes in the \$100,000 Cleopatra Invitational for older female pacers at Scioto Downs in Ohio. She will start from post 6 with driver Aaron Merriman and is 4-1 on the morning line. Grace Hill is the 3-2 favorite in the field of eight.

"We're really looking forward to it," Beatson said. "It will be a good race."

So Much More was scheduled to race in the U.S. in 2021 when the Breeders Crown was hosted by The Meadowlands, but after receiving a bye to the Mare Pace final, she was scratched from the event because of sickness.

"We were all set to go, we were all keyed up for that," Beatson said. "It was very disappointing."

She got to compete in last year's Breeders Crown final at Mohawk, where she finished third. So Much More also has finished third in three Roses Are Red finals during her career, including this year's final in June. That race was won by Grace Hill.

For her career, the daughter of Big Jim—Ladysai has hit the board 113 times and earned \$1.12 million in purses in U.S. dollars (nearly \$1.5 million Canadian).

"Most of them level off, but she's 7 now and just keeps going," Beatson said. "We're not surprised that she can beat horses and she can go with the boys, but the fact she keeps doing what she's doing, the way she performs week after week, is a bit surprising.

"I don't know how she does it; I guess she's built that way. She's got a good heart, good lungs, she's still sound. And she looks forward to racing. She loves to load up and go."

The Cleopatra is part of a 16-race Scioto card that also includes the \$100,000 #SendItIn Invitational for older male pacers. The event features another Canadian visitor, Linedrive Hanover, who is the 3-1 second choice on the morning line behind 5-2 favorite Charlie May.

Linedrive Hanover saw his 2022 season come to an end in July because of injury, but not before he became one of only two horses to win a race that included Horse of the Year Bulldog Hanover with a Canadian-record 1:49 triumph in the Juravinski Memorial Cup at half-mile Flamboro Downs.

He has started four races this year and enters the #SendItIn off back-to-back FFA victories at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

"I thought we had a top horse last year, and I think we've got a top horse this year again," said Anthony Beaton, who trains Linedrive Hanover for owners West Wins Stable, McKinlay & Fielding, and Mac Nichol. "We're very excited about the way he came back and he's been very sound so far this year. We just have to look after him as best we can.

"He's got a pretty steady dance card from here on out. We did skip The Meadowlands races (in July and August), but if this is a way to keep him a little fresher, we'll take our lumps missing those races and hopefully we can pounce on them at the end of the year."

Linedrive Hanover, a 5-year-old son of Betting Line—Lillian Hanover, has won 13 of 22 career races and earned \$355,307. He has finished worse than third only twice.

He set his career-best time of 1:47, just one-fifth of a second from equaling the fastest mile ever in Canada, on July 1 at Mohawk.

"I thought the horse deserved to have a good mark like that on his card," Beaton said. "He just never gets tired. I've never seen an animal with his energy level. He's got more energy than you can shake a stick at."

Linedrive Hanover will start Saturday from post 7 with Merriman in the sulky.

"He's looking good going into this race," Beaton said. "Obviously, we would have liked a better post, but at least we're in a starting spot. We're looking forward to a good race this weekend, and from here on out the rest of the year as well."

Charlie May, who finished third in last year's #SendItIn Invitational, enters this year's event off a 1:47.1 win in the William R. Haughton Memorial on July 15 at The Meadowlands.

### Bargain scores in \$106,300 NYSS at Batavia

A select group of six 2-year-old New York Sire Stake colt and gelding trotters were on hand at Batavia Downs on opening day Wednesday (July 26) in a single division vying for a \$106,300 purse and when the dust had settled, **Bargain** (Chapter Seven—Batoutahill) came away with the biggest check.

Titan Your Chip (Mark Macdonald) got the jump off the gate to grab the early lead. However, Bargain (James McDonald) also left and was motoring up the rim to the quarter and overtook the front just past that station. With horses in single file, Bargain trotted to the half in 1:00 when Chaplind (Trond Smedshammer) made a first-over move from third and was on the attack.

Chaplind drew close to Bargain at three-quarters and was almost even at the top of the stretch and that's where his bid failed. But the passing lane opened for the pocket-sitting Titan Your Chip and he came barreling down the lane towards the leader. Titan Your Chip was gaining ground all the way to the line, but Bargain stayed in control under minimal urging and trotted to victory in 1:59.3.

It was the third win in four lifetime starts for Bargain (\$2.80) who is owned by Christinatakter&Anderberg, Nancy Takter and Jaf Racing, Joe Sbrocco and R A W Equine. Nancy Takter trains the winner who was bred by Steve Stewart and Michael Andrew.

There were also three \$20,000 Excelsior series races on the card and all three were won in gate to wire fashion.

**Woweress** (Crazy Wow—Chaperess) scored a 7-3⁄4 length victory in 1:58.2 to claim his first lifetime win for driver Frank Affrunti. Woweress (\$7.20) is trained by George Ducharme for owner/breeder Purple Haze Stable.

Then **Tobern** (Crazy Wow—Bertaux) simply jogged by an 18-length margin to match his lifetime mark in his fourth win of the year for driver/trainer/owner John Stark Jr. Tobern (\$2.40), who remains unbeaten lifetime, was bred by Bernard White and Kristie Leigh Farm.

Finally, **Voss Blue Chip** (E L Titan—Angelita Hanover) led every step of the way en route to a three-quarter length win in 2:02, which was his initial career victory. Jim Morrill Jr. drove Voss Blue Chip (\$4.60) for trainer Jared Bako, who co-owns the gelding with Lady I Racing and Blue Chip Bloodstock, who also bred the winner.

## Camerican leads Tuesday's New York Sire Stakes winners at Yonkers

The New York Sire Stakes circuit was back at MGM Yonkers Raceway on Tuesday night (July 25) with three divisions for 2-year-old pacing fillies featured on the 10-race program.

**Camerican** (Jordan Stratton) won the fastest grouping, taking the \$51,300 final flight in 1:55.2. After dashing to the front from post 3 and hitting the quarter in :29.1, the half in :58.3 and the



three-quarters in 1:27.1, Camerican sprinted home in :28.1 to defeat a first-over Blue Point (Jason Bartlett) by two lengths, with So Well Dressed (Matt Kakaley) closing from second-over to come in third.

Ron Burke trains Camerican, who is by American Ideal and out of the Camluck mare Camille, for owners/breeders Burke Racing Stable LLC., Weaver Bruscemi LLC., M1 Stable LLC. and Jack Piatt III. Camerican has made four appearances thus far in her freshman season, winning twice and finishing second in her other two opportunities. Camerican, the 1-5 favorite, returned \$2.50 to win and keyed a \$5.70 exacta and a \$23.80 trifecta.

Back in the first \$50,400 split, **Peace Talks** (Bartlett) pulled out of the pocket to take charge heading to the :28.3 opening quarter and after putting up well-rated middle-half panels of :58.3 and 1:27.3, she pulled away in a :28.2 final quarter to win by 3 1/4 lengths in 1:56. I'm A Believer (Stratton) was the runner-up and Hunting Hula (Pat Lachance) came in third.

A daughter of American Ideal—Triple V Hanover, Peace Talks is trained by Chris Ryder for owners Henderson Farms, Jeffrey Bell, Fac Racing LLC. and Robert Mondillo. Bred by Donald Robinson, Michael Robinson, Steve Stewart and James Daut, Peace Talks, who sold for \$87,000 at last year's Lexington Selected Yearling Sale, broke her maiden in her third chance, and has now earned \$34,674 and paid \$7.50 to win as the 5-2 second choice. The exacta kicked back \$28.00 and the trifecta was worth \$72.50.

In the second \$50,400 section, odds-on favorite Bronx Barista (Mark MacDonald) was in front through fractions of :27.3,:57.1 and 1:25.2 but bore out badly on the final turn, handing the lead to pocket-sitter Highway Queen (Brett Beckwith) coming into the stretch. Highway Queen was unable to hold on either, though, as **Delightville** (Kakaley), who had raced in fourth and then third after tucking in from post 6, rallied by Highway Queen on the outside and went on to a two-length victory in 1:55.3. Highway Queen ended up second, with Fresh Legs (George Brennan) third.

Delightville is a Huntsville—D D Delightful filly and is a Travis Alexander-trained homebred for Fiddler's Creek Stables LLC. She has a record of 2-0-0 from three starts, sent her bankroll to \$40,935 and returned \$7.80 to win as the 5-2 third choice. The exacta and trifecta were \$24.40 and \$78.50, respectively.

a 1:56.4 victor for driver Tyler Buter, trainer John Butenschoen and owners Berg Bros. Racing LLC. and James Crawford IV, and **Sandy Court** scored in 1:58 for driver Jason Bartlett, trainer Mark Ford and owner Bay Pond Racing Stable.

It was an action-packed night of Ohio Sires Stakes racing at MGM Northfield Park Wednesday (July 26). Two \$55,000 divisions for freshman filly trotters were contested along with three \$40,000 divisions each for 2-year-old filly pacers and colt trotters. **Sugar Instead** continued to show her dominance over the filly trotters, while Downbytheseaside fillies dominated the filly pace.

Sugar Instead and Ronnie Gillespie made it three straight in the sires stakes. The daughter of Volstead made it look easy, grabbing the lead heading to the quarter pole and cruising to a five-length win in 1:56.4. Trained by Virgil Morgan Jr. and owned by Joyce McClelland and Larry Wills, Sugar Instead has earned \$112,500 in her freshman campaign winning three of four races.

Legacy Affair finished second with Roxanna third.

In the other division for filly trotters, **One Fancy Lady** and Don Irvine Jr. rolled up the backstretch from fourth, reeling in the leader Purplepeopleater at the top of the stretch and holding on to win by a head in 1:58. It was the first win in four starts for the Long Tom filly. One Fancy Lady is trained by Rosy Weaver who co-owns with Heartland Acres and Kabby D LLC. She raised her earnings to \$30,250 with the win.

Purplepeopleater was second with Maxine Hill third.

The 2-year-old filly pacing division was dominated by Downbytheseaside fillies. **Heartofthesea**, **Seaside Diva**, and **Flyin Bullets** all came home winners.

In the first division, heavy favorite Heartofthesea with Ronnie Wrenn Jr. raced to the lead at the quarter pole and stayed there winning by two lengths in 1:55. It was the second win in three starts for the Brian Brown trainee. Heartofthesea has earned \$44,800 this year for owners Country Club Acres, Wingfield Brothers, and David Van Dusen.

John's Shadow finished second with Seriously Fearless third.

The second division was a battle for Seaside Diva and Chris Page. After leading through the first half of the race, Seaside Diva gave up the top spot to Fearless Ginger and Chris Lems heading into the final turn. Around the final turn, Seaside Diva

fought back grabbing the lead and holding off a late charge by Fearless Ginger to win by a head in a new lifetime mark of 1:52.3. Seaside Diva has hit the board in four of five starts, winning two. Trained by Ron Burke and owned by the Burke Racing Stable, Weaver Bruscemi, Knox Services, and Let It Ride Stable, Seaside Diva has earned \$82,750 this year.

Fearless Ginger held on for second with Rose Run Zoey finishing third.

The final division for the freshman filly pacers went to Flyin Bullets who has won back-to-back sires stakes races. Flyin Bullets and Brett Miller were sixth at the half-mile marker, went three-wide up the backstretch, and finally grabbed the lead mid-stretch to win in 1:53.4, a new lifetime mark. It was the second win in three starts for Flyin Bullets who is trained by Clair Umholtz. Owned by Umholtz and Kennedy Racing, Flyin Bullets has earned \$45,000 this year.

Beautiful Lather was second with Venice Blue Chip third.

In the first of three divisions for the 2-year-old colt trotters, **Royal Precedent** and Aaron Merriman raced to the lead off the gate and fought off a late challenge from Deville Hill and Dan Noble to win by two lengths in 1:58.1. It was the second OSS victory for the son of Creatine who has won three of four starts for trainer Sam Schillaci. Owned by the Claude Gendreau Stable, Royal Precedent has earned \$60,750 this year.

Deville Hill held on for second with Irresistible Son finishing third.

In the second division, **Gypsy Hill** made his move to the sires stakes a successful one as he rallied down the stretch to win by a length in 1:58.2. The What The Hill colt with Anthony MacDonald trailed the leader E-Pass by sixth length as the three-quarter pole, but rallied around the final turn and down the stretch to win by a length in 1:58.2. It was the third win in four starts for the Jason McGinnis trainee who had previously won two legs of the Buckeye Stallion Series. Gypsy Hill has earned \$47,500 this year for Thestable Gypsy Hill Group and Hutchison Harness.

E-Pass finished second with Hung Over third.

The final division for the freshman colt trotters went to **Tennessee Tom** and Page. Page took the Long Tom colt to the lead off the gate and fought off a challenge around the final turn from Commander Tom to win by a length in 2:00.1. The Burke trainee has won twice in four starts, earning \$77,500 for the Burke Racing Stable, Weaver Bruscemi, Hatfield Stables, and Knox Services.

Rose Run Zoom was second, nipping Commander Tom at the wire.

Ohio Sires Stakes action continues Saturday night (July 29) at Eldorado Scioto Downs with the third leg for MGM Northfield Park with the second leg for 2-year-old colt and filly trotters and filly pacers.

After scoring in a new lifetime best of 1:51.3 last week, All Jk was another decisive winner and lowered her lifetime best to 1:51.2 after tonight's victory.

Sent off as the 1-5 favorite, All Jk wasted no time and left from post 5 to grab the early lead through the opening panel in :27.4. Lets Go Endofanera and John DeLong grabbed the pocket seat while Flirtin Fanera and Ricky Macomber Jr. were next in line third. All Jk coasted through fractions of :56 and 1:24.1 before being joined on the outside by Jada Caroline and Atlee Bender. Jada Caroline was able to reach the leader at the top of the stretch but All Jk found another gear late. Using a :27.1 closing panel, All Jk cruised to the wire three lengths in front of Flirtin Fanera while Jada Caroline held on for third. As the heavy betting favorite, All Jk returned \$2.60 at the betting windows.

With the win, All Jk remains undefeated in three starts this season. Owned by Country Club Acres, J. Sbrocco, M. Leeman

and T. Nichols, the daughter of JK Endofanera—Truth Above All has now earned \$73,000 in lifetime purse earnings in her young career. All Jk is trained by Brian Brown and was bred by Victory Hill Farm.

In the second division, **Teelatini** and driver John DeLong followed suit and continued their winning ways, scoring in 1:53.4. With the win, Teelatini remains undefeated through two rounds of Indiana Sires Stakes action.

Opting for a trip from off the pace, Teelatini was unhurried from the gate and settled along the rail in fifth. LeWayne Miller had Sunny Money marching away from the gate to grab the early lead through the opening panel in :27.3 with KB's Summer Breeze and Jordan Ross in the pocket. McKira and Joey Putnam wanted their turn on the front and grabbed command just past the half in :57.2. Approaching the three-quarters in 1:26, Teelatini was on the attack first-over but got a little steppy and had to be steadied through the far turn. Once straight, Teelatini found a :27.4 final quarter and kicked home to get the win by three-parts of a length over Topville Ohsolucky and Marvin Luna. Kb's Summer Breeze also rallied well late to round out the trifecta. Sent off as the heavy betting favorite, Teelatini returned \$3.00 for the victory.

With the win, Teelatini has now won two of three lifetime starts while pushing her lifetime bankroll to \$70,500 for owners William P. DeLong and William C. DeLong. The homebred daughter of Rockin Image—Nightcap is trained by Roger Welch.

# Ponda Title, Ponda Grace score in Tuesday's ISS for rookie trotting fillies

Round two of six Indiana Sire Stakes for the 2-year-olds got underway on Tuesday (July 25) at Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino. Two \$65,500 divisions for the rookie trotting fillies highlighted the 14-race card, with **Ponda Title** and **Ponda Grace** each getting the job done in their respective divisions.



Putting her perfect record on the line, Ponda Title was a decisive winner picking up her fourth career victory in as many tries. Leaving from post 6 in the field of seven, driver Kyle Wilfong hustled Ponda Title straight to the front end, finding themselves on the outside of Truly Unbelievable and Kyle Husted in a brief duel for the lead in an opening quarter of :27.3. Truly Unbelievable relinquished the lead to Ponda Title as the fillies made their way onto the backstretch, with Wilfong tapping the brakes in the second quarter to reach the half in :57.4. Ponda Title continued to have things her way on the front end through the final turn, leading to three-quarters in 1:27.4 with Truly Unbelievable still second and Skyway Paige and LeWayne Miller first over into third.

As the fillies turned for home, Ponda Title opened up a two-length lead at the top of the lane as Truly Unbelievable vacated the pocket. Trotting home in :28.1, Ponda Title would complete the gate-to-wire victory by a length on the line over a determined Truly Unbelievable and Husted in 1:56. Skyway Paige would hold for third to round out the trifecta.

Bred by Pond-A-Acres, Ponda Title is a daughter of 2010 Hambletonian champion, Muscle Massive, out of the Angus Hall mare, Elin. Trained by Jay Hochstetler, Ponda Title has now banked \$81,000 for owners Connie Hochstetler, Robert Buddig and Allen Schwartz.

In the second division on the evening, Ponda Grace crossed the wire second, however would be declared the winner following an inquiry. The complexion of the race changed quickly as heavy 4-5 favorite Agent Of Fortune jumped it off behind the gate, with driver Atlee Bender electing to steer Ponda Grace into the

third position from post 6 as James Yoder cut a :28.2 opening quarter with Misty Mills. Misty Mills would lead the fillies onto the backstretch towards the halfway point in :58.4 pressure would come as LeWayne Miller unleashed Crystal Swan first over. The two freshman fillies dueled on the far turn, sprinting in tandem to three-quarters in 1:28.1 putting three lengths on the third place Eves Romance and Jordan Ross.

It would be Crystal Swan who won the final turn skirmish leading the fillies into the top the stretch however she would soon have company as Jordan Ross steered Eves Romance into the passing lane and Bender split rivals with Ponda Grace to her outside. The trio battled down to the wire with Crystal Swan digging in gamely bracing for the hard-charging Ponda Grace, however, Crystal Swan would go off stride just prior to the wire which she crossed first, and was disqualified to third for the lapped-on break. Ponda Grace and Bender would be declared the winner following the disqualification, stopping the clock in 1:57.1 trotting home in :28.1. Eves Romance and Ross finished third and was placed second.

Trained by Erv Miller, it was the second career victory in four career starts for the daughter of Swan For All—Much Fanfare. Bred by Alan Byler, the 1:57.1 was a career best effort for Ponda Grace and pushed her bankroll to \$56,900 for owners Anthony Lombardi, Doug Overhiser and Panda Monium Stable.

Marc Tardif's 3-year-old pacing gelding **Luke McGook** grabbed another victory at Bangor on Wednesday (July 26), giving the seasonal star an unblemished record of five-for-five in the glamour boys' division of the Maine Sire Stakes.

Leaving from the pylon position and driven by regular pilot Kevin Switzer Jr., the son of Rock N' Roll World left little doubt who would be in command at the :29.2 opening panel of the \$15,142 event. With the world at his back the Leighton Propertyowned horse with the funny name rolled through the middle half of 1:00.2 and 1:29.3 while maintaining a respectable, but not overly boisterous, single-length lead on Colt Bennett (Bruce Ranger, David Crochere).

First up at the half and through the third panel was stable mate Someones Hero (Dave Ingraham, Tardif). Sensing some hesitation Walter Case Jr. moved So Rock N' Roll (Tardif) three wide down the backside to swoop his tiring colleague.

With the fracas behind him, Luke McGook pranced home in 1:58.3, with nary an anxious moment to score by 1-1/4 lengths. Colt Bennett finished second with So Rock N' Roll getting up to be third in the first of three non-wagering events.

Luke McGook was bred in Maine by Erica Saucier, and now has \$178,574 in lifetime earnings, with 13 career victories.

The second \$14,146 Maine Sire Stakes event, a 2-year-old colt trot, was captured by **Chipper Dale** in 2:12 by a 1-3/4 length margin with trainer/driver Valerie Grondin at the controls. Chipper Dale is by the sire Shake It Off Lindy and is owned and was bred by Lynn-Marie Plouffe. Pembroke Will (Heath Campbell, Grondin) finished second after cutting the fractions; Carrabassatt (Mark Athearn, Gretchen Athearn) was third.

The final non-bettor was captured by **Two Towns Over** who grabbed the other \$15,367 sophomore colt pace division in a seasonal best 1:58.1.

Driven by Aaron Hall for owner/trainer Valerie Grondin, the son of Deuce Seelster made every call a winning one, wiring the field and scoring by 3-3/4 lengths. Stable mate Mattucci (Walter Case Jr., Grondin) finished second; Rockaroundsam (Andy Harrington, Tardif) was third. Two Towns Over was bred by Andrew Bustard.

**Outlawofthevalley** provided a mild upset in defeating wagering favorite and previous point leader Wabanaki (Ivan Davies, 1-5) in the \$15,166 Maine Sire Stakes for 3-year-old trotting colts and geldings.

Scoring from the Euro-rail position, driver Kevin Switzer Jr. let Stealin Money (Nick Graffam, 20-1) leave sharply and cross over. However, the dust barely had time to settle as Switzer Jr. was back out and rolled on to re-take command in a :29.4 opening panel.

Stealin Money sat a tight pocket with Wabanaki not content in third and choosing to pull first over into the 1:01.4 half-mile marker. The pair battled on the front end through a 1:31.4 third stanza, where track announcer Mike Sweeney noted that Wabanaki "refused to go away."

Down the stretch it appeared that the lathered-up Outlawofthevalley had his hands full, but the wire arrived and the pacesetter was able to maintain a half-length lead over the favorite to score in 2:02.2. Outlawofthevalley a son of Pembroke Slugger, is owned and was bred by Leighton Property, and paid \$9.80 to win for trainer Tardif.

Stealin Money hung on to be third.

Trainers Valerie Grondin and Marc Tardif swept the four divisions of Maine Sire Stakes events, each taking two races on the day's program.

It's a three-day weekend for participants in the Maine Sire Stakes at Cumberland. Today (July 28) they will host 2- and 3-year-old trotting fillies and 3-year-old pacing fillies. Saturday (July 29) has two divisions of freshman pacing fillies, with the freshmen pacing colts going on Sunday (July 30). All the divisions are on the betting program.



# Hambletonian, Oaks elims, highlight Big M weekend

The next-to-last weekend of racing at The Meadowlands means the impending conclusion of the Championship Meet has wall-to-wall stakes events certain to get harness fans' hearts racing, with the highlighted contests coming on Saturday (July 29) when eliminations for the \$1 million Hambletonian and \$500,000 Hambletonian Oaks take place.

The show is put together by the TV team at the New York Racing Association (NYRA).

# Elim winners to go from posts 3 and 4 in \$350,000 Adios Final

Elimination winners It's My Show and Cannibal will leave side by side in Saturday's \$350,000 final of the Delvin Miller Adios Pace for the Orchids at Hollywood Casino at The Meadows.

The connections of those two got to choose their post positions by virtue of their elimination wins. Cannibal's group won a draw for selection order, and trainer Nancy Takter chose post 4. Trainer Linda Toscano then opted for post 3 for It's My Show.

It's My Show put on a spectacular show in his elim, scoring in 1:47.4 to set a world record for sophomore geldings on a five-eighths-mile track. But Cannibal was no slouch, triumphing in 1:48.2. It's My Show is undefeated in seven starts this year while Cannibal has lost only once, in the Meadowlands Pace final.

The Adios anchors a blockbuster 16-race card that also features five other Grand Circuit stakes. First post is 11:45 a.m., with the Adios as race 15.

For the Adios Day card, The Meadows is offering a total of \$170,000 in pool guarantees, several in association with the Meadows Standardbred Owners Association (MSOA) and the United States Trotting Association Strategic Wagering Initiative. The innovative, and potentially lucrative, wagers include an Adios Pick-8 with a \$15,000 guarantee (race 8) and a pair of guarantees for the Adios in race 15, trifecta (\$40,000) and superfecta (\$20,000).

All the Adios Day action will be livestreamed, with free access at the MSOA Facebook page and YouTube channel. The livestream show, which begins at 11:45 a.m., will be hosted by The Meadows race caller Jeff Zidek, prominent harness announcer Gabe Prewitt and Dawnelle Mock of the Pennsylvania Horse Racing Association.

# Take two for Etonnant in 2023 MGM Yonkers International Trot

While it is unclear if Richard Westerink is familiar with the proverb "if at first you don't succeed try, try again" he clearly lives by it. The owner/trainer will once again cross the Atlantic Ocean with \$2.5 million winner Etonnant, perhaps the top horse in Europe right now, in hopes of winning the \$1,000,000 MGM Yonkers International Trot.

"I've never won a race in the U.S. and it is a dream for me," said Westerink. "My horse is in very good shape. We were preparing for the Prix d'Amerique, but I said last year we were preparing for it also and my horse got sick and didn't race. Since the horse is fine now, it makes sense to race at Yonkers and think about the Prix d'Amerique later."

For the record, Westerink will be making his fourth trip to MGM Yonkers Raceway in search of the elusive International Trot trophy. His best finish came in 2015 when he finished second with Timoko, sire of Etonnant. Last year Etonnant was sent off as the 8-5 favorite in the MGM Yonkers International Trot won by Cokstile and was charted with a break on the fourth turn just after the three-quarter call and finished eighth.

Whether or not the break in stride by Etonnant was caused by the track configuration or some confusion between horses can be debated, but Westerink seems certain of his horse's ability to handle the tight turns of the Yonkers half-mile oval.

"Maybe [the tight turns] are not his thing, but last year the race went badly for me when Back Of The Neck came out in front of him," said Westerink. "If not for that I think we would've been second or third by the final turn and it is a different race. Maybe he would've won the race. I think he can handle the turns and it is not a problem. We won at Kouvola in Finland [June 17, 2023] and the turns there are flat and very tight. He won there in a new track record time. It seems he handles the turns easier now."

Since missing the Prix d'Amerique in January due to sickness, Etonnant has gone on a roll, winning six of eight starts at distances from one to 1.67 miles. His most recent triumph came on July 15 in the \$120,000 Prix de Washington at Enghien-Soisy Racecourse in upper Normandy and Etonnant is expected to start there again this Saturday (July 29) in the \$150,000 Jean-Luc Lagardere.

Westerink was hoping to arrive in the U.S. in August to compete in the John Cashman Memorial at The Meadowlands but said the cost of travel, vet and insurance — \$80,000 — was simply too high. With MGM Yonkers providing guaranteed money to international shippers and with the large number of horses coming from Europe decreasing vet bills, the cost of a U.S. trip for the MGM Yonkers International was more attractive.

The star-studded field for the 1 ¼-mile race is certainly living up to its name with an international flare. Etonnant (France)

joins Vivid Wise As (Italy), Get A Wish (Denmark), Aldebaran Zeus (Australia) and Jiggy Jog S (Sweden) as we reach the halfway mark of attendance for the expected 10-horse Yonkers International Trot field.

"I know the Australian horse and of course Vivid Wise As," said Westerink. "We beat [Vivid Wise As] on the outside a couple of times and right now I think we can handle him."

The \$1,000,000 MGM Yonkers International Trot will be the marquee event on a blockbuster program that includes a pair of six-figure invitationals and the \$1.8 million New York Sire Stakes Day of Champions to honor the best 2- and 3-year-olds in the state. Post time for the special card is noon.
