Record Mixed Sale thrusts 2025 Black Book sessions to all-time numbers

A tremendous, record-breaking Mixed Sale grossed \$38.5 million which pushed the total sale gross to the cusp of \$75 million, by far the best total in the sale's 87-year history.

A roaring 2025 Mixed Sale for the Standardbred Horse Sales Company rebounded a week of slight declines to record highs. The closing session on Friday (Nov. 7) in Harrisburg, PA wrapped a week of auction action that handily crushed the all-time record for gross at the sale.

The 2025 Mixed Sale grossed 21.9 per cent more year-over-year with \$38,518,500 from 699 sold for an average of \$55,184, which also sets a record with a 4.2 per cent increase over the previous best average of \$52,945 from last year's Mixed Sale. On the winds of these figures, the overall Standardbred Horse Sales Company auction grossed \$74,574,000 from 1,563 sold for an average of \$47,712, besting the previous record gross of \$70,228,377 from the 2007 sale by 6.2 per cent.

"This Mixed Sale, it was unbelievable," said Dale Welk, president and director of operations for the Standardbred Horse Sales Company. "I was in my office and I couldn't believe the numbers I was seeing up on the board. Non-record 2-year-olds were selling tremendous... It was just absolutely incredible. You think, 'This is wonderful and I'm going to bask in it,' but then you start thinking that next year we probably won't have – hopefully

Date Night Hanover (Mattias Melander, winning a Kentucky Sire Stakes event for 4-year-old trotting mares in September). On Friday, she was sold for \$985,000 to Armitage Farm.

we don't have – the dispersals and that kind of thing, so then we'll be down a bit. Then, we'll have to report that we're down. It's going to be hard to ever be close or beat this one again."

Preferred Equine emerged on top of all consignors with \$25,296,000 grossed from the Mixed Sale alone for a total of \$31,130,000 over the week. It was an all-time SHSC consignor record, dwarfing the previous record of \$20,507,000 Preferred set last year by 52 per cent.

Hanover Shoe Farms wrapped the week from mostly yearling offerings with \$10,504,000 grossed and Alliance Bloodstock rang just behind with \$10,125,000 grossed.

"Long week, for sure, with a big draft of horses," said David Reid of Preferred Equine. "[But] it ended on a very solid note and capped a very successful week for Preferred Equine and our customers, for the most part. We'll leave here with a bang today. As we discussed yesterday, the cream rises to the top. The racehorses themselves... the female portion of the sale continues to be strong. There's been some shift in the movement of the male racehorses, but the energy around here today for that Fabulous Fillies section was very strong and I'm happy to be a part of it. It's a great venue, for sure."

Hip #1613 Kadena topped the Friday session, becoming another seven-figure horse to exit the sales ring. The Gimpanzee filly, out of world champion Mission Brief, brought \$1.2 million in a contested auction that went to Armitage Farm – the fresh outfit stamped on top of Shadwell Farm in Midway, KY by Jim McLane and Rita Armitage. Of the four in total that they purchased in the closing session, Team Armitage also signed the ticket for the second-highest purchase of the day, \$985,000, in **Hip #1605 Date Night Hanover**, a Chapter Seven half-sister to stakes

winner Delayed Hanover who sold as the sales topper of the 2022 Harrisburg Yearling Sale for \$600,000. Armitage consultant Doug Paul, of M&L of Delaware notoriety, confirmed that both mares will be retired to the breeding shed.

"Our whole approach was to try to buy quality mares, having a quality band, and breed in the upper echelon with not volume but more quality," said Jim McLane, whose farm sold the second-session topper of the 2025 Lexington Selected Sale with \$750,000 yearling Jimdougie Armitage, named for McLane and Doug Paul. It was the highest-priced trotting colt sold this year at the Lexington sale.

"Our philosophy was that if you pay what we pay for a mare, you're going to have to have more people to take care of it and it's going to cost you more overall to bring a yearling to the sale. So, we bought a decent farm with decent property. We hired a number of people and are trying to get a quality band together with enough people to take care of them, rather than to have volume that you turn out and you would worry about them getting hurt or something. We're moving in that direction."

Doug Paul said, "It's always tough to get high-quality race mares, like 'Date Night.' Most of the people want to keep them and

breed them themselves. To get almost a million-dollar winner is really tough to find at any sale, even if you want to pay for them. [And] Kadena is just... the Mission Brief family is probably the best family in the business and, no matter what, she's selling high-priced foals year after year after year."

Date Night Hanover and Kadena will join the ever-expanding broodmare band for Armitage Farm along with R Melina, R Dutchess and R Cee Cee, all of whom Doug Paul also confirmed will retire from racing.

"We've got a lot of high-quality young mares that are coming off the track," Doug Paul said. "In two to three years, we should be really well positioned in the Lexington sale to do really well."

Meanwhile, one of the top sellers from the Fabulous Fillies catalog will remain on the racetrack. Cindy Stewart of Hunterton Farm signed the ticket for \$650,000 on **Hip #1581 Rodeo Drive Deo**, a filly whose bloodline goes back to a mare the Stewarts cultivated named Los Angeles – the granddam of Rodeo Drive Deo.

"People don't realize that it's your family," Steve Stewart said. "It means a lot. That's our family. You saw it yesterday with Marvin Katz. It's what you grow up with – they come back home. We've never had anything in the family. Our plan is to race her next year. That's why we spent that much money. She's Kentucky eligible and in Kentucky you can race for gobs of money. There's a lot of money to race for as 4-year-olds. There's some fillies that can't go race there for different reasons or whatever, so it's an added bonus."

Steve also said he hopped on board with buying her because of excitement from long-time clients Mike and Don Robinson

from Ohio, who assessed the mare as a racing prospect and felt ripe for the plunge.

"They are horse degenerates just like us and they love the business so much," Steve said with a laugh. He also confirmed Ron Burke will train Rodeo Drive Deo through the remainder of the season and the ownership will then make a plan for her 4-year-old campaign.

Another mare from the Mission Brief family brought \$650,000 later in the session when Ola Yoder's Kountry Lane Standardbreds acquired **Hip #1630 What A Bid Hanover**. The Muscle Hill filly is out of What A Knockout, whose granddam Spice On Ice foaled the dam of Mission Brief, Southwind Serena. Spice On Ice also foaled The Ice Queen, whose progeny include stakes winners The Ice Dutchess, Ice Attraction, and R Dutchess.

Hip #1702 Fallout also brought big bids as the sale neared its close. Last season's Metro Pace champion fetched \$500,000 from Burke Racing Stable LLC. The Captaintreacheros colt is a full-brother to millionaire Blue Diamond Eyes as well as stakes winner Captain Kirk.

"This Mixed Sale, it stayed strong from the first horse that went through yesterday until the end of today," said Welk. "We were selling \$90,000 horses at the end of the sale. It was great and I can't thank the buyers, the sellers, and everyone enough."

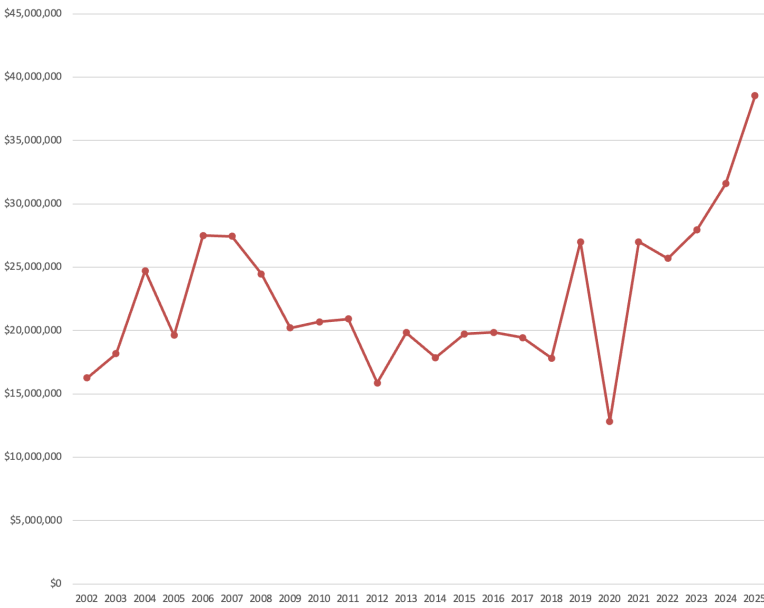

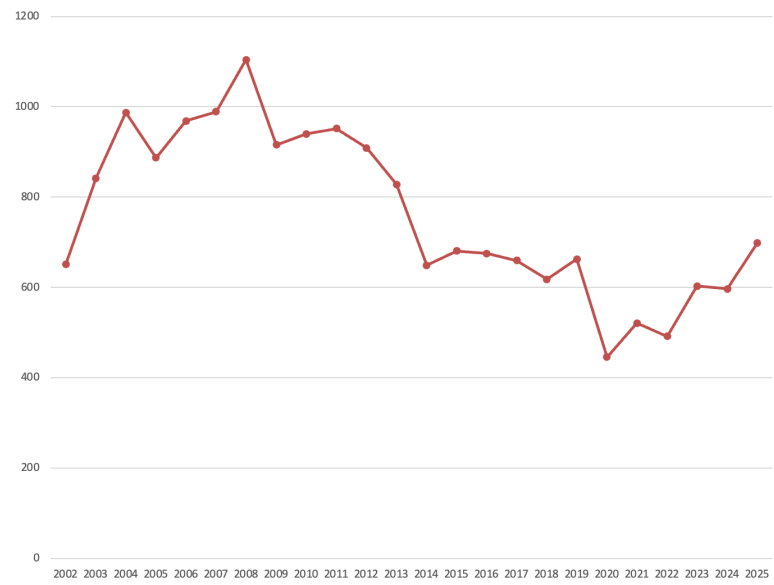
Mixed Sale - Median



Mixed Sale - Gross



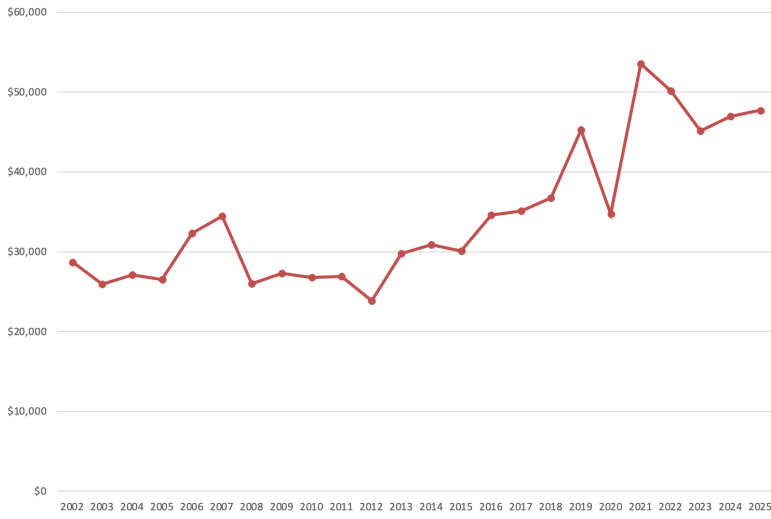
Mixed Sale - Number of Horses Sold



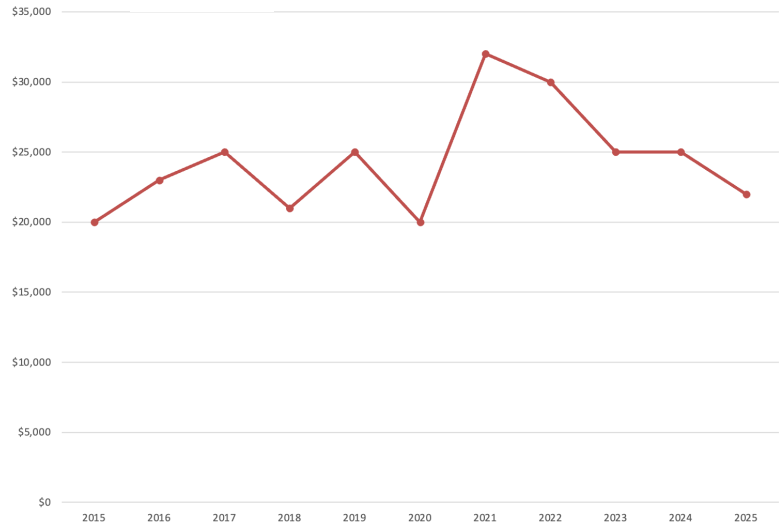

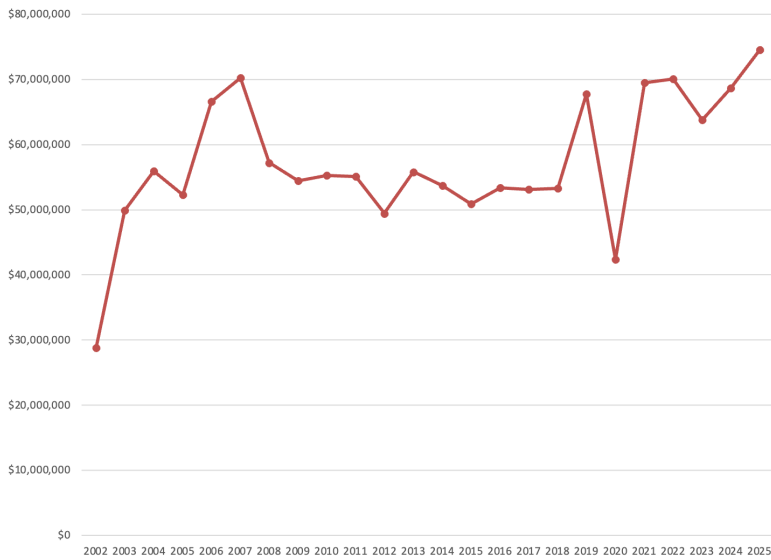

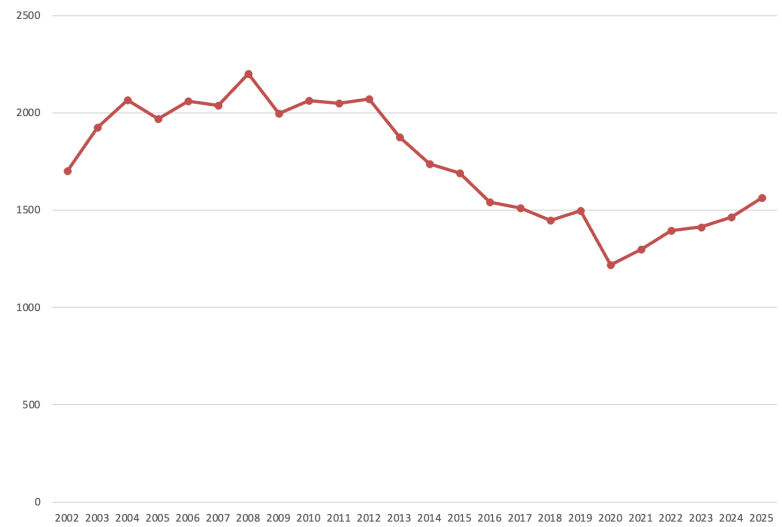

My picks for the 2025 Dan Patch awards

It's that time of year. The Breeders Crowns are over. Harrisburg, my usual benchmark for season's end, is done. It's time to think about Dan Patch winners and the Horse of the Year Award. Barring something unforeseen, this is how my ballot for the 2025 racing year will look.

PACERS

2-YEAR-OLD COLT PACER

Beau Jangles

(Cattlewash—Mrs Major Hill—Art Major)

If anybody casts his or her ballot differently, it is my opinion that his or her voting privileges be revoked. They just are not paying attention and have no idea on how they are voting.

From beginning to end of the racing season, he dominated like no other colt has since and possibly including Somebeachsomewhere. He went 12-for-12 with earnings of \$1,227,326.

2-YEAR-OLD FILLY PACER

Loua Dipa

(Sweet Lou—Looksgoodinaromper—Pet Rock)

Not quite as dominant as Beau Jangles at the beginning, but every bit as much as the season progressed. Nine-for-12 with earnings of \$742,241. By Breeders Crown night, there wasn't another pacing filly who could even come close to her exhaust. To my eyes, she and Beau Jangles constituted the greatest 2-year-old colt and filly that I've seen. That goes back to 1956.

3-YEAR-OLD COLT PACER

Louprint

(Sweet Lou—Rockin Racer—Rockin Image)

Despite a couple of hiccups at the end of the season, this colt, when himself, dominated the class. A winner of 10 of 12 starts with earnings of \$1,025,949. Surprisingly to this observer, he was not the leading money winning 3-year-old pacer, that

achievement goes to Miki And Minnie. He now goes to stud with this guy wondering whether we saw all that he could do.

3-YEAR-OLD FILLY PACER

Miki And Minnie

(Always B Miki—That's The Ticket—Roll With Joe)

A winner of 12 of 13 starts and the highest earning 3-year-old regardless of sex with \$1,038,659.

OLDER MALE PACER

Ervin Hanover

(Captaintreacherous—Eloquent Grace—Well Said)

Like a fine wine, this horse keeps getting better with each season. A winner of 10 of 16 starts and \$843,160 this season capped off with his dominant win in the Breeders Crown.

OLDER MARE PACER

Twin B Joe Fresh

(Roll With Joe—Fresh Breeze—Captaintreacherous)

All set for another Dan Patch win. Winner of six of nine starts and \$526,714 in 2025 and 36 of 49 and \$2,862,479 lifetime. We have been honored by her presence.

PACER OF THE YEAR

Beau Jangles

(Cattlewash—Mrs Major Hill—Art Major)

To me, the greatest 2-year-old these eyes have seen and that includes Romeo Hanover, Bret Hanover, Albatross, Niatross, Nihilator, Sweet Lou, and Somebeachsomewhere. He has swept through a magnificent campaign seemingly without difficulty.

TROTTERS

2-YEAR-OLD COLT TROTTER

Apex

(Walner—Mission Brief—Muscle Hill)

Winner of six of nine starts and \$871,798 including a win in the Grade 1 Mohawk Million.

2-YEAR-OLD FILLY TROTTER

Setyoursightshigh

(In Range—Special Interest—Cantab Hall)

Consistency and money earned won out for this filly. In 11 starts, she had seven wins and four seconds and earned \$678,159.

3-YEAR-OLD COLT TROTTER

Super Chapter

(Chapter Seven—Lifetime Pursuit—Cantab Hall)

The leading money winning 3-year-old of 2025 regardless of gait or sex. In 13 starts, he was 8-3-1 with earnings of \$1,154,574.

3-YEAR-OLD FILLY TROTTER

Yo Tillie

(Tactical Landing—Consolidator—Triumphant Caviar)

She dominated her division as no other trotter, winning 11 of 12 starts and earning \$979,195.

OLDER MALE TROTTER

Lexus Kody

(Archangel—Lexus Helios—Ken Warkentin)

A winner of 10 of 20 starts and \$1,151,401 including the \$1 million Yonkers International Trot.

OLDER MARE TROTTER

Warrawee Michelle

(Walner—Sound Check—Yankee Glide)

A near dead heat in earnings with Elista Hanover (\$548,991 to \$524,201), it all came down to the Breeders Crown where she bested said rival.

TROTTER OF THE YEAR

Yo Tillie

(Tactical Landing—Consolidator—Triumphant Caviar)

She was dominant in her division over all others in theirs.

DAN PATCH HORSE OF THE YEAR

Beau Jangles

(Cattlewash—Mrs Major Hill—Art Major)

How does one go against the combination of dominance and perfection? The reality is that I can't. The only way in which I could possibly change my mind would be if Yo Tillie took on and defeated her elders in the Fan Duel in a couple of weeks. THE VIEW FROM WOODBINE MOHAWK PARK

Elegantimage appeal considers culpability of R Dutchess and Tim Tetrick

The morning of Friday (Nov. 7), three Grand Circuit drivers took part in a virtual hearing about the \$273,750 (U.S.) Grade 1 Elegantimage final at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Sept. 20. The Ontario Horse Racing Appeal Panel (HRAP) heard statements from Dexter Dunn, Louis-Philippe Roy, and Tim Tetrick concerning an incident near the quarter pole which led to the disqualification of winner R Dutchess (3, 1:52s; \$486,351).

As previously reported in HRU, the ruling against the Susanne Kerwood (Canada) and John Butenschoen (U.S.) trainee was swiftly appealed.

At Friday's hearing, Fred Brethour represented the registrar, while Jean-Marc MacKenzie was counsel for the appellant.

Brethour presented an opening statement:

"It is the opinion of the registrar that the horse R Dutchess, [driven] by Tim Tetrick, violated AGCO [Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario] rule number 22.05.01a that states changing course or position, in or out, or bearing in or out during any part of the race to manage [or] compel another horse to take back, shorten its stride, or lose stride [is a violation]. In turn, because of the interference, the horse R Dutchess finished first and was placed 11th behind the horse that [she] had interfered with, number 2 Global Heritage, driven by Dexter Dunn, and that is on the basis of rule 2209."

AGCO rule 2209 states: "In the case of interference, collision, or violation of any rules, the offending horse may be placed back one or more positions in that heat or dash, and in the event of such collisions, interference or violation preventing any horse from finishing the heat or dash, the offending horse may be disqualified from receiving any winnings and the driver may be assessed a monetary penalty or suspended. If a horse is set back, it must be placed behind the horse with which it interfered."

Video footage was the cornerstone of the appeal hearing, with the three drivers involved each asked to explain what

was happening in the moments before R Dutchess bore in on Global Heritage in the Elegantimage final. Had Lasting Dream, who was second-placed-first, set off a chain reaction on the turn, or was Roy's filly already clear of R Dutchess when she caused Global Heritage to break?

MacKenzie told HRAP chair Stanley Sadinsky that he would reserve his opening statement.

Dunn was the first witness called by Brethour.

The New Zealand native said he was "probably in [his] 19th season" of driving and in his "seventh or eighth year driving in the United States, driving mostly Grand Circuit races throughout the season over here."

Brethour asked Dunn if he could recall what happened in the Elegance final.

“Yes sir,” replied the driver. “We raced them into the first turn. I was driving Global Heritage, and as... Mr. Tetrick... was going to drop [R Dutchess] in front of me and race around the first turn, it got tight when I was down the inside.”

Participants were next shown video footage from the upper pan and front tower cameras, as requested by Brethour, who added of the latter, “They don’t seem to have as much value, but I do want them shown.” Five different perspectives on the interference were ultimately displayed, including lower pan, back tower, and apex, at varying playback speeds. “I just wanted it noted that these are the shots that we have to adjudicate with,” he said.

Dunn identified himself as driving Global Heritage (3, 1:52s; \$151,780), wearing the black-and-blue colors of owner Lindy Farms of Connecticut. He told Brethour that “contact was made” between R Dutchess and his own filly near the quarter pole.

“I obviously had two horses outside me,” Dunn said. “I couldn’t say where the pressure come from, exactly, with Mr. Tetrick being the one [closest] outside of me, you know, it was the bike of his horse that contacted my horse.”

Dunn said he could not recall whether any drivers called out during the incident.

MacKenzie next asked Dunn about the position of Global Heritage relative to the other fillies approaching the quarter, as video from the race was shown. At moments, the driver said he was unable to see what was happening in the replays.

“[Tetrick] is in the two-wide lane, by the looks of it, but like I said before, from this angle, it’s awfully hard to make an assumption,” Dunn told MacKenzie. “I mean, honestly, I just had pressure from the outside. I had two horses outside of me... I mean, it’s hard to pick one or the other, sir, because both horses are coming down at the time.”

MacKenzie asked the driver if he had spoken with Tetrick immediately after the race in question, “indicating to him that it wasn’t his fault, it was the outside horse [Lasting Dream] pushing down on him.”

“I kind of agreed with that at the time, yes,” Dunn said.

MacKenzie inquired about the direction in which the drivers were looking at the time of the incident.

“Mr. Roy was looking to his left, Mr. Tetrick looks like he’s looking straight ahead,” said Dunn, examining a full-screen replay angle from the upper pan camera. He added that he was unable to tell who was responsible for bearing in on his filly when they were three-wide, with Global Heritage on the inside.

David Stewart was the next to answer questions, speaking as witness for the registrar. He stated that he began his career

as a racing official with the Ontario Racing Commission in 2008 and had been an AGCO senior racing official for about a decade. Stewart stated that he was the senior judge at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Sept. 20.

Brethour asked Stewart to “explain to the Panel what happened that evening, during that race.”

The senior judge recalled seeing “six horses that are all kind of leaving and getting out for position.

“Number 10, Louis Roy, is currently at the head of the 9 horse right now. He is three-wide going into the turn. Dexter Dunn’s horse is along the rail; Mr. Tetrick is in about the two-and-a-half-wide path there, following second-over. He starts coming down, and as the horse is coming to the rail, you can see where his horse’s head is cranked, that [she] is running in, and at that point, [she] gets down into the front legs of Mr. Dunn’s horse and causes that horse to go off-stride. After that, then, Mr. Tetrick gets to the rail, with Mr. Roy still on his outside.”

Video footage from the start to the moment of contact was shown, with the front tower shot requested by Brethour. Stewart said the replay showed “Mr. Roy cross[ing] over in front of Mr. Tetrick so he is clear and he is past him,” followed by “Mr. Tetrick angling [R Dutchess] down towards the rail [while] Mr. Roy is still in his position on the outside of Mr. [Yannick] Gingras on the 5 horse [Highlandstarburst].”

The senior judge said he could see “where [R Dutchess]’ head is cranked out... because [she] is running in, and because the horse is running in, [she] gets down into Mr. Dunn, causing [Global Heritage] to go off-stride.”

Stewart said that Dunn said that he was unsure “who was at fault” after the race, but he felt that first-turn action “caused his horse to be crowded and number 9 [R Dutchess] got into them and then [Global Heritage] unfortunately made a break.” He added that Louis-Philippe Roy “stated that he maintained his path [with Lasting Dream]. He just took what room was given to him there on the outside and he didn’t crowd number 9.”

Roy himself joined the hearing a little later than expected. He had driven three horses to wins in Friday morning qualifiers at Mohawk: top older pacer Ervin Hanover, 2-year-old filly pacer My Girl Friday, and, coincidentally, Elegance winner-by-placing Lasting Dream (3, 1:51.3f; \$554,811).

Next week’s column will cover the testimony given by Roy and Tetrick. Final submissions were made Friday (Nov. 7); the HRAP has reserved its decision on the matter, which will be announced at a later date.

the lane, and possibly in the trailer hauling her back and forth across the state. The frustration of walking this tightrope for the owners and trainer of this filly was akin to trying to solve a Rubik's Cube blindfolded.

For me, following this fractious filly was fun. Watching a racehorse that constantly goes off-stride is like watching a funambulist. Funambulist is a fancy name for a tightrope walker. Every step of every race she competed in was like watching a man on a high wire cross Niagara Falls. There was drama with every step. Owners, gamblers, friends, and trainers all watched each race of this filly with our hearts racing, muttering, "Keep at it, keep at it, c'mon." We felt great emotion. We should harness this emotion.

My philosophical, and perhaps preposterous, idea is that if you step back and look at a race objectively, a racehorse likely to break stride at any second will add to the drama of any race. Simply hoping that the horse you chose to wager on does not jump off-stride is an asset we could monetize.

Every year, my plea to the public is to monetarily reward trotters and pacers who dare to race without hobbles to enhance the magical sight of a horse in motion. While I remain a minority voice for free-legged-ness in our horses, let me suggest another type of race that is a close cousin.



Racing funambulists

To highlight my never-ending volleys of follies, allow me to present a joyful, accurate report concerning a harness racehorse that struggled to stay on stride. After recapping this wayward trotter's exploits, I will suggest a few unusual races for race secretaries to write.

During the summer of 2024, I closely followed the racing fortunes of a 2-year-old filly trotter owned by an acquaintance. I watched and wagered on every one of her races. As a 2-year-old, this filly went behind the gate 10 times. She broke stride seven times. The few times she did not break stride, she raced well for significant mile segments. Once, after breaking stride and spotting the field about 50 yards, the filly restarted and trotted up a storm to grab a minor check.

This fumbling filly did not seem to have a pattern. This lovely trotter went off-stride before the gate, with her nose on the gate, at the quarter pole, at the half, at the three-quarters, in

Give me control to create a new harness race, and I would arrange something like this: trotters, eight starters, all on the gate, post positions seeded by ability, 5-year-olds and under, and bonus money for racing without head poles or hobbles. Forget about requalifying after a few breaks; one flat line per season will be the ticket to racing paradise. The condition sheet would look something like this:

- The Treadlightly Trot – for fillies and mares with lifetime earnings under \$5,000, ages 2 – 5, with more than six pari mutuel starts and less than three flat lines. This race is open only to trotters that statistically have a less than 50 per cent chance of remaining on-stride. Horses on the stewards' list are eligible. Purse, \$6,000 (added money for subtracted equipment). State-bred preferred.

That race has drama. A race of this ilk will give plenty of room for mayhem and make it much easier to follow your horse during the mile. There will rarely be a single-file conga line. There will be horses everywhere on the racetrack. A race like this is *much* more playable for a pitiful handicapper like me.

Betting conglomerates, computer programmers, and serious handicappers will avoid this race like the plague, leaving it to those of us who are less sophisticated gamblers. Trip handicapping loses some power when half the field runs. Merely

staying on-stride and trotting down the lane might win the day. Your horse is never out of a horse race of this construction because a right turn into the parking lot or a left turn into the infield is never off the table.

Keep your smooth striders, your racing to form, your deep thinking, your obsession with speed, and statistics. Bring on the mayhem, chaos, disorder, and madness, where the smiles lurk. Advertising offbeat races, like the one above, would be marketable because they are dramatic and unique. The fun crowd can look forward to holding their breath for two minutes and three seconds, or more, every step of the way. Trainers and owners with a mistake-prone entry would always have hope that good manners get rewarded.

P.S. – At age 3, the breaking filly that inspired this column evolved into one of the finest and steadiest trotting fillies in the state

Naughty Beauty, Fragment, Heart For Two victorious in 2-year-old Matron Stakes at Bally's Dover Downs

Naughty Beauty, Fragment, and Heart For Two were winners in graded Matron Stakes at Bally's Dover Downs Thursday (Nov. 7). Todd McCarthy drove two of the three winners for trainer Andrew Harris and his co-owners William Pollock and Bruce Areman.

After breaking slowly and sitting seventh in the nine-horse field at the quarter in :27, Naughty Beauty (Bettor's Delight—Beautyonthebeach) driven by McCarthy rallied to finish just a head in front of I'm A Lou Lou (Tim Tetrick) in 1:53.4 in the Grade 2 \$104,900 Matron Stakes for 2-year-old filly pacers. Tall Dark Tequila (Jason Bartlett) finished third.

Naughty Beauty, trained by Harris who co-owns with Pollock and Areman, now has two wins and two seconds from six starts with \$77,450 in earnings. The fifth choice in the betting at 10-1 paid \$22.80 to win.

In the Grade 3 \$122,600 Matron for 2-year-old colt and gelding pacers, Jason Bartlett guided Fragment (Huntsville—The Show Returns) to an easy 3¾ length victory for trainer Per Engblom and his Engblom Stable LLC and co-owners Douglas Sipple and Peaceful Acre Farm.

Apocalypseblue Chip (McCarthy) was second and Thai Hanover (Jeremy Indof) third.

As the odds-on favorite, Fragment paid \$3.40 to win and improved his lifetime record to 15 9-2-0 while increasing his earnings to \$582,566.

In the third and final Matron Stakes on Thursday, this one a Grade 2 with a purse of \$110,300 for 2-year-old filly trotters, McCarthy, Harris and his co-owners Pollock and Areman teamed up again for their second Matron victory on the night with Heart For Two (Gimpanzee—House Music FR).

McCarthy sat a pocket trip before pulling ahead in the stretch to finish a half-length in front of pacesetter Atlantic Summer (Ronnie Wrenn, Jr.) in 1:57.3. R Ro (Tetrick) was third.

It was the second win in 10 starts and increased her earnings to \$106,340.

Freshman fillies at Philly in Liberty Bell Stakes

The Liberty Bell Stakes series continued on Thursday afternoon (Nov. 6) at Harrah's Philadelphia, with 2-year-old fillies, two divisions on the trot and one on the pace, having to work in cool temperatures and battling both each other and a strong stretch headwind.

Yannick Gingras once again showed why he is a Hall of Fame driver with a nerveless steer behind **Sandyboots Yankee** in winning the first of the two Liberty Bell pacing divisions. JK Sassy Lady crossed over to the top in the field of five; Sandyboots Hanover just inside her was looped, three-wide and forced to take back to last. The four in front of her paired up two and two down the back and through the final turn; Gingras chose to put the daughter of Always B Miki—A Beach Cowgirl in a blind switch when the second-over tipped wide, which left her last at the stretch call.

When that one couldn't keep up into the lane, Gingras shot the Ron Burke trainee into that emerging space and came along well to win in 1:53.4 by three-quarters-of-a-length over JK Sassy Lady while restoring a regular breathing pattern to her 2-5 backers. Sandyboots Yankee, another Simpson-Liberty Bell doubler, won for Burke Racing Stable LLC and Weaver Brusceci LLC, Lawrence Karr, and Phil Collura.

Gingras and Burke came right back in the second Liberty Bell pace, this time with the Tall Dark Stranger—Apple Bottom Jeans miss **With The Fur** as she broke her maiden in 1:54.3. With The Fur, an 8-1 shot, had a cushy ride in the 3-hole, moved out on the turn, and left the field well behind her as she made her first win a stakes success for owner Howard Taylor.

The lone Liberty Bell event for trotters saw **Berry Good News**, who in her last start had made an early break but still came back to miss just a neck to Sister Wine, reverse that decision today in 1:56.3. The victorious daughter of Greenshoe—Poof She's Gone barreled away strongly and put Sister Wine in behind her, set the pace, then had enough left to hold off that game rival, this week's margin a head. There was a "Tyler" exacta in this race, as driver Buter beat

driver Miller, with the winner trained by Nifty Norman for Melvin Hartman and David McDuffee.

There were two trotting features for the overnight set, and both were won by driver Johnathan Ahle. A \$13,500 contest for up-and-coming horses went to the International Moni sophomore miss **Moni Buys Happiness**, who had a rough trip including a long first-over battle, yet despite 47 days off dug down to beat out the favored second-over Manoaah by a neck in 1:55.2. Richard Hans, always to be remembered for his hand in Googoo Gaagaa, is the trainer and owner of the winner of four out of seven starts after not racing at 2.

The International Moni gelding **Khaosan Road** proved a half-length better than pacesetting millionaire favorite Chapercraz in a classic stretch duel to take the \$13,000 fast-class feature in 1:53.3. Ahle sent Khaosan Road forward early then yielded to sit on the back of the chalk, vacated the golden chair mid turn, and had to go all he could to defeat the stubborn leader while running his earnings to \$493,056 for trainer Åke Svanstedt and the partnership of Knutsson Trotting Inc. and Little E LLC.

Driver Simon Allard had a driving triple, two of them for trainer Per Engblom. Driving doubles were recorded by Ahle (the two fast-class features), Gingras (the two Burke stakes horses), Miller, and Jack Pelling; in addition to Burke and Engblom (1-2 in North America in wins), Jenny Melander trained two winners on the Thursday card.

Slugger On Deck scores in DSBF prelim

Jo Ann Looney-King's homebred **Slugger On Deck** parlayed a pocket trip into a 1:53.1 win in his \$20,000 first-round division of the Delaware Standardbred Breeders' Fund series for 2-year-old male pacers on Thursday (Nov. 6) at Bally's Dover. **Watch Em Win** and **Roman Raider** captured the other splits.

In the last of three divisions, Slugger On Deck and driver Allan Davis left for a pocket ride behind Harrington series champion and 1-9 favorite C Millertimeagain (driven by Corey Callahan). After drafting behind splits of :28.2, :56.2, and 1:25.1, Davis angled Slugger On Deck off the pegs just above the eighth pole, and the He's Watching—End To End Hanover colt vaulted clear to win by three lengths and knock two seconds off his previous lifetime mark. South Of The Hood (Montrell Teague) rallied up the open stretch to collar C Millertimeagain for second.

Jim King, Jr. trains five-time winner Slugger On Deck, who paid \$8.80 to win.

The first section saw 1-20 favorite Watch Em Win and driver Tim Tetrick brush from third to clear early leader Stained Glass (Ross Wolfenden) with a lap to go before drawing 5½ lengths clear of that rival to win in 1:53.2. Iheartmum (Art Stafford, Jr.) finished third.

Ron Burke trains Watch Em Win (\$2.10), a He's Watching—Winners Over colt with six career wins, for Burke Racing Stable, Knox Services, Phil Collura, and Weaver Brussemi.

Roman Raider and Barton Dalious rounded out the trio of winners with a three-quarter-length, maiden-breaking 1:58.1 score over pacesetter He's Peeping (Jason Thompson) in the second division. Tug River Sas (Wolfenden) finished third.

Wayne Givens trains Roman Raider (\$3.80), a Sports Column—Pillage gelding, for Legacy Racing of Delaware and Hazzard Racing Stables.

Rookie male pacers will reconvene for the second round of the Dover DSBF series on Nov. 13 before the top eight point earners from preliminary competition will meet in a \$110,000 final on Nov. 20.

First-round DSBF action at Bally's Dover will continue on Monday (Nov. 10) with two \$20,000 splits for 2-year-old trotting fillies.

Beckwith gets first win at World Driving Championship

Brett Beckwith picked up his first win at the World Driving Championship in New Zealand on Friday (Nov. 7) when he guided **Look To Da Stars** to a 10-length romp in the fourth of the day's five WDC races at Addington Raceway.

Beckwith and Look To Da Stars raced in the outer flow throughout the early stages of the 1,980-meter race, getting away fourth-over in eighth before eventually finding themselves uncovered on their way down the backstretch to the final turn. At that point, Beckwith stepped on the gas and the 5-year-old trotter responded by taking the lead from Sandfly Bay, driven by New Zealand's Blair Orange, and drawing away from the field. (Watch replay [here](#).)

"That was awesome," said Beckwith, who drove Look To Da Stars for trainers Mark and Nathan Purdon and owner Thompson Bloodstock, via text. "It was one of the most special wins I've ever had. I had a great fan base rooting me on. A big shoutout to the Pattersons [of the Commodore Hotel], who sponsored the race, a great family, and my man Andrew Stuart and 'Magic' [Jason Broad] for supporting me through the whole trip."

Beckwith had not enjoyed the best luck during the first three rounds of the World Driving Championship but opened Friday's fourth day with a second-place finish behind Sandy Shore before breaking through for his first victory three races later.

"It's been a rough week, but we finally got a win, thankfully," Beckwith said in a Trackside NZ interview after the race. "The trainer had this one ready to go."

He added about the experience of competing in the WDC in New Zealand, "It's been awesome. It's a beautiful country, great people. It's tough to dream about something like this, especially coming over here and racing horses."

In the day's first WDC dash, Orange got his 3,000th lifetime New Zealand victory, with pacing mare **Always A Menace**. The 47-year-old Orange became the youngest driver to reach 3,000 in New Zealand, and the fourth driver overall.

Also winning races Friday were Canada's James MacDonald, Sweden's Mats Djuse and France's Pierre Vercausse.

After 15 of the WDC's 20 races, MacDonald remained the leader, with 130 points, followed by Australia's Gary Hall, Jr. and Djuse. Beckwith was in ninth.

The WDC visits Winton for four dashes on Sunday (Nov. 9) before concluding with a single race back at Addington on Tuesday (Nov. 11), New Zealand Cup Day.

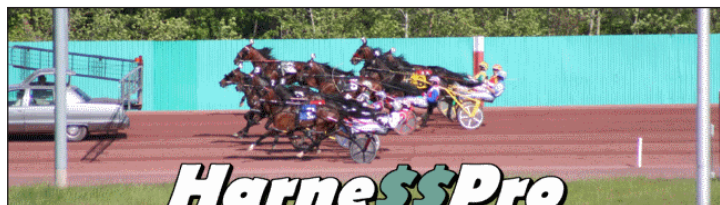

Captain's Quarters, a Metro Pace champion, North America Cup runner-up and O'Brien Award finalist, will stand stud in 2026.

His dam is a half-sister to O'Brien and Dan Patch Award winner Sportswriter, p, 2, 1:49.2s; 3, 1:48.3s (\$1,649,411), and a full-sister to O'Brien and Dan Patch Award winner Precocious Beauty, p, 2, 1:50.1s (\$869,920). Precocious Beauty is the dam of Tall Dark Stranger, p, 2, 1:49.1s; 3, 1:47.1 (\$2,365,549). His maternal family also includes Downbytheseaside, p, 2, 1:49; 3, 1:48.3f (\$2,283,068), Swingtown, p, 2, 1:50.1; 3, 1:49.2f '25 (\$1,368,436), Whichwaytothebeach, p, 2, 1:51.1f; 3, 1:49.2s; 1:48.4s (\$1,057,737), etc.

Captain's Quarters won the richest 2-year-old race in North America in 2023, the \$970,000 Metro Pace, in just his fifth career start, and was Canada's fastest 2-year-old colt pacer of the year, while earning more than \$105,000 per start as a freshman, leading all North American 2-year-olds in the process.

At age 3, Captain's Quarters won the fastest elimination of the Pepsi North America Cup in a career-best 1:49.1 and was the runner-up in the \$1 million final. Other notable performances of his sophomore season included a victory in his heat of the Little Brown Jug and a third-place finish in the Cane Pace, where he was individually timed in 1:47.

Between the eliminations and finals for three of pacing's most prominent races, the Metro Pace, North America Cup, and Little Brown Jug, Captain's Quarters netted three wins and two runner-up finishes in six starts – the best summary from those stakes events – including victories over O'Brien Award winner Legendary Hanover and Dan Patch Award winner Captain Albano.

“Captain’s Quarters is the total package,” said Jody Jamieson, regular driver of the colt. “His gait, determination, and stamina made him one of the best freshman pacers I have ever seen. Having driven some of the best 2-year-olds in the business, Captain’s Quarters is without a doubt at the top of the list for speed and conformation. Ontario is the big winner in securing this pedigree and raw talent.”

The large majority of Captain’s Quarters’ starts were in signature events and included races such as the Nassagaweya, Champlain, Metro, Somebeachsomewhere, North America Cup, Meadowlands Pace, Cane Pace, Max C. Hempt Memorial, Little Brown Jug, Tattersalls, and Breeders Crown. For his career, he put together a record reading 5-3-4 in 18 starts.

“Captains Quarters is a superb individual, very sound and good-looking with tremendous speed,” said Herb Holland, who trained the colt for owner Rich Stiles of Chelsea, MI. “His owner pointed him out to me when he was a yearling at Lexington; the package was all there, as he was a very correct individual with a great head and nice eye.”

Winbak Farm owner Joe Thomson said, “Captain’s Quarters was a \$235,000 yearling from Lexington. From day one, he’s had the presence needed to be a top stallion prospect.”

Ontario’s only son of the great Captaintreacherous, Captain’s Quarters’ introductory fee will be \$5,000, with multiple mare discounts available.

‘Dajudge,’ Dismas excellent in Big M’s Exit 16W

The first of six Thursday race cards this year at The Meadowlands featured four divisions of the first leg of the Exit 16W Pop Up Series for both trotters and pacers, and **Herecomesdajudge** and **Dismas** were two good-looking winners.

Herecomesdajudge took the \$20,000 split (race 4) for trotters 4-years-old and younger in 1:54.4 for trainer Julie Miller and her son, driver Tyler Miller.

The 3-year-old son of Muscle Hill—Designed To Be sat an easy-chair comfortable 2-hole trip behind Soft Landing, who took the field past the quarter in :27.3 and half in :58.2. Despite the sleepy :30.4 second fraction, Tyler moved ‘Dajudge’ off the rail heading to three-quarters, and grabbed the lead at that station in 1:27.2 on the way to an easy 3¾-length score. Walkwhileyoutalkn was second with Bless Me Father third.

The winner’s Kentucky back class showed as he notched his sixth win in 27 career tries while upping his bankroll to \$142,152.

“He wasn’t feeling like himself [when he scratched on Oct. 28 at Cumberland Run],” said Tyler of the regular sire stakes competitor in the Bluegrass State. “We didn’t want to race when he wasn’t at his full potential. I was still pretty confident [tonight]. He felt great and loves that trip. He’s been racing well in Kentucky.”

Herecomesdajudge returned \$6.20 to win as the 2-1 second choice in the eight-horse field.

Dismas, a 3-year-old gelded son of Lazarus N—Itz Cherry Ripe N who is trained by Per Engblom, won the second of two \$17,500 divisions (race 7) for 2- and 3-year-old colts and geldings on the pace in 1:51.1 as the even-money public choice.

Driver Braxten Boyd opted to sit a pocket trip, and it worked to perfection, as after leader Doctor Arroganto cut out fractions of :26.3, :55.3, and 1:24.1, Dismas vacated the pocket with a little less than an eighth-of-a-mile to go, and under some energetic urging from Boyd, got up by a neck over Doctor Arroganto. Lastdrivedownmain, who, according to Boyd, suffered a flat tire, was third in the eight-horse field.

“It looks like the horse is very capable,” said Boyd, who teamed up with the winner for the first time. “[Sitting in the] 2-hole was perfect, that was a decent one to follow and Scottie [Zeron, driving Lastdrivedownmain] got a little bit of a flat tire there, so that helped. He put up a great performance tonight. Hopefully, I can get the drive back and have a little success with him.”

Dismas is now three for 14 lifetime, good for earnings of \$28,000. He paid \$4.20 to win.

A PAIR OF WINNERS: The other two Exit 16W winners were:

- Race 3 – \$17,500 2- and 3-year-old filly pace: **Twin B Cardi B** (a 3-year-old by Stay Hungry—Perfectly Sweet), driven by Anibal Borjas, trained by Tony Alagna, winning time 1:54.1 in her parimutuel debut, paying \$4.80 to win as the 7-5 second choice.
- Race 5 – \$17,500 2- and 3-year-old colts and geldings pace: **Captivated** (a 3-year-old gelding by Tall Dark Stranger—Never Ever Forget), Boyd, Bill MacKenzie, lifetime-best 1:51.4, \$10.80 as the 4-1 third choice.

A LITTLE MORE: Boyd was red-hot, leading the driver colony with four wins on the night... A carryover of \$7,950 coaxed punters to place \$31,945 of “new money” into the 20-cent Pick-6 pool. Those with winning tickets had big smiles on their faces after the Bill Clark-driven **Uncle Coz** won the payoff leg at odds of 45-1, creating a return of \$17,551.66...
