# Sintra posts 12-1 upset in Canadian Pacing Derby

It was the first Derby victory for driver Jody Jamieson who said it felt, "as good as any of the big wins I've ever had."

Four-year-old gelded pacer Sintra and driver Jody Jaimeson rallied up the pylons to capture the \$615,000 Canadian Pacing Derby at odds of 12-1 Saturday evening at Mohawk Racetrack.

The Dave Menary Stable star unleashed a furious stretch rally to charge up the inside and nail Rockin Ron at the wire in 1:48.1 for trainer Gaetan Hebert.

"It's pretty awesome," said Menary. "He's a special horse that I thought was a half-mile track horse at the start of the year, but that hasn't worked out well this year.

"He likes the big track and he likes to flaunt his speed and I'm happy to be here."

Sintra and Jamieson left from post nine and were able to drop in fourth heading into the first turn. Nirvana Seelster claimed the front and posted an opening-quarter of :26.



Afterward, Jamieson greeted fans on the way to the winner's circle.

Elimination winner Rockin Ron and driver Louis Philippe Roy would circle around to the lead from second heading up the backside and led by the half in :54. Similar to his elimination, Roy allowed Rockin Ron to roll in the third-quarter and open up a 2 ½ length lead at three-quarters in 1:21.


Sintra and Jamieson stayed in on the far turn and sat fifth, buried along the pylons turning for home.

In the stretch, Rockin Ron continued to pace strongly and had a sizeable lead with less than an eighth of a mile to go. Staying along the rail proved to be the winning move by Jamieson, as room was available and Sintra took dead aim at the leader. The four-year-old used every inch of a racetrack to track down and surpass Rockin Ron by a neck.

McWicked rallied from seventh to finish third, while All Bets Off and Nirvana Seelster finished in a dead-heat for fourth. Keystone Velocity, the even-money favourite, finished sixth.

A son of Mach Three out of Dancing Barefoot, Sintra came into the Pacing Derby off a second-place finish to Rockin Ron in his elimination.

"I wasn't sure what I was going to do off the gate," said

Jamieson following the race. "Dave didn't want me to get away 10th and I didn't want to be blasting out to the lead.

"As it worked out, I got away fourth and (Keystone Velocity) moved quickly to get his position and I wasn't sure it was going to work out, even at the head of the stretch. (All Bets Off) was on a left line and (Rockin Ron) ran out a bit, (Nirvana Seelster) was on the left line and it opened up and Sintra with any kind of a trip at all...he just explodes through."

Rockin Ron, who was the 2-1 second choice, almost pulled off another front-end mission for the team of Roy and trainer Ron Burke.

"It was what I wanted to do," said Roy following the race. "I had (Nirvana Seelster) leaving out so I couldn't keep him there, I just wanted to take him on and pace up front.

"He wasn't steering as good as he was last week. Last week he was perfectly straight, but he was a little bit on the line today. Ron will correct that and he'll come back as good as

he was last week."

Sintra is owned by Brad Gray, Michael Guerriero and Menary Racing Inc. The four-year-old is now eight for 13 with \$578,735 banked this season, while his career totals now sit at 16 wins and \$882,385 earned.

A \$2 win ticket on Sintra returned \$27.40. The \$2 Exacta (Sintra-Rockin Ron) paid \$184.90, while the \$1 Trifecta (Sintra-Rockin Ron-McWicked) checked in at \$476.45.

# **International Moni takes Simcoe Stakes**

The regally-bred International Moni showed his grit to win Saturday's \$165,838 Simcoe Stakes for sophomore trotters at Mohawk Racetrack.

A field of 12 three-year-old trotting colts and geldings competed in the annual Grand Circuit event.


International Moni, a son of Love You—Moni Maker, was made the 3-5 favourite and lived up the hype. The Frank M. Antonacci trainee and driver Scott Zeron got away fifth in the early going, while R First Class pocket-pulled and secured the lead heading to the half.

R First Class posted a half of :57.1 and led into the far turn, while International Moni came first up and grinded his way up to the leader at three-quarters in 1:26.

The stretch drive was a duel between R First Class and International Moni, as neither wanted to give in. At the wire, International Moni prevailed by three-quarters of a length in 1:53.3. Magic Night finished third, while Dunbar Hall was fourth.

"Heading into the first turn I didn't know what was going to happen," said Zeron. "We had a lot of us heading into there, so I just protected my position, was able to control when I came first up with him and he had to work today coming first up and coming home in :27.3. It was big."

Owned and bred by Moni Maker Stable, International Moni is now five for seven this season to bring his career totals to six wins and over \$500,000 earned. The Lindy Farms star will now prepare for next Saturday's Canadian Trotting Classic eliminations.

# **Kendall Seelster upsets in Champlain Stakes**

The two-year-old pacing filly finally turned the tables on previously unbeaten Percy Bluechip.

Kendall Seelster, the distant 9-1 second choice, used a perfect pocket trip to upset the previously undefeated Percy Bluechip in Saturday night's \$169,831 Champlain Stakes for rookie filly pacers at Mohawk.

Trained by Paul Reid and piloted by Randy Waples, Kendall Seelster arrived at the Champlain from a runner-up effort to Percy Bluechip in the Eternal Camnation, but the former turned the tables on her heavily-backed rival (1-5).


Kendall Seelster showed speed off the gate but it was Percy Bluechip (Trevor Henry) who would demand the lead through an opening-quarter of :26.2 with Waples content to sit the trip with Pueblo Blue Chip and Kissin In The Sand following their early foot.

Percy Bluechip and Kendall Seelster separated from the field down the back straight marking the half in :55.3 as Big Thong made a first-over attempt but flattened as the field straightened for home.

Percy Bluechip maintained a precarious lead at the top of the lane but there was no denying Kendall Seelster who angled out and powered to a four-length score in a Champlain record time of 1:51.1. Percy Bluechip finished second, while Pueblo Blue Chip was third.

Waples said he was pleased with the determined effort from his filly to finally take down Percy Bluechip in her fifth attempt.

"I seem to draw (Percy Bluechip) every week and I always seem to get away close to her or on her back," said Waples. "I can never beat her and sometimes I don't get out to get the chance. The first couple times I raced against her, even if I

got out there was no beating her."

Waples believes the previously frustrated trips may have been to their advantage on this night.

"My filly is really fresh right now because she hasn't been getting out," said Waples. "Tonight things worked out and she got out and raced really well. Take nothing away from that other mare, she's about as good a two-year-old filly as I've seen in a long time."

Kendall Seelster, a bay daughter of Shadow Play—Kiddie Cocktail is now a two-time winner for owner 1187422 Ontario Inc. from seven starts and Waples said he is looking forward to a bright future.

"It will be interesting to see how much better she can get," said Waples. "She doesn't necessarily have to leave out of there, she does have great gate speed, but she races quite well the other way too. It will be interesting to see when she gets the right kind of trip just who she can beat."

Bred in Ontario by Seelster Farms Inc., Kendall Seelster was purchased for \$47,000 at the Forest City Yearling Sale. She paid \$21.80 to win.

# Stay Hungry, Dragon Time take Champlain splits

Stay Hungry, with Doug McNair at the controls for trainer Tony Alagna, maintained his healthy appetite for winning with a romping score in Saturday's first \$97,880 Champlain Stakes division for freshman pacers, at Mohawk.

The Somebeachsomewhere—My Little Dragon colt, a \$150,000 Lexington Select purchase for owner Brad Grant, was an impressive winner in his debut last week and passed a serious class test on Saturday with a first-up score in 1:52.1.

Evening Play made the early pace through splits of :27.3 with Trump That, Odds On Lauderdale and Stay Hungry chasing. Odds On Lauderdale (Scott Zeron) swept to the front to mark the half in :56.3 as Stay Hungry waited patiently for McNair to push the button on the first-up trip.

Stay Hungry, once asked, paced menacingly to the wire with Im A Big Deal and Phil The Thrill followed his cover, while Odds On Lauderdale faded after setting the pace. McNair and Stay Hungry gobbled up ground with ease down the lane and were never threatened for an impressive first stakes score. Trump That edged Torrin Hanover for place.

Stay Hungry, the third foal of three-time Breeders Crown winner My Little Dragon, has lived up to all expectations thus far including winning both qualifying efforts.

"They've been high on this horse all winter long," said McNair. "I trained him a few times before I qualified him and he showed tonight that he's a pretty serious horse."

Could a shot at the Metro Pace be next for Stay Hungry?

"I hope so. He beat some pretty nice colts tonight so he'll move forward," said McNair.

Stay Hungry paid \$3.80 to win.

Dragon Time was full of pace down the lane drawing clear to a comfortable score in the second division of the \$96,880 Champlain.

The Menary stable student followed Hudson Phil through a comfortable opening split of :28.2 from a patient steer by Yannick Gingras. Simple Kinda Man (Trevor Henry) made a first-up move with Courtly Choice and Babes Dig Me following his cover, but a determined Dragon Time was game down the lane finding his best pace late to easily overtake Hudson Phil for the win.

The victory, which came just two races after Menary won the Canadian Pacing Derby with Sintra, didn't come as a surprise to Menary.

"I knew from the get go he was going to improve. He's a Bettors Delight out of a Dragon Again mare. He has a lot of pedigree but sometimes that breed takes a little longer to come," said Menary.

Dragon Time finished fourth last time out in the Nassagaweya after holding the lead briefly at the top of the lane.

"Last week, first up was not his ideal trip and he raced really tough," said Menary. "This week he had some cover and he dug all the way to the wire. Yannick gave him a really good trip."

Dragon Time, who stopped the clock in 1:52 and paid \$9.40 to win.

# Drunk On Your Love shines in Ohio Super Night action

The Foreclosure N gelding gives an Ohio native a big win on a night featuring eight \$250,000 Ohio Sires Stakes championships worth a total of \$2 million.

Ohio native Jason Settlemoir can be described as a 'jack-of-all trades.' He is general manager of the Meadowlands Racetrack, an executive with Tioga Downs and Vernon Downs and assistant track announcer and simulcast director for the Little Brown Jug. Now Settlemoir can add yet another title to his resume: Ohio Sires Stake Champion owner.

Settlemoir and Mark Ford share ownership in Drunk On Your Love, winner of the \$250,000 Ohio Sire Stakes Championship for sophomore pacing colts, the glamour event of the \$2 million Ohio Super Night on Saturday (Sept. 2) at Scioto Downs.

Driver Dan Noble elected not to rush Drunk On Your Love out of post 3 and sat fifth on the rail past the quarter mile station in a spirited :26.2. The pair were fourth over in seventh past the half. Big Bad Bruce (Chris Page) led the field past the half in :55.3 and the three quarter pole in 1:23.1.

Noble sent the gelded son of Foreclosure N-Western Show three-wide around the final turn and sprinted clear of Big Bad Bruce by 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  lengths in 1:53.

"As a Buckeye, back here in Ohio to be here with my family and friends, to win this race is nothing short of a dream come true," said an emotional Settlemoir. "To have a horse of this caliber is a great opportunity. It's been a lot of fun.

"I thank Mark for telling me that I should buy a part of this horse. I also need to thank Jimmy Pollock, Jr. for the great care he had given him all season Danny (Noble) has done a great job in driving this horse. I just wish Terry was here."

Settlemoir, who was introduced to the sport by the Ohio Hall of Fame trainer Terry Holton, worked at Scioto Downs from 1995 to 2005.

"This means the world to me," said Settlemoir. "To have a horse like this is special."

Drunk On Your Love is conditioned by Pollock, Jr. and now sports 10 career wins and \$304,000 in career earnings.

Pistol Packin Mama (Trace Tetrick) gave trainer Tyler George his biggest thrill of his career by overcoming post position 7 to take the \$250,000 three-year-old filly pace. The final time of 1:53 was over a 'good' track dulled by the remnants of Hurricane Harvey.

The daughter of The Panderosa—Art Debut has not finished worse than second in her 12 career starts. Pistol Packin Mama has now earned \$232,750 for the Herres Stables.

"I'll be honest I was afraid of post 7, but when they went three wide into the first turn and she got to sit fourth, I was a little happier," said George. "This is by far my biggest win."

Rose Run Sydney continued her seasonal dominance with a gutsy win in the three-year-old filly trot. Driver Jason Brewer floated the eventual winner off the gates wings and found a

hole, third on the rail, allowing Gabbysloosechange (Dan Noble) to control the fractions of :27.3, :58 and 1:27.2.

Rose Run Sydney sprinted clear by 1 1/2 lengths to win in 1:57.1. The win brings Rose Run Sydney's career earnings to \$337,892. Steve Carter is the trainer and co-owner with Adam Friedland and RBR Racing.

"The filly is very handy, she behaves and drives like a car," said Carter. "Adam (Friedland) said she was the best filly in sale, so I bought her (as a yearling) based on that."

Owner/trainer Chris Beaver capped off a busy night with a Fraser Ridge (Ronnie Wrenn, Jr.) win in the sophomore colt trot. The son of Triumphant Caviar—Classical Mary battled his stablemate Buckeye Boss through the last turn and held off a late charge by Full Surge (Mike Wilder) and Magic Vacation (Kayne Kauffman) to score in 1:55.2.

Fraser Ridge is owned by Donald Robinson, Robert Mondillo, Beaver and RBH Ventures. He now has \$370,457 on his card.

Beaver sent eight starters postward in three trotting events, picking up five purse checks.

The Super Night started with a bang as Impinktoo (Peter Wrenn) scored a 14-1 upset over the previously undefeated and 1-9 choice Looking For Zelda in 1:57 to capture the two-year-old filly trot. Jim Dailey trains the daughter of Manofmanymissions—Margie Seelster for William Walters, Joe McLead and RTK Racing.

The two-year-old colt trot went to Mission Accepted (Ryan Stahl) who wore down the pacesetting Sultan Of Cash to win in 1:56.3. Jeff Conger trains and co-owns the son of Manofmanymissions—Witty Girl with Knox Services and David B. Willis.

The undefeated Seeing Eye Single (Josh Sutton) took the

freshman colt pace in 1:53.3. Conditioned by the nation's leading trainer, Ron Burke, the Dragon Again — Shabalabadingdong gelding rallied to score the head win over Rockathon (Dan Noble). Seeing Eye Single has now earned \$205,000 for Burke Racing Stable, J&T Silva Stables, Purnel & Libby and Lawrence Karr and Weaver Bruscemi.

Trainer Jim Dailey made a return trip to the Scioto winner's circle when Bad Girls Rule (Dan Noble) went gate-to-wire to win the two-year-old filly pace in 1:54.3. The pocket sitting Believe In Waco (Art McIlmurray) held on for second. The daughter of World Of Rockinroll—Bad Girls Club scored her fourth win in seven seasonal starts for the 3rd Floor Stable.

# Sears scores sweet stakes sweep

The Hall of Fame driver won two Triple Crown races at Yonkers on Saturday — the \$500,000 Yonkers Trot with Top Flight Angel and the \$500,000 Messenger with Downbytheseaside.

The wins were by the smallest possible margin, but that didn't diminish the enormity of what Brian Sears accomplished Saturday night at Yonkers Raceway.

The 49-year-old Hall of Fame driver swept the \$500,000 Yonkers Trot and \$500,000 Messenger, walking away with the hardware in the track's signature events for 3-year-olds.

"It's probably a once in a lifetime thing," said Sears, reacting to the fact that he won a pair of Triple Crown events on the same card. "It's a good feeling."

Admittedly, Sears got a little lucky in winning the Trot, as a pair of miscues set the stage for him to get a winning trip.

After finishing third in his elimination a week ago, Top Flight Angel (Archangel—Top Photo) had drawn post 9 (second tier) for the final. At the start, elimination winner Guardian Angel As (post 4) and Di Oggi (post 2) both broke stride, creating some confusion, and, as it turns out, good fortune for Sears.

"No question those horses going off stride helped," said Sears. "Otherwise, I'm getting away fourth or fifth and it changes the outcome."

Even-money favorite Devious Man emerged from the first turn with the lead, second choice Yes Mickey had the pocket and Top Flight Angel raced gapped in third.

The trio stayed that way until the five-eighths, when Sears swung Top Flight Angel off the rail and set his sights on the leader.


"(Devious Man) has had some pretty tough miles this year," said Sears. "So maybe he wasn't at the top of his game. My colt won at Yonkers in 1:55 earlier this year (on Aug. 3). I thought that made him a contender."

It sure did.

Top Flight Angel made steady progress around the far turn, and did not pass Devious Man until deep stretch.

Pocket-sitting Yes Mickey took a late lunge at the winner, only to come up a nose short in second. Devious Man was third.

Top Flight Angel, whose three wins during 2017 have all come at Yonkers, paid \$16.20 to win and trotted the mile in 1:56.3 for trainer Julie Miller and owner Alan Hainsworth.

Brian Sears needed some good fortune to craft a victory in the Yonkers Trot with Top Flight Angel, who edged Yes Mickey and Ake Svanstedt at the wire.

"You know when you have a hunch about something?" said the trainer about her premonition that her horse would race well. "He just really likes that track. In the elimination, a typical Brian (Sears) elimination. Get the horse out, get him into the final. Brian was really happy with the horse. And then when the draw came out for the final, I figured he was going to sit behind Devious Man (another Miller trainee) the whole way. I was not surprised that he won. I think I have figured him out. Being first up probably wasn't what we wanted, but when Brian pulled, he obviously knew he was going to go forward. He was going to be ready to pounce."

Miller also trained Money Mackintosh, who finished sixth. "If he had drawn better than post 7, I think he could have been closer," said Miller.

Purse money and prestige are great. But when one wins the Yonkers Trot, they also get an invitation to a grueling test, the \$1 million Yonkers International Trot on October 14.

So, Julie, is your horse up for it?

"It's great to be asked and get an invite," said Miller. "Obviously, we are going to entertain the idea. We are going to talk to the owner and see what he thinks. It's hard to pass up a million dollars. It's tough for 3-year-olds facing horses

like (2016 YIT winner) Resolve. There are a lot of pros and cons. We'll just try to make a good decision." She then added: "When you are going for a million, a nickel (fifth-place check) is pretty good."

Sears won the first half of his stakes double by scoring with one of the top 3-year-old pacing colts in training, Downbytheseaside, in the Messenger.

Sent off at odds of 1-20, the chalk players breathed a long sigh of relief when he outlasted 22-1 chance Art Scene by a nose after a pulse-pounding stretch drive.

All seemed well in the early stages as after Summer Side (post 2) and Blood Line (post 6) left at the start along with the favorite (post 7). Sears then put the son of Somebeachsomewhere—Sprig Hanover in gear and made the quarter in :27.1 on the front end.

The outer flow did not begin to develop until they hit the grandstand for the first time, which allowed Sears and Downbytheseaside to dawdle their way past the half in :56.

Game over, right?

"That probably helped a lot," said Sears of the :28.4 split. "I was pretty confident, but he didn't pick up the lines like he did last week."

Sears' victory in the Messenger with Downbytheseaside was also a close one that was just a nose better than Art Scene.

Miso Fast, who earned his way into the final by finishing eighth in a nine-horse elimination last week, grinded his way toward the leader nearing three-quarters, providing live cover for Art Scene. As pocket-sitting Blood Line was slowing to a crawl, driver Jordan Stratton smartly steered Art Scene into the pocket, setting up a stretch drive that saw the son of American Ideal-Lover Of Art duck into the passing lane before coming up just short on the wire. Funknwaffles finished third.

"I really don't know exactly what the scenario was there," said Sears of his nerve-racking, razor-thin win. "Maybe he wasn't as sharp as he has been."

Downbytheseaside is now eight-for-12 this year, good for earnings of just over \$956,000. The Brian Brown trainee, whose four 2017 losses have come at the hands of Huntsville (twice) and stablemate Fear The Dragon (twice), paid \$2.10 to win and completed the mile in 1:52.1 for owners Country Club Acres, J. Sbrocco, R. Lombardo and Diamond Creek Racing.

# She stands by her man

Devious Man has hit the board in each of his 11 starts this year. The New York Sire Stakes star from 2016 won the Beal earlier this year in an upset but has now lost as the favorite in both the Hambletonian and Yonkers Trot.

Julie Miller isn't the least bit perturbed.

"He's had a little bit of sickness," said Miller. "But (driver and husband) Andy (Miller) was happy with his performance (last night). He's been everything I've wanted. We purchased him as a nice New York Sire Stakes horse. He's been 1-2-3 all summer, was second in the Hambletonian. You can't complain about that. He's racking up money."

Lifetime, Devious Man has won 11-of-23 and banked just short of \$1.2 million.

# Donttellmeagain tops PA Stallion Series championship

The sophomore pacing colt won his eighth straight stallion series race over two years.

The Meadows Racetrack and Casino played host to eight Pennsylvania Stallion Series championships Saturday afternoon, each carrying a \$40,000 purse, and the finals yielded a treasure of memorable moments. Like Clockwork and Sidewalk Dancer extended their winning streaks to five, four stake records fell and Donttellmeagain wrapped up an extraordinary stallion series performance over two years, winning Saturday's championship and his eighth consecutive stallion series race in as many starts.

Donttellmeagain figured to be rough on his 3-year-old colt and gelding foes in the stallion series; his more-than-respectable third-place finish in the Hempt final to Fear The Dragon, harness racing's top-rated horse, was proof enough of that. But Jim King, who trains the Dragon Again—Donttellmewhattodo gelding for Paton Racing Stables, wasn't worried about this year alone.

"We still have the Liberty Bell, the Keystone Classic and the Simpson," King said. "We'll probably do this. He has a chip in an ankle, so we'll take that out when the season's done. We're planning on bringing him back. The long-term goal was to get him through this season as good as possible and see

what kind of horse he can make. That's why we didn't put him in with the sires stake horses."

In the championship, Donttellmeagain easily overtook Jo Pa's Somebeach with a first-over move for Tim Tetrick and downed him by three lengths in 1:50.3, with Mike's Z Tam third. The time knocked a tick from the previous stake mark set by Stevensville in 2014. With the win, Donttellmeagain soared over \$200,000 in career earnings.

Like Clockwork got a latish start to his freshman campaign but had won all four races since his July 8 debut. It appeared that streak would end Saturday when Iluvtomakemoney passed him at the top of the lane, but Like Clockwork reasserted for Mike Wilder and defeated Iluvtomakemoney by a neck in 1:54. Beach Watch earned show.

"Mike said he didn't see that other horse at all," said Tim Twaddle, who conditions the homebred Ponder—Macharoundtheclock gelding for Birnam Wood Farms. "Once he saw that other horse, he took back off. I'll have to monkey with his bridle a little bit. He has the Keystone Classic, the Simpson and the Liberty Bell. He's eligible for the Breeders Crown, but we'll take it one week at a time."

Tetrick collected three championships while David Miller won a pair of titles. Highlights of the other finals:

# 2-Year-Old Colt & Gelding Trot — Hockey Hanover

Mississippi Storm in the lane — and that's just what he did, scoring in 1:55.4 to shatter the previous record of 1:57.2 set by Boy Town in 2011. Mississippi Storm was 1/2 length back in second, with I Know My Rights third. The win was especially impressive because Hockey Hanover was stuck outside for most of the first quarter before finding a seat fourth.

"With the 7 post, I thought we had to go," said trainer/driver Wilbur Yoder. "We were lucky to get a spot. I moved him after that, and he did the rest. He felt comfortable the whole way. He's tough."

Yoder said Hockey Hanover next will try for more points on the PA Fairs Circuit in pursuit of a rare double — stallion series and fairs titles in the same season. McMullen Stable campaigns the Explosive Matter—Hotentrot gelding, a \$10,000 yearling acquisition who has won nine of 11 starts and never finished worse than second.

# 3-Year-Old Colt & Gelding Trot — Thisguyisonfire

After Thisguyisonfire broke stride at the gate in his last start, Miller wanted to be cautious with him early. There's cautious, then there's away last, which is where the duo got away. But in perhaps the day's most remarkable journey, Thisguyisonfire and Miller circled the field, with help from live cover, and triumphed in 1:56.1, 1/2 length better than Soho Hanover, with Media Buzz third.

"Dave said he had to watch him a little bit at the gate," said Jim Campbell, who trains the son of Yankee Glide—Adelaide Hall for Fashion Farms. "Once he got going, he got set. Thankfully, he was good enough to overcome everything."

# 2-Year-Old Filly Pace — Sidewalk Dancer

Even though she was parked the opening quarter, Sidewalk Dancer took the suspense from this championship when she jogged on the front for Tetrick in 1:53.3, erasing Half Past Seven's previous stake record of 1:54.1. She Said So shot the Lightning Lane for second, beaten 2 lengths, while Some Renditions completed the ticket.

"She's learning to be a racehorse, and she's got plenty left," Tetrick said. "I think she'll be able to carry her speed a long way, and I think she'll be good the late part of this season."

Chris Oakes trains the daughter of A Rocknroll Dance—Road Sign for Northfork Racing, Omar Beiler and Dennis Coons.

### 3-Year-Old Filly Trot — Dressed To Impress

Although Miller has driven Dressed To Impress three times and produced three victories, he modestly denied that he's discovered the key to the daughter of Andover Hall—Warrawee Krisp.

"The trips have always been working out," he said. "The favorite covered her up, and I was thinking second. But when I moved her over at the top of the lane, she trotted right on."

Special bond or no, the duo outkicked the 2-5 favorite, Itsgoodtobequeen, to upset her in 1:55.1, with Massive Risk third. The time lowered the previous stake record of Broadway Socks by three ticks. Tim Lancaster trains Dressed To Impress for Andrea Lea Racing Stables and Lakefield Gore.

# 3-Year-Old Filly Pace — Freakonomics

Bettors considered Freakonomics so much the best they hammered her down to 1-9. The daughter of Western Terror—Mind Boggling needed only 1:52 to prove them right, as she grabbed the lead at the quarter for Tetrick and handily downed Beach Club by 2-1/4 lengths. Perplexed completed the ticket.

"I think she'll be really good in stakes on a half-mile track," Tetrick said. "She's handy, she's quick, and she likes to win races."

Ross Croghan trains Freakonomics, who extended her lifetime bankroll to \$140,298, for Let It Ride Stables and Dana Parham.

### 2-Year-Old Filly Trot — Bone A Fide Babe

Bone A Fide Babe saved ground for three-quarters before attacking the leader, Perfect Image, from third. The daughter of Cantab Hall-Bone A Fide prevailed in 1:58.2, holding off the rallying Explosive G by a head. Perfect Image saved show.

"She was on the right line so bad in her last start that I didn't dare keep her on the outside and risk her running," said winning driver Dan Rawlings. "She's still not quite 100 percent, but she was better."

# Carat Williams crowned King of France

For the moment, at least, the king among the five-year-olds in France is called Carat Williams thanks to a victory Saturday in the Criterium des 5 ans at Vincennes in Paris.

Sébastien Guarato, the man behind the well known Bold Eagle, is Carat Williams' trainer and he can say that he has the best horse in the "C-crop" in his home country.

The Criterium des 5 ans is one of the biggest races for the five-year-olds in France and the distance of 3,000 meters (approximately 1.9 miles) on the big track is demanding.

Carat Williams (Prodigious) and his driver David Thomain got away fast and were in front early in the race. After a few lead changes, where one of the toughest opponents Charly du Noyer chased the front position, Carat Williams could trot in a suitable pace during the first 2,500 meters. In the last turn there were just two horses poised to win. Carat Williams and Charly du Noyer were better than their antagonists, but the chasing Charly du Noyer was never any threat for the leader.

Carat Williams won in an approximate mile time of 1:57.2 and earned \$128,000 for his efforts.

Bold Eagle (Ready Cash) won the race in 2016 and trainer Guarato has recorded three victories in the race since 2014.

## Timoko heads for retirement

In January of this year, he passed Ready Cash in the hunt of becoming the richest trotter ever in French harness racing history and the fact that Timoko fought hard with Ready Cash in the early years and Ready Cash's son Bold Eagle in the end describes much of Timoko's greatness.

Richard Westerink and his Timoko have conquered Europe during a long period, but now it seems like the fairytale has come to an end.

In an interview with newspaper Le Parisien, Westerink said that Timoko's legs and joints are worn and there will not be a start in Belgium, as planned, this weekend.

The fans all over the world thank Timoko for his excellence on the track.

The HHBNYS have been overwhelmed by the support of old and new members. To show its appreciation, the HHBNYS will make both sustaining payments due in 2018 for two 2017 New York sire stakes-eligible yearlings that are sold in New York. The total value of those payments is \$1,100 each. Any member that purchases a yearling at either sale will automatically be entered in the drawing.

New York sales are a great place to purchase a yearling and we hope members attend and purchase a yearling to support the sales companies and the New York breeders who consign to them.

The rules for the payment opportunity are:

- 1. To be entered into the drawing, you must be a member of Harness Horse Breeders of NYS, or join before the respective sale begins. In addition, you must have your name listed as purchaser on the sales slip of at least one New York-bred yearling at one of the designated sales.
- 2. The Harness Horse Breeders will make the payment directly to the NYSS office.
- 3. The drawing will pull one member name after each sale. If the first name does not correspond with the name on the sales results for a yearling, drawing will continue until a match is made.
- 4. To be eligible, the yearling chosen by the winner of the drawing must be from a verified sale as certified by the sale company. No bid in's or buy backs will be eligible for the drawing prize.
- 5. The drawing prize is non transferable between HHBNYS members. HHBNYS Board of Directors and staff are not eligible.
- 6. Winners have 10 days after notification to assign the prize to a specific yearling if multiples were purchased, and to notify HHBNYS of that name. # What is the French **Connection?**

Harness Racing Update is proud to introduce a new results banner called the French Connection which will appear when a horse connected to Lindy Farms was produced using American mares bred to French stallions.

Lindy Farms' Frank "the elder" Antonacci said the farm has had an active interest in breeding its mares to French stallions for many years, but the process has become easier recently thanks to frozen semen.

"It just makes common sense that if you can breed our horses to their horses, then possibly you could come up with a superior individual, considering they are two different bloodlines," he said. "I'm trying to add a little variety in the pedigree."

The French Connection banner is a way of educating people about horses with French and American blood that may, at first glance, look to have unusual pedigrees.

"If someone comes here and says, 'I go and buy all these Muscle Hills and they're all the same, but if I buy this horse and this is the only pedigree in America that might look like this and this is a significant family that produces racehorses, I might have a chance to have a better horse," Antonacci said.

"I think it will produce a superior horse... As an industry we make great horses, it's just the great horses can come from every single mare out there nowadays. I'm not smart enough to know which mare that's going to be. But I know that maybe the next great horse that I breed might come from one of these mares and when that horse comes he's going to be open to breed every horse in America and the world."
