Kentucky ruling could mean end of trainer responsibility rule

Court ruling dropping all charges against thoroughbred trainer Graham Motion puts the absolute insurer rule at risk.


Lawyer Howard Taylor said the court ruling may untie his hands "to look for a cause that would exculpate the trainer."

Since as long as anyone can remember, a trainer, whether in thoroughbred or standardbred racing, was held responsible whenever a horse of theirs tested positive for a prohibited substance, no matter the circumstances. After a ruling was released earlier this week from Franklin Circuit Court Judge Thomas Wingate, in a case that involved the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission (KHRC) and thoroughbred trainer Graham Motion, that could change. In his verdict dropping all charges against Motion, the judge ruled that the absolute-insurer rule is unconstitutional.

The Motion-trained Kitten's Point tested positive for the medication Methocarbamol, a muscle relaxant that prevents

cramping, following her win in the Bewitch Stakes in 2015 at Keeneland. He was fined \$500 and received a five-day suspension. His attorney, Craig Robertson, argued that the amount of the drug found in the horse's system was so small that it was impossible for it to have a performance-enhancing effect on a horse and that the absolute-insurer rule denies a trainer his or her due process rights because it guarantees they will be held guilty if any drugs are found in a horses's system. Judge Wingate agreed on both points.

Marc Guilfoil, the executive director of the KHRC, said the commission will look into what course it may take.

"We are evaluating the opinion and the order issued by Judge Wingate in the Graham Motion case and are in the process of evaluating all legal options," he said.

Though a ruling involving a thoroughbred trainer, the decision was widely hailed by attorneys who normally represent standardbred trainers. They believe it will give them added ammunition when fighting for clients who have had drug positives. For now, the decision applies only in Kentucky, but Robertson said it is certain that attorneys fighting for their clients in other states will use the Franklin Circuit Court ruling as part of their defense and ask courts elsewhere to also strike down the absolute-insurer rule.

"In most states this will untie my hands to look for a cause that would exculpate the trainer," said horse owner and attorney Howard Taylor.

Taylor believes that the problem with the absolute-insurer rule is that it is so unwavering that it does not allow an attorney to present evidence that the positive was a matter of environmental contamination and not a trainer trying to improve the performance of their horse.

"This was the right decision," Taylor said. "I understand the reasoning behind the absolute-insurer rule but it places an unreasonable burden on some people. For instance, I am representing a guy who has a positive test in Pennsylvania and he knows exactly where it came from. His horse came up positive for a drug he never heard of. The judges even had to look up what it was. It turns out the guy paddocking for him told him it was a medication he takes every day. He was paddocking the horse that day so the trainer knows exactly where it came from, yet the racing commission has charged this guy despite this. Pennsylvania has a trainer responsibility rule chiseled in stone and so does Indiana, but they should allow for a rebuttal presumption."

While agreeing with and pleased by the Kentucky decision, attorney Drew Mollica believes the KHRC will appeal and he said it may be too early for lawyers representing horsemen to celebrate. Mollica added that he believes the portion of

the case where the judge threw out the positive because it was in such a minute amount could ultimately be as important as the absolute-insurer finding. Motion's horse tested positive 2.9 nanograms per milliliter of Methocarbamol. The KHRC threshold for the drug is 1 nanogram per milliliter. Testing methods have become so advanced and sensitive that labs are now able to find the tiniest amounts of drugs within a horse's system.

"It was a gutsy decision by a good judge because this judge stood up and said, 'Wait a minute,'" Mollica began. "He looked at the facts. For years in racing, they find you guilty, goodbye, that's the end of the case. He looked into the science. The RMTC (Racing Medication & Testing Consortium) throws out these levels that are hogwash. There's no science behind them. In the Graham Motion case, there's no question that the trace amount found was so low that it is impossible that it could have had a performance-enhancing effect on that horse. The threshold level of 1.0 nanograms is out of bounds with science.

"What racing commissions have been saying is that even with contamination it's still your fault. At some point common sense has take to take hold. We don't live in a sterile environment, What happens if some knucklehead throws cocaine in your water bucket? The rule is too draconian."

In a statement released Thursday, the RMTC wrote that, "the original study upon which this threshold is based was founded on sound science. The thresholds and withdrawal guidance provide the best information for compliance where an intravenous dose is given at 48 hours or more prior to a race. In fact, this methocarbamol threshold was revisited by the RMTC's Scientific Advisory Committee (SAC) as recently as last year. Every time a new study comes out on any of the controlled therapeutic substances, the RMTC SAC reviews that data to ensure that the threshold remains relevant. The RMTC stands behind its recommendation."

The RMTC also criticized the decision saying it, "has moved Kentucky backward in its regulation of horse racing – putting at risk the health and welfare of horses racing in Kentucky, the safety of jockeys and the integrity of Kentucky horse racing in general.

"Furthermore, the court's mystifying ruling undermining Kentucky's reliance upon the absolute insurer rule regarding trainer responsibility puts Kentucky out of step with other major racing jurisdictions and undermines its efforts toward national uniformity of regulations.

"The United States as a whole has moved away from the rebuttable presumption standard to the absolute insurer rule. Kentucky needs to move along with the rest of the country. This is the best way to ensure the integrity of the sport as well as the health and safety of racehorses.

"In conclusion, the RMTC vigorously opposes this decision and stands by the KHRC."

Also known as the trainer responsibility rule, it was put in place largely so that a trainer's defense could not be that he or she simply did not know how the drug got into the horse's system or claim that an outside party might have doped the horse. Should a trainer now attempt that sort of defense, Taylor does not believe they will be successful, despite the Kentucky ruling.

"It's not like they're going to start letting people off left and right," Taylor said. "It's still going to be a matter of if you can't figure out how something got into the horse's system you will be held responsible. But if you do know what happened and can prove that something got into a horse's system and it was not intentional or a matter of negligence they should be able to let you off. I use this argument all the time: You are the insurer of last resort, you are not the absolute insurer."





Fire at Goshen Historic Track destroys barn

Fortunately, no people or horses were hurt in Wednesday's blaze fought by 75 firefighters from 16 companies.

The Middletown (NY) Times Herald-Record is reporting that a fire that broke out in a sprawling barn near the grandstand at the Goshen Historic Track (GHT) on Wednesday evening (Aug. 23) around 6:15 pm drew 75 firefighters from 16 companies, and workers at the track led 10 horses to safety as the flames spread.

Tim Masters, facilities manager at the Historic Track, who personally led some of the horses away from the flames, said none of the horses were injured.

Fire officials said no humans were hurt either in the three-alarm fire, a smoky blaze that could be seen for miles around Goshen (full Times Herald-Record story here).

The blacksmith shop, a row of stalls and most of the BOCES barn were destroyed at the site, which is a National Historic Landmark. The barn sits next to the track behind the Harness Racing Museum and Hall of Fame. Firefighters told *The Times Herald-Record*, the museum "was never in danger, and firefighters managed to limit damage to an office building directly behind the barn to minor exterior damage."

"We should all have tremendous appreciation and praise for Tim Masters organizing and executing the evacuation of all horses on the grandstand side to the safety of the Parkway barn in about 20 minutes," said Janet Terhune, executive director of the Harness Racing Museum & Hall of Fame. "Tim continued the following day overseeing the cleanup of the aftermath. This fire could have been horrific had it not been for Tim's quick action."

"Flames were coming out all over the place," trainer Ian Kaufman told CBS2's Janelle Burrell. (full CBS story here) "I couldn't believe what I was seeing."

Kaufman said there were just seconds to react to get one horse, named Caviar Hall, out.

"Caviar Hall was in a burning stall after the fire erupted and it was thanks to one of the horse trainers that he was able to make it out safely," he said. "The whole stall was full of flames and the horse wasn't moving. I was yelling at the guy, 'please kick him — get him out of the stall."

Charles Peralo was driving by the track when he saw the

flames and raced over to help.

"The horses were absolutely freaking out," he said. "A bunch of people just started rushing over and we just started grabbing the horses, we didn't even have the rope to do it."

One spooked horse, a 3-year-old filly named Claire, made a run for it and was seen galloping away in the village before eventually being rescued.

It took firefighters three hours to get the flames under control. The cause of the fire is under investigation, but Masters says it appears to be electrical.

"We are grateful for the quick and effective job performed by our local fire departments, which came to our rescue and prevented tremendous tragedy for both GHT and our community at large. Their response saved numerous other structures," said Steve Jones, president of the Goshen Historic Track board of directors in a statement released Thursday. "We would like to express our gratitude to everyone who helped remove the horses from the stalls and ensured their safety, specifically Candyce Conroy, Kristy Nehrkorn and Tim Masters, just to name a few.

"We will be working with fire officials regarding the cause and carefully reviewing all of our structures to ensure their safety... Our goal is to improve and maintain this historic

facility for our community and the horsemen who support GHT."

The daughter of Bettor's Delight—Double Creme was put into play just after the half, moving up to challenge leader Scuola Hanover (Dave Miller) with three-eighths to go. It was a thrilling finish, with Double A Mint (\$6.20) getting up in time over longshot pocket-sitter Yankee Will Dance (Brett Miller), while Apple Hanover (Tim Tetrick) finished third. The final time was 1:53.2. It was her third

career win in five starts. The freshman filly is owned by Burke Racing, Weaver Bruscemi, Dandy Farms, and Silva, Purnel & Libby.

In division two, trainer Burke did it again with Strong Opinion (Matt Kakaley). The daughter of Well Said-Rough Sketch got to the top before yielding to eventual second-place finisher Alexa's Power (Scott Zeron). After patiently drafting, Strong Opinion took aim at the leader at the eighth poll, winning a thrilling stretch drive in 1:53.3. Sarpa Hanover (Andy McCarthy) finished third. Strong Opinion (\$3.60) is owned by Burke Racing, Jack Piatt II, Silva, Purnel & Libby, and Weaver Bruscemi.

The third and final division was the fastest of the afternoon as the highly touted Rainbow Room (David Miller) had to dig in late to win. The daughter of Somebeachsomewhere—Rainbow Blue brushed powerfully shy of the half and held off 4-5 co-favorite Come See The Show (Tim Tetrick) by a nose to win in 1:51.2. Majorsspeciallady (Matt Kakaley) finished third.

It was the fourth career win in five starts for the talented filly, who is owned by Crawford Farms Racing, Val D'Or Farms, and Ted Gewertz. She is trained by Joe Holloway.

Gall recognizes the importance of customers; here's some suggestions from one

Last weekend, the east coast of Canada, particularly Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, was abuzz with harness racing. In addition to filling the Red Shores track during the legendary Old Home Week, Charlottetown also played host to the final leg of the World Driving Championship and the 2017 World Trotting Conference which hosted delegates from the worldwide harness racing industry. There was certainly no shortage of good cheer when hometown hero James Macdonald won the WDC for his hosting homeland.

In his closing address to the World Trotting Conference delegates, as he passed the torch to next year's WTC host Sweden, Standardbred Canada CEO and president Dan Gall was quick to speak of addressing customers needs and wishes. "We must ask the customer how they want us to move forward," Gall said. "We need to listen to our customers, at our racetracks, in our paddocks and of course, our fans. By listening to them, our job is relatively easy."

When I read these comments in a press release the first thought that crept into my mind was: "Customer"! He just called me a customer! One of my biggest beefs for years has been that horseplayers are not treated like customers – at least not anywhere close to approaching the way slots players are treated. So, my thinking was, if Gall is serious about asking the customer how to move the industry forward, why not provide some feedback right away from what I would consider a typical customer... me?

Now, I am not a "whale" when it comes to wagering, but I am sure not a \$2 bettor either. I estimate that I average \$100,000/year in bets, likely at around an average takeout rate of about 20 per cent, so as someone who contributes \$20K annually to the industry in wagering (plus more in horse ownership, licencing, buying food at the concessions etc.), I think I am deserving of a say.

Here are some items on my customer wish list:

• Make rebates reasonable. As you can see in the accompanying picture, last week I bet more than \$3,000 and was given back a mere 20 bucks as a "takeout adjustment" reward. I know of several offshore wagering sites that would return close to five per cent on those bets. That means if I chose to bet with them, I could have received \$130 more in rebates for that \$3K in bets. So why do I keep betting through the tracks? Partly because I don't trust offshore sites, but more so because I would be taking all my wagering

dollars out of the industry, one that I have a great passion for. Still, tracks can do better than returning less than one per cent to regular, loyal customers.

• Do something to improve the information that handicappers get when they buy a program. This is 2017. Why can't we have the yearling price of every starter in track programs? How about a trip note for each race? Layoff stats for trainers? Track bias notes? You want your



customers to win so they come back and keep pumping money through the mutuels, so give them as much information as you can arm them with to be successful and don't overcharge for them at the track. Make customers pay whatever will recover your cost to produce and sell the programs, but no more.

- Don't make it undesirable for me to come to watch live racing. When I pull into a parking lot, I don't want to drive through an obstacle course of potholes, and, I surely don't want to see the closest parking lot to the entrance closed in winter and leased out to store autos for a car dealership as has been the practice at Woodbine for several winters. Don't make me feel unwanted before I even get through the door.
- If WEG feels it necessary to charge \$10 admission to the North America Cup, well... fine. I'm not going to get into the pros and cons of that decision again, but here's an idea: For HPI customers that accumulate "reward points" why not give them the option of using an applicable number of points to pay for that admission ticket? Here's the rub with the \$10 charge: many loyal customers and regular bettors feel alienated to have to pay on the biggest night of the year to accommodate the "once/year crowd" when they have supported your product all year long. Throw the regulars a bone.
- WIFI. It's 2017, every racetrack should have reliable WIFI that works anywhere you go in the track. There are ads in some of the tracks pushing customers to bet online, but the WIFI is, on most days, not very good. This should be a priority.
- If I am going to be forced to use the HPI.Bet wagering site monopoly, can I get a page on the site that gives me a breakdown of my wagering stats that I can sort to be able to see my R.O.I. on specific bets? This feature seems like a basic component of most U.S. Advance Deposit Wagering sites.

• Why not create an event for bettors? I'm thinking like a once/year "low takeout" night? 12.5% takeout across the board all night long, as a customer appreciation night. Hardcore bettors don't want hats, t-shirts or weiner dog races, they want a chance to turn a profit, whether that be for a day, week, month or the whole year. You might even be surprised with the new business you would attract.

I could probably hammer out several more bullet points as I have been a regular customer/bettor for more than four decades, but the bottom line going forward is bettors need to feel that their business is appreciated and most of all, that they have a fighting chance to at least break even playing this great game of ours. Cater to those needs and you have a chance to "move forward". If there are tools you can provide that help customers win more frequently, provide them. If you don't listen as you indicate you want to, I'm afraid you will lose more customers to business models like daily fantasy games that offer 10 per cent rake on virtually every game. It's too easy for gamblers to leave. Make it harder by showing that you genuinely care.

Will the Breeders Crown determine sophomore year-end honors?

With nearly exactly two months remaining until Hoosier Park plays host to this year's Breeders Crown, divisional honors for almost all of the 3-year-old glamour divisions remain contentious and unsettled. The 'It all comes down to the Breeders Crown' saying isn't necessarily always the case as many times divisional honors are already sewed up prior to the two-day event, but this year may be different come the end of October.

First, the only 3-year-old division that won't have any suspense and honestly hasn't been competitive in two years. That's thanks to the greatness of Ariana G, who can do little at this point that would prevent her from winning the filly trotting division.

Ariana G is six out of eight in the win column this year and both those losses came when she raced against males in the Beal and then last week in the colt division of the Zweig at Vernon. For some reason she hasn't been able to break through against her male counterparts even though appearing fastest on paper, but she won't have to worry about that when racing against strictly her own kind in the Breeders Crown. Win, lose or if she doesn't race for any reason it likely won't matter as Ariana G should repeat as divisional champion. The only possible bit of suspense could be if something falls apart at the top of the 3-year-old pacing division and Ariana G is spectacular in the Breeders Crown; perhaps she would rate an outside chance at overall Horse of the Year.

If anything, Horse of the Year remains an outside possibility for her. Even if the Breeders Crown for the colts was an open (it's not, it's colts and geldings only) she'd probably still race in this division. She's six out of eight on the year, but a perfect six-for-six against fellow fillies. She

seems just as fast on paper as the boys but it hasn't panned out. Regardless of what happens in the Crown, she's the likely divisional champion.

For as open and shut the trotting fillies are, the trotting colts couldn't be any more of the opposite. It starts with the champion from last year, the enigmatic Walner. If Walner had remained healthy, this division would be another walkover as he towers over a rather ordinary 3-year-old crop, but in his absence it's quite possible that the Breeders Crown will go a long way in determining who the winner of the colt trotting division is.

Reports are that Walner's injury is minor, but considering he didn't make his seasonal debut late into July and then had to miss the Hambletonian, it's doubtful that the connections of the horse would take the slightest risk of further injury to jeopardize any lucrative stud deal that may be in the works.

If Walner doesn't return then the question becomes, who then? Perfect Spirit was placed first in the Hambletonian but he isn't even eligible to the Breeders Crown, although he could always supplement for \$62,500. An intriguing possibility would be what happens if What The Hill were to win the Breeders Crown; would that be enough to give him divisional honors? Although DQed in the Hambletonian, he did cross the wire first and was inarguably best in that race. Ordinarily, a horse that wins both the Hambletonian and the Breeders Crown would be a lock for divisional honors.

The remaining group of horses that rate just as good a chance of any to claim divisional honors with a Breeders Crown win could include Devious Man, who already has a \$500,000 win to his credit from the Beal. Horses with profiles such as Long Tom, Enterprise and even the emerging Yes Mickey who just upset a number of these horses including Ariana G, have comparable resumes any of them could make a legitimate case by closing out their year with a win in the Breeders Crown.

On the pacing side with the colts, the division has been dominated by the same horses all season. Although what once looked like a three-way tossup as to which horse would

emerge as the crops best, it's looking more in recent weeks that the top-rated horse in the Hambletonian Society/Breeders Crown poll, Fear The Dragon, is very much in the driver's seat.

The North America Cup winner has since also won the Hempt as well as the Adios and I think he's built himself enough of a cushion that if he continues his winning ways he could afford a loss or two – including in the Breeders Crown – and still be a strong possibility for divisional and overall year-end honors. He's four-for-four in head-to-head against Huntsville and he's proven his worth against that rival.

The biggest threat at this point to Fear The Dragon is stablemate Downbytheseaside. Downbytheseaside just beat Fear The Dragon at Northfield two weeks ago in the \$300,000 Milstein and did it first over from post 7 no less; an herculean effort. These two are also scheduled to meet next month in the Little Brown Jug and if Downbytheseaside notches one or two more wins, the Breeders Crown may absolutely come down to these two Brian Brown trainees.

The pacing fillies sometimes fly under the radar and that has been the case so far this year despite a climatic showdown potentially looming in the Breeders Crown.

The Aaron Lambert trained filly Agent Q has been head

and shoulders the best of the division all year, but to the surprise of some, including myself, she actually trails fellow filly Blazin Britches in this week's edition of the poll referenced above.

Both fillies sport similar records, although Agent Q has defeated the best her division has to offer all season, and her seasonal earnings of \$414,975 compared to those of Blazin Britches \$123,392 proves it. Blazin Britches has been no doubt sparked by her fantastic 1:48:4 in at the Meadowlands in the Shady Daisy – a race that she tied the track record for 3-year-old fillies that was coincidentally tied three weeks earlier by none other than Agent Q – who was equally as impressive in her 1:48:4 win in the Mistletoe Shalee.

We could debate who's better, but we should be able to see it play out on the track with any luck. The two are commonly staked to only one race prior to the Breeders Crown. If the Breeders Crown is the first time these two are able to race each other head to head, the winner of the highly anticipated race would be a cinch to claim divisional honors.

\$800,000 yearling to debut Saturday

Red Mile will play host to the second of three preliminary legs of the Kentucky Sires Stakes (KYSS) for two-year-old trotters on Saturday night, with the highest-priced yearling of 2016 set to make his pari-mutuel debut.

Three divisions of both fillies and colts will be racing for a purse of \$30,000 each along with valuable points toward the Sept. 17 \$250,000 finals.

The colts go in races four, seven and eight and the first division is loaded with prospects including all three winners from last week's leg, as well as Tactical Landing, the full-brother to Mission Brief that topped all yearling sales last fall with a bid of \$800,000 at the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale.

The fastest winner of the returning winners is Wolfgang (PP1) who trotted to a spectacular 1:54.2 win for trainer/driver Jimmy Takter. From the first crop of 2012 Kentucky Futurity winner My MVP, Wolfgang sped home in :27.3 after cutting the mile to hold Hat Trick Habit (who has also drawn into the first division) at bay. Brixton Medical, Goran Falk, Bud Hatfield Stable and breeder Fair Island Farm

own Wolfgang.

Have It All Together was a front-stepping 1:56.2 winner in the first leg for trainer Joel Smith and owners Pinske Stables, Andy Miller Stables and Kentuckiana Racing Stable. He'll start from post three for Marcus Miller.

Greg Peck and Christy Markos' US Marshall was a handy 1:56 winner in the opening leg and he's drawn the outside post seven in Saturday's race with Christian Lind named to drive.

The fillies compete in races three, five and nine with the three winners from last week's opening leg all drawing into separate divisions on Saturday.

Nixie Volo trotted through a deluge to a remarkable 1:57.1 win in her division and has drawn post three for this one. Trainer John Butenschoen has lured Lexington native Mike Simons in to drive the Yankee Glide filly for owners Kentuckiana Farms, VIP Internet Racing and 83 Racing.

The Dan and JoAnne Shetler-owned homebred Muscle Hill filly Passionate Miss shocked the horseplayers with her win in leg one at a pari-mutuel return of more than 100-1. That honeymoon price is history as she'll take play from the rail here. Dan trains and drives Passionate Miss and Sawgrass

Farms is the Shetler's partner on their filly.

Zoe Bi is the third returning winner and she starts from post two in what is clearly the deepest of the three divisions. Special Hill, Lovely Lindy and D Bomb return as contenders after solid efforts last week and Lily Stride ships in after a third-place finish in the \$330,800 Jim Doherty Memorial Grand Circuit stake at The Meadowlands.

Zoe Bi held on by a short head in 1:59.1 after an overland trip as the favourite in last week's race. Chris Beaver trains and owns the Donato Hanover \$15,000 yearling bargain in a partnership with Marion Beachy and Synerco Ventures. Zoe Bi has won five of her six starts and Dave Palone drives on Saturday.

"We appreciate Mark Ford and the SBOA of NJ cooperating with this request."


