This week's tote problems illustrate racing's innovation black hole

Intransigent structures and systems along with a lack of vision continue to cripple the sport's growth.

Earlier this week, a "glitch" in how wagers were sent from FanDuel to the tote caused quite the ruckus in horse racing wagering pools, including at several harness tracks.

The coding problem allowed for wagers to be sent at the base rate, rather than the total cost of the ticket. So, if someone took a 20 cent all-all-all superfecta in a seven-horse field, the ticket cost was 20 cents, not \$168.

As initially reported by Ed DeRosa of Horse Racing Nation, this resulted in some astronomical pool sizes. At The Meadows, a superfecta which usually handles about \$10,000 ballooned to over \$1 million. At Monticello, a superfecta pool approached a mind boggling \$1.5 million.

This was certainly eye-opening to many, but in my view it should not have been. This has been a characteristic of the betting side of this industry for decades.

Recently appointed head of the National Thoroughbred Alliance, Pat Cummings, shared some excellent thoughts about the incident on a twitter thread on Friday.

"That a single customer could 'wager' hundreds of thousands in succession, across multiple tracks and countries, and most of those tracks just rolled along shows you where we stand," Cummings said. "Regulators, operators, ADWs, tote companies... everyone is in play on blame, not just FanDuel."

I couldn't agree more.

The term "innovation" is often misunderstood to mean eureka moments, or some sort of invention by one person in a lonely lab or basement somewhere. As Matt Ridley detailed in his immaculately researched book, "How Innovation Works", this is not the case.

Innovating involves dozens and sometimes hundreds of iterations; it's incremental, responding to needs and wants of a market through collaboration and trial and error. No one person invented a light bulb, or a lead pencil. They evolved.

Almost every innovation many of us take for granted developed through a bottom-up, not a top-down approach.

Most have heard of the Stephenson Rocket, the world's first locomotive, but it was not invented by the famous brothers, its prototype had been invented over a quarter century earlier by someone else.

Often, the hope of an innovation is not the end result. Collaboration and open markets change goals, or the substance of new initiatives.

Ironically, fracking might end up being a catalyst towards clean, renewable energy, because two sharp MIT engineers used the fundamentals of hydraulic fracturing to move turbines through pressurized water in Texas.

What's my point as it pertains to horse racing?

The tote system has never been constructed, or able, to foster this type of innovation, i.e., the only innovation that works.

The system — AmTote was created in the late 1920s — is not driven by a market, but by an entity. And in 2023 that entity is controlled (and in many cases hamstrung) by several other fiefdoms, that can involve tracks, horsemen, or states.

The system has surely innovated — we have new bets, and it has expanded to world-wide markets — but truth be told, this is the same system that allowed the "Fix Six" Breeders' Cup scandal, and 20 or so years later was at least some part of this week's problems. It's also the same structure that allows for huge odds changes we all see almost each and every harness race, sometimes after the race is being run.

This lack of open, dynamic innovation causes more than those obvious drawbacks which anger our dwindling customer base. In my view, it stunts growth and opportunity.

Horse racing has tried to enter the sports betting space, but on the sports betting platform's terms. Being last to market is never a good idea, and **Churchill Downs Inc has already abandoned its BetAmerica hub**; the industry has moved to rent seeking behavior in sports betting, by tagging along as a form of subsidy.

Because the tote lacks innovation (or cooperation of its partners to lobby) in broad ways, it was never able to create, for example, its own platform for pari-mutuel sports betting.

In sports betting, parlay markets are already huge and growing. Tote technology, where people could easily wager pari-mutuelly on Formula 1 exactas or trifectas, or betting superfecta boxes on the Masters, or U.S. Open could be a massive opportunity.

Most of us might be tempted to look at this week's coding glitch, hope the problem is fixed and then move along. But to me this misses the big picture.

Horse racing itself is insular. It rarely looks outside to see what's possible, but even if it does, it hits a brick wall of fiefdom or alphabet bloat. This is the cause of the innovation black hole, and it is what horse racing needs to address.

A structure and culture of innovation, whether it's related to the tote, exchanges, or horse racing data, is hard and it doesn't guarantee success. But just like with light bulbs, lead pencils and locomotives, it at the very least gives it a chance.

My guesstimate on my favorite Harrisburg yearlings was too high

For as long as I can remember, I have gone through both the Lexington and Harrisburg catalogs and pre-priced all the yearlings in them based almost solely on their pedigrees and the appeal of those pedigrees to me. There are times when I am higher or lower than the price actually realized. There are the odd times when I am right on the money and hit the price exactly at or quite close to where the yearling actually sold.

Readers of this column will recall that previous to last week's Harrisburg sale I wrote three articles where I identified the horses selling in the three days of the yearling sale who's pedigrees most appealed to me.

In the Day 1 session, I picked 13 pacing colts whose pages jumped out at me. Now that the sale is over, I'll revisit these colts together with my pre-sale guesstimates and what they actually brought, who bought them and how much they paid. I'll follow these colts through the 2024 racing season and assess my prognostications around this time next year. I have never been as far off or near as far off as I was this year.

My guesstimates were high, sometimes way high on 12 of the 13, which leads me to believe that my stable will go into the 2024 racing season as a tremendous bargain group.

In all the years I have been doing this, and they have been considerable, I have never been so far from reality.

My conclusions are several: the sale, more specifically Day 1, and much more specifically, the Hanover Shoe Farms consignment for Day 1, was off significantly. Despite being the leading consignor on Day 1 (\$7.5 million) and the leading yearling consignor overall (\$9.3 million) — both by a wide margin — Hanover's yearlings for the opening session were off 45 per cent in gross and in the area of \$3.5 million compared to 2022. Was there a reason or reasons for a decline that was higher than the overall sale decline? Undoubtedly, there were several. My guess for the No. 1 factor was the loss of Dr. Bridgette Jablonsky running the show. Through the years, she accomplished a great deal for Hanover and built up a large following of customers who had great faith in her and the Hanover product. Not only was she gone, but three of her most loyal associates, Tim Hayes, Dr. Megan Moschgat and Dan Atkins, followed her out the door. Such people are not easily replaced.

Long-time loyal Hanover clients such as Determination, Dave McDuffee, Ronnie Burke, Tony Alagna, George Segal, Myron Bell and others were conspicuous by either their absence or by the diminished number of purchases by them.

World events and economics also had to be a factor.

Another reason, in this guy's opinion, was the choice of yearlings for the opening session.

There is no such thing as a perfect yearling but those chosen for the first day at Lexington or Harrisburg need to be as close to perfection as possible. Those that meet those standards are rewarded and fetch the highest prices. Those that do not are penalized significantly. When speaking of perfect yearlings, I always think of the words of Arthur "Bull" Hancock, the late patriarch of thoroughbred racing's Claiborne Farms. "I don't want a perfect yearling. A yearling isn't meant to be perfect. It is only a sample of the horse that it will become. If it is perfect as a

yearling, there is only one direction in which it can go. That direction is not up."

I found it particularly shocking that two of Hanover's Day 1 offerings each brought \$10,000; a price well below even the Day 3 average. My guess is that these two and several others would have fared better if they were sold on Day 2 or Day 3. Hall of Famer Jack Darling volunteered on Facebook that he had looked at both the \$10,000 Hanover yearlings in question and that each toed in rather significantly. These types of yearlings often turn out to be good racehorses, but they rarely sell well, especially in a select session.

Bottom line, in all the years that I have been doing this, I have never been so far off in my guesstimates.

Here are the 13, with my guesstimate price, the price at which they sold and the person who signed the sales slip:

Queen Belina best in Swedish Breeders Crown again

Jörgen Westholm-trained **Queen Belina** (Nuncio) claimed her second title in the Swedish Breeders Crown as she took a safe wire-to-wire win in the \$300,000 Breeders final for 4-year-old mares on Saturday afternoon (Nov. 18) at Eskilstuna racetrack.

Queen Belina proved best among the 3-year-old fillies in the BC final last year and when trainer Westholm steered his horse in this year's race, it ended with victory. After a quick start, Westholm hit the lead with Queen Belina and the duo stayed in that position without being seriously challenged in a mile rate of 1:57.3 over 1.3 miles. Cabaret Artist had to attack three wide with one kilometer to go and held well as runner up ahead of first over trotter O'Mara Zon.

UPSET IN BC FINAL FOR 3-YEAR-OLD COLTS AND GELDINGS

Kriteriet winner Fame And Glory was the heavy favorite in the \$300,000 Breeders Crown for 3-year-old colts and geldings and in mid-stretch it looked like Timo Nurmos' horse would capture another big trophy in Sweden. Fame And Glory bested leader Caviar From Mine in the last turn, but driver Björn Goop had to be very active when he realized that **Stens Rubin** (Readly Express) got space to sprint on the inside with 100 meters to go. Stens Rubin got his nose first at the wire and Johan Untersteiner, who had three weapons in the race, could see from beside that Erik Adielsson steered his horse to a big win in a mile rate of 1:58.1 over 1.3 miles.

Fame And Glory was beaten by a nose as second and Timo Nurmos' Nouri di Quattro was third.

HAGOORT IN TOP

Dutch trainer Paul Hagoort and driver Robin Bakker succeeded in the \$150,000 Breeders Crown for 3-year-old-fillies with favorite **Ester Degli Dei** (Maharajah), who managed to keep the lead from post 1 which meant that Ester Degli Dei could relax on the front.

Bakker stepped on the gas at the end of the last turn and the opponents just saw the leading favorite leaving the rest of the gang. It was a 1:57.2 mile rate for Ester Degli Dei, who is bred in Italy. Oaks winner Adriatica claimed the second spot ahead of Ninetta Boko.

A FAIRYTALE FOR A FAIR DAY

An amateur trainer with rather few merits on the big stage became the happiest winner on Eskilstuna's Breeders Crown Day. Elisabeth Almheden's 4-year-old gelding **A Fair Day** (Maharajah) entered the \$300,000 Breeders Crown final for 4-year-old colts and geldings after an impressive elimination win and from post 3 behind the gate, driver Oscar Ginman had his tactics clear: the front position.

A Fair Day opened quickly for the lead and Ginman seemed pretty confident in his position throughout the race. The home stretch became a pleasant journey for A Fair Day and Ginman and the duo landed in a mile rate of 1:55 over 1.3 miles.

Bedazzled Sox was second after a pocket trip and Game Brodde followed as third.







Down Under's 'Mr. Harness Racing' aims for third Inter Dominion in December

He is "Mr. Harness Racing" Down Under, but Mick Boots is largely unknown to most who follow the sport.

And that's just how the former garbage man, truck driver and pub worker likes it.

"I'm just a knockabout bloke who will have a beer and chat with anybody. There's nothing special about me," Boots said.

Except the fact he's become an absolute juggernaut in ownership ranks, first in Australia and now Boots is spreading his wings into neighboring New Zealand.

It has all happened relatively quickly and gained so much more momentum when Swayzee, the lone Aussie raider in last Tuesday's iconic \$750,000 New Zealand Cup, romped home.

Swayzee became just the second Aussie-trained winner of the NZ Cup since My Lightning Blue's 1987 win. Arden Rooney in 2015 was the other.

It was just 16 years ago when Boots bought his first share in a pacer.





Now, the self-made businessman, who in his own words, "left school aged 14 years and 10 months," is a giant in the game.

When we chatted recently, Boots said he owned 212 horses in Australia and nine in NZ.

"Don't quote me on those exact figures," he said with a laugh. "I've got them spread across that many trainers, I might have missed a few."

Boots isn't kidding, either.

"I've got horses with 39 trainers; actually, no, make that 41 because I've just added a couple in South Australia recently," he said. "I've got horses racing in all the Australian states (NSW, Victoria, Queensland, Western Australia, South Australia and Tasmania) and now the nine horses in New Zealand with two trainers over there, Cran Dalgety and Nathan Williamson."

He buys tried stock and has been increasingly spending up at yearling sales. He also breeds "about 10 a year" as well.

Boots was born and still lives in the New South Wales Riverina town of Leeton, about six hours by car from Sydney. It's an area with a strong harness racing history.

And that's where he watched Swayzee win the NZ Cup.

"With my wife and my dogs out in the cool room in the stables," he said with a laugh.

Boots grew up around horses, although his father, David, was into thoroughbreds.

So, it surprised a few when Boots' first foray into horse ownership came when he and a friend bought a pacer called Jaydens Castle in late 2007.

There was no shortage of beginner's luck. Jaydens Castle won 22 races and was placed (top three) another 24 times, including seconds in Group 1 Vicbred finals as a 3- and 4-year-old.

The genie, so to speak, was out of the bottle.

"It was a great start," Boots said. "He was a fantastic horse for us. My mate moved more into thoroughbreds and that kick-started my involvement in harness racing."

You need plenty of coin and some luck to build an empire like Boots.

The coin came from a landscaping supplies business his father started, but one Boots took over and stunningly transformed.

"Dad had a good little business going until he got breast cancer when he was 50," Boots said. "He went in and had surgery to remove it, but had a massive heart attack in the hospital and said we had to sell the business. I put my hand up to take over, which probably surprised a few because I'd left school as soon as I could in year eight; I was 14 years and 10 months.

"But I saw an opportunity to grow the business and just backed myself. Within 12 months of taking over, I'd employed another 11 people. We just kept growing and growing. Just before I sold the business on July 27, last year, there were 105 employees and another 15 subbies [sub-contractors]. I'd turned 60 and I'd had enough. It was getting harder to get the right sort of staff, so I sold the business and retired."

Then Boots really started to open his shoulders and build his harness racing stock.

Back then, his best horse had been dual Inter Dominion finalist Bundoran, who also ran fifth in the Miracle Mile early last year.

Around the time he retired, Boots added another NSW Riverina product, Jason Grimson, to his growing group of trainers.

Grimson has been a revelation in the Down Under training ranks, especially over the past two years, winning the past two Inter Dominions and a string of other major races.

Through horses like Betterzippit and now Swayzee, Boots has become a key part of the growing Grimson success story.

They teamed up with Betterzippit to win the inaugural \$1 million Nullarbor slot race in Perth in April and then Grimson unleashed Swayzee for the first time in his stable at Bathurst a couple of weeks later.

But Swayzee's win trumped that.

"I know the New Zealand Cup was a bigger win, but Betterzippit is still my most special because it was my first really big win," Boots said. "There's been a lot of jealousy about Jason's success and things said about him, but I'm telling you, he's just a great horseman. I've spent a lot of time around him and you can see it.

"I've seen a few old-school great horsemen and that's what Jason is. He works hard, he only ever has a small team and he's very hands-on. He's a man of few words, but a great judge. I'll send him a video of a horse I'm looking at buying and he'll give me a simple yes or no. That's all I need."

Boots recently turned to Grimson to try and resurrect one of his favorite and best pacers, Himanameisjeff.

"I think he's right up with Swayzee as the best horse I've had, but he's had injury after injury," Boots said. "He's rising 7, but he's only raced 27 times [and won 14]. He's done two tendons in one leg and another tendon in another leg, but Jason's been able to get him back to show the talent we know he's got and win five of his six starts for him.

"You won't see him at the Inter Dominion though because he doesn't handle the smaller tracks. We tried him in the Victoria Cup [Oct. 14] at Melton and he couldn't go away from the marker pegs around the bends. He won't handle Albion Park because it's similar to Melton, so we'll keep him to the big [1400m] track at Menangle where, hopefully, he can stay sound and win a lot more races."

So, it will be Swayzee carrying Boots' hopes into the Brisbane Inter Dominion, which starts on Friday (Dec. 1).

And Swayzee will also be aiming to give Grimson an almost unthinkable three-peat in Down Under's most historic race.







Difficult to understand and dangerous

Al could lure away gamblers with virtual horse racing.

Hot wars in the Middle East, artificial intelligence trolls taking over our brains, tribalism, political gridlock, immigration, global warming, and my front right tire keeps losing air. If the world does not have enough problems, consider one you may not have heard about.

Imagine the scene below.

Today, the horse racetrack is visually stunning. The horses are magnificent, the day is scenic, the weather perfect, the sounds exciting, and your horse, number 6, Withering Heights, is circling the pack and closing in on Planetary Dreams, the leader. The crowd roars, and the hooves pound as Withering Heights, on whom you wagered 10 dollars and went off at odds of 6-1, passes the second-place horse, Cool Breeze. The camera zooms for a closeup as Withering Heights and Planetary Dreams widen their eyes and strain for the finish line for a photo finish. Heart pounding, you lean forward for the finish.

This scene is 100 per cent BS.

The race is a manufactured experience in the fledgling universe of virtual sports betting. The horses, racetrack and presentation are fake. The money wagered on these digital races is real. Who would wager real money on a phony horserace and waste their money on what is a randomly generated video game, a game where the "horses" are controlled by a CPU for the paying customers and spectators? The answer is some today, more tomorrow.

You and I may huff, "I would NEVER bet real money on fake horses. Only a fool would bet fake sports."

Maybe, maybe not, but never is a long time. Virtual sports betting creators are much more concerned with creating new customers than converting dinosaurs. The worrying part is that improving

a virtual horse racing experience is as simple as enhancing graphics and algorithms.

And equally frightening is that content generators can stage a hell of a horse race program with minimal effort. And deeply scary is that virtual sports entrepreneurs can offer the player much more favorable odds. In a virtual horse racing world, races go off as scheduled, none of the horses break stride or are completely uncompetitive, and the weather is always perfect.

Of course, a virtual horse race runs full-faced into gamblers who enjoy experiencing a skillful and decision-made wager. Opponents of virtual racing will howl that this type of wager is simply a twist on slot machines, and they will be correct; and are probably minimizing the problem.

The new generation of simulated horse races will not be cartoonish, crude plastic ponies. AI will maximize virtual sports presentation and addictive behavior. Virtual sports could turn into slot machines on steroids. The near-miss phenomenon will make each race close, and that "almost won" is psychologically and physiologically reinforcing.

A quote from a traditional horse gambler about his experiment with virtual horse racing: "They're also more real than the slots I've indulged in before. Play a game for long enough, and you forget that the horses you're roaring on are predetermined or that the potential goal scorer will never, ever score, tangled in a net of algorithms. Objectively, you know that it's all pre-programmed, but in the action phase that goes out the window, you become involved in what you see on the screen."

The idea that gamblers will spend money on a sport that doesn't exist feels dystopian. But there is a market for virtual sports gambling. The market is growing. Losing traditional horse racing customers and potential new customers is a given. How many? The answer is difficult to pinpoint, the numbers are complex, and the participants who create the games are reluctant to share their business and are not held in high esteem by "real" gamblers.

Let's look for a bit of light in a very dark tunnel. If virtual horse racing appeals to the slot machine crowd, and since live racetracks rely on existing casinos - why not introduce the virtual horse racing experience at our casino-dependent tracks? A touch of synergy. A new product for casinos. Live horse racing and fake horse racing all in one location. More money for all. Who knows, but these are desperate times.

Irene Petersson takes care of her horses like they were her kids

Called "the backbone of the sport," grooms spend most of their waking (and sleeping) hours with their designated four-legged children. They usually don't get the option to choose who they want to care for, but instead, are assigned the animal. The horse may be a nasty character that loves to bite and kick, or is like a spoiled, stubborn child who has a mind of their own.

Regardless, it is the caretakers' job to get the horse to trust them for they are the ones who feed, brush, clean, comfort and race the horse.

Born in Sweden, Irene Petersson is known to be one of "the best of the best."

"Although my family was not involved in harness racing, I always loved the horse and wanted to spend as much time as I could working and learning about them," Petersson said. "I leased a pony at a farm where people boarded standardbreds. Most of the people had another job and the horse was a hobby. After school I would hurry over to the barn and began helping out. This was my introduction to the sport. Little did I know that this passion would be my lifelong career."

When Petersson arrived in the States, she got a job at Hanover Shoe Farm working with the yearlings and getting them ready for the sale.

"I then got a job working with trainer Per Eriksson in sunny Florida," Petersson said. "What a wonderful way to start out. Being from Sweden where the weather can get quite cold, it was such a blessing to wake up in hot, sunny Florida amongst the palm trees and beaches. It is much easier working when it's in the 80s than a frigid 20.

"I think the horse appreciates the warmer weather also, and you hardly miss a day breaking, training and racing when the weather is good."

After Eriksson, Petersson got a job with Hall of Fame trainer Chuck Sylvester.



"Chuck was the best boss I ever worked for," she said. "I only wish I would have paid more attention while I was there, for, in my opinion, Chuck is one of the best trainers; past and present.

"After working for Chuck, I took a few years hiatus and just enjoyed being in Florida, but it wasn't long before I slipped right back into it and got a job with trainer Randy Beekman. I worked for Don Swick, and Pilgrim Farms, too. Today I work for top trainer Tony Alagna and have been there for almost eight years."

Petersson has taken care of a lot of top horses over the years.

"I have cared for many, many horses," she said. "Each and every one became "my surrogate child," whether it was a male, female, trotter or pacer.

"There was Chip Chip Hooray, Day For Night, Valentina Blu, Heart On Fire, Ari Ferrari J, Piper Hanover, and Pilot Discretion, among many others."

Petersson refused to choose a favorite.

"I can't answer that because I have had many," she said. "They are my children. They may not have two legs but have four, but to me they are as close to children as I'll ever have.

I think I speak for all the other grooms in the business when I say really wish owners would be a little more appreciative and thankful to the people who treat their horses as their own. Sadly, people look down on the caretakers because we shovel horse dung. We devote our time into doing the best we can to get their horses to race and hopefully make a champion. A little thanks, pat on the back, or recognition saying, 'Hi, how are you doing?' or 'Thank you for taking such good care of my horse' goes a long way.

"I've gotten a lot of trotters, perhaps because I'm Swedish and that is what I grew up around. I normally am assigned fillies, perhaps because they are at times 'goofy,' but I get along with them."

Petersson's days start pretty early, but she doesn't mind because she's doing what she loves.

"I get to the barn around 4:30 or 5 [a.m.] to feed all the horses," she said. "I clean and freshen their water and when they are done eating, some will get turned out in the paddock while I clean the stalls. I like to drink my cup of coffee before bringing them in but usually it doesn't happen and I have to slurp it down while bringing them back in.

"At the Alagna Stable in New Jersey, where I am now, we are given a schedule of what time our horse will jog or train. After they are done exercising, I put them away. Each one has a different personality so they are treated individually. Some horses need 'more' attention and some need 'special' attention but when a horse is in my care, I give them 110 per cent. They all need the same care for they have feelings, too."

Petersson loves her job and wouldn't trade it for anything.

"My horses are my life and I've loved each one," she said. "I cry every time one leaves, whether they leave due to being sold, claimed, or go off to start a new career as a mother, sire, riding horse, or pet.

Although it's out of my control, it's still hard.

"I think I speak for all the other grooms in the business when I say really wish owners would be a little more appreciative and thankful to the people who treat their horses as their own. Sadly, people look down on the caretakers because we shovel horse dung. We devote our time into doing the best we can to get their horses to race and hopefully make a champion. A little thanks, pat on the back, or recognition saying, 'Hi, how are you doing?' or 'Thank you for taking such good care of my horse' goes a long way."









Beat Cop completes sweep, wins second DSBF title

Following open-length wins in both of his preliminary divisions, PT Stable's **Beat Cop** (\$2.20) delivered an encore performance in the \$110,000 Delaware Standardbred Breeders' Fund (DSBF) series final for 2-year-old male pacers on Thursday (Nov. 16) at Bally's Dover, defeating stablemate Lovenbury by 6-1/4 lengths in a lifetime best 1:53.4.

Tim Tetrick was in no hurry early with the Dragon King—Beat The Beat gelding, yielding to early leavers Papas Son (driven by Art Stafford, Jr.) and Come On Eddie (Montrell Teague) to sit third through a :27.4 first quarter before blitzing to the fore with a lap to go. Beat Cop cleared Papas Son just beyond the winning post, and he opened a 2-length lead through a :56.4 half, maintained that margin to three-quarters in 1:25.2, and steadily drew clear off the final turn. Lovenbury angled off the pegs turning for home and overtook Papas Son for second, giving trainer Crissy Crissman-Bier a sweep of the top two spots.

Beat Cop, now a nine-time winner from 12 starts, has banked \$165,225 in his career, having also swept the DSBF series at Harrington Raceway earlier in the fall.

The \$20,000 DSBF consolation went to **Rowdy Dragon**, who rated splits of :27.3, :57.3 and 1:26.1 en route to a 1:55.3 maiden-breaking victory. Victor Kirby drove the Roddy's Bags Again—Delightful Play gelding for trainer Bryan Truitt and owner Bryan Truitt, Jr.

Three more \$110,000 DSBF finals are slated for next week at Bally's Dover, with 2-year-old trotting fillies squaring off Monday (Nov. 20), 2-year-old male trotters Tuesday (Nov. 21) and 2-year-old pacing fillies Wednesday (Nov. 22).

Update on Friday night's Yonkers accident

A multiple-horse accident in the eighth race on Friday night (Nov. 17) at MGM Yonkers Raceway led to a no contest being declared. Horses and drivers involved were Oaxacan Dream N and Jim Marohn, Jr., Two Proud and Matt Kakaley, Man Dontforget Me and Bob Di Nozzi and Silent Crossing and Tyler Buter.

Due to the accident, the final race on the program was also canceled.

SOA of New York president Joe Faraldo provided an update on the condition of the drivers involved in the accident.

Jim Marohn, Jr. has broken forearms and a thumb and will need surgery to repair the bones. Tyler Buter suffered broken ribs and a collarbone and also has back pain. Bob Di Nozzi also suffered broken ribs, while driver Matt Kakaley was banged up but did not require a stay in the hospital.

All of the horses involved — Oaxacan Dream N, Two Proud, Man Dontforget Me and Silent Crossing — are believed to have escaped without serious injury as well.

Racing is scheduled to resume at MGM Yonkers Raceway on Monday (Nov. 20). Yonkers will also have a card on Tuesday (Nov. 21) before the track goes dark the remainder of the week for Thanksgiving.

Southwind Ozzi to stand in Ohio at Cool Winds

Little Brown Jug winner Southwind Ozzi p,2,1:53.2f; 3,1:48f (\$1,132,645), has officially retired and will stand his first full season (2024) at Cool Winds Farm in Lima, OH for a stud fee of \$3,000.

A multiple Grand Circuit winning son of the immortal Somebeachsomewhere, the now 7-year-old Southwind Ozzi was an ultra-consistent racehorse that won a third of all his lifetime starts. In his million dollar-earning career that spanned

six years, he obtained sub-1:50 win records in each of his last five seasons.

Southwind Ozzi took his 1:48 record while winning the \$400,000 Delvin Miller Adios by 7 lengths. The signature stakes victory was the fastest by a 3-year-old on a five-eighths mile track in 2019, and remains the second-fastest mile in the 57-year history of the Pace for the Orchids.

With nine victories in 15 seasonal outings as a sophomore, Southwind Ozzi banked \$837,685, and was the richest 3-year-old pacing colt in the tough Pennsylvania Sire Stakes program, winning that \$253,000 final, also at The Meadows.

'Ozzi' also won the \$384,000 final heat of the Little Brown Jug in 1:50.1, following up his 1:50.3 elimination heat victory at Ohio's renowned Delaware County Fair.

"He's a good horse and he gives me a lot of confidence when I drive him," driver Brian Sears said after his Jug triumph. "I know I've got a lot of options during the race. I don't have to be stuck with one plan. He proved it today. He got around the half-mile track great and roughed first over both trips and got it done convincingly."

He completed his career with \$1,132,645 in earnings having finished first, second or third 59 times, with a lifetime summary of 107 36-14-9.

Trainer Bill MacKenzie said, "We are very proud of Ozzi and his accomplishments, and, in concert with his owners Vincent Ali, Jr. and Alma Iafelice, we are excited to partner with Cool Winds Farm in Ohio for the next phase of his career."

From the Camluck mare Southwind Solara p,3,1:53s (\$36,184), she the dam of five in 1:52 or faster, Southwind Ozzi is full or half-brother to several stakes winners and fast-class performers, including Southwind Silence p,2,1:52,2f (\$504,496); Southwind Bella p,3,1:50.2f—'23 (\$229,495); Southwind Yukon p,3,1:52.1f (\$167,291), etc.

French Wine, Coach Stefanos dominate in Star Destroyer at Harrah's Hoosier Park

Grand Circuit action returned to Harrah's Hoosier Park with five divisions of the Star Destroyer for 3-year-olds highlighting the 14-race card on Friday (Nov. 17). Entering as the headliners on the card, **French Wine** and **Coach Stefanos** did not disappoint, each delivering dominant victories in their respective divisions for 3-year-old colts and geldings.

Saddled with post 8 in the field of nine in the \$60,000 3-year-old colt trot, driver Andy Miller landed French Wine in the fourth position on the first turn as Texsong Soprano and Mike Oosting put up a :26.2 opening-quarter. The hot pace didn't deter Miller from pulling on the right line on the backstretch, giving French Wine his marching orders to the lead at the half in :55.3. French Wine began to assert himself on the front entering the far turn, opening up to a 2-length lead at three-quarters in 1:25.1 as Talent Scout and Doug Rideout challenged Texsong Soprano for the second spot. Turning for home, French Wine remained strong on the lead, powering home in :27.1 to hold a late-charging Helpfirstedition at bay by just over 3-lengths on the line in 1:52.2. Texsong Soprano held for the third position.

The victory was the fourth of the year in 17 seasonal outings and eighth in the career for the royally bred son of Bar Hopping—Creamy Mimi. Trained by Julie Miller, French Wine pushed his career bankroll ever closer to the million-dollar mark, banking \$992,694 in lifetime earnings for owners Andy Miller Stable Inc, Daniel Plouffe, Jean Cristophe Plouffe and One Legend Stable Inc.

Not to be outdone, Coach Stefanos delivered as the 1-9 favorite in dominant fashion in the \$65,000 3-year-old colt pace. Leaving from post 4 in the field of eight, regular pilot Trace Tetrick settled in the fifth position through the opening-quarter as Burnout and LeWayne Miller led the way to that station in :26 parked to the outside of Liteningonthebeach and Jordan Ross. Burnout cleared on the backstretch but the pace remained hot to the half, taking the field to that point in :54.1. Tetrick had seen enough as he angled Coach Stefanos to the outside, leading the first-over charge to the leader's wheel at three-quarters in 1:22.4 with Buzzsaw Russ and John De Long in-tow second-over. Coach Stefanos powered to the lead at the top of the stretch, sprinting to the wire in :26 to score by 2-1/4 lengths over Buzzsaw Russ in 1:49. Dynamite Dylan and Andy Miller rallied for the show spot.

The Erv Miller trainee notched his third victory in his last four starts and eighth of the season through 16 starts in 2023. Owned by Kenneth Duffy, D&M Trading Il LLC and John Stefanos, the gelded son of Tellitlikeitis—Watch B Be Watched has earned \$535,365 in 2023 and \$780,420 for his career.

Earlier on the card, **Dragon By The Sea** kicked off the stakes action in the first of two \$30,500 divisions of the Star Destroyer for sophomore pacing fillies. A late driver change found Atlee Bender in the bike as he left alertly from post 4 to sit the pocket behind To All A Goodnight and Andy Miller through an opening-quarter of :26.1. Bender popped the pocket on the backstretch to gain the top spot only briefly as Tarapasta and LeWayne Miller took charge to the half in :55.4. It was Racin Hungry and John De Long's turn to lead the outflow while she engaged Tarapasta on the lead through three-quarters in 1:24.4 with Dragon By The Sea angling back out for more from third. In the stretch, Racin Hungry put away Tarapasta before Dragon By The Sea uncorked a :26.3 final-quarter to chase down the leader by three-quarters-of-a-length in 1:51.4.

Trained by Jeff Smith, the daughter of Downbytheseaside—Prima Dragon earned her seventh victory in 18 tries this season. With the win, Dragon By The Sea has banked \$190,595 in her career for owner John Van Horn.

Driver John De Long had the hot-hand on the evening, driving five winners on the card including **Mollop Hanover** in the second division for 3-year-old pacing fillies. Mollop Hanover settled in the third-spot early as Cantgetuoutamymind and Andy Miller rode the wind to a wicked :25.3 first-quarter. De Long moved at the quarter with Mollop Hanover to take command prior to leading to the half in :54.2. Trace Tetrick brought the heavily favored Hungry For Love first-up to the leader's wheel at the three-quarter pole in 1:23.2. Headed at the top of the lane, Mollop Hanover dug-in gamely to find more in the stretch, gutting out a :28 final-quarter to open her lead back up to 2-1/4 lengths on the wire in 1:51.2. Let's Misbehave and Marvin Luna rallied for second, with Walkin On Sunshine and Jay Cross rounding out the trifecta.

Missy Essig trained the 3-year-old daughter of Betting Line—Mayhem Seelster to her seventh victory in 18 starts this season. The victory brought Mollop Hanover's lifetime earnings to

\$131,832 for owners Eric Good, West Wins Stable and Dumain Haven Farm LLC.

De Long wasn't finished in the stakes action on the evening, scoring the mild upset with **Believe U Me** in the \$60,500 3-year-old filly trot. De Long landed in the third position early as Picaboo Lady and Joey Putnam stung Helpoftheseason and Peter Wrenn to a :27.2 first-quarter. Wrenn mashed the brakes on the backstretch, stealing a :31 second second-quarter to the half in :58.2. Pressure came to the leader from Southwind Cherry and Trace Tetrick, surging first-over into second while Believe U Me snuck off the pylons to follow her cover on the way to three-quarters in 1:27.4. In the lane, Believe U Me surged off of cover in :26.4 to get the jump on Picaboo Lady who rallied up the passing lane, scoring the victory by 1-1/4 lengths in 1:55.1. Helpoftheseason gamely held for third.

The Ontario Sire Stakes Champion scored her sixth victory in 19 seasonal efforts for trainer Ron Burke. Owned by W J Donovan, the daughter of Muscle Mass—I Believe is now a winner of \$289,228 for her career.

Blooded Horse Sale up 13 per cent

The 76th Annual Fall Blooded Horse Sale saw a 13 per cent year-over-year increase with an almost identical 300 horses sold vs 302 last year.

"We knew we had a good group of horses catalogued," said sale manager Jerry Haws. "We appreciate the stables that consigned nice racehorses and the breeding farms that sent attractive mares, yearlings and weanlings."

The Burke Racing Stable consignment included sale-topper Brookview Bolt 5,1:52s for \$100,000 and runner-up Coastal p,4,1:50.2f for \$85,000. Brookview Bolt, an ultra-consistent 5-year-old son of Swan For All with earnings of \$130,250 this year while racing in the Open Trot at Hoosier Park, was purchased by Bill Rhoades of Pennsylvania.

"I needed an open trotter for Northfield Park and The Meadows," Rhoades said. "He fits that class well; I'll see which of my owners want a part of him."

Though Coastal had just won the \$85,000 Ohio Sires Stakes 4-year-old Mare Championship, she was purchased by Jonas Schlabach of Ohio not to race but to breed. "I own a share of Monte Miki and needed a good mare to breed to him," he said.

Also in the strong Burke Racing Stable consignment was the rich and fast Uncle Peter trotting mare Favorite Aunt 4,1:54h (\$202,634) that went to Steiner Stock Farm on a \$53,000 bid.

Amanda Beaver brought the 3-year-old Indiana Sires Stakesplaced trotting filly Swan Fancy that was purchased by Ed Zubkoff (agent) of Michigan for \$43,000.

The yearlings sold first and were led by a pair of especially beautiful ones from Dublin Valley Farm.
