That innocent comment thanking his trainer/co-owner Ake Svanstedt, who drove Nordic Catcher S to victory in the 100th edition of America's Trotting Classic, and Ake's wife/assistant trainer Sarah, erupted into a bit of a firestorm on social media with people questioning whether something nefarious had taken place.

"To be honest, I was in shock that the horse won, and won so easily, as I really didn't think he could win, because I thought there were two or three horses in the race that were better, and I gave no thought to what I was going to say if he did win," Gural said. "I meant to simply compliment [trackman] Gary [Wolff], because the track was in great shape. I don't have to tell you the track was in great shape."

On Tuesday (Aug. 12), stories discussing the controversy appeared in the *Paulick Report*, written by Andrew Cohen, and in *DRF Harness*, written by Derick Giwner.

"When Andrew called me, I had no idea what he was talking about, because I had no recollection of what I'd said," Gural said. "It was such a thrill, and such an unexpected thrill that, you know, I didn't even remember what I said.

"And when he told me, I realized the horsemen would understand it, but to a novice, it probably sounded wrong. But there's no way I would ever tell Gary how to make the track to benefit any horses that I own."

Gural has had horses with the Svanstedts for about a dozen years now, and during that time, Sarah has not been shy about mentioning if she was unhappy with The Big M's track surface.

But it should be pointed out that The Meadowlands is not the only venue Sarah has on speed dial should the track conditions not meet with her liking.

Sarah said she has found that being so vocal can be a blessing and a curse, because, although it hopefully will help in the long run, it also attracts attention and makes you the messenger.

"She'll text me if the track is great, and she'll text me if the track needs water, and I'll forward it on to get to [Meadowlands chief operating officer/general manager] Jason [Settlemoir], typically, and, she'll also tell me what other people are telling her to tell me, because they know that she speaks to me as a horseperson,

so it's not the same as Jason speaking to me," Gural said. "So, for example, the drivers wanted the qualifiers changed from Saturday to Friday. So, she called me, and she said, 'The drivers asked me to call you to see if you would agree to change the qualifiers, because they're exhausted.' So that's why we changed."

According to Settlemoir, there are many trainers that have reached out over time regarding watering the track, including Nancy Takter and both Marcus and Mattias Melander. Marcus trained four of the starters in the 2025 Hambletonian, which most certainly benefited from the springy track surface that day.

In an effort to respond to their trainers, The Meadowlands has gone so far as to set up meetings between the trainers and Wolff.

Sarah said she knows that sometimes the racetracks she contacts may get tired of hearing from her, but she's not going to change.

"I said to Jason, 'It's not just the complaints from us," Sarah said. "People are talking to us because they know I am stubborn. They know I will speak up. And I said, 'The day I'm going to give up my voice for the horses' care, then I shouldn't do this anymore."

Three years ago, Sarah came up with a creative way of helping the track situation at The Big M.

"That's when I said to Jason, 'Can I put a logo on the water truck?" Sarah said. "I can pay whatever, just to get our name to go around the track, the water truck has to go then, right?' He said, 'Yeah, you can do that."

Following Gural's "water" gate, questions were also raised regarding the fact that watering the track was more important

to the Svanstedts because they pulled shoes on Nordic Catcher S in the Hambletonian, but according to Sarah that was not a factor.

"If they go with shoes or not, they still need a healthy track for their bones and ligaments and joints," she said. "It's just common sense. That's why it's so hard to understand the people that want this tough, rough, hard surface for those poor horses. Everyone thinks differently, but if you think of it like I said in the comment, how would you like to race on concrete with steel shoes?

"I just cannot comprehend why they want this hard track. That's why I said to Gary, 'Can you please find the interview with Dexter [Dunn].' He was on In The Sulky with the story he told about Bulldog [Hanover] when he went [in 1:45.4] and the sky opened up, like an hour prior to the race, and they were concerned. How is this going to go now, because pacers need concrete to go fast? And then it got so much water, and he went :45."

Nordic Catcher S went a lifetime and stakes best mile of 1:50 on Hambletonian Day without shoes, which shouldn't have come as a big surprise since he went 1:50.3 the week before in his Hambletonian elim with shoes on a track surface that Sarah wasn't thrilled with.

Sarah also explained that on Hambletonian Day, long before the races started, she simply texted Gural to remind the track staff to start drenching the track early because it was going to be a hot day and the track would dry out quicker.

"I didn't say a specific way of doing the track," Sarah said. "Starting to do the job two, two-and-a-half hours prior to the races starting, that's the key for the whole card, because you only have so much time in between the races.

"Like I tried to explain for Gary, I said, 'You cannot start baking a cake and put it in and then, pull it out in five minutes when it needs 30 minutes.' I didn't get an answer to that."

Both Gural and Sarah have been quoted before in this column talking about their playful back-and-forth regarding water, or lack thereof, in the track surface at The Meadowlands.


"Of course, again, it came out wrong, but in his happy moment, like I said, it was just a funny joke," Sarah said. "But, like I said, this has been an ongoing thing. So, I would say horsepeople, Meadowlands, New Jersey people, they know about this problem."

Gural said he was extremely sorry that his joking remark was misunderstood.

"Ninety-five per cent of the time that Sarah calls, I don't have a horse racing that night, so all I care about is that the racing surface is as good as possible for the health of the horses," Gural said. "And I feel the same way about Tioga and Vernon. And if somebody calls me to complain about the track surface at either of those tracks, I'll immediately get on the phone and address it."

As for Sarah, she plans to keep being a vocal advocate for horses.

"Like I said, I don't just care for the Svanstedt horses, I care for all horses, and that's why I'm trying," she said. "I am not going to give up my voice for the horses. I'm not ever going to do that. So, you know what? At least I feel good when I care for them

Stars set to collide at Pocono throughout Sun Stakes Saturday card

The highly-anticipated first-time matchup between Miki And Minnie and Chantilly is just one of many explosive battles on the highly anticipated annual card

Traditionally, the James Lynch Memorial for 3-year-old filly pacers doesn't rise to the level of attraction of the other headlined stakes on the Sun Stakes Saturday card at Pocono, but that's not the case this year. For that matter, even this year's Delmonica Hanover for 3-year-old filly trotters one could argue is just as highly anticipated as the stakes for 3-year-old males — the Earl Beal Memorial or Max Hempt Memorial.

Starting with the Lynch, it's going to be take two as last year's respective Dan Patch and O'Brien winners Miki And Minnie and Chantilly take stage to do battle for the first time. These two were first set to square off in the Fan Hanover final at Woodbine Mohawk Park in June, but Chantilly scratched due to sickness in a race that Miki And Minnie would go onto win – narrowly.

Since that time, both star fillies have been once beaten this year (first time in her career for Chantilly), but it doesn't take any luster away at all from the matchup. Miki And Minnie enters the Lynch with a four-race winning streak, three of which came at The Meadowlands including a 1:48.3 win two back in the Shady Daisy which tied her career best mark set in that Fan Hanover win.

For all the deserved talk of Miki And Minnie and Chantilly, the filly Rodeo Drive Deo shouldn't be overlooked. In fact, the last time she and Miki And Minnie raced at Pocono, Rodeo Drive Deo tracked that rival down off cover to win fair and square. Rodeo Drive Deo hasn't had the same success in nearly any other race against Miki And Minnie as readily evident by her past performance lines, but she may be able to stalk nicely from the starting rail position and launch one move to touch off everyone.

As for Chantilly, HRU's **Melissa Keith detailed her first defeat** last week, though Keith handled the subject with more grace than I would have. I know what happened is far from unprecedented or even uncommon, but feel that a filly that was an unbeaten 13-for-13 across two racing seasons deserved better than that. For all the work that went into those wins — and I'd imagine the pride in having never been beaten — why give away a first loss like that?

You can't wager based on emotion obviously, but the race from last week doesn't sit well. When you combine that with the fact that Chantilly is racing outside of Woodbine Mohawk Park for the first time, races on a smaller-sized track for the first time, and draws an unfavorable post position compared to her top rivals in the race, there are legitimate reasons you could play against her. There's tremendous anticipation to see how this race plays out as the first of the four consecutive main (non-consolation) stakes.

Moving from the pacing fillies to the trotting ones in the next race, Hambletonian Oaks heroine Conversano returns since that win two weeks ago and is going to face a set of stiff foes. No disrespect at all to the deserving New Jersey Sires Stakes and now Oaks champion who has now won five of her last six and seven of nine on the year overall, but her 5-2 programmed favoritism is likely going to give way to presumed post-time favorite Yo Tillie, who meets up with many of these for the first time this year.

Through five starts this year while non-Hambletonian Oaks eligible, Yo Tillie has been spectacular. Between four races at The Meadowlands and the most recent in Lexington, no other filly has yet to get any closer than a three-length margin. Post 7 isn't ideal, but there's no chance she's taking back early in her shot against the division's best with the money on the line.

Also in the mix is What A Bid Hanover, who comes off breaks in consecutive races but is a proven elite-level filly. I sometimes think Ake Svanstedt enjoys making things difficult for her just to see what she's made of, and her race last out in the Continentalvictory was no exception to that when she had to advance uncovered from last before making a break and she was about to engage up to the leader.

Another one to watch out for could be Delaney Hanover. Huge in her Oaks elimination win two back, she had a regrettable trip in the Oaks final when stacked fourth-over into the cover flow led by a 70-1 chance, before doing all she could do to fly home when three-wide in :26.3 to make it somewhat interesting late from an impossible spot. For a filly though that doesn't customarily show speed, it could be an uphill battle once again trying to close in this environment.

Next up comes the Max Hempt for the 3-year-old glamour boy division and unlike the prior two races, there is familiarity here between the market principles. In recent weeks, Prince Hal Hanover has done well to solidify his position at the top of the division (in my estimation), but we'll see how long-lived it is as possible rightful owner of that spot Louprint qualified back this past week with a vengeance. Prince Hal Hanover has been exceptional with driver Todd McCarthy and following that first-placed-second Meadowlands Pace last month, he came back with a 1:48.1 score in the Adios and then just last week captured the Carl Milstein at Northfield with a fairly stress-free win on the front there in 1:50.1. Starting from the rail in the Hempt, I'd imagine he won't want to be sitting worse than second at any point.

Messenger champion Twisted Destiny has had it tough in his last two. Used extremely hard early in the Adios final, he hung in there pretty well considering. Then, last out, he did all he could to try to close off cover on the half-mile at Northfield and land second while not having a reasonable chance to catch the leader. He remains right there near the top of the division as does Captain Optimistic who has now put together a couple of strong consecutive wins. Most notable was his most recent start in the Cane Pace on Hambletonian Day when he had to wait after having Madden Oaks get a couple of lengths jump on him before being able to angle and then confidently track down that rival anyway in a career-best time of 1:48.1.

Not to be overlooked is Swingtown, who was a fast-charging second in the Adios three back and then was third last week in the Milstein. The posts are poor for both Manolete and Papis Pistol but even they aren't impossible either if the race somehow sets up for closers.

Anchoring the four major stakes is the Earl Beal and this race looks different than perhaps it could have as recently as a week ago. With it being announced earlier in the week that Hambletonian winner Nordic Catcher S would be out for the remainder of the year with injury, along with top 3-year-old Maryland not entering, the two that conventional wisdom would say stand out in the race become Super Chapter and Emoticon Legacy. The Hambletonian reflected the first time this year each horse was defeated.

For Super Chapter, what looked like a good 2-hole trip in that race turned out to be less than ideal when the leader was passed by Nordic Catcher S and tried his best to close into an uphill task by that point. Emoticon Legacy was just an even third-over in that race where none of those coming off cover were particularly advancing through the stretch.

As for other alternatives, Meshuggah caught the eye in his Hambletonian elimination two back with a flying finish following a shuffle to last and then once again had stretch traffic troubles in the Hambletonian final; he's back to Scott Zeron now also. Gap Kronos S had noticeable late trot to offer in the Hambletonian deep to the inside and don't forget he actually proved better than Nordic Catcher S when those two raced against each other in the Reynolds at the end of June at The Meadowlands. Onajetplane steps up but comes off a couple of nice wins, including a career best 1:51 two back, and now lands the rail.

On first visit to the U.S. Jack Callaghan wins two races at The Meadowlands

Top young Aussie driver Jack Callaghan lived his dream last weekend.

Callaghan, 23, was born into a strong and passionate harness racing family and winning a race at the iconic Meadowlands track — let alone two as he did last weekend — was fairytale stuff.

"It's something I'd dreamed of since I was a little kid and to get a double the first night I drove anywhere in the U.S., let alone The Meadowlands, is just awesome," Callaghan said.

"This isn't just the first time I've driven in the States, it's the first time I've ever been there. So, to get these opportunities on a trip when I've really gone to meet people, visit some stables and learn, is pretty incredible."

Callaghan's instant success fuelled speculation Down Under he could make the U.S. home, but he quickly dismissed that.

"I'd definitely look at a move at some stage, but not in the short term," he said.

"It's so hard to get into the U.S. full-time now. I'd say it's something for down the track, maybe three, four or five years from now.

"I didn't come on this trip to get drives. I came because I've read and heard so much about the racing in the U.S. and have always wanted to see it firsthand.

"I know lots of people here, so it's opened doors to visit stables, catch-up with friends and, most importantly, learn heaps to go home a better driver and horseman."

The Meadowlands opportunities last Saturday (Aug. 9) came about by chance.

"I heard lots of the top drivers would be away at Northfield Park and others would be driving at Yonkers, so they might be short of drivers at The Meadowlands," Callaghan said. "I contacted the stewards, who they call starters over here, and told them I was available if they wanted.

"I couldn't believe it when I picked up eight drives."

I feel you get your chance pretty much every time in the races here, especially at The Meadowlands. Back home the barrier draws are just so important, but here not as much. You can work your way into a position. I think it makes for fairer racing for all horses to get their chance.

Along with his two winners – Gazoo in race 5 (for trainer Veronica Spicer) and Ayr Pioneer GB in race 12 (for Besim Odza) – Callaghan also snared a third and a fourth.

Callaghan said he hopes to become a frequent site on the winning drivers' list.

"I'll just make myself available when I'm needed, but I love driving and will whenever they want me," he said.

There should be plenty of opportunities with Callaghan's holiday, which started on July 28, stretching until the end of September.

"I'm not missing much at home," he said. "There's the big TAB Eureka meeting, but that's really a one-off. I didn't have a drive in it.

"So, I can stay here another eight weeks or so and then things will get busier back in Australia."

Callaghan has been staying with Todd McCarthy, one of the biggest Aussie success stories in the U.S.

"It's great to catch-up with Toddy, who is a mate and someone I've always looked up to," Callaghan said. "What he's done over here is just incredible.

"I already have or will visit the stables of Noel Daley, the Takters and Brett Pelling and I'll also get down to Lexington, where it all seems to be buzzing at the moment.

"I'm just loving soaking it all in and seeing how things are done over here. The driving is an added bonus."

James Herbertson and Ryan Sanderson, Western Australia's Deni Roberts and Queenslander Angus Garrard.

Callaghan boasts over 800 wins in Australia, including seven at the Group 1 level.

After starting out with his father, around the Newcastle area, Callaghan moved to work for Luke McCarthy's stable for a number of years.

In recent times, he has worked alongside the hugely successful young NSW trainer Jason Grimson and done much of his stable driving.

"I don't have too many set plans when I get back home because finally getting over here and experiencing it all became a priority," he said. "I'd kept pushing back coming over because I'd had nice horses with target races back home, but this was the time to park everything and do it."

Callaghan has been surprised by how different the racing is in the U.S.

"So, different; completely different," he said. "The whole racing style, the rules are so very different.

"I feel you get your chance pretty much every time in the races here, especially at The Meadowlands.

"Back home the barrier draws are just so important, but here not as much. You can work your way into a position.

"I think it makes for fairer racing for all horses to get their chance."


Macomber stable on the fast track with Swiss Lights

Tonight (Aug. 15), Swiss Lights looks to add his fourth seasonal win in the opener at Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino. Conditioned and piloted by Ricky Macomber, Jr., the Rockin Image—Shes Lights Out gelding already has an Indiana Sire Stakes victory under his belt, and last week he captured the 99th edition of the Fox Stake at the Indiana State Fair. Although he has been fast out of the gate among the youngsters in the division, he's still learning the game.

"I think he is still green and learning," Macomber, Jr. said. "He is still kind of acting like each start is his first start, looking at everything and wanting to be aggressive. We are working on manners every day."

Swiss Lights sold at last year's Hoosier Classic Sale as part of the 3-D Farms consignment. Offered around 100 horses into

the sale's second session, the colt is the second foal from a Somebeachsomewhere mare that earned more than \$160,000 on the track, and whose dam is the \$670,000 earner Arts Diva. At the time of purchase, Jamie Macomber served as trainer for the Macomber stable, and picked out the yearling, paying \$27,000 as agent for Doug Overhiser.

"He made the list because of his breeding and he was on my dad's short list as well," she explained. "He was my perfect size and he was beautiful. He had a slight toe in and that was me looking really hard for a fault."


Joining Overhiser in the ownership group are Bermuda-based owners Arnold Manders, and Joseph Vieira. They are new owners for the Macomber stable, but long-time participants in pony racing and harness racing.

"They came with our second trainer," Jamie said. "They are like family to Ki Waldron, who is also from Bermuda. I met them for the first time when they were here for the colt's first start."

Within a few months of the Hoosier Classic's conclusion, Jamie took on the role of co-sale manager, now under new ownership and branded the Midwest Standardbred Horse Sale. That left Ricky to take over the training duties. As the winter turned to spring, Swiss Lights displayed all the right traits, but needed an education.

"He showed a lot of raw speed but he had no idea what to do with it," Ricky said. "He would have speed bursts, so we had to teach him what to do with it and use it when we asked. He just wanted to go fast and beat the others, so, yes, he showed signs, but he has come a long way with managing his speed and himself."

While he may be a budding star for the stable, in the barn he is located beside one of the Macombers' bona fide standouts, Dover In Motion. And he is already learning from his trotting counterpart and winner of more than \$680,000 lifetime.

"His stall is next to Dover In Motion, so he has developed a love for apples with 'Dover," Ricky said. "You can't just give Dover apples anymore."

Bred by Merlie Schwartz, Swiss Lights handled his first taste of competition with ease. Qualifying in mid-June at Hoosier Park, the freshman took control after the quarter and then breezed to a six-length advantage at the wire, stopping the clock in 1:55.2. He would return June 25 to win his pari-mutuel debut with Ricky in the bike, finishing over three lengths in front as the favorite in a time of 1:54.2.

"I didn't know what to expect because you don't know what everyone else has," the trainer/driver said of the gelding's first few attempts. "I did know he was doing everything right and doing it well, and he had the speed."

That speed was on full display in the opening round of sire stakes competition July 11 at the Anderson oval. Sent off as the second choice behind Jk The Great in a \$66,500 division, Ricky and Swiss Lights patiently sat third through the mile before dashing home in :26.3. The duo edged Jk The Great and Marcus Miller by a half-length, pacing the mile in 1:52.4.

In the second leg they tangled with the talented Dancingdreamer and Royal Richie Doyle. Despite posting the fastest last quarter in the field (:25.3) and timed in 1:52, the gelding had to settle for third behind the other two.


Between sire stakes legs, Ricky dropped Swiss Lights into Grand Circuit action in Indianapolis on Aug. 6. In against three

others in the \$45,093 Fox Stake, the freshman wired the field to win by a half-length in 1:52.2. The Fox Stake victory was the second in three years for the stable. In 2023, Warrior For Truth would be declared the winner weeks after the contest due to the disqualification of Tellmeitmatters. The couple didn't get to experience the winner's circle presentation then. All that changed last week, and it was special.

"It means a lot, every win means something, just some more than others," Jamie said. "I am not from Indiana, but have been here longer than I have been in one place my entire life. To me, we race at the State Fair for the Fox Stake. We go to the State Fair for the Fox Stake, so it is awesome to win it. It also has memories for me as a kid traveling to the Indiana State Fair for the Grand Circuit with my parents when we had the stock. For Ricky, this one meant more because he actually won the race — rather than being placed — and he had never won the Fox Stake."

Swiss Lights starts from post 3 in the first of two Indiana Sire Stakes divisions tonight at Hoosier Park, a \$66,000 contest that has drawn six entries. He is in against three other winners led by the Ron Burke-trained What Nooo Waaay, a victor in sire stakes both in Indiana and Kentucky this season.

On Wednesday (Aug. 13), The Red Mile hosted two \$80,000 second round legs of the Kentucky Championship Series for sophomore filly pacers and male trotters, two \$30,000 second round Kentucky Commonwealth Series divisions for 3-year-old male trotters, and five second round \$15,000 Kentucky Golden Rod Series for 3-year-olds of both gaits and sexes.

LOOKSGOODINLOULOU, MR MOUTON HAVE THEIR PICTURES TAKEN IN CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES

Yannick Gingras and **Looksgoodinloulou** handed favored Unreasonable (Marcus Miller) her first loss in her last five starts in the division for 3-year-old filly pacers in 1:48.4. Caviart Delight (Scott Zeron) was third.

Trained by Ron Burke, world champion Looksgoodinloulou was one of the top fillies in her division last year and was second by a nose to champion Miki And Minnie in the \$400,000 Championship Series final last fall.

This year the filly was not quite exhibiting the same form she had last year and entered a fifth behind Unreasonable last week.

This week, the daughter of Sweet Lou—Looksgoodinaromper was assigned the rail. Unreasonable went straight to the lead from post position 4 in the field of five. That filly set fractions of :27, :54.1 and 1:22.3 with Looksgoodinloulou merely following her lead in second.

As the fillies entered the final drive to the wire, Looksgoodinloulou simply outfinished Unreasonable with a final quarter in :26. Unreasonable held her own with her panel in :26.1 but turned up on the short end of the wire.

Bred by Burke Racing Stable and Weaver Bruscemi, Looksgoodinloulou is owned by her breeders in addition to Lawrence Karr and Phillip Collura.

The filly paid \$9.92 to win. Her record stands at 14 7-3-0 and she has banked \$384,087.



Fresh off his world-record equaling effort, favored **Mr Mouton** (Dexter Dunn) wired the field of eight to take the Championship division for sophomore male trotters in 1:51.4 for trainer Ake Svanstedt. Gimpanzee Dancer (Andrew McCarthy) was second and longshot Mountcastle (Zeron, 67-1) was third.

There's not really much to tell about this contest, as Mr Mouton began trotting from post position 6 and went straight to the top. He set splits of :28, :56.3 and 1:25.1 en route to victory. He was provided with a brief tussle at the top of lane as Gimpanzee Dancer pulled within a head but it was to no avail.

Bred by R. Kevin Greenfield, Mr Mouton is an altered son of Chapter Seven and the Father Patrick mare Burberry. He now has two consecutive wins at The Red Mile since finishing fifth in his Hambletonian elimination on July 26.

Mr Mouton only started once as a 2-year-old in a New York Sire Stakes event at Saratoga Harness, but he did break his maiden and defeated Kentucky champion and \$1 million Hambletonian second-place finisher Super Chapter.

The gelding was purchased for \$140,000 by Knutson Trotting, Little E LLC, Stolz Geiger and Jorgen Sparredal Inc. under the name Count Seven.

Mr Mouton paid \$2.38 to win. He possesses a resume of 7 4-2-0 and has earned \$143,713.

The son of Chapter Seven—Fatima Blush was bred by Marvin Katz, Sam Goldband and Al Libfeld. He was purchased at the 2023 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale for \$47,000 by James Crawford IV, Charles Rowe, David Miller and Lawrence Means.

Chat Room paid \$4.50 to win. He has amassed \$250,547 in purse money with a record of 18 6-2-3.

Global Sensation and Dunn took the second division of this series in 1:52.3 as the favorite for trainer Marcus Melander. Precise Landing (David Miller) was second and Onemore Volo (Todd McCarthy) was third.

The son of Chapter Seven—Fly Angel Fly wired the field of seven.

Global Sensation was bred by Al Libfeld, Marvin Katz and Sam Goldband. He was purchased for \$160,000 at the 2023 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale by Holly Lane Stud East, Daniel Plouffe and Jean Plouffe.

The gelding's record is now 19 4-4-3 and he has earned \$131,325. Global Sensation paid \$4.60 to win.

FLOSSY HILL WINS FIRST GOLDEN ROD SERIES DIVISION

Joining Flossy Hill (Todd McCarthy, \$19.16) as Golden Rod Series winners on the day were Whiskey Wow (David Miller, \$11.98), JK Fancy Nancy (Dunn, \$6.62), Ake Palema (Zeron, \$2.82) and Manforce (Dunn, \$9.16).

HIGHLAND KISMET SAILS OVER THE RED MILE SURFACE

Highland Kismet set a track record for his age, gait and sex in 1:50.1 in an open handicap which went off as the first race on a 16-race card.

Sent off as the second choice in the field of seven, Highland Kismet and Tim Tetrick wired the field in 1:50.1 to etch their names in The Red Mile record books for trainer Nancy Takter.

Leaving from post position 5, the 4-year-old gelded son of Father Patrick—Highland Top Hill took control from the outset and established fractions of :27, :54.4 and 1:22.2. Spy Coast (Yannick Gingras) chased admirably and also trotted a :27.4 final panel but simply his efforts were in vain. Longshot Tom's Muscle (Ernie Hendry, 44-1) closed for third.

Bred by Highland Thoroughbred Frm, Highland Kismet is no stranger to The Red Mile's winner's circle as he won a \$85,300

division of the Bluegrass Stake in Lexington last fall. The gelding, who was second in last year's \$1.05 million Hambletonian to Karl, collected his first win from five starts this season and first for new conditioner, Takter, who took over the reins several months ago.

Highland Kismet has a record of 22 9-2-0 and has earned \$540,056.

The gelding paid \$7.26 to his supporters, and the time is a new lifetime mark.

BURKE COLLECTS WIN 16,000

On another steamy day Tuesday (Aug. 12), conditioner Ron Burke breaks yet another of his own records to continue rewriting harness racing history. The Hall of Famer captured his 16,000th career race at The Red Mile when **Kimpanzee** (Yannick Gingras) crossed the line in 1:54.2 in the seventh event, a \$10,000 Wildcat Series division, on the 17-race card.

There are not enough superlatives in the dictionary to describe Burke's achievements or what he has established in harness racing. Actually, there is no trainer, present or past or possibly in the future that can rival his accomplishments.

Take for example, the training standings this season. Burke has already collected nearly 300 more victories and more than \$8 million in earnings over his nearest competitor.

Saying he towers over the opposition is an understatement.

All this transpired from a child that told this reporter more than a decade ago, he was afraid of horses as a youngster and became involved in the sport due to his late, great father, Mickey Burke.

A Canonsburg, PA resident, Burke is based at The Meadows with his 300-head strong "Burke Brigade," yet relayed he was thrilled to hit this milestone in the Bluegrass.

"Really happy it happened here [at The Red Mile]," he said. "My new home away from home."

Burke has now amassed an astounding \$359 million from 74,111 trips to the post as of this writing.

How many champions has Burke been responsible for? There is Foiled Again, the highest earning standardbred of all-time (Dragon Again, \$7.63 million), Sweet Lou (Yankee Cruiser, \$3.47 million), Atlanta (Chapter Seven, \$3.12 million), Hannelore Hanover (Swan For All, \$3.06 million), Buck I St Pat (Jailhouse Jesse, \$2.32 million), Southwind Frank (Muscle Hill, \$1.95 million), Warrawee Ubeaut (Sweet Lou, \$1.84 million) and Mission Brief (Muscle Hill, \$1.59). His most recent star is Louprint. (Sweet Lou, \$1.18 million).

Burke also owns 20 Breeders Crown trophies which is second all-time behind only fellow Hall of Famer Jimmy Takter, with many more to come.

Aiding his trainer to reach the 16,000-win milestone was **Sippinonsearoc** (Gingras) in the \$80,000 second leg of this

series for sophomore male pacers in a geared down 1:48.2 as the heavy favorite. Crack Shot (Doug McNair) was second and Captain Arturovico (Geremy Bobbitt) was third.

Captain Arturovico left the gate on top and established the first split of :26.3 while Sippinonsearoc was second. Gingras, however, did not wait long to move his horse to the front as the gelding went by the half-mile marker in :53.4 and the three-quarter pole in 1:21.2. The son of Downbytheseaside—Queen Ann M was never seriously challenged.

The fastest 2-year-old in history was bred by Trent Stohler and Alesha Binkley. He was purchased by his trainer, Weaver Bruscemi, R A S Racing and Knox Services Inc. for \$77,000 at the 2023 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale.

He is the first foal out of an Ohio champion and paid \$2.44 to win.

Sippinonsearoc has a record of 20 9-4-2 and has earned \$720,900 in purse money.

Luna Lovegood (Dexter Dunn) scored her first triumph of the season in four starts in the division for 3-year-old filly trotters in 1:53.1 for trainer Marcus Melander. R Lady W (Scott Zeron) was a neck back in second with Stash Some Cash (Tim Tetrick) completing the trifecta.

Todd McCarthy and Voguish left from post position 5 in the field of five and set all the fractions of :28.4, :56.3 and 1:24.4 while Luna Lovegood (post position 4) sat in the garden spot (second) throughout the mile. Dunn gave his filly her instructions at the top of the lane and she trotted home for

her first win since the \$116,600 Matron Stake at Dover Downs on Nov. 11, 2024.

A daughter of Gimpanzee – Southwind Venus, Luna Lovegood improved her resume to 14 6-1-1 and her bankroll to \$422,010.

The filly was bred by Blue Chip Farms and Stefan Melander. She was purchased for \$100,000 at the 2023 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale by Holly Lane Stud East Ltd.

Luna Lovegood was favored in the Breeders Crown last year for her age, sex and gait and has experienced some trouble staying on stride this season. She is a half-sister to Miss I LA (Walner, \$437,508).

The filly paid \$11.88 to her supporters as the third choice.

KADENA, WINNPANZEE, STRANGERINTHENIGHT WIN COMMONWEALTH SERIES SPLITS

Favored **Kadena** (Andrew McCarthy) wired the field in 1:52.3 to win the first \$30,000 division of this series by a head over My Honor (Gingras) and Grand Reserve (Zeron).

The sophomore daughter of Gimpanzee and world champion Mission Brief is trained by Melander.

Kadena was bred by Mission Brief Stables and was the sales topper at the 2023 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale at \$800,000 for owners Jeffrey Snyder and S R F Stable.

The filly paid \$4.18 to win. She has now collected \$158,017 and her record is 14 5-3-1.

Strangerinthenight paid \$6.14 to win. She is the first foal out of a world champion and O'Brien Award winning dam.





Big payday for My Debt Collecter in New York Sire Stakes at Yonkers

My Debt Collecter came from off-the-pace to take Tuesday night's (Aug. 12) \$174,000 New York Sire Stakes race for 3-year-old trotting fillies at MGM Yonkers Raceway.

Driven by Tyler Buter, My Debt Collecter settled into the sixth spot while Calculus Risk (Jeff Gregory) went to the point and cut the opening quarter in 28 seconds flat. Race favorite Chapvious (Jason Bartlett) then tipped to the outside from third on the second turn, and she would work her way around Calculus Risk, clearing just after the :57.1 half-mile marker.

The outer tier developed when Sonmar Pond (Matt Kakaley) swung off the pylons from fourth beyond the half, which gave cover to My Debt Collecter. However, Sonmar Pond was unable to reach Chapvious, who was clear to three-quarters in 1:26.2 and around the final bend as well, as Buter sent My Debt Collecter into a three-wide position for the stretch drive.

Chapvious had the tactical advantage on the engine, but My Debt Collecter and Calculus Risk both had trot to her outside in the lane, and it would be My Debt Collecter's :29.1 final quarter that propelled her to the victory by a half-length in 1:56.4. Calculus Risk was a solid second as Chapvious faded to third. Sonmar Pond wound up fourth over Royal Mission (Brett Beckwith).

Nifty Norman trains My Debt Collecter, a daughter of Chapter Seven, for co-owners/breeders David McDuffee, Mel Hartman and Little E LLC. She has nine wins, seven seconds and three thirds from 19 career starts, has earned \$527,618 and paid \$8.60 to win as the 3-1 third choice. She was atop a \$56.50 exacta and a \$237.50 trifecta.

In a non-wagering \$20,000 Excelsior Series division, **Made Of Dreams**, a Chapter Seven filly bred by Buckstone Land Livestock, took the lead from the pocket before three-quarters and went on to a 1:57.2 win for driver Jason Bartlett, trainer Joe Bongiorno and owners Glenn Goller and Stephen Demeter.

There was also another Excelsior Series flight on the parimutuel card, and **Flashchap**, by Chapter Seven and bred by John Cummins, tallied from first-up in 1:58.4 with Tyler Buter in the bike for trainer George Ducharme and owner Purple Haze Stables LLC.

New York Sire Stakes action at MGM Yonkers Raceway concludes for this year tonight (Aug. 15) with a single \$174,000 contest for sophomore pacing fillies, and a pair of \$20,000 Excelsior Series splits will also take place.

MGM Yonkers Raceway is currently operating on a Monday/ Tuesday and Thursday through Saturday live racing schedule with post time each night at 6:45 p.m. (EDT).



Butenschoen wins 2,000th career race

John Butenschoen captured the 2,000th training victory of his decades long career when **R Zee** was victorious in a division of The Wildcat series at The Red Mile on Monday (Aug. 11). Scott Zeron was in the bike for Butenschoen.

"My wife [Jackie] has been counting down the wins to [2,000] but I wasn't," Butenschoen said. "Of course, it means something, especially to win 2,000 with a horse that is owned by people who have trusted me for so many years. And honestly, I could never have reached this point without my owners, my staff and all the support I've been so fortunate to have."

Ever humble, Butenschoen began training in his home state and was introduced to harness racing by his father at age 12 when his father Walter, and a family friend happened to purchase a horse to compete at Maywood Park.

The horse happened to be trained by Bob Welch, trainer Roger's father. The two boys became friends and the rest as they say is history.

Butenschoen became involved in the yearling game with Doc Walker and Roger hooked him up with Delvin Miller. Through his work with the legendary Miller, he met his wife, Jackie.

After four years of working with Miller, Butenschoen set out on his own and remained based in Illinois for more than two decades while training some young horses on the circuits in Pennsylvania, New York, etc.

When the winds of change began to shift in Illinois, Butenschoen relocated to Wind Gap, PA and wintered in South Florida with his good friends the Pinskes.

"My career has been all about relationships," Butenschoen said. "Some of this business is just happenstance and maintaining those relationships. That's how I was able to meet Doc Walker and the Crawfords in Morrisville at a yearling sale when they were just starting out."

His penchant for friendships has certainly served Butenschoen well. The 62-year-old has earned \$36,999 million as of this writing from 13,694 starts. He is known for his work with young horses, especially trotters.

Butenschoen, however, sees his achievement as notice to shift gears.

"It's time to take a step back and let Tyler [his son] make a name for himself," he said. "He and Lindsay [one of his essential staff workers] already handle so much. Tyler is so passionate about the work and you have to be in this business, but with any agricultural endeavor it takes time to transition.

"So, it will take time to pass off the torch to Tyler and I will also have to talk to my owners and see if it is OK to take a week or two off here and there. There are a lot of things I have missed and with some health news about my dad and his best friend, I don't wait until I'm older to do things. Also, the business is so different now. I can use Facetime no matter where I am to look at horses jogging or have meetings."

Butenschoen already has a plan, but of course, it is not solely his own.

"My wife has really always wanted to go to Alaska," he said. "So, she has been looking everything up to book a cruise. I spoke with Tim Hayes and Megan and they took a Viking Cruise up there and had a great time. It will be nice not to be 24-7 doing this and spend some time with my wife."

Lately at The Meadowlands, you can expect the unexpected.

First of all, there is normally no live racing after the Hambletonian, but The Big M resumed action last week the Friday (Aug. 8) after the 100th edition of the Hambletonian, with the first of six weeks of harness action that will go until Saturday (Sept. 13).

In addition, this week — and next — there will only be one day of racing to accommodate the large crowds anticipated for

preseason football at MetLife Stadium, so this week, racing will be conducted tonight (Aug. 15) and go dark on Saturday (Aug. 16), before next week finds no racing on Friday (Aug. 22), and then live action resuming on Saturday (Aug. 23). Post time is the normal 6:20 p.m.

Confused? Don't worry about it. Just remember to be at the mile oval tonight for a special betting opportunity.

Last Saturday (Aug. 9), the Late 50-cent Pick-4 sequence was won by horses at odds of 6-1, 42-1, 7-1 and 6-1, which resulted in the first 50-cent Pick-4 carryover of 2025.

There will be \$26,408 in the hat before betting begins on the Big M's most-popular puzzle on tonight's 10th race.

With the carryover not subject to the already low 15 per cent takeout, the action figures to be fast and furious.

For example(s):

- Were \$100,000 in "new money" put in play, that would create a total pool of \$111,408, which means a return to players with winning tickets of 111 per cent.
- Were \$150,000 in "new money" put in play, that would create a total pool of \$153,908, which means a return to players with winning tickets of 102 per cent.
- Were \$200,000 in "new money" put in play, that would create a total pool of \$196,408, which means a return to players with winning tickets of 98 per cent.

"These are the types of opportunities our players love," said Big M chief operating officer/general manager Jason Settlemoir. "Whenever you combine our low-takeout multi-leg wagers with a carryover, it creates a lot of excitement, especially in the Pick-4, which does not see carryovers very often."

ANOTHER CARRYOVER? Yes, indeed, the Pick-4 is not the only carryover on tonight's program.

The 20-cent Pick-6, which began with a 6-5 shot and a 10-1 chance before the Pick-4 races completed the sequence last week, will offer a \$4,028 carryover when the bet begins on race 8.

FOR CLARITY, THE SCHEDULE: In a departure of what usually takes place after Hambletonian Day, racing will continue at The Big M on a Friday-Saturday basis through Sept. 13. Post time will be the normal 6:20 p.m.

There will be two exceptions. Due to preseason football at MetLife Stadium, there will be no live action on Saturday (Aug. 16) and Friday (Aug. 22).

WHO ARE THESE GUYS? They'll be new faces and voices broadcasting the action tonight.

Dave Little is back on the Sam McKee Memorial Broadcast Set and will be the host. He will sit alongside co-host Anthony Stabile, a longtime thoroughbred and standardbred commentator who called the Big M card last Friday.

On the microphone from the best seat in the house will be harness driver, owner, commentator and voice of Oak Grove Racing Peter Kleinhans, who has been the full-time announcer at a handful of tracks during his career.

Joe Romanelli, the former track announcer at Freehold Raceway and the current voice of the qualifiers and baby races at The Big M, will be handling interviews from the back paddock as well as providing commentary and selections on the FanDuel Television (FDTV) feed.

BIG M GOES NATIONAL: For a fifth consecutive year, the TV teams at the New York Racing Association (NYRA) and The Meadowlands are combining forces to bring high-caliber harness racing stakes events to a coast-to-coast audience over the networks of FOX Sports as part of NYRA's "America's Day at the Races" telecasts.

The next broadcast will be Friday (Sept. 5), when the New Jersey Classic Series finals take center stage.

After moving third over, Come N Get Me was more than four lengths back in sixth place at the three-quarter pole. Come N Get Me went to the far outside down the final stretch, and a strong burst of closing speed pulled him even with Okay One More at the line in the photo finish. Okay One More had 11-1 odds, while Come N Get Me was at 15-1.


