THE VIEW FROM WOODBINE MOHAWK PARK

On June 17 at Woodbine Mohawk Park, the wheels stopped rolling behind one of the track's most popular pacers.

Although a 74-1 longshot in the \$100,000 Mohawk Gold Cup Invitational, Wheels On Fire (p, 4, 1:48.1m; \$907,873) and regular driver Doug McNair were well-positioned approaching three-quarters, right behind pacesetter Billy Clyde. When that leader jumped off-stride, under pressure from first-over Linedrive Hanover, a cascade of interference unfurled in his wake. After the race, driver Mark MacDonald told AGCO judges that Billy Clyde had hit his knee and cross-fired, resulting in the ill-timed break.

Every horse behind Billy Clyde was affected. Two went down: Whichwaytothebeach and Wheels On Fire. An ominous silence hung over the crowd as Abuckabett Hanover, in line to Dexter Dunn, went on for the 1:47.2 victory. Both of the fallen horses

were able to get back on their feet. Whichwaytothebeach's driver Travis Cullen went to hospital after being checked out by paramedics. Wheels On Fire collapsed to his knees, miraculously raised himself to all four legs, and walked off the track, along with McNair.

Whichwaytothebeach returned to the races after wiring the field in a Pocono qualifier on July 26, even winning his next Mohawk visit on Aug. 19 for Cullen and trainer Desiree Jones, in a prep for the Canadian Pacing Derby.

Wheels On Fire's ongoing absence from the WMP free for all/preferred is another story. The largest horse at the Campbellville track left some big shoes to fill on Saturday nights.

A Wheels On Fire profile appeared in the Dec. 3, 2022 issue of HRU.

On Friday (Sept. 15), owner Brad Grant updated HRU about his gelding's whereabouts and progress. Wheels On Fire is back at trainer Richard Moreau's stable, making a slow and steady return to health after the career-disrupting accident.

"The worst part was I wasn't at the track that night," Grant said of Wheels On Fire's last, but not necessarily final, race. "I was away, but I was able to slip away and put it on the computer and watch it. It's unfortunate. Could have been worse. Thankfully, Dougie wasn't hurt, and the horse was able to get up and get off the track on his own steam."

Now eight years old, Wheels On Fire was voted the 2021 O'Brien Older Pacing Horse of the Year after joining Grant's stable in 2020. The former Ron Burke trainee won his Mohawk debut on Feb. 15 of that year.

"He was a consistent Saturday night horse," said the Milton, ON-based owner. "He didn't always win, but he was always in the race... I found out things after the accident, you know: I

think he had a bigger fan base than we realized, because there was a lot of people who had reached out to the University [of Guelph's Ontario Veterinary Hospital], Equine Guelph, when he was up there, and reaching out to Richard and I, asking how he is. We appreciate everybody's concern. I think he was a couple of weeks there, and then we were able to ship him back to Richard Moreau's place."

The gelded son of Somebeachsomewhere—Ab Fab has 47 wins from 147 lifetime starts, and has raced every year since eligible. He will be sidelined for the remainder of the 2023 season, however.

"He's been doing pretty well," Grant said. "From June until last week, he's been basically stall-bound, and he is now out, being able to walk and jog very, very lightly. He still can't be turned out in the paddock yet. We don't want him running full-bore."

Recovery has been gradual for Wheels On Fire, who hit the track hard in the Mohawk Gold Cup.

"Richard's team, they've done a great job nursing him along and looking after him, keeping the wounds clean and bandages changed and everything else," Grant said. "A lot of his getting back will be because of the care and the attention he's got from Richard's team."

With the pacer's absence from the track entering its third month, Grant said there's no timetable for a potential return.

"It's a long process," he said. "He's lucky that he's hopefully able to come back, and you know, we keep our fingers crossed. To be very candid and honest, if he doesn't come back to be the horse he was, he will not race again."

The pacer's injuries were severe, but not sufficient to warrant considering euthanasia, said Grant.


"Unless his vets said there was no chance of anything ever healing, or something like that, the thought of euthanizing him was never there," Grant said. "If they said, 'This horse is never going to race again; it's going to cost 'x' amount to get him sound, to be just a horse,' I would have been fine with that. That was never mentioned."

Wheels On Fire's future will include a dignified retirement, whenever the time comes. Next year, he will ideally qualify at Woodbine Mohawk Park and begin his return to highlevel competition. Grant cautioned against overly-optimistic expectations.

"I don't expect you'll see him on the track, anywhere near the track, ready to qualify, if he comes back, any time before early next spring," Grant said. "Richard knows my feeling on it is, 'Take all the time you need."

It's too soon to know what to expect next season, even if Wheels On Fire does make it back to his home track.

"I guess we'll find out once we start back with him, whether he's going to be the 'Wheels' of old, or through Joanne Colville

[administrator/coordinator for the Ontario Standardbred Adoption Society] and her team, we'll find a great second home for him, if he needs it," Grant said.


The only certainty is that Grant will be looking out for the gentle giant's best interests, whatever they may be.

"His resume will not show racing in cheap claimers," he said. "He'll retire a preferred horse on the WEG circuit. I stay in touch with Richard and I know he's in great hands over there... He's more than a pet over there. He's a part of the family."

While his outsized physique didn't spare him from injury in his most recent start, Wheels On Fire's comeback is now being guided by it. "I just know he's got a big heart, as well as a big body," Grant said. "He's got a huge, huge heart, and I think that's got a lot to do with it. I've just made the decision: The horse will tell us what he's going to be able to do. If he can't be the horse he was, then he's retired."

Highest Hambletonian handle in 18 years spurred by on-track betting

The Hambletonian Day 2023 international betting numbers are finally in and the wait was worth it.

The international and domestic numbers added up to being the top Hambletonian Day handle in 18 years and were certainly the best since The Meadowlands president/chief executive officer Jeff Gural took over the track in 2011.

John Campbell, president/chief executive officer of the Hambletonian Society, anticipated positive numbers from overseas.

"Well, I was sure we were going to be up a little bit over last year based on what we handled domestically," Campbell said. "When I left on Hambletonian Day, I was extremely happy with the crowd. I thought it was a really good crowd and I was extremely happy with the racing. It was an exciting day and it was reflected in the handle that I was pretty sure was going to be up a little bit over 2022, which was a very good year.

"Definitely, we had a great vibe in 2022, but the crowd was even bigger this year. So, I think we're back to pre-COVID electricity and I think it was a bigger crowd than we've had in a number of years, and maybe ever since we switched sides [from The Meadowlands old building to the new building]."

When combined, the foreign and domestic all-source wagering on the 16-race program totaled \$8,759,100. The European handle totaled nearly a million dollars — \$631,091 bet through France's PMU (Pari Mutuel Urbain) and \$322,220 from Scandinavia's ATG. But, the domestic numbers, particularly those on-track of \$921,938 — up 18 per cent over last year's \$781,310— were perhaps the most impressive.

"At the end of the day, the on-track number was fantastic," said Meadowlands chief operating officer/general manager Jason Settlemoir. "You know, we were just shy of a million dollars. So

that was nice to see. It was a great day and it established a new record in the 10-year history of our new grandstand. And the only time betting busted the \$9-million area was in 2005, and that was prior to [Gural]."

In 2005, \$9.01 million was bet on Hambletonian Day, breaking the record of \$8.81 million set just three years prior. This year's total ranks third on the all-time list.

"It was a great day," Settlemoir said. "And I'd like to thank the Hambletonian Society and Mr. Gural for having the faith in this team here at The Meadowlands to continue to host the most prestigious trotting race in the world. I'd also like to thank the customers, owners, trainers, drivers, and grooms for all their support during that day."


For the first time since 2011, The Hambletonian was broadcast live on one of television's big four networks. As a result of being on Fox, the race went off at 4:45 p.m., two hours earlier than in 2022, placing it in a better timeframe for the European market that is six hours ahead of New Jersey.

"I was just very proud of the fact that we were able to get on network TV. It absolutely matters. I think it's exposure that we have to take advantage of every time the opportunity presents itself."

It was the seamless cooperation of several entities — The Meadowlands, the Hambletonian Society, NYRA and Fox — that combined to create this Hambletonian Day success story.

"I also want to thank the folks at NYRA [New York Racing Association] for being such big supporters of us here at The Meadowlands and their class-A team that they have with Tony Allevato and Eric Donovan," Settlemoir said. "They're great to work with and we look forward to continuing our relationship with them into the future."

Don't think for a minute that this year's success has everyone resting on their laurels.

As Campbell pointed out, preparing for Hambletonian Day is a 365-day pursuit. There will also be some extra planning going on since the Hambletonian will be celebrating its 100th anniversary in 2025.

"We had our post-race meeting with The Meadowlands and already just started discussing plans for next year, so they'll start in earnest later in the fall, but we've already discussed 99 and 100 with The Meadowlands about 10 days ago," Campbell said. "It's a year-round thing, Hambletonian planning, there's just no other way to put it.

"And, you know, we're very fortunate with The Meadowlands management and staff that they're very receptive to making changes and making adjustments, which even though we had a great Hambletonian we'll be making adjustments and changes for next year, just to try and make it better."

Settlemoir is also excited about the 100th edition of "America's Classic Trotting Race", however, he also wants to take it one year at a time.

"Obviously, the 99th year is just as important as the 98 years leading up to it," Settlemoir said. "And the hundredth year will be just as important. 2023 has been a great year so far. So, we're going to put our thinking caps on and start looking forward to, obviously, wrapping up 2023 in the last quarter here coming at us, and then looking at 2024 with a bunch of optimism.

"And continue to tweak some of our plans and not only for on-track marketing ideas and things like that, but also tweaking some of our plans off track as well to try to exceed 2023. It's going to be tough to do because 2023 has been such a great year from an export standpoint. We just need to work in 2024, on maintaining our off-track numbers and trying to get more people here to the track. We'll work with NYRA and the Hambletonian Society and Fox and see what we can come up with for 2024."

Settlemoir said he's open to good marketing ideas, especially ones that involve bringing people out to the track, so should anyone have a suggestion they should email him at jsettlemoir@playmeadowlands.com.

Campbell believes the numbers look promising moving forward.

"The one thing I will point out is people say, 'Well, we don't get people to track the way we used to,' which is true," Campbell said. "However, when you figure the number of people who are watching our big events nowadays, when they're simulcast all over the world, there's more people than ever watching our big events, whether it be Hambletonian Day, Little Brown Jug, or North America Cup. So, it isn't like people aren't watching at all, it's just that they're spread out all over the world. And when you spread out, that betting gets hacked up so the track and horsemen don't get what they used to out of it.

"What people have to realize is that the only barometer we have for our popularity of what we're putting out to the betting public, is handle now. That tells you how your product is being received. And, you know, the fact that we've been up the last two years shows an upward trend and we're going to do everything we can to get over that \$9-million mark next year."



My Little Brown Jug memories, Part 3

1975 - Seatrain - A gelding had never before won the Jug, but as they say, there is a first for everything. Coming into the race, the overwhelming favorite had been Nero who had won 28 of his previous 31 starts. Seatrain was a relative novice making only his 10th lifetime start. Nero ended up encountering traffic problems, getting boxed in, finishing fifth in his elimination and failing to qualify for the final heat. This was a Jug that had more than its share of good horses. In addition to Nero and Seatrain, there were Whata Baron, Polaris Lobell, Bo Bo Arrow and the Canadian champion Albert's Star. Just the fact that Seatrain was in Delaware to begin with was a minor miracle and the fact that he started in the Jug, perhaps a major one. There was some question as to whether he was good enough to even go to the Jug. Two weeks before the race, he rattled off an impressive win at Batavia. That was enough to convince his owner/breeder/ trainer Lee Benson to send him to Delaware. Then on the eve of the race Seatrain was ill. He was running a fever. It appeared as though he would have to be scratched. But the racing gods were with his camp. It poured on Wednesday and on Jug Day Thursday. The race would have to be postponed and would take place on Friday. By then Seatrain was fine. He won the first heat in convincing fashion. Albert's Star steered by Keith Waples won the second. The third and final heat was won by Seatrain who led all the way. Not only was it a coming out party for Seatrain, but it was also one for his driver Ben Webster as a first step to the fame he would ultimately achieve.

1976 — **Keystone Ore** — The Jug itself went as expected. The two pre-race favorites were Keystone Ore and Armbro Ranger. Armbro Ranger won the first elimination. Keystone Ore despite being saddled with the 8-hole came out and won the second.

Yes, it may be difficult, but a horse can win the Jug despite a poor post position. Then Keystone Ore came back to win the final heat and the race.

But there was a significant backstory in this Jug. There were several horses in it who became sires, although none made a lasting impact. They included Keystone Ore, Armbro Ranger, Warm Breeze, Precious Fella, Windshield Wiper, Raven Hanover and Cavalcade. But there was one horse who might very well have been the best of the division and the one who's impact on the breed was monumental. Stanley Dancer did not make many mistakes during his career, but he made a significant one this year. He had a pair of Most Happy Fella 3-year-old colts that he sold to Delawarian Bill Brooks for the price of \$47,500. One of them was Afella Rainbow who turned into a solid "A" pacer on the New York Circuit earning \$323,866. The other one was an ill-tempered colt named Oil Burner who turned out to be, one of, if not the very best of that class earning \$535,541 despite being hardly eligible to many of the stakes. Both colts turned out to be bargains for trainer/driver Ben Webster. In the stud Oil Burner drew mixed reviews, but he sired one colt who had blazing speed and became a generational sire. His name was No Nukes. From No Nukes we got Western Hanover, who sired Western Ideal who gave us Rocknroll Hanover and American Ideal. From that same branch through Western Ideal, we got Always B Miki. From another branch by Western Hanover, we got The Panderosa, then Shadow Play, to the mighty Bulldog Hanover. All in part from a discard of Stanley Dancer. Ya never know!

1977 – Governor Skipper – Governor Skipper entered the race as the overwhelming favorite and he did what big favorites are supposed to do. He won the race in straight heats defeating a field that included Crash, Nat Lobell, Jambooger, Jade Prince, Super Clint and Jonquil Hanover. The only horse who might have been able to give him a battle on Delaware's half mile track was Big Towner, but he wasn't eligible. He was driven by regular driver John Chapman for trainer Bucky Norris for his owners the Wirtz Family who among other entities owned the NHL>s Chicago Blackhawks and the NBA's Chicago Bulls. Governor Skipper was a wonderful horse who did most of his racing to his advantage on the New York tracks Roosevelt and Yonkers. He did what a horse who stood the way he did was not supposed to be able to do. He stood as the old timers would say "a quarter past eleven." Ho toed out significantly. Such horses were not supposed to be good on a half mile track, the logic being that they would hit their knees on the turns. It apparently didn't bother Governor too much since just about all of his best racing was done on the smaller ovals.

1978 – Happy Escort – To say that Happy Escort was a longshot wouldn't come close to describing it accurately. Not only was he well behind the pre-race favorites Abercrombie and Falcon Almahurst coming into the Jug, but he was only considered fourth best in trainer Bill "Showbiz" Popfinger's stable at the beginning of the 1978 racing season. Ahead of him were Say Hello, Spicy Charlie and Escape Artist.

Popfinger subsequently had a breakup with owner Leon Machiz and Say Hello and Escape Artist were taken out of his stable. Spicy Charlie became lame. That left Happy Escort as his only Jug possibility. Owner Bob Suslow wanted him in the Jug, so Popfinger entered him not thinking he had any chance. There were 13 entered so the field was split. As luck would have it, the race split so that the three best, Abercrombie, Falcon Almahurst and Flight Director were in one elimination. Happy Escort was lucky enough to draw away from all the strength. He won the first elimination and Falcon Almahurst won his over Abercrombie. The top four from each elimination came back for a third heat. Abercrombie and Falcon Almahurst got into a suicidal speed duel tiring each other out. Joe O'Brien was there with Flight Director to go by them. The three heat winners came back for a decisive three horse final.

Here is Popfinger's description of what took place: "I had the lights on, the horn honking and the pedal to the metal. I went by those other drivers so fast, they got whiplash." In actuality, Popfinger did make an unconventional move which probably won him the race. He drew the 3-hole in the three-horse race. Flight Director had the rail and they left, Flight Director, Falcon Almahurst and Happy Escort in that order. 

1979 – Hot Hitter – This Jug is likely best remembered for driver Herve Filion standing up in the sulky on the way to the winner's circle. The horse was clearly the best of the 3-year-old crop in 1979. He came to the Jug as the clear favorite and left as the all-time money winning 3-year-old with earnings of \$716,939. His closest competition in the Jug was Tijuana Taxi piloted by Jim Miller who finished second in both heats. Happy Motoring who had won the first leg of the Triple Crown, the Cane Pace finished a well beaten eighth. Hot Hitter went on to win the final leg of the Triple Crown, the Messenger Stakes with Henri Filion subbing for his brother Herve who had suffered a broken hand previously in a racing accident. Strike Out colts finished one-two in the Messenger with Striking Force getting up for second with Dr. John Hayes in the bike.



It was the smallest Jug field since Bret Hanover scared away all but six opponents. In winning this Jug he became harness racing's alltime money winner with earnings of \$1,738,546 eclipsing Rambling Willie's previous record.

1980 - Niatross - Many might say that Niatross was our greatest ever. I am not about to disagree, even though I>m a member of the Somebeachsomewhere camp. However, after watching the replay of his Little Brown Jug win, I might be persuaded to switch camps. What he did was astounding. He won the first heat in a world record time of 1:55 on cruise control over a far behind Trenton Time. Then he came back in the second heat and lowered his own world record to 1:54.4. doing it seemingly easier than he had done in the first. Storm Damage finished second, with Tyler B third. There were only seven other pacers whose connections considered facing the great champion. It was the smallest Jug field since Bret Hanover scared away all but six opponents. In winning this Jug he became harness racing's all-time money winner with earnings of \$1,738,546 eclipsing Rambling Willie's previous record. The performance was played out before the largest crowd to ever witness a harness race, as 45,621 were in the stands and around the perimeter of Delaware's half mile track. There are some who say that the numbers Delaware puts up for attendance may be slightly fictitious. If that was the case this year, there were likely more rather than less than officially noted.

1981 – Fan Hanover – There are those that might say that this was a helluva horse race. There might be some others who might have said this was a stampede masquerading as a horse race. The race was won by Fan Hanover, still the only filly to win a Little Brown Jug. Coming into the race there were four projected favorites: the free legged Wildwood Jeb coming off of a victory in the Cane Pace, Landslide, coming off of a win in the Adios and undefeated for trainer driver Eddie Lohmeyer, the chestnut Bret Hanover colt Seahawk Hanover and the Albatross filly Fan Hanover poised to tackle the boys for the first time.

Seahawk Hanover won the first elimination for driver Ben Webster and trainer Skip Lewis. There was a mishap in the first elimination of this race where Eastern Skipper made a break for his trainer/driver/owner Herve Filion and knocked himself and two others including Landslide out of contention.

The second elimination was won by Fan Hanover, coming from last to first, something not often seen at Delaware, much of it three deep to just catch Wildwood Jeb at the wire.

It was in the third heat that the fireworks really exploded. Seahawk Hanover was leading when Wildwood Jeb put his foot through Seahawk's right wheel resulting in a pileup that took four of the eight horses out of the race. Fan Hanover managed to avoid the melee. She went around the fallen horses and led the rest of the way to capture the Jug.

The vision that runs through my mind when thinking of this race is an enraged Skip Lewis running out on the track with Jimmy Marohn, Wildwood Jeb's driver in his sights. I believed then and still think that if Lewis had not been restrained, he might have committed murder in front of 46,000 people.

Don't judge a book by its cover

If presented properly, harness racing can be interesting to newcomers.

"One person with passion is better than 40 who are merely interested."

E.M. Forster

When we encounter another person with a quirky passion, our thoughts are: What do they see in that? The "that" can be almost anything, for example: book collecting. A bibliophile, bibliolater, or bookman (bookwoman) is madly devoted to books.

"Book collecting is an obsession, an occupation, a disease, an addiction, a fascination, an absurdity, a fate. It is not a hobby. Those who do it must do it," said Jeanette Winterson.

Often, understanding what an unusual passion consists of can be complicated. What does a person who spends a lifetime collecting books do? Is the thrill of the hunt their motivation? Does a bibliophile feed their ego simply by involvement? Do they search in person, or today, is their quest for books online? Is the goal of a book collector to make money via buying and selling? Do they organize, catalog, and display books, or do they put their books in storage? Is it a competition to find rare books? Are they interested in ancient texts, rare books, books for speculation, or building a personal library? Do they seek collections by authors or by eras of first publication?

If you substitute "book collecting" with "harness horse racing," you see a parallel world. We are both rather eclectic groups of people with a passion that can sometimes be expensive. Our diversity makes it challenging to explain our obsession in a few words. We have long learning curves with a scarcity of teachers. Is our passion wagering on racing, training or breeding horses? Are we a business, a sport, a gambling enterprise, an agricultural endeavor, or a hobby?

The entryway into any niche world can be complex. New book collectors do not wake up one morning and decide, "I'm going to collect books passionately." Nor do they answer the plea, "Join us. Collecting books is great."

Imagine meeting someone at a coffee shop in Alaska and asking, "Why don't you join me in harness racing, a sport where a single horse pulls a cart with a passenger for one mile in competition with other horses and carts."

Recruitment of new devotees for unusual pastimes such as book collecting or harness horse racing is challenging. We are not trendy. We do not have Internet influencers or employees with the specific task of driving participants in our direction. We are not on television. Enticing new individuals to deep involvement is a slow process, and today's world goes so fast.

Finding new people who enjoy our old passion is up to us. Allow a few thoughts when a possible newbie appears:

- Take a new candidate to either a breeding farm or a yearling sale and let them know these are the places where dreams begin.
- Don't try to introduce every area of harness racing at once. Pick the stream of interest the recruit seems most interested in and stick to that area.
- Go slowly, very slowly, in that area for a specific time frame. For example, invite the person to follow your young trotting filly through a racing season. Follow that single horse until October. Put on blinders for most other aspects of the sport.
- Tug the interest rope with a positive, fun attitude. Be determined. Don't just let the new participant wander in the field. Hook them up and walk with them often.
- Use the Internet as a friend. Online resources can educate new participants.
- Embrace our rural roots and outdoor settings. Mention and demonstrate how racing horses can get people out of the house to farms, paddocks, and racetracks, all far from the beeping phone.

Essential in any approach is to put yourself on the other side of the fence and have a positive, upbeat attitude. Imagine an acquaintance takes you into their study to show you a collection of hardback books about fishing published between 1900 and 1930. At first, you may be bored or baffled, but your host is proud and excited. You are slightly intrigued. The positive vibe of this collector is infectious. You think, "Hey, my favorite author is humor writer Jay Cronley. What if I collect a copy of each of his books? That would be cool." A seed gets planted.

Sound crazy? So, what do you get out of being a recruiter? You may be pleasantly surprised at the joy of lighting the fire or passing the torch. As for me, I'm off to hunt for Jay Cronley books.

Two of the richest and most prominent two-year-old Grand Circuit trotting events — the Peter Haughton Memorial for 2-year-old trotting colts and geldings and the Jim Doherty Memorial for 2-year-old trotting fillies — were contested at Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino for the first time ever on Friday (Sept. 15). Leaving from post 4,T C I left sharply but so did Amazing Catch off the rail. T C I gained control just before the half in :57.2 and led the field to the three-quarters in 1:27. Spaaaanzano and Aaron Merriman were the first to take aim at the leader but they would have their work cut out for them as T C I's

lead was widening with every stride. Utilizing a :27.2 closing quarter, T C I kicked home impressively and finished nearly two lengths in front of Amazing Catch. Security Protected and Tim Tetrick closed from well back to round out the trifecta. As the heavy betting favorite, T C I returned \$3.00 to his backers at the betting windows.

With the victory, the Ron Burke trainee recorded his eighth straight victory and has now won eight of nine lifetime starts. Owned in partnership by Burke Racing Stable, Hatfield Stables & Knox Services & Weaver Bruscemi, the son of Cantab Hall—Nicole's Promise pushed his lifetime earnings to \$677,470. With the victory, T C I stamped his ticket to the Breeders Crown Two-Year-Old Colt trot final set to be contested at Harrah's Hoosier Park on Friday, Oct. 27.

The inaugural Peter Haughton was raced in 1981 and was created and named in honor of the sport's rising star, 25-year-old Peter Haughton, who tragically passed away the year prior. It quickly became one of the biggest events for 2-year-old male trotters with superstar winners include such names as Donato Hanover, Muscle Hill and King Of The North.





Soiree Hanover soars in Jim Doherty Memorial at Harrah's Hoosier Park

Trainer Lucas Wallin was not exceptionally pleased with his filly's post position prior to the race. Post 9, however, proved to be no problem for **Soiree Hanover** (Tim Tetrick) in the \$400,000 Jim Doherty Memorial for 2-year-old filly trotters on Friday (Sept. 15) in 1:54.2. This is the first time this event has been hosted by Harrah's Hoosier Park.

"I was a little closer than I thought I would be since some of the horses I thought wouldn't break did," said Tetrick referring to Miss Dior (John De Long and The Moment (Brian Sears). "But it didn't seem to be a problem for her especially with the long stretch here."

Ponda Title (Kyle Wilfong) went straight to the lead at the beginning of the mile, but Cheval Rapide (Yannick Gingras) had a mind of her own and led the field of 10 through a first quarter mile in :26.4. Ponda Title stuck right with her rival as the two fillies separated themselves from their eight rivals after a half-mile in :56.2 with Soiree Hanover positioned in third. Cheval Rapide established the third-quarter fraction of 1:25.1

but the rest of the field including a stubborn Ponda Title were right on her hooves.

Soiree Hanover trotted first-over and overtook Ponda Title by a head in mid-stretch as Cheval Rapide retreated. The filly came home strongly to sail by a game Ponda Title who held second while Graceful Design (Andrew McCarthy) closed from fifth to finish third.

"The 9-hole is always a tough spot to start from," Wallin said. "And I expected Timmy to be sitting in fifth or sixth with her early in the mile. It's always tough for a 2-year-old filly to come first-over, but she handled it very well. This is one of the times where it all worked out."

A daughter of Walner—Spring Gala, Soiree Hanover improved her record to 6 4-0-2 and boosted her bankroll to \$392,425.

The filly is the seventh and most prolific foal out of her dam, who is daughter of Hall of Fame broodmare Gala Dream. Gala Dream is also responsible for Dan Patch Award winners Pastor Stephen (Cantab Hall, \$1.05 million) and Father Patrick (Cantab Hall, \$2.55 million).

Bred by Hanover Shoe Farms, Soiree Hanover was purchased by Snogarps Gard Inc. for \$110,000 at the 2022 Standardbred Horse Sale.

The filly paid \$3.60 to win as the favorite and punched her ticket to this year's Breeders Crown event for her age, gait and gender.

As was the case last year, the Doherty and Haughton offer "Win and You're In" status for the 2023 Breeders Crown. The official winner of each race, if Breeders Crown eligible as of June 1, will advance directly to their respective final, with no starting fee, and the opportunity to draw for post 1 through 5.

Harrah's Hoosier Park kicked off the 30th season of live

racing on Friday (March 24) and is set to play host to the richest open stakes schedule ever throughout the 2023 live racing season. Worth over a combined \$12 million, the 160-day season will be the most lucrative stakes program in the track's history culminated by hosting the Breeders Crown events. Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino will be hosting the Breeders Crown for the third time on Friday (Oct. 27) and Saturday (Oct. 28).

The marquee races in Canada for pacing freshmen now have their finalists following a pair of eliminations for the \$970,000 Metro Pace and the \$540,000 Shes A Great Lady on Saturday night (Sept. 16) at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Legendary Hanover and **Clever Cody** built cushions on the lead to take their \$40,000 Metro Pace eliminations.

Driver James MacDonald floated Legendary Hanover from the outermost post in the first elimination to race fourth behind a :27.1 skirmish for command. MacDonald methodically moved Legendary Hanover into the backstretch and seized the lead from Booming Economy past a:55.1 half and strolled through the final turn. Past three-quarters in 1:23, Legendary Hanover started scooting away from his rivals in progress to a 1-1/2-length score over fastclosing Captain Luke, who came from last for second. Lous World persisted through a first-over push in the final turn to hold third at 92-1 with Storm Shadow and Chain Gang completing the top five.

"He's a big, strong horse. He should be able to handle [getting strung out], I think," trainer Anthony Beaton said after

the race. "This colt's just done it every way. Nothing seems to bother him. He's very easy on himself overall. He can get a little temperamental – he was a little agitated in the paddock tonight. But after warming up he settled down and he was super."

"We could've raced [next] Thursday on Jug Day for 125 [thousand] American and been the 1-9 favorite," said trainer Doc Moore on putting Clever Cody, the Ohio Sires Stakes champion, in the box for the Metro Pace. "But there's five of us partners and the

other four wanted to try him here, so here we are and it turned out pretty good. I just didn't want to make him look bad here, so he made himself look good tonight. I didn't know what to expect really, because the style of racing he was doing in Ohio probably wouldn't work for this track, but it seemed to tonight."

With the victory, Clever Cody has now made six visits to the winner's circle from nine tries while banking \$311,050 for owner Clever Cody Stable. The son of The Panderosa—Cams Van Go, off the 2-1 second choice, paid \$6 to win. Clever Cody was a \$24,000 purchase from the Ohio Select Sale.

The post-position draw for the \$970,000 Metro Pace will take place Tuesday evening at 6:30 p.m. on Woodbine Racing Live.

Its A Love Thing and **Caviart Belle** took their respective \$35,000 eliminations for the Shes A Great Lady by narrow margins earlier on the card.

In the first elimination, driver James MacDonald sent Its A Love Thing for the front from the outermost post in the sextet and clicked a :27.3 first quarter before 3-5 favorite My Girl EJ swung off the pegs from third. My Girl EJ grabbed the lead before a :56.3 half and coasted around the far turn as MacDonald revved Its A Love Thing from the pocket to three-quarters in 1:24.4. Its A Love Thing then slid to the lead into the final eighth and held My Girl EJ at bay while under a hand drive to win by a half-length in 1:50.4. My Girl EJ settled for second with Genie Hanover another five lengths behind in third. Stonebridge Halo and Rocket Deo rounded the finalists.

Caviart Belle kept rolling to three-quarters in 1:23.1 and spun for home with an anxious challenger in Odds On Platinum pulling outside to take a shot at the 1-9 favorite late. Gingras kept Caviart Belle to task and she responded to hold a half-length on Odds On Platinum at the finish while Bettor Sisters took third and the last two final berths going to Watching You and Elodie Hanover.

"She definitely wasn't as sharp," Yannick Gingras said of Caviart Belle's tight victory. "Even in the post parade she was a little lazy on me, and that's really not her thing. I didn't want to wake her up or nothing like that, so I just left her alone. I was hoping it was a good sign, but she was a little tired finishing. I think she'll be that much better next week. Last time she did it with the plugs in, but obviously we asked her [today] – I thought Sylvain [Filion

and Odds On Platinum] had me in the stretch. She showed she had some class; she wanted to put her nose in front."

Caviart Belle bagged her fifth win from seven starts and has now earned \$157,513. Nancy Takter trains the daughter of Captaintreacherous—Eloquent Grace for owner Caviart Farms. She paid \$2.10 to win. Caviart Belle sold for \$375,000 at the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale.

Trainer Ake Svanstedt sent out two winners in the four eliminations. The top five finishers in each will return for the rich finals next Saturday (Sept. 23) as part of the spectacular Mohawk Million card.

In the first Trotting Classic elimination, Challenger marched the field of six past the opening quarter in :27 and tripped the halfway timer in :56.2. **Up Your Deo** got into the outer flow from the garden spot before the 1:24.1 three-quarters and trotted by the leader and away from the field to win easily in 1:51.2, a new life mark. It was tight for second with Hasty Bid edging out Chapercraz. Tuscan Prince and Challenger earned the last two spots into next week's rich final.

Three trotters from the rear overtook the leaders and were charging hard down the stretch with favorite **Celebrity Bambino** hitting the wire first in 1:52.4. Winners Bet took second followed by Gaines Hanover. Osceola held for fourth with Little Expensive picking up the last spot in the final.

Amazing 'Grace': Grace Hill thrills in Milton Stakes masterpiece

Grace Hill, sent off as the 4-5 choice, was simply spectacular in the \$220,000 Milton Stakes, for fillies and mares, 3-year-olds and up, Saturday night (Sept. 16) at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Off since a snappy 1:49.4 score at Scioto Downs on Aug. 25, 5-year-old Grace Hill paced back in the spotlight under the bright lights at the Milton oval off a pair of qualifiers and delivered one of the finest performances in her decorated career.

Boudoir Hanover, leaving from the outside post 9, blasted off the wings and crossed over to grab a short-lived lead into the first turn, but Silver Label forged on to seize control just before an opening panel timed in a lively :25.4. Doug McNair, in rein to Grace Hill, sized up the pacesetter from in third.

It was Silver Label still calling the shots on the front end through a half-mile in :54.1, followed by Boudoir Hanover, Grace Hill and Prohibition Legal. McNair then tipped out the daughter of Always B Miki—Western Silk, and set their sights on Silver Label, inching closer with every step to the outside. A neck on

top at three-quarters in 1:21.3, Grace Hill was in full flight as the field straightened for the drive home.

Ahead by 1 ½ lengths at the stretch call, the Breeders Crown winner bounded home in :26.2 to notch a comfortable two-length triumph in a time of 1:48. Prohibition Legal was second, Boudoir Hanover, at 65-1, was third and Mikala was fourth.

"She's a fun mare to drive, she's just like driving a sports car," McNair said. "I drove [Silver Label] last week, and she got beat by her stablemate from off her helmet, so I figured if I didn't put mine on the front in a big hurry with her, she can sprint as fast as anything. When you're first-up against a great mare on the front with a real nice one on my back it wasn't the ideal spot, but she made it look pretty easy.

"I maybe just raced her wrong a couple times at The Meadowlands, she finished second and third. To be honest, I think she races better chasing. She won one time sitting last at the head of the stretch coming a :25 final-quarter. It's just tough to take your chances that way and run into traffic. Tonight, we got to sit quite a way and when I moved her, she was really good."

Owned by Tom Hill, it was the latest victory for the bay, who now boasts a 27-10-5 record, including six wins from seven appearances at Mohawk, from 57 starts, to go along with over \$1.7 million in career purse earnings.

"I don't know if she just loves Canada or not, but she sure feels like a different horse on this track," McNair said. "She seems to not get tired and she's a lot of fun."

The well-travelled mare, trained by Virgil Morgan, is now 8-2-1 from 11 starts on the campaign.

Bred by White Birch Farm, Grace Hill, a \$75,000 purchase at the 2019 Lexington Select Yearling Sale, paid \$3.60 for the win.

Ohio Select Sale up nearly 11 per cent

The Ohio Selected Jug Sale was a flurry of bidding activity, paving the way for the highest gross in the sale's storied history, which enjoyed a double digit increase of 10.7 percent from last year's auction. The sale also saw the highest priced yearling sold in the state of Ohio fetch \$225,000 from Greg Luther.

The sale topper was HIP #106, a Catch The Fire half-brother to Captain Cowgirl p,3,1:49.3f (\$600,579), named Catch The Cowboy. The handsome colt was bred and sold by Jeff and Senena Esty's Spring Haven Farm, who themselves are perennial leaders in average and gross in Ohio Standardbred auctions. From the Western Hanover mare Rideintothesunset, this was also the dam's most expensive yearling.

Overall, the gross sales totaled \$8,276,000 for 269 yearlings sold, resulting in an average of \$30,766 per horse. This was a 9.4 per cent increase from last year's premier Ohio yearling auction. The median was \$25,000.

President of the Ohio Breeders, Randy Haines was very pleased with the outcome.

"This was a strong sale across all categories," Haines said. "It speaks volumes to the prominence of the Ohio program and people's desire to be a part of it."

The sale is conducted by the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale Company, and general manager Bruce Brinkerhoff was equally excited about the strength of the sale.

"We are very thankful for the enthusiastic bidding from a deep contingent of buyers throughout the day," Brinkerhoff said. "Our consignors have upped their game and continued to bring horses that are in great demand... and it shows with record gross, average, and the record priced horse."

Looking at the numbers more closely, the highest average for pacing sires, for the third year in a row was dominated by Downbytheseaside at \$50,968 for 31 sold. First crop sire Catch The Fire was second at \$35,909 for 22 sold, followed by Lather Up with \$34,000 for eight sold.

On the trotting side Triumphant Caviar had just five yearlings sold, but averaged \$79,000. Much of that was on the strength

of two six-figure yearlings, especially HIP #144, a full brother to two-time Ohio Sire Stakes champion Rose Run Yolanda at \$150,000, who was the highest priced trotting yearling sold. Both of those colts hailed from the Rose Run Farm consignment who sold 13 yearlings for a gross of \$856,000 for a leading consignor average of \$65,846.

While the stallion Volstead averaged \$37,000 for six sold, Uncle Peter (\$33,909 avg.; 22 sold) and What Hill (\$31,632; 38) also led the trotting sires with greater numbers sold.

Spring Haven Farm topped the consignor gross sales category with \$1,331,000 in total for 44 sold. They were followed by Dublin Valley Farms with \$901,000 (38) and Midland Acres with \$898,000 (36).

Archie Yoder's Rose Run Farm also sold the highest priced pacing filly in the sale, HIP #36, a gorgeous Downbytheseaside filly that was purchased by Burke Racing for \$140,000.

Palone indicated he was thinking Lightning Lane with Chiapanecas, the 1-5 favorite, pretty much from the start.

"I really wanted to take care of this filly because I know she has bigger dances later in the season," Palone said. "At the same time, you want to get the money. She was well within herself with the plugs in. It ended up being the best-case scenario."

The daughter of Stay Hungry—Maniana executed the game plan perfectly, brushing past Lou Lou to down her by a length in a career-best 1:53. Early leader Ginger Tree Belle completed the ticket. Ron Burke trains the winner for breeder/owner William Donovan.
