# Catching up with Brett Pelling

*Nine months after his return to the United States, the former top trainer said he is finally ready to gear up to make a serious run at the track.*

Nine months after returning to the United States from Australia and more than 11 years after he last trained a top stakes barn, trainer Brett Pelling said this week he is finally ready to make a more noticeable return to the track.

"I thought that my work authorization would go through in, like, 45 days and it ended up taking basically six months. I just got it a month ago. So, now I'm good, but, you know, I couldn't take risks," Pelling said. "So I just kind of laid low and mucked around with a couple horses that I bought myself the year before and just kept working on getting the papers through. It's disappointing. I would have liked to race a bit through the summer, but it just didn't happen."

Pelling, now 59, left the game and the United States at the top of the sport in January of 2006 to move his family to Australia. In January, he announced he was returning in an article in HRU ([full story here](#)) that also included his candid thoughts on the sport. Rarely shy about expressing himself, Pelling was happy to share a few thoughts this week about the state of the game as he drove from New Jersey to Kentucky.

To date, Pelling is training just a handful of horses and has made just 18 purse starts in 2017, but said, "We're growing. My son is here with me. We've got another guy that we've hired on... I've got people ready to go."

Pelling said he is grateful to Winbak Farms for giving him a couple of horses to train.

Asked if he's enjoyed his return to the game, Pelling said it's been good to see old friends.

"I enjoy being around the people that I've known for a long time and getting back on the road to see familiar places. I like being busy, so I've definitely enjoyed that," he said.

"I'm (based) at White Birch Farm (in New Jersey), same as before. Actually, it's White Birch's own barn, which is a really beautiful barn. Joe Parisi, when he bought it, he spared

nothing. It would be one of the most gorgeous barns that you could ever be in. It's pretty cool.

"I've got to buy a place to live, so we're kind of in the middle of finding a place right now. Hopefully, I'll get that sorted out, but there's a lot of work involved."

Pelling said studying pedigrees in preparation for the fall yearling sales was an eye-opener.

"I've been away for 10 years. People say, 'What do you think about the horses?' And I said, 'You know what? The trotters are unreal. The trotters have gone about three generations in one generation. It is unreal how many good trotters there are that can just trot fast, trot easy. I think they've gone leaps and bounds,'" Pelling said.

His take on the families of the sport's top pacing stallions is not as glowing.

"The pacers have gone a step backwards. I'd go on the record saying that I believe the pacers are not what they were. The trotters have gone leaps and bounds."

Pelling said he is in the market for some yearlings and would like to train a stable of 30, but he doesn't want to train just anything for anyone.

"I'd rather be a little particular and keep control of it," he

said. "I'm not out there hustling. If you're a good owner, you're usually already with someone and you've got a good relationship so I'm not looking to take any owner from anybody. So, that makes it a little difficult.

"I want to buy a couple myself, anyway. I want to keep that going."

Picking out yearlings is complicated, Pelling said, by the fact that he views Pennsylvania, the top jurisdiction for sires, as being overly protectionist of its residents. When residency is a primary criteria for getting horses in to race, Pelling said it can be a disincentive for people living outside the state to buy Pennsylvania bred.

Pelling said he also worries New York will soon follow Pennsylvania's lead to try to keep as much of the slot money in the state, as well.

"It's been interesting watching the lay of the land," Pelling said.

## 57 facts about Jimmy Takter on his 57th birthday

Hall of Fame trainer Jimmy Takter turns 57 today (Sept. 30). To celebrate, here's 57 facts about him.

Happy 57th birthday to trainer Jimmy Takter (shown with wife Christina in the winner's circle Friday night at Red Mile after Manhego remained perfect lifetime with her ninth straight win).

1. The **first** world record he set was with Sir Taurus in 1:57.2 on July 13, 1987 at Yonkers in a \$152,300 NYSS event. The record was for a three-year-old trotting colt on a half-mile track.
2. **Twice** he has qualified a male and a female in record time:  
Male – Always B Miki in 1:48.2 at Red Mile on Sept. 25, 2015  
Female – Pure Country this summer in 1:48
3. He won **three** Breeders Crowns, minimum, for five straight years – not counting his 2015 total of 6. That makes 30 Breeders Crowns total for Takter and 18 since his Hall Of Fame Induction Day of 2012.
4. He had **four** different drivers for his four Hambletonian winners: Mal Burroughs in 1997 with Malabar Man, Ron Pierce in 2010 with Muscle Massive, Jimmy himself in 2014

with Trixton and Brian Sears with Pinkman in 2015.

5. He will be shooting for **five** straight Hambletonian Oaks triumphs in 2018.

6. **Six** was the age of Moni Maker in 1999 when she won the second of her two straight Horse of the Year titles. This is the last time anyone has repeated as HOY.

7. There are **seven** combined Hambletonians between Takter and fellow Swede Per Eriksson.

8. Takter is the only trainer to have the HOY on two continents in the very same year – Kramer Boy in 1997 in Sweden and Malabar Man in 1997 in the U.S.

9. Takter's first Hambletonian appearance was also John Campbell's first Hambletonian win. In 1987, Sir Taurus didn't get any money in the final that Mack Lobell won.

10. Twice Takter has finished 1-2 in the Hambletonian at the Meadowlands. No other trainer can say this. **Ten** years ago, Malabar Man won and Take Chances was second. In 2014, Trixton won and Nuncio was second.

11. **Eleven** years ago, Takter sent out the runnerup in the HOY ballot – Passionate Glide. It was also 11 years ago that Takter debuted in the Little Brown Jug and won it with Mr Feelgood with Mark MacDonald also winning in his first attempt.

12. Takter trainee Always B Miki has **12** wins in 2016 en route to a HOY season in which he also became the fastest standardbred of all time (1:46). It was the fourth HOY for Takter but his first with a pacer.

13. There were **13** years between Takter's first and second Hambletonian wins – 1997 with Malabar Man and 2010 Muscle Massive.

14. The last two times the Hambletonian has been won by a trainer back to back, both were Swedes and both were born in 1960. Per Eriksson won in 1991 and 1992 with Giant Victory and Alf Palema, respectively. Takter won in 2014 and 2015 with Trixton and Pinkman, respectively.

15. Pinkman is Takter's richest single-season performer (\$1.9

million in 2015). Not bad-considering that he was catalogued at the Standardbred Sale in Harrisburg as a two-year-old before being withdrawn.

16. Two decades ago, Takter took over the training of Moni Maker (1997) and she would go on to become the richest female performer in the sport's history.

17. Takter and daughter Nancy Johansson are the only father/daughter combo to each have HOY trophies. Takter with four and Johansson taking hers home in 2014 with J K She's A Lady.

18. Takter is the second leading trainer of all time in earnings (near \$125 million. USTA trainer stats begin only in 1992).

19. Takter worked for Soren Nordin among others early on. Soren, who passed away at age 91 and won his last race at 82, would have been 100 this past Sept. 5.

20. Takter homebred See You At Peelers won her first 22 starts and was a two-time divisional winner. Vintage Master lost his first **20** starts for Takter, but went on to bank well over \$2 million.

21. Back in 1985, on the second of five Statue Of Liberty Nights, Takter and his father Bo drove in back-to-back races in the trotting stakes on the card. Bo had Ellizar H from post 10 in the Statue Of Liberty for \$150,000 at a flat mile and Jimmy, just 24, had Bandolino in the Hiram Woodruff in the very next race.

22. Takter's all-time winning percentage at the Meadowlands is **22.7** per cent. That's even more impressive when you consider how often he races multiple horses in the same event.

23. Takter's 30 total Breeders Crown wins is one more than the combined total of Breeders' Cup wins between the two leading money-winning trainers in thoroughbred history – Todd Pletcher has won nine Cups and his one-time mentor D. Wayne Lukas has won 20.

24. Takter is a six-time Trainer Of The Year and is going for his fourth straight. He won his first in 1996.

25. Takter is the only trainer to send out a Meadowlands Hambletonian favorite from post 10 (2014 – Father Patrick).

26. In 2014, there were 314 ballots cast for the best three-year-old trotting colts and fillies and 313-out-of-314 went to a Takter trainee. In the colts' division, Takter's Father Patrick (94), Nuncio (57) and Trixton (five) earned 161 votes (trainer Charlie Norris had one vote for Datsyuk). In the fillies' division, Takter's Shake It Cerry received 156 votes and his Lifetime Pursuit earned one vote.

27. In 2014, Takter sent out the top five winningest trotters in the sport. They combined for \$6,070,149. This total was more than the next 16 earners combined.

28. Only Takter has had a female trotter timed in sub-1:50 in a race at the Meadowlands. Shake It Cerry was timed the same as J L Cruze in 2015 in his record 1:49.4 effort.

29. Billy Haughton drove the Hambletonian winner in 1980 (Burgomeister) while his entymate (Final Score) was second. Takter drove Trixton to victory in the 2014 Hambletonian while his entymate (Nuncio) was second. In both cases, the trainer/driver who was victorious was not driving the divisional winner. Tommy Haughton drove Final Score and Yannick Gingras drove Father Patrick, who broke at the start and lost all chance as the public's choice.

30. Takter has won 30 Breeders Crowns.

31. Takter is the first trainer since Stanley Dancer to have had both the fastest trotter and the fastest pacer of all time. Dancer in the 1970s had Albatross and his sub 1:55 efforts, after having Nevele Pride become history's fastest trotter in 1969. Jimmy Takter had Always B Miki in 2017 at 1:46 and Tom Ridge on Labor Day weekend of 2004 establishing the all-age mark of 1:50.2.

32. Jimmy has not won a Hambletonian in the 21st century with a favorite. Malabar Man did it at 1-5 in 1997, but Muscle Massive was 6-1 in 2010, Trixton and Nuncio were the two choices after Father Patrick in 2014 and Pinkman was second choice to the lady Mission Brief in 2015. (Note: Takter was favored in 2004 with Tom Ridge (eighth) and with Bar Hopping in 2016 (fourth)).

33. Nine of the 33 Hambletonians since 1985 have been won by Swedes – 1985-1991-1992 Per Eriksson, 1988 Jan Johnson, 2017 Ake Svanstedt and the four by Takter 1997-2010-2014-2015

34. Cabrini Hanover was Takter's first foray into the high-end pacing game. In 2004, she set the world record for a two-year-old filly pacer (1:51) the same weekend Takter set the all-age trotting mark with Tom Ridge at 1:50.2.

35. Creatine (driven by Johnny Takter) won the 2015 Breeders Crown and gave the Takter brothers the distinction of being the second set of driving brothers to each drive a Breeders Crown winner. Earlier that same night, Trace Tetrack completed the Timmy-Trace double.

36. Takter was 36 when he won his first Hambletonian with Malabar Man in 1997.

37. Could "7s" be wild again for the trotters? Consider that in each of the last five decades ending in a "7" the Horse of the Year was a trotter and a decisive winner (Nevele Pride in 1967, Green Speed in 1977, Mack Lobell in 1987, Malabar Man in 1997, Donato Hanover in 2007). Can Takter's Ariana G get it done in 2017?

38. Takter is the only trainer in history to condition a winner of a million-dollar race with an amateur driver – Mal Burroughs with Malabar Man in the Hambletonian in 1997.

39. Takter twice trained a colt who would go on to sire either a HOY or the fastest trotter ever.

Takter's Enjoy Lavec sired Enough Talk (1:49.3 in 2008) and San Pellegrino sired San Pail (HOY in 2011).

40. Takter is the second leading money-winning trainer behind only Ron Burke.

41. Takter's first winning drive in the U.S. came several weeks before Stanley Dancer's last Hambletonian win. Takter with Baltic Speed in the summer of 1983, the year Duenna won the Hambletonian for Dancer.

42. "Stanley Dancer is the one guy I really wished I had worked for years ago," Takter once said.

43. Takter has trained pacers, trotters, males and females that have won Horse of the Year.

44. The last female to win an elimination of the

Hambletonian was Takter's Pampered Princess in 2007.

45. Takter had his three \$10 million+ seasons consecutively – 2014-2015-2016.

46. Southwind Allaire was 25-1 when she upset in the Hambletonian Oaks in 2003. It is the largest win price for any of the Oaks or Hambletonian winners sent out by Takter.

47. Mr Lavec was the 1994 Hambletonian runnerup for Takter. He was from the first European-sired crop of Speedy Somolli and he was raised in Ireland.

48. Takter's 2010 Hambletonian winner was the \$425,000 yearling Muscle Massive. He was the third straight son of Muscles Yankee to capture the Hambletonian. Takter's world record setter Tom Ridge was also a son of the 1998 Hambletonian winner Muscles Yankee.

49. Drivers and trainers 50 or older to win the Hambletonian at the Meadowlands: Stanley Dancer (56) in 1983 with Duenna; Ray Schnittker (50) in 2008 with Deweycheatumnhowe; Roger Hammer (59) in 2005 with Vivid Photo and Takter (53) in 2014 with Trixton.

50. Takter's brother Johnny won the Peter Haughton for Jimmy with Weingartner.

51. Takter's first year in the U.S. was 1977, the year that Green Speed was the Hambletonian-Yonkers Trot winner and HOY. Billy Haughton won the Hambletonian for the second

straight year (following Steve Lobell in 1976). Takter later won both of those races consecutively – the Yonkers Trot 2009-2010-2011 and the Hambletonian in 2014-2015.

52. Takter's first ever driving winner was a 42-1 longshot named Air Money Jagersto in Sweden at age 18.

53. The first wave of top-notch horses trained by Takter on his own included: Genuine Comfort, On A Cruise, Classic Air and Sir Taurus in the mid-late 1980s.

54. Ariana G (#1) was ranked ahead of Walner (#2) this year on the Hoof Beats Predictive Rankings.

55. Takter was named the 1988 Sports Eye "Newcomer Of The Year".

56. The first time Takter had the two-year-old colt and filly trotters of the year was in 1996 when Malabar Man and Armbro Prowess took the respective awards.

57. Though Takter hasn't had a Triple Crown winner yet, he did win all the Trotting Triple Crown events of 2014 but with different colts – Nuncio in the Kentucky Futurity and the Yonkers Trot and Trixton in the Hambletonian.

## Handicapping Sunday's star-laden Red Mile card

Red Mile's two-week Grand Circuit meet began this week and Sunday marks one of the best racing days to be found anywhere on the calendar this year to date. Featured throughout 11 divisions of the Bluegrass where sophomore pacers and trotters will rule the day are both the Little Brown Jug and Jugette winners, and a highly anticipated matchup between Jug winner Filibuster Hanover and the horse that missed the Jug, Huntsville.

**Race 1:** AIN'T THREE OK has banked nearly \$100,000 on the season but somehow hasn't landed in the winner's circle yet, although she does show five runner-up finishes to her credit. She was actually pretty good last out in the Nadia Lobell as a big longshot and now goes first time Sears. TEQUILLA MONDAY did as well as she could in Delaware when trying to come from off the pace both times in the Jugette; NYSS star deserves to be favored in here. ELLA CHRISTINA beat eventual Jugette winner Caviart Ally at Philly three back but was a non-factor in the Jugette; I'd be surprised if she beat these on the big track. I'm not sure if I'd accept a price on ROARING TO GO of anything under 5-1. **Picks: 4-3-5-1**

**Race 2:** BOOGIE SHUFFLE won in 1:48:2 four back at Philly when he beat Filibuster Hanover and is one of the "now" horses of this group. Harder trainee was doomed by the posts in the Jug, but he'll take a ton of action in here and probably should end up as the favorite. MISO FAST looked for awhile to be just one step below the top three horses in this division earlier in the season, but hasn't been able to win in some time; is just two-for-17 on the year. MAROMA BEACH goes for Burke and gets Gingras; worth keeping an eye on. **Picks: 2-6-4-5**

**Race 3:** This looks like a spot where VICTOR GIO T would have to show something in order to keep competing against these types; the move to the inside will help. BILL'S MAN is going the better of the two Butenschoen trainee's in here.

JAKE goes for the hot barn. **Picks: 1-3-7-4**

**Race 5:** CAVIART ALLY pulled pocket on Blazin Britches in the Jugette final and wore that rival down in the stretch through guts and determination; Noel Daley filly couldn't be any sharper right now. Between the heat racing 10 days ago and shipping since then I suppose she could "bounce," but she's so much the best that it shouldn't matter.

**Race 6:** This division of the Bluegrass for 3-year-old fillies features the new #1 ARIANA G is now tops in the Breeders Crown/Hambletonian Society Top 10 poll and looks to continue her customary dominance in this group. DREAM TOGETHER gave it an honest shot against the champ in the Elegance but couldn't trot with her late; figures to be up close again. CAVIART WONDER breaks but isn't worse than most of these. SUNSHINE DELIGHT exits a career performance. **Picks: 2-3-1-4**

**Race 8:** DREAM BABY DREAM is better than that one-for-12 record this year indicates with Rod Allen and seems due for something more. She trotted the same final quarter time last out as Ariana G for what that's worth and is playable for win in this race. What do we do with FEED YOUR HEAD? Her early September Mohawk form was phenomenal but it's now her first race in three weeks on the heels of two straight sick scratches. That said, I'd expect Takter to have her ready. ICE ATTRACTION pops up with a good one every now and then; beat similar on Hambletonian day. **Picks: 4-1-6-3**

**Race 11:** This race features Meadowlands Pace winner Huntsville against newly crowned Little Brown Jug winner Filibuster Hanover and I can't wait to see what we get from these today. Filibuster Hanover has made one more start this year than Huntsville (14 to 13) but he seems to have been put through less wear and tear. His Jug win was foreshadowed by that PASS Final at Philly last month and Burke has him going great guns at the moment; gets the big test for class now. HUNTSVILLE tuned up for this race with a big win in the Jenna's Beach Boy at Hoosier last week and that Sept. 3 PASS loss doesn't look as bad now once we see what that race produced. OCEAN COLONY is the best of the rest. **Picks: 1-5-3-6**

**Race 12:** What The Hill got his due last out in the Canadian Trotting Classic when he won easily in 1:51.4 off a perfect 2-hole trip. He now makes his third start back since having a throat procedure following the Hambletonian and is one of a few from this barn that are peaking right now in early fall; fires out again. LONG TOM set a good clip up front in the CTC and ran out of steam in the late stages; I wouldn't be too quick to dismiss. DEVIOUS MAN is another that's likely to show speed but if he hasn't been able to last on the front at Yonkers, is he going to last here? He'll look to sit a trip if possible. INTERNATIONAL MONI didn't pack the same closing kick in Canada that he did there earlier in the year; would need a bit of a reversal now. **Picks: 6-3-4-8**

**Race 13:** ART SCENE didn't get the trip last out at Hoosier and ended up finishing a non-threatening fourth, but that's okay. His mile two back at Mohawk was vicious and he should find this group more to his liking; bounces back now. MAJOR MOE shows two straight :26 and change final quarters and deserves respect coming from the barn of Brian Brown; can figure for a share. BLOOD LINE has been overmatched in almost all of his starts this year and will

have every chance to win this if good enough. EDDARD HANOVER is a player if you forgive his most recent. **Picks: 6-4-2-5**

## Custom Cantab more than exceeds yearling price

*The top Indiana Sires Stakes performer cost just \$6,000 as a yearling, but has delivered big for trainer Chris Beaver.*

Ohio horseman Chris Beaver looked for a way to compete in the Indiana Sires Stakes program without breaking the bank to do so. The last two years he has come to the Hoosier State to purchase a few yearlings that don't put a significant dent on the wallet while showing upside. After a few attempts, he has found the sires stakes competitor he sought in trotter Custom Cantab.

When it came to selecting this trotting filly out of last year's Hoosier Classic sale, it wasn't a complete roll of the dice. The yearling, out of Tagliabue mare Custom Model, was a half-sister to a trotter Beaver had in his barn named My Ghost Bi, sired by Chocolatier.

"I had a brother to this horse and he was a big, coarse horse. He just wasn't real fast. This was the third foal," the trainer and co-owner said. "There is nothing special with the way she looks, but she looks a lot better than what the mare had previously."

Selling in the first session of the Hoosier Classic sale, Beaver purchased Custom Cantab for a reasonable \$6,000

final bid. The price signaled the value the conditioner was looking for in a yearling. While babies sired by Swan For All and the first crop of Guccio brought considerably more, the offspring of Mr Cantab weren't nearly as appealing to buyers.

"I bought two Mr Cantabs last year because they were a value. For some reason, the guys over there were way off on them," Beaver said. "They weren't selling very high. I couldn't afford Swan For Alls, and Guccios were selling high. I was looking for something that wouldn't cost a whole lot but I thought had an upside."

This season, Mr Cantab's freshman crop has delivered at Hoosier Park Racing & Casino. From 38 starters, the sire has produced 18 winners with earnings of just under \$500,000. That group is led by Custom Cantab and River Otter, a trotting colt that has already won a \$75,000 Indiana Sires Stakes final and has seasonal earnings closing on \$100,000. In short order, Custom Cantab has become the second richest performer for Mr Cantab, with \$169,000 on her card this year, and the fourth fastest from his first four crops. Despite total progeny earnings of more than \$4 million to date, and represented by millionaire and Centaur Trotting Classic champion Homicide Hunter, Beaver said the scuttlebutt on the sire wasn't positive.

"Everyone had told me that these horses, when they get to where they're racing, they get sour and they don't want to do it. I was always a little guarded," he said of training down his filly. "I trained her a lot out of a hole with that in mind. I just figured we'll get there and we'll find out if she's any good."

As the time came to bring the filly to the races, Beaver was anxious to see how she would respond to competitive action. Owned by the trainer in partnership with Donald Robinson and R B H Ventures Inc., Custom Cantab soon displayed the upside Beaver wanted. Competing for the first time in Indiana Sires Stakes action July 4, the freshman finished half a length behind Meadow Brook Grace in a time of 1:57.3. One week later, she again raced second, this time in the \$80,000 ISS final. In the contest she covered the mile in 1:56.2 as O So Easy and trainer Verlin Yoder claimed victory. In those first starts Beaver knew he had a contender.

"The first time I raced her over there she trotted home a back half in :56 and a last quarter in :27 and change. I knew she was good enough," Beaver said. "I raced a couple over there the year before and one of them could trot in :59 or :58, but he couldn't put a big quarter together. I thought once I saw that she could trot a fast quarter that she would be good there, it was just a matter of making sure her attitude held out."

In the next round of ISS eliminations and final, Custom Cantab broke through for her first career wins. She trotted to a three-length triumph in the \$20,000 elimination before topping favorite O So Easy by half a length in 1:55.3. That victory locked the freshman into the \$200,000 Super Final in mid-October at Hoosier Park. Outside of those wins, however, Custom Cantab has had a run of "second-itis" with six races where she finished just out of the winner's circle, many times

trotting behind divisional rival O So Easy.

"To me, I race Grand Circuit some too, and I don't know that any filly in this country is any better than Verlin's," Beaver stated. "That's my opinion. That filly has raced hard a lot of times and she just keeps going."

In her latest runner-up performance, Custom Cantab didn't finish second to O So Easy. This time it came in Grand Circuit action at Hoosier Park. Drawing post 10 in the \$240,000 Kentuckiana Stallion Management Stake Friday, September 22, the trotter and driver Peter Wrenn managed to hit the wire nearly two lengths behind winner Basquiat. While the Jimmy Taker-trained filly established a new Hoosier Park track record via a 1:53.4 mile, Custom Cantab set her own personal mark, circling the oval in a time of 1:54.1.

"She's professional. She'll just sit in the hole and relax and drop the bit. She goes in a straight line. Somehow, even with the tough miles she's going, knock on wood, she doesn't seem to hurt herself doing it," Beaver said of his pupil. "I couldn't say that I imagined she would trot in 54 this year. That wouldn't be accurate. But she always trained well."

Beaver and his partners were looking for a horse with upside. What they have is a filly that could play spoiler in the lucrative super final. Win or lose, she has already delivered for her connections.

**Manchego** won her ninth start in a row, taking the fifth of five divisions of the \$330,000 Norman Woolworth Memorial Bluegrass Two-Year-Old Filly Trot on Friday at Red Mile.

The stakes event was sponsored by Arden Homestead Stable, E.T. Gerry & Peter Gerry, Margareta Wallenius, Kleberg, Stoner Manor Inc., Menhammer Stuteri Ab, Continental Stables, Jorgen Jahre Jr., and LST Stables,

Sent off the 1-9 favourite, Manchego sat third through a :30.1 opening quarter before brushing to the top approaching the half, timed in :59.3. Pressured to three-quarters by Ciao Dolce, who pulled first-over moving around the turn, Manchego soon drew away from the field off a 1:29.2 clip to win by seven lengths in 1:56.1 over Ciao Dolce and Southwind Angelica.

Manchego, by Muscle Hill out of the Cantab Hall mare Secret Magic, has amassed \$571,398 in earnings competing for the interests of Black Horse Racing, John Fielding and Herb Liverman. Trained by Jimmy Takter and driven by Yannick Gingras, she paid \$2.10 to win.

**Sevenbuyeleven** moved first-over around the final turn to take the first division of the Bluegrass in 1:55.1.

Getting away third, Sevenbuyeleven sat off a :28.3 quarter set by White Cheetah, who yielded for the pocket as odds-on favourite Front Circle challenged for the front by the half in :58. Corey Callahan tipped Sevenbuyeleven wide moving into the turn, matching strides with Front Circle at three-quarters

## Pasithea Face sets Dayton track record while winning Derby

*The trotting mare won the Dayton Trotting Derby in 1:53. Meanwhile, Rockin Ron won the Dayton Pacing Derby in 1:50.2.*

**Pasithea Face S** dominated in Friday evening's first Grand Circuit event at Hollywood Dayton Raceway, the \$167,000 Dayton Trotting Derby, with a 1:53 track record performance before the late-closing Rockin Ron stole the show in the \$140,000 Dayton Pacing Derby.

Driven by Tim Tetrick, the Swedish-bred Pasithea Face S trotted out from post four and took over the lead from insider JL Cruze (David Miller) during a :27 first quarter. She continued to lead through a half in :54.4 and turned away the 2-1 favoured mare Hannelore Hanover (Matt Kakaley), who was parked out the whole way leaving from post seven. Pasithea Face was left all alone on the lead by the 1:24.2 third quarter mark and cruised home in a three-length romp. Crazy Wow (Chris Page) came on to finish second ahead of JL Cruze.

Pasithea Face's 1:53 winning time was a new track record for older trotting mares. Jimmy Takter trains the five-year-old Muscle Hill–Jovelinotte mare, who notched her third stakes win since arriving in North America earlier this year, for Courant Inc. of Delray Beach, FL.

After finishing third last time out in the Maple Leaf Trot north of the border behind JL Cruze and winner Hannelore Hanover, Pasithea Face was sent postward as the 7-2 third choice in the Derby and paid \$9 to win. Hannelore Hanover finished seventh.

"I thought it was her race to win if I could get the lead," said Tetrick. "I put her in a bad spot two weeks ago in the

Maple Leaf Trot, but I knew she'd be good if I got her a clean trip tonight."

Leaving from the inside post position, Luck Be Withyou (Brett Miller) fired out to a quick two-length lead into a :26.3 opening quarter with seven starter Boston Red Rocks (Josh Sutton) moving up to challenge into the second panel. After a half in :54.4, Boston Red Rocks was on even terms with the early speedster and gained the advantage outside approaching three-quarters in 1:21.4. Luck Be Withyou fought back entering the stretch while Dealt A Winner (Aaron Merriman) rallied off cover.

However, Rockin Ron, who got away seventh and was positioned fourth-over in the outer flow tracking Missile J (Tim Tetrick), swept by on the far outside to prevail by one and three-quarter lengths in 1:50.2. Dealt A Winner finished second while Missile J secured third-place in a show photo finish with pocket pursuer Easy Lover Hanover (Doug McNair) and Mach It So (Ronnie Wrenn Jr.).

Rockin Ron paid \$12.60 to win as the 5-1 fourth wagering choice. McWicked, the 2-1 favourite, was buried inside and finished ninth.

Campaigned by Burke Racing Stable LLC, Weaver Bruscermi LLC and Rtc Stables Inc., Rockin Ron has won seven of 24 starts this year and 27 races in his career. With the victory, the five-year-old son of Real Desire and Im All A Roan passed the \$1 million mark for U.S. earnings.



## Hurrikane Empress, Southwind Avanti win at Freehold

Freehold Raceway played host to the \$55,300 Renaissance Final for two-year-old filly pacers Friday afternoon in a early race before the card.

Hurrikane Empress was parked to the quarter in :28 before taking the lead from Some Renditions. 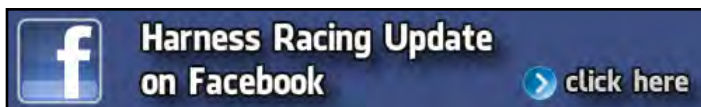

The National Thoroughbred Racing Association (NTRA) is reporting that the U.S. Treasury Department and the Internal Revenue Service have announced that they will formally adopt modernized regulations regarding the withholding and reporting of pari-mutuel proceeds.

The NTRA has long pressed for these updated regulations that will allow horseplayers to keep more of their winnings, thereby increasing the amount wagered on U.S. pari-mutuel racing by as much as 10 per cent annually, or upwards of \$1 billion, according to independent estimates.

## Horner responds to Faraldo

As usual, Joe Faraldo continues to be either a complete apologist for drug trainers (many of whom are his constituents) or imagines that issues are far more complicated than they really are. While desirable, an emphasis and required financial resources from regulators are unlikely given competing fiscal needs and the limited proceeds from wagering at most tracks, including Yonkers. Rules requiring increased owner accountability for trainer choice are not complicated, involve making choices which can be clearly defined and involve no "innuendo or slander" of anyone. They don't involve discretion or concerns of "favoritism"; they are rules.

He may not like where the lines are drawn but he is free to propose a different or no approach to this issue in his domain. Other jurisdictions and stake sponsors will act to protect integrity and promote accountability. The very weak nature of the objections he raises confirms the wisdom of the proposals. In at least that sense, he has done the industry a service.

## Gural's response to Clay Horner about Joe Faraldo

While I expected Joe (Faraldo) to agree with (Brett) Sturman, the reality is owners know who the bad guys are. The thing that amazed me over the last four years has been the fact that when we had excluded certain trainers with large stables from racing at my tracks not a single one of the owners called to ask why. How is it possible that a trainer could tell his client that his horses are no longer allowed to race at my three tracks without the owner wondering why?

I think this in itself makes it clear that these owners know

exactly why and from what I have seen most of the trainers we have excluded have seen the number of horses that they are training increase while the honest guys are down to a handful of horses and most of them are really struggling to survive.

Joe also knows that the states are not going to allocate more money for drug testing, however, I do agree with him that having boots on the ground investigations and using appropriate testing protocols at experienced labs will go a long way to solving the problem.

For myself, we are spending about \$300,000 this year on various protocols, including out of competition testing to try to make sure that anyone racing at my three tracks is racing on a level playing field. It is not easy to test everyone, obviously, and a degree of luck is required because of the timing nature of these illegal medications but we did come up with two positives as a result of our out of competition testing this year. If Joe was serious, I suggest he reach out to the other leaders of the horsemen in the states that are receiving the \$500 million per year subsidy and pass the hat and raise an additional \$700,000 to go along with the \$300,000 we are spending and I think we could put together a very strong effort with a \$1 million budget to rid the sport of cheats. I have put my money where my mouth is and hopefully the horsemen will do so, as well.

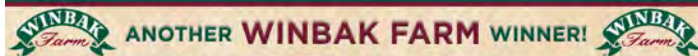
