Lexington sale's third session up year-over-year

On Wednesday, gross sales of \$11.6 million and an average of \$50,445 were up 7.9 per cent and 3.2 per cent, respectively, over 2024's third day numbers. Through three days, the sale has grossed \$52,519,000, down nearly 5 per cent from 2024.

Following a second session that was down compared to 2024, the sales numbers rebounded, somewhat, during the third session of the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale held Wednesday afternoon (Oct. 1) at the Fasig-Tipton sales pavilion.

The gross, average, median and number of horses that sold for \$100,000 or more were all up when compared to the third session in 2024.

On Wednesday, 229 yearlings grossed \$11,552,000, total, for an average of \$50,445 and a median of \$40,000. Twenty-eight yearlings sold for six figures. The gross was up 7.9 per

cent compared to the 2024 third-session gross of \$10,705,000. The average was up 3.2 per cent over the \$48,881 reached last year. The median was up 8.1 per cent over the \$37,000 median in 2024 when 24 yearlings were sold for \$100,000 or more.

However, this year's gross is down 7.3 per cent compared to the \$13,021,000 from the third session in 2023. The average is down 4.3 per cent compared to the '23 average of \$52,717, but the median was the same as two years ago when 29 yearlings sold for \$100,000 or more.

Through all three sessions, this year's auction has grossed \$52,519,000, which is down 4.8 per cent from last year (\$55,172,000) and off 10.2 per cent from the record sale of 2023 (\$58,485,000). The average of \$91,977 is down 6.1 per cent from the record of \$97,996 set in 2024 and down 4.5 per cent from the three-day average of \$96,351 two years ago. The cumulative median of \$60,000 is down 3.2 per cent from 2024 (\$62,000) and off 7.5 per cent from 2023 (\$67,000). So far, 180 horses have sold for \$100,000 or more, up from 178 in 2024, but down from 226 in 2023.

"We rebounded nicely this evening and had a great sale," said co-sales manager Bruce Brinkerhoff. "Pound for pound it was the best night of the auction so far. We look forward to continuing tomorrow and finishing the week strong and we appreciate all the support from the consignors and all the people that participated in bidding and buying."

Brinkerhoff's co-manager David Reid said, "The quick way to change your slight downward trend is just to predict we're going to be down and then we were up today. It was green arrows in gross, average, median, number over \$100,000. It shows the meat of the market a little bit and it was straight, right across, balanced in pacers, trotters, fillies and colts today. They were all right around that \$50,000 average, which, to me, bodes well because it just shows the strength of the middle market and I'm happy to see that. If there was some worry about where that middle was going to fall and to hold steady at that, year over year.

"The proven sires were strong and the freshman sires were strong. Captain Corey second crop was very good. Overall, I'm very happy with the results as of today."

Hip #394 Shoreline Station, a Sweet Lou colt out of Seaside Park consigned by Spring Station Bloodstock LLC topped the session with a winning bid of \$275,000 by trainer Linda Toscano. The dam is a sister to Captain Optimistic.

"[Shoreline Station is] just an outstanding individual, deep pedigree, current with the same family as Captain Optimistic doing so well," said Spring Station farm manager Josh Green. "He's a first foal out of a mare that people know as just a tough, tough filly that raced in Ohio that was better than maybe would have shown on paper. A beautiful colt – twitchy,

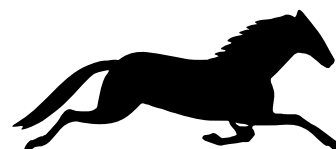

athletic, just an outstanding individual and maybe one of the best that we've sold so far.

"He was my favorite colt in our consignment and we had a lot of people interested in him. I am just absolutely thrilled that Linda Toscano and her team believed in him. We're actually going to retain a piece of him. She was nice enough to ask us to stay in for a piece with her partnership."

The only other yearling that sold for \$200,000 or more was **Hip #395 Hold The Bun**, a Captain Corey filly out of Bonnie Lou that sold for \$200,000 to Knutsson Trotting Inc. out of the Cameo Hills consignment.

Through three days, Cameo Hills is fifth in gross among consigners with \$4,035,000 in sales. With 35 sold, so far, the New York farm is averaging \$115,286.

"We've had a terrific sale," said Cameo Hills owner Steve Jones. "I thought coming down here that we probably would. We had nice pages and the right sires, nice individuals, and I would've been shocked if we didn't have a good sale. Somebody asked me before the sale last year how we were going to do and I was probably a little more excited than I should've been before the sale and thankfully it worked out last year.

"We expected to have a good sale. The weather has been great and the horses were well-received and we're very excited.

"I typically don't have a very tough time selling any colts that I have, but that Venerable colt [Hip #50, Valorous, \$575,000] that we sold the first night, I was very attached to that horse. I've said many times, that's the best-looking horse I've ever raised, so I felt pretty sure about that. Apparently, the people down here felt the same way. He's the highest-priced trotting colt sold the first night.

"We also sold a Chapter Seven colt the first night that Jeff Snyder bought that was also an unbelievable looking horse. [Hip #27, Tony Pro, \$425,000]."

Speaking of consignors having a great sale, Steve and Cindy Stewart's Hunterton Farm has topped \$10 million in sales though three days (\$10,770,000 to be exact) to lead all consignors. Hunterton has sold 84 yearlings, so far, and is averaging \$128,214.

"And we've got 40 left," said Cindy. I think 16 on the last day and 24 or 26 [Thursday].

"The one thing we don't do is, say we're going to do this or we're going to do that," Steve said. "The only comment I made earlier was that when you have half your consignment on the first two days, you're going to get a pretty good shot of doing pretty well."

Through three days, Preferred Equine is second in gross with \$7,662,000, followed by Kentuckiana Farms (\$6,187,000) and Crawford Farms (\$4,267,000).

“I’m very happy with Preferred,” said Reid, putting on his sales agency hat. “The customers are happy. You’ll always have a hiccup, but on the other hand there were some good surprises as well. Some of the dual eligible horses made the difference today, but overall, from a Preferred point of view, we’re marching right along and we’re pretty content for sure.”

On the buyer side, Ake Svanstedt leads with \$2.5 million spent, total, to purchase 14 yearlings.

“This is the place to go and find the right horses with the select breeding,” said Svanstedt’s wife, Sarah. “There’s so many nice horses to look at, both the fillies and the colts, and the nice families. The fillies, especially, seem to bring high numbers and obviously they have a second chance if they don’t hit on the racetrack, so it’s always fun and interesting. You want to try to find the golden egg. It’s a very joyful environment here.

On Tuesday, the Svanstedts topped the session by purchasing **Hip #182 Jimdougie Armitage** for \$750,000. The colt is a son of the Svanstedts’ Hambletonian champion Captain Corey.

“We looked at him many times on the video and the horse, too,” Sarah said. “It’s the group from Corey that wanted to have the colt. With the pedigree, it’s very interesting and, obviously, he hasn’t had great mares from last year so this year he had a little bit better. It was an expensive one, but let’s hope and fingers crossed that it’s going to work out because I’m so happy that Corey bloomed out. I love him so much. He really put a stamp on his babies, too, so that’s nice to see.”

Sarah said she and Ake are not done buying, yet.

“We’re still looking and going to shop more,” she said. “You’re trying to have at least the number that you’d like to have and then most of the time it ends up more than that. It depends on owners that find something that wasn’t planned or new owners and maybe you saved some money somewhere so you’ll try to put more into the group. We try to buy at least 15 here every year.”

Andrew Harris, agent for Bill Pollock, has spent \$2,285,000 to buy eight yearlings. He’s now second by gross. Marcus Melander has spent \$1,860,000 to purchase 13 yearlings.

Andy Miller led buyers during Wednesday’s session, spending \$595,000 to buy seven yearlings.

In the sire race, Walner still leads by a wide margin. Through three days, the leaderboard is:

- Walner – \$10,495,000 for 80 sold (\$131,188 average)
- Chapter Seven – \$7,045,000, 62, \$113,629

- Muscle Hill – \$4,063,000, 34, \$119,500
- Captain Corey – \$3,343,000, 29, \$115,276
- Bulldog Hanover – \$3,217,000, 35, \$91,914
- Captaintreacherous – \$3,184,000, 32, \$99,500

The fourth session of the sale begins today (Oct. 2) at 1 p.m.

“It should be consistent,” Reid said. “I don’t see any reason why it won’t be. There’s quality horses here tomorrow and that’s what is going to carry us forward. I don’t see a drop off in the catalog, so I expect the marketplace to be as strong as it was today or even last year. I’m looking forward to it and getting over today’s hump and we’ve got two more sessions... they’ll be a little shorter sessions.”

“It’s been a great week. Beautiful weather and great energy in the crowd. There was a good pace and finished at 7:12 p.m. tonight, so I was happy to see that and be able to get people out of here at a regular time so they can go out and enjoy the Lexington experience and see the town.”

“They’ve worked hard and it’s a long week so they deserve it. We’ll get through tomorrow, then Friday have a little racing action then come back here Friday night and then have a great weekend of racing to close it up.”

(Armitage Farm) of the Captain Corey colt who sold for \$750,000 (to Ake Svanstedt).

Steve and Cindy Stewart's Hunterton Sales Agency – who I proudly and affectionately call my sponsors – remain at the top of the consignors list through the two sessions with 60 sold for \$9.234 million. With Hunterton consigning a record 126 to the sale, they are only halfway done.

Favoritism for Favoritism

Caretaker Caity Hillier cheers on the little filly who could.

As industry focus shifts to yearling sales and the upcoming Breeders Crown, a foal with a late start to her career can get lost in the shuffle. Favoritism was born on June 10, 2023, the last of that year's foals born at Millar Farms of Stouffville, ON.

Now 2 years old, the pacing filly had a close connection to Caity Hillier from the very beginning. On the evening of the Bettors Delight daughter's first career start, the former Millar Farms caretaker visited Woodbine Mohawk Park to show her favoritism for Favoritism.

The Puslinch, ON horsewoman recalled the auspicious timing of the filly's birth. Favoritism's dam, Hidden Gem, went into labor as her most successful offspring was racing in a 2023 Roses Are Red elimination at Mohawk.

"I actually happened to be there the minute she was born," said the filly's former groom, adding that she wasn't sure why Favoritism was born so late in the season. All of Hidden Gem's other offspring were born between Feb. 21 and April 12. When the mare was bred back to Bettors Delight in 2022, USTA records show she was first inseminated on April 8 and last inseminated on July 6.

"I happened to be in the [farm] house, watching her full sister, Silver Label, race that evening," Hillier said. "As Silver Label crossed the finish line, I got the call that her mother Hidden Gem just started foaling, so I rushed out to the barn, about 9:30 at night, and I got to see her just as she came into this world. I spent the first year-and-a-half of her life with her, every single day."

The tiny daughter of Bettors Delight had big shoes to fill.

Silver Label (p, 4, 1:47.3m; \$1,345,501) finished second to Treacherous Reign on the night of Favoritism's birth, and was second to Grace Hill a week later in the 2023 Roses Are Red final. Voted O'Brien 2-Year-Old Pacing Filly of the Year in 2022, Silver Label won 26 of 61 lifetime

starts against the top distaff pacers of her time. She retired after winning the Mohawk Filly and Mare preferred on Dec. 21, 2024 for driver James MacDonald and trainer Nick Gallucci. Now starting her career as a Millar Farms broodmare, Silver Label was bred to Always B Miki in early 2025.

Favoritism's other two full sisters are gritty Woodbine/Mohawk/Yonkers campaigner Franschoek (p, 5, 1:51.2s; \$179,383), now a Millar Farms broodmare, and Savethelastdance (p, 3, 1:51.3s; \$193,782), an Ontario Sires Stakes Gold winner at ages 2 and 3 who produced her first foal, by Bulldog Hanover, this year.

Hillier said Favoritism was born with an outsized personality.

"She was such a sweetheart from day one," she said. "She was born about mid-June, and she was just this tiny little thing compared to her big sister Silver Label, both literally and figuratively. She always stayed dainty, but she had a heart of gold from day one. I really hoped that she would race well."

Although the youngest foal at Millar Farms, Favoritism was a fast learner.

"She was the easiest baby I think we had that year," Hillier said. "She took to haltering instantly. I had her picking up feet from about a month old. She was just so agreeable, like she took everything in stride. I couldn't have been more proud of her."

Hillier watched Favoritism growing up on the farm, frequently napping in the summer sunshine. She was watching again, trackside at Mohawk, when Favoritism and driver James MacDonald joined the race 8 post parade on Friday (Sept. 19) night. While no longer working for Millar Farms, Hillier said she still felt a strong connection to the little filly who could.

Favoritism didn't disappoint, clearing fast-leaving Born To Fly on the first turn, and fighting to regain the lead after E A Hazel took control before the half. The 1-5 favorite held off Docs Girl Friday and Amazing Addy in deep stretch, getting her maiden 1:56 win at first asking. Every other filly in the race was older than the winner, with half of her rivals foaled in March 2023.

Nick Gallucci invited Hillier into the winners' circle photo. When she called out "Cookie," Favoritism looked in her direction.

"Her barn name for us was 'Cookie,'" Hillier said. "I hope she recognized me; it seemed like she did. I hope that when I cross paths with them later in life, that they remember me, and they usually do, which I hope means that I'm doing something right."

"It's so amazing. I never get over seeing them go from these little itty-bitty foals to being full-grown racehorses. I did take a job a little closer to home. I'm sad to have left Millars'. They were so great to me for so many years, but it's amazing to see what she's become, and I wish her all the best success from here on out."

Putting Favoritism's late start into perspective, she was just 18 days old at the same time of year (June 28) when Chantilly (p, 3,

1:49.4s; \$786,862), Millar Farms' homebred Canadian Horse of the Year, was winning her first qualifier at Mohawk last season. A year ago, on the same weekend as Favoritism's maiden victory, Chantilly was capturing the She's A Great Lady final.

With her most famous stablemate on the brink of a comeback tonight (Oct. 2) in Ontario Sires Stake Gold leg 5, little Favoritism will make her second career start on Saturday (Oct. 4) night.

Hillier still works as an equine caretaker, at a multi-breed farm not focused on racing. But on nights at the track, the emotions of a harness racing groom are quick to resurface.

"It brings tears to my eyes every time I see any of them, especially in their first start, whether they win or come dead last or anywhere in between, I'm always just so proud of the horse that they've become, but it's so much more special when they get that first win," she said. "Definitely congratulations to Nick Gallucci for getting her out there and getting that first win in her first lifetime start. I'm excited to see how she continues."

Oscar Bonavena still punching at age 10

The champion trotter has overcome much to remain relevant in open ranks.

He is the marvel they just call “old Oscar.”

Oscar Bonavena had won his first start way back on April 22, 2018 at Rangiora in New Zealand’s South Island and more than seven years later, as a rising 10-year-old, he will be a leading player in two of NZ’s biggest Group 1 trotting races in coming weeks.

For all the champions, pacers and trotters, Mark Purdon has trained and driven, none have been more special to him than old Oscar.

Purdon, Australasia’s most decorated harness horseman, talked of his bond with the veteran trotter.

“He’s as special to me as any horse I’ve had,” he said. “He’s just so unique, he’s got such a lovely temperament and he’s come through much.”

Named after a powerhouse Argentinian boxer of the 1960s, Oscar “Ringo” Bonavena who famously tested Muhammad Ali

in an epic stoush, Oscar the trotter has had more than his share of battles to overcome.

Those battles started the day Oscar Bonavena was born prematurely, leaving him weak and with such crooked legs the vets said he’d never make a racehorse.

Oamaru horseperson Charlotte Purvis fed Oscar by bottle until he was strong enough to stand and drink from his mother.

Purvis’ father, John, bred and raced Oscar Bonavena for his debut win at Rangiora and a slashing and close second to the Purdon-trained Enhance Your Calm in a 2YO Sires’ Stake final a month later.

Purdon liked what he saw of the horse chasing him home and that’s when former Kiwi and now U.S.-based horseman Chris Ryder and Purdon’s late father, Roy, peeled-off some serious cash to buy Oscar Bonavena.

“I trialed the horse and he gave me a great feeling,” Purdon said. “It also helped that Phil [Williamson, trainer] had a very high opinion of him and he’s a terrific judge with trotters. It all gave me confidence he’d be a good buy.”

Oscar Bonavena then won eight of his first 10 starts for Purdon, along with a second, and emerged as the most exciting young trotter Down Under.

But it was at 3 he faced his second major battle when diagnosed with the rare condition of a cyst in his knee.

“When they first diagnosed the cyst, they said it was unlikely his legs would be able to stand-up to racing... we thought we’d done out money,” Purdon said.

“That’s six years ago and it’s amazing to think what he’s gone on to do since, although with lots of ups and downs along the way.

“Whether it’s a hock, stifle or knee, he’s gone from one problem to another and been a really challenging horse to train, but he’s taken less maintenance now than he ever has.”

Oscar Bonavena's career was seriously in limbo after a failed trip to Australia in early 2020. He was sidelined for 14 months, but made it back to steadily build into a major trotting force again.

"We thought that might have been the end," Purdon said. "Especially when the vets gave him a pretty dire diagnosis."

At his eighth start on the comeback trail, he beat New Zealand's best trotters in the Group 1 NZ Trotting free-for-all at Addington on Nov. 9, 2021.

It was his first start in a feature he has since contested another three times. Oscar Bonavena won the race three times (2021, '23 and '24) and finished fourth in 2022.

Last year, his battle-weary old legs carried him to an upset win over the then undisputed Down Under trotting king, Just Believe in the race.

On Nov. 14, he will return for his fifth crack at the New Zealand free-for-all.

Three days before that, Oscar Bonavena will also tackle New Zealand's iconic trotting race, the Group 1 Dominion Trot (3,200 meters, standing start) for the fifth time. He won that in 2023.

Despite all his challenges, Oscar has raced 93 times for 36 wins, 15 seconds and 11 thirds.

He is sixth highest on the Down Under all-time earnings list for a trotter on \$1,211,113. Lyell Creek (\$2,256,724) and Just Believe (\$1,929,253) are the leaders.

Given the earning potential in coming weeks, Oscar Bonavena could climb as high as third place, which is currently held by I Can Doosit (\$1,377,319).

Despite that early nightmare trip to Australia which derailed his career, Purdon, who now trains the trotter in partnership with his son, Nathan, dared to try another Aussie raid earlier this year.

In a topsy turvy Brisbane Inter Dominion series in July, Oscar Bonavena produced the run of the race in the final, storming from an impossible position to snatch third place, smashing the clock with his closing splits.

"He's still got all that speed of his, which is remarkable," Purdon said.

"I said early, he's as fast as most of the best pacers we've had at home. I know because we've worked with them.

"There was a day at home when we worked him with Ultimate Sniper and another top open-class pacer and Oscar just cruised up alongside them at top speed. It was quite remarkable. Ultimate Sniper won an Inter Dominion final.



"We thought long and hard about Brisbane, but, for some reason, he's as sound now as he's been for years so we decided to give it a crack. We were so proud of him and he's come back home and gone on with it."

Oscar Bonavena had a freshen-up after the Brisbane trip and has returned wins in both starts.

The latest, in last Sunday week's Group 3 Banks Peninsula Cup on the grass track at Motukaraka in New Zealand's South Island, was mesmerizing.

Despite coming off a 30-meter handicap with Purdon driving himself, old Oscar rounded up his rivals on the home bend and blasted away by about 30 meters.

It was his second win in the race, but four years after his first.

"That was a really special win," Purdon said. "They gave him a great reception. That was the best part really. It was terrific for the horse."

"He's been a wonderful horse... If he is not better than ever, he is certainly as good as ever."

Oscar Bonavena's next run will be the Canterbury Park Cup (Oct. 17). He'll then likely go to Ashburton (Oct. 27).

During the build-up, Oscar will continue building on his side project, his emerging stallion career.

"He served about 20 mares last year and already has 15 bookings this season," Purdon said. "In true form for him, mixing breeding and racing hasn't changed him at all. He's still got his amazing temperament."

He became a "dad" for the first time when a filly called "Ivy" was born early last month.

Purdon said the plan was for Oscar Bonavena to race on until the middle of next year then retire fully into his breeding barn days.

Corner Store obliterates records in Mass Stake action

The \$2.4 million Massachusetts Breeders Stakes continued at Plainridge Park on Tuesday (Sept. 30) as the top 3-year-old trotters and pacers of both genders lined up in seven events.

The speedy oval at The Ridge produced four stakes records, three track records and five new lifetime marks, but no single effort was more outstanding than the mile turned in by **Corner Store**, who simply rewrote the record books across the board.

The opening stake was the first \$45,000 division of trotting fillies that was carded as a non-betting event and **Tactical Moni** (Tactical Landing—All Our Moni) set a new stakes record and tied the track record for 3-year-old trotting fillies.

Tactical Moni (Brett Beckwith) got away fifth as the lead changed hands between Bridgeoverbroadway (Mitchell Cushing), Elegant Dance (Nick Graffam), and Peach Cocktail (Matty Athearn), the latter who then took the girls to the half in :57. As the race moved onto the backstretch, Beckwith had Tactical Moni out and trotting and flew past the field to take the lead at three-quarters and opened up a four-length gap at the top of the stretch. From there the race was over as Tactical Moni won by 9¼ lengths in 1:53.3.

Tactical Moni is owned and bred by Moni Maker Stable and trained by Domenico Cecere.

Corner Store (Brett Beckwith) set a track and stakes record of 1:51.3 in her Massachusetts Breeders Stakes division for 3-year-old trotting fillies on Tuesday (Sept. 30) at Plainridge Park. The mile was only two-fifths-of-a-second away from making Corner Store the fastest 3-year-old trotting filly ever bred in Massachusetts, a record held by Raised By Lindy (1:51.3).

The previous stakes record of 1:53.4 was held by Treaty of Versailles (2024) and the existing track record of 1:53.3 is co-held by Decadence (2017) and Stash Some Cash (2025).

But all those records changed drastically again in the very next race, which was the second \$45,000 division of trotting fillies where Corner Store (Six Pack—Seven Eleven) put on an eye-popping performance.

Beckwith fired Corner Store to the front and opened up a gapped advantage ahead of R Lady W (Matt Kakaley), who had settled in second. After fast fractions of :27 and :54.4, Corner Store and R Lady W had broken away from the rest of the pack and were trotting up a storm at three-quarters in 1:22.3. After the race made its way through the turn, R Lady W was making up some ground as they headed down the stretch, but Corner Store was wrapped up and heading for home an easy winner by 1½ lengths in 1:51.3, which was a new lifetime mark.

The time was also a new stakes and track record and was only two-fifths-of-a-second away from making Corner Store the fastest 3-year-old trotting filly ever bred in Massachusetts, a record held by Raised By Lindy (1:51.3).

Corner Store (\$3.20) is owned by her trainer Paul Kelley, in partnership with Matthew Lamont, Ellen Palillo, and Leo Bauer.

The pacing fillies were up next in two \$45,000 splits.

In the first, it was a one-horse race as **Cindy's Faith** (Roll With Joe—Ravenna Star) was a runaway winner.

Bruce Ranger set up shop on the point with Cindy's Faith, and cut quarters of :27.2, :55, and 1:22.4 as the rest of the field followed with no answers. Cindy's Faith rounded the bend and bolted for the line while Ranger sat chilly to win by 10¼ lengths in a new lifetime record of 1:51.2.

Cindy's Faith (\$2.80) is owned and bred by Shark Racing and trained by Larry Stalbaum.

Then in the second division, **Wassail Blue Chip** (Courtly Choice—Baccara Hanover) tuned in the mile of her life in victory.

Beantown Deuce (Kakaley) was leading at the quarter, but soon succumbed to Wassail Blue Chip (Gingras), who had floated on the outside to gain command. Once in front, Wassail Blue Chip paced confidently to the half in :56.2 and three-quarters in 1:24.2. Challenges came from Beantown Deuce and Moneymakesherhappy (Beckwith) in the final panel, but Wassail Blue Chip turned them both away to win by 2¼ lengths in a career best, 1:52.2.

Wassail Blue Chip (\$17) is owned by Erv Miller Stable, Andray Farm, and David J. Miller and trained by Alicia Gray.

Blue Chip Bloodstock bred Wassail Blue Chip.

The pacing colts and geldings then took to the track in two \$45,000 divisions.

The first group was won by **Courageous Warrior** (Huntsville—Chief Karen) who tied the stakes record and took a new lifetime mark.

Courageous Warrior (Athearn) lined up first in the turn before Digging For Gold (Graffam) pulled from third to take the front at the quarter in :27.2. Digging For Gold then got to the half in :56 and three-quarters in 1:23.3 while Courageous Warrior kept his nose on Graffam's helmet. Halfway through the turn, Athearn tipped Courageous Warrior and drew alongside Digging For Gold at the top of the stretch. The two matched strides to the line where Courageous Warrior moved to the lead by a neck in 1:51.1.

Courageous Warrior (\$20.40) is owned by Curran Racing and Nickerson Racing and trained by Jimmy Nickerson.

The stakes record for 3-year-old pacing males is now co-held by Rocknroll Lou (2024).

The second division went to **Jon I Love Dat** (Downbytheseaside—Franney Love Dat) who moved early and then hung on late for the win.

It was a five-horse mad dash off the gate that eventually saw Southpaw (Jimmy Whittemore) take command at the :26.3 quarter. But that lead was short lived as Gingras pulled Jon I Love Dat from third and had the front before the half. With only a minor threat posed by Massive Speed (Kevin Switzer, Jr.) as they approached three-quarters, Jon I Love Dat and Southpaw continued to be the players as they made their way around the last turn. When they reached the top of the stretch, Southpaw pulled and tried to advance, but he came up three-quarters-of-a-length short as Jon I Love Dat hung on to win in 1:52.

Jon I Love Dat (\$2.80) is owned and bred by Robert Lovett and trained by Janice Connor.

The final stakes event of the day was a single \$75,000 division on trotting colts and geldings that was won by **Te Quiero Lindy** (Walner—Adios Lindy), who set a new stakes record, tied the track record, and tied his own lifetime mark with the victory.

Te Quiero Lindy (Tyler Miller) took the lead from stablemate My Degenerate (Andy Miller) in the first turn and then passed the quarter in :27.2. While Moni Man (Beckwith) sat third, Te Quiero Lindy marched to the half in :57.3 and three-quarters in 1:25.1 with My Degenerate still waiting to move from the pocket. That came at the top of the stretch when Andy Miller pushed My Degenerate to the outside and bore down on Te Quiero Lindy, matching strides with the leader all the way to the wire where it took a photo to show that Te Quiero Lindy had won by a nose in 1:53.2.

Te Quiero Lindy (\$3.80) is owned by Andy Miller Stable, PJ Hoopes, and Lindy Farms of Connecticut, who also bred the winner.

The previous stake record was 1:53.3 (Big Man Ev 2017 and Pepper Wow 2024) and the track record is now co-held with Spanzaaano (1:53.2, 2024).

Beau Jangles topped \$1 million in earnings, pushed his unbeaten streak to nine and swept all five Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Gold events with a 1:50.2 victory on Tuesday night (Sept. 30) in the lone \$140,000 Leg 5 Gold for 2-year-old pacing colts at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

The mile comes 10 days after the son of Cattlewash out of Mrs Major Hill won the \$1 million Metro Pace at Woodbine Mohawk Park in 1:49.1.

Beau Jangles now sports earnings of \$1,042,125 for the ownership group of Graham Grace Stables of Clifton, VA, Kiwi Stables of La Plata, MD, and Bolton Stables of Clermont, FL. Bred by Tara Hills Stud of Port Perry, ON, where Cattlewash stands stud, Beau Jangles is trained by Dr. Ian Moore and driven by Bob McClure.

Starting from the rail, McClure had Beau Jangles on top before the half and cruised from there to a three-length win over No Waitlist (Tyler Borth). Tiltthecowscomehome (Jody Jamieson) was third.

Sent off at 1-9 in the field of eight, Beau Jangles paid \$2.10.

Bred by Prince Lee Acres of Uxbridge, ON, and sold for \$40,000 at the 2023 London Classic Yearling Sale, P L Spencer now has seasonal earnings of \$378,081 and a lifetime haul of \$387,681. The gelding is 9-4-0 in 15 starts this year and 10-4-0 in 19 career outings.

Sent off at 1-5, P L Spencer paid \$2.40.

In the \$140,000 OSS Gold leg 5 event for 3-year-old trotting fillies, McClure drove **Stormont Beautiful** to a dominant 7½-length score over 99-1 longshot Roxie Hart (Mario Baillargeon). Bright Green (Roy) was third.

It was the first Gold victory for the homebred daughter of Resolve out of Stormont Red owned by Stormont Meadows of Long Sault, ON. The Kevin Benn trainee is now 5-3-2 in 14 2025 starts and 8-6-2 in 21 career outings. The win increased Stormont Beautiful's bankroll to \$289,258 this year and \$332,883 lifetime.

Sent off at 3-2, Stormont Beautiful paid \$5.10 to win.

Rookie trotters wrap INSS legs at Harrah's Hoosier Park

Indiana Sire Stakes action returned to Harrah's Hoosier Park on Tuesday (Sept. 30) with the sixth and final leg for both divisions of 2-year-old trotters. A trio of splits was needed for each group as they competed for their final chance to earn their way into the \$250,000 Super Finals during Hoosier Champions night on Friday (Oct. 10).

The \$45,500 first division for trotting fillies kicked off the card with a 22-1 **Dangoodfeelin** pulling the shocker from the perfect

pocket trip. Trainer Robert Taylor was in the bike, landing the 2-hole trip behind 4-5 favorite Meadowbrook Ashley (Doug Rideout) who cut first half fractions of :27.2 and :57.2. After Meadowbrook Ashley led to three-quarters in 1:27.2, Dangoodfeelin exploded out from behind, trotting home in :27.3 to win by four lengths in a career best 1:55.3. Hot Martini (Ricky Macomber, Jr.) wore down Meadowbrook Ashley late to get up for second.

Dangoodfeelin has won five of 13 on the season for owners Harvey Fry and Nathan Yoder. Fry also bred to daughter of Dover Dan—Dancin Feeling who has banked \$58,550 on the season.

The \$46,000 second split for fillies proved much more formful as **Help Cum Laude** scored as the 4-5 favorite. Atlee Bender guided the bettors' choice into second early while 13-1 shot Honeymoon (Kevin Lambricht) took control of the field of eight through a quarter of :28.2. Bender brushed Help Cum Laude to the top on the backstretch before a half of :58.4 when For Dayze (John De Long) charged alongside the favorite first-over at three-quarters in 1:28.2. Help Cum Laude turned away the challenge before opening up by three lengths on the wire with a :27 final split to stop the timer in 1:55.2. For Dayze held for second with OMG Am I Ok (Trace Tetrick) rallying for third.

The effort was a career best for Help Cum Laude who is now two-for-two since the move to the Erv Miller stable and a winner of three of six on the year. Owned by Ervin Miller Stable, Anthony Lombardi, and Doug Overhiser, the daughter of Helpisontheway—Cum Laude Hall was bred by Black Creek Farm and sports a bankroll of \$65,190.

The final \$46,000 division for trotting fillies went to mild 7-2 upsetter **Swan Gracelyn** with trainer LeWayne Miller in the bike. Swan Gracelyn floated away in fifth while Make It Spicy was on top through a hotly contested first quarter of :27.3. Miller moved Swan Gracelyn first-over on the backstretch, brushing to the top after a half of :57.4 under urging as the Swan Gracelyn hesitated slightly while trying to clear moving into the final turn. Once on the point, Swan Gracelyn took pressure from Double A Dream (Tetrick) at three-quarters in 1:27.2. Swan Gracelyn repelled that challenge in the lane before facing one final foe as Pastor's Delicacy (Kyle Wilfong) picked up steam late at 42-1, coming up a half-length short of Swan Gracelyn who broke her maiden in 1:57. Clear And Cool (Jordan Ross) rallied for the show spot.

Owned by Nathan Yoder, L&S Racing, and Platinum Stables, the winning daughter of Swan For All—Paint By Numbers was bred by Black Horse Racing and has earned \$38,484 through seven outings this year.

Not the only maiden breaker on the evening during stakes action, **Dan D Man Can** broke through in a big way as he captured the \$45,500 first division for trotting colts. Bender secured the third spot early through a quarter of :28.1 before taking over from Swan In All (Ross) on the way to the half in :57.4. The 1-5 favorite cruised to three-quarters in 1:27.2 before pouring it on in the stretch, winning by 3¾ lengths over The Gambler (De Long) and Bravo Alpha (Rideout) in 1:55.

Erv Miller trains Dan D Man Can who broke his maiden in start number eight for owners Red Barn Stable, Doug Overhiser, and Lava Java Stable. The Dover Dan—Caramela Hanover gelding was bred by Homestead Acres and has banked \$78,528.

The win was one of four driving wins for Bender, and three training wins for Erv Miller as those two led their respective categories on the night.

Driver Marcus Miller teamed up with **Sunday Swagger** for the first time in the \$46,000 second division as the duo led every step of the way in a 7-1 upset. Sunday Swagger trotted to the top through an opening quarter of :27.3 before being well rated with middle-half fractions of :57.2 and 1:27 in front of pocket-sitter August Salazar (De Long). Once in the stretch, Sunday Swagger marched clear to a 1¾ length victory in a lifetime best 1:54.3. The 1-2 favorite Swan Affect (LeWayne Miller) rallied for second after never seeing the cones, with August Salazar holding for third at 31-1.

Jay Hochstetler trains Sunday Swagger who has won two of eight on the year for owners Connie and Homer Hochstetler,

Robert Buddig, and Allen Schwartz. Bred by Homer Hochstetler and Robert Buddig, the gelded son of Dover Dan—Sweet Thing has made \$50,875 in 2025.

The \$46,000 final division for trotting colts was won by **Power N Steam** who capitalized on late breaking leaders en route to a 3-1 victory. Mike Oosting and Power N Steam got away seventh in the field of eight while 4-5 favorite Swan Bi Bi (Ross) took the field to the quarter in :28.1. Power N Steam followed the cover of I'too Volo (Tetrick) after a half of :58 to get towed into contention when I'too Volo jumped it off rounding the final turn while matching strides with Swan Bi Bi at three-quarters in 1:28.2. Reestablished alone on the lead, Swan Bi Bi appeared poised to cruise in the stretch before jumping it off midway through the lane, leading to Power N Steam inheriting the top position late and getting the job done by 1¼ lengths in a career best 1:56.4. Bluebird Atomic (Kevin Lambright) got up for second, with Woodside Julius (LeWayne Miller) finishing third at 62-1.

Ken Rucker trains Power N Steam who has won two of eight on the year for owners Earnest Sork and Noreen and Shawn Nessa. Bred by Randy, Zane, and Tyler Wilt, the Swan For All—Flowers N Dreams colt has racked up earnings of \$46,219 on the year.
