# Has Michigan harness racing been re-incarnated?

An interview with Michigan Harness Horsemen's Association president Brett Boyd.

The glory days of racing in Michigan have, more or less, been erased from history.

The memories of Hazel Park and Wolverine Raceway have been buried under the limestone long ago.

Some track record holders like Scotch Valley, Vicki's Jet and Belle Acton, well, this is about the only time you will see their great names in print from here to eternity.

Horsemen like Joe Marsh, Jr., Bob Williams, Wally McIlmurray, Harold Fisher, Bob Farrington, Ted Taylor, Irving Utter, even Charlie Goins, on occasion, to name a handful, are only fond memories of those ancient enough in age to have witnessed their greatness more than a half-century ago.

Yes, Michigan still has some fairs – more than a dozen these days – from Bad Axe and Fowlerville to Ironwood and Hastings, but the most important one to crop up in the roster was the Barry County Fair in Hastings, a very slick half-mile oval.

Hastings, without doubt, is one of the most superb "smaller" towns in America and located within a reasonable distance of four well-known cities – Grand Rapids, Kalamazoo, Battle Creek and Lansing.

Hastings, by the way, has a rich history in harness racing – back over a century – a brief example being on June 24, 1893 when the chestnut mare Fedora swept three straight heats in the \$200 free-for-all, the fastest heat in 2:24 1/4.

But just a few days ago, Hastings was the site of the revival of pari-mutuel racing in Michigan, or, as Brett Boyd lamented,

borrowing a page from astronaut Neil Armstrong, "One small step for harness racing, one giant leap for Michigan harness racing."

### ***First, thanks for your untiring efforts on behalf of our sport.***

**Boyd:** “It’s been a labor of love fighting for Michigan horse racing and our families. This has been going on for 35 years and I’m honored to be serving again as the MHHA [Michigan Harness Horsemen’s Association] president.”

### ***Isn’t this, actually, your second go-around with the MHHA?***

**Boyd:** “Yes, I stepped away from the MHHA after a 10-year stint in 2014 to try to get Jackson Harness Raceway opened with my wife, Brandy.”

### ***Tough assignment.***

**Boyd:** “Ultimately, we were NOT successful in getting our favorite track re-opened but we did succeed in helping our horsemen in future negotiations with Northville Downs.”

### ***It’s not just with tracks with whom you have to negotiate, it takes some help on the legislative side of the ledger, too. Correct?***

**Boyd:** “Yes, absolutely, and, yes, I did spearhead an effort with my local legislators to secure some tax revenue with the passage of the online gaming bill in Michigan.”

### ***How great was that?***

**Boyd:** “Yes, but, at the last minute, they placed a \$3 million revenue cap on the tax revenue to the Ag[riculture] Equine Fund from online gaming.”

### ***Can anything be done to, kind of, amend that?***

**Boyd:** “Well, we are trying to get that [\$3 million] cap removed and we have 16 co-sponsors to get this done.”

### ***That is always a tough assignment; politics with two parties always getting in the way of each other.***

**Boyd:** “I know, but I believe we have bipartisan co-sponsors on our behalf in this effort.”

### ***But it takes two-to-tango – maybe three with casinos – and, here, in Florida, that didn’t work out too well.***

**Boyd:** “I know, Florida was a tragedy but we have met with all 27 casinos in Michigan and have reached a tentative agreement for revenue sharing moving forward.”

### ***Can you trust them?***

**Boyd:** “We incorporated that agreement into our legislation and that would create over \$15 million in additional revenue for our county fairs and our industry.”

### ***So, you are optimistic that the legislation will pass?***

**Boyd:** “We have to be optimistic. We have worked very hard to get this far and this will help restore the Michigan racing and breeding industry, as well as the fairs. By the way, the Bills – House Bills 4367 and 4347 – have passed the agriculture committee and now we wait for the rules committee. I think we have significant support in the Michigan House and Senate and we are hopeful that our Governor [Whitmer] will appreciate our efforts and what the Bills do for our fairs, participating youth, and our entire industry.”

### *You know that Michigan was, once, a very strong industry in agriculture.*

**Boyd:** “Yes, back 20 years ago, in an economic study done by the legislature, this was a \$1 billion industry and we are hopeful to make it a \$1 billion industry again.”

### *So, this new pari-mutuel facility. How did Hastings get the nod here?*

**Boyd:** “The MHHA worked hand-in-hand with Mike and John Carlo to get a new pari-mutuel facility at the Barry County Expo Center in Hastings. This was an effort to open a facility for horsemen and secure current and ongoing revenue for advanced deposit in Michigan.”

### *Done deal?*

**Boyd:** “It generates about \$2.5 million annually for horsemen and our programs and it was important to recognize Hastings to maintain this revenue source.”

### *So, you have a meeting with purse money, and “they’re off!”*

**Boyd:** “Yes, but, this year, all of our purse money for our 20-day meet is restricted purse money for Michigan owned, bred or sold horses.”

### *Is that set in stone forever?*

**Boyd:** “I don’t think so. We are hopeful that, once our legislation passes, we could, potentially, open another facility and have expanded race day opportunities for horsemen.”

### *Sounds like it’s been a huge mountain to climb.*

**Boyd:** “Yes, it’s been long, tedious, and very tough, but we are hoping to offer expanded racing opportunities next year at Hastings with the ultimate passage of our legislative and we’re optimistic about the future.”

### *Have any ultimate goals?*

**Boyd:** “Yes. Our ultimate goal is to build one of the best programs in the country for 2-year-old, 3-year-old and 4-year-old trotters and pacers. After that, I am sure our success will lead into great things for aged horses, as well.”

### *Billion-dollar industry in Michigan again?*

**Boyd:** “That’s our goal.”

# M-M's Dream has 'Girl Power' thanks to her owner

In late July, The Meadowlands announced a new race, the Girl Power for 4- and 5-year-old mare trotters, but according to trainer Ron Burke, owner Frank Baldachino was not happy.

Baldachino and Hillside Stables co-own 6-year-old female trotter M-M's Dream, who is trained by Burke.

"He told me, 'That's not fair,'" Burke said of Baldachino's reaction to the new race's age restriction. "I said, 'I don't know, call Jeff [Gural]'. And he did and was relentless on him about it.

"Basically, Frank Baldachino beat Jeff up about it, until, finally, Jeff relented."

On Aug. 11, a release was sent out by The Meadowlands that the Girl Power, scheduled for Friday (Aug. 29), has been adjusted to also include 6-year-olds mares.

Burke is excited for the opportunity for M-M's Dream to race again at The Meadowlands, where she recently won the Dr. John R. Steele Memorial on Hambletonian Day (Aug. 2) for the third-straight year.

"It's the track that she likes the most," Burke said. "Now, instead of racing some race for \$40,000, we're going to race for \$100,000.

"So, of course, 4, 5 and 6, I don't know why you just didn't go aged. What's the difference? Who's really around at 7 that would be a factor. You know what I mean?"

The win in this year's Steele Memorial was the first stakes victory of the season for the daughter of Swan For All—Trading Places, who Burke said has been dealing with some issues.

"She has a chip," Burke said. "So, we had to address that. And, like I said, I'm not going to race her as much, I'm not going to train her as hard, and then I'm going to make the ones count when I do race her.

"When I can take her shoes off, it's a huge difference. Of all the horses in my barn, I've never seen one that gets a bigger reaction out of shoes off."

Burke took her shoes off in the Steele because the track was in such good shape. Meadowlands president/chief executive officer **Jeff Gural landed in some hot water** that day from a misunderstood comment he made about the track condition following the victory of his horse, Nordic Catcher S, in the 100<sup>th</sup> edition of the Hambletonian.

"Everybody was so mad about that," Burke said. "I go, 'We all raced on the same track. You're mad because she got the track good for all of us?' What the f---, who cares? It's the dumbest thing. It's not like it's cheating. Oh, we made the track real good for Jeff's horse. Oh, guess who else's horse has raced on a real good track? Ours.

"That's not why the horse won. The horse won because the horse was vicious the week before. [Trainer] Ake [Svanstedt] did a great job getting that horse ready for one race. Give the guy credit, he's pretty good at what he does.

"It was said incorrectly, that's all it was, and by an 80-year-old guy that was in a jubilant mood. I've got bigger things to worry about than if Sarah [Svanstedt's] helping the trackman get it right. Like I said, the track was great. Maybe she should be in charge of the track."

Burke did say that he has noticed more horses with suspensory, and soft-tissue injuries, than in years past.

"We've had a lot of problems this year there with horses getting sore, and I don't know what it is, because I'm not

there all the time, but when I’m there, it’s always a big night, and the track seems good, but maybe when it’s not, it’s not as good,” he said, adding with a laugh, “I’m the least complainer; I usually race through a minefield if the purses are good enough.”

Following the Girl Power, Burke said M-M’s Dream will tell them if she’s up to racing on Sept. 5 at The Meadowlands in the last leg of the Miss Versatility before the final on Little Brown Jug Day in Delaware (Ohio) on Sept. 18.

“If she comes out of [the Girl Power] good, and she’s fresh, yeah, of course, we’ll race her,” Burke said. “She never gets sore; I can just tell when she just isn’t herself.”

As for whether there are plans to remove the chip, Burke said, “No, she’ll just get bred. This is it. At the end of the year, we’re done.”

Burke also said that he appreciates that The Meadowlands added a race for trotting mares, even if M-M’s Dream is the senior citizen in the bunch.

“She seems now like she always has to race against the younger horses,” Burke said. “Her competition isn’t her age or older, it’s her age or younger, and basically, younger.”

“I think [having the Girl Power is] good. It’s another big race for the most underserved division that has the least amount of money to race for.”

Ayroplane and Ayrodrome were bred by Scotland's Ayr Standardbreds owned by the O'Neil family, Ryan, Hugh, Elizabeth, and Michael.

Oakwood Harry is a Captain Crunch son and the first foal from ultra-impressive daughter of Foreclosure, Oakwoodanabella IR.

The most buzz may surround Oakwood William, a son of Always B Miki out of the Grinfromeartoear mare Trend Setter.

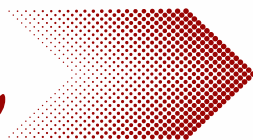

## Bicc's Tobee gives trainer Törnqvist biggest win to date

Maria Törnqvist's stable is definitely one of Sweden's most successful at the moment and she has really progressed as a trainer during the last two or three years.

She was lacking a big win, but in Wednesday's (Aug. 20) \$300,000 Margareta Wallenius-Klebergs Pokal for 5-year-olds, Törnqvist had a shot with **Bicc's Tobee** (Tobin Kronos), driven by Dwight Pieters. Bicc's Tobee sprinted to a safe win in a mile rate of 1:54.3 over 1.3 miles.

Favorite Daim Brodda couldn't fight for the win when she was left first over for the last kilometer. From behind, Olly Håleryd

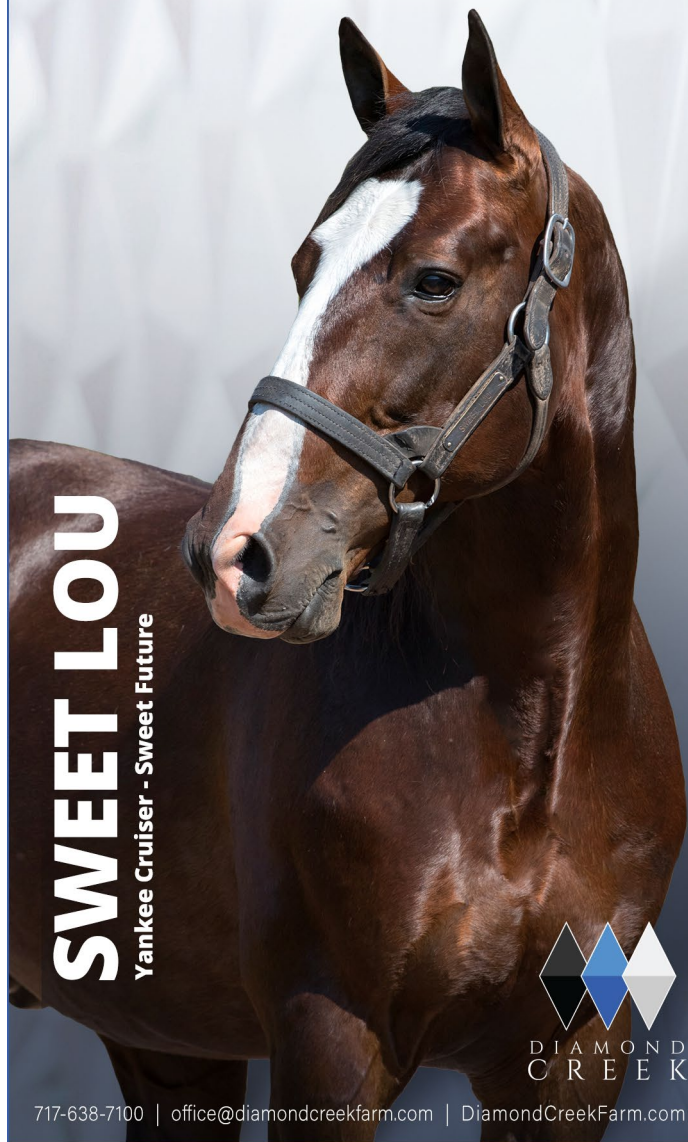

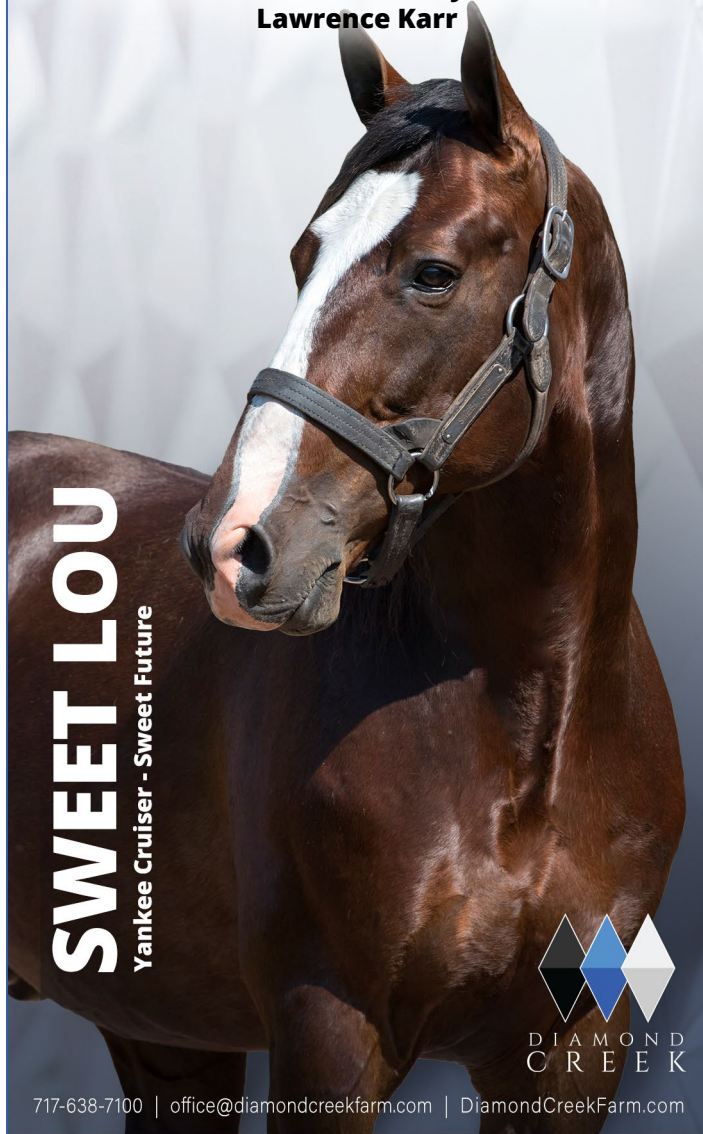

### Zach Mullins built a meaningful connection to a life in racing

The man from Inverness is in the zone.

Once an active coal mining hub, the town of Inverness, NS, has transformed into a golfer's dream destination, showcasing world-class golf courses that draw duffers from across the globe. Inverness Beach, a long, scenic stretch of sandy coastline, is a haven for swimmers and beachcombers alike.

But for standardbred horseman Zach Mullins, Inverness is more than just a vacation destination – it's a field of horse racing dreams.

"People love horse racing here," said the 25-year-old Mullins, who is also a full-time carpenter. "I have been around it all my life and that will never change. Being around the horses and being at the races is something I truly appreciate and love."

Mullins showed early promise in the race bike during his 2020 rookie driving season, just two years after he began his training

career. He notched 11 wins from 75 starts that year, including his first career driving victory on July 26 at Inverness Raceway.

He piloted Whim Roader, a son of Nukamiki out of the Water Tower mare Water Sprite, to a commanding wire-to-wire, four-length win in race 3 at the half-mile Nova Scotia oval.

“My dad [Richie Mullins] and I were looking for a cheap claimer to race at Inverness,” said Zach, whose first training win came when Tuckers Best was best of six at Inverness on Oct. 14, 2018. “We brought him home and he had terrible feet, but we worked with him, and we were able to get him right. That win will always be special.”

To date, Zach’s best season in the sulky, in terms of wins, came in 2023 when he recorded 24 victories. On the training side, he’s already set a slew of personal-best marks in 2025.

Zach, who is atop both the trainer and driver standings at Inverness this year, didn’t expect his 2025 campaign to turn out the way it has – but he’s not questioning it.

“I definitely never saw it coming,” he said. “There was never really anything that made me think any of this was going to happen.”

A big part of that success has come from Windemere Barkley, a 2-year-old son of Somewhere Fancy. Zach trains and co-owns the colt with his brother, Cole. The horse, bred by Windemere Farms in Springvale, PEI, has quickly become the star of Zach’s stable.

Windemere Barkley captured one of six \$8,000 P.E.I. Colt Stakes Grassroots divisions for rookie colts on July 16 at Summerside Raceway. The Mullins brothers purchased him for \$3,500 (Hip #138) at the 2024 Atlantic Classic Yearling Sale.

In five starts, he’s delivered four wins – all in stakes company – and a second-place finish. His most recent triumph, a 4½-length blowout at Charlottetown Driving Park, was completed in a career-best mile of 1:59.1.

“When we first got him, I hadn’t seen any photos online,” Zach said. “But I did know his breeding because I had his brother, Windemere Albert, a couple years earlier. He had injuries early on, but he was a very nice 2-year-old and 3-year-old. He was just a kind horse to be around. My brother and I went to go see him [Windemere Barkley] because we liked his brother so much.”

The siblings liked what they saw in the horse with eye-catching conformation and a modest price tag.

“We saw him, and he was just phenomenal,” Zach said. “He was full of muscle, big, and just so kind. And the way he carried himself once we got him into the barn was outstanding. He was so natural in everything he did. He hit the pace the first time I brought him onto the track.”

It was then that Zach began to believe he had a special horse under his tutelage.

A qualifier ahead of his first lifetime start on June 29 – he was second at Inverness in his debut – solidified that credence.

“I was sitting third into the five-eighths turns in a training trip and I kicked him out two-wide and he went by them as if they had stopped,” Zach said. “That’s when I realized the type of speed he had.

“His last win, he did it so easily. Hopefully, he will keep moving forward.”

Zach currently has seven horses in his barn. While he continues to balance horse racing with his carpentry career, he has no shortage of support in the backstretch.

His father, who handles the head maintenance role at Inverness, remains a constant source of wisdom and encouragement.

“When I started in the business, my dad always told me there are going to be some bad days and tough times, but you need to persevere, and you need to enjoy the good moments,” Zach said.

And then there is local legend Alex ‘Trapper’ MacQuarrie.

“He’s 77, he had almost 1,300 career driving wins, lots of training wins, and so much knowledge about horses and horse racing,” Zach said. “He’s pretty much like my grandfather. He has been around since I was a kid and he is my dad’s best

friend. He always has great advice and he’s an amazing helping hand in the barn. He jogs my horses every day.”

The MacQuarrie family remains closely involved with the Mullins operation.

“Alex’s niece, Angela MacArthur, co-owns a horse with me, Woodmere Novak, and Trapper jogs him,” Zach said. “Angela also owns Light My Shadow. Alex’s brother Angus MacQuarrie, who is turning 90 this week, co-owns Yacht Seelster and Woodmere Novak.”

Having a front-row seat for a horse racing master class is not lost on Zach, whose other brother, Ross, is a bylaw officer for Inverness County, who also helps out in the barn.

“I can’t believe how lucky I am to have so many great people who love the game helping me out,” Zach said. “I don’t take any of that for granted.”

Although carpentry remains his main livelihood, Zach has built a meaningful connection to a life in racing.

On most nights, you’ll find him exactly where he wants to be: at the racetrack.

“It’s a great atmosphere and there are so many wonderful people – it is like a community,” he said.

A community Zach is grateful to be part of.

“Racing isn’t my full-time job, but I treat it like it is,” he said. “I have the same work ethic at the racetrack. Work harder every day, treat your owners and horses with respect.

“I have a group of great owners – Donnie, Darlene and Brock MacLellan, Jimmy and Angela MacArthur, Jimmy and Jamie Struthers. I’d like to thank them all for their support and just being all around great people in the harness racing game.”

As for his own main objective in racing, it is anything but complex.

“Winning more races would be nice,” Zach said with a laugh.

Hardly a longshot for a horseman who’s clearly in the zone.

# A fresh prospect put Wicked Road on the right path

Success in the Ontario Sires Stakes was always the path forward for Wicked Road, even if the exact destination came by way of a detour.

A natural from the outset, Wicked Road flashed plenty of promise while training down for conditioner Meg Crone, who envisioned a career in the Grassroots ranks for the bay daughter of McWicked—Ashleeswayrhigway.

Encouraged by the young filly's steady development, Crone started her exactly there.

"She had trained down very well," said Crone, who recorded career highs across the board, including her first million-dollar year, in 2024. "She's slick-gaited, she's smart, and we felt the Grassroots would work well for her."

Wicked Road made eight starts during her rookie season, four of which came in Grassroots contests, finishing with a lone third in a lower-level dash at Mohawk on Aug. 2, 2024.

After a trying maiden campaign hampered by health and consistency-related challenges, Crone shut Wicked Road down at the end of last October.

Six months passed between then and Wicked Road's first start of 2025.

In that time, Crone formulated a fresh plan, giving her resilient pacer the chance to return rejuvenated and ready to make a statement between the rails.

"We thought she was going to be a Grassroots filly, but it's better to excel than to chase and pick up small checks," said Crone. "That's part of why we went to the Prospect Series."

Wicked Road's journey to Prospect glory began with an impressive 4¼-length triumph on April 13 at Flamboro, marking her first career victory.

The \$15,000 purchase at the 2023 London Classic Yearling Sale then parlayed that confidence into a four-week stretch of brilliance, starting July 12 with a 3½-length decision in 1:54.4 at Georgian Downs.

What was still to come may have felt unexpected to some, save for Crone.

"It wasn't necessarily a surprise for me because like I said, she's always been great-gaited – she's got good gait speed," said Crone. "You can come off cover good. It was just a matter of things going her way."

And that they did.

Next time out on July 19, Wicked Road set a lifetime mark of 1:54.3 in a three-length victory, also at Georgian.

Some eight days later, the ascending sophomore found herself answering the Prospect bell for the first time.

Working with regular driver Anthony Haughan, Wicked Road seized the early advantage and never looked back to finish 1½ lengths clear of Lydia Go.

The eye-catching effort at Dresden Raceway confirmed what her trainer had long seen in her.

"Going into the Prospects, it really takes a handy horse when you hit the smaller tracks, like Dresden," said Crone. "They've got to be able to get around any size track. You've got to be able to put yourself in a position to win. It's not one where you can take back to last and expect to swoop the field or anything."

Armed with a newfound confidence and strategy, Wicked Road one-upped herself yet again, leading coast-to-coast in the next Prospect event on Aug. 12 at Georgian to extend her win streak to four.

The spree stood out to Crone for many reasons, but none more than the sheer dominance displayed.

“She’s won all of them with ease – you never really had to ask her,” said Crone. “The plugs have been in for the majority of her wins, and they never had to be pulled except maybe for one.

“Anytime you have a horse, and they get a win or two in a row, that’s the best way to build that confidence.”

While Wicked Road’s unbeaten stretch ended in a Prospect tilt on Aug. 19 at Mohawk, the classy 3-year-old found a way to vie for OSS success while playing to her strengths.

“Not getting stressed just seems to keep her a bit healthier,” said Crone. “It’s definitely not easy, the Prospect, but it’s a bit lighter on her since you’re not racing so hard every week.

“We give her about three starts per month. That seems to be the right number for her.”

Outside of the direct connections, Crone said she is most happy for the folks at Hutt Racing Stable, who own Wicked Road, and Winbak Farms, the young filly’s breeder.

“It’s really nice to have her, especially since we’ve trained for Hutt and Winbak Farms for quite a few years,” she said. “It’s always nice to do well for them, because they always give us an opportunity with horses every year.

“Winning for them is extra special. They’re one of our most loyal owners.”

Wicked Road’s remarkable turnaround has Crone smiling on the inside, too.

“It’s always nice when you break them, and they win,” she said. “It means a little bit more.”

Wicked Road is the latest highlight-maker in Crone’s roster of success stories, headlined by trotting superstar Amigo Volo.

Remembered best for Breeders Crown victories in 2019 and 2020, Amigo Volo joined Crone’s stable in the fall of 2023 as a 6-year-old.

Just two years later, the now older trotting sensation delivered her first career O’Brien Award nomination after a standout 2024 campaign for them both.

When asked if there are any parallels between her young and old pupils, Crone needed no more than two seconds to think.

“No, no,” she said with a laugh. “Amigo Volo is a once in a lifetime horse, even [driver/trainer] Carter Pinsky will tell you that. You’ll never get another Amigo. He’s just amazing in every way.

“We’re just thankful that Carter and [owner] Karl Pinsky trust us with him. Like I said, he’s once in a lifetime. Unfortunately, I don’t think there will be another Amigo. Hopefully, but I don’t think so. You can’t even describe how special Amigo is.”

While Wicked Road certainly has a way to go before reaching Amigo status, conquering the next challenge would be a solid first step.

“We hope for her to be competitive in the Harvest Series at Mohawk,” said Crone. “I think she’ll be an even better racehorse when the weather cools down. She’s one that should benefit from the cooler temperatures.”

So begins the road to the next hot streak.

# Burke's Al Papi sets world record at The Meadows

**Al Papi** set a world, track and stakes record of 1:49.2 for a 2-year-old colt pacer on a five-eighths-mile track in the first of two \$69,182 Pennsylvania Sire Stakes (PASS) divisions on Thursday (Aug. 21) at The Meadows.

Ron Burke was on hand at his home track to see his trainee rock the clock.

"He is very nice," Burke said of the freshman son of Papi Rob Hanover—Yankee Cruiser.

Al Papi, driven by Yannick Gingras, left for the lead from post 3 in the five-horse field and was never seriously challenged through fractions of :27, :55.4, and 1:22.2 before crossing the wire a length in front of Toast Of The Town with Melillo in third.

The winner's back half was a sizzling :53.3, prompting Meadows track announcer Jeff Zidek to say, "I was not expecting a world-record mile here in this five-horse field, but he got it there."

Owned and bred by Burke Racing Stable LLC, J&T Silva- Purnel & Libby, Lawrence Karr, and Weaver BrusceMI LLC, Al Papi now has a record of 3-1-1 in five starts this season and returned \$3.40 to win.

When asked if Al Papi reminded Burke of any of his other fast colts, he said, "The other colt that won I think is actually better."

Burke was referring to undefeated **Frantic Hanover**, who won the \$69,182 second PASS division for 2-year-old colt pacers on the same card.

Driven by Tim Tetrick, the 1-9 favorite won by three lengths over Thai Hanover, with Ain'tplayinnice in third.

Frantic Hanover, a son of Stay Hungry—Francia, is now a perfect five-for-five this season, including all four legs of the PASS and a division of the PA All-Stars.

Sophomore trotting fillies took to the track at Harrah's Hoosier Park with a pair of \$49,000 splits for the sixth leg of Indiana Sire Stakes where **Miracle Maven** and **Martz Seven** got back in the win column on Wednesday (Aug. 20).

Miracle Maven and driver John De Long left from post 5 in the first division as the 7-5 second choice in the wagering behind Fifty To Win (Marcus Miller) who was riding a four-race win streak into Wednesday's card. Miracle Maven left

alertly to grab early control in the field of six through an opening quarter of :28. The trotting fillies turned into the backstretch headwind when Fifty To Win moved first-over from third to take over just beyond the half in :57.2. A 13-1 longshot, Let Em Dance (Kevin Lambright), charged first-over to take on the favorite around the final turn, moving alongside at three-quarters in 1:26.3.

Let Em Dance put away Fifty To Win at the top of the lane and appeared poised for the upset before Miracle Maven

found room up the cones. Trotting home in :28.2, Miracle Maven rallied by Let Em Dance in the final stages of the mile to win by 1¼ lengths over the live longshot in 1:55.1. CS Massive Jewels (15-1, Kyle Wilfong) rallied for the show spot, 2¾ lengths back of the winner.

The win was one of a pair on the night for trainer Henry Graber, Jr. who trains the winning daughter of Don't Let'em—Bad Babysitter for owners Hillside Stables, Frank Baldachino, Beasty LLC., and Eleven Star Stables. Miracle Maven has won half of her six outings this season, and eight of 15 lifetime, good for career earnings of \$284,815.

In the second split, last year's Super Final champion Martz Seven pulled a mild 7-2 surprise with driver Kyle Wilfong. Leaving from the rail, Wilfong floated away third in the field of six while Ponda Jewel (Pete Wrenn) swooped down from the outside to lead to the quarter in :28.1. The tempo slowed to the half in :58.4 before Ponda Jewel was challenged

by Classical Jane (Trace Tetrick) who moved first-over and alongside the leader while Martz Seven tipped off the cones to follow her cover at three-quarters in 1:28.3.

Turning for home, Ponda Jewel dug in to rebuff the challenge from Classical Jane before Martz Seven began to pick up steam from second-over. Sprinting home in :26.4, Martz Seven rallied to lead before trotting 1¼ lengths clear on the wire in 1:55.4. Ponda Jewel held for second, with A Million Dances (Mike Oosting) finishing third.

Trained by Walter Haynes, Jr., Martz Seven has won three of nine in her sophomore campaign for owners Stephen Stoll and the Black And White Stable. The daughter of Swan For All—La Mirada has banked \$93,528 on the year, and \$303,615 lifetime following the sixth win of her career.

**Titans Mischief** (E L Titan—Morosita Bi) was on his best behavior as he stifled his opponents in the \$108,300 New York Sire Stake for 2-year-old colt and gelding trotters at Batavia Downs on Wednesday (Aug. 20) evening.

With no challengers off the wings, Titans Mischief (Matt Kakaley) inherited the lead from a pole position start and dominated a fractured field due to three breakers. With Who's Eyes Blues (Jim Morrill, Jr.) and Al (Tyler Buter) following loosely in chase, Titans Mischief set quarters of :30, 1:00.2 and 1:28.4 before heading into turn four and the eventual payoff. At the head of the lane, Titans Mischief was on top by three and on cruise control, finishing under Kakaley wraps in 1:57.4.

It was the third win in six lifetime starts for Titans Mischief (\$5), who is owned by his trainer Bruce Clarke, in partnership with John Coffey.

With \$170,775 now on his card, Titans Mischief moved into fourth place for earnings among all 2-year-old trotters in North America.

There were also two \$20,000 NYSS Excelsior Series races on the card.

In the first, **Twin B Seven Sins** (Chapter Seven—Affair Hall) won in 2:00 for driver Tyler Buter, trainer Noel Daley, and owners Patricia Stable, Caviart Farm, Allister Stables, and L. A. Express Stable.

The second was won by **Credito** (Credit Winner—Paya La Renta) who trotted in 2:03 for driver Ray Fisher, Jr., trainer Ryan Swift and owners Ilovemyharnesshorse Tito.

The live racing schedule at Batavia Downs shifted from Thursday to today (Aug. 22) this week, but post time remains the same at 6 p.m.

On Saturday (Aug. 23), the New York Sire Stakes returns for the second time this week with a double-header on the bill. The

3-year-old filly trotters will line up for \$121,800 in purses and the 3-year-old colt and gelding trotters will also vie for \$114,900 in loot.

Saturday will also feature Batavia Downs' signature race, the \$100,000 Robert J. Kane Memorial Invitational Pace that features some of the best older open pacers in North America, including millionaires Captain Albano and Desperate Man.

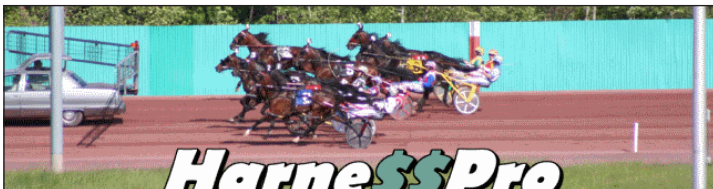

## Baillargeon celebrates \$100 million in career earnings

After surpassing the \$100 million mark, Baillargeon was joined by his wife, daughter and members of Woodbine Mohawk Park's driving colony for a special presentation.

A Quebec native now living in Acton, ON, Baillargeon has been a mainstay around Woodbine and Ontario's racing circuit for close to three decades. He began his career in 1977 at Blue Bonnets in Montreal and raced across North America, including stops in the 1980s in California, Michigan and Florida.

After spending a large portion of the 1990s in Quebec, Baillargeon shifted his focus to Woodbine/Mohawk later in 1999 and enjoyed career years through the early 2000s.

Nicknamed "Super Mario," Baillargeon has recorded 7,899 career wins to go with his \$100 million in earnings.

## Big M to race Saturday only as live racing winds down

For a second straight week, the usual two-day-a-week racing schedule at The Meadowlands will be cut in half due to preseason football at MetLife Stadium, as there will be no live action tonight (Aug. 22) before a 15-race program takes place on Saturday (Aug. 23).

Post time is 6:20 p.m.

Thereafter, there will be three more weeks of live action on a Friday-Saturday basis, with harness racing concluding on Saturday (Sept. 13), before the trotters and pacers take a four-week break while thoroughbred turf racing is conducted at The Big M.

Saturday's card is rock solid, with four \$25,000 leg three divisions of the Kindergarten Series for 2-year-olds, the \$45,000

Renaissance final for 2-year-old filly pacers, and a pair of \$60,000 New Jersey Standardbred Development Fund finals – one for 3-year-old colt and gelding trotters and another for 3-year-old filly trotters.

**CHECK OUT THE SHOW:** They'll be a new face on the Sam McKee Memorial Broadcast Set for the Saturday races.

Brett Sturman, the columnist and handicapper from [harnessracingupdate.com](http://harnessracingupdate.com), will sit alongside Dave Little providing commentary and selections.

The remainder of the lineup is the same as usual with Hall of Famer Ken Warkentin back calling the races after a two-week hiatus and Joe Romanelli conducting back paddock interviews as well as providing analysis and handicapping tips on the FanDuel Television (FDTV) feed.

**WHAT A CARRYOVER:** Last Friday (Aug. 15) marked the first time in 2025 that there was a carryover in the 50-cent Pick-4, and the bettors bet with both hands.

The carryover of \$26,408 coaxed players to pour \$134,179 of “new money” into the Late Pick-4 pool for a grand total of \$160,587, and after a sequence that saw winner's odds of 2-1, 3-5, 5-1 and 8-5, those with winning tickets cashed in for \$173.45.

**STABILE'S GOT A SIX-PACK:** While serving as co-host of the simulcast show Friday (Aug. 15) night, Anthony Stabile had himself quite a night giving out winners.

Stabile picked six on top with some headline-worthy payouts along the way.

Among Stabile's six-pack were **Big Bad Bill**, who paid \$13 in the third race. He also tabbed the \$30.60 Exacta cold in the eighth before **Albert Alpha**, another \$13 winner, topped a cold \$30.80 Exacta in the 12th. Stabile finished the night with **Rockabilly Charm** (\$10.80) in the 14th before completing a sweep of the Late Daily Double, which returned \$34.40.
