A million reason to love this year's Little Brown Jug

Walking across the infield toward the Little Brown Jug winner's circle — her face equal parts disbelief and elation like someone that just won a million-dollar lottery — trainer Linda Toscano spotted her old boss, John Campbell, going the other way to the paddock.

"Well, how's your week going?" Campbell said grinning as he pulled Toscano into a warm hug. "I'm so happy for you."

For Toscano, who is already having a heck of a year, this was, indeed, the week of weeks.

In the span of 24 hours, she won both her first Jugette (with Ucandoit Blue Chip) on Wednesday (Sept. 20) and her first Jug (with It's My Show) on Thursday (Sept. 21).

Another first? She will always be the first trainer to win a Jug that carried a \$1 million total purse (\$850,000 final, three heats \$50,000 apiece) in its 78 years.

The million-dollar purse is the reason Campbell, who retired from driving in 2017, was suited up for the first time since he and Foiled Again met fans at Shenandoah Downs in Virginia in 2019. Campbell has long advocated for the Jug to get to \$1 million to drive entries and help sustain one of the world's greatest harness racing traditions. To celebrate the occasion, he donned the maroon, blue and white and led the post parade to a roar of approval from the Delaware faithful. They know and appreciate their history in Delaware and love their traditions.

"I love this place," Toscano said. "I love everything about this place. I say all the time that the people showing up here are showing up for racing. We play to an empty grandstand a lot, so it's kind of fun to play in front of a crowd and a crowd that likes racing."

Thursday marked the first sign in years that an event that had been showing its age like an over-loved teddy bear finally appears to be headed for refurbishment. We're all better for it.

The million-dollar purse isn't guaranteed for next year. But anyone that witnessed this year's race needs to hope to high heaven the political forces in Ohio that made this year's seven-figure purse happen can make this a more permanent arrangement. Better yet, Ohio people, contact your representatives.

After all, there were three Jug heats for the first time in 10 years and the excitement was palpable.

No more so than with Toscano who is only the third trainer to win the Jug and Jugette in the same year following Billy Haughton in 1974 with Armbr Omaha (Jug) and Handle With Care (Jugette) and Ron Burke in 2021 with Lous Pearlman (Jug) and Scarlet Hanover (Jugette).

And Toscano pulled it off – by a neck, no less – with only the kind of master trainer stroke one can pull off when your event has same-day heats. Between heats, she changed It's My Show equipment to a blind bridle.

"When the plan works, it works," she said with a laugh and shrug.

In fairness, driver Scott Zeron – celebrating his second Jug victory after 2012's win with Michael's Power – had more to

do with it. He is now just the third driver to win the Jug and Jugette in the same year. Haughton did it first in '74 with the aforementioned duo. David Miller turned the trick in 2011 with Big Bad John in the Jug and Idyllic in the Jugette.

Zeron also won this year's Hambletonian with Tactical Approach, making him just the ninth person to win both classics in the same year and the first since Brian Sears did it in 2013 with Royalty For Life (Hambletonian) and Vegas Vacation (Jug).

"[Zeron] has been the best kept secret in harness racing for four years for me, but now everyone has figured out that he can really drive a horse," Toscano said. "I kind of had him all to myself. Now, I have to share."

Toscano has had six Jug horses before and admitted she was "not close" to winning.

Despite three second-place first heat finishes, her best previous finish in a final was a third in 2012 with Bettors Edge.

Coincidentally, that was the same year Zeron won his first Jug in his very first drive.

Proving this year's Jug was about karma and history and tradition – just like it should be.

'Show' her the money

Linda Toscano trainee It's My Show wins the first \$1 million Little Brown Jug.

Linda Toscano thought she was having a great day Wednesday (Sept. 20) when she and driver Scott Zeron combined to capture the \$255,000 Jugette.

She had no idea how much better Thursday (Sept. 21) would be.

Toscano and Zeron combined forces yet again, this time joining with It's My Show to beat Seven Colors by a neck and capture the 78th Little Brown Jug, the first to ever offer a purse of \$1 million.

It's My Show won in 1:49 at odds of 7-1. Ken Hanover was third.

Zeron joined Billy Haughton and David Miller as the only drivers to win the Jug and Jugette in the same year, having done so in 1974 and 2011, respectively.

The victory was Toscano's first in the Jug and made her the third trainer in history with such a double, following Haughton, who was also the trainer in 1974, and Ron Burke in 2021. She is also the third woman to win the race, following in the footsteps of Caroline Lyon and three-time winner Casie Coleman.

Toscano choked back tears as she accepted the gleaming Jug trophy, hugged her driver, and kissed her star pacer on the nose.

"This has been a pretty good week," she said with a grin. "This has been the race that's eluded me. And it's the race that I've wanted for so long."

Zeron was not sure they could bounce back.

"Honestly, when you lose the elimination, it almost feels like you've lost the whole day," Zeron said.

The first elimination went to Moment Is Here, driven by Tim Tetrick and trained by Bob McIntosh, with both Hall of Farmers seeking their first Jug win. Hungry Angel Boy and Blue Hunt also advanced.

David Miller appeared to take a step closer to his record-breaking sixth Jug when he steered Ken Hanover to a come-from-behind win in a stakes-record time of 1:48.4. Seven Colors and Thunder Hunter Joe also made the cut.

By finishing second, It's My Show earned post 5 in the final, and Zeron knew he had a challenge.

"Post position's everything in this race," Zeron said. "We needed some crazy things to happen in the final, and some crazy things did happen."

The craziness came from Moment Is Here and Cannibal fighting it out for the lead through the first three-quarters of the race, before both began to fade. Seven Colors sling-shotted off the final turn and looked to be on his way to victory.

Zeron, however, had other plans.

"Seven Colors had an even better trip than I did," Zeron said. "I tripped out my horse heading into the last turn, and he felt like a million dollars. I still didn't know until halfway down the stretch [what would happen]."

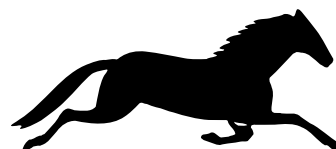

The connections of It's My Show celebrate in the winner's circle after winning the first \$1 million edition of the Little Brown Jug.

"I had shivers down my spine when I knew I was winning."

The win caps a career year for Zeron, who captured all three of North America's million-dollar races: the Jug, the Hambletonian, and the North America Cup, which hits seven figures in Canadian funds.

It's My Show earned \$450,000 for his Thursday efforts to make his lifetime bankroll more than \$1.1 million for owners Richard and Joanne Young.

Jug officials dreamed of making the purse \$1 million in time for the 75th anniversary in 2020, but the COVID-19 pandemic derailed many celebratory plans. That left them three years to achieve what many considered to be an essential milestone for the race many consider to be the most prestigious in pacing.

"Ten years ago, a million-dollar Jug would have been an absolute pipe dream," Jug publicity director Jay Wolf said.

Wolf said the purse funds came from sources including the Ohio Harness Horsemen's Association, race sponsors, and the state. It is part of a continuing effort, started with the passage of video lottery terminals in 2012, to make Ohio harness racing an industry leader.

"It has absolutely made Ohio the best state in the country to race in, and we're just glad we're in the heart of it," Wolf said.

The question remains whether the race can maintain its seven-figure feature, but Wolf said the commitment is there.

"The hard part is to convince people that this is a great investment in agriculture and tourism here in the state of Ohio," he said. "As soon as this race is over, we'll go to work for next year."

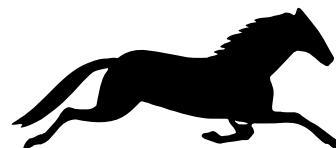

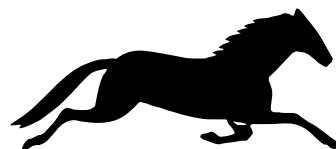

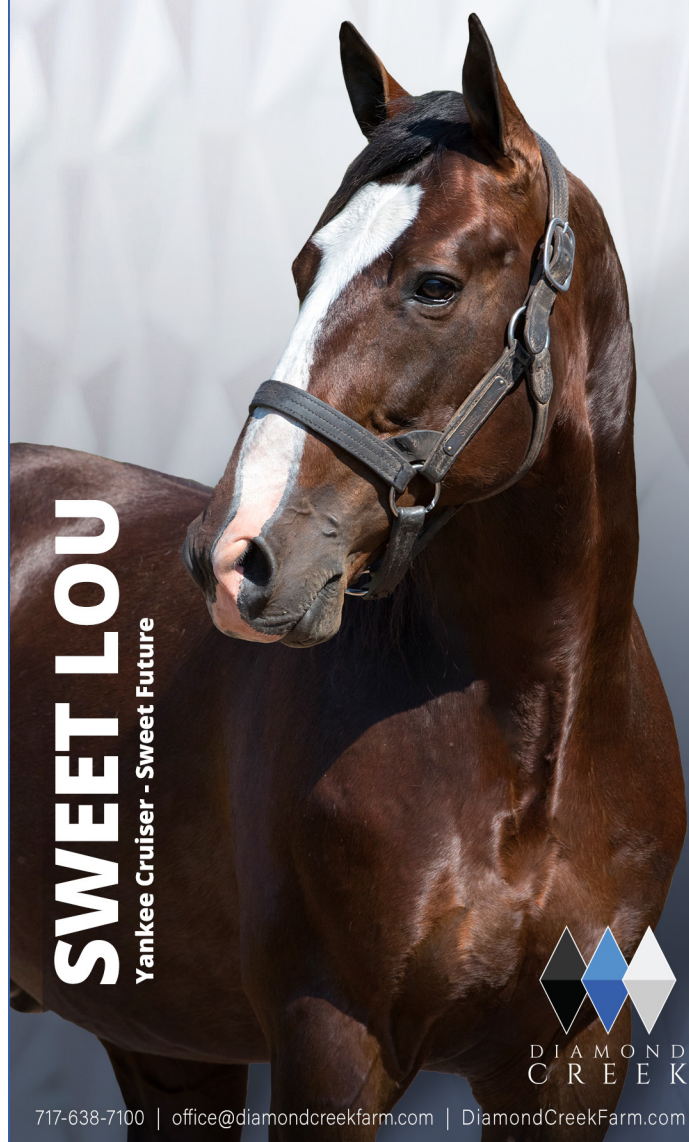

Daughter of Toscano's first Breeders Crown winner gives her, and Scott Zeron, first Jugette win

Twenty-one years ago, 17 years before she became a Hall of Famer, trainer Linda Toscano won her first Breeders Crown with Molly Can Do It.

On Wednesday (Sept. 20) at the Delaware County Fairgrounds in Ohio, Toscano won her first Jugette with Molly Can Do It's daughter **Ucandoit Blue Chip** — a horse the trainer calls a complete clone of her mother.

"Molly's picture is in my office and you look at [Ucandoit Blue Chip] and it's like looking in a mirror," Toscano said.

The trainer said winning the Jugette for 3-year-old pacing fillies — which carried a total purse of \$305,000 with the final going for \$255,000 — was on her bucket list.

"I got beat by [a neck] in three heats with Sprig Hanover a lot of years ago," Toscano said of the 2008 Jugette. "It's one of those races that has eluded me."

Until Wednesday, thanks to two terrific steers from driver Scott Zeron.

Toscano was effusive in her praise for Zeron, who also won his first Jugette. The two have had quite a year together, that got even better on Thursday when they teamed up to win the Little Brown Jug with It's My Show.

In June, they teamed up to win the \$1 million (Cdn) Pepsi North America Cup with sophomore pacing colt It's My Show.

A few weeks ago, the tandem won a Pennsylvania Sires Stakes championship with Odds On Hail Mary and in June and July, they teamed up to win both the Zweig sophomore filly trot and Empire Breeders Championship with Sadie Hanover.

"Somehow, he puts them in the right place at the right time for me and he's got a clock in his head and I cannot say enough good things about the ride we've been on," Toscano said. "He does a great job for me."

On Wednesday, Zeron sat patiently in the pocket with Ucandoit Blue Chip in the final and out sprinted fellow elimination winner Zanatta (Joe Bongiorno) in the stretch to win.

When the final field was sent on their way, Zanatta protected her rail position forcing the eventual winner to sit in the pocket past the quarter in :27.4 and the half in :55.4. As the field went by the grandstand for the first time, Southwind Bella (Yannick Gingras) was the first to move, but could get no closer to the leader than third at the three-quarters in 1:22.4.

Zeron gave his cue to Ucandoit Blue Chip in the final turn and used a :27.3 last quarter to score a 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ length win in 1:50.2.

Ucandoit Blue Chip is a daughter of Keystone Velocity bred by Blue Chip Farms. She sold for \$32,000 at the 2021 Standardbred Horse Sales Company's yearling sale. Ucandoit Blue Chip is the 11th foal out of Molly Can Do It. She was purchased by her owner Bill Elliott of Woodstock, ON. He still owns her solo.

"I looked at her and watched the video," Elliott said. "I went to the sale and looked at her. I remember that a gentleman from Ontario was looking at her and I said, 'You're interested in her?' He said, 'Yeah' and I said, 'You're just going to cost me money.' He asked how much I was going and I said, 'I'm buying her.' I knew she wasn't going to sell for \$100,000, but I was taking her home and I knew I was buying her. I had spoken to Linda about training a couple of other horses and, when I bought her, I walked up and asked her if she'd take her and she said yes."

At the time, Toscano was trying to reduce the number of horses she trained.

"The mother is the only reason I have her because [Elliott] wandered around the sale that year and he said to me, 'Would

you consider taking one?’ and I said, ‘Yes,’” Toscano said. “But, I’ve been trying these days to get my numbers down a little bit. When he said, ‘I bought that filly out of Molly Can Do It, did you look at her?’ and I said I did. He said, ‘What do you think?’ and I said that she’s a clone for her mother. He goes, ‘So, are you going to train her?’ and I said, ‘How can I not?’”

In the winner’s circle, Elliott beamed. It was his first Jugette victory, too.

“It’s a dream come true,” Elliott said. “I’ve raised a horse that raced in the Jug [in 2005], a horse called With Anticipation, and I had some broodmares, but I’ve never raced a horse in the Jug myself. Actually, up until a month ago, I had a horse that was favored to win [the Jug] – I owned a part of Seven Colors. We sold him four or five weeks ago, otherwise I would have had one in both [races].”

As for Ucandoit Blue Chip, her owner is smitten.

“She’s just beautiful, athletic,” Elliott said. “It was funny, after we bought her and training down, Linda told me she didn’t act like anything special. She just did what she had to do. Now, she’s the same racing – she knows where the wire is. If you take a look at the races she’s won, there’s a lot of races where it looks like halfway through the stretch that she’s first up, half-a-length back, but then all of a sudden in the last 50 feet she wins by a neck. She just knows what to do.”

Toscano added, “She’s starting to get stronger and she’s starting to get confident in herself. She has the tactical speed and now she’s finishing. This was a big feat today, so I’m thrilled with her.”

Ucandoit Blue Chip now has a lifetime record of 6-3-2 in 14 starts and earnings of \$372,734.

JUGETTE HEATS RECAP

In the first Jugette elimination, all five participants had the lead at some point in the mile. At the end, Ucandoit Blue Chip was 1 ¼ lengths better than Daffled Hanover (David Miller) and Earthwindfire (Tim Tetrick). Vivians Dream (Gingras) finished fourth and advanced to the final.

The second \$25,000 elimination went to Zanatta in a lifetime best 1:50.1. The pacesetter Southwind Bella (Gingras) was second beaten by three-quarters of a length, Hey Hey Mama (Ronnie Wrenn, Jr.) was third and the supplemental entry Odds On Hail Mary (Zeron) was fourth, but scratched out of the final.

Zanatta is owned by the One Legend Stable and trained by Jen Bongiorno.

Captains Quarters is ready to set sail in Metro Pace

A royally-bred colt with a nautical name advanced to Saturday night's (Sept. 23) Metro Pace final at Woodbine Mohawk Park after finishing second in the faster of two Sept. 16 Metro eliminations. Driven by Jody Jamieson, 7-5 favorite Captains Quarters closed in a :25.2 last quarter, running out of racetrack in pursuit of 1:50.4 winner Clever Cody.

Bred by James Avritt of Lebanon, KY, the colt was a \$235,000 Lexington Select Sale yearling, his catalog page rich in black type and converging bloodlines of the co-fastest Metro Pace winners.

Captains Quarters (p, 2, 1:53.3s; \$30,243) is a son of Captaintreacherous (p, 3, 1:47.1m; \$ 3,148,657), who equaled the Metro Pace record with his 1:49.2 victory in 2012, en route to divisional Dan Patch and O'Brien Awards. The colt's dam is Prescient Beauty (p, 2, 1:50.4m; \$495,860), three-quarter-sister to the original Metro Pace stakes record-setter, Sportswriter (p, 3, 1:48.3s; \$1,649,411), who won the 2009 edition and year-end 2-year-old male pacing title on both sides of the border.

Herb Holland said he first encountered the colt when inspecting him for someone else.

"Initially, that owner [Rich Stiles of Chelsea, MI] asked me to look at [Captains Quarters] in Lexington for him, for another trainer," Holland said. "So, I actually did, and I liked the colt. He ended up purchasing him and did send him to another trainer. That trainer had some personal issues, early spring, and wasn't able to continue on with the training, and he asked me if I could continue on with the training. Consequently, his misfortune was my good fortune."

The 66-year-old trainer told HRU he was instantly impressed.

"His pedigree was beyond, as good as anybody's in the sale," Holland said. "He actually was a little undersized at the sale, but very correct. I think if he was a hand taller at the sale, then probably we don't have him today."

Although Captains Quarters won his first career start, Aug. 11 at Woodbine Mohawk Park in 1:53.3, he had to catch up to peers with an earlier start to their season. Holland said the colt had shown maturity in a pair of July baby races at Mohawk, more than compensating for a delayed start to his training.

"He didn't know anything, because he had never trained or jogged with horses, and that's the reason we got him to the races a little late..." Holland said. "I started him at 2:30 and just brought him down, assuming that's where he'd been. So, I didn't dig in hard with him; I just took my time. We were in no rush with him... When I got him, he didn't know about chasing down horses and all that. He caught on quick."

Driver Jody Jamieson has driven Captains Quarters in all four lifetime starts, and is listed to drive him in the Metro final.

"When I went to train the colt with company, I asked Jody if he'd come in and train with me, and he did, all the time, and never refused," Holland said. "So, when it was time to come and race him... I told Mr. Stiles, 'Jody's been coming in the mornings and helping me train him'... Jody schooled him a couple of times, and knew he had a lot of quality."

Owner Rich Stiles is full owner of Captains Quarters, after a proposed partnership with the horse's original trainer fell through at last year's Lexington sale. Holland made the successful bid on Hip #295 as an agent for Stiles, but said he had not anticipated the partner backing out of the deal for the six-figure colt. Fortunately, Stiles was able to finalize the purchase over the phone with Randy Manges, Lexington Select Yearling Sales Company co-manager.

“I've been fortunate enough, but I've never had the owners to buy those kind of horses,” Holland said. “A lot of good trainers don't get the opportunity to train those kind. When you do, you look better... The reality is, if the owners don't put them in your barn, you could be great and nobody knows you.”

As for Stiles taking full ownership of Captains Quarters, Holland said the Michigan-based owner was “tickled as punch” with his colt's progress and already excited for next year's stakes campaign.

In April, Holland began working with the colt at Beechwood Acres, a private training center in Milton, ON. “It's a perfect scenario,” he said. “They have a few broodmares. It's R A W Equine... They own horses with the Taktors and Per Engblom.”

Captains Quarters proved a precocious learner in early lessons there.

“We trained him faster than he qualified, but my biggest concern was just teaching him to sit in and follow horses, and finishing his miles strong and not tired,” Holland said.

Although he hasn't added to his maiden victory yet, the blue-blooded colt has hit the board in subsequent stakes at Mohawk, with show finishes in the Nassagaweya and Champlain Stakes.

"The colt could be a little excitable, so we always wanted to race him from off the pace and just let him finish the mile strong," Holland said. "If there were other races for him, I may not have put him in there, but there were no overnights after the 'non-winners of one.' There was no 'non-winners of two' for him, so we elected to put him in there. He was excellent. He's been excellent after every race."

Clever Cody capitalized on a front-end trip in his Metro elimination, while Captains Quarters overcame a tougher trip for place.

"We got a little road trouble with him, and the flow didn't go," Holland said. "They backed the half up to 57 seconds. When you're sitting back, it's pretty hard to catch the front end then."

Wednesday (Sept. 20), the trainer said he was feeling confident, "but not overconfident!" as Captains Quarters readied for the biggest race of both their careers.

"This would be the biggest purse [\$850,000] I've raced for, for sure...", Holland said. "Mr. Stiles has been great and I don't feel the pressure at all. You get anxious and you want to perform well, because you don't get the opportunity very often."

Although not a leisurely type of horse, Captains Quarters is taking it all in stride.

"If you're not paying attention, he could get away from you in a heartbeat," said Holland, crediting partner Carolyn MacIsaac and caretaker Jenna Arbuckle with keeping the "energetic" colt on an even keel.

The rest is up to three-time Metro Pace winner Jamieson on Saturday night. The WMP regular won previous editions driving Stockade Seelster (2022), Mystician (2010), and Yankee Skyscraper (2006).

Usually working with value-priced yearlings, Holland said he'll be back at all the sales this fall.

"It's difficult to pick an apple that fell off the tree that's still good," said the Glace Bay, NS native, marveling at sending out his first Metro Pace starter after working for over 20 years in Ontario. "I left Cape Breton in 1976 to go work for Duncan MacDonald at Liberty Bell Park. I've raced at Hollywood Park, Yonkers, Roosevelt... Spent 20 years in [New] Jersey, racing. You name it, I was at that track."

With Captains Quarters, Holland has landed the catch of a lifetime.

"The story of how it came to be that I ended up with him, it would be hard to believe," Holland said. "How many things had to go wrong for somebody else, for it to go right for me? The good Lord has always blessed me, so I feel lucky."

Emoticon Hanover's imprint on this year's Mohawk Million

And other thoughts throughout one of the more highly anticipated race cards of the year.

In the fourth edition of the Mohawk Million (Sept. 23) open to all 2-year-old trotters, a record number four fillies will take on six colts and geldings in an attempt to replicate Venerable's feat

from 2021 as the only other filly to win the seven-figure event. Of those fillies, the two being sent out by Serge Godin's Determination and trainer Luc Blais, both have close relations to the world champion trotting filly they campaigned just a few years ago, 2018 O'Brien winner Emoticon Hanover. That's because Determination's entrant Drawn Impression (Muscle Hill) is the first foal out of Emoticon Hanover, and the other entrant Emoji Hanover (Greenshoe) is a half-sister to Emoticon Hanover, both being out of the mare Emmylou Who.

Whereas Determination bred Drawn Impression, Emoji Hanover on the other hand, was a \$180,000 buy at the 2022 Lexington Selected Yearling sale.

The Mohawk Million didn't exist at the time Emoticon Hanover raced as a 2-year-old, but she had shown the same early career promise as a freshman that both Drawn Impression and Emoji Hanover have demonstrated thus far. Both Emoticon Hanover and Emoji Hanover won the Champlain Stakes, and when the rapidly progressing Emoji Hanover did so in her most recent race in a time of 1:54.2, she improved four full seconds than her clocking when she notched her first win in the race prior. Like Determination's misfortune last year at the post draw in this race with Silly Me Hanover, Emoji Hanover has drawn another outside post, this one in the farthest out, post 10. Of the two Determination slots, Drawn Impression will attract more attention and may have even battled for race favoritism if not for

being scratched-sick out of her division of the Champlain. Her wins in the Peaceful Way elimination and \$425,000 final where she vaulted off cover both times to sprint away once underway were extremely impressive. Post position 5 should lend itself well enough towards her racing style and the question for the daughter of Emoticon Hanover may only be a matter of fitness.

A win from either of these fillies would not only add to their own career, but also to the story of Emoticon Hanover as well as give Determination and Blais a win in the Mohawk Million; a race that they've been part of since day one.

Ultimately, the road to Mohawk Million glory will go through the nearly unbeatable, T C I. The Cantab Hall colt trained by Ron Burke comes off a win in the newly relocated Peter Haughton at Hoosier Park last weekend and there haven't been many anxious moments in any recent races as he continues to run up a potential record-breaking bankroll by the time his 2-year-old season is done. Burke's other entrant, Tennessee Tom is formidable as well. The Long Tom gelding went from fifth to the lead in a super-fast brush en route to winning the OHSS championship two weeks back.

Elsewhere, Security Protected got the 2-hole ride against T C I two back in their PASS Final at Pocono three weeks ago and that's where that race ended. He did close from well out of it when those two faced off again last week at Hoosier, but he had too much ground to cover and lands a similar outside post once again. Desiree Jones is another trainer with multiple slots accounted for in the race, as she'll send out presumed longshots despite having posts 1 and 2, Tactical Strike and Top Mast. Tactical Strike looked like she was giving ground away on the inside throughout during her race in the Champlain but gradually closed later along the inside. It was a similar trip for Top Mast in the other Champlain division, who also stayed along the inside and came on mildly through a late seam.

Allegiant will have raced just six days prior to the Mohawk Million and won't have much time to rebound. Maybe she bounced somewhat from her prior win in 1:52.2, but she clearly wasn't at her best last Sunday at the Red Mile when she gave way tamely to fillies she had beaten with regularity prior. Griff regressed last out in the Champlain when she made an early break, and that came following two improbable wins with rallies coming from out of nowhere. Show Me is another that will have just five days off in between his most recent race, a maiden breaking score in his sixth career try. He did well for himself to win when taking it to favorite International Law who broke, and then did enough to hold off a couple others that were closing.

\$970,000 METRO PACE FINAL – 2-YEAR-OLD OPEN

For \$970,000, this year's Metro is just \$30,000 shy of giving Woodbine Mohawk Park what would have been two separate million-dollar races on the same card. And in a bit of an oddity, all horses from the Metro elimination won by Legendary Hanover

A win from either of these fillies [Drawn Impression and Emoji Hanover] would not only add to their own career, but also to the story of Emoticon Hanover as well as give Determination and Blais a win in the Mohawk Million; a race that they've been part of since day one.

drew posts 1 through 5, and all horses from the elimination won by Clever Cody have drawn the outside posts 6 through 10.

In the Metro, Legendary Hanover will look to keep his perfect career record of six-for-six intact. He won his elimination last week comfortably after getting away fourth from post 8 and then brushing to the lead and never looking back from there. He's twice won in 1:50, perhaps here in the Metro he may be able to crack that barrier.

Seemingly habitual slow starter Captains Quarters got caught on the inside throughout his elimination in a race where nothing really went his way. Good thing that was only an elimination, and once he was able to angle in the stretch, he had plenty of pace as shown by that :25.2 final quarter. Lou's World outraced his elimination odds at 92-1 on the driver change to Todd McCarthy when he came first over all the way from seventh and was able to get into second through the stretch as pocket sitter and well supported Chain Gang backed away from that spot. Clever Cody comes off a lifetime best mile of 1:50.4 when he won his elimination holding sway throughout, Ohio invader showed he will be a threat. Remember The Alamo got a 2-hole trip in his elimination but needed a little bit more late. Gem Quality wasn't bad in his elimination when he continued to press on despite the first-over grind.

\$540,000 SHES A GREAT LADY FINAL – 2-YEAR-OLD FILLIES

The top two fillies in both eliminations threw down last week and it'll be fascinating to see what comes now as all four collide in the final. Caviart Belle and her impeccable record is still the one to beat and will warrant her role as race favorite, though Odds On Platinum did put a brief scare into her in last week's elimination. For Odds On Platinum, she'll try to win the same race as a 2-year-old that her dam, American Jewel won and set a world record at the time in doing so, when she won the Shes A Great Lady in 2011. Last week, Odds On Platinum tracked

Caviart Belle intently halfway through the stretch and when she angled out to take her shot, it looked like she had momentum and thought for sure she was going to go by. But to her credit, Caviart Belle was emboldened by the challenge and came right back and ended up prevailing by a half-length in the end.

In the other elimination, It's A Love Thing and My Girl EJ similarly had the race late to themselves as well. My Girl EJ was coming off that race against Geocentric when she raced unbelievably well and stands another solid chance to shine. It's A Love Thing used all of that fast final quarter of :25 and change to keep My Girl EJ in second and she continues to fire every race. Gets another shot at Caviart Belle.

\$381,000 ELEGANTIMAGE – 3-YEAR-OLD FILLIES

After just missing by a neck in the Hambletonian Oaks, Bond has come back to win close calls in her last couple, including last week's Elegantimage elimination. In winning her race last week in 1:52.1, she was a full second quicker than fellow elimination winner Righteous Resolve.

In Bond's elimination, she was handled aggressively making multiple moves to the lead and had enough left to stave off a late push from Rose Run Yolanda on the inside who found late clearance to come up just a neck short. In that race, Call Me Goo popped out around the final turn to take her chance but still found herself a length or two down. Tactical Mounds made a belated uncovered move from far back and closed well too late.

Righteous Resolve went coast to coast and easily denied pocket sitter Baroness Hill. Quick Stop, who sat last out of six for most of the race, rallied wide from an impossible spot to nail down second when she closed in :26.2.

\$660,000 CANADIAN TROTTING CLASSIC – 3-YEAR-OLD OPEN

This group is a pretty well-known commodity by now and Up Your Deo looked about as good as ever when he ran up the score in his elimination win in a career best time of 1:51.2. It did come off a perfect pocket trip but any repeat of that try would seemingly make him tough to beat now with the big money on the line.

In the other relatively uneventful elimination in which no real racing took place until the final quarter mile, Celebrity Bambino returned to the winner's circle off a second over trip. In that race, both the leader and first over horses tired, and Celebrity Bambino was able to capitalize off the trip and hold off third-over horse Winners Bet by a neck. Gaines Hanover was right there as well to those horses inside in another honest effort.

Raber-owned fillies a formidable pair in Kentuckiana trot

Ryan Raber, a mere 21 years old, purchased his first standardbred at the 2019 Hoosier Classic Sale. In that short window of time, the Montgomery, IN, resident has fared well in the business with multiple winners. Tonight (Sept. 22), a pair of fillies he owns in partnership will vie for top prize in the \$260,000 Kentuckiana Stallion Management stake for freshman trotters. Skyway Paige is the 5-2 morning line favorite, while Crystal Swan is 15-1. Both 2-year-olds are trained by Susan Miller, wife of horseman LeWayne Miller.

"I couldn't be more blessed," Raber said of owning the fillies, each set for their biggest test thus far. "I'm just lucky to have the opportunity. I never dreamed I would be in this position."

The young owner has grown up around horses. The son of Loren "Short" Raber, proprietor of Hoosier Standardbred Farm, Ryan learned the breeding side of the business and regularly attended the Hoosier Classic each fall when the farm sold its annual consignment. At age 17, he decided to buy his first horse, Country Girl Charm. That initial selection sent him down a path of immediate success.

"She was a Whom Shall I Fear and I gave \$6,000 for her at the Hoosier Classic sale," Ryan said. "I got her trained down at home and she turned out to be a decent horse."

Decent is an understatement. When Ryan believed she was ready to qualify as a 2-year-old, he reached out to LeWayne Miller. Once in his stable, Miller liked the filly so much, he bought a stake in the trotter. Over three seasons and a handful of starts at age 5, the mare collected 10 wins and hit the board another 14 times in 42 attempts. Country Girl Charm took a sophomore mark of 1:54.2 at Harrah's Hoosier Park and finished her career with \$333,825 in earnings.

"I'm not a big fan of racing aged horses," Ryan said. "We did a little with her just because she was so special. We still have her now. She's actually in foal with her first baby."

Along the way, Ryan sold more pieces of the filly, and today, the ownership group includes D&S Stable in Montgomery and JW Stable, located in Milroy.

“I was just getting started and it pretty much took everything I had to buy her and get her conditioned,” he said. “I sold pieces of her as I went along and that really got me jump started.”

The experience with Country Girl Charm solidified Ryan’s involvement in racing and forged a partnership with Miller that remains strong. Ryan has bought into other horses Miller owns or trains, and he purchases yearlings each fall and gets them started at home in Southern Indiana before turning them over in the spring. Last fall he purchased Skyway Paige at the Hoosier Classic sale for \$10,000. Then, Miller offered a chance to buy into Crystal Swan after he signed the ticket for \$25,000. Ryan initially passed.

“If I buy a horse, I’m hands on,” Ryan said. “I don’t really go by another man’s word. I like to see the horse myself. LeWayne said there is a piece available. I told him no at the time of the sale. She sold Friday, so I went back that night and looked at her and something about her caught my eye. I called him back and said, ‘I’d like to have a quarter if I can.’ Her mother and Country Girl Charm’s mother are sisters, so that immediately grabbed my attention.”

Miller broke and trained Crystal Swan while Ryan developed Skyway Paige at his Montgomery farm. Country Girl Charm’s success paved the way for the installation of a half-mile track. Three weeks before she was set to qualify, he shipped the Swan For All freshman to Miller in central Indiana.

“I like to train them around 2:05 before I bring them to the big track,” Ryan said. “A lot of times if I train them in 2:05, they are ready to qualify right away. I trained Skyway Paige there in 2:07.”

Bred by Ken Slabach, Skyway Paige is the third foal from Cantab Hall mare Prismatica, a winner of more than \$200,000 on the track. She is a 100-per cent producer, with Skyway Paige her richest (\$106,545 to date) so far. The filly has hit the board in seven of eight seasonal starts, with three wins for the partnership of Ryan, his father Short (Hoosier Standardbred), Miller (L & S Racing), and Anthony Swartzentruber. The freshman trotter enters the Kentuckiana with back-to-back victories in Indiana Sires Stakes action, taking her 1:55.3 speed badge two starts back. She currently ranks second to Ponda Title in sires stakes divisional points. Dexter Dunn is slated to drive Friday, and the duo will start from post 5.

“She’s been drawing outside in all the sires stakes races,” Ryan said. “She drew the 5-hole, which I think is the winningest post here at Hoosier, so we’ll see.”

Crystal Swan, now owned in partnership by Ryan, First Chance Stable, Platinum Stable and David Postman, finished fourth her last time out, also an Indiana Sires Stakes leg. The Swan For All lass is the first foal from Dejarmbro mare Tymal Hurricane. She is a three-time winner, including a sires stakes score (1:55.4) and a Grand Circuit win at the Indiana State Fair. Bred by Benjamin Graber, the winner of \$82,738 has been assigned post 4, with Miller set to drive.

“Crystal was a gorgeous filly out of a great family, so we made her eligible,” Ryan said. “She is also Breeders Crown eligible.”

The owner’s motivation for staking the fillies to the Kentuckiana ties back to Country Girl Charm, who was not eligible to the race as a freshman.

“I missed it with Country Girl Charm and it looked like she would have been okay in there with the way the race turned out,” he said. “I decided I didn’t want to miss that opportunity again.”

No matter the outcome of tonight’s race, Ryan is pleased to have a piece of two quality trotting fillies that have already achieved considerable success this season.

“When I bought Country Girl Charm, my dad told me, ‘Enjoy it. You only get one of these in a lifetime,’” Ryan said. “Now both of these fillies have records faster than she did as a 2-year-old, and Skyway Paige is closing in on her 2-year-old earnings. I’ve been very fortunate; very lucky.”

The Kentuckiana Stallion Management stake for freshman filly trotters is programmed as race 6, with a post time of 8:04 p.m. The event also includes Ponda Title, runner-up in last week’s Jim Doherty; Dozen, winner of five straight for Marcus Melander; Sambuca Hanover, victorious in four of six seasonal starts; and Graceful Design, third in the Doherty and Peaceful Way finals. Tonight’s Hoosier Park card is headlined by the \$210,000 Caesars Trotting Classic and several other open stakes. The 15-race card boasts purses of more than \$1.5 million.

He may not have been dropped into the box for the Kentucky or Commonwealth Series events, but **Arson** served notice he may be scorching any surface his hooves are upon when capturing his division of the \$50,000 Kentucky Goldenrod Series for freshman male pacers at Red Mile on Tuesday (Sept. 19) in 1:51.1. The event was one of eight \$50,000 finals for freshman and sophomore male and female trotters and pacers on a 14-race card.

Steered by Todd McCarthy, Arson commenced his mile as the public's top choice and deservedly so as the regally bred son of Captaintreacherous—Western Montana captured his last three starts in this company and extended his winning streak by a neck. Steely Knife (Yannick Gingras) gave the colt all he could handle but settled for second. Nuclear (Andy Miller) was third.

Owned by Thestable Arson Group and Hutchinson Harness the colt is conditioned by Eric Patalan. Arson was bred by Diamond Creek Farm and was purchased for \$85,000 at the 2021 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale.

The colt is the fifth foal out of his dam to exceed \$100,000 in purse money. He is a half-brother to: champion Pure Country (Somebeachsomewhere, \$2.43 million), Grand Teton (A Rocknroll Dance, \$564,639), Territory (Sweet Lou, \$215,453) and Charleston (Downbytheseaside, \$630,447).

Arson is also a half-brother to the unraced Geothermal, who is the dam of the sport's swiftest and top ranked horse, Confederate.

Congressional (Tim Tetrick, \$7.90) captured the pacing division for sophomore colt and geldings in 1:49. The son of Always B Miki—Betterluck Hanover is trained by Noel Daley.

He is owned by Michael Hall, Kdp Stable and Ctc Stable. He was bred by Roll The Dice Stable.

Swan Explosion (Peter Wrenn, \$9.64) visited the winner's circle in the 2-year-old colt and gelding trot after trotting home in 1:55.2.

Melanie Wrenn is the trainer for owners Bottom Line Racing, Wrenn Racing and Timothy Wittmer.

Swan Explosion was bred by Gabriella's LLC.

The Roxbury (David Miller, \$11.50) won the division for freshman filly trotters. The daughter of Walner—Paint The Corners is trained by Carter Pinske.

She is owned by Al Libfeld, her breeder.

Buckhead Ridge (Scott Zeron, \$22.82) won the contest for 3-year-old male pacers in 1:52.3. Trained by Gregg McNair, the son of Nuncio—Tuonela is owned by his trainer, Dean Lockhart and Brady Doyle.

He was bred by Russell Williams.

Maine glamour boys close out Farmington

Two \$14,000-plus divisions of the Maine Sire Stakes for 3-year-old male pacers closed out the harness racing meet at the Farmington Fair on Wednesday (Sept. 20), with a couple of the usual suspects finding the winners circle once again.

In the first and fastest \$14,692 split **Colt Bennett** came from off the pace to win his fourth race of the year in 1:58.

When the wings folded Mattucci (Heath Campbell, Valerie Grondin) fought for command from pylon position and led the field into a :29.1 opening panel. As the field passed the stands for the first time going to the half, Mattucci was well in control of the tempo, having set a comfortable :59.1 second quarter.

Walter Case, Jr. ranged So Rock N' Roll up first over and had collared the pacesetter by the third stanza in a snappy 1:28.4. The Marc Tardif-trained recent winner was on top at the head of the stretch, with a seemingly comfortable margin.

However, 'Double Digit' Dave Ingraham had other ideas and unleashed a torrid burst of speed with Colt Bennett to chase down the leader and prevail by a quarter length. Trained by David Crochere for owner Nancy Lombardi, it was the :28.4 final quarter that sealed the deal for the connections and gave the son of Rock N' Roll World his fourth win of the season. He was bred by Steve O'Toole.

Anthingforyoudear (Dan Deslandes, Marc Tardif) finished third.

Luke McGook redeemed his recent second place finishes to get back to winner's circle following an interrupted seven-race win streak.

Driven by Kevin Switzer, Jr. for trainer Marc Tardif, Luke McGook left little doubt about his intentions when the wings folded as he assumed his favorite position on the front end.

From that point Switzer set moderate fractions of :30.1; 1:02.1 and 1:32.3 while Two Towns Over (Aaron Hall, Valerie Grondin) maintained a tight pocket in anticipation of any diminishing pace. Rockaroundsam (Case, Jr., Tardif) came first over and got to within a half-length of the pacesetter at the third panel.

Nonetheless, Switzer found another gear with Luke McGook and the gelding responded with a :28.2 final quarter to prevail by a half-length in 2:01.

Town Towns Over finished second; Rockaroundsam was third.

Luke McGook is owned by Leighton Property and picked up his eighth seasonal victory. Bred in Maine by Erika Saucier, he is a son of Rock N' Roll World and now has over \$207,000 in lifetime earnings.

The Maine-sired Standardbreds invade the Cumberland Fair with the trotters on Wednesday (Sept. 27), the sophomore pacers on Friday (Sept. 29), and the \$240,000 (est.) freshman finals on Saturday (Sept. 30).

Owned and bred by Jan Donaway, South St Dottie now has \$66,285 in seasonal earnings with eight trips to the winner's circle.

Katelyn Angel (Kevin Switzer, Marc Tardif) was back a length and a half to be second; Ally Mac (Walter Case, Jr., Cain MacKenzie) was third.

The Tardif Taskforce sent **Pickmepickme** out from the outermost post position in the second division, where she came from off the pace to wrap up another victory in 2:00.

Driven by Andy Harrington, the daughter of Western Maverick was first over heading down the backside for the final time, and pulled away from the pack to win by 2-1/2 lengths.

Owned, trained and bred by Marc Tardif, it was the 13th victory of Pickmepickme's career, pushing her lifetime earnings to \$139,720.

La Mambacita (Heath Campbell, Valerie Grondin) set the fractions and settled for second; Justcallmemimi (Case, Jr., Graffam) was third.

Next week, the Maine-sired standardbreds transition over to the Cumberland Fair with the trotters on Wednesday (Sept. 27), the sophomore pacers on Friday (Sept. 29), and the \$240,000 (est.) freshman finals on Saturday (Oct. 2).

The folks in the Fair's mutuel department had such confidence that **Wabanaki's** \$15,166 Maine Sire Stakes for 3-year-old male trotters would have a predictable outcome, that they instituted place and show wagering only and barred the pre-ordained winner from the betting pools.

Davies took a seat in the heavy going with the son of Boy Band, and pulled his trusty steed out at the half to race uncovered through the third panel.

At the head of the stretch the gelding had gained some separation but had to fend off the late charge of 26-1 longshot Eustis (John Beckwith, Gordon Corey) who got within a half-length of Wabanaki when they tripped the timer in a soggy 2:04.3.

Owned by Anita 'Bunny' Anastosopoulos-Andrew, and bred by the late Mike Andrew, it was Wabanaki's sixth win of the season.

Eustis paid \$54.00 to place. Outlawofthevalley (Kevin Switzer, Jr., Marc Tardif) finished third.

In similar fashion, management determined that there would be no 'wild endings' in the \$14,952 filly trot. Thus, Davies' filly **Wild Ending** was unceremoniously barred from the wagering.

As expected, the dedicated daughter of Boy Band cruised coast-to-coast in 2:06.2 over the sloppy conditions to score by 4-3/4 lengths. Once again, owned by Anita 'Bunny' Anastosopoulos-Andrew, and bred by the late Mike Andrew, it was Wild Ending's sixth win of the season.

B R Glory (Andy Harrington, Lisa Watson) finished second and paid \$20.00 to place. Melania's Best (John Nason) was third.

Before the regular card, the 2-year-old trotters had their day in the liquid sunshine, where **Pembroke Breeze** cruised to victory in the \$14,367 Maine Sire Stakes for the frosh fillies.

Driven by Heath Campbell for trainer Valerie Grondin, the daughter of Pembroke Slugger made every call a winning one, scoring in 2:06 on a surface deemed 'good.'

Owned and bred by Bill Varney, it was the third seasonal victory for Pembroke Breeze. Twisted Venture (Mike Cushing, Sherry Cushing) finished second; Bernie's Legacy (Ivan Davies).

Bill Varney's 'Pembroke' moniker got another workout with **Pembroke Will** as that gelding took the \$13,971 event for 2-year-old male trotters in 2:10.1.

Varney owns and bred that son of Pembroke Slugger who was also driven by Campbell for trainer Grondin. Stable mate Chipper Dale (Grondin) made an uncharacteristic miscue and finished second.

Scioto race meet concludes

The 2023 racing season concluded at Eldorado Scioto Downs on Saturday (Sept. 16).

Chase H Hanover and Tony Hall took the last open pace of the year in 1:48.2. The 5-year-old gelding by Captaintreacherous was fresh off a fourth-place finish in the Jim Ewart Memorial Pace last weekend during Ohio Super Night. Chase H Hanover, owned by Bottom Line Racing and Carl Howard, is trained by Scioto's leading trainer Virgil Morgan, Jr.

Morgan took top training honors for the 29th consecutive season, with 109 wins in 430 starts and \$1.65-million in earnings.

Dan Noble was the meet's leading driver with 175 wins in 1,036 starts and \$2.7-million in earnings. Noble, the son of Harness Racing Hall of Fame member Sam "Chip" Noble III, also surpassed 7,000 in career lifetime wins during the Scioto season.

The 90-day Scioto race meet generated a 32 per cent increase in handle, over \$13-million, compared to 2022 numbers. The 2020 racing season, which saw Scioto be the first track open after the COVID-19 shutdown, produced the best wagering year in track history, and handle this year was only 1 per cent off from that historic year.

“We appreciate the support of our horsemen, fans and gamblers to make our 2023 season one of our best racing years yet,” said Jason Roth, Scioto’s director of racing. “The new grandstand brought a lot of positive energy, both from our fans and employees. We’re already looking forward to making 2024 even better yet.

The addition of Jenna [Otten, as on-air commentator], having our Super Night on Fox Sports and hosting the richest day in Ohio harness racing history, all contributed to our successful year and we look forward to expanding on that next year.”
