"It's better than Kentucky"

Lindy Farms of Connecticut is not only one of harness racing's great farms, it is a forward-thinking, third-generation operation built by the Antonacci family with equal parts passion, practicality and pride.

Lindy Farms' octagonal barn makes an indelible first impression.

The sun has yet to crest the horizon and illuminate the full magnificence of the octagon-shaped barn at the main entrance to Lindy Farms, but the impact of the soaring ceiling crisscrossed by thick Douglas Fir beams isn't diminished much in the pre-dawn light. This equine cathedral — with three exquisite shedrows branching off from it — is just steps from the parking area at Lindy's main farm. That the octagon makes an indelible first impression is no accident, but it speaks as much to the Antonacci family's practicality as it does to its strict belief in doing everything first class and providing esthetics that are good for the soul.

"This barn we built in 1999 when the original barn got hit by lightning and burnt down. This was one of the last projects Sonny Antonacci worked on was designing this

barn," said farm manager John Belskie, referring to farm patriarch Guy "Sonny" Antonacci who started Lindy Farms in 1972 and died in 2001 at the age of 71. "He wanted it to look nice, but it also had to be very functional. A lot of times when you go to farms and are looking at yearlings you're stuck down an aisle, you've got a lot of people looking at a yearling and you can't really see it. He wanted somewhere that you brought the horse. You sit here in the octagon, we flip on the lights and prospective buyers can walk all around and check it all out."

You see that class, beauty and functionality everywhere Belskie takes you while acting as an affable tour guide of the some 900 acres the mostly standardbred operation has on some eight parcels of land in and around the bucolic Connecticut town of Somers (pop. 12,000) in the northern part of the state.

"I was at a town meeting this past Wednesday night. Whenever I walk in there they call me the Town of Somers Open Land Preservation Department," Belskie said, laughing. "They don't have one, but the Antonaccis are essentially it because they buy land that could potentially be developed into houses and put up horse fencing. The town loves that."


This is, after all, a pretty little New England town where some residents recently took up a fight to stop a new gas station from opening on Main Street lest it spoil the Rockwell-esque vibe.

It is the morning before the Hambletonian, which is something of a holy day at Lindy Farms. The Antonacci family, with other partners, holds the record for owning the most Hambletonian winners with five — Lindy's Pride (1969), Speedy Crown (1971), Probe (1989), Harmonious (1990) and Victory Dream (1994).



Apart from the Hambletonian victories, the family also has the unpleasant distinction of finishing second in the Hambletonian six times since 1991 — with MB Felty (in 1991 won by Giant Victory) Lindy Lane (1996, Continentalvictory), Cantab Hall (2004, Windsong's Legacy), Chocolatier (2006, Glidemaster), Crazed (2008, Deweycheatumnhowe) and Lucky Chucky (2010, Muscle Massive).

"When you think about all the seconds, it's actually an incredible number," said Frank M. Antonacci, president of Lindy Farms and another prime reason the farm stands out in the industry. Frank M. is young — he will turn 33 on Sept.

28 — passionate and a third generation Antonacci interested in enhancing the farm, not shuttering it, bucking a troubling industry trend in which heirs increasingly show disinterest in the horse industry. His younger brother, Phil Antonacci, is one of two assistant trainers on the farm — Patrizio Ancora is the other — that work under head trainer and racing manager Domenico Cecere.

Incredibly, Lindy's Pride was the first horse purchased by Sonny and his cousins Frank and Tommy Antonacci and Fred, Frank, Leo and Joseph Lomangino. Lindy's Pride also won the other two legs of the trotting Triple Crown and, naturally, the family was hooked. In large measure, Lindy's Pride led to all this — the sweeping vistas that explode like nature's fireworks every autumn, the equine spa where horses get the very best in high-tech therapeutic care; the European-style training oval and straight track through the New England woods; the green waves of paddocks dotted with faraway mares and the miles and miles and miles of, mostly, vinyl white fencing that delights the family but makes Belskie



grumble about the extra hassle required to keep it clean.

"Everyone thinks the vinyl is a low-maintenance type of fence, but we're up here constantly and instead of us replacing boards or taking the paint machine out, we have to

take power washers and water out to the back 40 trying to clean it," Belskie said shaking his head.

In truth, it's a rare and minor complaint from a man that started working for Lindy some 23 years ago when the operation was all of about 20 acres and was home to just a few horses.

"The family owned broodmares all over the place, but they were boarded out. So, they wanted to build a farm and bring them all home," Belskie said.

Nearly a quarter-century later, Lindy is home to some 220 horses and Belskie is standing beside the paddock where the great Moni Maker served out her retirement until her death in 2014 at the age of 21. The paddock is adjacent to a house on the hill featuring a sweeping view down to the training track and beyond. The house is owned by Jerry Antonacci, one of Sonny's two sons; the other is Frank "the elder", Phil and Frank M's father.

"Being here as Lindy has grown over the years from what we started with and seeing it now is unbelievable. On clear days, you can see Hartford out that way and Springfield, Massachusetts out behind us," Belskie said, pointing south and then north on the horizon. For the record, Springfield is more than 10 miles away and Hartford is more than 20.

Living and working at Lindy Farms clearly has its benefits.

"I like coming out in the morning, out behind the main farm," Belskie said, his voice softening. "You go in those fields way out and you look back at the barn and it's just quiet, nice, beautiful views and views that not a lot of people get to see if they're not walking out there."

Lindy Farms has come a very long way in the nearly 45 years since the Antonaccis moved to Connecticut from Lindenhurst, New York, on Long Island — the town that was the inspiration for the name of Lindy's Pride and, later, the farm — and started a sanitation company that today is the family's main business. USA Hauling and Recycling, is one of

New England's largest independently owned and operated waste management companies.

Through it all, Lindy Farms long has been a prime diversion and passion.

Belskie said Sonny Antonacci was fond of having people up to the farm and surprising them with the sheer scope and beauty of the place.

"He used to have this old station wagon and he had his German Sheppard and the people would say, 'This place is beautiful. It's just like Kentucky.' And he'd say, 'It's better than Kentucky' and then he'd turn and walk away."

To be fair, you can't blame some visitors for being gobsmacked by Lindy. New England is a little off the usual standardbred path, which makes the scope and richness of this operation all the more impactful.

Yet, it turns out Lindy Farms is just the beginning of an ever-expanding family empire built on looking forward.

Don't you remember me?

"I heard a neigh. Oh, such a brisk and melodious neigh as that was! My very heart leaped with delight at the sound." [Nathaniel Hawthorne].

When I was a very young trainer, I had a quiet mare who never raced with any degree of enthusiasm. According to her driver, the late great Jim Doherty, Rita Lee Lobell was, "...a nice, slow mare."

Not content with that career summation, the owner called in a horse psychic. The psychic herself was not a horse. She was a human being - I assume - who claimed she could communicate with horses on some spiritual level. After a private consultation with the mare - and a whole lot of money - the psychic announced: "Rita does not want to be a racehorse. She's sad and she misses her mommy and the nice old lady who took care of her at the baby farm. She wants to go back and run up and down the hills with all the friends she played with when she was a little girl."

Being a somewhat paranoid person, I wanted to ask the psychic if the mare blamed me for her sadness, but that would have cost another \$500.

Okay, so now we had our answer. Rita was a 2:05 pacer because she missed her mommy and some nice old lady. Lucky we called in that psychic before we went and spent far less money on a very thorough veterinary examination. I don't know why I'm sounding cynical and snarky about this when, at the time, I kind of believed the psychic — and to some extent I always will. I'm pretty sure that the North American standardbred is the most intelligent breed of horse, and for that reason, the psychic might have accidentally touched on a valid point.

They say that elephants never forget, but what about harness racehorses? Apart from the rather complex and repetitive things they've been trained to do by human beings, how much about their non-professional world do trotters and pacers actually remember from day to day? Do fillies and colts who were raised in the same fields at Hanover Shoe Farm or Winbak or wherever remember each other when they meet up on the track two or three years later? Do they recognize their schoolyard pals in the paddock or post parade and then reminisce about the fun times they once had together? Do they remember us the way Rita Lee Lobell remembered the little old lady?

Sadly, folks who study animal behavior will tell you a lot of discouraging things about a horse's ability to ponder the past or to anticipate the future. They'll tell you how horses don't really think or reason the way humans do, and anything that passes for abstract memory on a horse's part is simply a manifestation of their various instinctive and learned behaviors. Naturally, most horsemen will readily disagree with these scientific opinions because for every zoologically researched factoid about horse behavior there are a million anecdotal rebuttals from foolish people like me who truly believe that horses remember us as much as we remember them — perhaps even more so.

Long before we had a great trotter named Marion Marauder, we had a great pacer named Marauder and he was my favorite horse. He was a talented colt who earned nearly \$700,000 and is probably best remembered for winning the 1985 Adios in a walk-over when Nihilator was scratched from a third heat runoff.

When Marauder went to stud I bought a yearling filly from his first crop. Her name was Backinthehighlife. She wasn't much of a racehorse, but she was very professional and incredibly smart. In fact, she was so smart that she was accidentally broke to the jog cart the morning after the sale. I'd forgotten to tell my helper that our "new horse" was a yearling, and when I arrived at the barn I found a scribbled note that I still keep in my box of treasured possessions. This is what it says.

"Hey, Dave. Jogged the new filly and she was good but I think you should put a tie down on her because she starts off a little crazy. After the second mile she calmed down and paced nice. I'll be back at feed time."

So that's how Backinthehighlife got broke. I told you she was smart.

In early April, I brought my precocious filly to the Meadowlands where she could train down with a lot of other horses. When I shipped into my digs at the Meadowlands — thank you Joe DeFrank — I discovered that a filly in the adjacent barn was also sired by Marauder. Her name was Light Of Heart. Mind you, the world was not overflowing with

daughters of Marauder, so I found this to be kind of interesting.

One Sunday morning, I was caring for my three horses when suddenly I heard a horrible roaring and gurgling sound in the distance. It sounded like a T Rex was eating a horse, and it was coming from the next barn. When I quickly located the source of the horrific sound, my heart sank. I discovered that Light of Heart had somehow reached over her gate and her stall door. She had hooked her halter on the door latch, and she had fallen. Now she was suspended only by her neck and was loudly strangling to death on her throat latch.

The barn area was virtually deserted, and if anyone was going to do something, it had to be me. I raced around looking for something... anything. Atop a bale of hay, I found a pair of the luckiest wire nippers in the history of wire nippers, but by then the horrifying gurgling and gasping had stopped. I reached over the gate, and, after three hard slices, I cut through the filly's halter. It broke free violently. Light Of Heart's head and neck fell to the ground hard, and perhaps startled by the sudden drop, she again began gasping for air.

Soon, help arrived and a veterinarian appeared on the scene. Her head and neck were, by now, badly swollen. It took a lot of IV fluids and medications to get her heart rate down to an acceptable rate. Within two weeks Light Of Heart had completely recovered, and that was the last I ever heard of her — or so I thought.

About nine or 10 years later, one of my owners took me out to Ohio to look at a horse and to see his friend's breeding farm. This guy had a broodmare field that went on for what seemed like miles. Broodmares in the distance looked like small dots on the horizon — and there were dozens and dozens of them, too.

For the most part, the mares stayed away from us, but then, like Nathaniel Hawthorne, I heard a neigh... a melodious neigh. It was coming from a mare who was trotting towards us from hundreds of yards away and leaving behind an impressive trail of billowing dust clouds with each stride. She stopped a few feet short of me and then ambled up to my face. She put her head on my shoulder and puck-puck-puckered at my earlobe.

I didn't think much about this. I figured she was just another friendly mare. Then, the breeder said to me, "I got a little scared for a minute there with her running down hollerin' to us like that. She's not exactly a friendly mare. I guess she likes you." I said, "Who is she?" He responded, "Her name's Light Of Heart and her daddy is Marauder. I guess you

never heard of either one of them, right?"

Suddenly, his words sounded fuzzy and far away, and I got very emotional — almost frightened. When it was time to walk away, Light Of Heart followed me all the way to the gate. I couldn't believe what had just happened, and I knew this time for certain that when I left that field, I would never see her again.

Backinthehighlife lived a long and happy life and so did Marauder, but I wonder what Light Of Heart did with all of her borrowed time. I only know that when I walked away from that gate and glanced back, she was still looking at me quizzically, as if to say, "Don't you remember me?"



Control The Moment retired from racing

The owners of Control The Moment announced Thursday that the sophomore pacing colt has suffered a career-ending injury, which has forced him to prematurely retire from racing.

"We will always have his remarkable racing career to look back upon, winning eight of nine starts as a two-year-old, including the Metro, and O'Brien Award as the top two-year-old in Canada," said part-owner Howard Taylor in a release on behalf of his partners. "His three-year-old season was highlighted by his victories in the Meadowlands Pace and the Cane Pace."

Control The Moment won 12 of his 18 career starts and \$1,085,220. He took his lifetime mark of 1:48.2 in winning the Meadowlands Pace.

"Fortunately, his injury will have no impact on his ability to breed, and we look forward to what we hope will be a long and successful stallion career," Taylor said. "It has not yet been determined where Control The Moment will stand stud. An announcement will be forthcoming as soon as arrangements are finalized."

Roaring To Go, Tequila Monday win NYSS events

The New York Sire Stakes (NYSS) resumed downstate Thursday night, with Yonkers Raceway playing host to the \$143,224 Frank Becerra Pace for 2-year-old-fillies.

With just nine young ladies at the prom, the event went as one, five-horse wagering group and one \$70,912, four-horse non-bettor.

The on-the-card (\$72,312) quintet was, essentially, a walkover. Actually, it was a paceover, with odds-on Tequila Monday (Dave Miller, \$3.60) winning her sire stakes debut down the road (:28, :56.2, 1:25, life-best 1:53.1) by

"She felt real strong," said Gingras post-race about Thats All Moni. "I dropped back in behind (Magic Presto) at the end of the last turn because I could, but my filly was really strong all the way through the stretch."



The daughter of Cantab Hall—Mom's Millionaire is a three-quarter sister to the \$1.4 million winning Snow White and was purchased for \$230,000 at last year's Lexington Selected Yearling Sale.

Thats All Moni, who paid \$3.30 to win, is owned by Brittany Farms, Marvin Katz and Al Libfeld. She now has three wins in six starts and over \$121,000 in earnings.

The second elimination featured arguably the top two-year-old in the sport and she didn't disappoint. Ariana G crushed her rivals by seven-and-three-quarter lengths in a flashy 1:53.2.

The daughter of Muscle Hill—Cantab It All and driver Gingras got away third before brushing to the lead at the half in :56.3. Ariana G trotted to the three-quarter pole in 1:25.1 and then pulled away without breaking a sweat for a :28.1 last-quarter and another dominating victory.

"She's unbelievable" said Gingras following the victory. "I've been really blessed the last three years with trotting fillies. I've got three Hambletonian Oaks in a row, but this filly ranks right up there with them."

Ariana G is a full-sister to Breeders Crown and Hambletonian Oaks champion All The Time and the rookie trotting filly is quickly upstaging her big sister.

"She had a lot more tonight, that's for sure," Gingras said. "Turning for home she was really latched onto the bit in a good way. She wasn't being too grabby or nothing, but she just had a whole awful lot of trot and all the way through the wire I had a handful and I was really impressed."

Dream Together finished second to Ariana G, while Pure Kemp was third. The final two spots in the Peaceful Way final were secured by Stuck In My Spanks and The Erm.

Ariana G, who paid \$2.10 to win, improves to six for six with her victory Thursday. The Katz and Libfeld homebred will carry earnings of \$295,870 into next week's rich final.

Following the eliminations, the post positions for the \$363,000 Peaceful Way final were drawn. Elimination winners earned their connections the right to select their post for the final.

Miller wins eight Wednesday






