Ron Burke wants good karma in this year's Hambletonian

Despite a number of close calls, the Hall of Fame trainer is still looking for his first win in the big race.

In 2017, on the way to the winner's circle after thinking they had won the Hambletonian with What The Hill, trainer Ron Burke and driver David Miller had to stop and wait while the judges reviewed the race. What The Hill was ultimately disqualified and Burke and Miller are still looking for their first Hambletonian victory, something that could be rectified on Saturday for one or both of them.



Trainer Ron Burke knows a lot of things about the Hambletonian. He knows what it's like to have two horses in the final, what it's like to send out the morning-line favorite and even what it's like to cross the wire first.

This year, he wants to know what it's like to go into the record books as a Hambletonian champion.

In Celebrity Bambino and Point Of Perfect -2-1 and 6-1, respectively, on the morning line - Burke again has a good chance to win the \$1 million classic at The Meadowlands on Saturday (Aug. 5) that has eluded him with his five previous Hambletonian finalists.

Burke was second in 2015 with Mission Brief, the 4-5 favorite who was beaten three-quarters-of-a-length, and in 2016, when

"People always say you don't know what it's like to win a Hambo," Burke said. "Yeah, I do. For 10 minutes I did, I also know what it's like to have them take it away. That suckedsucked."

Southwind Frank came up a nose shy. In 2017, Burke trainee What The Hill crossed the wire first but was disqualified for interference and placed eighth.

"People always say you don't know what it's like to win a Hambo," Burke said. "Yeah, I do. For 10 minutes I did. I also know what it's like to have them take it away. That sucked.

"[In 2019, Maximum Security] got taken down in the [Kentucky] Derby and I'm sitting with people at the barn and they're like, 'I wonder how that feels?' and I go 'I know exactly how it feels."

After being driven in his Hambletonian elimination by Yannick Gingras, Point Of Perfect will be handled in the final by David Miller, who also drove What The Hill.

"It just seems like right now nothing goes wrong with me and David," Burke said. "It's a little bit to me like it's karma. Like we are owed one – me and David are owed one."

Burke believes Miller did nothing to cause the disqualification.

"I've never bitched to him about it," Buke said. "Because I know in my heart Ake [Svanstedt] was coming out, Andy [Miller] was coming in, so it wasn't his fault. I will say to this day he should have never come down and I feel it was because of a rush. They had seven minutes to make the decision before the TV show turned off and they rushed to judgement. If they would have taken their time, talked to everybody and looked at it. I feel me and David would already have a Hambo."

Gingras will be driving Burke's Celebrity Bambino in the final, who he chose over Point Of Perfect.

After winning the Hambletonian elimination with Bambino, Gingras was reminded by Meadowlands' TV host Jessica Otten that he would have a choice to make for the final and he said in part, "Last time I won both eliminations I picked the wrong one, so maybe I'll let you pick for me. What do you think?

"It's the race everybody's looking for. And it's been well, well, well documented that it's one thing that's missing and I know

it, so it's going to come one of these days. I drive a lot of good horses for great connections."

Gingras also said that he didn't need to wait for the draw to decide who to drive in the final, that he was choosing Celebrity Bambino.

Gingras' choice did not surprise Burke, who said that everything they did with Celebrity Bambino this year was with the Hambletonian in mind.

"We skipped the Zweig," Burke said. "We tried him with no shoes in the Dancer, so we knew we could do it if we needed to and we did not like him with them off.

"We changed his racing style to more of a closer, because we just felt like there was only so many down-the-road trips in him and we didn't want to use them all up before the Hambo. [Gingras] could have been third or fourth with Celebrity [in the elim] and he was still going to take him."

Just like Burke and Miller, Gingras is also looking for his first victory in America's Classic Trotting Race.

Gingras has had great success on Hambletonian Day, having won the Hambletonian Oaks – for 3-year-old filly trotters and companion race to the Hambletonian — a record six times, but the best he's done in the Hambletonian was finish second on three separate occasions, including twice for Burke, the aforementioned Southwind Frank and Mission Brief.


"The loss with Mission brief was by far the worst loss of my career," Burke said. "It's worse than the What The Hill loss. You know, it's like nothing hurt more."

By virtue of the elimination victories by both of his horses, Burke knew they couldn't draw worse than post 5 as stipulated in the race conditions. However, he is a traditionalist and would rather see both the draw and the race itself done differently.

"If you win, you pick your post," Burke said. "It's what the Adios does. [By winning the elimination] You earned the right to pick your post. To me, pick your post is the best. To me, pick your post or open draw, either way. I don't subscribe to the go around there for the eliminations and just make the final thing, we try to win. People bet on the races. Our job is to go out and try to win every time. So, I don't need that to try to win. I'm going to try to win anyhow. And plus, a \$100,000 purse [for the eliminations] is enough reason to win.

And that's not all he would change.

"I'm still unhappy that we're not a two-heat race," Burke said. "I would have rather been putting the harnesses back on both of those horses and going right back out. I've seen what it did to the Adios, we took one great day of racing and made two good days of racing. It never has been the same.

"Don't tell me it hurts the horses. Bullshit. It doesn't hurt the horses. I have never seen one of my horses that I found was hurt. I do it at the [Little Brown] Jug all the time and I think they come out of it even better."

Burke agreed that in the past there were some logistical issues with Hambletonian heat racing, but he believes they no longer exist.

"They said it's about getting the program out," Burke said. "Listen, we all have these phones. You could send it to everybody that wanted it. They're worried about getting the program pages out, just put out a blast on the USTA and, boom, we all got it."

It could be a big day for Burke with horses in 12 of the 16 races on Hambletonian Day, including Railee Something, the 7-2 second choice in the Hambletonian Oaks.

Right after the races Burke will be heading out of town for his son's bachelor party. Hopefully, with many things to celebrate.

Fair odds selections for Hambletonian Day

Going beyond just making picks for Saturday's huge card at The Meadowlands.

I saw a Tweet earlier this week from a user named @thoreval on Twitter, though I suppose the platform is now known as 'X'. This comment has been liked nearly 40 times and caught my attention. It read, "It boggles me to see public handicappers

assign every annotation imaginable to qualify their picks rather than offer fair odds estimates. Picks are not bet-able without an associated fair price."

That was a completely valid comment. For myself, I may sometimes point out where there are unreasonable morning lines in my analysis, but I seldom have listed what closing odds I would be willing to accept to play the horses that I'm selecting. In other words, I may play a horse I like at assumed odds of 5-1 but would not play that same horse if the associated price were 9-5. That additional context is rightfully needed, and as a service to that Twitter user along with anyone else who will find it of interest, my estimated fair odds are included here in my Hambletonian Day analysis.

RACE 12,\$1 MILLION HAMBLETONIAN FINAL

Getting right into it with harness racing's signature event, the morning line for Celebrity Bambino of 2-1 aligns neatly with what I would consider fair odds if you like the horse. He was excellent in the Reynolds when coming back after a month off where he surged past the top pair late in somewhat of a surprise. I felt he wasn't as strong in the Dancer, but he left no doubt in his Hambletonian elimination win last week. No one was going to catch him that race and that 1:50.4 win is a personal best as well as being faster than anyone else in here for that matter. On the opposite side, Ghostly Casper has longshot potential. He rarely seems well positioned even going back to

those Woodbine Mohawk Park races, but he was moving well on the outside in the late stages last week when coming from an impossible spot and now picks up Sears. He is trending in the right direction and 12-1 would be fair. Following two tripped-out wins from the rail, Winners Bet was brave last out when racing parked first-over from post 10 into the faster of the two eliminations and held relatively well. Osceola got his act together last week and was splitting through traffic late at a huge price. Oh Well had every chance to get to longshot elimination winner Point Of Perfect in their elim and couldn't. It's still top connections, however, and an inside post. Maybe 5-1 would be fair. Point Of Perfect will pick up David Miller as Yannick Gingras opts as expected to the other Ron Burke elimination winner Celebrity Bambino.

Picks (with my fair odds): Celebrity Bambino (2-1), Ghostly Casper (12-1), Winner's Bet (6-1)

RACE 10, \$500,000 HAMBLETONIAN OAKS

Walner Payton was an overlay in her Oaks elimination win last week and would be justified in taking further support now. She did have a valid excuse in losing two back when she had to come first-over from sixth into the 8-5 favorite on the lead and still just barely missed. Last week, her class showed when she fended off the favorite the length of the stretch. Odds of 5-2 from the rail would seem like a fair proposition. Railee Something was favored last week over Walner Payton and gave it her all to try to reach through the stretch. She's been remarkably consistent having been no worse than second in any of her eight starts this year. The wild card here is Bond. Untouchable just two starts ago, she went through wild fractions on the front-end last week, tired late and was very lucky to just hang on and qualify for the final. It's highly subjective but I'd rate fair odds for her at 4-1. Last year's brilliant 2-year-old filly from Canada, Righteous Resolve, was outkicked late in her elimination but maybe was up too close to that fast pace. Same could be said for Secret Volo who was still grinding late though now moves to the outside and I wasn't crazy about her loss two back as the even money favorite. Post 10 is going to produce a price on Heaven Hanover. She's a more than capable filly and could figure with some Tetrick magic. Heart On Fire finally showed a flash of that 2-year-old form when she was raging up the inside to shock in her elimination after having those super-fast fractions set it up for her. Even with that win, I'd still consider fair odds for her somewhere in double digits.

Picks: Walner Payton (5-2), Heaven Hanover (12-1), Bond (4-1)

RACE 6, \$200,000 NJSS FINAL 2-YEAR-OLD COLTS & GELDINGS TROT

Magic Hill rates 8-1 on the morning line and I'd go as low as 6-1 as fair odds on him. Gingras must think highly of him by sticking here last out in a Kindergarten series race over a Burke

horse and subsequent winner of that race, TCI. Two back this one came home in :26.4 and is certainly worth a swing if the odds are there. Sig Sauer was extremely impressive in his debut win. He looked like he was still powering away with no signs of slowing in that easy 1:54.4 pari-mutuel debut. The sky could be the limit. Lord Ritchie was short of room in the stretch in his most recent and now picks up Dexter Dunn. My Way traded changes on the lead throughout in his most recent NJSS race and Tim Tetrick never seemed like there was a doubt when he waited to re-engage and easily pass by Poof Of Record. Mars Hill has paid well in both career starts and should continue to offer another price once again.

Picks: Magic Hill (8-1), Sig Sauer (6-5), My Way (4-1)

RACE 7, \$171,400 LADY LIBERTY

Test Of Faith should attract attention off her 5-1 programmed line and I'd even go as low as something like 7-2 on her as fair odds. As has been her MO, she was conservatively handled from poor posts in her first two starts of the year, but should be prominent now from a far more workable post. She was impressive in holding off Bythemissal in that recent 1:49.1 qualifier; anxious to see what she brings now. Grace Hill is 0 for her last 2 at The Meadowlands following her amazing Roses Are Red win in Canada. She got the second over trip two back in the Haughton but was outkicked by Mikala that night. Mikala, who was over 40-1 that night, brought her 'A-qame' and was

continuing to pace up a storm through the wire. I recognize how sharp she is right but feel like a price of at least 6-1 would be required. For Silver Label, it's a question of what the odds are she runs back to that race in the Perfect Sting. Max Contract is generally double digits against these but does surprise on occasion.

Picks: Test Of Faith (7-2), Grace Hill (5-2). Mikala (6-1)

RACE 8, \$128,750 SAM MCKEE MEMORIAL

This looks like Ruthless Hanover or bust, and it comes down to what odds would be acceptable on that horse from the outside post. I think he's a couple steps better than anyone in here and would be willing to go as low as 3-2 as fair odds coming down from the 5-2 morning line. He's just three races removed from that 1:46.4 performance in the Brower, and two races back he was parked early temporarily before getting into a cut-throat duel with Abuckabett Hanover. He was surprised last out at Chester but that will happen sometimes; his best is more than good enough.

Picks: Ruthless Hanover (3-2), I Did It Myway (10-1), Mad Max Hanover (12-1)

RACE 11,\$278,000 JOHN CASHMAN MEMORIAL

Southwind Tyrion might be an interesting upset prospect to consider. His 8-1 morning line doesn't seem far off, though something around 12-1 may be feasible too. His odds of 15-1 from the Crawford despite having post 10 didn't seem terrible and then he demolished lesser last out in a new lifetime best of 1:50.2. It's Academic remains in super form and after wearing down Venerate when racing first over two back in the Crawford, and he was similarly relentless last out at Plainridge. Even with those successes, he's still starting on the outside looking in and I'm not sure if odds of 3-1 would be asking too much. Venerate making just his third start of the season, but he generally makes the most of them; a big qualifying win over Alrajah One It looks imposing. Asteroid makes his third start in North America and was aggressively handled last out in the Spirit of Massachusetts. He could be there, and I think 8-1 would be fair. Jujubee comes off an all-time track record performance at the Meadows but it's back to the wolves now.

Picks: Venerate (5-2), Southwind Tyrion (10-1), Asteroid (8-1)

RACE 13, \$240,000 NJSS FINAL 2-YEAR-OLD COLTS & FILLIES TROT

I think Svanstedt may have gotten a little cute last out with Sunkist Beauty as the big 2-5 favorite, taking her first over only to be caught by the filly on her back. But she can make amends starting from the rail once again; her debut win was noteworthy. This will be the fifth career start already for Allegiant who has

the look of a very nice one for trainer Vernon Beachy. A dominant 1:53.2 winner three back at Oak Grove, she was beaten next out by Sunkist Beauty before then winning confidently two weeks ago. Soiree Hanover moves outside for the first time. The unbeaten filly is yet to show early speed, but that may change now. Walcango sprung the upset last out and that cover trip continues to work out for her; odds will be determined by whether you think she can work out a similar journey once again. Special Talent gave it a good try on the front-end last week and two back closed in :26.4. A good trip seems in line from here as an intriguing price play.

Picks: Sunkist Beauty (5-2), Special Talent (8-1), Allegiant (5-1)

RACE 14, \$315,700 CANE PACE

Meadowlands Pace winner Confederate has supplemented to this race and it seems futile to try to make a case elsewhere. Christchurch has speed but was overtaken in that Pace final. Similarly, Hungry Angel Boy has really come alive in recent weeks, but he couldn't track with Confederate late in the Pace though he did wildly overachieve that night. Confederate is deserving of an ultra-low price.


Picks: Confederate (1-5), Hungry Angel Boy (10-1), El Rey (12-1)

RACE 15, \$130,000 SAM MCKEE MEMORIAL

Taurasi exploded when last seen to a 1:47.2 mile and it came in a race where he tracked cover but never saw the rail. The favorite in that race was Lou's Pearlman, a starter in the other McKee division so there was some decent level of competition in that race. His morning line is 12-1 but I'd even go down to 8-1; might be this good right now and aside from the next horse coming up, not many others scare me. Bythemissal never seems to draw well in these big races and was hampered in the Haughton when having to race wide throughout from a similar bad post. Obviously, he's fast enough but you never know how the trip will go from here. Does 2-1 seem fair? Tattoo Artist looked home in the Haughton following his wide move and though he got caught. He's still been very honest these past couple of months and should be taking advantage of post edge. Natameri continues to overachieve and shocked against Ruthless Hanover here in June.

Budding breeder from Tennessee looking for a little Hambletonian luck with Osceola

A little more than a decade after getting into the horse business, lawyer Richard Arnold has built a growing standardbred operation at his successful Willow Oak Ranch cattle farm in Tennessee.



Richard Arnold has a fascination with genetics. That pursuit is what led him into the cattle business, and eventually brought him to horse racing and breeding. On Saturday (Aug. 5) at The Meadowlands, Arnold's Willow Oak Ranch will be represented by \$1 million Hambletonian finalist Osceola and New Jersey Sire Stakes finalist Mars Hill.

"Personally, I'm excited about it, and I'm really happy for all the people that have helped us get here," said Arnold.

The 76-year-old attorney from Tennessee is quick to identify all that have helped he and his wife, Mary, along the journey into standardbred racing and breeding. The story begins with the late Bart Glass, who Arnold connected with first through cattle and Walco Farms.

"[Glass] used to come to our bull sale every year. We would sell around 150 bulls a year. He had some serious health problems around 2007 and 2008. He was a real good friend, and my wife and I would drive up and spend time with him. We liked Kentucky basketball and cattle, and eventually we got around to talk about horses," Arnold said. "He kept encouraging us to try the horse business. He thought if we applied the same principles we used in developing our cattle that we might enjoy it. He knew how much I liked genetics and breeding and studying pedigrees."

Arnold started his cattle farm in 1982 in Rogersville, located northeast of Knoxville. He was slow and methodical in growing Willow Oak Ranch. There, he crossed Chianina cattle with Angus cattle to develop the hybrid Chiangus breed. At the height of Willow Oak's operation, Arnold had 450 cows and sold 150 bulls each year.


"In about 1995, we felt we had a product that was good enough and we started having our own commercial sale. Our target was commercial ranchers around the country," said Arnold. "Our selling points were that these cattle were a hybrid vigor that would grow very well, they calved easily, they're very athletic, and they had lots of lean red meat with good marbling with no external fat. That took off. By 2000, we developed a national market and have been selling them across the country ever since."

Under Glass's advice, the breeder began researching standardbreds, and he attended his first sales in Lexington in 2009 and 2010. Arnold pored over the pedigrees of each horse, watched endless videos and delved into the data in the USTA's Pathway database. He noted the similarities between cattle and racehorses.

"There are two or three principles that are the same," he said. "One is that conformation is critical for animals to have any longevity or durability. Pedigree is critical. Families make a huge difference. Horses, of course, need a little more attention and care."

Just like in his approach to cattle, Arnold took a slow, methodical path with equines. First, he bought a pair of yearlings to bring back to the farm. He didn't intend to race them as much as to help determine how horses would fit into an operation focused on cattle.

"I wanted to try to figure out if we were going to be able to integrate the horse business in the middle of this cattle business. It helped us figure out what we needed to do," he said.



With the horses requiring more attention, Arnold has taken the property behind his home and made it the primary home for his growing standardbred enterprise. At first, he converted a hay barn that featured 10 stalls. Today, they have facilities that offer 40 stalls to accommodate the 15 yearlings, 14 weanlings and 26 broodmares. They have also scaled back the cattle operation as the broodmare band expands.

"We took our time, like we did in the cattle business," Arnold said. "We took the core of the farm behind our house and developed a nursery, mainly because the horses need more attention. I wanted to have these horses where they could be seen all the time by the people that work here and me. If you come here now, you think we only have horses, but we still have a lot of cattle. The cattle are all in the surrounding pastures."

Arnold sells the Willow Oak Ranch yearlings at Lexington each year, with Glass' son, Jimmy, preparing the babies before sending them on to Steve and Cindy Stewart at Hunterton Farm, who consign them as agents. As Arnold learned more about the business of racing, the breeder desired to keep ownership stakes in some of the horses he bred.

"I didn't initially intend to race horses, but when I got into it, I realized I'm trying to breed an animal I knew nothing about the end use," he said.

In his thirst for knowledge, Arnold has tapped into the experience of those around him. He talks with his conditioners, which include Gregg McNair, Tony Alagna, Julie Miller and Virgil Morgan, the Stewarts, Jimmy Glass, and others about his vision for Willow Oak Ranch and where he wants to take the breeding operation.


"A lot of them are very generous with their knowledge," Arnold said. "My wife always jokes that if I decided to become a Catholic, I would call the pope directly. I'm not shy about asking questions. And I actually listen. And I do my best, if I understand it, to do what people suggest. I think we improve every year in what we're doing."

The benefit of having horses in his backyard is that Arnold gets a feel for each crop of yearlings before they head to the sale. So, he knows which he may want to own a portion of after they sell. Conway Hall mare Armbro Exquisite is the first broodmare that Arnold purchased when he delved into breeding horses. Each of her first eight foals are starters, with seven winners including Saturday's Hambletonian starter Osceola. Arnold campaigned his full-sister, Baby Longstockings, with McNair serving as trainer.

"She cracked a bone at 2, but when she got going she was really good as a 3-year-old in Canada," Arnold said.

Baby Longstockings finished in the money in 12 of 15 starts as a sophomore, hitting the board nine times with three wins. The Muscle Mass filly took a mark of 1:55.1 while earning \$156,055 that season.

When it came time to sell Osceola, Arnold knew he wanted to own a piece of the colt. When McNair purchased the yearling



for \$70,000, he offered the breeder a third and brought on Paul Hawman of South Carolina to round out the partnership. Last season, the Muscle Mass colt started the year with two wins in his first three starts, but was plaqued by breaks in several attempts including the Breeders Crown final where he jumped it off and finished last.

"When he first started out in Canada as a 2-year-old, it looked like he was going to be really difficult to beat. Right in the middle of the summer, he decided that when he was going around the turn, he was going to run a little bit. You could never tell what he was going to do," Arnold said. "He was in a number of top races. He looked good in all of them until he didn't, until he ran."

This season, the colt started with two victories and a runner-up performance to kick off his sophomore campaign. However, breaks in the Goodtimes and an Ontario Sires Stakes Gold leg led McNair to make equipment changes. Arnold admitted that the Hambletonian appeared off the table until the trotter rebounded in a qualifier, winning by 13 lengths and stopping the clock in 1:53.4.

In last week's elimination, driver Doug McNair, Gregg's son, raced Osceola conservatively through the mile, trotting seventh until the field turned for home. Once in the stretch, the trotter with the second longest odds on the board (51-1), closed with a :27.1 brush to finish third, registering a 1:51.3 mile.

"He is loaded with trot. He's got a lot of it. He can leave fast from the gate and he can finish fast. Doug deserves all the credit in the world. He didn't let him go until the last 50 yards," Arnold said. "The last two races he's looked like the horse we thought he could be last year. Gregg is as patient as he can be and Doug has been disciplined driving him."

Osceola has drawn post three in the \$1 million final with a morning line of 12-1.

Earlier in the card, Arnold will have another interest as freshman Mars Hill will attempt to stay undefeated in the \$240,000 New Jersey Sire Stakes final for colt and gelding trotters. Trained by Alagna, the Muscle Hill colt is out of Cardinale, which Arnold also bred. The second dam, Mississippi Beauty, is one of the yearlings that first arrived in Rogersville, bringing everything full circle.

"Myron Bell once told me, and I buy this completely, he said, 'It takes skill and judgment to breed a good horse. It takes skill, judgment and luck to breed a great horse.' I'm still waiting on the luck," Arnold said.

Should Osceola cross the wire first on Saturday afternoon, it would be worth the wait.

Forty-three notes for the 43rd Hambletonian in New Jersey

- **1.** Ake Svanstedt, 64, is the only driver to win three milliondollar races after turning 55. He won two Hambletonians and a Yonkers International Trot. He can extend his own record to an amazing four with Up Your Deo.
- **2.** Triple Crown races #503 and #504, all time, are on Hambletonian Day 2023. It's the Hambletonian and the Cane Pace, respectively. The Cane debuted in 1955 the same year of the first Triple Crown winner Scott Frost.
- **3.** Ron Burke and Yannick Gingras swept both Hambletonian elims this year with Point Of Perfect and Celebrity Bambino. This marks the fifth time that a trainer has swept the Hambletonian elims at The Meadowlands:

Milton Smith (1993) with American Winner at 4-5 and Hi Noon Star at 3-1 and. They finished first and third, respectively, in the final.

Chuck Sylvester (1998) 1-2 in both elims and 1-2 in the final. Muscles Yankee and Armbro Rotary in the first elimination. Silver Pine and David Raymond in the second one and then Muscles Yankee and David Raymond in the final with Silver Pine and Armbro Rotary, respectively, bringing up the rear.

Trond Smedshammer (2006) with Mr Pine Chip and Here Comes Herbie. It didn't help in the final as Herbie was sixth and Mr Pine Chip was last.

Marcus Melander (2019) Greenshoe the 1-5 favorite and Green Manalishi at 9-1. They finished second and fifth in the final, respectively.

- **4.** Not a single 2023 Hambletonian finalist is in double digit starts at 3. They are averaging 6.2 per. In 1981, Hambletonian year one at The Meadowlands, they averaged 14 starts.
- **5.** Point Of Perfect was 0-15 at 2. On the pacing side, a couple of colts won the Meadowlands Pace who were also 0-15 at 2. It was Escort in 1976 and Art Official in 2008.

- **6.** Todd McCarthy was unable to qualify for the 2022 Hambletonian with Molotov Cocktail in the same race where Cool Papa Bell was third. But Sears opted for the Hambletonian runner-up Joviality S, the filly, leaving eventual-winner Cool Papa Bell open for McCarthy.
- **7.** On Hambletonian Day in 1981, the first in New Jersey, Ray Remmen won the first race on the card, too, with Hagar The Horrible at \$7.80.
- **8.** A couple of guys you might have heard of were born before and after the 1989 Hambletonian dead heat with Probe and Park Avenue Joe.

Scott Zeron, 89 days prior.

Dexter Dunn, 27 days later.

9. In four of the last seven Hambletonians, four different Swedish trainers had the public choice.

Jimmy Takter (2016) with Bar Hopping, who finished fifth.

Marcus Melander (2019) with Greenshoe, who was second.

Ake Svanstedt (2021) won with Captain Corey.

Lucas Wallin (2022) was off the board with Rebuff at odds-on.

10. Tactical Landing looks to be the third first-crop winning Hambletonian sire of the 21st century. His sire Muscle Hill did it with Trixton in 2014, and Andover Hall did the same in 2007 with Donato Hanover. Before that there was Self Possessed by Victory Dream in 1999, Victory Dream by Valley Victory in 1994,

Mack Lobell by Mystic Park in 1987, Duenna by Green Speed in 1983 and Timothy T by Ayres in 1970.

11. In his first three years, Burke took quite a dip into the Hambletonian deep waters.

In 2015, favored Mission Brief was second to Pinkman.

In 2016, he lost by a nose with Southwind Frank to Marion Marauder.

In 2017, he was DQ'd with What The Hill.

12. Andy and Julie Miller are no strangers to long prices or favorites come Hambletonian time. French Wine this year is yet another big ticket into the final. No other trainer in The Meadowlands Hambletonian history can say they have had the Hambletonian favorite and the longest shot in the field in another year.

Devious Man was the favorite at 2-1 in 2017 and was second, and The Chancellor was fourth in 2009 at 78-1.

- **13.** Miller time? David is catching up to Del Miller with starters in the Hambletonian final. It's 26 for Del and David has his 23rd with Ghostly Casper.
- **14.** In the 39 Hambletonian finals at the Meadowlands, (not counting the three race-offs), 25 out of 39 times the first quarter was the fastest of the race. Only four times was the last quarter the fastest.
- **15.** Tim Tetrick was the first to be in 17-straight Hambletonian finals, from 2007-2023.





- **16.** There will be MacDonalds at The Meadowlands on Hambletonian Day. Anthony, Mark and James will all be there.
- **17.** Walner had five fillies in the 2022 Hambletonian Oaks and won it. He has four colts in the 2023 Hambletonian and looks to double up.
- **18.** How did the 2023 Hambletonian sires do themselves in the Hambletonian?

Muscle Mass was seventh in his elim in 2008.

Muscle Hill won in 2009.

Resolve was fifth in the final in 2014 at 48-1.

In 2017, Walner was not in it.

In 2018, Tactical Landing was first in his elim and third in the final. Bar Hopping, who has since died, was fifth as the favorite in 2016.

- 19. Daniel Plouffe will try to do what has not been done in 48 years, own a Hambletonian winner (French Wine) after having owned a pacing Triple Crown winner (Blissful Hall, 1999). Stanley and Rachel Dancer did it in 1975 with Bonefish in the Hambletonian and pacing Triple Crown king Most Happy Fella in 1970.
- **20.** Chapter Seven did something last year in the Hambletonian not done in the prior 26 years. He sired the 1-2 finishers in the Hambletonian, a colt and a filly Cool Papa Bell and Joviality S. It last happened in 1996 with Valley Victory's Continental victory and Lindy Lane.
- **21.** Nancy Takter, trainer of Tactical Approach, is continuing on in dad's absence. Jimmy Takter is the all-time money leading trainer in Hambletonian history. He cashed in each of his last nine Hambletonians (2010-2018).
- **22.** Muscle Hill will send out his fifth Hambletonian favorite, Celebrity Bambino, hoping for better results than with last year's odd-on choice Rebuff. Ramona Hill carried the mail all the way in 2020 as the chalk, Bar Hopping was the choice in 2016 (fifth) and Mission Brief started it off finishing second in 2015 as the fave. Muscle Hill is the only sire in Meadowlands Hambletonian history to have two fillies as the favorite. The record for most favorites as a Hambletonian sire belongs to Stars Pride with eight.
- **23.** Humble beginnings? I'd say so. Check out these brand names and how they started out in the Hambletonian:

Stanley Dancer 18-10-12-9-11-6-9

Billy Haughton 18-11

Herve Filion 8 (lone appearance)

Ake Svanstedt 10-9-10

Yannick Gingras 7-10-10-11-7



- **24.** "Photo" finished 1-2 in the 2005 Hambletonian when Vivid Photo won over favored Classic Photo. Their sire and grandsire did not make it to this special day. S Js Photo or Photo Maker. As an oddity, only one "photo" horse did make it to a previous Hambletonian final, Fast Photo who was fifth in 2000.
- 25. It's been 11 years since Tim Tetrick's Hambletonian win with Market Share in the last \$1,500,000 test. But 11 is not the record for years in between wins. Del Cameron had a 12-year gap, 1953-1965. Sep Palin had 12 years from 1935-1947 and Ron Pierce went 14 from 1993-2007. Jim Campbell set the trainer standard of 27 years last year with Tagliabue in 1995 and Cool Papa Bell in 2022.
- **26.** There are two female Hambletonian trainers in 2023. In 2021, five of the 10 starters in the final were trained by women. There were 10 in the last 30 years or 33 per cent. Before that? There was 15 out of 160 just 9 per cent.
- **27.** Who nose? Eight of 97 Hambletonians have been decided by a nose and that doesn't count the 1989 dead heat. Four Hambletonians have been decided by a head and seven by a neck. So, 19 of 97, 20 per cent, were tight, again not counting the tightest of them all in 1989.
- **28.** Guy Axworthy won the first two Hambletonians as a sire at age 24 and 25. He was 1-2 in 1926, 1-2-3 in 1927 and 2-4-5 in 1928. He was the leading sire of 1926 and 1927.
- **29.** Sub :27 home in the Hambletonian? Glidemaster and Chocolatier are the only 1-2 finishers to each do this in the Hambletonian in 2006. They went :26.4 and :26.3, respectively. Sutton, a fast closing third, did it in 2016 in :26.4. Lagarfeld went :26.3 the same year and was seventh. Three in under :27 home in 2019 finishing second, third and fourth, Greenshoe :26.4, Gimpanzee :26.2 and Soul Strong :26.4.
- **30.** Walner has a good shot at the Hambletonian if history is a guide. Winning the Hambletonian as a stallion without racing in it himself.

Other stallions who sired Hambletonian winners:

Forbidden Trade by Kadabra in 2019.

Royalty For Life by R C Royalty in 2013.

Market Share by Revenue S in 2012.

Vivid Photo by S Js Photo in 2005.

Amigo Hall (2003) and Yankee Paco (2000) by Balanced Image.

Victory Dream (1994), Continentalvictory (1996) and Muscles Yankee (1998) by Valley Victory.

- **31.** David Miller and Gingras, the two members of the \$200 million driving club, are both looking for their first Hambletonian.
- **32.** Deo Volente won the first two Triple Crown races of 2023 at Yonkers. Up Your Deo is back in to try for leg two of the Trotting Triple Crown.
- **33.** Chris Ryder is no stranger to a top female trotter. He won the Breeders Crown back-to-back with Mystical Sunshine a decade and a half back. He has Walner Payton in this year's Oaks.



- **34.** No son of Muscle Hill has ever sired a Hambletonian winner. Tactical Landing, Resolve, and Bar Hopping will try to break through this year.
- **35.** Oh Canada. Yannick Gingras, Matt Bax, Doug McNair, Scott Zeron and James Macdonald are all natives of the Great White North.
- **36.** The last five Hambletonians had 68 per cent Swedish trainees. The first five Hambletonians in Meadowlands history had 18 per cent Swedish trainees.
- **37.** Walner Payton and Instagram Model both have several New York lines on their recent form. This almost worked in the 2022 Hambletonian for Joviality S. All of her lines were in New York prior to the Hambletonian elims last year. Duenna in 1983 was also a New York regular prior to her move to East Rutherford where she won the first million-dollar trotting event the Hambletonian.
- **38.** Walner's lineage suggests he has a huge shot of siring this year's Hambletonian winner:

The son of HOY Chapter Seven was fourth in 2011 Hambletonian.

Windsong's Legacy was a Triple Crown winner in 2004.

Conway Hall was fourth in the 1998 Hambletonian.

Garland Lobell's siring credits include Andover Hall, Angus Hall, Armbro Trick, Emile Cas El, Etc.

Super Bowl the 1972 Triple Crown winner had none until Windsong's Legacy.

Stars Pride with an astounding eight Hambletonian winners from his first 15 crops.

Worthy Buy was second in the 1943 Hambletonian.


Volomite was second in the 1929 Hambletonian.

- **39.** Todd McCarthy is on the sidelines unable to repeat his 2022 Hambletonian upset, meaning John Campbell's 1987-1988 backto-back Hambletonian wins Mack Lobell, Armbro Goal mark hasn't been duplicated since then.
- **40.** Walner Payton's not the first Hambletonian Day starter named for a very famous football player. Walter Payton retired as the all-time leading rusher and passed away in 1999. Herschel Walker was second in the elims and third in the 1992 Hambletonian final.
- **41.** Favorites have won just two of the last nine Hambletonians. But the first 30 editions they took 15 of 30 or 50 per cent.
- **42.** Jorgen Jahre is in the Oaks this year as the breeder of Secret Volo. Nineteen years ago, he owned Oaks upsetter Silver Springs.
- **43.** George Brennan has had some huge Hambletonian days in 2006 with Holborn Hanover in 1:46.4 and he took both the Hambletonian and the Oaks in 2011. He's now a member of the \$200 million-dollar driving club.

Hambletonian notebook: Looking like a million

Oh Well aims to add another big payday in Hambletonian for Marcus Melander, who also sends out three in Oaks. Ake Svanstedt duo hopes to return to top form. Ron Burke eyes

Oh Well heads into Saturday (Aug. 5) with one million-dollar win already to his credit and will try to add a second when he goes behind the gate with nine rivals in the \$1 million Hambletonian Stakes for 3-year-old trotters at The Meadowlands.

Given the limited opportunities to compete in million-dollar races, it is difficult for a trotter to capture multiple events with seven-figure purses. A handful of successes spring to mind from this century: Windsong's Legacy, Donato Hanover, Deweycheatumnhowe, Muscle Hill, and Market Share. All won two million-dollar races in their careers, both at age 3, the Hambletonian and Canadian Trotting Classic.

Oh Well won the Mohawk Million at age 2 at Woodbine Mohawk Park. He will go into Saturday's Hambletonian as the 7-2 second choice on the morning line, leaving from post two with Tim Tetrick driving for trainer Marcus Melander. Tetrick won the 2012 Hambletonian with Market Share. Melander is seeking his first trophy. He finished second twice – with Joviality S in 2022 and Greenshoe in 2019.

A son of Muscle Hill-Fine Tuned Lady, Oh Well has been a model of consistency during his career. The colt has finished no worse than second in 13 of 14 lifetime races, with five wins. Only three times has he been beaten by more than a length.

This season, Oh Well has a 1:51.2 win in a division of the Stanley Dancer Memorial on July 15 at The Meadowlands to go with five seconds in six starts. He was second in his Hambletonian elimination last week, finishing a half-length behind Point Of Perfect in 1:51.2.

"He's got a lot of second places this year, but he's been racing well," Melander said. "He's gone [1]:50, [1]:51 a couple of times. A couple of times, he just got beat by the wire when someone was flying, like with Air Power in the New Jersey Sire Stakes final.

"It's been a good year for him even if he's only won one race so far. He was really good in the Stanley Dancer, and if he gives another effort like that again, like he always does, he should be one of them that could win the race."

Oh Well is owned by S R F Stable, which won the 2017 Hambletonian with Perfect Spirit and was among the owners of 2021 champ Captain Corey.

For his career, Oh Well has earned \$915,585.

"Last year, he was a big horse, and it's hard for them when they're that big and just 2 years old," Melander said. "He's a lot stronger this year, more mature overall. I really like the horse. I think he has class. He can do a lot of work himself, so it's not like he needs to be on the lead or that he needs a trip. He can do whatever you ask."

Melander's uncle, Stefan, won the 2001 Hambletonian as trainer/driver of Scarlet Knight.

In addition to having Oh Well in the Hambletonian, Melander has three horses in the companion \$500,000 Hambletonian Oaks for 3-year-old female trotters. The draw was unkind, with his Kayleigh S getting post 8, Secret Volo getting post 9 and Heaven Hanover getting post 10.

"It is what it is," said Melander, who has twice finished second in the Oaks, with Hypnotic AM in 2020 and Iteration in 2021.

Despite her unfavorable starting spot, Secret Volo is the fifth choice on the morning line at 6-1. Walner Payton is the 3-1 favorite.

Secret Volo, the New York New York Mile winner in June at Yonkers, finished second behind Heart On Fire in her Oaks elimination with Brian Sears in the sulky. A daughter of Walner—Secret Serenity, she has two wins, two seconds and two thirds in six starts this season.

"She raced good in the elimination, I think," Melander said. "It was a fast first quarter (:25.4) and Brian had to leave a little bit

with her, but she finished strongly. She's always right there with them. She's not winning every week, but she's always right there."

Heaven Hanover, who was the Pennsylvania Stallion Series champ last year, and won a division of the Delvin Miller Memorial at The Meadowlands on July 15, is 12-1 on the morning line. She was third in her Oaks elimination, which was won by Walner Payton. Tetrick will drive the daughter of Father Patrick—Hillarmbro.

"She didn't have the speed last year," Melander said. "We just kept her in the Stallion Series and let her develop that way. She was big last year, too, so she might have needed that year to just get some experience. This year, she's a totally different horse. She feels like she has a lot more speed."

Kayleigh S, a 2022 New York Sire Stakes champion, and driver David Miller are 20-1 on the morning line. Winless in six races this season, she was fourth in her Oaks elim. The daughter of Chapter Seven-Pasithea Face S is a full sister to Joviality S.

"I'm not sure why, but it took a couple of starts for her to get going," Melander said. "She's a little bit bigger than her sister, so maybe it just took a couple of starts before she got in that form. The last two races have been very good. She is getting better and better with every start."

Three trainers have won the Hambletonian and Hambletonian Oaks in the same year: Jan Johnson in 1988, Jimmy Takter in both 2014 and 2015, and Jim Campbell in 2022.

Speaking of trainers with an opportunity to win both the Hambletonian and Hambletonian Oaks this year, Melander will be joined by Matt Bax, Ake Svanstedt and Ron Burke in pursuit of the two trophies.

Svanstedt, already a two-time winner of the Hambletonian, will send out Up Your Deo in Saturday's Hambletonian and Bond in the Oaks.

Up Your Deo won the first jewel in the Trotting Triple Crown, the MGM Yonkers Trot, on June 30 and will try to add the second by winning the Hambletonian. He will start the Hambletonian from post six with Svanstedt driving and is 15-1 on the morning line. He finished fifth in his elimination, which was his first start since the Yonkers Trot.

"I expected more from him in the elimination; I was not satisfied," Svanstedt said. "I hope he can be more sharp with just a week between races."

Up Your Deo, a son of Walner—Grand Stand, was winless in eight starts last year. He has three wins and a third in five races this season.

"He has been very good this year," Svanstedt said. "He was just a horse last year but coming back this year he's improved mentally. Last year, he was stubborn, but this year he fights. He wants to win. He's good gaited and is nice to drive. Everything is nice with him. I think he will be better (Saturday)."

Bond will start from post 3 in the Oaks with Svanstedt in the sulky and is 9-2 on the morning line. She finished fifth in her elim after getting to the opening quarter in a sizzling :25.4 and half in :53.4. Svanstedt made a bridle change prior to the race and plans to return to Bond's previous bridle on Saturday.

"I let her go into the (first) turn, there were four or five horses (leaving), but then she got fired up and I couldn't stop her," Svanstedt said. "I don't think there is anything wrong with her. It's just that she must behave."

Bond, a daughter of Southwind Frank—Boccone Dolce, has hit the board in 13 of 14 career races, winning 10. She had a ninerace win streak snapped on July 15 with a third-place finish in a division of the Delvin Miller Memorial.

"It was a tough race also, but she was just a little sick," Svanstedt said. "Normally, she is fast and strong."

Burke will send out two horses in the Hambletonian, morning line favorite Celebrity Bambino and Point Of Perfect. Both were elimination winners last week. In the Oaks, he will have Railee Something, who is the 7-2 second choice on the morning line after finishing second to Walner Payton in her elim.

Railee Something has hit the board in 17 of 20 races, winning 11. She will start Saturday from post five with driver Yannick Gingras.

"She's been very good every start," Burke said about the daughter of International Moni-Railee Priti. "We have to get her another

half-length finishing. If we can find a half-length finishing, she can go with those fillies. We'll make a bridle change with her. I think she's getting alongside of horses and hanging. We'll (make a change) to try to get her to surge by."

The Hambletonian Oaks is race 10 on Saturday's 16-race card, which begins at noon (EDT). The Hambletonian is race 12. For the day's complete entries, click **here**. For free TrackMaster programs, click **here**.

Chris Page and Ron Burke poised for big night at Eldorado Scioto Downs

The driver-trainer tandem have a horse in each of the six divisions of the Ohio State Fair Stakes on the same day Burke has two horses in the Hambletonian in New Jersey.

The 2023 Ohio State Fair Stakes wraps up Saturday night (Aug. 5) at Eldorado Scioto Downs and on paper it appears that the Chris Page/Ron Burke duo are poised for a big night.

Page has a drive in each of the six divisions of the OSF divisions, each one with a Burke trainee.

In the \$172,000 (div) Buckeye State Pace for freshman colt and gelding pacers, Page will steer Outer Banks (post 6) in the first division.

Outer Banks, the son of Downbytheseaside—Speedo Miss, has won half of his four seasonal starts, including the first two legs of the Ohio Sires Stakes. He was a solid third last time out one week ago at Scioto Downs in the third OHSS leg.

In the second division, Page will guide Midwind Beach Boy from post 8. The \$150,000 Next Generation champion followed up his seasonal debut win with a victory and a pair of second-place finishes in the Ohio Sire Stakes. He is the richest colt in the field by the virtue of his \$115,000 in earnings.

"[Midwind] is fast, but I have to take care of him. He acts like he can get hot. My job has been to make money and to keep him from getting too warm," said Page. "I have two really nice colts in this division. There is not too much that separates the two."

While the two may be close in talent, Outer Banks definitely drew into the tougher of the two \$86,000 divisions where he will have to face Janelle Granny, a winner of \$85,411, from the rail and Clever Cody (1:51.2f; \$56,800) from post 4.

Burke Racing Stable, RAS Racing and J & T Silva - Purnel & Libby own both colts and they added Weaver Bruscemi to the ownership group on Outer Banks and Knox Services on Midwind Beach Boy.





A pair of \$73,500 divisions of the 3-year-old colt trot will go postward for the Governor's Cup.

Rose Run Yorick, who was unraced at 2, is trying to make up for lost time. He has a 3-2-1 record in 13 starts. His mark of 1:56.2 was taken back in April in a NW1 event at Miami Valley Raceway.

"He is kind of a year behind the others. He is still finding his legs," said Page. "He's got a lot of talent and Ronnie really likes that horse."

The second division will see John Dutton, not the Kevin Costner Yellowstone character but the What The Hill—Fast Love gelding, go to the gate from post 3.

John Dutton is the fastest and the richest trotter in the division thanks to a 1:53.2 mile and his \$94,791 in 2023 earnings. He has six wins in just 11 seasonal starts.

"Johnny is as sharp as anyone right now," said Page.

Rose Run Yorick is campaigned by the partnership of Burke Racing Stable, Hatfield Stables, Knox Services and Weaver Bruscemi.

A \$33,000 yearling purchase at the 2022 Ohio Select Sale, John Dutton has earned nearly \$225,000 for Burke Racing Stable, Knox Services, Johnny Yoder and RAS Racing.

The night concludes with two divisions for sophomore colts in the \$149,700 (div) Director Of Agriculture Pace.

In the first division, Page had a choice between a pair of Burke trainees – Wicked Character (1:51.3f; \$137,800) and Act Fast (1:49.4f; \$259,452). Page passed on Wicked Character and

selected Act Fast, who won last weekend on Adios Day at The Meadows in his lifetime best time.

"[Act Fast] had a slow start to his 3-year-old campaign. I think he's turned the corner for the good," said Page.

Burke Racing Stable and Knox Services share ownership in the colt with Rich Lombardo Racing and Beasty LLC.

In the final OSF division, Page will be behind The Real Way, a winner of three straight races, including two OHSS legs.

"[The Real Way] has been ultra-sharp lately. He went the big mile last week to get the cheese. It was a very good race for him," said Page.

The homebred gelded son of Downbytheseaside—Real Diva is just \$12 short of \$200,000 in career earnings for breeders Burke Racing, Weaver Bruscemi and Knox Services, who co-own with the Let It Ride Stables.

The first Scioto Downs race on Saturday is scheduled about an hour and 15 minutes after the Hambletonian final is to be contested at The Meadowlands. Trainer Ron Burke will send out last week's elimination winners – Celebrity Bambino and Point Of Perfect — in a quest to win his first Hambletonian trophy, a point not lost on Page.

"Hopefully it all comes together and Ronnie gets his first Hambo win," said Page. "It looks like he has two very good shots to win."

"We feel that with the help of FOX and NYRA the Hambletonian tradition is ready for the public recognition it richly deserves," Settlemoir said. "This year, the Hambletonian will have an earlier post, which is expected to increase business not only in North America and Canada, but also in Europe, where the race will be shown late in the evening.

"With the race shown live on FOX, we expect the pool for the Hambletonian to break the \$1 million barrier, which is uncharted territory. The \$1 million plateau moves the sport, The Meadowlands and the Hambletonian to the next level. It's a magical moment for the sport."
