Breaking down the Dan Patch Trainer and Driver of the Year contenders

Following on from **last week's column** that detailed divisional situations for 2- and 3-year-old equines, this week focuses on the human Dan Patch awards for trainer and driver.

TRAINER OF YEAR

Beginning with the trainer award, the Dan Patch comes down to three individuals in my view. Those are: Ron Burke, Ake Svanstedt, and Nancy Takter.

Takter won this award unanimously in 2020 when backed by stars Tall Dark Stranger and Manchego, and her resume this

year does every bit of standing up to that one. This year, Takter won the Hambletonian for the first time in her career with Tactical Approach, who together also won the Breeders Crown and Kentucky Futurity. Takter also campaigned star 2-year-old Karl; a winner of the Breeders Crown and the Valley Victory and became the second ever 2-year-old colt trotter to earn over \$1 million in his freshman campaign. It's likely that the award for overall Trotter of the Year will come from Takter.

Not to be overlooked either should be the work that Takter did with the 3-year-old colt, Cannibal. An accomplished 2-year-old last year, this was a horse that began his sophomore season in a couple of Stallion Series races in Pennsylvania, to spring an upset in a Meadowlands Pace elimination and then go on to win signature races such as the Adios and the Tattersalls Pace. Included in her high UTRS of 0.386 Takter also trained one of the top 2-year-old pacing fillies, Three Diamonds winner Caviart Belle.

Trainer Ake Svanstedt has been close on prior occasions to winning trainer of the year, and this year represents perhaps his most impressive one yet. It seems that if he wasn't winning every major trot race this year, he was always a factor.

Svanstedt was second in trainer earnings this year at over \$9.8 million, well clear of Tony Alagna in third at \$7.3 million.

Svanstedt's gaudy UTRS of 0.420 is the best of any trainer with over 100 wins this year.

In the course of the two nights over Breeders Crown weekend, Svanstedt took home four races, three of them on the Saturday night events. He won Breeders Crowns with Warrawee Michelle, Bond, Southwind Tyrion and Jiggy Jog S. Bond and Jiggy Jog S are certain to win year-end awards for their respective divisions, and honors certainly aren't out of the question either for Warrawee Michelle or Southwind Tyrion depending on how voters see things. Other notable accomplishments include winning the Maple Leaf Trot with Alrajah One IT, and capturing a pair of \$300,000 races with Up Your Deo in the MGM Yonkers Trot and the Earl Beal Memorial.

Like Michael Jordan's playing days, you could make an award-winning case every year for Ron Burke, a winner of the award in 2011, 2013, 2018, but this year even more so. Even by typical Burke standards, his performance this year was way out of the ordinary. Whereas \$20 million in earnings has become the norm for Burke, this year he's cleared an astonishing \$27 million in purses earned as a trainer. His UTRS of 0.358 holds up amazingly well considering that, by year's end, Burke will have posted over 5,000 starts this season.

Speaking to Burke's ability not only as a conditioner, but someone who also expertly manages his horses, he plotted a path that led to him training the richest 2-year-old trotter (ever) with T C I, and the richest 2-year-old pacer with Breeders Crown winning filly My Girl EJ. Between those two and another Breeders Crown win with Bythemissal who is presumed to also be named older pacer of the year, along with Hellabalou who upset in the MGM Borgata Pacing Series final, Burke won four separate races over \$500,000. He should also be given credit for the work with Canadian Trotting Classic winner Celebrity Bambino, top older

trotter and multiple stakes winner It's Academic, and with M-M's Dream, who was able to get the better of rival Jiggy Jog S on a couple of different occasions.

In a race that could come down to Burke and Svanstedt, my nod would be to Burke for a truly deserving year.

DRIVER OF YEAR

Scott Zeron gave some thoughts on the topic in a column last month so no need to fully replicate all them here, but I would tend to agree with his case.

Simply put, a resume that among other major stakes races includes the Hambletonian, North America Cup and Little Brown Jug has led to him capturing most of the driver headlines throughout the year. Even more impressively, in none of those did Zeron win with the favorite. He won the North America Cup with It's My Show in a moderate upset at the time over Confederate, won the Little Brown Jug with that same horse without the advantage of an inside post in the final, a rarity. And in the most impressive upset of all, he sleekly steered Tactical Approach to a 12-1 win in the Hambletonian.

With Tactical Approach, Zeron also won the Breeders Crown, Kentucky Futurity and the Carl Erskine. He also won the Jugette with Ucandoit Blue Chip as part of a memorable twoday span in Delaware, OH, and won multiple stakes between the Lady Liberty and the Perfect Sting with Silver Label. All told, Zeron won three of the four races offered this year with the highest purses, just recently went over the symbolic \$10 million in driver earnings this year, which will only further bolster his support.


Yannick Gingras returned to the top of the driver earnings standings this year, amassing over \$15 million in what was one of the strongest years in his career. Driving in stakes predominantly for the Takter and Burke stables, Gingras won two Breeders Crowns with Karl and Bythemissal, one from each of those trainers. In addition to his work throughout the year with Karl and Bythemissal, Gingras had notable stakes wins in the Canadian Trotting Classic (Celebrity Bambino), Three Diamonds (Caviart Belle), and the Adios (Cannibal).

Tim Tetrick will finish second in driver earnings with \$13.7 million as of this printing and a UTRS of 0.349, right behind Gingras' 0.356. Tetrick was excellent as a driver in keeping Confederate fresh throughout the year, and he'll warrant some attention for his role in driving what will be the sport's Horse of the Year. In addition to Confederate, Tetrick engineered an upset with Heaven Hanover from post 10 in the Hambletonian Oaks, and also drove Soiree Hanover who may win her 2-year-old filly trotting division.

Both David Miller and Dexter Dunn also went over \$10 million in earnings on the year. Dunn's had an incredible streak with this award and did win three Breeders Crowns to make a late-season case. Hall of Famer Miller has shown to any doubters that he's still got it and among his wins this year, his drive with TCI in the Mohawk Million was his most memorable.



Owner Bruce Areman on his lifetime in harness racing and his hopes for the future

There would likely be a chance that an involvement in harness racing would be pre-ordained if your first-grade classmates were ultra-talented horseman Jack Moiseyev and Barbara Dancer, daughter of Harold, Jr. (Sonny) and mother of Jennifer and Joe Bongiorno. Such was the case with the now 63-year-old Bruce Areman.

"I was born and raised in Freehold," Areman said. "Horses were always there or in the background. Jackie Mo and I were friends as kids. I recall being at the track and jogging horses while sitting on one knee and with Jackie on the other of Jack's dad Sid. Of course, Sid wasn't wearing a helmet and neither were we. Back then, there was no such entity as OSHA [the Occupational Safety and Health Administration]. Such behavior today would likely get all three of us kicked off the grounds. Sid was a terrific horseman and an even more wonderful person, as was Sid's father, Max. I remember both of them with great fondness.

"I've been involved with harness horses, first as a fan and later as an owner for as long as I can remember. The first horse I owned was a \$4,000 claimer named Dancers Tribute. Since then, I've owned entire or parts of numerous horses.

"I've been friends with Bill Pollock for almost all of my adult life. Bill has also been a fan and frequent racegoer for as long as I've known him. He would ask me to help get him involved in the business. I would put him off by telling him, and firmly believing, that I would only do so when the right opportunity presented itself. I know that Bill Pollock is not the type of guy who would be satisfied with owning cheap claimers or fractional ownership in horses owned by multiple owners.

"A year ago, last October, I was at Gaitway Farms to watch one of my horses train. I had become good friends with my trainer Andrew Harris. I had discussed the possibility of Bill becoming involved in the business with Andrew, but stressed that I felt that it should only involve the right horse. Andrew mentioned that Abuckabett Hanover, a very good horse, was being offered in the present online auction being held by Preferred Equine Marketing. He was a very good horse that would not go cheap. There was a partnership group that owned him. There were some of the partners who wouldn't part with him unless the price was right. That evening, Oct. 29, on Bill's birthday my wife and I, together with Bill and his wife and Mr. and Mrs. Joe Klecko were having dinner together. Yes, the former New York Jets star Joe Klecko, who is Bill's best friend and was best man at his wedding.

"I mentioned Abuckabett Hanover to Bill. He immediately was interested. 'Who will we get to train him?' he asked. He was already at the point where we owned him. That is Billy's way. He looks at the entire picture. When others are walking, he is on the run. I told him that Andrew Harris was the only person I would consider. We set up a meeting for Monday, the day that "Bucky" was to be sold. The relationship between Andrew and Bill immediately clicked as I was sure it would. We set our sights on buying him. Bill did not set a price tag. His assumption was that we were going to buy him. Abuckabett Hanover became ours for \$534,000."

Since then, you three fellows have increased your holdings to where at this year's Lexington and Harrisburg sales, you, in effect, blew the roof off.

"If Bill Pollock is nothing else, he is, firstly, a quick read and secondly a man with a plan. He is a true visionary. His plan was to develop a well-balanced, quality racing stable. In order to do that you would need to begin with young, well-bred horses who were to develop into the Bulldog Hanovers and Confederates of the future. Such horses are never available on the open market. You need to develop your own. We went to the [2022] Harrisburg sale with that in mind. We came out of the sale with two wellbred fillies Tandem Hanover at \$510,000 and Donegal Spirit at \$200,000. The results were sort of mixed. Tandem Hanover appears to be a very talented trotting filly. She won early in 1.54.2 when that was near as fast as 2-year-olds had gone. She then got sick and we thought it best to stop with her and give her time. We have high hopes for her in the coming year. Donegal Spirit won in 1.53.1f and earned some money. We also have high hopes for her as well this coming year.

"We had much more time to do our homework this year. Once the catalogs for Lexington and Harrisburg came out Andrew hit the road visiting the farms where the yearlings were domiciled. I would often tag along to help broaden my knowledge and enjoyment."

Before any of this happened, you added to the size and certainly the quality of your racing stable by purchasing Seven Colors.

"Yes. We bought him on Hambletonian Day after he had finished second in the Cane Pace. When we first bought him, the opinion of some was, "you got robbed" to shortly thereafter, "you stole him" after his ultra-impressive win in the \$300,000 Millstein Memorial. From there, we went to The Meadows to win a leg of the Pennsylvania Sires Stakes. Then the following week he won the Pennsylvania Sires Stakes final at Harrah's Chester. Then we went to Delaware, Ohio to race in the Little Brown Jug. That race, both the elimination and the final, were both a combination of my greatest thrills and greatest disappointments of all my time in the sport. The thrill being the great way he raced. The disappointment in getting nipped after doing all the heavy lifting in both heats."

From there, you and Andrew hit the road for the next two weeks.

"Yes. From Delaware, we went to Lexington where we visited several farms intending to look at and evaluate all of the yearlings on our list. We narrowed the list to 10. I asked Andrew how many of those would he be pleased to get? He responded,

'Three or four.' But Bill Pollock had other ideas. 'We are going to try to buy them all,' he said. 'Can you imagine how disappointed we would be if the one or two that we didn't get turned out to be the champions." So, it was. We bought them all."

From there, it was on to Harrisburg.

"Initially, our intent was to not be as aggressive in Harrisburg as we were in Lexington. Then on the morning of Day 1 at Harrisburg we spoke to Bill. He had a change of heart. Just go out and try to buy the ones you like the most. You have put a lot of work into this. This might be our only chance to get these kinds of horses. Like the man from Nike says, Just do it."

It is now said and done. You have 20 of the best-bred and best-looking yearlings in the world. Fifteen pacers and five trotters. They collectively cost around \$6 million. Do you have any favorites among them?

"Of course, it's still very early. Thankfully they are all doing as well as would be expected from them at this point. I can't narrow it down to one. I'll come up with two: one trotter and one pacer. The trotter is Hatfield, a full brother to T C I who I believe to be one of the greatest trotting colts I have ever seen race. [T C I's] race in the Mohawk Million was iconic, coming back to win after making a break at the start. The pacer is the filly Treacheryinthedark, the sister to Seven Colors who we bought for a record-setting \$700,000 in Lexington. In addition to her possessing an incredible pedigree, she is a fantastic individual. She is big and strong and seems to be very smart. How fast she will become remains to be seen. I was told that there were four different groups involved in the bidding on her at \$500,000."

How do you occupy your time away from your horses and your family?

"I used to own a gym in Freehold. In 2010, I went to work at Tom and Bill Pollock's Trinity Energy, a company at the cusp of solar energy in this country. I was employee number 60 which began as a business specializing in heating and air conditioning. There are now over 3,000 of us working there. It is a company devoted to not only preserving the environment, but also to believing in giving people opportunities. I can testify to the validity of that."

As proud as I am about the group of horses we have assembled, I am even more pleased with the camaraderie of our group, Andrew and his family, Bill and his and of course mine."

Twenty-one Group 1 wins for Vivid Wise As

Vivid Wise As (Yankee Glide) continues to win big races in Europe and on Friday (Dec. 8) afternoon, he claimed the \$105,000 Gran Premio Duomo in Florence, Italy, paired with Matthieu Abrivard.

Alessandro Gocciadoro's star hit the lead after a quarter of a mile and Vivid Wise As held stablemates Always Ek and Bepi Bi safely behind him in the finish as he won in 1:56.2.

This was Vivid Wise As' 21st Group 1-win in his long career. The International Trot at Yonkers earlier this year is his biggest win so far, followed by the \$415,000 Prix de France 2022.

JOSHUA TREE BACK AS A WINNER

Jean-Michel Bazire had a nice day at work when Vincennes played host to some big races during the Saturday (Dec. 9) afternoon card. After claiming the two initial races on the card, it was time for his top trotter **Joshua Tree** (Bold Eagle) in the third race, the \$125,000 Prix Octave Douesnel for 4-year-old colts.

Joshua Tree didn't get an easy way throughout the first turn since several drivers wanted to find position in front, surely with eventual nice cover from Joshua Tree in mind, and it was Italian star Dimitri Ferm who was first to hit the inside lane. Alexandre Abrivard, who sat behind Mauro Baroncini's horse this time, opted to let Josh Power go to the lead after a while and in the next moment, Bazire pushed his Joshua Tree to the front position.

In front, Bazire had the race under complete control and Joshua Tree looked stronger, gait-wise, than in his comeback two weeks ago as he sprinted to a safe win in a mile rate of 1:57.1 over 1.6 miles.

Dimitri Ferm finished strongly on the inside as runner up and josh Power held to third place.

The 4-year-old mares' objective on Saturday's card was the \$125,000 Prix Ariste Hemard over 2,700 meters. Favorite **Just Love You** (Love You) was seen in the front early as driver Alexandre Abrivard was eager to steer the race on the lead with Laurent-Claude Abrivard's mare. A quick change in positions ended with Just Love You in front with Italian trotter Diva del Ronco in the pocket as the field turned into the uphill part of the track.

Some well-merited Swedish trotters tried to challenge on the backstretch, but neither Bonneville W.I (third in the inside), Aurelia Express or Global Dancer became a serious threat to the leading favorite, who safely claimed the trophy in a mile rate of 1:57.

Diva del Ronco was as second and Jazzy Perrine finished quickly on the inside as third.

Enthusing Mr. Bruce

A study in harness-fan recruitment, Part 1

Mr. Bruce crumpled the *Daily Racing Form* and pushed it into my chest and said, "I can't make anything of this. Give me the harness program."

"It's in the back of that Racing Form."

Mr. Bruce was used to the chapbook-style Western Harness Racing (WHR) programs that were sold only at Hollywood Park. I hooked him on that format because it was I who took Mr. Bruce to the harness races for the first time in his life. I was used to the West Coast Racing Form's harness past performances since moving to Hollywood from my less-than-luxurious flat in Bel-Air. In Hollywood, I bought a Form at a local street newsstand to handicap the night races I would attend. The official program was only available at the track.

I was working regularly as a writer when I met Mr. Bruce. He lived nearby my one-bedroom apartment off Highland Boulevard. He was transposed from Queens, NY, and like me, he moved to Hollywood searching for a career in show business; that quirk of camaraderie triggered a natural friendship. Mr. Bruce was like most East Coast transplants hoping to make a living in "the business." Most of them I met around that time had something else in common; they were unacquainted with harness racing.

One night, I asked Mr. Bruce to come with me to Hollywood Park, just for the hell of it.

"You don't have to bet," I said. "Just watch it up close. It's cool and the place is never crowded."

He liked the not-crowded part because he was germophobic. A person sneezing 10 feet away caused Mr. Bruce to put his hand over his mouth and nostrils while walking another 10 feet away. He had nothing better to do, so he got into my Honda with an open mind about a new experience.

I drove us south on LaBrea Boulevard to the point where the urban scenery was thick with a Bukowskian [sic] atmosphere. I made a left on Prairie Boulevard to the parking lot. "Plenty

of spaces," Mr. Bruce said. We strolled to pay for grandstand admission and then to buy programs. We found a spot to hang on the apron as it was dressed for dusk. Long shadow stripes painted the backstretch as pacers and trotters scored.

"This is a mile track," I said, "and every race is a mile race. So, it's best not to watch races at track level, you know?"

Mr. Bruce knew that without any knowledge of racetracks. He studied film in New York and came west to be a film maker. He had an eye for scenes and angles and knew a litany of filming terms. He understood aspect ratio in photography and F-stops and all the rest of that technical movie-making stuff. We watched races on the apron at the finish line and from as far up the stretch as we could stand and from the grandstand seats at various spots and on TV monitors indoors where grandstand betting took place.

Once he ran out of brain film, so to speak, he asked me some questions about this and that and equines and horsemen and then I had a litany of terms for him. Especially when it came to betting. Like all beginners he had a timid approach to gambling on horses. He made one bet; two dollars to show on a horse that won. He got back his two dollars with 20 cents more while I collected the same per cent from a \$10 win bet. Mr. Bruce's interest was afoot.

The WHR meet had a good deal of dates left before the thoroughbreds took back their historic landscape, so I gave Mr. Bruce the only book I had at the time about betting horses: *Beating the Harness Races* by Aaron Bernstein (1976, Arco Pub. Co., 127 pps, 11.2 ounces, soft cover).

It was a rudimentary text but perfect to expand a novice's understanding of the sport (customer reviews were 4 1/2 stars out of 5). Mr. Bruce engaged with the Bernstein book more than I thought possible. I admitted I had no idea about Bernstein's prowess concerning the sport but Mr. Bruce, took it seriously. He learned the author's speed-rating system — something I did not calculate when handicapping — and before long he was betting to win.

Mr. Bruce's style of doing anything insisted upon precision. Aside from his meticulous approach and technical appreciation for filmmaking, he was an excellent carpenter (he gifted me with hand-made shelves for a kitchen) and he was a neat-nik as well as an avid reader of classic literature. He could appreciate and dissect the few moments of comedic brilliance in a Jerry Lewis movie and explain the films of R.W. Fassbinder with finesse.

And in 1978 I turned him into a harness racing fan.


Depending on health and legal situations, our annual Christmas parties consist of about a dozen misfits who hang together by the thread of the party and the steely determination of Aunt Sarah.

Gaitway Guy grinds to gritty DSBF win

GTY Stable's homebred **Gaitway Guy** withstood a sustained first-over attack to score his second preliminary win in the Delaware Standardbred Breeders' Fund (DSBF) series for 3-year-old male pacers at Bally's Dover, drawing away to a handy 1:54.1 victory in his \$20,000 second-round division on Thursday (Dec. 7).

Corey Callahan floated Gaitway Guy into third as fellow first-round winner Marshal Dillon (driven by Tony Morgan) pushed clear of Night Terror (Allan Davis) through a :27.2 first quarter. Not long after Marshal Dillon pulled the half back to :57.2, Gaitway Guy angled first-over and ground forward to engage the pacesetter nearing the far turn. The two hit three-quarters in tandem in 1:25.3, and Gaitway Guy struck the front on the far turn before edging clear of his six rivals off the corner for home. The Delmarvalous—Brussels Hanover easily put away Marshal Dillon at the eighth pole and sprinted 3 lengths clear of runner-up Big Truss (Hugh O'Neil), who followed the winner's live cover. Showdown Lynx (Art Stafford, Jr.) rallied belatedly to just miss second.

Jeff Smith trains 12-time winner Gaitway Guy, who paid \$2.20 to win as the overwhelming favorite and has earned \$249,400 through his career.

In the other split, **Meg A Bags** and driver Montrell Teague took full advantage of the open stretch and converted a pocket trip into a 12-1 upset.

Meg A Bags sealed off the pocket behind 4-5 pacesetter Bad Boy Too (Simon Allard) through a :27.1 first quarter and kept close attendance to the pace as Notte's Mist (Allan Davis) mounted a first-over push from third into Bad Boy Too to three-quarters in 1:25.2. With Bad Boy Too and Notte's Mist embroiled in battle turning for home, Teague dove to the open stretch with Meg A Bags, and the Roddy's Bags Again—Megginspin gelding surged forward to win by 1-1/4 lengths in a lifetime best 1:54.2. Bad Boy Too held second over Notte's Mist.

Jason Skinner trains Meg A Bags (\$27.00), a four-time winner with \$50,459 in career earnings, for Ryan Davila.

The eight qualifiers for next Thursday's (Dec. 14) \$110,000 DSBF series final are: Gaitway Guy, Marshal Dillon, Meg A Bags, Bad Boy Too, Delightinhisglory, Big Truss, Night Terror and Notte's Mist.

Slick Tony: New to Winbak Farm of Maryland

Winbak Farm of Maryland is dedicated to the strengthening of the Maryland program. In 2024, the farm is proud to announce the addition of Slick Tony, p, 2, 1:51.4f; 3, 1:50.2f; 1:49.3f (\$1,049,516).

"Slick Tony is a beautiful horse with a slick gait and extremely intelligent," said driver Russell Foster. "He was always easy to drive and showed speed early."

Slick Tony was a 66-time winner during his career. From 2 through 7, Slick Tony earned over \$100,000 each season.

At 2, he won two Delaware Standardbred Breeders Fund eliminations (1:54.1 and 1:52) and \$100,000 final (1:51.4 – last quarter :26.4) at Dover Downs. He won a Delaware Standardbred Fund elimination (1:54.3) and \$100,000 final (1:55) at Harrington Raceway (finishing a close second in the other elimination). He also won two Maryland Standardbred Race Fund divisions at Ocean Downs (1:57.4 and 1:56.4).

"At 2, Slick Tony was never worse than second in his 11 starts," said Jack Burke, general manager of Winbak Farm. "He had nine wins and showed his toughness and willingness to win from the first time he was behind a starting gate."

At 3, Slick Tony won two Delaware Standardbred Breeders Fund eliminations (1:53.1 and 1:53.4) and \$100,000 final (1:52.4) at Harrington Raceway and a Delaware Standardbred Breeders Fund elimination (1:52.3) and \$100,000 final (1:50.4) at Dover Downs (he was second in the other elimination).

At 3, Slick Tony won the Maryland Invitational in 1:52.2 at Rosecroft Raceway from the 7-hole against a tough field of older competition. He also won the Maryland Standardbred Race Fund division at Ocean Downs, open at Rosecroft Raceway (1:50.2) and open at Harrington (1:51.4 – equaling Harrington's divisional track record). He was also second in an open at Harrington.

"At 3, Slick Tony received an invite to the \$400,000 Milstein Memorial at Northfield Park after he dominated in Delaware," said Foster. "He showed he could go against and beat tough horses, like Lather Up and Dorsoduro Hanover, and finished fourth from the 7-hole."

At 4, Slick Tony had 16 wins. He won the Blue Hen open at Dover Downs twice (1:50.3 and 1:51), DE Special division at Harrington, open at Harrington five times (in 1:51.4 2x, 1:52, 1:52.4 and 1:53.2) and open at Rosecroft twice (1:50.3 and 1:51.1).

"He was tough as nails and willing to race any way you wanted to do it," said Foster. "He had a big set of lungs and seemed like he could go forever."

He was second in the Blue Hen open at Dover Downs twice, Great Northeast Series division at Harrah's Philadelphia, open at Harrington and open at Ocean Downs. He set his lifetime best record in 1:49.3 at Harrah's Philadelphia, last quarter of :26.3.

"Slick Tony was always a pleasure to drive, he was one of those horses that had his own personality [ears pinned back not in a mean way but almost like leave me alone and let me do my job]," said driver Montrell Teague. "He may not have always been the fastest out of the gate but if he was up close enough, he had the desire to win more than most around that last turn."

As an older performer, Slick Tony won multiple opens at Dover Downs, Harrington, Rosecroft and Ocean Downs. Slick Tony was Harrington's Horse of the Meet in 2019 and 2021.

"When selecting a stallion to breed to, race performance is obviously important but a strong pedigree is also crucial," said Burke. "Slick Tony comes from a strong family of rich performers and should be a great cross for many mares."

Slick Tony's dam, Queen Kathy, p, 2, 1:58.4; 3, 1:58.1; 1:54.4h (\$161,243), was Delaware's Pacing Broodmare of the Year in 2017 and 2018. She is a half-sister to three earners of \$100,000 and to the dam of Schoolkids, p, 2, 1:51s; 3, 1:50.1f; 1:49.3f (\$1,053,826).

Slick Tony's second dam is O'Brien Award winner, Games, p, 3, 1:56.3f; 1:55.2f (\$305,109). His third dam is the dam of Misfit, p, 1:49.4 (\$1,190,067).

"You don't become a millionaire without that hard-to-find quality of class," said Teague. "I think he will make a great addition to the Maryland program and wish him the best of luck."

Slick Tony will stand his introductory season at Winbak Farm of Maryland for \$3,000 USD.

"Slick Tony should be a great cross for mares sired by American Ideal, Art Major, Artiscape, Bettor's Delight, Dream Away, Rocknroll Hanover, and Somebeachsomewhere," said Burke. "If breeders have questions, our staff is available to assist with hypothetical matings."

Gingras, Flirtin Jk take Big M feature

It's not very often a Hall of Fame driver says he messed up, but that was the case in the Friday night \$17,500 high-end conditioned pacing feature at The Meadowlands, where Yannick Gingras guided **Flirtin JK** to a nerve-racking victory for those who bet the duo down to 1-9.

"I screwed up," said Gingras, who sits in the top spot in the driver standings at The Big M. "It wasn't a very good drive and we still won, so I'll take it."

Gingras was being a tad hard on himself, given the way things panned out.

It looked like just another day at the office for a heavy Gingrastrainer Ron Burke favorite, as Flirtin JK was away alertly from post 6 in the seven-horse field and led at the quarter in an anything-but-blazing :27.4.

Johnathan Ahle then opted to vacate the pocket and take the lead with 13-1 third choice Barrier, so Flirtin JK raced in the pocket. But as Barrier backed down the half to :57, Erinwood Yves got anxious in the 3-hole and rolled to the top at the five-eighths and led at three-quarters in 1:24.

Sitting a 3-hole at the top of the stretch at a nickel-on-the-dollar is no way to make friends, but Gingras found a way to stay in the chalk players' good graces.

"Once we got to the top of the stretch, in a short field, you're probably not going to get locked in," said Gingras, who found more than ample real estate along the inside with less than an eighth-of-a-mile to go to sprint clear of his foes by 2 lengths at the finish in 1:50.3. Barrier finished second with Southwind Sambucca third.

"Once we got room," said Gingras. "He paced right through there."

"I liked him the first time I raced him," said the pilot known as "The Green Hornet." "He's got some sore feet but he's been racing really well and we got lucky tonight."

Flirtin JK, a 3-year-old gelded son of Jk Endofanera—Mcflirty, returned \$2.10 to win while scoring for the fifth time from 32 career starts. He lifted his lifetime earnings to just over \$117,000 for owners Burke Racing Stable, Weaver Bruscemi and Gingras.

A LITTLE MORE: Gingras led the driver colony with three winners, running his 2023-Big M leading total to 119. Burke trained three to victory lane, and tops the trainers with 106 victories. Free past performances for every race of every Meadowlands card are available by going to **playmeadowlands.com**. All-source handle on the 14-race program totaled \$2,877,367.

On a special Thursday (Dec. 7) card, Brett Beckwith, 20, and Tyler Miller, 25, both recorded driving doubles.

The duo combined to take all four legs of the Late 50-cent Pick-4, which returned a whopping \$3,407.10.

The first of Beckwith's wins came with the Patrick Hlubik-trained 4-year-old mare **Bette Tina** (Betting Line—Dragontina) in the seventh race as the 4-1 fourth choice in 1:54.3 in a TrackMaster Series (rating of 74 or less) dash for fillies and mares on the pace.

"She was pretty good in her last start [when third at The Big M]," said Beckwith. "I had confidence going in."

Seven-week spring meet dates approved for Virginia's Shenandoah Downs

The Virginia Racing Commission (VRC) approved 2024 spring harness dates for Shenandoah Downs Wednesday morning (Dec. 6) at its December meeting in New Kent.

The Woodstock oval's seven-week season will run from April 6-May 19 with race cards scheduled every Saturday and Sunday at 1:05 p.m. The traditional fall meet will take place from Sept. 14-Oct. 27 pending VRC approval. A four-day meet at the Shenandoah County Fair will run from Aug. 28-31.

The track offered spring racing for the first time ever last year and will continue with a nearly identical plan in 2024. Racing fans in the Shenandoah Valley were able to wager on the Kentucky Derby in conjunction with the harness card this past May, and with the approved spring dates next year will be able to wager on both the Derby and Preakness.

The Shenandoah Downs simulcast signal will again be available via Twinspires, TVG, Xpressbet and NYRAbets and at tracks/OTBs around the country.
