**Foiled Again Now Richest Standardbred Ever—
Sort Of**

When Foiled Again finished second in last Saturday's American-National at Balmoral the \$50,000 check he picked up increased his career earnings to \$ 5,749,968. That's good enough for first place among all standardbreds worldwide.

Or is it?



Foiled Again's chase for the earnings title has shed light on the virtual impossibility of comparing earnings among horses that race in different countries and for different currencies.

Calculate the

figures one way and Foiled Again is indeed the richest standardbred ever. Calculate them a different way and he trails the actual leader by some \$2.4 million, a gap he can never hope to overcome.

Figuring out what Foiled Again has made is the easiest part. He's raced only in North America and changing the dollars he has made in Canada into US dollars isn't that difficult. That makes him the richest pacer ever, whether that's here in North America or anywhere.

The problem is what to do with the European trotters, who race for all sorts of different currencies--Euros, Swedish Krona, Norwegian Krone, etc. Exchange rates and how they vary over time make computing earnings quite complex. For instance, in 2004, the Euro was worth as little as \$1.20. In 2009 it was worth as much as \$1.60. Yesterday it was worth \$1.34.

In September, the USTA reported that Ready Cash, who races in France had become the richest standardbred of all time with earnings of \$5.71 million, less than what Foiled Again has now earned. Based on that story out of the USTA Foiled Again is now indeed No. 1.

(Ready Cash has made €4,239,300.)

Faced with the headache of converting foreign earnings into U.S. dollars, the USTA relies on annual exchange rates published by the European Trotting Union, which is how it calculated Ready Cash's earnings at \$5.71 million

The problem is that among Europeans Ready Cash isn't anywhere close to being the richest trotter ever. Varenne's career earnings are recorded at €6,035,665 or €1,796,365 more than Ready Cash has earned. Converting Varenne's

earnings to dollars based on current exchange rates you get \$8.1 million, which dwarfs Foiled Again's figure.

But the USTA has converted Varenne's earnings into dollars based on the exchange rates that were in place when he was racing in the late 90s and early 2000s. That's how it comes up with its figure, \$5,636,255.

It's not even clear if Foiled Again is the richest U.S. based horse of all time. According to the USTA's stats, Moni Maker has made \$5,589,256. But once you consider that she raced all over the world trying to figure out how her earnings compare to those of Foiled Again, Ready Cash and Varenne is an exercise in futility.

Shortly, the Ready Cash-versus-Foiled Again debate will likely be a moot one. Foiled Again is expected to race just once more this year, in the TVG Pace at the Meadowlands. About the same time that he will be headed to the sidelines for the year Ready Cash will just be gearing up for the prime racing season in France. If he can again win the Prix d'Amerique, which is worth €1 million he will blow past Foiled Again, no matter whose calculations are used.

So who's the richest standardbred of all time? The answer is that there really isn't any answer.

Somebeachsomewhere's Stud Fee Bumped to \$30,000

The stud fee of world champion Somebeachsomewhere will rise 50 percent from \$20,000 to \$30,000 in 2014, which will make him the most expensive pacing stallion to breed to in North America.

Brent MacGrath, the trainer and one of the original owners of the Schooner Stables of Truro, Nova Scotia that campaigned the colt, told Harness Racing Update that the fee increase has been determined by the results of Beach's offspring at the sales and at the track.

"No other horse is having the impact on the game that he has," MacGrath said. "It's strictly, purely business."

At the recent Harrisburg Yearling Sales, Somebeachsomewhere's offspring sold for an average of \$81,846, the highest of any stallion. At the Lexington Yearling Sales, his offspring sold for average \$83,400, which was also ranked the highest. One share in the horse sold at the Harrisburg Sales for \$150,000.

MacGrath said that when you calculate the math on the sale and on the on-track results, the actual value of Somebeachsomewhere's stud fee is closer to \$40,000.

Schooner Stables owns 75% of the shares, Hanover Shoe Farms, which bought into the horse to stand him, owns 10% and the remaining 15% are owned individually.

Somebeachsomewhere, which the Schooner Stables purchased for \$40,000 at the Lexington Sales, recorded the fastest mile in a race with a time of 1:46.4 and lost only once in 21 career starts. He earned more than \$3 million and set a single-season earnings record for a pacer with more than \$2.4 million in 2008, the year he was named Horse of the Year in the U.S. and Canada.


Somebeachsomewhere's excellence as a racehorse has genetically translated to his offspring, which have set numerous world records for speed and he has also set

marks for his progeny's earnings. Last year, his offspring broke a record for seasonal earnings by two-year-olds with his first crop of racehorses eclipsing the previous mark that was almost 25 years old. He sired 31 two-year-olds that raced in 1:55 or better. He produced 10 horses that won \$100,000 or more. He produced a Breeders Crown winner - Somewhereoverarainbow - and two divisional champions. His best horse to date is Captaintreacherous, the U.S. Pacer of the Year in 2012 and one of the favorites for U.S. Horse of the Year in 2013.

"If you look at the return breeders are getting from all their stallions and subtract the average sales price from their stud fee and looking what's left, Beach is clearly ahead of everyone else," MacGrath said. "Anybody in the (syndicate that owns Somebeachsomewhere) that was on the fence about where his stud fee should be certainly thought it should be at \$30,000 once that share sold for \$150,000. The reason (his offspring) are selling for an average of \$83,400 are because of the champions he has produced. You can have a horse that produces good horses, but the people don't seem to be interested in them when they go to sale. If that was the case we couldn't up our stud fee when they are not selling the way they should be at yearling sales. We believe the stud fee is justifiable given the fact the price they are selling for.

"If you are a commercial breeder, you need to breed to the hot sire that the people are paying for, and that today is Somebeachsomewhere. The results have, and will

continue to provide, maximum breeding investment value."

Hanover Shoe Farms announced the 2014 stud fees for all its stallions yesterday. In addition to Somebeachsomewhere they are: Andover Hall (\$20,000); Cam's Card Shark (\$5,000); Cantab Hall (\$20,000); Crazyed (\$4,000); Donato Hanover (\$15,000); Explosive Matter (\$7,500); Muscle Massive (\$6,000); Well Said (\$15,000); Western Ideal (\$7,500).

Cantab Hall's book is already full and closed.

Callahan On New Meadowlands Qualifiers: "It Was Strange."

With opening day right around the corner, the Meadowlands held its first ever races of any kind yesterday morning where the track was essentially turned around. There were eight qualifying races at the Meadowlands, where what was the finish line is now the starting point, what was the first turn is now the second turn and what was the second turn is now the first.

"It was way different, it weird" said Corey Callahan, who had four drives. "Your memory is programed to do it one way, so when you flip it and do it on the other side it seems strange, very strange. Trond (Smedshammer) said our horses are going to have to get used to it because when they come out of the first turn there they start to moving out off the rail, thinking it was like the head of the stretch."

Callahan said the biggest difference may be the winds and how they may change the complexion of the races.

"Everybody will figure it out," he said. "The only

adjustment we're really going to have to make is with the wind. With the old track, a lot of times the wind was in your face up the backside and then it would blow you home in the stretch. Now it's going to be in our face in the stretch. You'll probably see some pretty big third quarters because the wind will be at our backs.

"That was one of the things I liked about the Meadowlands. You could be third or fourth over and tip out and the wind would kind of blow you home. Now the wind is going to be in your face and it's going to make it a little rougher on those horses coming from behind. A lot of horses, when they hit the wind it will stop them. I'd be worried that this so going to favor the front end speed."

Burke Sets New Earnings Record

Ron Burke became the first harness racing trainer to surpass \$20 million in purses in a single year when For All We Know finished third in a \$14,000 mares claiming handicap pace at Mohegan Sun at Pocono Downs on Wednesday night.

In addition to the record for purse earnings, Burke's trainees have 981 wins so far in 2013 -- another record.

Burke is on his way to leading all North American harness racing trainers in both wins and earnings for the fifth consecutive year. He won 906 races in 2012, breaking harness racing's training record of 842 established by his stable in 2010. He saw his horses win \$19.69 million in purses in 2012, breaking the record of \$18.54 million set by his stable in 2011.

Race 8, Autumn Series 3-Year-Olds Pace

ALEXAS JACKPOT debuts up this way via Pocono and has the look of a sharp looking claim for Fine. On the speed favoring PA surface, this one fired to a 1:50:3 win three back when going first start off the claim and has been good since. High percentage barn on this circuit.

LYONSPARKHAVENLAKE has generally faced faster rivals throughout the year and now makes his fifth start for Moreau; capable of speed if Fillion chooses so. HE'S A SENSATION is an obvious short priced threat from the rail; he exits a win and that try from October 3 prior to the scratch would have him figure. TAURANGA was hard used last out through a :26 flat opening quarter for O'Sullivan; that try four back against Jettin's Dragon was excellent.

Race 9, Claiming \$15,000 Trot

NORTHERN VICTORY makes his second start at this level since the Puddy claim three back and it's hard not to think he won't be lurking in here from the rail after missing by a neck last week. He seems to be a much better horse when on the big track. KASHS CAVIAR returns to the mile track while dropping back into claimers; Corey Johnson trainee has a sub 1:55 mark on the year; no shot try in that most recent. WHIPLASH took these types right down the road two back and never threatened in his subsequent start. Gets Sylvain back; speed likely coming again now. KILTED PRIDE is Macdonald's choice as he stays loyal to the barn; this one can surprise with a trip. MOPEY COREY was used very hard last week in an impossible trip and all his prior ones were good; likely to be overloekd in the waging from out here.

Race 10, Claiming \$8,000 Pace

JOHNNY PRINE TYME has been relatively decent in his last pair despite his long odds and he could be heard from here on the move inside and should still offer a more than fair price. This was one was used early in both those recent tries and had some late pace to offer last week when he closed from out of it; switches to Waples tonight. WESTERN SENATOR is the current scourge of this class and is the obvious one to beat at a short price. He's won three of the last five times he was at this level including a win as the 2/1 favorite last week; can do it either way. ROCKNROLL KING drops back down to the level of the claim and from the looks of things, the track was playing unreasonably slow in that recent race from Flamboro and he makes his second start now for the new barn. DRAFT HANOVER is another that always attracts attention at this level; any live cover flow increases his stock.

Race 11, Autumn Series 3-Year-Olds Pace

THORN IN YOUR SIDE remains an unbeaten 4 for 4 since moving to Auciello and this one was somehow let go on the board last week at a rather generous 3/1 offering. Two of those four wins have been in the 1:51range and he simply looks fastest on paper; come catch him if you can. DG'S CAMME never got involved last week but I think he's better than that; some of his summer miles would rate favorably in here. JA EL POCKETROCKET went a big mile a couple back when he was in the NW 2 condition that so many others in here have been racing in; might live up to his name. SOUTHWIND AMAZON is aided by inside draw for McNair and Saftic closed well with him two back; SEA HARRIER seems to be doomed by the post with little early speed to show.
