Despite failing to set records for a third session, the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale still has a record average of \$97,996 through the first three days.

No new records were set during the third session of the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale held Wednesday afternoon (Oct. 2) at the Fasig-Tipton sales pavilion, but the auction is still on a record pace for average through three days.

The cumulative average is currently \$97,996, an all-time best through the first three sessions. It's up 1.7 per cent over the three-day average of \$96,351 in 2023 that was the previous record. This year's average through the first three sessions is up 3.1 per cent over the 2022 average of \$95,015.



David Reid's Preferred Equine has already topped \$10 million in sales through three days.

"We're very pleased to be ahead of the record pace from two years ago, as far as sale average," said sale co-manager Bruce Brinkerhoff. "We're well ahead of that pace and also last year's record sale as well... So, we're very pleased through three sessions to be above all-time records and we hope to be able to maintain that through the rest of the sale in the next two days."

The gross through three sessions is \$55,172,000 for 563 yearlings sold. The cumulative average is \$62,000. So far, 178 yearlings have sold for \$100,000 or more, down from 226 last year. The gross is off 5.7 per cent from last year's \$58,385,000, though 44 fewer horses have been sold this year compared to the same point last year. The median is down from \$67,000 in 2023.

On Wednesday, 219 yearlings went through the ring, grossing \$10,705,000 in all, for an average of \$48,881. The median was \$37,000. The gross for the third session is down 17.8 per cent from last year's third-session total of \$13,021,000, though 27 fewer horses were sold this year than last. This year's third-day average is down 7.3 per cent from last year's \$52,717.

"We saw a little bit of a challenging market, but it was good in spots," said sale co-manager David Reid. "This time of the week,

it's kind of like a hump day and transitioning to new people coming in and some people leaving town.

"Trotters did hold up right across the board again today. It's like I was saying before, there are going to be opportunities. There were pockets here today and the people here were able to benefit that we retreated a little bit off from the first two nights. It was still a very impressive session, it's just that we're rolling along into our fourth session tomorrow and it's going to be what it's going to be."

Reid said there may be a slight market correction at play while new pedigrees enter the market.

"It gets back to the diversification, I really believe, on the pacing side, and even on the trotting side," Reid said. "With the influx of the foreign-based pedigrees, I think it's good long-term for the breeding, but the familiarity might not be there for all the buyers. It's a learning curve and I think it's attributable to some of that.

"There's just a lot of selection. I think at the end of the week, you're going to see that's where part of the difference was... with the pacers."

PREFERRED TOPS \$10 MILLION IN SALES

On Wednesday, Reid's Preferred Equine became the first consignor over \$10 million in sales. Preferred has grossed

exactly \$10,240,000 this year through the first three days for 99 sold. Last year, for the complete sale, Preferred had sales of \$10,561,000. The all-time Lexington consignor record of \$11,261,000 was set by Preferred in 2022 when the agency sold 145 yearlings.

"It was solid [on Wednesday]," Reid said. "Here again, we had bright spots. It was a solid marketplace, solid trade. The greatest judge of a horse is the public and throughout today we really didn't hit any out of the park, but we got them sold and moved on and we had a good day that way.

"We look forward to [Thursday, Oct. 3]. We realize the marketplace is what it is and we just do the best we can. For the week, it's been a great week."

Through three days, Kentuckiana is in second place among consignors with gross sales of \$7,903,000, followed closely by Hunterton (\$7,875,000). Crawford Farms is fourth with sales of \$3,883,000.

By average, Hanover Shoe Farms, which sold its last horse of this sale on Tuesday, still leads with \$216,308 for 13 sold, followed by All American Harnessbreds (\$170,000 for six sold) and Cameo Hills (\$144,417 for 24 sold). Peninsula Farm is fourth with an average of \$139,533 for 15 sold.

Kentuckiana sold the top three yearlings by price on Wednesday.

Topping the third session was Hip #514 Storybook Love, a Chapter Seven filly out of Stirling Debutant purchased by Bax Stable as agent for Al Libfeld for \$210,000 from the Kentuckiana consignment.

Four other yearlings sold for \$170,000 or more.

Diamond Creek sold Hip #424 Carve, a Captain Corey filly out of Alpine, for \$170,000 to Kemppi Stables, which also paid \$170,000 for Hip #471 AJ Hall, a Cantab Hall—Aela Jamieson filly sold by Preferred.

BRITTANY COMING TO THE END OF THE LINE

On Wednesday, Brittany Farms sold four of its own yearlings and one as an agent. It only has two more yearlings to sell [Thursday, Oct. 3] and one on Friday (Oct.

4) before ending its reign as one of the sport's top breeders.

Owner George Segal is exiting the breeding business and farm manger Art Zubrod and his wife, office manager Leah Cheverie, are retiring. Unfortunately, the farm has not had the results it was hoping for this year in the auction ring.

"I had a lot of nice people come and give us well wishes or whatever you want to call it and that was nice, but it's been a crappy sale for us and I don't know why," Zubrod said. "Horses are selling for about 50 per cent of what I thought they'd sell for.

"Last year, we were the leading consignor of anybody that sold all five days and this year, I tell you, we'd have trouble being in the top 10, so I'm not sure what went on."

Through three days, Brittany has sold 13 yearlings for gross sales of \$1,015,000, averaging \$78,077.

CONCORD STUD PLEASED

Meanwhile, Julie Meirs of Concord Stud said she's pleased with her farm's results, so far.

Through three days, Concord has gross sales of \$2,659,000 for 23 sold, averaging \$115,609.


"I think we've had a good sale," Meirs said. "It's been a solid Lexington sale. We had 10 the first night and we love selling Day 1 at Lexington, so it was a strong way to start off. Then, three yesterday, but one for \$300,000 so that was pretty good, as well.

"The yearling [Tuesday] for \$300,000 [Hip #292, Ocean Rider] was a bit of a surprise. I didn't think we'd be there, so it was a positive surprise. We knew that he would be good, but we just didn't know what that final number would be. We didn't think he

was going to be \$50,000, we knew he'd be six figures... well, we hoped. I hate to say 'we knew' because you never know what's going to happen."

TEAM HARRIS STILL DOMINATING BUYERS

The team of Andrew Harris and Bill Pollock did not buy any horses on Wednesday, but still lead all buyers by a large margin. The duo has spent \$5,115,000 for 15 yearlings and has collared eight of the top 17 sold by price, including three of the top five:

- 2nd overall Hip #83 Going Viral (f, Chapter Seven—Check Out Trixie) for \$650,000.
- 3^{rd} overall Hip #106 Ice Fall (c, Walner—Ice Attraction) for \$625,000.
- 5th overall Hip #267 Naughty Beauty (f, Bettors Delight—Beautyonthebeach) for \$550,000.

Trainer Nancy Takter added six more yearlings on Wednesday and has now spent \$2,597,000 for 23 horses. Trainer Tony Alagna is close behind with purchases totalling \$2,180,000 for 23 yearlings after buying nine more on Wednesday and spending \$369,000 to bring them home.

NO CHANGE IN TOP SIRES

There is no change in the sire leaderboard through three days. It is as follows:

- Walner \$8,936,000 for 51 sold (\$175,216 average).
- Chapter Seven \$7,581,000 for 50 sold (\$151,620).
- Muscle Hill \$4,203,000 for 32 sold (\$131,344).
- Gimpanzee \$3,900,000 for 36 sold (\$108,333).
- Captaintreacherous \$3,688,000 for 38 sold (\$97,053).
- Perfect Sting \$2,924,000 for 34 sold (\$86,000).

The fourth session of the sale begins today (Oct. 3) at 1 p.m.

"Maybe just the world economics, the political situation, inflationary situation – at some point, it's probably going to affect the market and maybe that's what we saw a little bit today and maybe a bit more of a buyers' market [Thursday, Oct. 3]," Reid said.

"I think through the week we've been saying, the catalog is so strong. It's still got sire power and I think there's opportunities for people and, truthfully, that's a great thing for the sport. You get all shapes and sizes of horses and all shapes and sizes in stables and they come here and they are going to find what they want.

"It's been a good week, with great weather and good atmosphere and look forward to session four."

Let the sunshine in

The sun was shining bright on my old Kentucky home Wednesday morning (Oct. 2). The sun is also shining bright over Fasig-Tipton as the first two sessions of the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale were record-breaking.

Monday's opening-night session got underway at 7 p.m., with a two-hour gathering to celebrate the life of the late Randy Manges kicking things off. With a photo montage of Randy and his many, many friends being shown on the TVs, everybody gathered to do a little reminiscing. Randy's son, David, flew in from Dallas, while his daughter, Carey, made the trip from Boston. Opening remarks came from Kurt Becker, and then David took the microphone to speak eloquently about his father.

When the sale began, I had taken a seat on a bench directly outside the sale office at Fasig-Tipton. That was always where Randy could be found taking a break, so I wanted to honor the memory of my great friend by sitting in his spot for Hip #1.

In making my rounds early, I went over to say hello to my sponsors, Steve and Cindy Stewart. I wished them luck, and it looked like it worked, as the Stewarts' Hunterton Sales Agency was the leading consignor by gross for the opening session, with 21 yearlings selling for \$4,567,000. Hunterton's sale-topper for the night was Hip #95, a Tactical Landing filly who sold for \$550,000 to a partnership of David Anderson, Robert LeBlanc, John Fielding and Pryde Stable.

Hip #15 lit up the tote board with the final bid of \$925,000 going to Ken Jacobs. The Hanover Shoe Farms-sold Walner filly is the first foal out of the 2020 Hambletonian champ Ramona Hill. Just like Ramona Hill, the yearling filly named Rani Hanover will be trained by Tony Alagna.

I talked to many, many people Monday night at the sale. Chris Coyle noted to me that famed French horseman J.P. Dubois was in attendance, and I later saw him walking in the back ring. I can say that J.P. looks great for age 84.

I also had a chance to say hello to Tim Twaddle, whose large group included his daughter, Meadow. Another large group was three generations of the Altmeyer/Wilder family. Going solo in the back patio area was Richard Gutnick, and while we talked, he reminded me again that he'd framed a story which I



wrote about him several years ago at The Horseman And Fair World where I christened him "King Richard."

Eventually I made my way back out to Randy's bench and Bill O'Donnell came over to say hello. So too did Mark Weaver, who introduced me to Jason Robinson. Tuesday's sale session was another big day for the Stewarts' Hunterton Sales Agency as they sold the afternoon's topper. Honors went to pacing filly Naughty Beauty, a daughter of Bettor's Delight—Beautyonthebeach, who sold for \$550,000 to Andrew Harris, acting as agent for William Pollock. The filly was bred by Jim Avritt, Sr.

By day's end there was a new second-session average of \$97,768 for the 227 yearlings sold. After two days, Hunterton has sold 44 yearlings for a total of \$7,105,000, second to only Preferred Equine at slightly more than \$8 million.

During my pavilion travels on Tuesday, I had a chance to say hello to Trond Smedshammer and Bernie Noren. I stopped to chat with David McDuffee for a spell, and he gave me a hip number to keep an eye on and who he expected to purchase. So, I kept track, but Dave's prediction failed to come to fruition.

While I had seen Brian and Jennifer Brown in their usual spot on Monday night, Brian was solo on Tuesday. I sat for a few minutes with the new-and-improved Brian, telling him that his recent 60th birthday looks good on him.

I was able to leave Fasig-Tipton at a reasonable time to make it home to watch the Detroit Tigers in their first playoff game in 10 years. What an exciting and fun game to watch, especially with the Tigers holding on to win 3-1.

I was getting a bit nervous late in the game that the Astros would tie it up and go into extra innings as I had plans to meet a large group for dinner at Tony's at 6:15 p.m. But the game



Actually, we were supposed to have dinner at Frank and Dino's, but that restaurant remained closed Tuesday as a result of lingering power problems from last Friday's storm. Moira Fanning had put the plans together and she told me that somebody at Frank and Dino's called to let her know of the situation and then actually made our reservations at Tony's.

My group included Moira and her husband, Tom, John and Paula Campbell, Emily Ratcliff, Amanda Gaskin, Australia's Wally Mann and Kristen Odegard, who lives in Paris (France, not Kentucky).

We had some great conversation at the table. One of the topics was Summer Slam, and it wasn't about Tuesday's afternoon at Fasig-Tipton. It was about the Summer Slam that is scheduled for MetLife Stadium adjacent to The Meadowlands over Hambletonian weekend next year. So, if you're planning on attending the 100th Hambletonian next year you might want to answer the bell early and start checking hotel prices now.

Tony's was filled with harness people in there. Taking the table behind me was a group that included Nick Salvi, Wendy Ross and Jenn Bongiorno. I received a nice hug from both Wendy and Jenn (who told me that Marty Byrd is also in town with her), but when Nick tried to do the same, I politely stepped back. Scarlett Wilder, our roving eyewitness reporter, soon joined the trio to make it a quartet.

While I was washing hands in the men's room, I was hip checked by somebody. That somebody turned out to be Buzzy Sholty. As I headed back to my table I saw Will Alempijevic, whose group included Nik Drennan. Andy and Julie Miller also had a really big group dining together. I also grabbed a peak at a back booth where Jonas Czernyson and Kristin Shetler were, with Joe Holloway and Marty Granoff nearby.

Arriving at Tony's at 6:10 p.m., I made the decision to not valet park and instead take a chance on parking on Short Street where there were many spots open. Thing is, parking meters are in action until 7 p.m. I decided that with a tip the valet parking charge would be \$15, the same as what a parking ticket would cost. I can happily report that when I made it back to my car after dinner at 9:45 — yes, we were at Tony's for 3½ hours — my windshield was clean with no ticket in sight.

I arrived at The Red Mile on the sunny Wednesday morning about 8:45. It was chilly so jackets were required. The breakfast area was again empty, but there is hope for Thursday as Emily Ratcliff texted me asking if I had any requests as food will be served. I told her bagels with cream cheese have always been a popular item in the past.

It was again quiet walking through the barn area. Tahnee Camilleri again waved hello as she's done every morning. I saw Tahnee as I was looking over to see if Chris Ryder was around as I wanted to wish the newly-elected Hall of Famer a happy birthday.

I saw associate judge Jeff James heading into his office so I went in and sat down. Jeff and I go back to even before I started working at Hazel Park and Northville Downs in 1979. Jeff had a great Hall of Fame driving career in Michigan. It was just a few years ago that he transitioned into the role of a judge.

While I was sitting with Jeff, Tyler Butenschoen came in to make a couple of driving changes for the Butenschoen barn. He asked Jeff if Jody Jamieson was expected at The Red Mile on Friday. Jeff told Tyler that Jody would be in town on Saturday but not Friday. But what did Jeff do? He picked up the phone and called Jody to see if he could make it a day early for Tyler. Jody said he would make his way to the Bluegrass, which meant Tyler left the office very happy.

Linda Toscano came in to scratch a horse out of Friday's card, and just as she was leaving the office Jeff's phone rang. It was Dewayne Minor, who took his filly out of the open trot that is slated as race 1 on Friday's card. Jeff then made another call to Tony Alagna, telling him that with Linda's scratch his AE1 horse would be moving into the race.

Also on Friday's card as race 6 is the Bob McIntosh Memorial. There will be an on-track ceremony to remember the late Hall of Famer following the race.

Traffic in Lexington is very light this week as the county's schools are closed for a fall break. While there is no football game this week as UK has a bye, Keeneland opens on Friday afternoon. As for the weekend's weather, it's a direct opposite of last week as highs each day will be around 80 degrees and not a chance of rain.

Remember, racing resumes Friday at The Red Mile at 1 p.m. Remember to fill up your gas tanks as prices have dropped into the \$2.70s. I filled up my tank on Wednesday and using my dollar off with my Kroger fuel points paid just \$1.87 a gallon.

Highland Kismet is Mary Clark's well-earned reward

Despite the name, Highland Thoroughbred Frm is also Mary Clark's Inglewood, ON standardbred farm. This year, the owner/breeder reached a career pinnacle in harness racing, thanks to homebred star Highland Kismet. In a season of proud moments, Clark told HRU that her favorite was when the unraced 3-year-old gelding suddenly turned a corner in an April 26 Woodbine Mohawk Park qualifier.

"Well, we didn't know what we had right?" she said with a laugh. "Go back and look at that qualifier. Mark [Etsell] was the driver, and he was in the back, and all of a sudden, 'Kismet' just took off and just kept going, on his own. He won the qualifier in a really good time. So, we knew right there that we had something of real interest, and then he went on to win several races after that... Well, many races after that."

Highland Kismet (3,1:51.1s; \$485,806) won his first career start May 2 at Mohawk, an off-the-pace 1:54.4 effort for Bob McClure, his driver in every subsequent start. The Father Patrick—Highland Top Hill gelding has eight victories in 13 starts this season, taking his mark in a Sept. 14 Canadian Trotting Classic elimination at his home track. His 1:51.1 mile is Canada's fastest by a 3-year-old trotter and a Mohawk track record for 3-year-old trotting geldings.

The 2024 Hambletonian runner-up had a slow beginning to his career, but an owner who believed in his potential.

"He was not with the program [at age 2]," said Clark. "He wasn't difficult, but he wasn't focused. We had him castrated at 2, and you can debate that; Would Kismet be Kismet if he hadn't been [gelded]? We don't know, right?"

She recalled how 2023 O'Brien Award of Horsemanship winner Mark Etsell told her he was unsure whether Highland Kismet would amount to much on the racetrack, but agreed to work with him.

"One day, they just took him around the track and he just snapped to it," said Clark. "They gave him more opportunities, then he did the qualifier and really shocked everybody."

Everybody except Clark herself.

The 83-year-old owner said she trusted the genetics behind her top trotter. Clark bred and raced Highland Kismet's dam, Highland Top Hill (5, 1:52.4s; \$148,624).

"Top Hill' did race moderately well, and we decided to keep her as a broodmare," she told HRU. "She was second to Ariana

G [in the 2017 Kentucky Filly Futurity]. It was so muddy that the drivers could not see.

"Every foal she's had — Kismet was her first — is a beautiful animal. Kismet's half-brother [Highland Destiny] is going to train with Mark [Etsell], probably in December. He's a Greenshoe. Then she has a beautiful filly, [Highland] Firen Ice. She's a wonderful broodmare, and I remember when I first started out, somebody told me that the broodmare really is the key."

Highland Top Hill's second foal is a full sister to Highland Kismet, Highland Starburst. The 2-year-old filly has two show finishes from five starts, racing exclusively at Mohawk and race timed in 1:55.1 in the Aug. 24 Peaceful Way Stake final.

"Sometimes it doesn't come together for a while, as we found out with Kismet," said Clark. "She shows signs of maturing and going on, but I really don't expect to get two Kismets in a row."

Highland Thoroughbred Frm started out in the thoroughbred pinhooking business, raising young horses for resale as yearlings, but soon moved into standardbred breeding. Mary and her late husband, Jack Clark, were new to the horse industry. Jack had just retired from a successful career in mining equipment manufacturing after a diagnosis of Parkinson's disease. Mary had worked as a nurse. They relocated to Inglewood, ON from Toronto.

"We were sitting here on this farm and we thought, what are we going to do with it?" Mary said. "My husband said 'Well, we should grow hemp.' And then a friend suggested we call a girl named Christina Anderson, who worked in London, ON and managed a horse stable there. Christina came with us, and that's when we started pinhooking. We went on to

standardbreds after that. She was here for a couple of years, and then she was killed in a plane crash [in 2006]."

Jack passed away in 2008, but not before founding the Jack Clark Chair in Parkinson's Disease Research at the University of Toronto, and working with Mary to establish Highland Thoroughbred Frm, with former Amstrong Brothers broodmares as a foundation. The inaccurate farm name stuck.

"My manager at the time, when we were just starting off, said we should call it 'thoroughbred' because 'thoroughbred' has a lot more status," Mary said. "Basically, [pinhooking] didn't work out too well, so we transitioned to standardbreds. I really would like to change the name, because we are a standardbred breeding farm."

The Clarks purchased SJ's Image (2, 2:00.1f; \$57,198), Highland Kismet's maternal great-granddam, from the Armstrong Brothers' broodmare dispersal. Long known by their horses' "Armbro" prefix, the Inglewood, ON farm was Canada's top standardbred breeder for 50 years before winding down operations in the early 2000s. SJ's Image produced Highland Image (3, 1:54.1s; \$17,823), Highland Kismet's maternal granddam, in 2007.

Highland Image was exported to Italy in 2018.

"I sold her, unfortunately," Mary said. "I was collecting an awful lot of horses."

Highland Thoroughbred Frm made its reputation as a boutique breeder with a small staff and mares sometimes outsourced to other farms.

"Basically, we can manage," Mary said. "We only had, at our peak, five broodmares here... We have lots of land where they can get good grass... They have the whole summer to graze. We look after the horses really well here."

She said she considered Highland Kismet the reward for years of dedication to her horses.

"It's a matter of kismet, really, that all this happened," Mary said.
"It was just being in the right place at the right time."

The Sept. 21 Canadian Trotting Classic final at Mohawk has been the only real disappointment of Highland Kismet's season. Seven days later at The Red Mile, McClure guided the gelding to a muddy 1:55.1 romp in his Bluegrass Stake division, and explained what went wrong in the previous start.

"He just choked," McClure told interviewer Bob "Hollywood" Heyden. "He got ramped up getting out of there [in the CTC final at Mohawk], horses came out under him, and he was in a bad spot. I ended up shutting his air off and he run. I had no intention of racing him from off the pace, but I got caught in a similar situation, between two horses, and he didn't want to go up to the [starter] car. Luckily, though, he was an absolute sweetheart in the hole, and the way it all worked out, that's the way you want to go into the [Kentucky] Futurity. That's probably as good or the best he's been."

Harness Racing Update

Mary said she couldn't attend The Red Mile for the Bluegrass, but she watched it from home and appreciated McClure's explanation of Highland Kismet's rare miscue.

"I was really proud of Bob for mentioning that," she said.

The proprietor of Highland Thoroughbred Frm said that 2024 is a pivotal year for the Ontario standardbred nursery.

"I wish I was [younger]," Mary told HRU. "Then I would keep going. I do sell some, but I am 83, so I am divesting myself. The horses that are going to Mark [Etsell] this year will be the last horses. I'm not producing any more babies. I'm a very tenacious person. I don't give up easily, but you've got to face reality when you're in your 80s and you've got to plan for the life of your horses after you're not here."

Mary said she intended to sell Highland Top Hill this fall, and to sell her 2024 King Of The North filly, Highland Firen Ice, as a yearling next fall. Spring Station of Midway, KY will handle the consignments.

Her only pacing broodmare, the unraced Highlandbeachbelle, is at Diamond Creek Farm and in foal to Bettors Delight.

"She's the last one of the series," Mary said. "I've got to be careful I don't breed more and more horses. I have seven retired horses here, and of course Kismet's mother [Highland Top Hill], Highlandbeachbelle, and four going into training with Mark [Etsell] late this year. And that's it."

But it's far from the end of her love affair with standardbreds.

"I do have this propensity for keeping my horses," she said. "You do get a little concerned about their maintenance and where

they're going to go and how many you're going to have. I even take back some of my horses that I've sold."

Highland Kismet represents the past and future of Highland Thoroughbred Frm.

"I'm looking forward to many more good years with him," said Mary, calling the late-blooming trotter her "cool dude" despite some hot temperaments on both sides of his pedigree. "He's not an excitable horse. You feel very comfortable when you're around him. Actually, you feel very peaceful when you're around him. He's just a special, special horse."

Asked about 2024 Breeders Crown plans, Mary replied that she had one: "To win. And I will be there for that one, for sure."

She said Highland Kismet will winter comfortably in Kentucky after the Oct. 26 championships at The Meadowlands, and return to racing next year.

Mary called Highland Kismet a welcome culmination of her dreams, one who will stay with her even as she scales back in the industry.

"I love animals anyway, so it's wonderful to love an animal and have him reward you at the same time," she said. "Animals reward you anyway, but he's really rewarding me as best he can."

40th anniversary of the first ever Breeders Crown

On Oct. 5, 1984, The Red Mile played host to the very first Breeders Crown which was for freshman colt trotters. The first ever winner was Workaholic, a son of Speedy Crown out of Ah So. The \$167,000 Harrisburg yearling raced for the Workaholics Stable which was made up of businessmen from the Eastern shore of Maryland: Ken Heineken and Paul Ewell, the major decision-makers, along with Harold "Chip" Gordy, Bruce Moore and Bob Warfield.

Hakan Wallner trained the colt who would catapult to divisional honors on the strength of this convincing two-length score over nemesis Prakas. Berndt Lindstedt drove him for the first time as fellow Swede Jan Johnson had handled the occasionally cantankerous colt prior.

Workaholic went off at 5-1 and that the first Breeders Crown was not the only featured event that day. It landed on Kentucky Futurity Day in 1984.

The excellent yearling choice by the Workaholic group was far from their only one. Just the week before the initial Crown, they plunked down \$210,000 for a yearling named Royal Prestige — also a Speedy Crown — who'd go on to a stellar career that culminated in a 13-for-19 sophomore season and a Hambletonian runner-up finish as the favorite. Then, they did it again, for the third-straight year in 1985, buying a colt by the name of Friendly Face.

But back to Workaholic. He never did top this moment in the sun and at 3 was timed in 1:54.3 (his best), but just fourth in a heat of the World Trotting Derby. He was placed second in the Breeders Crown behind Prakas. He then went to stand stud for three seasons in New Jersey before heading to France. There he was met with near 3,000 applications for his first-year services forcing a lottery-draw. He did make his presence felt there, but here, he will forever be known as the one who got the ball rolling in the now 40th anniversary year of the Breeders Crown.

AN OCT. 2 CONNECTION BETWEEN ALBATROSS AND SUPER BOWL

It's pretty hard to believe the connection that these two superstars — Albatross and Super Bowl — had in their lives. On Oct. 2 this year we marked the 25th anniversary of the passing of Super Bowl.

First, a little history. They both starred in 1971-72 in the Stanley Dancer barn; Albatross as two-time HOY and Super Bowl as a freshman star then a Triple Crown winner in 1972 and HOY runner-up.

They both then went to Hanover Shoe Farms for a storied quarter century stud career. Both lived to age 30 with Albatross — a foal of 1968 — passing on Aug. 5, 1998 and Super Bowl on Oct. 2, 1999.

In 1972, Super Bowl won twice on Kentucky Futurity Day, the heat and final, with a flat tire. Super Bowl was the eighth and final Stars Pride Hambletonian credit.

Not to be outdone, Albatross had an epic day himself on Oct. 2, 1971. The very first Tattersalls was held that year, and the son of Meadow Skipper made it his own personal showcase with back-to-back 1:54.4 victories, the first and second sub 1:55 race miles ever. And they were adventurous to say the least. The first heat saw him starting from the second tier and was 10th at the quarter. As he was rolling the middle half he then shied from a swirl of leaves in his face. No matter. World record time. Then, starting from post 1, he got away sixth in a pedestrian 30 second opener. No problem. He then roared through an epic middle half reaching three quarters in 1:26.2 before maintaining to yet another world-record mile.

Albatross wound up 1971 25-for-28 and was an easy choice for harness racing's best.

That was 53 years ago for Albatross, and his buddy Super Bowl would pass away on that very day a quarter century ago. A fabulous lifetime together both on and off the track, and in the history books.

A COUPLE OF RARE JOHN CAMPBELL NOTES

It's been seven years plus since John Campbell's last competitive drive (June, 30 2017) but he's still quite visible heading the Hambletonian Society. Here are a pair of John Campbell facts from way back that I believe are first hitting the surface.

1. Campbell and Niatross. Niatross burst upon the scene in 1979 the year Campbell won his first of 16 Meadowlands driving titles and 16 national earnings titles. But, did Campbell race against Niatross and hit the board at all? Yes.

On Aug. 2, 1980 at The Meadowlands in the \$125,500 Oliver Wendell Holmes. In a historic event where for the one and only time in Meadowlands history where three second tier horses went 1-2-3! Niatross won it from post 13 and actually paid \$2.60, \$2.40 and \$2.40 to show. Storm Damage, post 12, had the first-time services of Joe O'Brien and finished second (\$4) and the same \$4 to show, and Royce with Campbell from post 14 was third, despite being 50-1 on the morning line, and paid \$7 to show.

Campbell had driven the son of Albatross last on June 28 at Yonkers, and the next year Royce would be voted the Older Pacer of the Year, posting three 1:53.4 victories along the way. This is the horse -

Royce — who became Campbell's very first divisional champion.

2. This one I thought deserved oxygen mainly because, as we count down to Hambletonian #100, anyone similarly having a milestone anywhere near that would likely get overshadowed. One week before the Hambletonian hits the century mark the first Saturday of August in 2025, the Monticello OTB Classic turns 50!

On July 27,1975, with \$230,100 on the line, it was the richest race ever held to that point. Silk Stockings turned the tables on the boys in a new track record.

What does this have to do with John Campbell you ask? Glad to oblige. You see a 20-year-old Campbell was on that very program. Campbell was in the opener with Argyle Fay in a B-3 pace for \$2,300 finishing third in the 2:06 mile. He trained too and his grandfather Dunc Campbell owned. John was then second best in race 3 with Shirley Duke for owner Murray Mackey of Ontario, another one conditioned by John, this was a B-1 contest that went in 2:02.1. I can't prove the following sentence but it makes great sense. For the first time ever John Campbell and Billy Haughton drove in consecutive races at any racetrack. Haughton, 51, was fourth in the \$10,000 OTB Classic consolation with Meadow Roy. Interesting to note this was the only Haughton entrant on the entire card; this coming a year after the "Green Wave" (AKA: Team Haughton) won an unheard of 88 stakes races in 1974.

Oh, one more item. In an era where Monticello was getting some of the best concerts right on track-the front cover program advertisement looked like this: Pointer Sisters July 28-31... Barry Manilow Aug. 4-6... Lesley Gore Aug. 7-8... Eddie Fisher Aug. 12-15 "The Catskills Favorite Son."







Rookie trotters wrap Indiana Sire Stakes with formful finish

Rookie trotters took to the track Tuesday (Oct. 1) at Harrah's Hoosier Park for the sixth and final leg of Indiana Sire Stakes prior to the \$250,000 Super Finals on Friday (Oct. 11). There were two divisions for both the trotting colts and fillies on the evening, with the bettors proving to be dialed in on the young trotters.

Starlitfranknstein kicked off the stakes action on the evening, leading every step of the way en route to a dominant victory as the 3-5 favorite in the first of two \$66,000 splits for trotting colts. Leaving from post 3, driver Trace Tetrick pointed Starlitfranknstein right to the front, trotting with the lead to an opening quarter of :28.3 in front of 53-1 pocket-sitter, Flight To Broadway (Logan Loney). The pace slowed to the half in :58.4 before Starlitfranknstein opened up entering the final turn, trotting away by five lengths at three-quarters in 1:27.3 as Kansas Boy (LeWayne Miller) moved around Flight To Broadway for second. Trotting home in :27.2, Starlitfranknstein would not be caught, coasting to a

3¾-length victory in 1:55. Tarzan (Mike Oosting) rallied for place, Kansas Boy held for third.

Trained by Ron Burke, Starlitfranknstein has won three of eight in his freshman campaign, hitting the board six times while banking \$129,327. Bred by John Wagler, the son of Swan For All—A Southern Lily was a \$12,000 purchase at last fall's Hoosier Classic Yearling Sale and is owned by Burke Racing Stable, Weaver Bruscemi, Beasty and Frank Baldachino.

The second division saw **Eugene The Genius** return to the winner's circle following a third-place effort in his last outing in the \$390,000 Peter Haughton Memorial behind Maryland. Sent off as the 2-5 choice from post 2, regular pilot Mike Oosting floated Eugene The Genius to the front early, parked to the outside of Kody Kickstand (Ricky Macomber, Jr.) through an opening quarter of :27.3. Eugene The Genius cleared to the lead on the backstretch, slowing things down in the middle half with fractions of :58 and 1:27.4. Eugene The Genius kicked clear at the head of the



lane, sprinting away with a :27.1 final quarter to cross the wire 3¼-lengths clear in 1:55. Sure Did (Marvin Luna) slipped up the passing lane to finish second, Bluebird Ladychuck (Dan Shetler) closed at 29-1 to be third.

The leading points earner across the six legs of Sire Stakes heading into the Super Final, the Missy Essig trainee has won seven of nine on the year and yet to miss the board. The gelded son of Helpisontheway—Muscle Baby Doll was bred by Black Creek Farm and Hickory Hollow Stables and has banked \$230.745 for owners Russ Beeman and Charles Weaver.

The 5-2 second-choice, **Woodside Izz**, used front-stepping tactics to take the first of two \$68,500 splits for the trotting fillies. Miller and Woodside Izz glided around 3-5 favorite Swan Jewel (Tetrick) to grab early command through a quarter of :28.4. The pace slowed considerably into the wind on the way to the half, with Woodside Izz reaching that station in 1:00.1 before leading to three-quarters unchallenged in 1:30. The stage was then set for a sprint for home, with Swan Jewel pulling alongside Woodside Izz in the lane as the duo battled to the wire. In her haste, Swan Jewel jumped it off just prior to the line, allowing Woodside Izz to reach the wire alone up front by 1¼ lengths in 1:57.2. Swan Jewel was not deemed to be lapped-on crossing the wire, holding for place, while Kelsey's Reason (Luna) was third.


Susan Miller trains the daughter of Dover Dan—Diamond Peak who has won four of nine on the season while banking \$136,925. The \$11,000 yearling purchase was bred by Lester Beechy and is owned by L+N Racing, Richard Freese, Platinum Stables and Matthew Lamont.


Miracle Maven and John De Long utilized similar front-end tactics to conclude the stakes action in the second division for trotting fillies. The 1-5 favorite took command immediately off the gate, trotting to the first quarter 2½-lengths clear of pocket-sitter Bluebird Lola (Tetrick) at the first quarter in :28. Bluebird Lola closed to the De Long helmet at the half in :57.3 as the duo trotted well clear of the remainder of the field. Miracle Maven gained separation once again on Bluebird Lola on the final turn, trotting to a 4½-length lead at three-quarters in 1:27.1. Bluebird Lola would yo-yo once more back to within reach of the leader in the lane, however it was Miracle Maven who held sway up front by 1¼ lengths in 1:56.1. Martz Seven (Mike Peterson) finished third, 7¼-lengths back of the leader.

The daughter of Don't Let'em—Bad Babysitter is trained by Henry Graber, Jr. for owners Elen Star Stables, Frank Baldachino, Beasty and Hillside Stables. Bred by Noah Wickey, the \$8,500 bargain buy at the 2023 Midwest Classic sports career earnings of \$146,020 while winning five of eight on the year.

The top-10 points earners across the six legs from each division qualify for the \$250,000 Super Finals on Hoosier Champions Night at Harrah's Hoosier Park on Friday (Oct. 11).

Belmondo sets Mass Breeders Stakes record at Plainridge

Another record was broken in the Massachusetts Breeders Stakes at Plainridge Park on Tuesday (Oct. 1) afternoon and another was tied in the second leg for 2-year-olds of both gaits and sexes who lined up behind the gate in seven races that totaled \$315,000 in purse money.

The pacing and trotting fillies, along with the pacing colts and geldings all went in two \$40,000 splits due to the number of entries, while trotting colts and geldings competed in one \$75,000 dash.

Drivers Brett Beckwith and Marcus Miller were tops in the bike as they both had two winners in stakes competition.

The new standard was established in the \$75,000 trot for colts and geldings where **Belmondo** (Walner-Love Lockedon) got a perfect trip and struck late in record time

Belmondo (Marcus Miller) lined up behind Castel Lindy (Yannick Gingras) off the gate and followed his live cover through quarters of :28, :57.2 and 1:26, where My Degenerate (Tyler Miller) made his way to second heading into the last turn. But when they got to the top of the stretch, My Degenerate broke, giving Miller a clear shot with Belmondo, who trotted furiously past Castel Lindy to win by 2¾ lengths in 1:55.

The time was a lifetime mark for the winner in his first career victory, a new stakes record for a 2-year-old male trotter and a new track record for a 2-year-old trotting gelding.

Belmondo (\$8.40) is owned by the Andy Miller Stable, One Legend Stable and Jean Goehlen and is trained by Julie Miller.

Lindy Farms of Connecticut bred Belmondo.

The stakes record that was tied came in the first division of trotting fillies where **R Lady W** (Walner—Born Lindy) captured her first lifetime win.

R Lady W (Brett Beckwith) was sitting second at the quarter behind Corner Store (Gingras) until Corner Store made a break at the three-eighths pole and pulled to the outside. From there, R Lady W opened up a three-length advantage and found herself at the half in an easy :59.3 R Lady W picked up the tempo from there by putting together back-to-back quarters of :28.2 and :28.1 to finish the mile in 1:56.1 for the win.

The time was a new lifetime mark and also tied the stakes record for 2-year-old trotting fillies.

R Lady W (\$5.40) is leased by M & L of Delaware and trained by Linda Toscano.

Lindy Farms of Connecticut also bred R Lady W.

The second division of trotting fillies was won by **Riviera Princess** (Cantab Hall—Dubai Princess) who turned in the mile of her life.

Gingras sent Riviera Princess to the point from post 6 and dominated the field from there. Leading by 1½ lengths the whole way, Riviera Princess stopped the clock in :30.1, 1:00 and 1:29.2 before turning for home and scooting away by six lengths in a :28.1 final panel to win in 1:57.3.

Riviera Princess (\$4.40) broke her maiden with a stakes victory for owner K R Breeding and trainer Domenico Cecere.

Greathorse bred Riviera Princess.

Stellar performances were put in by both divisions of pacing colts and geldings.

In the first, **Digging For Gold** (Huntsville—Gold Orchid N) got his second straight Mass stakes victory.

Digging For Gold (Nick Graffam) led to the quarter before Jon I Love Dat (Mitchell Cushing) rolled up the outside to take command. Now sitting second, Digging For Gold followed the leader to the half in :55.4 and then pulled just before the 1:24.3 three-quarters to take the lead back from Jon I Love Dat in the last turn. In the stretch,

Graffam line-drove Digging For Gold to the line on top by 1½ lengths in 1:53.

It was the sixth win in only nine starts for Digging for Gold (\$3.80) who is owned by his trainer George Ducharme, in partnership with Jim Winske and Dr. Megan Moschgat.

Bamq bred the winner.

The second group of freshmen pacing males saw a major upset when **Mass Transit** (American Ideal—Spreckles) closed late to win at 33-1.

Mass Transit (Ron Cushing) got away a distant fifth as McCusker (Bruce Ranger) blazed a trail to the quarter in :26.3 and the half in :54 on top by four lengths. When McCusker got to three-quarters in 1:22.2, the field had reeled him in and Seafood Star (Matty Athearn) was pacing alongside as Mass Transit was now only four lengths off in fifth. The field bunched at the top of the stretch and Mass Transit found himself four-wide in the middle of the track and making up ground with every stride. Then just before the line, Mass Transit took the lead by three-quarters of a length and won in 1:53.3 to set a new career mark.

It was the first lifetime win in only his third lifetime start for Mass Transit (\$69.60) who is owned by EVM Racing, Stephen Demeter and Team Tritton and trained by Shane Tritton.

The Chesapeake Equine Clinic bred Mass Transit.

There were also two divisions of pacing fillies that went to post.

First, **Beantown Deuce** (Huntsville – Don't Think Twice) got her second straight stakes victory in her best performance to date.

American Lily (Steve Rybka) was leading the way as Beantown Deuce (Beckwith) was covered in second, enjoying the trip. After they reached the half in :57.2, Gingras pulled It's Crunch Time from third and rocketed to the lead by three-quarters. But just like that, It's Crunch Time made an untimely break, leaving American Lily, Beantown Deuce and a now interested Chasing Dudes (Graffam) just a length apart at the top of the stretch. As they made their way down the stretch, Beantown Deuce did the better work of the three and pulled away to a two length win in 1:54.4, taking a new lifetime mark in the lone non-betting event of the day.

Beantown Deuce is owned by Michael Goldberg Racing, who also bred the filly in conjunction with Andrew Harris Racing.

The second set of filly pacers was bested by **Wassail Blue Chip** (Courtly Choice—Baccara Hanover) who had control of the race from start to finish.

Marcus Miller had Wassail Blue Chip in front through quarters of :28.4, :59.1 and 1:27.3, where Moneymakesherhappy

(Beckwith) who had recovered from an earlier break and was now second on the outside. That challenge lasted to the top of the stretch where Wassail Blue Chip paced away from Moneymakesherhappy while holding off the pocket-sitting Beantown Roberta (Athearn) in deep stretch to win by $1\frac{3}{4}$ lengths in 1:56.1.

It was the third win in the last four starts for Wassail Blue Chip (\$2.10) who is owned by his trainer Erv Miller, in partnership with Andray Farm and David Miller.

Blue Chip Bloodstock bred Wassail Blue Chip.

THREE RECORDS FALL IN MASS BREEDER STAKES AT PLAINRIDGE

It was a record-breaking day in the Massachusetts Breeders Stakes at Plainridge Park on Monday (Sept. 30) afternoon after three stakes standards were rewritten by some of the finest state-bred 3-year-olds who were competing in the second leg of the series whose five races were valued at \$305,000.

The pacing fillies went in two \$40,000 splits due to the number of entries while all other divisions competed in one \$75,000 dash.

The connections of driver Yannick Gingras, trainer Ron Burke and owners Thomas and Scott Dillon had a big day as they sent two record-breaking horses to post while another talented triumvirate of driver Bruce Ranger, trainer Domenico Cecere and owner/breeder Lindy Farms of Connecticut also boasted a record-setter in one of their two stakes wins.

Gingras, Burke and Dillon got started in the \$75,000 pace for colts and geldings where they saw their **Rocknroll Lou** (Sweet Lou—Beautiful Lady) win his second straight Mass Stakes start in record time.

Rocknroll Lou got away third as O'er The Ramparts (Brett Beckwith) and Bang Ah Uey (Jimmy Hardy) traded leads in the :26.3 first quarter. After Bang Ah Uey finally crossed over, he settled in and got to the half in :55 before heading up the backstretch. As the race passed five-eighths, Gingras tipped Rocknroll Lou and bolted to the front before three-quarters, but couldn't clear a defiant Bang Ah Uey around the last turn. But at the top of the stretch, Gingras asked more of Rocknroll Lou and he delivered, pacing home on top by $2\frac{3}{4}$ lengths in 1:51.1.

The clocking was the fastest mile of his life for Rocknroll Lou (\$2.10), who also set a new stakes record for 3-year-old male pacers and became the fastest 3-year-old pacing gelding ever bred in Massachusetts.

Rocknroll Lou was bred by Lester Gelardi and Anthony Passafaro.

The Gingras, Burke and Dillon trio also won with **Every Mans Dream** (Always B Miki – Lindy's Nightmare) who made it two in a row in the first \$40,000 leg for 3-year-old pacing fillies.

Color Me Sweet (Beckwith) was bold on the front and cut the mile while Every Mans Dream (Gingras) sat in the pocket. Color Me Sweet stepped off fractions of :27.2,:56.4 and 1:25.1 before entering the last turn. It was there that Gingras tipped Every Mans Dream and in a matter of a few strides, went right past the leader and then stormed home on top by 3½ lengths in 1:52.4.

It was the third win of the year for Every Mans Dream in the non-betting event, who was bred by Lindy Farms of Connecticut.

Then the group of Ranger, Cecere and Lindy got to work and were responsible for the third stakes record of the day that came in the \$75,000 event for trotting fillies where their **Treatyofversailles** (International Moni—Birthright) turned in the mile of her life.

Dawn Of Lindy (Gingras) was the early leader until Ranger and Treatyofversailles came rolling up on the outside to take the lead past the quarter. From there, Treatyofversailles got to the half in :56.4 and three-quarters in 1:25.1 where Sassy Zaza (Beckwith) was making her bid on the outside. As they made their way through the far turn, Treatyofversailles started to separate from the field and in the stretch, pulled away to a 2¾ length victory in 1:53.4.

The time was a new lifetime mark for Treatyofversailles (\$4.40) and also rewrote the stakes record for 3-year-old filly trotters.

Ranger, Cecere and Lindy's second win came in the \$75,000 trot for colts and geldings where **Intl Blockade** (International Moni—Love N Lindy) bounced back from an untimely break last week.

Ranger shot right to the front with Intl Blockade and posted snappy and uncontested quarters of :27.4, :57.4 and 1:26.2 before facing a challenge from Keep Asking (Nick Graffam), who moved first-over from fourth to sidle the leader in the last turn. At the top of the stretch, Keep Asking had fought

his way to the lead, but the race was not over. Intl Blockade manned-up and came back strong, taking back the lead at the top of the stretch before trotting home under a line-drive by Ranger to win in 1:54.4.

It was the sixth win in only 10 starts this year for Intl Blockade (\$5.60).

The second \$40,000 split for pacing fillies went to **Beantown Ace** (Captain Crunch—Ace Of Pace) who got the nod in a blanket finish.

Real Shady Lady (Shawn Gray) grabbed the lead at the quarter from Valentine Rose (Matty Athearn), but Valentine Rose recaptured the front and led the single-file field to the half in :57.2. As the race made its way to three-quarters, Beantown Ace pulled first-over and drew even with the leader before entering the final bend. In that turn, Real Shady Lady tipped three-wide around both of them and things got really interesting. When the group turned for home, Beantown Ace pulled ahead of Valentine Rose and then held off Real Shady Lady and the late closing Who's Perfect (Heath Campbell) to win by a quarter-length in 1:55.3.

It was the third win of the year for Beantown Ace (\$6.20) who is owned and bred by Michael Goldberg Racing. George Ducharme trains the winner.

There was another impressive track record set in non-stakes action later in the card where **Leanne's Choice** (Courtly Choice—Village Madonna) turned in the fastest mile ever paced by a 3-year-old filly at Plainridge Park. And she did it as the only filly in the field against eight colts and geldings.

Making her first start since the Jugette in Delaware, OH, Leanne's Choice (Marcus Miller) led every step of the way en route to a $1\frac{3}{4}$ length victory in 1:50.2, which gave the filly a new lifetime mark and also set the new Plainridge standard.

Leanne's Choice (\$3.80) is owned by her trainer Erv Miller, in partnership with Ronald Michelon and Douglas Overhiser.

Racing resumes today (Oct. 3) at Plainridge Park at 2 p.m. and there will be a \$1,715 carryover in the Wicked Hi-5 pentafecta in race 6.
