Golden Receiver dominates Haughton Memorial for Andy Miller

Driver Andy Miller said that he wanted his five rivals behind him in the \$460,000 William R. Haughton Memorial at the Meadowlands on Saturday night.

Golden Receiver (Village Jove) obliged by pacing the opening panel for Miller in :25.4 which put everyone in a hole behind the leader. Once he had control of the race, Golden Receiver never relinquished it and held off a late rush by We Will See to win in 1:48.3.

"He's just so fast off the gate," said Miller of Golden Receiver. "Once he was in front, he relaxes and I had to show him the whip to get him to go on."

Miller said he knew that live horses would be coming at Golden Receiver in the stretch, but praised his pacer as "as tough as they come."

Golden Receiver proved that with his 12th victory in 19 starts this season. The Haughton Memorial win comes immediately after his similar pacesetting US Pacing Championship win on Hambletonian Day.

With a disappointing field of only six after some scratches, there wasn't much movement in the opening half. Foiled Again was the first to launch an attack against Golden Receiver. Aracache Hanover picked up his cover and We Will See was caught in the pocket behind the leader in the last turn.

Turning into the stretch, Golden Receiver was in complete control as Foiled Again surrendered. Aracache Hanover then stalled in late stretch. We Will See got out and was gaining ground in the final strides, but it was too late.

Mark Harder trains the winner for breeder Nina Simmonds, who owns the 7-year-old gelding with Stable 45, Richard Taylor, and Stephen Springer.

In the \$218,850 Golden Girls for older pacing gals, Driver Jodie Jamieson may have jinxed favored Put On A Show when he said recently that she was the greatest pacing mare ever—by far. She was bet down to 3-2, but she broke a lot of hearts (and wallets) when she broke stride at the start and was never a factor in the race.

That left Androvette to make the early fractions. When Rocklamation came to call on the outside down the backstretch for driver Ron Pierce, Androvette's driver Tim Tetrick had no intention of letting her go. That resulted in a half-mile in :53.4.

Drop the Ball had her nose on the back of Ron Pierce, and when his mare stalled all in the middle of the last turn, Drop The Ball tipped three wide and surged past the tiring leaders. But the hellhound on her tail was Rebeka Bayama. The Quebec-bred filly outgamed Drop The Ball in the drive to the wire to win in 1:49. Ginger And Fred was third.

Sylvain Filion drove the winner for trainer Pat Lachance. Another Filion---driving legend Herve---was part of the winner's circle festivities. Bayama Farms owns the winner. Rebeka Bayama is the only filly ever sired by Leader Bayama (Artsplace), who got just five foals in two crops in Quebec before he died.

The 1-2 favorite Maven (Glidemaster) easily mastered her rivals in the \$150,000 Moni Maker, winning in a romp in 1:52.3 for trainer Jonas Czernyson, driver Yannick Gingras and owner W. J. Donovan. It was revenge for her setback in the Hambletonian Oaks when Maven lost all chance due to interference from Check Me Out.

Maven was one of a quartet of fillies in the race from the Czernyson Stable and Gingras moved her with confidence down the backstretch. She trotted past the leaders with alacrity and the other fillies then simply argued over minor spoils. Valdonna nosed out Superstar Hanover for second. Win Missy B, second choice in the betting at 3-1, lost her chances with an early miscue.

Johnny Rock (Rocknroll Hanover) rocked the Big M with his 1:51.1 win in the NJSS for first-season pacing males. He was one of nine sons of Rocknroll Hanover in the race. Favored Rocking Amadeus shot to the lead going down the backstretch with a full head of steam, but Johnny Rock attacked the pacesetter past the half. Johnny Rock was under whip urging from driver Tim Tetrick to clear to the lead, but was firmly in control as the field entered the stretch.

Johnny Rock paced away from his pursuers while Rockin Amadeus had no more fight in him. Rocknmyjeans finished second despite drifting out in deep stretch. Wake Up Peter was third.

John Butenschoen conditions the winning colt for Illinois owners Jean Goehlen, William Wiswell, and Eugene Schick.

Authorize (Western Ideal) zoomed a final quarter estimated at :25.4 by track announcer Sam McKee to take the \$150,000 NJSS final for freshman pacing gals. She moved out past the half to chase after the leader Jerseylicious, picking up cover from Ideal Jenny.

Authorize was still four lengths back entering the stretch, but when driver Brian Sears tipped her she was on fire. Sears timed the winning move perfectly to sail past Jerseylicious. Miss Lauren closed fast on the inside to be third. The margin was a half-length in the 1:52.3 mile. Tony Alagna trains Authorize for Brittany Farms and the Brian Monieson Revtrust.

It took little more than a training mile for Corky (Muscles Yankee) to win the \$150,000 NJSS final for freshman trotting boys. His task was made easier when Deadliest Catch broke stride on the lead past the quarter-mile marker and allowed David Miller to slide Corky easily to the lead.

The race was then virtually over as Miller set lackadaisical fractions with D.R. Ackerman and Super Classic sitting on his back. When Corky turned into the stretch, Miller woke him up and the others were racing for second money as the son of Muscles Yankee coasted to the wire eased up in 1:57.3. King Muscles got second with Amalfi Coast was third.

Jimmy Takter trains the Corky for his wife Christina and partner John Fielding.

Southwind Cocoa scored an upset in a three-filly photo finish in the \$150,000 NJSS final for frosh trotting girls. In this race Miss Steel got the lead first, then yielded to favored Shared Past, who then passed the lead to With Sugar. In the stretch, Yannick Gingras was searching for a seam with Shared Past, but found none. Southwind Cocoa and Time To Kill had momentum in the middle of the track. The Chocolatier filly scored in 1:55.3 to pay \$22.60. Time To Kill was just a nose back while Shared Past just missed by a neck after getting room late.

Owner Richard Gutnick, trainer Linda Toscano, and driver Tim Tetrick were in the winner's circle, just as they'd been two weeks ago with Market Share after the Hambletonian.

'Generation Next' in Mohawk Stakes

Racing fans at Mohawk Raceway idolized Somebeachsomewhere during his racing days and on Saturday night they'll get a chance to check out some potential heirs apparent in the Nassagaweya for freshman pacing males and the Eternal Camnation for pacing fillies. The 22 starters in the Nassagaweya include a half-dozen sons of the Beach, including the Woodrow Wilson winner Captaintreacheraus.

Six of the 20 lasses in the two \$129,748 splits of the Eternal Camnation are daughters of Somebeachsomewhere. One division, in fact, is virtually a Somebeachsomewhere Sire Stakes as six of the 10 starters are daughters of the Hanover Shoe Farm stallion.

Captaintreacheraus is the hottest commodity in the freshman pacing class after his stunning 10-1/4 length win in the Woodrow Wilson on Hambletonian Day. He was supposed to win - after all, he was bet down to 30 cents on the dollar - but no one expected a 1:49.3 mile that left his pursuers several seconds in arrears.

His final quarter was paced in :27.2, which is the slowest final fraction in Captaintreacheraus's young career. In his previous five starts (including qualifiers), he shows final quarters as fast as :26.1 and as "slow" as :26.4.

Of course, Captaintreacheraus is bred to go fast and he's lived up to his pedigree and purchase price. He's a son of Rocknroll Hanover, harness racing's leading sire in 2012 as his offspring have already earned more than \$9.4 mil-

lion. Captaintreacheraus is the first foal of the Artsplace mare Worldly Treasure, a sister to the \$1.9 million winner Worldly Beauty.

That pedigree---and some stunning good looks---made Captaintreacheraus a \$250,000 yearling last fall at Lexington. He was bred by White Birch Farm, which retains an interest in the colt along with Brittany Farms, Joe Sbrocco, and Marvin Katz. Tony Alagna trains the precocious pacer.

Captraintreacheraus is listed as the 3-5 favorite in his \$108,125 split of the Nassagaweya.

Odds On Equuleus, the only colt to defeat Captaintreacheraus, is favored in his Nassagaweya division, also contested for \$108,125. The son of Art Major will be steered by John Campbell for Odds On Racing and trainer Robin Schadt. He was not in the Woodrow Wilson but sports a 1:52 win at the Meadowlands.

Sons of Art Major and Somebeachsomewhere loom as the co-favorites in the third Nassagaweya split, which carries a \$109,624 purse.

Fool Me Once (Art Major) is unbeaten in a pair of starts, including a 1:52.4 score last weekend. In that race he vanquished Lets Rock Together(Somebeachsomewhere), and the two match strides again in the Nassagaweya. Fool Me Once won on the front end for Sylvain Filion while Lets Rock Together rallied from far back at odds of 20-1 to get second for Randy Waples.

The first split of the Eternal Camnation features a balanced field of 10 fillies headed by Love Canal, a Badlands Hanover lass that's found the winner's circle three times in four starts. In her last outing, however, she was fourth at 3-5 odds after being back in the pack most of the way as Parlee Beach won easily.

Love Canal won't have to contend with the unbeaten Parlee Beach on Saturday as Parlee Beach is one of the six SBSW fillies in the second Eternal Camnation split. Hall of Famer Bob McIntosh trains Parlee Beach, who is coming off a 1:50.4 win at Mohawk. She drew post eight in her race and will have Randy Waples in the bike. She might well lead a Beach Party as daughters of SBSW threaten to gobble up the bulk of the \$129,748 purse.

Two Hambletonian finalists, both sons of Kadabra, are featured in the \$40,000 Ontario Sires Stakes Gold elimination for sophomore trotters. Knows Nothing is the 2-1 morning line favorite over Prestidigitator who is listed at 3-1.

Knows Nothing won an elimination heat for the Hambletonian in 1:53.1, and was sent off a 4-1 odds in the final. He could manage to pick up only a fifth-place check. Prestidigitator was sent off at 12-1 odds in the Hambo and was never really in the hunt, finishing eighth and being moved up a notch in the final placings.

In the Ontario Gold elim, which has a field of a dozen starters, Knows Nothing is back on Lasix after coming off the medication to comply with Hambletonian regulations. He has post seven for driver Jody Jamieson. Presidigitator has post four for driver Sylvain Filion.

The Saturday card at Mohawk also features a \$50,000 pace with eight free-for-allers going behind the gate. Alsace Hanover and Randy Waples get the favorite's status despite having post eight

Do Yourself a Favor: Watch the Gold Cup and Saucer Tonight; It'll Make You Smile

At about ten minutes to Midnight this evening (Atlantic time, ten to eleven eastern) the lights of a racetrack in Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island will go dark. Silhouetted against the glow of Ferris wheels will be hundreds of horsemen and grooms surrounding the track, with throngs of fans on the apron. A spotlight will appear on top of the historic Driving Park, and one by one the horses and drivers will come out of the paddock, introduced like rock stars at a stadium. Ten minutes later an Island hymn will be played, a call to the post will be trumpeted by a man surrounded by "Gold Cup Ambassadors" – a group of young people from the Island, each representing a horse. Then, a couple of minutes later the gates will spring for one of the most unique and interesting harness races to be raced anywhere in the World: The Gold Cup and Saucer.

"This is a race unlike any other I've been to, and I've been to many" said 38 year old New Glasgow, Nova Scotia native Harvey Timmons. "It's a place where the whole town has harness racing fever. If you walk the streets the week before the race you'll have strangers come up to you and ask 'who do you like'? Everyone has an opinion and everyone is knowledgeable about harness racing."

It's difficult for many of us to believe, but a race for \$60,000 in a far away part of the world generates more excitement, and attracts more horses from equally far away places than some of our bigger races. Why race for \$60,000 a thousand miles away when one can race at Mohawk or Yonkers for similar in an Open or high conditioned affair in your own backyard? Because it's the Gold Cup and Saucer and everyone seems to want to be a part of it.

"Everyone loves a good party, everyone loves a good race. You get both here," Ontario-based Driver Anthony MacDonald told the Guelph Mercury last year. "Mix in the food, patronage, atmosphere and golf and why wouldn't you come?"

Selling the event is a year-long affair and Racing and Experience Manager Brett Revington takes his job seriously. Not only is he tasked with assembling a good field, he has to try and increase handle, and revenues. So far, that's been working. Last season George Teague sent three horses with combined earnings of \$4.1 million. This season, horses like Metro Pace winner Mystician and top class stars like Stonebridge Terror and Piece of the Rock made the trip, among others. The handle has been getting better and better as well.

"Our on-track handle has been good – with some of the best numbers seen across Canada. We did about \$208,000 on-track last year. For the afternoon and evening cards, we jumped to over \$350,000 in total handle, the bulk of it on-track." Brett said.

This is at a track in a smaller city, with purses that usually range from \$500 to \$2000, without a big name simulcast presence.

I remember my first trip to "Old Home Week" [that's the week of the race, with harness racing each day, along with a fair] and the Gold Cup and Saucer, several years ago. I have been to many harness racing and thoroughbred racing events. I've seen many of the big horses and races since the 1980's, just like many of you have. But I must conclude I have not seen an event quite like this. The atmosphere, the fun, the pageantry and most importantly the people, make it something that I can't quite put my finger on, but I know I love it.

"I've often thought about what races I've been to, and what races I'd like to go to." Said Harvey Timmons. "I know, for me, if I had to choose between a Kentucky Derby and a Gold Cup and Saucer, my ass would be in Charlottetown."

This weekend, as in previous other weekends in late August, a great many people agree with Harvey. The Sobey's Gold Cup and Saucer is available for wagering on many ADW's in the US and Canada. Live video, available at those ADW's, will also be available on Redshores.ca.

Race 8, Eternal Camnation

L DEES LIONESSE was used hard early from post 10 in the Whenuwishuponastar series final before finishing a game second in a blistering 1:50:4 mile. With nearly \$130K on the line tonight, Zeron will be gunning the Coleman trainee once again. Fast enough to upset. PARLEE BEACH is a perfect 3 for 3 for McIntosh and will be heavily backed tonight on the heels of her sparkling recent win. It might not have mattered anyway, but she did trip out in that last race and could find herself in a more difficult position tonight. NIKKI BEACH was one of the best rookie fillies racing at the Meadowlands this summer and suffered her first defeat last out in the Sweetheart when collared by Jerseylicious. This field looks pretty salty; she'll need her very best with Sears but at least should offer some value. SOMWHEREOVRARAINBOW goes from Montrell to Tetrick; is a daughter of Teague's great Rainbow Blue.

Race 9, Nassagaweya

TERESAS BEACH easily broke her maiden at Pocono two back and that most recent race is better than it looks. Winner of that race was a 3-year-old that had been racing against some of the sports best sophomores in recent tries. Callahan follows her up here; should be in line for a good trip. FOOL ME ONCE made a brush from 6th to 1st in between calls last out; won in style. Obvious short priced contender for trainer Austin. Steacy turned the lines over last out to MacDonell on SUNSHINE BEACH and the response was instant. That was a powerful looking win and the speed is evidently there to overcome the post. APPRENTICE HANOVER paced a quick back half in his most recent when defeated as the favorite and LET'S ROCK TOGETHER looks like he's best from coming off the pace.

Race 10, Open

FORECLOSURE N has turned things around dramatically since arriving north of the border for Ryder. This one closed in :26:3 against Betterthancheddar last week and Tetrick has been behind him before. SPARKY MARK exits a no shot race from post 10 but prior to that had beaten Mystician and Bigtime Ball at Georgian. Second start back off the month layoff. ALSACE HANOVER had his winning streak derailed last Saturday to one of the sports best and actually looked good for a moment in the stretch. Gritty try; the one to beat. ST ELMO HERO is more than capable from the rail; may only need a little racing luck.

Race 11, N/W \$5,000 L5

WINTER BLUES was interfered with at the start in his most recent at Flamboro and those 1:54 miles at that track should rate just as well than the others 1:52 type miles on this one. Trainer Reid is clicking at nearly 25%, move back to the big track may help. Worth a swing. ANDERLECHT has faced better in many of his recent starts and I wouldn't expect Luc to take back in this position. Can take them all the way. BOMBAY AWAY seems to be a chronic slow started but did close in :26:2 last out. Staring into an 0 for 17 record on the year. VAL AMERICA drops and moves inside; MONSTER IN LAW returns and is no stranger to this track. Wide open race.
