# Fourth sale session "rocky" year-over-year

The session gross was down 25 per cent and the average was off 20 per cent. Through all four sessions, the gross of \$56,887,000 is down 6.8 per cent and the average of \$74,265 is down 6.2 per cent compared to 2024.

The fourth session of the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale was "definitely rocky" said co-sales manager David Reid.

Year-over-year, the gross of \$4,368,000 was down 25.6 per cent (from \$5,869,000 in 2024), the average of \$22,400 was down 20.6 per cent (from \$28,216) and the median of \$18,000 was down 10 per cent (from \$20,000).

"We sold fewer horses actually... 13 fewer horses [than last year]," Reid said. "So, we sold 6 per cent fewer horses

and our gross was down 25 per cent, average was down 20 and the median was down 10.

“So, for the sellers not a great day, but for the buyers it was a much better day. Truthfully, there’s a balance to that. In any market, that’s what you’re really going to try to do and rationalize in your head that you’ve got buyers that are going to pay X price and the sellers are trying to get X price and somewhere in the middle that’s where it’s going to meet. Today, it was just a little bit rougher... a little trickier, but I’m happy for the buyers that did the work and hopefully they feel that they got good value and they get good results from it.

“If you do your homework then you’re going to find buys and a number of people have come up here today and said they felt they got a really good buy or they stole this one or whatever.”

Reid stressed that the quality of horses, “did not drop off 20 per cent, the market did. So, here again, I think the proof will be in the pudding when they start training these horses and start racing them. There’s not that much of a difference from an individual point of view and even from a pedigree point of view. I think it was a market point of view.

“Whether the market is just getting a little sticky on funds or cash, I don’t know. We’ll find out when we get through the wash here, but the first four sessions were pretty healthy overall. There was a little bit of a drop off, but we’re talking a little different category [of horses today] but not significantly, so I’m surprised at the percentage of drop off because the horses don’t reflect that, in my opinion.”

Through the first four sessions, 766 yearlings have been sold for a total gross of \$56,887,000, an average of \$74,265 and a median of \$43,000. In all, 183 yearlings have been sold for \$100,000 or more. Through four days, the gross is down 6.8 per cent from 2024 (\$61,041,000), the average is down 6.2 per cent (\$79,171) and the median is down 4.4 per cent (\$45,000). Last year, five more horses had been sold through four days. Compared to the record sale of 2023, this year’s cumulative gross is off 10.4 per cent (\$63,458,800 in 2023), the average

is down 4.6 per cent (\$77,864) and the median is down 14 per cent (\$50,000).

“I’m a believer in the marketplace and the public auction is the best place to value a horse,” Reid said. “The results are not what we had hoped for today, but in totality it’s been a good week. It’s just a little unfortunate that we had a little bit of a dip today.”

Reid said he expects the sale will bounce back in tonight’s (Oct. 3) final session, which begins at 7 p.m.

“It’s more regional-based and I think the offerings that we have here [Friday] night are good,” Reid said. “There’s some freshman sires, some second-crop sires and then you get your proven sires and I expect there to be a good crowd here with good energy. I expect it to be a sold marketplace.”

On Thursday, three yearlings sold for \$100,000 or more, up from just one in 2024 and zero in 2023.

Topping the session was **Hip #727 Ebb N Flow**, a Green Manalishi S filly out of Hustle Heart purchased by Sabine Kagebrant, agent for Courant Inc., out of the Kentuckiana Farms consignment for \$145,000.

**Hip #730 Ivy Station**, a Papi Rob Hanover filly out of Indra Hanover, sold for \$110,000 to Rick Berks out of the Spring Station Bloodstock consignment.

**Hip #740 Sun Hawk**, a Bulldog Hanover colt out of Kiss Me Onthebeach, sold for \$100,000 to Brandon Arsenault, agent for Gregg McNair, out of the Hunterton consignment.

Kentuckiana led all consignors in sales on Thursday with \$862,000 for 37 sold. Hunterton was second (\$502,000 for 22), Winbak was third (\$449,000, 26), Preferred was fourth (\$444,000, 23).

“It was a little bumpy,” said Reid, referring to Preferred’s Thursday results. “The breeders, to sell these horses, they put them through the ring and have a certain expectation and I would say that some of them are disappointed today, but it’s not because horses weren’t exposed or because we had bad weather or because the buyers weren’t here... everything from a promotional point of view was on par and the market just acted accordingly.”

Through four sessions, Hunterton continues to lead with \$11,272,000 in sales for 106 yearlings. Preferred is second with \$8,106,000 for 111 horses. Kentuckiana is third with

\$7,049,000 for 113 horses. Crawford Farms is fourth with sales of \$4,489,000 for 46 yearlings.

Trainer Julie Miller has been one of the leading buyers in terms of quantity of horses acquired. So far, she has purchased 16 horses, spending \$1,540,000 to do so.

She said she purposely tried to pick her spots.

“I laugh all the time, I feel like a deer scene – I sit here and I wait and wait and I pounce on what I see walks by that looks phenomenal for our program,” Miller said. “I’m really blessed my owner, Jean Goehlen, stepped up this year and a couple of others. We’ve been really focusing on dual-eligible, but they really wanted to focus also on the New York program, so I’ve been able to find what we like – some Chapter Sevens, dual-eligible horses and making it work.

“We look Monday through Friday, but we always look through the whole catalog. Obviously, being a Jersey-based operation and having a satellite in Kentucky, we primarily focus on east coast and Kentucky, but there’s also nice Ohio-breds and Indiana-breds, so you never know when you’re going to find the diamonds in the rough. We try to do our homework and be diligent about what we purchase.

“We’re going to be here Friday looking. I’m looking forward to the Dana Parham sale and also Harrisburg. We just try to put the work in and find that horse that fits our program.

“At the start of the night, there might be 200 horses in the sale and we like, maybe, 80 of them, but I go by price. This year, we

really had a value budget. We said we were going to spend this much and stick to it and, God bless, only one horse went a little bit over our budget that we purchased. That's what we've been doing. I kind of always tend to go back to a family we've had success with or a mare you've had success with. We've had great luck with Walners and Muscle Hills, Chapter Sevens.

"We also had Venerate, we bought a Love You. We like to support new stallions. We got an Ecurie. I'm really happy with our broader base this year. We weren't just on certain stallions. We really have a nice influx of all horses. It's a great opportunity. Where else is it better to be than in Lexington buying horses?"

Through four sessions, Ake Svanstedt still leads all buyers with \$2,580,000 spent to take home 15 horses. Andrew Harris, agent for William Pollock, has spent \$2,285,000 and purchased eight horses. Marcus Melander has spent \$1,883,000 and landed 14 horses. Captain Corey led all stallions on Thursday with sales of \$373,000 for 12 sold, followed by Gimpanzee (\$306,000, 16), Bulldog Hanover (\$284,000, nine), Tactical Landing (\$256,000, 10), and Green Manalishi S (\$251,000, six).

Through the first four sessions, Walner offspring have, collectively, fetched \$10,495,000, followed by Chapter Seven (\$7,076,000), Muscle Hill (\$4,143,000), Captain Corey (\$3,716,000), and Bulldog Hanover (\$3,501,000).

in 1987 (2FT won by Nan's Catch) and 1988 (3FP won by Sweet Reflection), I was asked to try and give some small input.

Following dinner some of us joined Tom and Sue Charters and Ted Gewertz and Clair Chappell in the bar area at the Merrick Inn. And while I walked from my place to the restaurant (yes, I know that may be hard to believe but it's just about an eight-minute hike), Gunjan and Moira gave me a ride home.

Okay, now back to Thursday. Jenna Otten and her mom, Diane, were at the She Shed so I chatted with them for a few. The USTA's Rich Johnston and Cheyenne Christman were setting up the video equipment for the live feed of the draw, and their peer Wendy Ross was there as well. Emily Ratcliff and Bob Heyden also came upon the scene as they were going to serve as the on-air hosts.

Bob noted that this year is the 133rd renewal of the Kentucky Futurity, and then he spoke about what transpired in the 1954, 1962, and 1971 editions. With race secretary Tina Seekman and presiding judge Casey Larson handling the draw duties, the fields of the Futurity and companion Filly Futurity were held.

Drawing the trailing 11 post in the Futurity is the 2024 Dan Patch Award winner Maryland, who has raced admirably this year but has only five seconds and a third to show for it in seven starts. Drawing the outside 10 is the highly-regarded Emoticon Legacy, while likely race favorite Super Chapter will line up in post 4. And let's not overlook Go Dog Go (post 7) who, with hobbles for the first-time last time out in a Bluegrass split last Saturday at The Red Mile, won in 1:49.3, the fastest by a sophomore trotter in 2025.

There were about 30 people at the draw, including Nancy Takter, Jim Campbell, Marcus Johansson and Bernie Noren. I asked Bernie if it was any coincidence that he always makes the trip from his home in Sweden about the same time the NHL is getting ready to start its season. Bernie is a big hockey fan and we've talked NHL many times over the years.

Since it was in the low 80s and nary a cloud in the sky, it was hot so I decided to duck back into the shed to get cool for a few minutes. Ernie Martinez came in to say hello and he told me a few stories, mostly about the good old days with Bill Perretti.

Both trotting classics drew 11, which is the limit as per the conditions for the richest horses in 2025 being eligible. Also on Sunday's card, is the Allerage finals, including the event for older pacing mares.

There were rumors around that only Twin B Joe Fresh and Sylvia Hanover, the top two far and away in the division, were entered. I had heard also that there may or may not have been a third entry, which led to a discussion of whether or not the track would then just go with a match race?

I see that indeed that third horse was entered and the three mares will hit the track for Race 3 on Sunday night. No disrespect to the Jimmy Watson-trained Yankee B Something, who drew post 1, but it'll be a tough task against Twin B Joe Fresh (post 2) and Sylvia Hanover (post 3), who combined have won more than \$5 million.

Also on Sunday's card are a pair of Tattersalls divisions for 3-year-old male pacers. Recent Little Brown Jug champ Louprint, the top-ranked horse in North America, will be on the track in the second \$220,000 division (race 10), with that field also including Prince Hal Hanover. That race is the appetizer before the finale race 11, the traditional spot for the Kentucky Futurity.

Tonight, is the final session of the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale. Going into Thursday's fourth session, my sponsors, Steve and Cindy Stewart's Hunteerton Sales Agency, still lead the way with 84 sold for \$10,770,000 (an average of \$128,214). Applause has to go to Ake Svanstedt and Andrew Harris, both of whom have made purchases totaling more than \$2 million.

Let me insert here that applause has to also go to my hometown Tigers, who found a way to beat the Guardians and advance in the playoffs. Now it's on to Seattle.

If you are planning on heading out to the sale tonight, remember that an Eric Church concert at Rupp Arena gets underway at 7:30 p.m., so traffic will be heavy if you travel through downtown. Although the UK football team plays at Georgia at noon (UK is a three-TD underdog), things will be busy around town as Keeneland opens its thoroughbred meet today. Mike Vandeheede invited me earlier in the week to join him for a few races as he was gifted a box, but duties call for me to be at The Red Mile.

If you're planning on eating in the dining room at Fasig-Tipton tonight, I can tell you that the main entrees on the buffet are Glazed Ham and Beef Bourguignon. But if you are hungry much earlier and attending today's races (post time 1 p.m.) at The Red Mile, Winbak Farm is sponsoring an appreciation lunch on the backstretch beginning at noon.

I'll be back with you Saturday morning. And before closing, I can tell everybody that gas prices have dropped again in the Lexington area. After jumping from \$2.59 to \$2.99 and staying there for a day, I saw a huge decrease Thursday down a penny to \$2.98.

# AI can help race secretaries write more competitive races

New technology, such as artificial intelligence, is going to help race secretaries write more competitive races. Beyond that, it possesses the capabilities to do much more to make the sport of harness racing better, safer, and more entertaining.

Software developed by 1/ST called Racehorse 360 is designed to make use of artificial intelligence (AI) to enable race secretaries to write better races and to fill out more entertaining race cards.

This advancement in technology can initially act as a method for the race secretary to keep tabs on the inventory available for their track. The software identifies all of the horses that are housed in each trainer's stalls, and in what conditions they are a best fit for based on the horse's current performance charts.

It will also identify which of the races the software assembles figures to deliver the most profitable handle, so that those races can be carded earlier in the night, when they are more likely to generate the most profit for the track. This information is also generated through past performance data.

"It can identify eligible horses for carded races – specifically identifying those horses who are eligible for a particular race – and in conjunction with the health and welfare portion, it can identify horses who could potentially be scratched from the race due to veterinary reasons, allowing us to write safer races with fewer scratches," 1/ST Racing chief veterinary officer Dr. Dionne Benson said while speaking at the recent 72nd Annual Round Table Conference on matters pertaining to racing.

## FINNISH HARNESS RACING RELIES HEAVILY ON AI

In Finland, Suomen Hippos, the governing body for harness racing in the country, dove heavily into reliance on AI for all aspects of the sport, with glowingly-positive outcomes.

Finnish technology company HiQ developed an AI-driven race calendar for Suomen Hippos.

The problems facing Finnish harness racing aren't any different from what North American tracks deal with on a steady basis.

“The number of racing horses is declining, so we needed to ensure that the number of races matches regional demand,” said Arto Hytönen, director of harness racing at Suomen Hippos. “Additionally, we wanted to shorten travel distances to races, reducing the carbon footprint, improving horse welfare, and increasing cost efficiency for owners and trainers.”

As a data-driven sport, harness racing is a natural to draw benefits from what AI can offer. In Finland, the AI-driven race calendar created by HiQ for Suomen Hippos utilizes information such as horse statistics, stable locations, audience numbers, and betting turnover from races.

The company analyzed data on 700,000 horses and racing outcomes dating back to 1984 to arrive at its solution. HiQ developed a multi-phase algorithm that constructs the best possible race calendar by scoring race days and favoring local horses that have not competed too recently.

Jukka Niskanen, CIO of Suomen Hippos, pointed out that AI isn't replacing race secretaries. It is providing them with a tool to enable them to do their job more efficiently.

“In addition to reducing manual work, the new calendar allows us to justify decisions based on analyzed data from races and horses instead of relying on opinions and intuition,” Niskanen said. “AI-assisted scheduling makes data-driven decision-making a daily practice.

“We gain valuable factual insights from the data to support decisions, such as the total number of race days. The algorithm distributes race days evenly and flexibly across Finland, while also considering the preferences and criteria of racetracks, professionals, and hobbyists.”

## AI WILL ALSO MAKE RACING SAFER

The components of Racehorse 360 include tools to help veterinarians more easily identify lame horses that could be in danger of suffering further and more serious injuries.

The program uses AI to analyze video footage and identify horses on a track, providing veterinarians with real-time information on each horse.

## CHANGE IS COMING QUICKLY

This new technology is going to change the way racing operates in all manners, and it's going to happen quickly. Industry leaders are projecting that due to advancements brought about through AI, there will be more changes in horse racing over the next three years than in the previous 30 years. Expectations are that by 2028, at least 25 per cent of all racing-related decisions will be made with the assistance of AI.

AI isn't going to replace the human element in the sport. However, it's a guarantee that the humans who don't embrace the presence of AI and what it can do to benefit horse racing are going to be replaced.

And as those in the industry in Finland have been witness to, it is proving to be a change for the betterment of the sport.

“The AI tool strengthens the fact-based foundation for decision-making and the national placement of race days,” Hytönen said. “This supports not only the well-being of the horses but also that of their owners and the entire industry.”

# Nine-year-old Carsons Shadow learned some new tricks and continues to win

When Carsons Shadow arrived at trainer Gerard Demers' barn in mid-July, the seasoned pacer was mired in a 1-for-15 slump going back to that same time last year.

Though certainly not for a lack of effort, the scrappy war horse simply struggled to find his groove beyond a nine-length tally at Hanover Raceway on Sept. 7, and a runner-up finish at Grand River Raceway nine days later.

The lean stretch persisted into the fall and the early summer months of this year with Carsons Shadow failing to finish higher than fifth in seven starts following the brief September turnaround.

Still, something about the 9-year-old bay hinted he wasn't done just yet.

"I think he just needed a change of scenery," said Demers, who recorded career-highs across the board last season en route to his first million-dollar season.

"He was at the same spot for a long time – sometimes horses that have been in the same place for a while need a change – and I think he's fit really well in the program we have."

The Freelon, ON-based conditioner wasn't all that familiar with Carsons Shadow when owner Francois Morin called seeking his thoughts on the newly available horse.

But Demers knew that Morin was bullish on the son of Shadow Play—Carsons Ladyluck, and that was reason enough to cut the check.

"He's been good for us since day one," said Demers. "He's a little hot, but he's a solid horse with a lifetime mark of [1]:50, so we knew we had some speed coming in. We did our best to make sure he was sound and happy, and right now, he's giving us back what we gave him."

Carsons Shadow wasted no time rewarding his new connections, delivering a front-leading 2¼-length triumph in his July 20 debut at Georgian Downs.

What may have come as a surprise to some, did not to Demers.

"After I trained him the first time I told Francois, 'I think he'll be a winner the next start,'" Demers said.

While validated by Carsons Shadow's smooth score as the second choice in the field of six, Demers felt his new protégé was capable of even more.

"He raced with a blind bridle and he was pretty crazy, so he didn't finish his mile that well," the trainer said. "After that, we changed it, and now he's much better in the races. He's settled in nicely."

The adjustments paid immediate dividends, as the plucky pacer reached the winner's circle his next time out on July 27, also at Georgian.

A third at the Innisfil, ON oval one week later was then followed by a fourth in Carsons Shadow's first appearance at Woodbine Mohawk Park since Dec. 31, 2022.

Yet, the crafty veteran had no trouble turning the page.

In fact, Demers added, "he came back stronger."

Carsons Shadow got back in the win column on Aug. 24, circling the Georgian dirt in 1:55.4 to complete the comeback victory by three-quarters-of-a-length with driver Samuel Fillion in tow.

The gelding, bred by W. David Carson of Listowel, ON, has been on a tear ever since.

Carsons Shadow picked up another win at Georgian on Aug. 31 before rattling off three straight at Flamboro Downs to extend his current win streak to five – easily the longest such sequence of his 132-start career.

His most recent outing, a three-length tally, on Sept. 23, felt like déjà vu for Demers.

“He had the 7-hole, and I told Francois that I knew he’d be a winner again because he races from everywhere, and right now he’s on a roll,” Demers said. “When a horse is on a roll like that, they feel like they can’t be beaten.”

While the 30-time winner still runs hot on the track, he does everything right off the track to ensure he’s at his best when the starter car speeds away.

“At the barn, he’s a sweetheart,” Demers said. “You just do what you want with him. He’s a good eater, he likes to go outside, and he feels really good in the program I have. I think he’s really happy right now – he sure was at the race last week.”

Demers had never worked with a horse quite like Carsons Shadow – “one-of-a-kind,” in his words – prior to their union this past summer.

Their time together has proven, without a shadow of a doubt, that both old horses, and their wise trainers, can still learn new tricks.

“I always like challenges,” Demers said. “Challenge is my big thing, so when I get a horse that’s not really on a roll and I can help them, I do my best to help. It’s obviously harder if a horse is coming in with a mark of 2:10, but with him coming in at [1]:50, we know he’s been there. We just have to try to put him back where he was.

“He’s not the same as he was in his younger days, but we can still get him right for the class he’s racing. He’s a simple horse – he’s a small horse – but he’s got a big heart, and he tries hard every week. Right now, he’s on a roll.”

## Bazire shocks in Angers

Several of France's top trotters clashed in Wednesday's (Oct. 1) \$110,000 Grand Prix Anjou-Maine in Angers, and it ended in a big upset courtesy of Nicolas Bazire. The 1 15/16ths mile (3,125 meters) contest featured stars such as Izoard Vedaquais, Jushua Tree, Just A Gigolo, and Ideal du Rocher, but none could stop the longshot **Hymne du Gers** (Bold Eagle). Sitting the pocket throughout, the 8-year-old gelding sprinted clear in the lane to win easily for his trainer/driver Bazire. Sent off at 25-1, Hymne du Gers had shown little in his previous summer and fall starts, but given a perfect trip, he capitalized to score in a mile rate of 1:57.2 for the 1 15/16ths mile. Izoard Vedaquais, handicapped with a 25-meter disadvantage, finished strongly in second.

### UNTERSTEINER'S UNBEATEN STAR

A new star has emerged on the Swedish harness racing scene – and she's only 2 years old. Johan Untersteiner's **Cruiser** (Calgary Games) dazzled Wednesday night (Oct. 1) at Jägersro, capturing the \$110,000 Breeders Course final for 2-year-old fillies in record-breaking style. Cruiser gave her connections a scare when she broke stride behind the gate in the score-up, but quickly settled and was back on gait well before the start. Once the wings folded, she blasted to the front without issue. Untersteiner kept the tempo high throughout, and Cruiser powered home to an easy victory in a mile rate of 1:56 (1,640 meters) – a new European record for 2-year-old fillies. She is now undefeated in four career starts.

The colt and gelding division of the \$110,000 Breeders Course final went to **Reagan Boko** (Chelsea Boko), who impressed mightily with a gritty performance. Forced to race parked the entire way outside leader Revanche Boko, Reagan Boko still had enough in reserve to wear down his rival in the stretch and prevail in 1:58.2 for the mile.

The Paul Hagoort trainee is now two-for-two in his career, improving dramatically from his debut win at Victoria Park in the Netherlands (2:01.3 for the mile). The Jägersro victory was worth \$55,000.

# Fields set for 133rd Kentucky Futurity, 60th Kentucky Filly Futurity

The Red Mile drew the fields for the 133rd renewal of the Grade 1 Kentucky Futurity and the 60th renewal of the Grade 1 Kentucky Filly Futurity, the marquee races of the annual Grand Circuit meet that will be contested on Sunday (Oct. 5).

The Kentucky Futurity, traditionally the last race of the Grand Circuit fortnight, drew 11 horses, with post 11 starting from the second tier. Noel Daley, who teamed with Andy McCarthy last year when Sig Sauer gutted out a first-over trip through fast fractions for a 1:49.3 win, tries for a repeat in the Kentucky Futurity when sending Onajetplane, who enters off a third-place finish behind longshot Warrior and runner-up Super Chapter.

Super Chapter, runner-up in the 2025 Hambletonian, also entered as one of a five-prong battalion for trainer Marcus Melander, who won his first Kentucky Futurity when Greenshove scored a 1:51.1 victory in 2019. Melander also sends Bluegrass divisional winner Meshuggah along with freshman champion Maryland and two other pupils in Variegated and Mountcastle.

The Kentucky Futurity also matches up a pair of trotters that have breached the 1:50 threshold this season. Emoticon Hanover comes south from Canada, where he set a Canadian record with his 1:49.4 victory in the Canadian Trotting Classic. His 1:49.4 mark also stood as the national season's record for sophomore trotting males until Go Dog Go had an uncovered bid for a 1:49.3 win in Bluegrass action last week. Luc Blais, trainer of Emoticon Hanover, tries for his first win in the Kentucky Futurity as does Go Dog Go's conditioner Carter Pinske, who did win in the Kentucky Filly Futurity two years ago with Mommamia Volo alongside pilot Todd McCarthy.

A field of 11 will also go to the gate for the Grade 1 Kentucky Filly Futurity. Trainer John Butenschoen has an opportunity to land back-to-back victories in the classic debutante trot when sending R Dutchess to the gate, after he and driver Todd McCarthy paired with R Melina for a power-packed 1:50.1 victory on the point in last year's renewal of the Filly Futurity. This time Butenschoen has Tim Tetrick slated to drive R Dutchess in this year's Filly Futurity.

Delaney Hanover returns to The Red Mile after snapping the win streak of Yo Tillie, who was not paid to be eligible to the Filly Futurity and did not supplement into the race. The most prominent of the Hambletonian Oaks finalists entered with her third-place finish to Conversano, Delaney Hanover competes for trainer Lucas Wallin, who won in the 2022 Kentucky Futurity with Rebuff.

The field for the Kentucky Filly Futurity also includes a pair of Bluegrass division winners from last week in Champagne Problems and Kadena, whose dam Mission Brief finished runner-up in the 2015 renewal of the Filly Futurity to Wild Honey. The race also features a foal from 2018 Filly Futurity winner Atlanta in Deja Blu, who makes her third start since switching into trainer Ron Burke's barn.

## Burkholder looks to keep momentum going at The Red Mile

Matthew Burkholder, in the midst of his first million-dollar season, picked up his first Grand Circuit victory last week and will look to maintain the momentum on today when he sends out two morning-line favorites in divisions of the Grade 3 International Stallion Stakes at The Red Mile.

Requiem, coming off a 1:52.3 win in a division of last week's Grade 3 Bluegrass Stakes at The Red Mile, will get the action started for the 28-year-old trainer in today's first race, the first of four divisions of the International Stallion Stakes for 2-year-old male trotters. He is the 6-5 morning-line choice in the \$72,000 event, leaving from post 6 in a field of seven.

In the third division, going for a purse of \$73,000, Burkholder trainee Silverstein is the 9-5 morning-line chalk. He is coming off a third-place finish in the Mohawk Million and will start today from post 4.

David Miller will drive both trotters for Burkholder.

"It's definitely been a great year for us," said Burkholder, an Ohio native and resident who has seen his stable bank \$1.02 million this year, smashing his previous high of \$664,539 set just last season. "I try not to have many expectations; you just focus on doing your work, having the horses the best they can be, and the rest will take care of itself.

"We've gradually built the stable, and every year we try to get a little better. It's nice when you advance every year. That's the most important thing, I think. With success, you gain confidence, and I don't think confidence is a bad thing. Hopefully, we can build off this."

Requiem and Silverstein, two of the 30 horses in Burkholder's stable, are both owned by David McElrath's Dark Horse Farm. Silverstein was purchased for \$80,000 at the 2024 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale while Requiem was a \$45,000 buy at the same auction. The two trotters have combined to earn nearly \$367,000 this season.

"It's not just me; I have to thank the owners for buying me good horses," Burkholder said. "I really appreciate it, and the work of all the people around me."

Prior to having his own stable, Burkholder spent six years working with Ohio Harness Racing Hall of Fame trainer Marty Wollam.

"He's a great guy, and was a great guy to learn from," Burkholder said. "He taught me so much about conditioning."

Requiem, a son of Muscle Hill—Ostrich Blue Chip whose family includes past New York circuit standout Quincy Blue Chip, has hit the board in seven of eight races, winning three and earning \$102,500. His 1:52.3 Bluegrass triumph was a career best and the fourth consecutive start in which he lowered his time.

He began his season by racing in the Kentucky Sire Stakes at Oak Grove, posting two third-place finishes, then moved to the KYSS Commonwealth Series at The Red Mile. He finished third in the \$100,000 Commonwealth final on Sept. 15 and 10 days later won his \$82,000 Bluegrass division.

"He trained down really good; I was pretty high on him all winter long," Burkholder said. "Then at Oak Grove, he raced good, but he didn't race great. So, we started him in the Commonwealth (series), and he's improved every start. Last week, he was very good. David deserves credit for that too. He's developed him and brought him along and hasn't forced him to do anything.

"He's a very nice horse. He's even keeled. He's not aggressive, he just does what you ask him to do. Hopefully, he can continue forward."

Silverstein, a son of Chapter Seven—Shining Brightly out of the family of two-time Dan Patch Award-winner Passionate Glide, has hit the board in eight of nine races, with one victory and five second-place finishes. He has earned \$263,840.

His win came in a preliminary leg of the Kentucky Sire Stakes Championship Series and was followed by three consecutive seconds, with two of them behind eventual Championship Series final winner (and Mohawk Million runner-up) Endurance.

Silverstein, who was second to Endurance in the \$100,000 Kentucky Sire Stakes final at Oak Grove in mid-July, finished third in the Championship Series final on Sept. 14. In the Mohawk Million on Sept. 20 at Woodbine Mohawk Park, Silverstein was timed in 1:52.1 as he finished behind Apex and Endurance.

"It was a big thrill [to be in the Mohawk Million], especially at the top of the stretch when it looked like he had a chance," Burkholder said. "That was great. He raced super.

"But what a surprise he is. He didn't train down very good, made a lot of breaks. It seems like when he got behind the starting gate, he just started to figure it out, he started getting it. He's super consistent. He's trotted [1]:53 or better every week since his second start at Oak Grove. He's not a very big horse, but he's got a big heart. I'm very happy with him."

Neither Silverstein nor Requiem is Breeders Crown eligible, but the two trotters could continue their campaigns at Kentucky's Cumberland Run following the end of the meet at The Red Mile.

"We'll see how they are, but as long as they're doing good, we'll probably go," Burkholder said. "If they're healthy, I don't see why not."

Racing begins at 1 p.m. today at The Red Mile. In addition to the International Stallion Stakes divisions for the trotters, there are **three splits for 2-year-old female pacers**. For free programs, visit The **Red Mile website** and scroll down.

## SIRE STAKES REPORT

### De Long, Graber, Jr. sweep INSS divisions at Hoosier

The final legs of Indiana Sire Stakes for 2-year-old pacing fillies and 3-year-old trotting fillies were contested at Harrah's Hoosier Park on Wednesday (Oct. 1) with driver John De Long sweeping both divisions for pacing fillies and trainer Henry Graber, Jr. taking both splits for trotting fillies.

Two-year-old pacing fillies kicked off the stakes festivities with their \$67,000 first split won by **Rock The Charm** who pulled

a minor upset at 6-1. Leaving from the rail, Rock The Charm got away in the third spot while It's My Story (Trace Tetrick) charged to the top through an opening quarter of :26.4. The seven fillies raced single-file through middle-half fractions of :55.4 and 1:24.3. It's My Story brought the field into the stretch before being pounced on by 1-2 favorite Milliondollarimage (Jordan Ross) from the pocket with Rock The Charm following that move. Once tipped off the Ross helmet, Rock The Charm fired home in :26.1 to roll by the favorite late, winning by three-parts-of-a-length in 1:51.3 over Milliondollarimage and It's My Story holding for third.

The effort by Rock The Charm was a career best as the filly has now won two of seven lifetime for trainer Tabby De Long. Jesse De Long bred the daughter of Rockin Image—Seventimesacharm and also co-owns the earner of \$125,195 with John and William De Long.

The De Long tribe scored a win in the \$67,500 second division as well, this time with the Roger Welch trained **Whoomp** who entered off a win in the \$201,000 Kentuckiana Stallion Management in her last. Saddled with the outside post 8, De Long angled Whoomp into fifth early while Tell It Like This

(Trace Tetrick) grabbed early control through a first quarter of :27. Whoomp moved off the cones just before the half in :56.4, driving first-up around the final turn and into third as Tell It Like This reached three-quarters in 1:25. Pocket-sitter Somemore Blue (Marcus Miller) popped the pocket and moved around Tell It like This in the stretch before Whoomp steamrolled late in :26 to nail Somemore Blue by a half-length in 1:51.3. Tell It Like This held sway for the third spot.

Whoomp has now won three-in-a-row and seven of 12 this year good for earnings of \$224,601. William and Patrick De Long bred and co-own the daughter of Rockin Image—Nightcap along with Jesse De Long.

John De Long also teamed up with trainer Henry Graber, Jr. to take the second \$50,500 division for 3-year-old trotting fillies with **Miracle Maven** as the 8-5 second choice. Miracle Maven settled in the third position on the first turn while favored Fifty To Win (Marcus Miller) trotted around Bluebird Lola (Atlee Bender) to the top through a quarter of :26.4. Fifty To Win tapped the brakes to the half in :56.1 when Miracle Maven marched first-over and into second on the final turn with Fifty To Win reaching three-quarters in 1:25.1. Miracle Maven moved alongside Fifty To Win in the lane, with the two slugging it out the length of the lane before Miracle Maven got up by a head in 1:54 with a bottled-up Bluebird Lola finishing third.

Miracle Maven has now won five of nine on the year and 10 times in her career for owners Hillside Stables, Indiana Stables, Frank Baldachino, and Beasty LLC. The daughter of Don't Let Em—Bad Babysitter has banked \$167,545 on the year and went over \$300,000 for her career.

The first division earlier on the card went to Miracle Maven's stablemate as **Better Tak'em** delivered a 7-1 upset up the cones with driver Jordan Ross. Better Tak'em secured the pocket trip behind A Million Dances (Mike Oosting) who swept down from the outside post 9 to cut the quarter in :27. Oosting grabbed leather to the half in :57.1 when even-money favorite Martz Seven (Kyle Wilfong) started her first-over charge into second at three-quarters in 1:26.3. A Million Dances and Martz Seven went at it in the lane while Better Tak'em was desperate for racing room before finding room up the cones and winning by a head in a three-horse photo over A Million Dances and Martz Seven in 1:54.3.

A winner in three of nine this season, Better Tak'em has tallied seasonal earnings of \$167,470 for owners Henry Graber, Jr. and Indiana Stables. The daughter of Don't Le Em—Barmaid surpassed career earnings of \$285,000 following her seventh career victory.

### Thiskissformaryell fastest of DSBF trotters Wednesday

A quartet of \$20,000 Delaware Standardbred Breeders Fund (DSBF) first leg divisions for 2-year-old trotters were contested on the Wednesday at Harrington Raceway.

Whodathunkit Stable's **Dancing Willow** (\$15, Jason Green) kicked things off with a 2:03.4 win off a first-over grind over Rainingrainbows and Ridley Park. The Dusty Winner filly notched her first career victory for trainer Cliff Green.

In the second filly division, Emerys Angel (Top Flight Angel) did the heavy lifting, setting the pace throughout while favorite **Tuis Star** (E L Platinum) bided her time and charged at the leader to three-quarters and edged clear to draw away from the early leader for a one-length win in 2:03.1. Sheas Bluestone was a distant third. Tuis Star (\$2.10, Corey Callahan) is owned by Don and David Wiest and trained by the latter.

The first colt and gelding division saw heavy favorite, Nanticoke Racing, James Magno, and Joe Fonte's **Thiskissformaryell** (\$2.20, Jim Morand) prevail in 2:02.4 over Prime Yield and Wingspan, the fastest elimination on the program. The Iron Mine Bucky gelding notched his second straight win for trainer Les Givens.

Jo Ann Looney-King's **Pappy's Deal** (\$3, Allan Davis) was a 2:04.2 winner in the second division for trainer Jim King, Jr. The Xactly Hanover gelding was on the front for the back-half and held off Swee'pea and Winging It for his first career win.

On the undercard, Austin Stafford and Wyatt Starkey's **Navy Blue** (\$10.60, Art Stafford, Jr.) won the \$14,500 winners-over trot in 1:56.2 over Kodack Black and Secret Jet. It equaled a lifetime mark for Navy Blue.

Wagenhoffer Racing and E&K Stable's **Tom Creek** (\$4.40, Eddie Dennis) triumphed for the third straight race for trainer William Wagenhoffer in 1:57.2. The 4-year-old Long Tim gelding scored his sixth win at the meet.

Art Stafford, Jr. and Jason Thompson each had three wins on the card.

The top 8 point earners from the two legs will return to compete in the \$110,000 final on Oct. 15.

## Frantic Hanover tries for rebound in Saturday's International Stallion Stakes

Frantic Hanover comes south to Lexington off a defeat in the CA\$1,000,000 Grade 1 Metro Pace at Woodbine Mohawk Park and looks to return to his winning ways in the second of three divisions for the \$264,000 International Stallion Stakes for 2-year-old pacing males on Saturday (Oct. 4) at The Red Mile.

A colt by Stay Hungry—Francessa, Frantic Hanover suffered the only defeat of his career when sitting a bottled up trip in the pocket and obtaining clearance too late in the Metro Pace, settling for second to local sensation Beau Jangles. Tim Tetrick pilots the Ron Burke trainee from post 7, listed at 6-5 on the morning line, in a nine-horse contest carded as race 10 and sponsored by the Beach Glass Syndicate and Winbak Farm. This division also draws Andrew Harris trainee Brandon Blvd, who enters off a 1:49.1 win at 1-9 in his Bluegrass division last week. Dexter Dunn drives the colt by Downbytheseaside—Alexis Faith from post 9. Signal Caller, a 1:48.4 winner in a Bluegrass division when capitalizing on fast fractions set by Thai Hanover (who competes in this division from post 6), also lands in this contest from post 4 with Andy McCarthy driving for trainer Noel Daley.

Ron Burke also sends the morning line favorite in the first division for freshman pacing males, scheduled as race 3 on the day and sponsored by the Captaintreacherous Syndicate and Hanover Shoe Farms. Bluegrass division winner Melillo, a homebred Sweet Lou—Rosemary Rose colt, starts from post 6 off a 1:50.1 victory under wraps at odds of 1-9 and retains Yannick Gingras between the wheels. Melillo is one of three in the division for Burke, with his other two being Bluegrass division runners-up Winnercircleseeker from post 5 with Chris Page driving and Another C Note from post 9 with Tim Tetrick at the lines. The field also attracts Daniel Lagace's Sweet Lou—Lover's Dream colt Sweet Lovin Lou, who will start from post 4 after a third-place closing effort in the Metro Pace two weeks ago.

And then in the closing division for freshman pacing males, which is carded as race 11 and sponsored by Midland Acres, Burke again packs the strongest punch with the three favorites on the morning line. Regally bred Ubrute, a colt by Tall Dark Stranger—Warrawee Ubeaut set as the 6-5 morning line chalk, looks to improve from his runner-up effort to Signal Caller in that

quick-clip Bluegrass division. He starts just outside of Al Papi, a homebred Papi Rob Hanover—Baron Remy colt who finished runner-up to Frantic Hanover in the \$300,000 Pennsylvania Sire Stakes final on Sept. 5, in post 5 and a few slots wide of stablemate Lindy Dragonwater, a Downbytheseaside—Imagine Dragon gelding returning to Lexington off a 1:51 victory at odds-on in the Ohio Sire Stakes championship. Dunn will drive Al Papi while Page has the call on Lindy Dragonwater.

Saturday's card also features three divisions of the \$324,000 International Stallion Stakes for 2-year-old trotting fillies starting with Race 4, which is sponsored by the Tactical Landing Syndicate and Hickory Lane Farm. Jim Oscarsson pupil Southwind Chaska returns off a lifetime-best 1:51.4 win in a Bluegrass division as the 9-5 morning line choice from post 4 with Tim Tetrick in the bike. She starts inside of Emmas Mystery CCL, a Noel Daley-trained daughter of Muscle Hill—Mystery Woman, as the New Jersey Sires Stakes champion enters here following a third-place effort as the 6-5 favorite in the Kentuckiana Stallion Management Stakes at Harrah's Hoosier Park two weeks ago. Andy McCarthy has the drive from post 5.

The second division for freshman trotting fillies, carded as race 6 and sponsored by the Captain Corey Syndicate and Hanover Shoe Farms, aligns Bluegrass divisional winners Sparks and Jailbird Jog from bookend posts. Trainer Ake Svanstedt steers Sparks, a Walner—Sheer Energy filly, off a stalking burst to a 1:53.1 win in her division, from the pylon post while James MacDonald navigates Jailbird Jog, a Tactical Landing—Miss Don Fanucci S filly, out of post 9 for trainer Eric Patalan following her effortless 1:52.2 win in her division last week. Meanwhile, trainer Noel Daley sends the 9-5 morning line favorite with Carve, a daughter of Captain Corey—Alpine, fresh from a runner-up effort to Southwind Chaska as the 3-2 favorite in her Bluegrass division. Andy McCarthy has the drive out of post 4.

Freshman trotting fillies wrap their afternoon assignments in race 8, a division sponsored by Tara Hills Stud. Jim Doherty Memorial champion Atlantic Summer earns morning-line favoritism with a 2-1 listing as she looks to make amends from an eighth-place finish in the Kentuckiana Stallion Management Stakes two weeks ago. Gingras drives the Ron Burke-trained Captain Corey—Perfect Summer K filly from post 7 in the nine-horse affair.

Saturday's 13-race card also features a \$7,500 guarantee in the Early Pick 4, which begins in race 6. Every Pick 4, as well as the 50-cent Pick 5, at The Red Mile features an industry-low takeout of 12 per cent.

First-race post time at The Red Mile is 1 p.m. (EDT).
