Epic in the Ewart

Always B Miki equaled the 1:47 world record while winning the \$225,000 Jim Ewart Memorial at Scioto Downs after a dramatic head-to-head battle with nemesis Wiggle It Jiggleit.

Brett Miller, subbing for his cousin David, piloted Always B Miki to a 1:47 victory in the Jim Ewart Memorial at Scioto Downs Saturday that equalled the world record.

When the horses placed their hooves on the track for the post parade of the \$225,000 Jim Ewart Memorial on Saturday (Sept. 10) at Eldorado Scioto Downs, the throng lining the fence let out a roar for defending Horse of the Year Wiggle It Jiggleit. The stands were packed to catch a glimpse of an athlete that has captured the hearts and imaginations of legions of fans during his two-year career.

When the horses crossed the finish line, however, all those in attendance had shifted their adulation to honor the effort of his winning rival, Always B Miki, for not only had they been privy to witness greatness, but they were present for a world record equaling performance of 1:47, that will surely become an integral component of the sport's history.

That time equaled the all-age mark for a pacer on a five-eighths-mile oval set by **Sweet Lou** in 2014 and equaled by Always B Miki in both the Ben Franklin elimination and final earlier this year. Those miles all came at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono.

"He's a big horse alright," said Always B Miki's pilot Brett

Homicide Hunter (Eric Goddell) set a track record for four-year-old gelded trotters when he won the Chip Noble Memorial Saturday at Scioto Downs in 1:52.1.

Miller in the winner's circle immediately after handing over the lines. "He has so much power. You just can't let him get too into himself."

When the superb field of nine left the gate, Always B Miki, who commenced pacing from post six, was the 4-5 favorite, but Wiggle It Jiggleit at 8-5 was also receiving his share of support at the windows.

Shortly after the starter allowed the horses to begin the mile, Eric Goodell sent Luck Be Withyou to the lead from post position five.

Wiggle It Jiggleit and his regular reinsman Montrell Teague were not content to allow that competitor to cut the mile and made their move to the front from post position eight. Miller and Always B Miki had their own designs on the lead and the crowd was gasping at the sheer speed displayed by the pacers as Luck Be Withyou had laid down a scorching :25.2 first quarter.

Wiggle It Jiggleit brushed to the lead in front of the grandstand before Always B Miki procured the lead on the outside by the half-mile marker. The Jimmy Takter trainee appeared to pay the price for that effort when :53 flashed on the timer. As Wiggle It Jiggleit sat second, Always B Miki still maintained a head advantage after three-quarters in a sizzling 1:19.

Wiggle It Jiggleit appeared poised to come through on the inside and overhaul Always B Miki down the lane, but the five-year-old stallion would not be denied. After a nip and

tuck battle between these two champions, Always B Miki prevailed. Several hundred feet from the wire, he repelled the bid of Wiggle It Jiggleit and hit the line three-quarters of a length in front. Luck Be Withyou raced exceptionally well



to be third, while Freaky Feet Pete, who had a very tough trip, finished fourth.

Conditioned by Jimmy Takter and owned by Bluewood Stable, Roll The Dice Stable and Christina Takter, Always B Miki paid \$3.80 to win, with Wiggle It Jiggleit paying \$3.00 to place and Luck Be Withyou \$3.60 to show. The exacta was \$8.00 and the trifecta \$50.60.

Takter was absolutely beaming as he posed for a picture with Always B Miki. When asked to discuss the heroic feat Always B Miki had just produced, he acknowledged how scintillating it was to be associated with a horse with this much ability. He also noted, however, for the stallion to consistently provide the sport with a number of 1:47 miles this season, it does require much more than natural talent.

"It is not an easy thing to keep a horse at that kind of level for a long period of time," he said. "This is a very special horse."

Homicide Hunter sets track record in Chip Noble Memorial

Earlier in Saturday's Scioto Downs card, Homicide Hunter — who established a new world record three weeks ago at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono — garnered another accolade for his already sterling resume with a 1:52.1 triumph in the \$100,000 Chip Noble Memorial. Although the surface was less than spectacular due to inclement weather, the final clocking is a new track record for four-year-old trotting geldings.

The altered son of Mr Cantab and Evening Prayer was placed on the lead by his pilot, Eric Goodell, shortly after the field of seven was rounding the first turn at the Columbus oval. Once the Indiana champion placed race leader Muscle Up The Goal (Aaron Merriman) in his rearview mirror, the 4-5 favorite effortlessly clicked off fractions of :27.1, 55.3, 1:23.2 and hit the wire four-and-a-quarter lengths to the good of Muscle Up The Goal and third place finisher Wind Of The North (Chris Page), who closed very well in the stretch to finish behind the top two.

Conditioned by Chris Oakes and owned by Crawford Farms, Homicide Hunter glided over a track that had been soaked by powerful early precipitation that had begun to taper off prior to the horses placing their noses on the gate.

Goodell steered the horse with the greatest of confidence, and Homicide Hunter responded in kind. He never appeared under any serious pressure or any urging to produce his second record-breaking victory from his last three trips to the post.

With his latest triumph, Homicide Hunter is now 41 23-4-6 lifetime and boosted his bank account to \$715.263.

Prior to his being sold privately last winter, Homicide Hunter resided in the barn of Curt Grummel, who had his doubts the gelding would ever develop into a high quality racehorse when he was a youngster because he had a tendency to not finish strongly to the wire.


Homicide Hunter received top billing at Hoosier Park with hometown hero Freaky Feet Pete in Anderson, as he captured 16 consecutive races in 2015 before finishing second to Crazy Wow in the \$270,000 Carl Erskine Memorial.

Since joining Oakes' barn, the gelding has compiled a record of 13 4-1-2, but appears to be rounding into prime form as summer transitions into fall.

For those that supported him at the windows, Homicide Hunter paid \$3.60, with Muscle Up The Goal offering \$6.00 to place and Wind Of The North providing \$5.20 to his backers. The exacta was \$13.60 and the trifecta was \$68.80.

Betting Line wins 11th straight

Casie Coleman's sophomore pacing colt extended his streak with a win from post 10 in the \$204,040 Simcoe at Mohawk.

Betting Line, the 2016 Pepsi North America Cup champion, overcame post 10 to win his 11th consecutive race in Saturday's \$204,040 Simcoe Stakes for three-year-old pacing colts on a Mohawk card that also featured four Champlain divisions — two open and two for fillies — for rookie pacers..

Betting Line, a Casie Coleman trainee, got away fifth with driver David Miller, while Lyons Snyder powered to the front in :27. The leader continued to motor along in the second-quarter and reached the half in :54.

As Lyons Snyder set big fractions, the field was strung out and Betting Line was 11 lengths from the front at the half. Lyons Snyder took the field by three-quarters in 1:20.4 and had an eight length advantage on Betting Line, who was getting into gear and fourth.

In the stretch, Betting Line was able to reel in Lyons Snyder and get by in deep stretch for a half-length victory in 1:49.1. Voracity finished third, while Easy Lover Hanover was fourth.

Betting Line's only loss came in his 2016 season debut. The son of Bettors Delight—Heather's Western has earned over \$1.2 million this season for owners West Wins Stable, Christine Calhoun and Mac Nichol.

Betting Line is now a 17-time winner with career earnings exceeding \$1.8 million. His next start will be in the Little Brown Jug on Sept. 22.



Metro Pace winner Beyond Delight returned to the winner's circle in a \$105,474 Champlain division.

Driver Sylvain Filion switched up his approach and put Beyond Delight on the front end. The Tony O'Sullivan trainee cut out fractions of :27, :56.4 and 1:24.4 to lead the field into the lane.

Beyond Delight, who felt first up pressure from Filibuster Hanover on the far turn, turned away all rivals and pulled away late for a two length victory in 1:52.1.

Blood Line finished second, while Windsong Napoleon was filled with pace and finished third.

A son of Bettors Delight—Outtathisworld, Beyond Delight now has three consecutive victories after starting his career winless in seven.

The O'Sullivan trainee, who was a \$50,000 yearling purchase at Harrisburg, has broken through in recent weeks with his Metro Pace victory and now has over \$420,000 earned for owners Jeffrey & Michael Snyder and Four Friends Racing Stable LLC.

Beyond Delight paid \$3.50 to win.

Coming off a third-place finish in the Metro Pace, Ideal Wheel turned heads with an unorthodox victory in the other \$105,474 Champlain division.

The Coleman-trained colt was pushed to the front by driver David Miller to cut an opening-quarter of :27.3. Ideal Wheel then really took off and paced a :26.3 second-quarter to lead by more than 11 lengths at the half in :54.1.

The son of American Ideal—Bet On Luck just continued to go full throttle around the final turn and reached the three-quarter pole in a jaw-dropping 1:20.3, with more 13 lengths back to his nearest rival.

As expected, Ideal Wheel began to fade in the stretch, but his lead was too much for any rival to overcome. He paced a :31.1 final-quarter, but won by two-and-a-quarter lengths in a career-best 1:51.4.

Very Special Agent finished second, while Odds On Delray, the Metro Pace Consolation winner, was third.

Ideal Wheel is owned by Mac Nichol and was a \$150,000 yearling purchase at last year's Harrisburg Sale. The Coleman trainee now has three wins from six starts and over \$155,000 earned to begin his career.

Ideal Wheel paid \$2.90 to win.

Everyones Watching broke her maiden with a 1:52.4 victory in the \$104,566 Champlain Filly first division.

The Tony Alagna trained filly got a patient drive from Jody

Jamieson, as she sat fourth throughout the opening stages. Everyones Watching was edged to the outside nearing the three-quarter pole to catch cover into the lane. The daughter of Artiscape—Burnett Blue Chip unleashed a :26.4 final-quarter to get up for the win.

Windy Sport, who provided the cover for the winner, finished a neck back in second, while Happy Hannah, who cut the mile, was third.

A \$100,000 yearling purchase at last year's Harrisburg Sale, Everyones Watching was coming into the Champlain off a fourth-place effort in the Shes A Great Lady. The rookie pacing filly was winless in five starts before Saturday, but had never finished out of the money.

Everyones Watching pushed her earnings over the \$100,000 mark with her Champlain score. She is owned by Riverview Racing LLC, Deo Volente Farms LLC, Crawford Farms Racing and Steve Wienick.

She paid \$9.80 to win.

Blameitonthenight captured the \$106,066 second division to make it an Alagna sweep of the Champlain Filly Stakes.

Driven by Yannick Gingras, Blameitonthenight came first up in the middle-half to take a narrow lead at the three-quarter pole in 1:24.3. In the stretch, Blameitonthenight had to fight off stablemate Awash to win by half a length in 1:53.2.

Stonebridge Sundae finished third, while Southwind Ion was fourth.

A daughter of Mach Three—What Could Be, Blameitonthenight now has three wins in seven starts to bring her earnings total to over \$110,000. She is owned by Alagna Racing LLC, Crawford Farms Racing and Donna Ozment.

Blameitonthenight paid \$17.90 to win.

Stars shine in Maple Leaf Trot and Cdn Trotting Classic elims

CAMPBELLVILLE, September 10 – The top trotters in harness racing were on display Saturday evening (Sept. 10) at Mohawk Racetrack for the Canadian Trotting Classic and Maple Leaf Trot eliminations.

Both premier events featured a pair of \$40,000 eliminations, as 13 three-year-old trotters competed in the Trotting Classic and 12 older trotters clashed in the Maple Leaf Trot preliminaries.

Hambletonian champion Marion Marauder made a triumphant return to his home track in the first Canadian Trotting Classic elimination. The Mike Keeling and Paula Wellwood stable star scored an impressive four-length victory in 1:52.

Driven by Scott Zeron, Marion Marauder got away third and was pushed to the front in the second-quarter to front the field by the half in :55.4. Around the final turn, Waitlifter K

pressed at the heavy-favorite first up and was just three-quarters of a length from the lead at third marker in 1:24.1.

In the stretch, Marion Marauder flicked aside his challenger and pulled away confidently to win in 1:52.

"He's an amazing animal," said Zeron. "Hats off to Mike (Keeling) and Paula (Wellwood) for keeping him this well conditioned throughout the schedule he's had this year. To put up performances like this week in and week out, it's

Winter Harbor, who originally got away seventh, made a big third-quarter move and trotted home well to finish second to Marion Marauder.

Tony Soprano finished third, while Waitlifter K and Brooklyn Hill rounded out the top five to advance to next week's final.

Marion Marauder is in the midst of an incredible three-year-old season. The son of Muscle Hill—Spellbound Hanover has earned over \$1.1 million this season with signature victories in the Goodtimes and Yonkers Trot to go along with his Hambletonian title.

"I was thrilled with him tonight," said Keeling, who noted it was a short week for his colt after racing last Saturday in the Yonkers Trot. "Coming off a half (mile track) we didn't know how he was going to be and he was just tremendous. I couldn't believe the start tonight. He was great."

Owned by Jean Wellwood and Devin Keeling, Marion Marauder has won nine of 11 starts this season to bring his career totals to 10 wins and over \$1.5 million earned.

Marion Marauder paid \$2.40 to win.

In the second elimination, Bar Hopping delivered a large effort to win in 1:52.4 over Southwind Frank.

The public's support was fully behind Southwind Frank,

who was making his first start since capturing the Colonial on Aug. 20, but the talented son of Muscle Hill—Flawless Lindy just didn't have his usually best on Saturday.

Bee In Charge shot off the wings of the gate to grab early command ahead of Bar Hopping and posted an opening-quarter of :27.1. Southwind Frank got his cue to quickly move from third to first entering the backstretch and led the group by the half in :55.3.

Bar Hopping was trotting along third on the far turn when driver Tim Tetrick angled him to the outside to start gaining ground towards the lead.

Southwind Frank got a :28.3 third-quarter to lead the field into the stretch, but didn't have a lot to offer in the lane. Bar

Hopping trotted home with powerful strides on the far outside to blow by Bee In Charge and ultimately Southwind Frank to win by two-and-a-quarter lengths.

"I just wanted to be close and try not to do any work in the middle and keep him brave," said Tetrick following the victory. "I felt confident (turning for home), my horse was still trotting really easy and had plenty of trot left.

"You never know about (Southwind) Frank, he's a great animal and I know he struggles a little bit in the turns, but most of the time he just takes right back off, but my horse got him today."

Southwind Frank held off Bee In Charge by half a length for second, while Warrawee Roo and Dia Monde rounded out the top five to advance to the final.

Bar Hopping, now has four wins in 12 starts this season for earnings of \$456,310. He is trained by Jimmy Takter for owners Christina Takter, Hatfeld Stables, Marvin Katz and Al Libfeld.

Also a son of Muscle Hill, Bar Hopping, out of Cocktail Hour, finished fifth in the Hambletonian final after winning his elimination. The three-year-old trotting colt now has five career wins to bring his earnings total to \$557,548.

Bar Hopping paid \$10 to win.

The Maple Leaf Trot eliminations featured a European flavor, a couple of mares and the best older trotters around.

Resolve, who finished second in last year's event, was a

gate-to-wire winner in the first elimination for driver John Campbell and trainer Ake Svanstedt.

The five-year-old son of Muscle Hill—Anikawiesahalee was scheduled to be driven by his trainer in Saturday's elimination, but a travel issue prevented Svanstedt from making it to Mohawk.

Resolve was put on the front by Campbell and posted an opening-quarter of :27.2 before catching a :28.4 breather in the second panel. Five-year-old mare Shake It Cerry was sent first up from fourth on the far turn, while Resolve stretched out his lead to two lengths at the three-quarter pole in 1:24.2.

In the stretch, Campbell pushed the go button on Resolve and the Svanstedt trainee trotted home with powerful strides in :26.4 for a 1:51.1 victory. Shake It Cerry was just less than two lengths back in second, while Lookslikeachpndale was third.

"He's pretty push button," said Campbell about Resolve.

"He's been a great horse the last two years and been overseas and comeback and it's just a testament to what a great horse he is."

Campbell noted he wasn't given any instructions for during the race with Resolve, but rather for scoring down.

"The guy that takes care of said it was more important how I scored him down than the race," said Campbell. "He said you can do whatever you want in the race, but there was some

instructions on how to score him down, but after that he was push button."

Owned by Hans Enggren, Resolve picked up his third win of the season in his ninth outing Saturday. Resolve competed in the Elitlopp earlier this season in Sweden.

He will enter the Maple Leaf Trot Final with 13 career wins and over \$1.4 million in earnings. He paid \$3.10 to win.

Hannelore Hanover continued her dream season with an easy-looking victory in the second Maple Leaf Trot elimination.

The Ron Burke trainee was supplemented for \$45,000 to this year's Maple Leaf Trot and earned back \$20,000 for her connection with the elimination victory.

Driven by Yannick Gingras, Hannelore Hanover sat third while letting the dust settle between JL Cruze and Windsun Revenge. After an opening-quarter of :27, Hannelore Hanover got her cue to move to the front and led the field by the half in :55.1.

Il Sogno Dream came first up from fourth on the far turn, but there was never an anxious moments for Hannelore Hanover, who got to three-quarters in 1:24.1. The Burke trainee finished off the victory by cruising home in :28.1.

Il Sogno Dream finished three-and-a-quarter lengths back in second, while Windsun Revenge was third.

Swedish trotter Nahar, who is owned by Daniel and Henrik Sedin of the Vancouver Canucks, followed Il Sogno Dream around the final turn and ultimately finished fourth to qualify for the final.

JL Cruze faded back to finish fifth, but did qualify for next week's rich final.

A daughter of Swan For All—High Sobriety, Hannelore Hanover improved her 2016 record to 14 wins from 15 starts with her Maple Leaf Trot elimination score.

"I got a good third-quarter breather and I just let her trot a little bit in the stretch, but the plugs were still in and she had something left in the tank," said Gingras, who was thrilled the connections opted to supplement 'Hannelore'.

"\$45,000 is a lot of money, but I thought she deserved a shot and ultimately they came to the conclusion she did."

Owned by Burke Racing Stable LLC, Weaver Bruscemi LLC and Frank Baldachino, Hannelore Hanover is now a 23-time winner with over \$1 million in career earnings.

She paid \$2.10 to win.

The post positions for the \$687,000 Canadian Trotting Classic and the \$632,000 Maple Leaf Trot were drawn following Saturday's elimination.

Both finals will take place next Saturday (Sept. 17). Post time is 7:30 p.m.





GreatHorse and Beyond

The Antonaccis' rich racing history became the theme for its outstanding private golf club. But can horse racing apply some of the lessons the family learned from building GreatHorse?

Among the numerous equine photos, paintings and treasures that adorn the walls of the exquisite new clubhouse at the GreatHorse private golf club in Hampden, MA, there is one Frank M. Antonacci can't wait to show off — a gigantic framed copy of the black and white win photo from the 1989 Hambletonian raceoff judges declared a dead heat between Probe and Park Avenue Joe.

A legal challenge launched by Antonacci's family's Lindy Farms over that Hambletonian took two years to decide that the two trotters would be named co-winners and the connections of Park Avenue Joe would receive the winner's share of the purse because he had the better finish summary. Frank M. and his father, Frank "the elder" Antonacci, want to be clear they are not formally reopening that case even though the photographic evidence looks pretty compelling — look closely and it certainly appears their colt Probe was a few nose hairs in front at the wire before Park Avenue Joe reaches.

"It's crazy, right?" Frank M. said, pointing to Probe's nose on the wire and a tiny gap between the line and Park Avenue Joe's schnoz that became noticeable when the photo was blown up digitally to have it framed and added to GreatHorse's décor. "We were gathering all the digital photos to send to the designers and I was putting together all the horse stuff. So, I got this one and got screwing around with blowing it up and I said, 'Look at this.' I had it right away. I have two big 42-inch screens in my office that I can pull images onto. I blew it up onto one of those and I said, 'Oh, my God.' I showed (my uncle) Jerry (Antonacci) and my dad and they got a big kick out of it."

Frank "the elder" a part-owner of the Red Mile racetrack in

Lexington, KY joked he was going to put a huge copy of the photo in the grandstand for this October's Grand Circuit meet and ask customers, Who do you think won?

"Imagine if we had that technology back (in 1989) or maybe we did and they don't blow it up that big," Frank "the elder" said. "It is what it is, but it is a lot of fun to see."

That photo and this jaw-dropping clubhouse form the perfect intersection of the Antonacci family's deep passions, pride and pockets.

In early 2012, the Antonaccis purchased the former Hampden Golf course at auction for \$1.4 million, renamed it GreatHorse as an ode to their horse history and promptly poured more than \$45 million into a complete overhaul under the direction of Jerry's son, Guy Antonacci, and course architect Brian Silva.

"We were going to do a quick rehab and redesign, but once we got into it we decided that wasn't going to be a model that would work," said Frank M. "We had to fully commit, which we have, and build something special. That's the only way you can succeed in that business... We leveled everything. Tee to green, it was a complete redesign."

The redesigned club reopened in 2015.

Brand new is the stone clubhouse on the hill — featuring unbeatable vistas throughout the building and from a massive patio of what's known as a 100-mile view to the west across the Connecticut River Valley.

"On July 4th you can see seven or eight fireworks shows from here," said Frank M., "and the sunsets are spectacular."

It's a prime attraction, particularly when New England's fall colors are at their peak in the valley below.

There will be 24 weddings at GreatHorse this year.
Eighteen are on the books for 2017 and three are already

scheduled for 2018. So as not to displace club members when GreatHorse has a wedding, the Antonaccis commissioned a separate, stone banquet facility.

Inside the clubhouse, the focal point is a soaring wood ceiling reminiscent of the octagonal barn in Lindy Farms' main barn, except, hanging from this one is series of intricate, entwined orange glass sculptures created by Seattle artist Dale Chihuly, the man famous for creating more than 2,000 hand-blown glass sculptures that adorn the ceiling at the Bellagio Casino in Las Vegas.

"They say he's the greatest American artist of his generation," said Frank M.

Lindy Farms' colors and images of their great horses — Moni Maker, Lindy's Pride, Tarport Lib, Speedy Crown, thoroughbred No Nay Never — provide much of the rest of the theme.

Outside, GreatHorse's teaching facility is nearly finished. It will feature three hitting bays on the lower level and five bedrooms upstairs for stay-and-plays.

GreatHorse is the third major business the family operates after Lindy Farms and its main business, the waste management company USA Recycling and Hauling.

"The trash business is growing all the time and all these ancillary businesses that we have it all comes from there being six or seven kids involved in the family business now," said Frank "the elder". "If they come to the family with an idea, we kind of let them run with it a little bit."

All three of the Antonaccis' businesses — waste collection, horse racing and golf — have their business challenges and all three are very labor-intensive.

"I tell politicians, 'We have to be the stupidest business guys in the world. Instagram sells for a billion dollars and

has two employees. Every business that we have has hundreds and hundreds of employees and you can't do anything but have employees," said Frank M., laughing. "But what's great about the horse business is it's labor-intensive and you can't out-source the jobs."

GreatHorse currently has some 270 members, some of whom are national members that come up from Boston or New York City and stay for the weekend. They come for much more than the golf. There are tennis and bocce ball courts, with basketball courts to be added soon, which only makes sense since the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame is just 11 miles away in Springfield, MA.

The club also has a Vegas-style swimming pool with a splash pad for the kids and the tennis hut has an upstairs game room with a pool table and ping-pong table.

Some of the family-friendly tricks the Antonaccis learned from building Sonny's Place family entertainment complex near Lindy Farms in Somers, CT.

"It started out as miniature golf and a little driving range," said Lindy farm manager John Belskie. "Then they built the mini golf and then they decided they wanted an arcade and a restaurant and go-karts and batting cages. It's just expanded. They have a bar area in the back now. They have a gazebo and a bar. When we watch the races, a lot of employees go there... This year they decided they wanted to do a corn maze."

Game tokens are called Sonny Moni in honor of farm patriarch Sonny Antonacci and Moni Maker. That fun, relaxed atmosphere is evident at GreatHorse. The last thing the Antonaccis wanted was another stuffy country club. GreatHorse welcomes families and has a relaxed dress code.

"People say golf is dead and I see a little bit of a relationship here between the two industries. Golf is not dead," Frank M. said. "What we found when we built (GreatHorse) is we didn't think it's just about the golf. Just

like horse racing is not just about the race. It's about the whole experience. So, we built an experience that was great for the family, very high end that spoke to people's emotions and sense of well-being and having a good time. That's the experiences that we need to create in the horse business."

Limited Edition upsets in freshman pacing colt ISS final

Limited Edition and Sam Widger pulled a stunning 11-1 upset in the featured event of the evening, the \$75,000 Indiana Sires Stakes final for two-year-old pacing colts and geldings, at Hoosier Park Racing & Casino on Saturday (Sept. 10). Stopping the timer in 1:52.2., Limited Edition found late racing room to score his maiden breaking victory and give driver Sam Widger one of his four wins on the program.

Leaving from post four, Widger sent Limited Edition away from the gate firing and he grabbed the early lead through an opening panel in a snappy :26.3. On The Virg and Ronnie Wrenn Jr., the heavy post time favorites, grabbed a pocket seat while Meadowbrook Tiger and Ross Leonard were next in line, third.

On The Virg made his move to the lead down the backside and took command just past the half in :56. As the field reached the third station in 1:24.3, On The Virg continued to call the shots but Meadowbrook Tiger was applying pressure first-over with Rock N Tony and Ricky Macomber Jr. in tow.

On The Virg was able to hold off Meadowbrook Tiger but his biggest threat was patiently waiting to strike from the pocket. Widger moved Limited Edition to the passing lane and he exploded past the leaders with a :27.2 final quarter to get the win by two lengths. Rock N Tony rallied for second while On The Virg held on for third place honors. Limited Edition returned \$25.60 to his backers at the betting windows.

"He's always been a nice colt," Widger said after the victory. "We've just had some tough racing luck here and there. Tonight, the trip worked out perfect for us and he (Limited Edition) raced awesome."

Trained and owned by Perry Smith, the son of Rockin Image—Modern Way notched his first victory from seven seasonal outings. Establishing a new lifetime mark with the win, Limited Edition has now amassed \$56,550 lifetime.

The victory was also one of four wins for driver Sam Widger on the evening's 13-race card. Widger pulled a 7-1 upset with Double A Cash Hall for trainer Scott Galloway in the \$21,000 Invitational Trot earlier on the card. Widger's other two victories came in the 5th and 6th race behind The Right Move for trainer Tim Wilson Jr. and J-S Maple for trainer Jack Meyers, respectively.

Morrill, Brainard sweep the NYSS at Batavia

Horses trained by Tracy Brainard and driven by Jim Morrill Jr. have been tough to beat over the years and Saturday (Sept. 10) at Batavia Downs was no exception. That duo swept both three-year-old pacing filly divisions of the New York Sires Stakes (NYSS) and claimed the winner's share of \$119,300 in purses.

In the first \$60,200 division, Milky Way Rae (American Ideal—Aurora Borealus) was used early and late before grinding out a victory down the lane.

Milky Way Rae left for the lead but was pursued from the outside by American Ivy (Dan Daley) through a :27.3 quarter. By the three-eighths America Ivy had taken a seat third allowing the leader a breather and a :56 half. But before Milky Way Rae could get too comfortable, No Clouds Bluechip (Kevin Cummings) had pulled from fourth with Dime A Dance (Drew Monti) right behind her.

As the trio paced by three-quarters in 1:25, No Clouds Bluechip stalled and Dime A Dance went three-wide around her in the last turn. Starting with a two-length deficit at the top of the stretch, Dime A Dance put on a ferocious drive and took it to the leader, but Milky Way Rae fended off the challenge to win by a nose in 1:54.4.

"The race shaped up good for her because she likes to rock on the front" said Morrill. "I thought she could go in 1:52 tonight on this track but it didn't come to that."

It was the fifth win of the year for Milky Way Rae (\$13.20) and it boosted her 2016 earnings to \$86,674 for owner Fortunate One LLC.

The second \$59,100 leg saw Wishy Washy Girl (Roll With Joe—Wish All you Want) trip-out for the win and give the Morrill/Brainard team their second winner's circle presentation.

Wishy Washy Girl left and dropped in second behind Time On My Hands (Ray Fisher Jr.) who was rolling from the pylons. But despite the two being ahead of the field by a good ten lengths, Morrill pulled and tried to go to the front, cutting the quarter in :27. However Fisher would have none of that and he pushed his filly on and made Morrill see-saw his back into the hole.

Between the half in :55.2 and three-quarters in 1:24.4, Art Critic (Drew Monti) pulled and drew alongside Wishy Washy Girl. At the same time, Fisher was highly animated in urging on the front-running Time On My Hands who was clearly

running out of gas. This locked in Wishy Washy Girl who was raging with pace until the top of the lane. When the passing lane finally opened up, Morrill popped Wishy Washy Girl through the opening and sped to an instant two-length lead and won in 1:54.4.

"She was good but she would have been a lot better if they went 1:22 to three-quarters" Morrill explained. "That's why I came out of the two-hole at the quarter, because when they go too slow she's tough to hold. She was crawling over that horse around the last turn; she was very good."

The win gave Wishy Washy Girl three for the year and the purse enriched her bank account to \$82,328 for owners Michael Cimaglio and Stephen Demeter.

There were also two divisions of the \$15,000 Excelsior A series on the card.

Ghost Runner (Art Major—Spirit Of The West) was an easy wire to wire winner in 1:54.1 for Jim Morrill Jr. and trainer Erv Miller. Ghost runner (\$2.30) is owned by Dr. Scott Leaf, Deborah Mackenzie, Gerald Fielding and Tom Jackson.

The Morrill/Miller combo also took the second division with Rolling Going Gone (Roll With Joe-Long Gone) in 1:58, and once again wire to wire. Rolling Going Gone (\$2.30) is owned by Ross Bonafield.

Morrill Jr. ended the night winning five races.
