Bulldog Hanover (with trainer and co-owner Jack Darling) will also retire from racing on Saturday after racing in the TVG at The Meadowlands, in his case in the Open Pace.

In addition to training Bulldog Hanover, Darling co-owns the presumptive Horse of the Year with Brad Grant.

"Both of them have given me a lot of thrills and won a lot of big races," said Grant, who also co-owns Atlanta with Crawford Farms Racing and Howard Taylor. "I think both of them have really got people over the years interested in our business. I mean, Atlanta had a great following and Bulldog, this year with what he's done. They're two big holes to fill in our sport, never mind in any barn."

Michelle Crawford believes it will be a bittersweet night for Atlanta's owners and thinks there is so much that contributed to her being a "Queen".

"Natural born ability," said Crawford. "Her gigantic heart and perseverance. Her breeding from a prolific dam [Hemi Blue Chip] and sire [Chapter Seven]. The perfect storm."

Crawford will get to take Atlanta home as her sole owner following the TVG Mares Trot, which is Atlanta's last competition for the current partnership. As a result, Crawford wants to thank all the people who made it happen.

"Rick Zeron, Scott Zeron and their grooms and trainers," said Crawford. "Anthony Altamonte for making the connection for us to be able to be a part of her amazing journey. Then, on to the most current since her 3-year-old campaign, Ronnie Burke

and the Burke Brigade, Mickey Sr. and Jr. and especially Margaret [Gillon] for your impeccable care for our girl. Then the obvious, Yannick Gingras for guiding her through the finish line to the most exciting victories and giving us all goosebumps more often than not. Thanks for your love and care, too, Vicki Gingras.

"Then, I would like to thank our wonderful partners, Brad Grant and Howard Taylor, for allowing us to be a part of the most fulfilling animal anyone could have hoped for and more. The friendship and partnership has advanced to Monticello, Atlanta's full brother bred by Stefan Balazsi, so the hopes and dreams persevere. What a proud moment for [Stefan], I'm sure. To own this world-class champion is not only a blessing but an honor and we can't wait to see what she brings back to the industry with her future babies. Thanks for the ride, Atlanta. My heart is full."

There's an interesting story connected to how Taylor got hooked up with all of his top horses and Atlanta is no exception.

Taylor has the reputation for almost always saying yes when asked to take a piece of a horse, so it's no surprise that he ended up connected to several yearlings after the 2016 sale in Harrisburg.

"Two weeks [after Harrisburg] I get a bill in the mail and it included two horses I've never heard of in my life," said Taylor.

"One of them was named Django Unchained [whose name was changed to Atlanta. The other horse was Courtney Hanover].

"So, I called up Harrisburg and said who the hell are these horses?" said Taylor. "[The person at Harrisburg said] 'Well, Rick Zeron bought them and he told us that you had agreed to take a quarter.'"

Taylor remembers a friend introducing him to Zeron at the sale.

"So, I called up my friend, because I didn't even know how to get in touch with Rick at the time, and I said I just got these horses with Rick Zeron. How the hell did that happen? [The friend said] 'You were standing there and he said if I bought a couple of horses would you take a piece and you said yes.'"

"I swear to God, I never remember that conversation. I do remember meeting him briefly. Maybe he mumbled and I didn't understand what he was saying. I don't know. But it's funny how that ended up being Atlanta and that's how I got her."

Taylor knows he will miss his great mare and like Crawford and Grant is happy for one last chance to see her race.

"I'm sure she's one of, if not the, greatest horse I've ever owned and one of the greatest horses ever," said Taylor. "I guess it would be her, Tall Dark Stranger and Buck I [St Pat], but I think she's accomplished more than anybody."

"This is going to be very, very emotional. In fact, I cancelled a trip to make sure that I'm there."

Connections of both horses felt that The Meadowlands was the perfect venue for their retirement festivities.

"To be brutally honest, it's the last race on the schedule, but fittingly, it's a place where she had her glory," said Taylor. "She's the track record holder there [1:49.1, tied with Ecurie D DK], she's the Hambletonian winner there, she's done a lot of good there. And it's the center of the harness racing world. So, what better setting for her to have her last race?"

"Even if I didn't own her, she's the kind of horse, and there's not been that many, that I would go to the track to watch her race just to say that I saw her race. To me, she's that special. And the battles with Manchego and now Bella Bellini are just amazing. She's just unbelievable. Never makes a break, gives you 110 per cent every start. Just an amazing animal."

Darling agreed that retiring Bulldog – a son of Shadow Play out of the Artsplace mare BJ's Squall – at The Big M, where he went 1:45.4 and became the fastest harness horse in history, is appropriate.

"At the first of the year, I just remember thinking that race is quite late in the year and there's a 30-day gap in his schedule, so at the time, I wondered if we'd be sticking around for that, but it worked out well," said Darling. "He's as good now as he's even been."

"He's got the greatest demeanor for a stud that you can imagine. I've described him many times as the most perfect horse I've ever run across. If he could just pass on his talent, his heart, the lungs he's got, breathing capacity, the amount of try he's got and he's got such a great mind to him. His attitude and his mind, he's almost half human sometimes, I think. If he could pass all those traits on, he could really help the breed. I'm just really excited for what this horse could do as a sire. I'm just so happy that he's going to get the chance to show what he can do."

As for the possibility of Horse of the Year honors, Darling and Grant are playing it close to the vest.

"There's no doubt he should be mentioned," said Grant. "What happens will happen. He's done a great job, so he'll definitely get mentioned and if he wins it, that would be a bonus."

"I'm always slightly superstitious," said Darling. "I don't like to get ahead of myself. I don't like to count my chickens but that would be a great honor for him."

Meadowlands picks and analysis for stacked Saturday card

Both the Fall Final Four and TVG Finals are on tap.

The Fall Final Four and TVG Finals combined with the swan song for Bulldog Hanover will make for one last stellar race card in this harness racing season. Here are my thoughts for all the stake races.

RACE 4, \$475,400 GOLDSMITH MAID FINAL

Mambacita was locked in for almost the duration of the stretch last out in her Kindergarten final and then broke promptly once she was free. That was unfortunate for her but she'll have a chance to make amends; gets a third straight attempt to try to figure out Bond. Bond was aggressively handled last out when she retook by the half in :55. She held off a big longshot to win that race and Svanstedt will once again be leaving early from the outside; will be favored but no cinch. Heart Of Fire was towed into it beautifully last out and nearly sprung the upset; was a winner two back and deserves some respect. Quick Stop and Wild Jiggy S were two others that were rallying late in that same race. Blonde Bombshell won in the Garden State last out in a race where she gapped for most of it before somehow finding her best stride late.

Picks: Mambacita, Wild Jiggy, Heart On Fire

RACE 5, \$416,200 VALLEY VICTORY FINAL

Volume Eight looks imposing off that 1:52-flat crush job when last seen two weeks ago in the Kindergarten final. He was actually stung a bit while trying to two-move to the lead past Purple Lord before eventually clearing through a :55.4 half. It still didn't matter, as he turned that race into a romp through the stretch and looks to parlay that here into a possible Dan Patch

award. Celebrity Bambino delivered on a 2/5 promise last week when he closed well, having to make up a couple of lengths wide into the stretch. He did have to fend off a surprising late inside threat of Kimmeridgian and I'm sure will now be keeping close tabs early on Volume Eight. Upstaged was finding his way through seams last week as a big longshot who caught the eye; Te Amo Lindy was weaving late, likewise. Kilmister was all the rage early in the season.

Picks: Volume Eight, Upstaged, Celebrity Bambino

RACE 6, \$140,000 TVG MARES TROT FINAL

The storied career of Atlanta comes to an end where she'll square off against When Dovescry for the umpteenth time, as well as rival Bella Bellini. Atlanta couldn't get that elusive Breeders Crown win last month but was still a very good second when racing on the front end. In that race, Bella Bellini always had the look of a winner the moment she was tipped off cover. When Dovescry tired after an extended first-over trip in the Breeders Crown; was outkicked by Atlanta by nearly a full second in their recent qualifier and I believe she'll be returning to the races in 2023. Refined had some good late trot to offer in the Breeders Crown.

Picks: Bella Bellini, Atlanta, Refined

RACE 7, \$428,400 THREE DIAMONDS FINAL

Strong Poison went a tough trip in the Breeders Crown won by Sylvia Hanover, and I think we'll get redemption here in the Three Diamonds. She had a no-shot journey last week from post 10 where even with a second-over trip wasn't really close, but steadily made up a ton of ground and lands an ideal starting slot. Bellisima Hanover found a late seam from the pocket to get by 1/5 favorite Charleston two weeks ago. Worth noting that Cultured was third in that same race and she came out of it to underwhelm as the favorite in the Three Diamonds prep last week. Zanatta pulled off the surprise win last week in part from an excellent Dube steer; will still rate a longshot. Vivian's Dream went a tough trip last week and seemed stalled at one point first-over but was surprisingly still in the mix late. Earthwindfire should have never sat second last out at 1/9 in a four-horse field and now is banished to post 10.

Picks: Strong Poison, Vivian's Dream, Bellisima Hanover

RACE 8, \$330,000 TVG OPEN TROT FINAL

What are we supposed to make out of this race? Yes, it's back to Dunn on Ecurie D who crushed in the Breeders Crown the last time these two were together, but this horse put in a definite clunker last week regardless of who was driving. Anything near his best would be good enough but does need to bounce back. It's Academic has gotten increasingly sharp in recent starts and two of his three wins on the year have come in just the last two weeks. Deserves credit for staving off Bella Bellini last out

and no doubt as to the racing strategy. Back Of The Neck should have been better in the Breeders Crown but maybe the post was a hindrance. From this spot, should be able to track cover just like he did in winning the Maple Leaf Trot and Dayton Derby. Jujubee got good earlier in October but feel that he now needs to prove it again. Lovedbythemas has been going at it all year and has knocked on the door many times against these. Incommunicado had some late trot last week once angled to the outside. Amigo Volo was a placing away from a 100/1 shocker in the Breeders Crown.

Picks: It's Academic, Back Of The Neck, Ecurie D

RACE 9, \$158,000 TVG MARES PACE FINAL

A couple of 3-year-olds in here taking on older and the question is can inseparable fillies Treacherous Dragon and Niki Hill go with 4-year-olds Test Of Faith and Grace Hill? I'm not sure. A bad post hindered Niki Hill in a game Breeders Crown defeat and she has another outside post here. On the other hand, Treacherous Dragon lands the rail and she's found a knack for getting her neck in front when it counts; anxious to see how she responds to the challenge. Test Of Faith was second to Treacherous Dragon in that qualifier, the first time they've been on the track together, but Test Of Faith outkicked her by three-fifths of a second, and seeks atonement from that Breeders Crown miss. It'll be interesting to see how Miller elects to drive her; I have no idea at this point as to what position she'll be in but the post is obviously good. Grace Hill has improved noticeably the past couple of months and was excellent at Woodbine Mohawk; seeks the early jump once again. Fire Start Hanover just sold for \$550,000 two weeks ago at Harrisburg; Nifty Norman continues to train.

Picks: Grace Hill, Test Of Faith, Treacherous Dragon

RACE 10, \$345,000 TVG OPEN PACE FINAL

It's one last chance to witness greatness in the form of Bulldog Hanover, as he'll complete his career and a 4-year-old season for the ages in the TVG Open. His Breeders Crown win was stylish, and he remains simply in different territory than anyone else; will

go out on top. Lou's Pearlman was solid last week in springing the mild upset; loses Dunn now, however. Abuckabett Hanover debuts for new connections following a \$534,000 purchase in days after the Breeders Crown; new trainer Andrew Harris also co-owns. Tattoo Artist will be blasting from the outside. He disappointed here last week but set the pace two back in a world record mile only to be bested by the pocket sitting Allywag Hanover; the same fate for Bulldog Hanover from the Red Mile in October.

Picks: Bulldog Hanover, Lou's Pearlman, Abuckabett Hanover

RACE 11, \$430,000 GOVERNOR'S CUP FINAL

Despite a 6-1 morning line, El Rey will take tote action and more importantly, is the one to beat in my estimation. Four races removed from a 1:49.4 win, he really picked up his game in the fall at Lexington and he couldn't have been any more impressive than when he found a late gear from an impossible spot last week in the tougher of the two Governor's Cup eliminations; best. Combustion, another sub-1:50 2-year-old, won his elimination last week but couldn't have had a better trip when he attacked from third approaching the three-quarters and got first run on a leader that eventually tired. Can win, but it won't be easy. Breeders Crown upset winner Ammo had the pocket trip in that race but was outkicked by Combustion. In the other elimination, Stormalong capitalized on a pocket trip to get by pacesetter Can't Stop Lou to deliver a \$30-win mutuel; heavily-backed favorite in that race came up empty. Save America had a second-over trip but wasn't fast enough late; a case can be made he's tailed off a bit (or others have caught up to him) since earlier in the year. If anything, big longshot Girldad was moving best of anyone in that elimination.

Picks: El Rey, Ammo, Can't Stop Lou

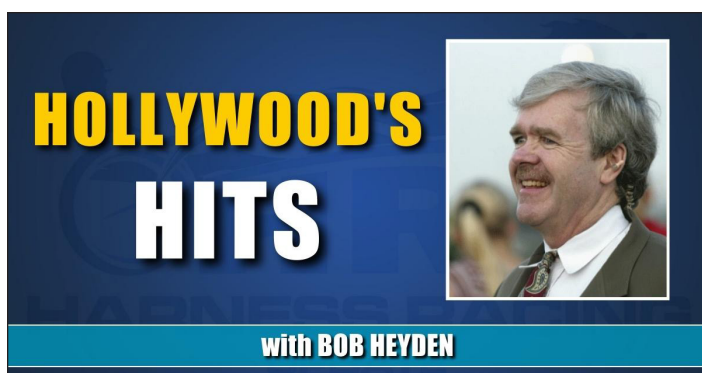

HOW MUCH DID YOU BET TODAY?



The colorful history of the Governor's Cup

It began in 1985 and to this day it is the only standardbred race ever to debut at \$1 million and follow that up with a seven-figure purse in its second year.

The first one, won by Barberry Spur, went for \$1,357,500; the second, won by Redskin, went for \$1,513,500.

Bill O'Donnell won the first two. Richard Stillings and Jerry Smith were the two victorious trainers, respectively, and to this day 36 years later Redskin still holds the all-time 2-year-old earnings mark for a trotter or pacer at \$1.407 million.

Let's go on to 1987. Oh, wait. The Governor's Cup wasn't held that year. After almost \$2.9 million, combined, in the first two years and the race was discontinued in 1987.

In 1988, a 30-year-old by the name of Tommy Haughton won the \$705,100 Governor's Cup. It was his biggest career win.

In 1989, John Campbell joined in the fun with In The Pocket for a pot of \$681,100. This colt would go on to be a prominent Down Under stallion.

This was the Gene Riegler Era. He is the only trainer to win this race three straight years and with superstars: Artsplace in 1990, Western Hanover in 1991 and Life Sign in 1992. All three went on to fabulous careers.

In 1993, Gallo Blue Chip's sire Magical Mike won the Governor's Cup. It was owner David McDuffee's unofficial intro to the big time thanks to a \$550,000 purse.

The late Kevin Thomas' CA Connection won the 1994 Governor's Cup, but that youngster is likely better known for being tied with Davids Pass in 1994 for the fastest fourth-place finisher in the Meadowlands Pace elims. He lost the coin flip with Davids Pass, who then won the final and CA Connection the consolation.

In 1995, Live Or Die won it for Val D'Or Farms (they won it 26 years later again with Early Action) and Bob McIntosh.

In 1996, The Big Dog and Joe Anderson took.

Chris Ryder's first major freshman stakes win came in the 1997 Governor's Cup with divisional champion Sealed N Delivered.

McIntosh won again in 1998 with the unheralded Island Fantasy and would make it three with Western Shooter in 2001.

Division champ and Breeders Crown winner Tyberwood won in 1999 for Richie Silverman and Gary Machiz.

Bettors Delight took the 2000 Governor's Cup. The all-time sire king repeated as divisional champ in 2001 at 3. Western Shooter is the very unusual Governor's Cup winner who never did race again. He lost his battle with a virus in early 2001 and left us all wondering what could have been. His 1:50 late-November scorcher is the stuff of legends.

Life Sign's son I Am A Fool was a convincing 2003 winner and a late-season sensation. Pat Lachance is the rare trainer/driver to win the Governor's Cup in 2004 with Syncros Z Tam. Jeremes Jet was clearly the best 2-year-old of 2005 and parlayed his Breeders Crown/Governor's Cup scores to easily capture the division, something Paul MacDonell would repeat two years later with Somebeachsomewhere, who was six-for-six, but done for the season by the time the 2007 Governor's Cup rolled around. Santanna Blue Chip, from the first crop of Art Major, took advantage in 2007.

No Pan Intended won the 2003 Triple Crown and his greatest credit as a stallion came in 2008 when Nebupanezzar won the \$647,800 Governor's Cup final.

In 2009, One More Laugh served notice of what was to come with a 1:49.2 stakes record for Tim Tetrack and Ray Schnittker. That son of McArdle banked over \$2.8 million when all was said and done.

Big Jim got Phil Hudon his biggest win in the states in 2010 for a \$709,000 pot.

Yannick Gingras got on the board in 2011 with A Rocknroll Dance, the very same horse who got him on the Meadowlands Pace board a year later.

J K Endofanera proved to be a handful every year he raced. He started his career with Linda Toscano for the Three Brothers Stable and captured the 2013 Governor's Cup for Brian Sears.

Artspeak won the division thanks to a convincing Governor's Cup win in 2014. Boston Red Rocks got hot at just the right time in 2015 winning both the Governor's Cup and the Breeders Crown for Peter Blood. Downbytheseaside previewed his award-winning sophomore season early by taking the Cup in 2016.

Captain Crunch in 2018 and Papi Rob Hanover in 2019 certainly left good impressions with stirring Governor's Cup triumphs. We eagerly look forward to their youngsters on the track shortly.

There is no doubt the Governor's Cup, which also was not held in 2012, has a distinctive history. More than three and a half decades later it remains a circle on the calendar of all horsepeople who dream of 2-year-old riches.

Beach Glass goes over \$1 million with win in the Progress Pace at Dover

Yannick Gingras aggressively drove the 3-year-old star to victory on Wednesday in the \$250,000 final.

Right out of the gate in Wednesday's (Nov. 23) Progress Pace at Bally's Dover, **Beach Glass** (Yannick) Gingras) and Pebble Beach (Todd McCarthy) stubbornly refused to yield the early lead as they blasted to the quarter together in a white hot :25.1.

Beach Glass retreated past the quarter and accepted the pocket trip. Pebble Beach was then able to grab the early lead.

Pebble Beach whistled to the half in :52.4 (:27.3) and crossed the three quarter beam in 1:20.3 (:27.4).

Mad Max Hanover grinded first over down the backstretch but was unable to gain any ground on the leader. I Did It Myway followed second over cover but also stalled on the rim.

Beach Glass confidently vacated the pocket, attacking Pebble Beach at the top of the stretch. Beach Glass, the homebred son of Somebeachsomewhere-Im With Her owned by the Schooner II Stable of Truro, NS and trained by Brent MacGrath, accelerated late in the lane and won by two hard earned lengths in 1:48.4.

The victory pushed Beach Glass over \$1 million both in lifetime and 2022 earnings. Beach Glass has earned \$1,079,649 this year and \$1,110,544 lifetime and sports a 12-4-0 record in 18 career starts.

Captain Cowboy closed from fifth and finished second for trainer Ron Burke. Corey Callahan drove.

Fouever Boy sat the rail and picked up the show position for trainer Tim Twaddle and driver Dexter Dunn.

Pebble Beach, the 3-5 betting favorite, tired and finished fifth.

Cameron Capone on the thrill of competition

The drive to thrive has always been part of Cameron Capone's life.

Whether it was during past days on the gridiron, the mat, or the field, or current times on the racetrack, the young New Jersey horseman has always enjoyed a good challenge.

And that's exactly what standardbred racing has provided him with.

"You're going to lose more than you win. That's just the way the sport is, but there is no better feeling than working with a horse to experience that thrill of winning," Capone said.

The son of accomplished driver and trainer Mark Capone has had a longstanding association with horses and horse racing.

While he doesn't remember all of the early experiences, and interactions, there are plenty of photos that depict an immediate fascination and enjoyment of the pacers and trotters that were under his father's watchful eye.

"I've always been involved. My dad always had a barn of 25-30 horses when I was a young kid. Honestly, he had me on a jog cart when I was 2. By the time I was 10, I was training in the race bike. I feel like I always had a connection to racing and the horses. I enjoyed being around the horses and being on the track, just loving what my dad was doing."

The younger Capone's passion for equine athletes and the sport they competed in continued to grow over the years.

It was during his mid-teens when he began to realize a horse racing career was for him. A few years later, when he attended college, that feeling heightened.

"Probably when I was around 16, I knew that I wanted to do it. My dad really pushed me to go to college, and when I was there, that was when I realized I really wanted to do it."

Working alongside his father, Cameron was an eager student, gathering up invaluable tips and pointers each day he was at the barn.

The more he worked with the horses, the more it sparked his interest to one day go out on his own.

"My dad always told me to treat the horses the best way possible. He gave the horses the best care, the best feed, the best hay. He was committed to keeping them as healthy, happy, and sound as possible. His horses always looked great. The main thing that I learned was not to cut any corners."

On March 19, Cameron sat in the race bike for a qualifier at Freehold. He teamed with Miss B, a veteran pacing daughter of Art Major—Misbet, to finish third, albeit a far distance back from the winner.

Five months later, he partnered with Holy Grail N, in another qualifier at Freehold, with the end result a 4 ¾-length victory.

This May, he drove in his first pari-mutuel race, an out-of-the-money finish at The Meadowlands.

That very same month, he earned his first training win, the milestone coming at Freehold with 8-year-old pacing miss Madame Leza A.

"She came to me, and I was told, 'You can't do this, and you can't do that with her.' So, she didn't race with a lot of equipment. She finished fifth the first time she raced for me, but the next time, she cut the whole mile and won by three lengths in 1:56.4. She was really strong that day. It was pretty cool. I remember the announcer saying that she had plenty in reserve. It was nice to be able to get that first win, to give you that confidence."

A 7-year-old pacer named Davids Coming Home has also been a standout for father and son.

"My dad always told me to treat the horses the best way possible. He gave the horses the best care, the best feed, the best hay. He was committed to keeping them as healthy, happy, and sound as possible. His horses always looked great. The main thing that I learned was not to cut any corners."

The son of A Rocknroll Dance—Arterra, who has racked over \$208,000 in career earnings, first came to the barn of Mark Capone in 2020.

"We claimed him for \$7,500 at Freehold and then he romped next time at the same level. We brought him to the Meadowlands and he won in 1:52. Then he came back and we bumped him up in class. He didn't win, but he did really well for us, which was great."

Two months ago, Davids Coming Home was claimed back by Cameron, who co-owns the gelding with George Tackley and Wendy Storrier.

He also co-owns Passa Grille Beach, a 7-year-old son of Somebeachsomewhere—KuteKatie who delivered him his first sub-1:50 mile.

"We have five horses right now, but I'd like to get that number up to between 10 and 15. Next year, I'd like to have a 50-win season, if that would be possible. Those would be my short-term goals. I feel like everybody's long-term goal is to develop the babies and try to produce a world champion. I'd really like to be like the big barns and have 80-100 horses."

When he's not at the barn in the mornings or at the track in the evenings, Cameron, a standout multi-sport athlete in high school, jumps at the chance to relive his football days.

It's also a chance to feed his competitive nature.

"I really like to do anything. We're having a Turkey Bowl this week, with a bunch of football teams we put together. A bunch of my friends are coming, so that will be great. I played football, I wrestled, I played lacrosse... I've always been an athletic kid. I also like golf a lot. I've been playing a lot of golf the past few years. Anything that keeps me active puts a smile on my face."

Those pursuits, even when the final score doesn't count, are still a reminder of what's needed to be successful in the racing world.

Win or lose on the racetrack, Cameron feels privileged to be part of an industry he's admired for years.

"You can't get too far ahead of yourself in racing. You can always think you're the best, but there is always someone out there that is better than you.... unless you're Ron Burke. But pushing yourself to be at the top of your game, making sure your horses are happy and healthy, and giving them the best chance to win, those are things that drive me every day."

As for what the best part of his job is, it's by no means a surprise.

"You get to work with these wonderful animals, and you get to create a bond with most of them. I think that's the coolest part about this business. You bring people around the horses, and they usually always fall in love with them. That's what it's like for me."

Hip Hop Haufor left fifth over on the back stretch, covered by Hussard du Landret and at the top of the stretch Bignon attacked four wide with good speed.

Four-year-old Italiano Vero finished as well as the winner as runner up and third was Hussard du Landret, but he was moved down in the result list due to an interference towards Flamme du Goutier on the stretch.

Instead, Ampia Mede SM claimed the third and last spot for the Prix d'Amérique from Sunday's race.

The mile rate for Hip Hop Haufor was 1:56.3 over 1.6 miles.

Just A Gigolo attacked from third over with a half-mile to go in the 2,700 meters long race and before the last turn he was in front. Juninho Dry's last attack was strong and he approached the leader the closer the wire got, but Just A Gigolo held on with a nose in a mile rate of 1:58.1.

FRENCH TROTTER BEST IN MODENA

Laurent-Claude Abrivard had his 4-year-old **Carlomagno d'Esi** (Love You) in the race when the \$215,000 Gran Premio Unione Europea was on the card in Modena, Italy on Sunday (Nov. 20) afternoon and the trip was successful.

Alessandro Gocciadoro claimed the filly division, the \$80,000 Gran Premio Unione, with his **Clarissa** (Exploit Caf), who was strongest after a first over trip, and the dominant Italian trainer had a great shot even in the open division. His Charmant de Zack didn't get his chance to challenge for the win until it was too late, since Carlomagno d'Esi's driver Andrea Farolfi made sure that Charmant de Zack wouldn't get enough room to sprint.

Farolfi opted a first over trip with Abrivard's 4-year-old and Carlomagno d'Esi proved to be strongest when Charmant de Zack's last attempt was staged too late.

The mile rate was 1:57.4 over 1.3 miles.

GOCCIARDO AND SMORGON WINNERS IN ROME

Two finals of the \$160,000 Gran Premio A.N.A.C.T for 2-year-old trotters were held in Rome on Saturday (Nov. 19) night and Marco Smorgon-trained **Ebano d'Arc** (Bird Parker), paired with Andrea Guzzinati, impressed via a first over triumph in 1:59.1 in the division for colts and geldings.

Gocciadoro continues to capture big trophies in his home country and the trainer and driver won the filly division with his **Ete Jet** (Maharajah) after a trip in front. Ete Jet came home in 1:58.3





Killer Stripes completes DSBF sweep; Misty Coast suffers interference

With odds-on favorite Misty Coast eliminated from contention on the first turn, **Killer Stripes** had clear sailing to control the terms through the final lap and record a 1:55.1 lifetime mark in Wednesday's (Nov. 22) \$100,000 Ramona Hubbard Memorial, the final of the Delaware Standardbred Breeders' Fund series for 2-year-old pacing fillies at Bally's Dover.

As Dexter Dunn landed Killer Stripes in the pocket behind early leader No Gel Nikki (driven by Montrell Teague), overwhelming 1-9 choice Misty Coast stalked patiently in fourth before Art Stafford Jr. angled her off the pegs to make her move midway on the first turn. However, Misty Coast locked wheels with Direct Mist at the :27.1 first quarter, and the pair stopped abruptly.

Killer Stripes brushed to the lead at the bell, rated middle splits of :56.3 and 1:25, and edged clear of No Gel Nikki through the final turn. The Badlands Hanover—Tiger Style filly drew clear under mild encouragement to win — for the third time in as many career starts — by 7-1/2 lengths. No Gel Nikki was an isolated second, eight lengths clear of Spoiled Rotn Girl (Allan Davis), who just nabbed the flagging Clearlydreamy (Victor Kirby) for third.

Misty Coast never recovered and finished sixth in the seven-horse field.

Trainer Andrew Stafford co-owns Killer Stripes, who has now earned \$70,000 in her career, with Thomas Ireland and Bonnie Benson.

Killer Stripes paid \$10.00, \$8.80 and \$10.00 across the board; No Gel Nikki returned \$53.40 and \$57.60; and Spoiled Rotn Girl paid \$180.20.

In the \$20,000 consolation, Ezy Ranch Inc. homebred **Ezycure** and Montrell Teague sustained an extended first-over bid out of third to wear down pacesetter Spicy Tuna (David Rearic) and defeat her by 2-3/4 lengths in 1:58.4. Mavericks Missy (Russell Foster) rallied off third-over cover to finish third.

Cory Mumford trains Ezycure, a Barber Pole-Best Business filly with three career wins and \$44,150 in earnings.

PERFECT TWENTY COMPLETES DOVER DSBF SWEEP

Perfect Twenty completed a sweep of the November Delaware Standardbred Breeders' Fund series for 2-year-old trotting colts and geldings with a 1:57.3 win in his \$100,000 divisional final, held Tuesday (Nov. 22) at Bally's Dover. Royal Flirt captured the final for rookie trotting fillies.

With Carls Legacy and Hespeakshescores both off stride at the start, Perfect Twenty and driver Tim Tetrack had a fairly easy time clearing for the lead from post seven. The Yankee Royalty-Jetta Spring gelding strode clear of two other leavers — Kodack Black (driven by Montrell Teague) and Reddy Fox (Art Stafford Jr.) — to control a :28.2 first quarter. With just over a lap to go, Kodack Black revved up from the pocket to engage Perfect Twenty but broke stride at the bell, enabling Reddy Fox to inherit the pocket and Perfect Twenty to steal matching :29.4 middle splits.

Up the backstretch, Perfect Twenty opened a nearly three-length lead before Kodack Black worked back into second and angled off the pegs again for the stretch drive. Perfect Twenty dug in to win by a length over Kodack Black, who was disqualified and demoted to fourth after having gained ground while off stride on the first circuit. Reddy Fox, who finished third beaten 11 lengths, was elevated to second; I Got It Made (Michael Cole) was elevated to third.

"I had to be going forward, for sure I thought it was me and Montrell's race — his horse made a mistake but still made it a good race," Tetrack said, indicating that Perfect Twenty lacked the turn of foot that earned him winning margins of 13-1/4 and 8-1/4 lengths in his preliminary heats. "Usually my horse will take right off, but he was still good enough to get the job done."

Trainer Clifton Green said that the winner of six of 11 career starts and \$149,375 has been promising from the outset.

"He was always a big, strong colt, and very smart. Never did anything wrong from day one."

Perfect Twenty, who paid \$3.20 to win, is owned by Robert Allison Jr. and was bred by Jason Leid.

The Marv Bachrad Memorial, the DSBF final for 2-year-old trotting fillies, saw **Royal Flirt** and trainer/driver Kim Vincent stalk patiently from third while 4-5 favorite Miss Daburg (Pat Berry) rated early splits of :28.4, 1:00.3 and 1:30.1. Miss Daburg's early exertion to clear from post eight took its toll on the final turn, though, as Lady Brass (Russell Foster) made steady first-over gains through the far turn and took the lead with a sixteenth to go, only for Vincent to flip Royal Flirt three-wide around that rival and nab her on the line by a head in 2:00.4. Lilmisswontbewrong (Corey Callahan) rallied belatedly to overtake a folding Miss Daburg for third three strides before the winning post.

"This filly's just been getting better," said Vincent, who has long had a preference for developing young trotters. "She had some growing pains – big trotter – but she likes the big track. If you don't have patience with a trotter, you're not going to make it."

Royal Flirt, a daughter of Yankee Royalty—J N Payton bred by William Miller III, increased her bankroll to \$72,600 with her second career win for owner Bart Cavanagh Sr., competing as Providence West Inc. She returned \$13.00 to win.

Vincent and Cavanagh also captured the \$20,000 combined consolation with Royal Mistake, a Yankee Royalty—Tug River Woman gelding who angled out of the pocket approaching the far turn, took the lead from faltering pacesetter Youngbuck, and staved off a late bid from 3-5 favorite Starlight Lounge to win by a head in 2:00.1.

GAITWAY GUY CAPS UNDEFEATED SEASON IN DSBF FINAL

Gaitway Guy faced a stout challenge from Ajayi heading into the far turn in Monday's (Nov. 21) \$100,000 Delaware Standardbred Breeders' Fund series final for 2-year-old male pacers at Bally's Dover, but he remained resolute through the final turn and capped his undefeated rookie season with a 1:55.3 score.

Getting away from the pole in the field of seven, the Delmarvalous—Brussels Hanover gelding yielded to two outside leavers before driver Corey Callahan opted to make his move.

"I just wanted to get away as close as possible," Callahan said. "Timmy (Tetrick, driving Delightinthisglory) grabbed the lead and looked like he had his horse settled, so I made my move, and it was pretty much over from there."

Delightinthisglory worked through a :27.4 first quarter to clear Night Terror (driven by Roger Plante), and Gaitway Guy brushed from third shortly thereafter to clear the lead with a lap to go in the one-mile race. After a :57.4 half, Gaitway Guy was forced to accelerate nearing the far turn as Ajayi (Montrell Teague) posed a major first-over threat, making up six lengths

to work nearly even with Gaitway Guy at three-quarters in 1:26.3. Undeterred, Gaitway Guy found more, digging in to rebuff Ajayi's challenge and opening a three-length lead in the stretch while driven out. Delightinthisglory reclaimed second late over Ajayi, who leveled off after his sustained bid.

Following Gaitway Guy's seventh career win in as many starts – one that lifted his bankroll to \$142,400 – Jeff Smith indicated that the GTY Stable homebred took some early conditioning to develop the demeanor of a champion:

"He can get a little bumpy or on a line at times, but he's got the ability. He's done it every start. He was a bit of a problem child early, but he's come around."

Gaitway Guy, who has now gone off at 1-9 odds in five consecutive starts, returned \$2.10 across the board.

In the \$20,000 DSBF consolation, **Notte's Mist** overcame an eventful trip before drawing away to a decisive 1:55.3 win. He was embroiled in a three-way battle through a :27 quarter, ultimately taking back to third while Sweetest Swing pushed forward for control. After a :57 half, Notte's Mist was shuffled into midfield as Marshal Dillon mounted a first-over charge to the lead, but Trae Porter found room to slide the Powerful Mist—A La Notte Hanover colt off the pegs at three-quarters in 1:25.4. Once clear, Notte's Mist found another gear, overtaking Marshal Dillon at head-stretch and winning by a widening 7-1/4 lengths. Showdown Lynx rallied up the open stretch to collar a stalled Bad Boy Too for third.

Wayne Givens owns two-time winner Notte's Mist, who paid \$4.00 to win, for owner-breeder Reginald Hazzard.

Bar Hopping dies at 9

Trotting stallion Bar Hopping, the sire of 2021 Dan Patch Award-winner and Hambletonian Oaks champion Bella Bellini among others, passed away unexpectedly Monday at Hanover Shoe Farms, where he stood since retiring from racing in 2016. He was 9.

"There is no indication of what it was," Hanover Shoe Farms president and CEO Russell Williams said, adding an autopsy would be performed to try to determine the cause of death. "Whatever it was, it was unbelievably sudden. He had just been in his paddock a few hours before, and everything was normal. "It's sad. We really loved him. He didn't have a mean bone in his body. He was as nice as could be."

Bar Hopping, a son of Muscle Hill out of Cocktail Hour, hit the board in 21 of 28 career starts, winning 10. His victories included the Breeders Crown for 3-year-old male trotters and Canadian Trotting Classic, both in 2016. He was trained by Jimmy Takter and earned \$1.29 million lifetime.

As a sire, Bar Hopping's first crop hit the racetrack in 2020, and included Bella Bellini, who this year captured the Breeders Crown Mare Trot and Hambletonian Maturity and is approaching \$2 million in career earnings, as well as 2021 Yonkers Trot champ Johan Palema and Grand Circuit winners In Range and Pub Crawl.

Subsequent crops included Date Night and French Wine, both winners of Kentucky Championship Series finals this year, and 2021 Pennsylvania Sire Stakes champion S I P.

Last season, Bar Hopping's 3-year-olds ranked No. 1 for average earnings and No. 2 in total purses.

"He was a very promising stallion, and very sought after," Williams said. "There is no telling how great he would have become."

Bar Hopping was owned by the Bar Hopping Syndicate.

She created so many great racing memories here and we are honored that the Meadowlands is the track where she makes the final start of her career."

World record holder Bulldog Hanover will also retire following his TVG Championship on Nov. 26. This outstanding 4-year-old pacer \$500,000 William R. Haughton Memorial in a world-record time of 1:45.4 on July 16 at the Meadowlands. He rolled off 13 victories this season capturing the Breeders Crown title along with the Dayton Derby, Hoosier Park Pacing Derby, Canadian Pacing Derby, the Dan Patch, William R Haughton, Graduate and the Roll With Joe Finals.

A commemorative video will play during Bulldog Hanover's retirement ceremony and the first 250 fans will receive a ceramic mug commemorating Bulldog as the fastest harness horse in history.

"Bulldog Hanover gave us a 1:45.4 world record performance on July 16th," said Settlemyer. "It's only fitting he retires on the track where he gave us that spectacular performance."

Chapter Seven share tops PEO sale at \$182,000

Not long after parent company Preferred Equine Marketing sold a share in Walner for \$750,000 as the sale-topper at the Harrisburg Mixed, a share in his sire Chapter Seven topped the Nov. 21 Preferred Equine Online Mixed Sale at \$182,000.

The share was sold by Preferred Equine Online as agent and purchased by France's LeTrot president and prominent breeder/buyer Jean Pierre Barjon.

Among two lots that sold for \$102,000 was the winner of last Saturday's Open Handicap Pace at Saratoga, the New Zealand-bred speedster Allneedisfaith N p, 1:49.2-22 (\$555,843), who was consigned as agent for the Doug Overhiser and partners reduction sale.

He was purchased by Gestion R. Zane Inc.

With breeding season fast approaching, stallion shares proved to be popular on the day. Two separate shares in Captaintreacherous, who led the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale in average at \$154,429, brought prices of \$102,000 and \$100,000 and were purchased respectively by Joseph Parisi and the OK Corral.

Two more racehorses checked in with solid prices – Maximus Red A p, 1:51.3f-22 (\$236,977) was bought by Tomas Ceraso for \$64,000 and the last hip to be offered, Meadowbranch Noble 1:53.1-22 (\$157,518), was haltered by Bigsexycyca for \$56,000.

Leading seller in the broodmare section of the sale was the Ohio-bred stakes producer Cruzin Tothe Dance. In foal to Downbytheseaside, she was purchased by Doug & Beth Yontz's Anvil & Lace Farm for \$37,000.

Overall 26 lots were sold, for a sale gross of \$905,300 and average of \$34,819. Horses not sold are still listed on the sale page, with "make offer" noted, and for many, an asking price.

Sale owner and manager David Reid said quality horses in current form continued to meet or exceed seller expectations at the online venue. "Like with every sale, good horses coming in off impressive races are still commanding the best prices."

Pocono closes 2022 meet; Kakaley, Burke honored

The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono held its final of 133 cards for 2022 in near-freezing temperatures on Saturday afternoon (Nov. 19), with the meet's leading horsemen and retiring 14-year-olds feted.

Top purse event of closing day was a \$25,000 fast-class pace, taken easily by the Bettor's Delight gelding Ilikemebettor A in 1:51.3. Marcus Miller guided the recent import to the lead, backed off the half to walking-horse time of :57.1 even under the conditions, then dashed home in :54.2 - :27 to serve serious notice he will be a big factor wherever he will next race. Erv Miller trains Ilikemebettor A, who has posted a Stateside record of 6-4-1-0-\$48,000 since October 1 for Ervin Miller Stable Inc. and Douglas Overhiser.

In an \$18,000 co-featured trot, Secret Bro was out raw and challenging much of the last half, and got his nose past favored pacesetter Rich And Miserable on the money in 1:54.2. Secret Bro, a Dejarmbro gelding, is trained by Jennifer Bongiorno for JB Racing, Richard Weinstein, and Joseph Di Scala Jr.

Secret Bro was driven by Matt Kakaley, who was the leading Pocono driver in both the victory and UDR categories, and was congratulated for those achievements in winners circle ceremonies. This is Matt's first UDR crown here, and his second in wins – the other coming when he was 23 back in 2011, the last time George Napolitano Jr. did not take that local laurel (he was second this year, and on closing day was the leading driver with four wins). Kakaley's final stats for the year at Pocono were 1199 262-216-153-361.

Also honored was the winningest trainer at Pocono, Ron Burke, who harnessed 76 winners during the meet. The only other time the Hall Of Famer led the local training colony in victories, 2020, he completed a "Pennsylvania Triple" – being the winningest trainer at Pocono, Meadows, and Philly – and he has a chance to get a second Triple this year: he has the Pocono title, he won't be caught at The Meadows, and he is second to Per Engblom at Philly with five weeks to go.

The Downs also honored with winners circle retirement ceremonies four 14-year-old horses, a group of very solid career accomplishment (223 wins among them, and earnings of \$2,504,746):

- Chancellorcullen N, a Grade I winner Down Under before coming to North America, and a career winner of \$435,557;
- Hopetobefirst, a winner in all 13 of his racetrack years, and a sub-2:00 horse in twelve of them, including at 14, when he won in 1:53.2, just off his lifetime mark of 1:52.3 taken at two, and an earner of \$400,938 with 64 career wins;
- Lyons Johnny, who did not race at two but then won in each of his 12 years of racing in under 2:00, ending his career with 60 victories and a bankroll of \$486,537;
- Zooming, the only trotter of the group, who nonetheless won in sub-2:00 in all 13 of his racing years, rolling up 72 wins and \$1,181,714 in earnings.

Finally, seven horses changed hands via the claiming box on closing day, for a total of \$150,750. Those numbers brought the yearly totals to 554 claims at Pocono, with \$12,019,775 changing hands for an average of \$21,696 (mirroring the last day's average of \$21,535). Doubtless many of those horses will be back at The Downs for the 2023 racing season, the dates for which should be announced shortly.

Beyond The Past (Drew Campbell) left from post six to take the lead, leaving pylon starter Something Bettor A (Ron Cushing) in the garden spot for the duration. Beyond The Past set swift fractions of :26.1, :55.3 and 1:24.1 while Something Bettor A was breathing down his neck every stride. Halfway through the final turn, Cushing left the pocket and Something Bettor A switched into glide. Something Bettor A was clear by a length at the seven-eighths and as he headed down the stretch, pulled away by 1-½ lengths to win in a new lifetime mark of 1:53.

It was the seventh career win for Something Bettor A (\$4.80). The very lightly raced 5-year-old son of Bettor's Delight-Distant Memory is owned by his driver Cushing along with Kevin Sywyck. Heidi Gibbs trains the winner.

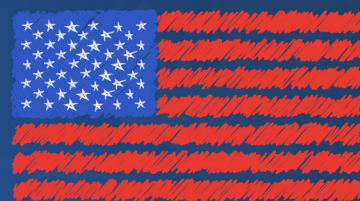
