# Sports betting Synergy

Woodbine partners with bet365 to offer betting on horse racing for the first time via a legal Ontario sportsbook app.

Woodbine Entertainment CEO Jim Lawson is stepping away from that position this fall, but not without having accomplished one of his major goals: Bringing horse racing to a legal Canadian sports wagering platform. By Sunday (Aug. 20), bet365 will include a "horse racing" option on its menu of sports available to Canadian customers. Lawson said he couldn't be happier.

"The first thing that comes to mind is a sense of accomplishment," Lawson said. "It was a big team effort. I think I drove them all crazy because I pushed so hard. In particular, in the last two months I've been pushing for the deadline of Aug. 20, and really, a deadline of Aug. 1st. It just slipped and slipped, mostly for technological reasons. I think they're still working out some things."

He wanted to ensure Woodbine's presence on a Canadian online sportsbook ahead of the 2023 King's Plate, the first leg of the Canadian Triple Crown for thoroughbreds. The race is this Sunday at Woodbine Racetrack. It and other racing product currently carried on HPI will become available this week via bet365. That includes harness racing.

routed directly into our tote system...
Yes, there's a commission to be shared or paid to bet365. However, our projections are that we are going to add a substantial amount of new customers, horse racing fans, and new revenue... Last March, Lawson spoke out about racing being excluded from the newly-legalized terrain of Canadian sports betting. When single-game wagering became available via Canadian sportsbooks on April 4, 2022, thoroughbred and standardbred racing did not. With a background in professional sports (hockey and Canadian football), Lawson said at the time that he considered the delay frustrating and nonsensical.

He was visibly relieved and happy Thursday.

"I expect [availability] is going to be turned on this weekend," Lawson said. "It's just a complicated process. For bet365 in particular to meet all of the regulatory compliance, it had to be that even though it's on an iGO [iGaming Ontario]-regulated and approved site, it really had to be clear that this was pari-mutuel and a Woodbine product, and a Canadian pari-mutuel regulated product. There's just a lot that goes into ensuring that the public knows that and that the regulators can regulate and audit it."

The racetrack CEO said it took a year to complete the platform that allowed the existing tote system to interface with bet365 in a way he called "seamless to the customer." This means bet365 players will not need to register for a Horseplayer Interactive (HPIBet) account with Woodbine in advance of placing their bets on races. He added that transactions had to be easily separable and auditable for both federal and provincial regulators.

"This is under the management and control of Woodbine, and under the regulatory regime of the CPMA [Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency], so it's a very delicate minefield to get through, not just

technologically, but from a legal and compliance perspective," he said.

Bet365 was a natural choice to make the project happen.

"We had begun discussions with a number of international sports betting operators, even prior to this sports betting legislation," Lawson said. "We didn't know how it was going to come about... Many of the majors, including bet365, their roots were in horse racing. Bet365 essentially was an off-track betting shop in the United Kingdom... At their heart and at their roots, bet365 is a horse racing company, and there are a number that fall into that category."

It was the company's commitment to the sport and marketing in Ontario that helped seal the deal with Woodbine Entertainment.

"We like the brand, we like the worldwide brand, and we like the fact that they understood and appreciated, a.k.a. 'liked' horse racing, so it just seemed like the perfect fit," Lawson said. "Given their size and their scope, they are technologically advanced... and were up to the task of integrating our system in a manner that would comply with the regulatory environment in Canada. They checked every box."

Bet365 wagers on racing don't go through HPI, he noted.

"They are routed directly into our tote system," Lawson said. "Our tote system sits at the back end of all of this... Yes, there's a commission to be shared or paid to bet365. However, our projections are that we are going to add a substantial amount of

new customers [i.e., knowledgeable sports bettors, particularly in their 20s-30s], horse racing fans, and new revenue... At the end of the day, it adds to the home market wagering, which is good for the standardbred and thoroughbred breeders in the province."


Timely partnering with a sports betting operator was essential for the long-range health of horse/harness racing, according to Lawson.

"As these mega-companies grow in Ontario and across Canada, they are marketing behemoths and they are just going to further eat into the available sports wagering dollar," he said. "To not take this step would have been devastating [to the national and provincial horse/harness racing handle]... I only know the Ontario numbers are projected to grow into \$10 billion in the next five years. For us not to be part of that wave would be hugely problematic to our wagering."

The deal with bet365 is non-exclusive.

"To be clear, we are going to add new sports betting operators in the coming months," he said. "It's going to be all of the majors; almost all of them, we know are interested. I can say we've already been approached... We need to get this launched, but we're ready to go."

Lawson is moving into the position of executive chair at Woodbine Entertainment as new CEO Michael Copeland takes the lines this fall. While scaling back his days at the office, he said he will remain involved in this and other projects and operations.

What about the possibility of physical sportsbooks, such as the FanDuel outlet located inside The Meadowlands' grandstand in New Jersey?

"I would say it is extremely likely, and now even more likely, as a result of yesterday's development," he said. "I don't know that the government is yet prepared to put a sportsbook into an operation like WEGZ [Stadium Bar OTB in Concord, ON], however we have every expectation that we will have a retail sportsbook focused on horse racing, operated by Woodbine Entertainment, at the Woodbine Racetrack. Now, we will have to partner, because we are not a licensed sports betting operator, nor do we intend to become a licensed sports betting operator."

He said that, ideally, bettors at future racing-themed sportsbook locations "will still have their sports betting app in their hands [on their phone], so they don't necessarily have to open up an HPI account or bring cash to bet on horse racing when they move over to the retail sportsbook at Woodbine or Mohawk... This makes more sense than ever now, with this digital capability... That's a discussion for another day, whether we can get that into WEGZ and Greenwood [OTB in Toronto's Beaches neighborhood], which are our two largest off-track wagering operations, and beyond that, whether the government is prepared to license that... I'm more confident that it's going to happen at Woodbine first and then the next step would be Mohawk."

The timing of the bet365 partnership launch couldn't be better for the standardbred stakes season, in Lawson's view.

"I think it's great for harness racing," he said. "I say this with respect: You have this whole audience with these young sports bettors who don't know very much about horse racing. You start at that foundation. What they do know about horse racing is the Kentucky Derby; they might know there's a U.S. Triple Crown; I'm not even sure they'd know there's a Canadian Triple Crown, but they know a little bit about... thoroughbreds.

"We have a whole program that we're building, our marketing department, to educate the sports betting customer and brand a sports wagering brand dedicated to horse racing... I'm hoping and expecting that what you're going to see is this huge, huge number of customers who think horse racing is the Kentucky Derby [get educated] on the North America Cup, the Mohawk Million, the Wellwood, the Peaceful Way, the Canadian Trotting Classic... I think you're going to see a whole new demographic say, 'Ohhhh, harness racing! I've heard about that!' Even the Canadian thoroughbred product: 'Ohhh, I didn't know Canada had a Triple Crown!' I think this is awesome for horse racing, but I think this is also going to really boost awareness about standardbred racing."

Not just this weekend, but 365 days a year.

### Stars set to deliver on Sun Stakes Saturday

Beginning with a postscript from **last week's column** that segues into this one, a supplemental cost presumption was made should Jugette-nominated Sylvia Hanover opt to race in the Little Brown Jug.

In response to that column on social media, Little Brown Jug publicity director Jay Wolf posted the filly notice as part of the race conditions. It states, "Any nominated filly making payments when due may start in the Little Brown Jug to which she is eligible by paying an additional amount equal to the total

required of colts and geldings plus the starting fee." From the notice, Wolf confirms that it would cost Sylvia Hanover – or any other Jugette-nominated filly for that matter – just a fraction of what the standard supplement fee is.

Going from speculative races to actual ones, Saturday at The Downs at Mohegan Pennsylvania shapes up to be one of the best Sun Stakes cards in recent memory. Included are the sport's top two rated horses, the Hambletonian Oaks winner, the Hambletonian runner-up and a slew of other notable interests.

The \$250,000 James Lynch Memorial for 3-year-old pacing fillies takes an even more prominent role than usual on the card, with another showdown coming between Sylvia Hanover and Twin B Joe Fresh. For Sylvia Hanover, all her prior races have been well documented, and the main question now is driver Bob McClure's strategy while racing her on a smaller sized track for the first time in her career. Known more for her ability to grind than blinding early speed, she can leave if she must, and that looks like it might be the situation here. With all main threats to her inside, I'd imagine McClure doesn't want any of them to be too far ahead at any point. This will be Sylvia Hanover's toughest race since the Fan Hanover in June. I am curious to see if she's up to the task.

Twin B Joe Fresh has only lost twice this year when racing against 3-year-old fillies and both of those came at the hands of Sylvia Hanover. After finishing second in that uniquely-run Mistletoe Shalee, she's since come back with two straight wins,

the most recent being a cool 1:48.2 career best win at Red Mile. She leaves to the immediate inside of Sylvia Hanover and there's no question that Dunn will look to get the early jump. Charleston lands the rail and I'd say has completed the Big 3 as part of this group of fillies over the past two seasons. Though, Sweet Amira looks intriguing now and brings Louis Roy with her. The Sweet Lou filly has been impressive of late, including last week when Beach Cowgirl couldn't make any impression on her from the pocket; Odds On Hail Mary was coming on late from well back in that same race.

Confederate highlights the \$300,000 Max Hempt and in the span of 20 minutes between this race and the immediately preceding Lynch, maybe we'll see a shakeup at the top of the standings when all is said and done. Confederate enters the Hempt off four consecutive miles in the 1:47 range, including a 1:47 flat win two back in the Meadowlands Pace which was then followed up by a just as smashing win in the Cane Pace. Similar to above, he's another one who hasn't traditionally been forwardly placed early but from post 5 Tetrick's hand may be somewhat forced early.

Last year's O'Brien and Dan Patch winner Stockade Seelster somehow paid nearly \$11 in his most recent Ontario Sires Stakes Gold Series leg after being sent off at odds of 1-9 in his prior Gold race. It wasn't that long ago where he looked menacing in his Meadowlands Pace elimination when he got steppy and broke stride. It could be an interesting spot here for him. Speedy type Christchurch may be aided by the move to the rail and five-eighths oval though he'll see pressure. Hungry Angel Boy had been on the rapid improve and never was able to get involved from the second tier in the Cane Pace. Redwood Hanover was superb in both his Adios elimination and in that final; was used too hard in that near record mile last out at Northfield. It's impossible to discount the connections but it really does seem like Fulton was stronger at the onset of the season.

The \$250,000 Delmonica Hanover sets up largely as a rematch of the Hambletonian Oaks as the first, second and fourth finishers from that race are all set to do battle again. Of note, the third-place finisher from that race, Righteous Resolve, was shockingly third earlier this week in an OSS Gold race.

Saturday at The Downs at Mohegan Pennsylvania shapes up to be one of the best Sun Stakes cards in recent memory. Included are the sport's top two rated horses, the Hambletonian Oaks winner, the Hambletonian runner-up and a slew of other notable interests.

As for Heaven Hanover, she'll be out to keep the momentum going after that thrilling Hambletonian Oaks win as a big longshot. The talented filly was also overlooked three back in the Del Miller Memorial. Though those two wins have come from off the pace, she did show early speed the last time she was seen here in June, as well as the same at Harrah's Philly last month. She has the post edge on Bond who in a reverse of tactics following that uncontrollable speed two back, picked the right race to sit off the pace in the Hambletonian Oaks. She came late with a rally from well off the pace, only to be caught at the wire by Heaven Hanover who raced from even further back. Secret Volo was expertly positioned in that race from Sears and had loomed; was likely a bit too close early to the fast fractions. Rose Run Yolanda returns from Ohio and did more than hold her own against these in the Del Miller last month at The Meadowlands.


Similar to the Delmonica Hanover, the \$300,000 Earl Beal Memorial sports top finishers from the Hambletonian two weeks ago. Hambletonian winner Tactical Approach came back from his upset triumph to win in a Kentucky-sired event earlier this week at Red Mile, but the next three finishers from the Hambletonian are all here.

Oh Well came first over in the Hambletonian, took command from the race leader into the stretch and fought on gamely the rest of the way as he always does. He hasn't been worse than second all year, but amazingly just has that single win coming from the Stanley Dancer. Celebrity Bambino was awesome two back when winning his Hambletonian elimination in a fast

1:50.4, but then was in trouble fairly early in the final despite being extremely well rated. He's excellent when at his best, but has become tough to predict. Up Your Deo was closing with a ton of steam in the Hambletonian and I thought looked like a winner mid-stretch before flattening out a touch late. Kilmister comes off a nice confidence building win on the Hambletonian undercard. He outraced his odds three back in the Dancer and could be rounding back into his better form.

In the \$100,000 Always B Miki invitational to close out the card, Allywag Hanover returns to Pocono for the first time since winning this same race last year. After some misfortune and not hitting the board in any of his five prior starts this year, he swelled up in the pocket last out in the Sam McKee Memorial and went on to produce a 1:47.2 win; nice to see him back! Stonebridge Helios kicked off the Hambletonian Day festivities with a fast win in that day's first race. Tattoo Artist has raced well and has a recent string of second-place finishes against the best competition; yet to win though since that higher level conditioned race at Philly in June. Lou's Pearlman was flying two back at The Meadowlands and then had a tough trip last out at Hoosier in the Dan Patch. Idealsomemagic gets a new driver in Andrew McCarthy. South Beach Star beat Ruthless Hanover three back.

### Melander looks for Pocono Sun Stakes repeats

It took several days for Marcus Melander to fully appreciate Heaven Hanover's win in the Hambletonian Oaks two weeks ago, but her last-to-first triumph from post 10 at The Meadowlands certainly put an immediate smile on his face.

"It's a great feeling," Melander said. "To win a race like that is very exciting. But on the other hand, we had two more horses [Venerate and Oh Well] to race with the Cashman and Hambletonian coming up. So, you're so excited to be in the winner's circle, but then you have to recharge because you still had two horses to go. It took a couple of days before it really settled in that we won the Oaks."

On Saturday (Aug. 19), Heaven Hanover will have another opportunity to put a smile on Melander's face. She is among a field of eight 3-year-old female trotters that will meet in the \$250,000 Delmonica Hanover Stakes at Pocono Downs at Mohegan Pennsylvania. She will start from post 4 with driver Tim Tetrick and is the 3-1 second choice on the morning line behind Hambletonian Oaks runner-up Bond, who is 5-2.

Heaven Hanover has been no worse than third in her past five races, winning three, including a Pennsylvania Sire Stakes division in June at Pocono Downs and a division of the Delvin Miller Memorial in July at The Meadowlands.

For the season, the daughter of Father Patrick—Hillarmbro has missed the board only once in eight starts and earned \$382,746.

"She's been racing good all year, and everything seems fine with her after the last race," Melander said. "She's done everything



right. She drew well for Saturday. There are some good horses in there, but she is one that can win the race, that's for sure."

Melander, who won last year's Delmonica Hanover with Joviality S, also will send out Secret Volo in Saturday's race. She will start from post 7 with driver Brian Sears and is 4-1.

Secret Volo finished fourth from post 9 in the Hambletonian Oaks, where she was beaten by a length and was a quarter-length from third. She counts the NY NY Mile in June at MGM Yonkers Raceway among her victories this season.

"She raced very good in the Oaks," Melander said about the daughter of Walner—Secret Serenity. "She left hard and just got beat for third. She's right there every week, but, unfortunately, she draws bad almost every start. She has a lot of gate speed, so she could still get good position.

"She's already won on a half-mile track, so I think a five-eighths track won't bother her at all. I think she will probably be a little better on a five-eighths track. She is a nice horse, and she always tries her best."

In addition to having two chances to repeat in the Delmonica Hanover, Melander will get the same opportunity in Saturday's Earl Beal Jr. Memorial. Hambletonian runner-up Oh Well will be joined by stablemate Kilmister in the \$300,000 race for 3-year-old trotters.

Oh Well, who has earned \$1.14 million in his career, has one win and six seconds in seven races this season. His victory came in a division of the Stanley Dancer Memorial on July 15 at The Meadowlands. The son of Muscle Hill—Fine Tuned Lady will start Saturday from post 8 with Tetrick in the sulky and is the 4-1 third choice on the morning line.

"He finished second in the Hambo, but he raced great," said Melander, who won last year's Beal with Temporal Hanover. "He drew on the outside this week, but I think he can overcome it."

Kilmister, the 2022 Peter Haughton Memorial winner, enters the Beal off a victory in the Muscle Hill Trot on Hambletonian Day (Aug. 5), at The Meadowlands. He also has won a division of the Empire Breeders Classic and was second in a division of the Dancer.

The son of Chapter Seven—Treviso will start the Beal from post 2 with Sears in the bike and is 9-2.

"He looked really good on Hambo Day," Melander said. "I think it was good for his confidence, as well, to get a win there. He showed that he was in form, and he drew well here. It's a tough field but he's one of them that can win."

Celebrity Bambino, who was fourth in the Hambletonian is the 5-2 favorite in the Beal, leaving from post 1 with Yannick Gingras driving for trainer Ron Burke. MGM Yonkers Trot winner Up Your Deo, who was third in the Hambletonian, is 3-1 and starts from post 4 for trainer/driver Ake Svanstedt.

Pocono's Loaded Sun Stakes Saturday card also includes the \$300,000 Max C. Hempt Memorial for 3-year-old pacers and the \$250,000 James M. Lynch Memorial for 3-year-old female pacers. Racing begins at 1 p.m. (EDT).

### Post-COVID 19 comeback complete at The Meadowlands

by Debbie Little

All you had to do was try to get on an elevator or walk around the building to see how crowded The Meadowlands was on Hambletonian Day (Aug. 5).

There was a buzz in the air not felt since pre-COVID 19 days.

The final numbers are not yet in from international wagering on Hambletonian Day, but The Meadowlands' chief operating officer/general manager Jason Settlemoir said he is optimistic that they will be good because the domestic betting numbers were strong.

"I was very, very happy with our strong off track on Hambletonian Day and I was very, very happy with our strong on track as well," Settlemoir said. "We got back to almost a million dollars on track. And getting back to close to a million dollars on track is something that's very exciting for me because it means that there is a will for people to want to return to the racetrack, especially on big event days."

This year's on-track handle of \$921,938 was up 18 per cent over last year's \$781,310. Hambletonian Day all-source wagering was just over \$7.8 million, which is a new record since The Big M moved into its new facility 10 years ago. The number also represented a by-far North American-best for 2023. A year ago, wagering on the first Saturday in August was a little more than \$7.6 million.

"I'll be honest in saying that this past Hambletonian Day was exciting to me, not only just the day of, but heading into it as well because I could feel the excitement building," Settlemoir said. "I could feel the excitement here on track again. I mean, it was fantastic."

Settlemoir explained that the placement of this year's Hambletonian was strictly for TV and that he would still prefer to have the Hambletonian as race 15 with maybe one or two races after it.

"So, we'll see what 2024 brings us," Settlemoir said. "In my opinion, if the Hambletonian was later in the day, our on-track number would have been up over a million dollars. So, we'll



look at it, we'll analyze it, and make the best decision for The Meadowlands along with working with NYRA [the New York Racing Association] and Fox Sports, to see what the best-case scenario is for everybody."

The Meadowlands has worked hard in 2023 to make their racing product the best and most exciting it can be, going so far as to hire "The Enforcer" Lou Haskell at the beginning of the championship meet to oversee specific driver policies which are detailed nightly in their program.

When asked how he thought The Meadowlands racing product has been in regard to those specific policies, The Big M's president/chief executive officer, Jeff Gural, said: "I think the racing is clearly better but still holes are being given. The races with no holes tend to be more exciting allowing horses to come from behind rather than the 'no right lines' model which I hate."

Settlemoir agreed with Gural's assessment.

"The racing is clearly better, but there's still some holes in that first turn, but I think it's been much, much better," Settlemoir said. "And like [Gural] said, too, the races tend to be much more exciting, allowing horses to come off the back rather than in straight alignment. And I think our customers find it that way as well, because our handle has been up throughout the year."

The Meadowlands' customers have always been vocal and this year was no exception. However, according to Settlemoir, feedback in general has quieted down, which he'll take as a positive sign since customers are much more likely to criticize than praise.

"Since Lou has come on board, I think everybody knows that it's one of those things that we're taking very seriously," Settlemoir said.

With their championship meet concluded, The Meadowlands is now focused on the first two weekends in September, which will feature eliminations and finals for the New Jersey Classic Series.

The finals for 2- and 3-year-old trotters offer an estimated purse of \$275,000 while their pacing counterparts will go for \$150,000 (est.). Consolations will be offered should they be needed.

The Meadowlands' last scheduled television broadcast for 2023 will be on Fox Sports 1 (FS1) at 9 p.m. on Friday (Sept. 8).

"We're constantly looking for ways to do things bigger and better," Settlemoir said. "And our focus obviously in the fall will be on wrapping up our great stakes and continuing on with our great promotions and marketing that we do both on and off track. One of the things that we're going to be looking at and analyzing this fall is going to be, not only just the promotions that work and don't work, but now that inflation seems to be cooling, at least here in the United States and throughout the world, we're going to be taking a look at some of our pricing as well for food and beverage, to see to see if there's any room to bring some of those prices down.

"So, we'll see. It just depends on what our purveyors and vendors' pricing continue to be. If it's getting softer, then hopefully we can soften up as well on our pricing. So, it seems like things

might be getting a little bit better, but I don't hold my breath right now with this economy."

The Meadowlands' handle for 2023 has been impressive to say the least. A total of \$203,794,252 has been bet on Big M races. That's good for an average per card of \$3,234,829, by far a Gural-era best.

However, it is still frustrating for Settlemoir that it's so hard on an average night to get people to actually come out to the track.

Promotions such as "Battle of The Meadowlands Masterminds," won this year by Dave Little, helped bring people out to the track since participants were required to be there in person in order to have an opportunity to win a nightly prize as well as be eligible for the \$10,000 grand prize that was given away on Hambletonian Day.



"You know, when I grew up, like many people that still come to the racetrack, it was about being social and being together and I like being around people for the most part," Settlemoir said. "And it bothers me that on a Friday we struggle on track and quite frankly on a Saturday we struggle on track, too."

Settlemoir acknowledged the support of Gov. Phil Murphy and the New Jersey State Legislature for what they've done for horse racing in the Garden State. As well as all the horsemen, horsewomen, sponsors and of course the fans that support The Meadowlands.

"From an export standpoint, we're excited about where we are and where we're headed," Settlemoir said. "I mean, it was a long time in the making, becoming the No. 1 bet race track at night time, the No. 1 nighttime signal, regardless of breed. So, a lot of hard work and effort went into that.

"That's been our goal and we finally got there this year. So, I'm super excited about that. I'm hoping that we will carry this momentum into the fall and the end of the winter, and continue rolling right on through next summer. But it's just not The Meadowlands, it's going to take an industry-wide effort on behalf of the horsemen to continue to support us here at The Meadowlands through putting their horses in the box and sponsorships for our great stakes and I'm excited at where we are right now."







### Seventeen in a row for Francesco Zet

Solvalla recently honored Margareta Wallenius-Kleberg by changing the name of its Jubileumspokalen 5-year-old race to Margareta Wallenius-Kleberg's Jubileumspokal. The purse in Wednesday's (Aug. 16) race was \$280,000.

Daniel Redén's **Francesco Zet** (Father Patrick) was the heavy favorite in the race and driver Örjan Kihlström had a quick

solution for the tricky post 1 behind the gate. High On Pepper from post 2 couldn't keep Francesco Zet's pace from the start, so Kihlström easily found the two-wide path before the first turn. Second over became the initial position for Francesco Zet, while Castor The Star found the front position with Mellby Jinx on the outside.

Kihlström was determined to leave his position and at the first back stretch, Francesco Zet was given the signal to attack towards the leader, three wide. But the road to the first over position was harder than Kihlström had in mind since Magnus A Djuse rapidly changed from a pocket trip for a two-wide one, a move that caused a three-wide turn for the favorite before he landed outside Castor The Star with 3/4 of a mile to go.

Francesco Zet just loves to win races, that is a well-known fact for everyone who have seen the horse in action and the way he sprinted away from the attacking opponents in the stretch was impressive. Redén's homebred trotter came home in a mile rate of 1:53.2 over 1.3 miles.

Borups Victory got a trip far back in the field and when Daniel Wäjersten attacked three wide with a half mile to go, Borups Victory got cover from High On Pepper and the two horses finished strongly throughout the last turn and in the stretch.

Francesco Zet (Örjan Kihlström) won his 17th consecutive race as he claimed the \$280,000 Margareta Wallenius-Kleberg's Jubileumspokal on Wednesday night at Solvalla.



Borups Victory finished second and High On Pepper third and they both deserved high grades for their performances, respectively.

Francesco Zet dominated as a 3- and 4-year-old in Sweden and Wednesday's race at Solvalla was the main objective for his 5-year-old season. He has already beaten older trotters in the Norrbottens Stora Pris in mid-June this year and maybe there's a chance that the Father Patrick son will be aimed for the French winter meeting later on this year.

Runner up trainer Wäjersten experienced a great moment just an hour before the big race at Solvalla. His **Great Skills** (Ready Cash) was outstanding when the \$190,000 European Championship for mares was held over 1.3 miles. Great Skills was pushed to the lead at the first back stretch when early leader Imhatra Am and Mats E Djuse kindly let the favorite take over the front position and the race then became a one-horse show.

Wäjersten stepped on the gas pedal in the last turn and Great Skills sprinted to an outstanding win in a mile rate of 1:54.

Glamorous Rain bested early leader Imhatra Am in the chase for the silver medal after a third inside trip.

The 5-year-old Great Skills was one of the most successful mares in the crop last year and her biggest win so far in her career was the Stochampionatet in July 2022.

### BACK ON WINNING TRACK FOR VERNISSAGE GRIF

Alessandro Gocciadoro really has all European trotting countries as his workplace. On Tuesday (Aug. 15),the dominant Italian trainer raced in Montecatini, Italy, where his Varenne son **Vernissage Grif** claimed the \$130,000 Gran Premio Citta' di Montecatini.

Vernissage Grif won this particular race in 2020 and 2021, but couldn't defend the title in last year's edition of the event.

But 2023 was his year again. After a safe elimination win in 1:56.2, Vernissage Grif continued to win the final from the lead in 1:54.3.

City Lux finished second and Bonneville Gifont was third.

### EBBINGE LOOKS STRONG IN DRIVING CHAMPIONSHIP

The World Driving Championship is being held in Germany and Belgium and before the event's last race day, Dutch driver Rick Ebbinge seems to have an insurmountable lead in the competition.

After the races in Mons, Belgium on Wednesday (Aug. 16), Ebbinge is 33 points ahead of the Australian driver Pete McMullen and it looks to be tough to beat the Dutch champion.

Ebbinge won the title for drivers in 2019 and is now trainer and driver mostly in Sweden.

America's Jordan Ross picked up a win in Mons on Wednesday's race card. Ross won with Lotus EV and he is number 7 before the last competition in Berlin on Friday (Aug. 18).

Tactical Approach and Scott Zeron slipped past Ari Ferrari J (Dexter Dunn) to glide to victory. Khaosan Road (Ake Svanstedt) was third.

Point Of Perfect (Yannick Gingras) assumed command at the beginning of the mile while the Hambletonian winner settled in fifth from his rail position. Point Of Perfect led the field of nine through fractions of :27.1, :56.3 and 1:24.1. The colt, however, had rivals on his trip to the finish line.

Ari Ferrari J and Khaosan Road made their bids a bit earlier than Tactical Approach, but he and Zeron went by in late stretch to collect his fifth victory in 10 starts this year.

Tactical Approach is by Tactical Landing, a full sibling to world champion Mission Brief and a Breeders Crown winner. He is out of the Donato Hanover mare Sarcy, who earned \$261,333 on the racetrack. Sarcy also foaled Kentucky champion Double Deceiver (Cantab Hall, \$770,954). The gelding also won the 2023 Matron Stake for his age, sex and gait and finished second in the \$600,000 Breeders Crown final behind King Of The North.

In the far turn favorite Righteous Resolve (Resolve) driven by James MacDonald challenged Jamieson and Climb The Pole but the longshot proved too strong, crossing the wire first in 1:54 for the upset victory.

Baroness Hill (Kadabra) driven by Louis-Philippe Roy eventually overtook Righteous Resolve and James MacDonald in the battle for second.

"It worked out good tonight," said Jamieson. "I didn't have to push her too hard leaving, I just let her keep trotting."

Jamieson is a co-owner with Steve Heimbecker, Aaron Byron, and his father Carl Jamieson, who trains the filly.

Climb The Pole has made \$179,368 over the course of her career and the win gives her \$131,163 in OSS earnings this year.

"I drove her tough and I let her go from there," said Jody. "She dug in, and she doesn't like being passed and she showed it again here tonight."

Runner-up Baroness Hill (Kadabra) is trained by Chantal Mitchell, and her second-place result moved her over \$120,000 in OSS earnings this year for owner Tom Hill.

Third-place Righteous Resolve, trained by Matt Bax has collected \$93,034 in OSS earnings this year for co-owners Bet Max Stables Inc. and Benenati Inc., and now has earned over \$775,000 in her career.

Favorite **Pass Line** (All Bets Off) won the first OSS Gold division on the night with driver James MacDonald in race 3.

The 2-year-old pacing filly has \$167,252 in earnings and \$113,728 in the OSS this year.


Collusion Hanover (Bettors Delight) finished second while Wicked Weather (McWicked) finished strong in third.

The 3-year-old filly pacing division of the \$114,000 New York Sire Stakes put on quite a performance at Batavia Downs on Wednesday night (Aug. 16) and the star of the show was **Rec Time** (Huntsville—Ms. Malicious) who stalked a torrid early pace before setting a new track record in victory.

In the first \$57,000 division, Rec Time (Jason Bartlett) got away third as Vivians Dream (Jim Morrill Jr.) seated Southwind Bella (Jack Pelling) at the :26 flat quarter before rolling to the half in a blistering :53.3. The field was in single file and somewhat gapped as they motored up the backside where Southwind Bella pulled the pocket once again approaching three-quarters. That allowed Rec Time room to advance along the pylons, putting the top three in tight quarters rounding the last turn. Vivian's Dream held sway to the head of the stretch, but that's where Rec Time found the passing lane and bolted to the lead and a 2-½ length win in 1:52.3.

The time was a new track record for 3-year-old pacing fillies and supplanted the 12-year-old standard of 1:52.4 set by New Album in NYSS action back in 2011.

It was the fifth win of the year for Rec Time (\$20.20) who is owned by D Racing Stable and Jason Osullivan. Deborah Daguet trains Rec Time who was bred by Fair Winds Farm, Mark Mullen and Steve Jones.

Then in the second \$57,000 split, **Earthwindfire** (American Ideal—Road Bet) remained undefeated in 2023 after winning her seventh consecutive race in a hard-fought battle.

Jack Pelling wanted the front with Earthwindfire, but Marcus Miller made him earn it as Turn On The Charm parked the pair in :27.1 before releasing them to cross over. Earthwindfire finally skimmed the cones in the turn and carried the girls to the half in a geared-down :56.1 half. With no imminent threats looming, Pelling continued to grab leather and put up another pedestrian :30.1 panel before Rock My Socks (Jason Bartlett) moved first from fourth and drew alongside the leader before the turn. Positions remained unchanged until the top of the stretch where Earthwindfire was flanked by Turn On The Charm to her left and Rock My Socks to her right. However, Earthwindfire kept looking forward and closed out the mile with a 1:54.1 score by a neck.

With the win, Earthwindfire (\$3.20) boosted her 2023 earnings to \$215,416 for owners Melvin Segal, Kentuckiana Racing Stable and Tulip Racing. Brett Pelling is the winning trainer of Earthwindfire who was bred by Stephen Dey III.

There were also two \$20,000 Excelsior races on the card. The first was won by **Sweet Cheyanne** (Huntsville—Ever After) in 1:55.1 for driver Marcus Miller, trainer Erv Miller and owner Douglas Overheiser. And the second went to **Light And Tight** (American Ideal—Don't Point At) in 1:55.1 for driver Kevin Cummings, trainer Nifty Norman and owners Pinske Stable and Hoese.

### GIGI HANOVER AND INSTAGRAM MODEL PREVAIL IN NYSS AT YONKERS

Heavy favorites **Gigi Hanover** and **Instagram Model** delivered as expected in the two \$85,500 New York Sire Stakes divisions for 3-year-old trotting fillies that occurred on Tuesday evening (Aug. 15) at MGM Yonkers Raceway.



With Mark MacDonald in the bike in the first split, Gigi Hanover went right to the point from post 3 and put up well-rated fractions of :29, :58.4 and 1:28. In the stretch pocket-sitter Usosweet Blue Chip was angled off the pylons by driver Marcus Miller and did gain some, but it wasn't enough as Gigi Hanover held sway to score by three-quarters of a length in 1:57 flat. Canterbury Hanover, piloted by trainer Jeff Gregory, got up for third.

Bred by Hanover Shoe Farms, Gigi Hanover is trained by Ake Svanstedt for owner Mellby Gard Inc. This was her third career victory, and she has now earned \$185,057. She paid \$2.20 to win as the 1-9 favorite and led a \$9.60 exacta and a \$38.60 trifecta.

Kayleigh S was fired out by Brian Sears in the other grouping, but Jason Bartlett wheeled out of the pocket with Instagram Model coming to the :28.1 quarter and took over the top spot beyond that marker. It was all Instagram Model from there, as she hit the half in :57.4 and three-quarters in 1:26, opening up a gap on the rest of the field in the process, and closed in :28.3 to win by nine lengths over Royal Filly and driver Tyler Buter. Kayleigh S wound up third.

Instagram Model, who was sixth in the final of the Hambletonian Oaks earlier this month, hails from the barn of Annie Stoebe

and is owned by R. Lynn Curry. Instagram Model, who was bred by Steve Jones and Ray Schnittker, has a record of 7-2-1 from 16 appearances, has pocketed \$386,036 and returned \$2.50 to win as the 1-5 favorite. The exacta was worth \$7.90 and the trifecta kicked back \$13.00.

Bartlett and MacDonald also won the three \$20,000 New York Excelsior "A" Series flights that occurred as non-wagering races prior to the pari-mutuel program. Bartlett guided **Metro Matty** (by Met's Hall and bred by Winbak Farm) to a 1:58 victory for owner Bay Pond Racing Stable and trainer John Butenschoen and **Woolco** (by Chapter Seven) to a 1:57 4/5 triumph for breeder/trainer Bob Krivelin and his Hero Stables, while MacDonald connected with **Five Fish Species** (by Chapter Seven and bred by Order By Stable) in 1:57.3 for owner Thestable Fivefishspecies and trainer Megan Scran.

The New York Sire Stakes circuit returns to MGM Yonkers Raceway next Tuesday (Aug. 22), with 2-year-old colt and gelding pacers coming to Westchester.

MGM Yonkers Raceway currently hosts live racing on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights with post time at 7 p.m. (EDT).

### Two-year-old trotters featured in stakes action at Harrah's Hoosier Park

Indiana-sired freshmen trotters were the featured attraction at Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino on Wednesday (Aug. 16) as the evening's 14-race card was highlighted by the third round of Indiana Sires Stakes action for the 2-year-old trotters.

**Ponda Title** turned in another dominant, gate-to-wire performance to capture her split of the stakes action and extend her win streak to five in the process. With Kyle Wilfong in the bike, Ponda Title used a sharp, front-running effort to hold off a hard charging Skyway Paige and LeWayne Miller to score in a new lifetime best of 1:55.

With the win, the daughter of Muscle Massive—Elin remains undefeated in five starts this season for trainer Jay Hochstetler. The 1:55 clocking established a new lifetime best for Ponda Title as she pushed her career earnings to \$114,250 for owners Connie Hochstetler, Robert J. Buddig and Allen Schwartz.

In the opening division of the stakes action for the trotting fillies, it was **Somebody Special** and driver Trace Tetrick who converted a pocket trip into a 1:56.3 victory. Using a :28 closing

quarter, Somebody Special was able to track down the pacesetting Black Gold and James Yoder and hold off a late surge from Crystal Swan and LeWayne Miller to get the victory.

Trained by Erv Miller, Somebody Special remains undefeated in three starts in her young career. The homebred daughter of Swan For All—Lima Simplicity is owned by Ervin Miller Stable and Geis Enterprise and has now earned \$40,700.

**Flirtnwiththepilot** and Peter Wrenn were able to overcome post 10 to go gate-to-wire in the first \$67,500 division of Indiana Sires Stakes action for the trotting colts. Stopping the timer in 1:57.1, Flirtnwiththepilot was able to hold off the heavily favored Gruesome Twosome and Daryl Bontrager to get the win by a length.

Trained by Melanie Wrenn, the gelded son of Pilot Discretion—Savannah's Lucy recorded his third win from four lifetime starts. Owned in partnership by S&R Racing Stables, Bottom Line Racing LLC, Hickory Hollow Stables and Wrenn Racing, Flirtnwiththepilot now sports a lifetime bankroll of \$51,545.

Team Wrenn swept the trotting colt divisions as they were also victorious just a few races later with **Elhelpski** in the final division in 1:56.3. Elhelpski made his game winning move down the backside and held off Flight Number One and John DeLong late in the mile to get the win by nearly two lengths.

With the victory, Elhelpski recorded his second win in just three lifetime starts. Owned in partnership by S&R Racing Stables, Bottom Line Racing LLC and Wrenn Racing, Elhelpski has now amassed \$70,800 in lifetime purse earnings.

Freshman filly pacers were in action Tuesday (Aug. 15) at Eldorado Scioto Downs for four \$20,000 divisions of the Buckeye Stallion Series. Kayne Kauffman drove **Illegal** to her third win in the Buckeye Stallion Series as he won two of the four races.

Kauffman won his first Buckeye Stallion Series race of the night in the third division when he drove Illegal to a gate-to-wire victory in a new lifetime mark of 1:53.4. Kauffman took the 1-5 favorite to lead and cruised to an easy three-length win for trainer Mike Polhamus. The daughter of Western Vintage has hit the board in all four starts, winning three all in the Buckeye Stallion Series. Owned by Polhamus and Kevin Quinn, Illegal has earned \$44,235 in 2023.

Around the final turn, Bug Juice went five-wide, grabbing the lead at the top of the stretch and drawing away to win by three lengths in 1:55.2 for trainer Brian Brown. Owned by Jennifer Brown, it was the second win in six starts for Bug Juice who has earned \$20,060 this year.

Sistermarystigmata was second with Appeasement third.

Ken Holliday took **Sarah Said** to the lead and never looked back going wire-to-wire to win the second division in a new lifetime mark of 1:53.2. The daughter of Well Said fought off a challenge from I'm A Beach Lady around the final turn and held off Naked On A Hill down the stretch to win for the third time this year. Garry Martin trains and co-owns Sarah Said with B Kleinberg Racing and Lee Unkefer. Sarah Said has earned \$29,074 this year.

Naked On A Hill finished second with Hot Shave getting up for third.

That lineup held in place through the early fractions of :29.3 and 1:00.4 before Wherever Rio Goes launched a first-over bid as they headed down the backside and applied heavy pressure to the leader before getting the call at three-quarters in 1:30.3

while Insurrectionist began a three-wide rally and Banker's Quest took closer order from third.

In the lane Insurrectionist (\$3.00) trotted strong and drew clear from his rivals, posting a 2-3/4 length tally in a career best 2:00.4 while stablemate Banker's Quest was clearly second best and kicked well clear of Wherever Rio Goes to complete the Banker Volo-sired exacta.

The winner is owned by his breeder Jeralene Roland and is trained by Dan Roland.

**Banker's Grace** (Banker Volo) captured the \$18,250 filly division with driver Nick Roland in tow, leaving the gate sharply from post 3 to secure the pocket position as Wisco On A Mission (Jacob Cutting) went to the front and Al-Mar Puredelight (Todd Warren) landed in third.

Wisco on a Mission led comfortably through fractions of :30.1 and 1:01.1 and was still going strong as they rounded the far turn after posting three-quarters in 1:31.

In the homestretch Banker's Grace vacated the pocket and bravely came after the leader, surging past in the shadow of the wire and posting a three-quarter length victory in 2:02.2 for her first career win.

Wisco On A Mission held second over Al-Mar Puredelight and Debutante Magnolia Moonlight (Chip Lackey) was home in third.

Banker's Grace (\$17.20) is owned by her breeder Kennedy Roland and trained by Dan Roland.

Drivers Plano and Brady Jenson each scored doubles on the Tuesday program.





### Luke McGook scores his seventh at Skowhegan

Marc Tardiff's **Luke McGook** continued to display his dominance in the Maine Sire Stakes, winning Tuesday's (Aug. 15) \$14,917 div. 3-year-old colt and gelding pace at the Skowhegan State Fair. It was the seventh consecutive victory for the Leighton Property-owned son of Rock N' Roll World, who also took a new seasonal mark of 1:56.1 in the wire-to-wire triumph.

Driven by regular pilot Kevin Switzer Jr. and conditioned by the powerful Peggy and Marc Tardiff stable, the winner of 15-of-20 lifetime starts cut swift early fractions of :28.4 and :59. At the third panel Switzer Jr. let out a notch in 1:27.4 while feeling some pressure from Colt Bennett (Dave Ingraham, David Crochere) and stablemate So Rock N' Roll (Walter Case Jr.).

Despite So Rock N' Roll posting a :28.1 final quarter he could only get to his rival's saddle pad as Luke McGook prevailed by a quarter length. Mattucci (Aaron Hall, Valerie Grondin) was third.

Luke McGook was bred in Maine by Erika Saucier and now has \$193,490 in lifetime earnings. He paid \$2.60 to win.

The other \$14,692 glamour boys' division was won handily by **Two Towns Over**, before the regular twilight card. Driven by Aaron Hall for owner/trainer Valerie Grondin, the son of Deuce Seelster cruised unfettered through comfortable fractions of :29.4, 1:00.4 and 1:31 before equaling his own seasonal best of 1:58.1.

Twice The Ice (Andy Harrington, Marc Tardif) finished second by three parts of a length; Rockaroundsam (Switzer Jr., Tardif) was third.

During Monday's (Aug' 14) card the 3-year-old pacing fillies enjoyed two divisions of Maine-bred action, with **Katelyn's Angel** grabbing her fourth win in a row in the \$14,459 event.

Driven by Switzer Jr. for the Tardif Taskforce, the daughter of Western Maverick got every call and opened up by four lengths to score in 1:58.4. Katelyn's Angel is owned and was bred by the Leightons and now has \$93,605 in lifetime earnings.



La Mamabacita (Campbell, Grondin) finished second; Justcallmemimi (Case Jr., Mike Graffam) was third.

In a sweep of the sophomore pacing fillies, Team Tardiff took the other \$14,684 division with **Pickmepickme**, who redeemed her recent activity with a much-anticipated victory.





### Martha Nichols Brown, 85, dies

Martha Nichols Brown of Hillsboro Beach, FL, who owned and operated Dunroven Stud in Lexington, KY, died Sunday (Aug. 13) of complications of a stroke. She was 85.

Mrs. Brown was the daughter of Harold Willis Nichols Jr. and Katherine Edwards Nichols, who for many years owned and operated Walnut Hall Farm in Lexington. Mrs. Brown spent a great deal of her youth at Walnut Hall and during most of her life lived on Dunroven Stud — property that at one time was a part of historic Walnut Hall — with her husband, Steve.

Dunroven Stud bred scores of horses over the years, among them 2012 Kentucky Futurity winner My MVP; 1997 Hambletonian Oaks champion Must Be Victory; 1998 Merrie Annabelle winner Rae; the stakes-winning filly Bold Dreamer, the dam of Hambletonian elimination winner Pampered Princess; stakes winner Bramasole, dam of \$1.3 million winner Caprice Hill; and the pacer Cam's Rocket, today best known as the sire of trotting stallion Googoo Gaagaa.

In addition to breeding horses, Mrs. Brown was active in industry leadership positions, serving on the board of the U.S. Trotting Association, the Kentucky Standardbred Association, Horseman Publishing Company (publisher of The Horseman And Fair World magazine), and the Stable of Memories (the Round Barn, located at the entrance to the Red Mile). In 2009, she was inducted into the Kentucky Harness Horsemen's Association Hall of Fame. She and her husband were regular attendees at the Hambletonian at The Meadowlands and Grand Circuit racing meets in the Midwest.

Born May 25, 1938, in Cincinnati, OH, she was a graduate of The Masters School, Dobbs Ferry, NY, and Vassar College, Poughkeepsie, NY. She was a former teacher at the Indian Hill School in Cincinnati, OH and at Sayre School in Lexington.

As an advocate of theater and the arts, Mrs. Brown served on the boards of Lexington Children's Theater, Kentucky Theater Association and the Kentucky Arts and Education Association. More recently, she was past president of the Landmark Condominium Association in Hillsboro Beach, FL, where she lived for many years until her death. She was a longtime breeder

of Charolais cattle, serving on boards of the Kentucky Charolais Association and the Ohio Valley Charolais Association. She was a member of Spindletop Hall in Lexington, the Boca Country Club in Florida, and the Maidstone Club in East Hampton, NY.

She was preceded in death by her husband of 51 years, Stephen M. Brown. She is survived by her sisters, Katherine N. Sautter (James), Margaret N. Jewett (Alan Leavitt), Elizabeth M. Nichols (George Lee), numerous nephews and nieces, as well as great-nephews and nieces. Mrs. Brown took great pleasure in her family and enjoyed offering advice and wisdom to them throughout the years. She followed their successes and achievements avidly.

A memorial service will be held on Sunday (Aug. 27), at 3 p.m. at Mt Horeb Presbyterian Church on Iron Works Pike in Lexington. Memorial donations may be made to the Stable of Memories, P.O. Box 11073, Lexington, KY 40512-1073 or to the charity of one's choice.

# OSS and Grand Circuit freshman invade Woodbine Mohawk Park

Eight of the 13 races carded Saturday night (Aug. 19) at Woodbine Mohawk Park are for freshman as three \$70,000 Ontario Sires Stakes Gold divisions for pacing colts and geldings go postward alongside \$30,000 eliminations for the \$640,000 William Wellwood and \$400,000 Peaceful Way.

Through two Gold Legs the 2-year-old male pacers standings are crowded with four different winners separated by just twelve points. Bettor's Delight colt Mirage Hanover is on top of that pile, and looking to separate himself from the pack.

In the second OSS Gold Leg the Scott McEneny trainee cut the mile from the quarter pole onwards and showed incredible speed, putting up fractions of :55.2 and 1:24.1 on route to a final time of 1:50.4, at that time the fastest seasonal mark by a 2-year-old pacer in North America.

"He was very impressive that night," said McEneny. "He did it so handy. [Driver Bob McClure] said at the seven-eighths pole he kind of started shutting him down, and the more he shut him down the faster he was going."

His most recent start was in the second leg of the \$20,000 Dream Maker on Aug. 4, where he was third in a photo after a first up move around the far turn.

"He scoped a little sick after that race, and just wasn't on his game that night," said McEneny. "Being a Bettor's Delight they kind of need to be on the bit a little bit more, and he just didn't look himself. But he has come into this week really good, we've scoped him, and blood is good, and everything is good."

The \$175,000 Harrisburg yearling is the third foal out of Mach Three mare Mayhem Seelster who earned \$390,000 on the racetrack, and was an OSS Grassroots champion, Gold winner, and third in the 2015 Breeders Crown 2-Year-Old Fillies Pace.

His half-sister Milieu Hanover has made over \$360,000, and his half-brother Mad Max Hanover who is also owned by Mirage Hanover's owner Marvin Rounick, has hit the board 20 times in 39 starts for over \$700,000 on his card.

Mirage Hanover drew into the final OSS division of the evening, race 9, where he will leave from post 5 with James MacDonald driving.

He is facing off against Tall Dark Stranger's full brother Total Stranger (Bettor's Delight), who is making his Canadian and OSS debut after a pair of runner-up finishes in three Kindergarten Series starts at The Meadowlands.

"He's feeling good this week, and it should be a good race," said McEneny. "We're looking to hopefully set him up for the Metro, and keep him healthy and keep moving forward."

The three other Gold winners from the first two legs are all entered on Saturday; T H McMurry (McWicked), Chain Gang (Bettor's Delight), and Do Better, who comes in off a sweep of the Battle of Waterloo elimination and final at Grand River Raceway.

The trio of eliminations for the William Wellwood, open to all 2-year-old trotters, are slated for races 6, 8, and 10, with six Ontario sired colts entered.

Resolve gelding Soar Higher is the leading Ontario sired earner so far this season with \$90,195 banked on the strength of a 1-1-1 record in three OSS starts for trainer Matt Bax. James MacDonald will be at the lines leaving from post 2 in the third elimination.

Finite (Resolve), Elegant Resolve (Resolve), Indy Be Quick (Alarm Detector), Salem Seelster (Muscle Mass), and Mrstery Deal (Wheeling N Dealin) round out the Ontario sired contingent.

The winner of the William Wellwood receives free entry into the Mohawk Million.

The Peaceful Way for two-year-old trotting fillies attracted nineteen entrants. Four are Ontario Sired.

Leading the way is Archangel filly Willys Home Run who is three for three in the OSS this season for trainer Kyle Fellows.

Sara Gatchell, Jake Higgs, Reg Higgs, and Yolanda Fellows co-own the full sister to multiple O'Brien award finalist Logan Park. Willys Home Run drew the rail position in race 7, the second elimination, and is 5-2 on the morning line. MacDonald will be at the lines.

Nautilus B (Muscle Mass) joins Willys Home Run in race 7. Love Those Legs (Kadabra) and Valuable Miss (My MVP) are in race 5.
