**Like Father Like Daughter, a Confident
Johansson Aims to Win Hambletonian**

Nancy Johansson will tell you she's just like her father - confident, driven, type A, expects to win.

"It's a Takter trait," she said. "We're all like that."

So that's why she's not the least bit intimidated about starting a long shot in the Hambletonian in Resolve or at all willing to concede that she can't beat her father, Jimmy, and his seemingly invincible trio Saturday at the Meadowlands.

"Yes, I think I can win," she said. "First of all, it's horse racing. I want my dad's horses to race as well as they can and I want to beat him fair and square. If I don't it's not the end of the world, but, obviously, I want to give it a good go. I'm not the type of person who is going to wake up in the morning and say, 'Gee, we finished fourth in the Hambletonian, isn't that great.'"

She will face a daunting task in the Hambletonian. Her father

will send out three horses, Father Patrick, Nuncio and Trixton, all of whom seem far superior to the eight non-Takter trained horses in the field. And Resolve is just 4 for 19 lifetime with earnings of \$45,590. But Johansson learned many things from her father, among them that a well-bred horse yet to peak is always dangerous.

"He's a super nice individual; you couldn't ask for a nicer individual to be around," she said of Resolve. "I am happy with the way he raced (when second in the Reynolds behind Nuncio). Hopefully, he'll take another step forward, which I think he will be able to do. All systems are go."

The second-place finish in the Reynolds was the first for Resolve under the care of Johansson. He had been trained by Roman Lopez.

Johansson, 33, was just one when her father moved his family to the U.S. to try his hand at training here. For Johansson that meant a typical American childhood, but she never wanted to do anything else but follow in her father's footsteps. After working alongside him and learning from him for years, she decided last year that it was time to go out on her own.

"I am a bit of a go-getter," said Johansson, who doesn't

have even a hint of a Swedish accent. "It's great to take care of good horses and I was completely spoiled. I've taken care of some of the greatest horses to ever race. But there comes a point where you want to go to the next step. It felt like it was the time to move on. I expect a lot from myself."

She was an immediate success, winning 18 races from 93 starters last year. Her best horse was Western Vintage, who made \$316,838 and finished second in the Metro. But while she might share her father's personality she was careful to distance herself from him. She trains at White Birch Farm and not at the family's training center. And she says she's too stubborn to ask for his advice or help. Johansson very much wants to succeed or fail on her own.

"I actually don't think people think that," Johansson said when asked if she's worried that people suspect her father has his hand in her training operation. "That's because a lot of people have seen me work myself and I work very hard. If you ask anyone at White Birch they'll tell you how hard we work and that in the winter our lights are still shining in the barn at 6:30, 7 at night, I have a horse named Freedomforoursoul and my dad owns a quarter of that horse and he never tries to tell me what to do."

"She is very independent and has lots of self confidence,"

Takter said. "She is very good at what she does. You need confidence and she has that. She always had a passion to work with horses and take care of them."

says if he doesn't it would be a "very sore defeat."

Johansson said she can't worry about her father's feelings or his potential disappointment. Her job is to prepare Resolve for the his best possible effort and to try to pull off an upset that would do wonders for her own career.

"Will he be proud of me if I beat him? I think so. I hope so," she said. "Then again, maybe he'll write me out of the will."

When asked about Resolve's chances, Takter is diplomatic. "He's in tough," is all he would say.

But what if? Takter isn't supposed to lose the Hambletonian. Father Patrick is considered one of the best trotters of his generation and if anyone can beat him it is Trixton or Nuncio.

Takter admits he fully expects to win and

Background Checks on the Hambo Horses

Although there are hundreds of active trotting stallions in North America, a trio of them account for seven of Saturday's 11 starters in the Hambletonian.

Muscle Hill leads the way with a three sons in the big dance while Cantab Hall and Donato Hanover each have a pair in the Hambletonian. That leaves four stallions with one starter. They are Andover Hall, Broadway Hall, Explosive

Matter and Majestic Dream.

It's one thing for a stallion to have starters in the Hambletonian, but the goal is to get a winner of America's greatest trotting classic. Muscle Hill's and Explosive Matter's oldest foals are just 3-year-olds, so they obviously

have not yet sired a Hambletonian winner.

In fact, the only stallions with 2014 starters who have sired a Hambletonian winner are Andover Hall (sire of 2007 winner Donato Hanover) and Broadway Hall (sire of 2011 winner Broad Bahn).

Amazingly, all 10 Hambletonian starters hail from broodmares by different sires. Some are from mares by popular, well-known stallions such as Muscles Yankee (Harper Blue Chip), Credit Winner (Resolve), Trixton (Garland Lobell) and Conway Hall (Royal Ice). Some of the other broodmare sires with 2014 starters might have a few people scratching their heads. Doncango is out of a mare by A Go Go Lauxmont, a stallion that died last summer at age 28 after breeding just a few mares in New York in his waning years.

Il Sogno Dream is out of a mare by Fill V, an unraced son of Valley Victory that began breeding mares in Florida as a 2-year-old in 1999. Fill V's dam was by Supergill but her maternal breeding was French, giving him 75 percent American blood and 25 percent French blood, the combination that has proven so successful in Europe.

Many of the 11 starters have interesting dams. Doncango is out of the 22-year-old B Cor Tamgo, who is also the dam of Broadway Hall, the sire of this year's starter JJ Alex.

Datsyuk is from Pink Ribbons, a classy filly who just missed winning the Delvin Miller by a nose and was third in her Hambo Oaks elim. Her owners pledged to use the Pink Ribbon's earnings to support breast cancer research. Emilie Cas El was the first foal from the vaunted Amour Angus and was a top stakes filly in her own right, but it took her a long time to produce up to her pedigree. She had nice fillies such as Impressive Kemp, but her colts by Enjoy Lavec and Deweycheatumhowe were duds. Now she's got a potentially great son in Trixton.

Gala Dream, dam of Father Patrick, is already the dam of his millionaire older brother Pastor Stephen.

Il Sogno Dream is line-bred 4x3 to Valley Victory and his second dam is a sister to Moni Maker.

Only two of the Hambletonian starters hail from the same maternal family. They are Trixton and Harper Blue Chip, both from the Medio family or what was once known as the

"Hanover sisters" family. Miss Bertha Hanover, a foal of 1926 and the eldest of the trio of "2:00 sisters" is the seventh dam of Trixton and the eighth dam of Harper Blue Chip.

One fascinating fact is that Lou Dillon, the fire-red chestnut mare who was harness racing's first 2:00 trotter in 1903, is the 10th dam of Don Dorado. Otherwise Lou Dillon has not left a wealth of distinguished descendants.

Four of the Hambletonian starters are natives of Pennsylvania while a pair was foaled in Kentucky and Ontario. Other states represented with one are New Jersey, New York, and Ohio.

Special recognition goes to Jules Siegel and his late wife Arlene. JJ Alex and Doncango were both foaled at their Fashion Farms in Pennsylvania. No other breeder has more than one representative in the race.

March was the birth month of four Hambletonian starters-----favored Father Patrick, Il Sogno Dream, JJ Alex, and Royal Ice.

Nuncio and Harper Blue Chip were both born at the same day-April 17, 2011---but the former arrived at Hanover Shoe Farms while the latter lists Blue Chip Farms as his birthplace. Datsyuk was born the very next day at Hickory Lane Farms in northwest Ohio.

Resolve was foaled on May 6 while Trixton came along on May 12. Doncango is the youngest horse in the field as he was foaled on May 22.

The elder statesman in the Hambletonian field is Don Dorado, born on February 20.

Doncango won his most recent start for trainer-driver Ake Swanstedt, whose magic touch with horses has stunned American harness racing fans. But he comes into the Hambletonian with only six career starts, making him the greenest of the trotters entered.

Two other greenhorns are Datsyuk and Royal Ice, each with only seven career starts.

The remainder of the Hambo starters are experienced "teenagers" with more than a dozen starts. They are Harper Blue Chip (14), JJ Alex (15), Trixton (16), Father Patrick (17), Nuncio (17), Don Dorado (17), Il Sogno Dream (19) and Resolve (19).

Calumet Butler Wins for Owner in Coma

The 1931 Hambletonian surely was one of the most unusual renewals of America's greatest trotting classic. The best 3-year-old trotter in the world--by far--wasn't even

entered in that Hambletonian. The role of favorite fell to a filly instead, but 1931 was the first time in the six years of Hambletonian history that the favorite failed to win.

The winning horse never won a race before the Hambletonian. Or after the Hambletonian. And he was killed later by bomb. (Yes, a bomb.)

The winning breeder and owner died without ever knowing he won.

The dominant colt that season, Protector, had been a sensational 2-year-old, but, alas, his owner failed to make

the necessary Hambletonian sustaining payments. That left the favorite's role to the filly Nedda Guy.

William Monroe Wright, founder of the Calumet Baking Powder firm, loved trotters and bred and raced them from his resplendent Calumet Farm in Kentucky. He had been one of the driving forces behind the creation of the Hambletonian in the mid-1920s and wanted to win that race more than anything in the world. He suffered a stroke, however, before the '31 Hambletonian and lay in a coma during the race. Tragically, he died without ever knowing that his dream had come true.

He also died without knowing that his son Warren would soon disperse all of Calumet's Standardbreds and replace them with Thoroughbreds. Calumet Farm then became an empire in Thoroughbred racing and campaigned such greats as the Triple Crown winners Citation and Whirlaway.

In the summer of 1931 the nation was in economic turmoil as the Great Depression continued to rip through the economy causing business failures, job losses, and endless personal misery. Americans simply didn't believe President Herbert Hoover when he reassured them prosperity was just around the corner.

"What corner?" many people asked. It wasn't any corner in their neighborhood. Around every corner in American communities were unemployment and bread lines.

Trotting fanciers could delight in the accomplishments of a Brobdingnagian colt named Protector that was trotting the

shoes off his rivals. They couldn't even come close. On August 4, 1931, Protector easily won the American Horse Breeders Futurity over the filly Nedda Guy in straight heats in Hartford, Connecticut.

Ten days later, however, when the rain-delayed Hambletonian was finally contested in Goshen, Protector stood in the stable unable to showcase his talents. Hambletonian Day saw the filly Nedda Guy heavily favored in the auction pool betting of that era with the colt Keno second choice and the filly Charlotte Hanover picked third. Keen observers of the pre-race warm-ups saw something they didn't like when Nedda Guy warmed up. Her first two trips with trainer Walter Cox seemed smooth and effortless, but when catch-driver Harry Stokes sat behind her for her third warm-up mile the cognoscenti saw a hitch in Nedda Guy's git-along. Still, she was bet down to favorite status.

Three fillies and three colts paraded for the crowd and prepared for the start under the open scoring system. (The field of six is still the smallest group ever to contest a Hambletonian.)

In the first heat, Keno stalked the pacesetters and then prevailed in the stretch drive over the filly Calumet Belricka and colt Calumet Butler. The mile was timed in 2:04-1/4. Nedda Guy was far back in the early stages of the first heat and was driven carefully by Stokes to finish fifth. In the second heat, Keno grabbed the lead only to surrender late in the mile to Calumet Butler. Nedda Guy

staged a furious finish to land second. This mile was in 2:03-1/4.

Nedda Guy was obviously lame but her backers felt that she would get the best of her rivals in the third and fourth heats. But it was not to be. Despite the fact that she was lame, her backers were so vocal that they insisted that she be brought to the track and paraded for the third heat.

Trotting fanciers simply couldn't believe she might not win

the Hambletonian trophy. Guy McKinney, Josola's Worthy, Spencer, Walter Dear, and Hanover's Bertha had all been favorites---and they had each won.

When Nedda Guy came to the track for the third heat, she was incapable of moving at more than a walk. She was withdrawn and

never raced again. (An x-ray later showed she had broken a bone in her hip.)

In the third heat Calumet Butler led all the way and held off Keno to win by a nose in 2:05-1/4.

Trainer-driver Dick McMahon's voice choked with emotion as he was interviewed after the Hambletonian. He spoke about owner Wright's dreams of this day and what a shame it was the famous businessman and breeder was not there to enjoy it.

A few weeks later, Wright died at age 80.

Calumet Butler and his playmates had avoided Protector in the Hambletonian but they couldn't avoid him in the Kentucky Futurity later that season. In the second heat of that race, Protector won in 1:59-1/4 with MacAubrey back 10 lengths in second and Calumet Butler well back in fifth in the six horse field.

No 3-year-old trotting colt would race faster than Protector for the next 30 years.

That fall Calumet Farm consigned 110 horses to the Old Glory Sale in New York and Calumet Butler went for a mere \$2,600 to W.J. Rosemire as agent for Julius Pajoncek of Hamburg, Germany. (By contrast, the 2-year-old Calumet Chuck sold to Hanover Shoe Farms for \$19,500 in the same sale.)

Protector was not a great stallion but he sired the resplendent mare Proximity, a hero during the post-World War II heyday of harness racing.

Nedda Guy produced the 1951 Prix d' Amerique winner Mighty Ned, but Nedda Guy is also the second dam of Good Time, also a post-war harness hero like Proximity. And Calumet Butler? He went to Germany as its economy was in such tatters that Adolf Hitler was able to rise to political power. Calumet Butler stood at a farm near Hamburg, but in 1944 he was the victim of a British air raid and died when a bomb hit the farm where he resided.

Julie Hopping Oaks is Miller Time

Designed To Be has lost two straight to Shake It Cerry but whatever bad taste might linger from those losses will no doubt be wiped away should she turn the tables on her rival in Saturday's \$500,000 Hambletonian Oaks.

Trainer Julie Miller can easily see that happening, an

opinion that will no doubt be shared by many handicappers. Art 2-1 Designed To Be is the morning line favorite and not Shake It Cerry (5-2).

The difference this time could be as simple as the post positions. Designed To Be drew the one and Shake It Cerry is a trailer from post 11, meaning she

will start directly behind the horse she has to beat. That could lead to some fascinating strategy between drivers Brian Sears (Designed To Be) and Ron Pierce (Shake It Cerry).

"Obviously in any race you want to be on the gate," Miller said. "It's a disadvantage if you're a trailer because you're at the mercy of whoever you choose to follow."

Planning all along to have her horse peak in the Oaks, Miller brought Designed To Be along slowly this year, starting only in a pair of Pennsylvania sire stakes races before meeting up with Shake It Cerry for the first time in the Del Miller. That was the controversial race where it was alleged that Jimmy Takter, driving a long shot, purposely blocked Designed To Be to help out Shake It Cerry

"Here's where I stand with that, my job as a trainer is to have a horse fit, healthy and ready to race," Miller said. "When a race comes under controversy like that that's the New Jersey Racing Commission's job to handle it if they see an infraction. That's why I've had nothing to say about it. I've got to turn the page and if I'm going to get frustrated over a situation I can't control that's not good karma for me."

Two weeks later the two fillies met again in a prep for the Oaks. Again Designed To Be was the favorite. Again, Shake It Cerry beat her, by a half-length.

Miller says she's not frustrated by the results of the last two races or discouraged. Rather, she says she's focused on the Oaks and is positive she'll be starting a horse ready for a stellar effort.

"I had a prominent owner, Mitchell Skolnick, say to me it takes everything to go right on that day to end up in the winner's circle to win a race like the Hambletonian Oaks," she said. "As of right now I feel like everything is falling into place, and we targeted this race. She's healthy and fit going into race and has one of the best drivers in the country. In my opinion she's the most deserving horse."

The one negative Saturday will be that Miller's husband,

It could be a wet Hambletonian Day.

The forecast for East Rutherford, New Jersey is calling for a 50 percent chance of a thunder storm during the night on Friday. It's worse on Saturday as the chance of rain is 70 percent.

Andy, won't be able to drive Design To Be. He fractured some vertebrae in a spill in April and isn't expected to return until October.

"If anybody knows Andy they know he is one of the most positive people you'll ever find," she said. "Obviously he wishes he were driving but unfortunately he can't. But he'll be so proud of me and our team if we are to win. I am proud of him for how he is dealing with this and the kind of positive attitude he has. To go from a position of being in control and driving all the horses and have to release that to other people can't be easy."

Miller will send out two other horses in the Oaks, Cee Bee Yes and Take The Money.

"Obviously, I don't think (Cee Bee Yes) is at Designed To be's level but if they mix it up why can't she pick up the pieces?" Miller said. "Take The Money has been an outstanding sire stakes filly and she had a really good race in the Reynolds here at the Meadowlands. She's just now coming into form. So, again, she has every opportunity.

\$225,000 NJ Classic Is Up Next for Well-Rested Western Vintage

MANALAPAN, NJ – July 31, 2014 – If the pieces all fall into place, the connections of Western Vintage could be sipping champagne on Saturday.

The son of Western Ideal is making his return to the races, after being sidelined since late June, in the \$225,000 Anthony Abbatiello New Jersey Classic, the fourth of 15 races on the Hambletonian Day program on Saturday, August 2, 2014 at the Meadowlands.

The New Jersey Classic and its filly companion event, the \$100,000 Thomas D'Altrui Miss

New Jersey for fillies, are restricted to New Jersey-sired three-year-old pacers. Both events are sponsored by the Standardbred Breeders & Owners Association of New Jersey.

In a well-balanced field, Western Vintage is rated the 5-2 second choice [Doo Wop Hanover is 9-5] and will leave from post two with Brian Sears at the lines.

Last season, Western Vintage won five of eight races and earned \$316,838. His victories included the \$150,000 New Jersey Sire Stakes Championship for two-year-old pacing colts and a division of the Bluegrass Stakes at the Red Mile. He finished second in the \$648,850 Metro Pace at Mohawk.

This all marked the bargain colt – he cost only \$7,000 at the 2012 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale – as a potential divisional star at three.

Health issues, however, detoured Western Vintage after four starts this spring.

"We gave him a break after the Hempt [on June 21] for a couple of reasons," said Perry Soderberg, the colt's co-owner. "One, because he had some really tough races up to that point, and two, his blood work wasn't perfect so we needed some time to improve that. It is a long year and another year after this one, so we want to take care of the horse."

Western Vintage opened his 2014 campaign with a New Jersey Sire Stakes win in 1:49.4 on May 17 at the Meadowlands and a week later was second to Doo Wop Hanover in the \$100,000 final.

Then it was on the road to Mohawk Raceway for the North America Cup elims [he finished fourth] and to Pocono for the Hempt [he was eighth].

Trainer Nancy Johansson qualified Western Vintage twice in July, including a 1:50.3 clocking and five and a half length victory on July 19 in the hands of new pilot Brian Sears.

"Well, Yannick [Gingras, who previously drove the colt] has been great, but he has [Jimmy] Takter's and [Ron] Burke's horses to choose from down the road, and they have been better than mine so far this year," Soderberg explained. "I know Brian has JK Endofanera and other options as well, but I am thankful that he wants to drive him now.

"All in all, I thought it was time to get the horse used to different drivers," he added. "He has been a bit tricky to drive, but he better get used to different drivers; that's how this business works."

Swedish-born Soderberg, who has been evaluating horses since 1986, usually picks out yearlings for others, primarily trainer Jimmy Takter and his owners. But when no one wanted Western Vintage, he purchased the colt for himself for \$7,000. Marvin Katz of Toronto bought an interest last October.

With \$53,890 earned this year, Western Vintage now has a bankroll of \$370,728.

"Western Vintage is coming in to this race in good shape," said Soderberg. "He qualified well, and I think he is the type of horse that can race good after a break."
